CEO'S UPDATE

Wagering Post-Covid

Like many, I've probably been guilty in recent months of signalling a warning about the changes that might follow on from the cessation of the federal Jobkeeper scheme in late March. Having had the good fortune to operate continuously throughout 2020, the three codes of racing enjoyed a unique opportunity to command the limelight and attract new interest to our sport. That has positively impacted wagering in the current year and that inevitably flows through to stakemoney or, in other words, the wages which support the trainers, breeders and owners who put on the show.

In reality, however, it's arguable that not a lot has changed due to Jobkeeper ending. Most of the organisations which were initially on Jobkeeper came off at the end of the first six months (in late 2020). Also, expenditure on international travel is still completely restricted and will remain that way for most of the current year. Even when international travel recommences, a return to 'normal' is likely to be somewhat gradual.

In the coming days we will announce another positive return to industry stakeholders (for the month of March) through the Wagering Activity Payment framework (which rewards our people on the basis of wagering performance). The coming months will provide us with an increasingly clear picture of the extent to which our new followers will stick with us over the long term. On any evidence we have seen to date, it would appear that the obvious strengths and appeal of greyhound racing are resonating strongly with that audience.

Lily Pad claims the EASTAR Match Race Series

■ GAWLER

Sunday April 4 saw the running of the first ever match race series at Gawler greyhounds, when the Eastar Match Races were conducted. The Series is normally run at Angle Park, but as an extensive upgrade of that track is about to commence, the Series was transferred to Gawler.

Entry to the Series was for those greyhounds that ran the fastest times recorded over a qualifying period at Gawler. There was also an opportunity for greyhounds to try and better their times by running a solo time trial the week prior. The eight greyhounds were then matched into four pairs to race against each other, with the overall winner being the greyhound that was able to run the fastest time on the night.

Race 1 saw Lily Pad defeat Burning Nitro, while in the second race, Velocity Bottino was too fast for Threaten. In the third race, Stress The Point accounted for All Show, and in the final event Barbados Express was too good for Ned's Choice. The times recorded were then assessed, resulting in a very tight finish. Lily Pad, trained by Lisa Rasmussen, was declared the overall winner, with the fastest time of 30.77 secs, to just edge out Barbados Express for Ben Rawlings, running 30.78 secs, while Stress The Point ran 30.79 secs to take third placing for Nicole Price. So in a very tight finish, the three runners finished with just 0.02 secs between them, and to further emphasise the close result, the next two runners finished within another 0.10 secs margin.

Cup win highlights a big month for Air Marshall

Greyhound of the Month for March was Air Marshall for trainer Ray Murray. The flying son of Banjo Boy and Auntie Chopper had a terrific month of racing, winning three of his four starts, with the highlight being the listed Murray Bridge Cup Final.

Air Marshall started the month off winning his Heat of the Murray Bridge Cup in a sizzling 25.27 for the 455m journey and making yet another feature final. In the past he hadn't been able to crack the big one but he turned that all around at the Bridge leading throughout, against a hot line up and winning in fine style by just under a length in 25.42. After winning the Cup Final he then was beaten into second in track record time at Angle Park over the shorts before a sizzling 30.73 win at Gawler over the 531m rounded out a successful month of racing.

At the end of the month Air Marshall's record stood at 52 starts for 29 wins and 15 placings and earnings just over \$50,000.



Danyo's Wylie sets unbeatable new record

The Run of the Month for March was Danyo's Wylie for trainer Lauren Harris after his super performance at Angle Park on Monday, 22nd March in a Special Event over the 388m journey where he was able to run a new track record.

He began brilliantly from box 5 running his first section in a sizzling 9.76 with the track record holder at the time, Air Marshall, in hot pursuit. However, Danyo's Wylie sped away to win by 1.50 lengths in a brilliant 21.72, breaking the previous time standard by .09 and setting a mark never to be beaten with the Angle Park redevelopment starting this month.

Saturday morning meetings once a fortnight

The next meeting will be on Saturday, 17th April at the Murray Bridge Straight Track. This is the only Saturday at Murray Bridge for about 3 months with all others being conducted at Gawler.

The following meeting will be on Saturday, 1st May at Gawler which will be a Timed Graded Meeting-“Worst to Best” rating. Greyhounds graded into 3 categories. Maidens, 1-4 wins & 5 or more wins. Specific grades of greyhounds are not considered except for Maidens. Races-N/P with Pathway Prizemoney. Reserves will be determined by Grader. There will be No Guarding. Refer to “Time Based Grading” published conditions.

Final field will be a 6-dog field plus reserves, comprising of the greyhounds running the fastest times in the heats, regardless of their finishing position in those heats]

Breeders 2021 Prelude (2) heats on Sunday 25th April at Gawler

\$2,000 Heats of Prelude (2) for Breeders 2021 will be run on Sunday, 25th April at Gawler.

The series is for all greyhounds eligible for Breeders 2021 with the \$4,000 Final to be run on Sunday, 2nd May also at Gawler.

Gawler to race on Saturdays from May during Angle Park redevelopment

After advice was received from the Gawler Centrals Football Club and Gawler Greyhound Racing Club a change was made to the racing dates during the Angle Park redevelopment where Gawler will be able to host the fortnightly Saturday morning meetings from May onwards. This will also mean that the Murray Bridge Straight track will race every week on Wednesday providing a weekly timeslot for the straight track.

Murray Bridge Straight track will still race on Saturday morning,

17th April with the first Gawler Morning meeting to commence on Saturday, 1st May. The Straight track will commence a weekly timeslot from Wednesday, 21st April.

As the redevelopment nears completion in August there may be some further changes to accommodate venue availability as necessary.

Grading of City A meetings while Angle Park is shutdown

During the Angle Park redevelopment from mid-April the below outcomes will come into affect -

- While Angle Park is shutdown for redevelopment the City A meetings will be shared between Murray Bridge and Gawler. Murray Bridge will conduct back to back Thursday meetings allowing for Heats and Finals of normal and feature races. Gawler will then run back to back Sundays, again allowing for Heats and Finals of normal and feature races. This will mean that there is one Metropolitan [CITY A] meeting per week.
- Feature 515m races will be run at Gawler over the 531m and any 731m feature races will be run at Murray Bridge over the 680m [the 680m start will be available as the 731m boxes will be removed from Angle Park allowing for that distance to be available]
- There will be a 680m event with CITY A prizemoney at Murray Bridge each Thursday whether the meeting is a City A or Prov 1 to support the stayers during this period.
- These meetings will be considered as if the greyhounds have never raced at the venue. This will mean greyhounds will be grades Maiden, Grade 6 and Grade 5 to start with unless new into the state and regraded higher.
- With all grades starting from new [no higher than Grade 5 effectively] there will not be as higher prizemoney races per meeting initially with no high grade races being conducted. There will be a Best 8 each meeting over the 455m, 530m, 680m at Murray Bridge and a 531m and 643m at Gawler for this high grade money. [GRSA

will just make up these races]. Trainers need to write "No Best 8" on the nomination if they do not want to be in this event. If there are insufficient nominations for a Best 8 the Grader will make up normal graded events based on the current policy.

- The Racing Department intends to run Grade 5 Heats on a regular basis but may have to run Mixed 4/5 Heats to ensure there are races for these dogs. The Finals of these races will pay the normal stakemoney for Finals [Grade 5 or Open depending on grade of Heats].
- The Grader will give preference to 455m or higher at both Murray Bridge City A and Gawler City A meetings with the intent that no short course races will be conducted. However, if there was a need to run some short course this would be under "standby" conditions.
- When a greyhound wins a Grade 5 or above over any distance at the Gawler City A and Murray Bridge City A meetings they will NOT lose any grade 6's at other venues. The normal rule has been suspended.
- If a greyhound has already won a Grade 6 [City A] it should be eligible for Murray Bridge City A and Gawler City A Grade 6 if they have more Grade's to win as these are considered different tracks. They will still only be able to win one City A at each of these meetings if they do not win more races than allowed.
- There will be NO retrospectivity for grading from when the shutdown of Angle Park begins.

“Beat The Grader” during redevelopment

Our normal race schedule generally doesn't allow for any “Beat the Grader” scenario's, however, with the changes to both Murray Bridge Prov 1 and Gawler Prov 1 this is likely to happen which is an added benefit to owners and trainers.

It will be available for the Murray Bridge Monday Prov 1 to Murray Bridge Thursday Prov 1 and then the Murray Bridge Thursday Prov 1 to Murray Bridge Monday Prov 1.

For Gawler the Friday Prov 1 to Sunday Prov 1 could happen, however, there is only a few days between meetings.

Please contact the Grader for clarification around the “Beat The Grader” policy.

Order of preference track classifications

As approved from the Grading Review meeting last November the track classifications in the Order of Preference policy has changed to be more reflective of the types of meetings and races being conducted when selecting greyhounds.

This will mean that SA track classifications in the Order of Preference policy on the current schedule has been updated to -

- City = CTA (Angle Park Thursday, Murray Bridge and Gawler)
- Provincial = CTB & PRI (Angle Park Monday, Gawler Friday/Sunday and Murray Bridge Monday/Thursday/Friday)
- Country = PR2 (Angle Park Tuesday/Saturday, Murray Bridge Straight Track Wednesday/Saturday, Gawler Tuesday/Saturday and Mount Gambier Thursday/Sunday)

GRSA and OzChase have extensively tested the changes and believe they are correct.

Time Grading events are now being coded differently in the Grade of event with TG1-4W & TG5+W being used which will enable a better allocation of points for the WPS for these events which was approved at the GRP meeting late last year.

The Grading Department expect very little changes to the current selection of greyhounds for our meetings by changing the SA track classifications for the Order of Preference policy, however, it will align better with our race meetings. Please contact the Grader for further clarification if required.

Online scratchings now available

GRSA have now made scratchings out of drawn race meetings available for trainers through the OzChase system. This will provide flexibility for the trainers during their busy schedules. Trainers can still phone scratchings through as normal.

Once a scratching has been lodged, GRSA will consider this greyhound as requiring to be removed and will be published as soon as received on the next work day.


Any Late Scratching's cannot be made via online and will have to be phoned through to the stewards.

Please see below for the process of making a scratching via OzChase -

To request that a greyhound is scratched from a race, a trainer can select the 'Scratch Greyhound' action.

A greyhound can be selected from the dropdown on the screen. Once selected, the details related to this greyhound (ear brands, certificate number and microchips) will be displayed.

The meeting list presented to the trainer for selection will show those meetings where the selected greyhound has been allocated as a runner or reserve. If the greyhound has multiple starts at the meeting, then all races for this greyhound will be listed against the appropriate meeting entry.

Home and Away trainer fee announcement

As announced by Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) on 23rd February 2021 a Home and Away Trainer Fee scheme is being implemented from 1st April 2021 in order to encourage strong nomination activity throughout the period of the Angle Park Track Works Project.

Any participant that travels to a regional track not designated as their "home" track will be paid an additional \$100 above their usual \$50 for attending a GRSA race meeting.

Using the current residential postcode listed for each participant in OzChase, GRSA has determined home tracks based on the closest track by distance. For the sake of clarity; Angle Park will not be designated as the home track for any participant. A list of postcodes, home tracks and the fee structure is provided to the right.

Participants should review this list which will be used to determine how much is paid for each race meeting attendance.

GRSA acknowledges that it may be that geographical distance is not the best measure to determine a participant's home track in every circumstance. Anyone that feels they've been allocated the wrong home track is encouraged to contact GRSA and apply to have their home track denomination changed.

Current super bonus for SA Bred

The super bonus scheme is premised upon a 100% dividend to breeders for SA Bred greyhounds. The following is a summary of the bonus by race:

RACE SUPER-BONUS

Adelaide Cup [515m] - G1 \$12,500, Adelaide Cup second - \$5,000, Adelaide Cup third - \$2,500, Adelaide Cup finalist \$1,000, BGC SA Derby [515m] - G3 \$3,500, BGC SA Derby second - \$1,500, BGC SA Derby third - \$750, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks [515m] - G3 \$3,500, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks second - \$1,500, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks third - \$750, Gawler Gold Cup [531m] - G3 \$5,000, Mount Gambier Cup [512m] - listed \$2,500, Murray Bridge Cup [455m] - listed \$2,500, Group 1 victory (interstate) \$10,000, Group 2 victory (interstate) \$5,000, Group 3 victory (interstate) \$2,500.

The super-bonuses for interstate events will only be applied for series/events that are open entry. Events that are restricted by age or gender are ineligible for the bonus. Events that are exclusively open to SA Bred runners or incorporate other restrictions, such as 'sweepstake' events, puppy/auction Classics and Maiden series are not eligible for the super-bonus.

Comments on nominations marked "only"

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

Re-grading for all tracks and distances

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.



BEANIES AVAILABLE

Approved beanies are part of the GRSA Dress Code Policy and available for sale from GRSA. These beanies are GRSA specific and are the only ones approved, at a cost of \$10 and are available to purchase from the GRSA office's.

Breeders Support Program

Details regarding the Breeders Support Program for litters registered in SA.

It is crucial that GRSA receives receipts for actual and verifiable expenses relating to litters whelped for items below or else no support payment can be provided: Claims will be a Maximum of \$2,000 with FSI and Pup payment in addition.

*In the event that the 1st payment of the SA Bred Scheme is claimed as a component of the rebate, those pups will automatically be registered in the scheme with only the 2nd and 3rd payments still required.

The limit of the support as it relates to the [50%] contribution to the stud/sire fee component is equivalent to the full support value of \$2,000. The limit of the support as it relates to 'other' expenses is \$1,000. Excluded expenses include veterinary [pre-conception], rearing, breaking in or pre-training costs.

Draft policy releases coming up

In coming months we will release two draft policies for review to our sub-committees for discussion: the animal welfare and registered person licencing policies.

I urge everyone, when the time comes, to have a look and let me know your views. Your representatives are on the Industry Consultative Group (ICG) and I will let you know when we are at the stage of releasing the drafts to them. The aim of these policies is to set modern standards and to be a place where you can go to see where you are at in relation to those standards.

Rules

The Greyhounds Australasia Rules and the Local Regulatory Rules, together with the Greyhound Coursing Rules, are the primary rules that form part of the Greyhound Racing Rules of Greyhound Racing SA Limited.

As with most rules, they change over time. As a registered person, there is an expectation (and assumption) that you are aware of the current rules (or at least know where to find them to refresh your memory). The current rules can be found on the GRSA website, under the Integrity tab. I urge everyone to bookmark this tab. If you have a printed copy of the rules, there is good chance it is outdated. It always pays to check for the recent version. If you need assistance, please contact me.

Forms

Like rules, there are times we change our prescribed forms to fit in with changes to rules or procedures.

Again, please make sure you use the latest forms, as lodging old forms may cause delays. You can have a look at the latest forms under the Forms link, under the Industry tab on the GRSA web page; or, drop into the Angle Park office where we have a full set of paper forms on display.

You can lodge forms in person; by mail; or email. If you do not have a scanner, take an image of your completed form on your mobile device and send that. Please note there are strict timelines for lodging some forms, under the rules. If you run into difficulty, please let us know so we are aware.

Kennel Inspections

Welfare Compliance Team members will continue routine kennel inspections in the lead up to the yearly licence renewal period.

Kennel inspections are important to ensure that greyhounds are kept in the best possible environment, safe and comfortable for them.

Covid-19 Update

Regrettably, the spectre of COVID-19 is still with us with the setbacks to the vaccine roll-out. It appears we will need to live with it for longer than we all hoped.

The rules from the police change regularly and GRSA responds to the latest changes to ensure our facilities comply with their requirements. I want to thank everyone for doing their bit in this area. You can see the latest changes under Stewards' Reports on the GRSA web page. In a nutshell, please continue to use the QR check-in when you attend a facility. GRSA does not access this data – it is digitally scrambled. I recently had the pleasure of meeting one of the programmers for the COVID-SAFE check-in app – a very talented SA local. After a chat about the app, I can assure everyone that the data is extremely safe and private. If you are not able to use the app, please see staff to complete a paper registration form. GRSA, after the required period [28-days] securely shreds the check-in forms. GRSA does not keep or release that data. The only time GRSA will release that data will be upon requirement by SA Health or assisting police. To date, we have not received any requests.

Angle Park Shutdown

With the Angle Park shutdown, you might not be able to drop in to collect any forms or other material that is available from the office.

If you need any help at all, please contact us and we will get the material to you. I intend to visit the Gawler, Murray Bridge and Virginia tracks during the shut-down, to run a 'mobile office'. Please come and see me if you need anything.

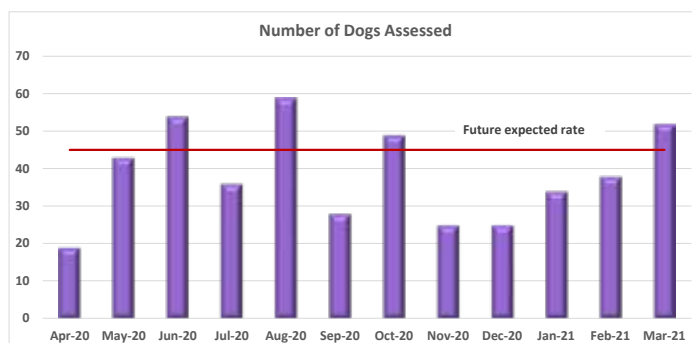

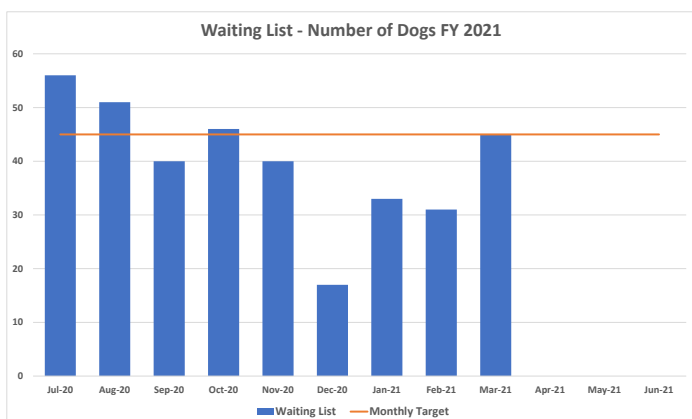
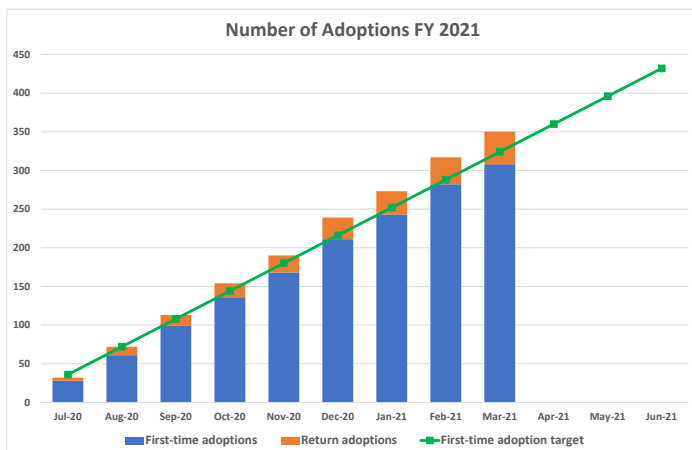
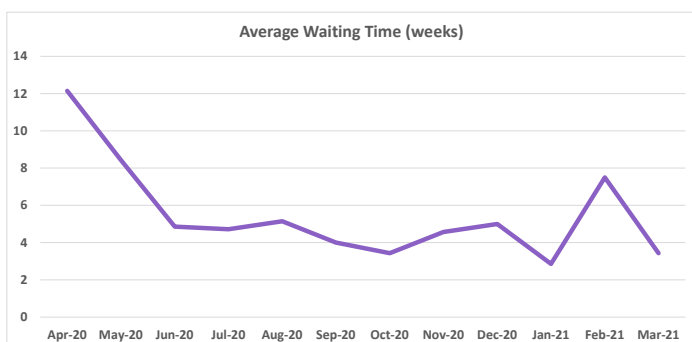
Latest updates from GAP

Meeting commenced at 11.40am. Shaun Mathieson, Racing Manager, thanked those attending in person, via phone and via Zoom. He welcomed both Bosco Stamenkovic and Tony Rasmussen to the panel and looked forward to their contribution.

He expressed his appreciation of long standing Grading Review Panel member Anthony "Tiny" McLean who has contributed on the GRP for at least 20 years and been a part of much of the grading initiatives under taken during that time. Unfortunately due to health issues and timing he stepped down from his role and the GRP wished him the best and thanked him for his long term contribution.

1. Minutes From Previous Meeting

The panel approved the minutes from the previous GRP meeting held on 30/11/20.

2. Business Arising

The Racing Manager provided a general verbal update to the panel on those items introduced from the last meeting. The panel were comfortable that no further updates were required as some items exist in the Agenda.

3. Agenda Items

305m Time Grading at Mt Gambier - The panel were supportive of Thursday meetings at Mt Gambier being Time Graded events (Maidens, 1-4 wins and 5+ wins) with only 400m plus events programmed and only the Sunday meetings having the new 305m distance included under specific conditions along with normal grading. This would enable a few extra races of different dogs on the Sunday where races are required.

Mt Gambier 305m Events - The panel were supportive of the current 305m restricted conditions of - Only two 305m races on Sundays, one for young Maiden greyhounds with the youngest greyhounds gaining entry first based on age. There will also be a Masters 305m with eligible greyhounds being selected on age with the oldest given first preference. Masters conditions are the same as races conducted in the Metro area with greyhounds 3¾ years and above eligible.

However the panel mentioned that the Club would be interested in running an extra 305m young Juvenile race if there were sufficient nominations. It was also suggested a Juvenile race could be programmed over the 305m for when the Maiden dog wins they can race in a Juvenile rather than straight to a 400m event. The panel advised the RM to liaise with the Club regarding these changes but were supportive of these options.

Actions: The RM to liaise with the Mt Gambier GRC in regard to Maiden and Juvenile 305m events as a possible addition to the Sunday program

Masters Times – The panel discussed that there has not yet been an allocated for the 305m time band for Masters or for Time Grading at Mt Gambier as yet so there is currently no time for this distance until more races are conducted. The panel were satisfied for this and advised that when a time is available, through more races being run, then to implement.

The panel were also advised that with the changes in the Time Grading file over a period of time that the current times for all Masters Events at each track were now not in the middle of the [5] Time Band. Members felt that most participants racing in these events understood the time's when they went faster making them ineligible of slower allowing them to stay in these events. They were comfortable with the current time cut off for Masters and believed they should be left as they are and have no reference to the Time Band.

The panel however did believe that whilst Masters are only really run at Gawler 400m, Angle Park 388m and the occasional 515m event at Angle Park that the Murray Bridge Straight Track times should be adjusted

outwards. With Angle Park shutting down there may be more Masters Races run at the Straight Track venue. The SPM will update the Times for Murray Bridge.

Actions: The RM is to leave the Masters Time bands as published and the SPM to look to wind out the Straight Track times at Murray Bridge for Masters events

Online Scratchings And Nominations – The panel were advised that with the assistance of Christine Costa, GRSA has been able to transition many trainers from fax nominations to online nominations leaving only a few people who continue to fax. The RM advised that we will continue to work with them as they transition. The panel were appreciative of the assistance Christine has provided going out of her own way to help these trainers.

The panel were advised that GRSA have now made scratching's out of drawn race meetings available for trainers through the Ozchase system, effective immediately. This will provide flexibility for trainers during their busy schedules. Trainers will still have the option of phone scratching's as normal.

Once a scratching has been lodged, GRSA will consider this greyhound as requiring to be removed and will be published as soon as possible or the next working day. Any Late Scratching's cannot be made via online and will have to be phoned through to the Stewards. The panel were supportive of this addition to the Ozchase system.

Actions: The RM to advertise the availability of the Online Scratching process to industry. Effective immediately

Grading Review Panel Members - The RM advised that after advertising for positions on the GRP that he had received three new applications from Tony Rasmussen, Bosco Stamenkovic and Christine Costa. Based on these applications the GRSA Board and Management made some changes to the panel.

It was confirmed that both Ben Rawlings and Kim Johnstone will continue in their roles for another 2 years.

With long serving GRP member Anthony McLean standing down from the panel Petar Jovanovic will move to the Wagering background with Tony Rasmussen added to the panel as the Mature Professional Trainer. Bosco Stamenkovic will fill the role with a Breeding background on the panel. GRSA was appreciative of Christine's application however as she already sits on the ICG panel it was felt she should not be added at this time.

Grade 6 Non SA Bred Maximum of 12 Lifetime Wins – The panel confirmed when a Non SA bred greyhound wins 12 lifetime races it will also lose its Grade 6 races like the SA Bred dogs even if they have some Grade 6's still left.

From the last meeting again the panel discussed the Grade 6 rules and the 12 wins for an SA Bred dog and 4 for a Non SA Bred dog. After a lengthy discussion the panel believed there were too many considerations to make any changes at present however will also discuss these rules at each meeting.

With some participants not familiar with the Grading Policy the panel believed a kennel house meeting about Grading or filming some crucial Grading items could be of benefit for those who do not understand the Grading policy. The RM advised that this could be done. The RM also advised the panel that the Grader and he needed to collate a Grading Policy book available for participants which the panel agreed with.

Actions: The RM to organise a kennel house meeting and liaise regarding filming Grading items along with the policy book

Grading Of City A Meetings When Angle Park Shutdown – The panel discussed the grading implications when Angle Park is redeveloped in mid April and out of action for a 3 – 4 month period. They agreed to outcomes listed below -

- When Angle Park is shutdown for redevelopment that the City A meetings will be shared with Murray Bridge and Gawler. Murray Bridge will conduct back to back Thursday meetings allowing for Heats and Finals of normal and feature races. Gawler will then run back to back Sundays again allowing for Heats and Finals of normal and feature races. This will mean that there is one Metropolitan [CITY A] meeting per week.

- Feature 515m races will be run at Gawler over the 531m and any 731m feature races will be run at Murray Bridge over the 680m [the 680m start will be available as the 731m boxes will be removed from Angle Park once redevelopment starts allowing for that distance to be available]
- The panel suggested there should be a 680m CITY A prizemoney at Murray Bridge each Thursday every week whether City A or Prov 1 to support these stayers during this period. The RM and Grader supported this suggestion.
- These meetings will be considered as if the greyhounds have never raced at the venue. This will mean greyhounds will be grades Maiden, Grade 6 and Grade 5 to start with unless new into the state and regraded higher.
- With all grades starting from new [no higher than Grade 5 effectively] there will not be as higher prizemoney races per meeting initially with no high grade races being conducted. There will be a Best 8 each meeting over the 455m, 530m, 680m at Murray Bridge and a 531m and 643m at Gawler for this high grade money. [GRSA will just make up these races]. The panel felt that trainers would need to write "No Best 8" on the nomination if they do not want to be in this event. If there are insufficient nominations for a Best 8 the Grader will just make up normally graded events based on current policy.
- The panel were advised that participants will still end up with 50% of Net Wagering Venue regardless of stake money levels which they understood.
- As there are only two meetings a month at each venue the panel were advised that it will be slow going moving through the grades. The Racing Department intends to run Grade 5 heats on a regular basis but may have to run Grade 4/5 heats to ensure there are races for these dogs. The finals of these races will pay the normal stake money for Finals [Grade 5 or Open depending on grade of Heats].
- The Grader will give preference to 455m or higher at both Murray Bridge and Gawler City A meetings with the absolute intent that no short course races will be conducted. The panel believed all the current Thursday night greyhounds will support these meetings and there should be no need to run short course at these meetings.

However if there was a need to run some short course this would be under "standby conditions". There panel were provided with a stake money breakdown for consideration for short course on the off chance they were needed which took into account the Prov 1 prizemoney for short course and the CITY A sprint distance stake money. The panel believed there should be no short course Maiden considered at all for these meetings. They believed that if there were 10 races of 455m and above then there should only be 10 races conducted with the short course running elsewhere. The panel were comfortable with this prizemoney level however wanted to ensure there was no incentive to run short course on these CITY A meetings and that Management gave priority to all 455m plus events.

- The panel discussed the Grade 6 rule for Angle Park City A meetings during the redevelopment period when a greyhound wins a Grade 5 515m event at the venue and will lose its Grade 6's at other venues. The panel believed there should be an embargo on the rule during this period meaning a greyhound can win a Grade 5 or above over any distance at the Gawler City A and Murray Bridge City A meetings and will NOT lose any grade 6's at other venues. The RM and Grader agreed to this policy.
- The panel agreed that if a greyhound has already won a Grade 6 [City A] it should be eligible for MB CITY A and GAW CITY A Grade 6 if they have more Grade's to win as these are considered different tracks. They will still only be able to win one CITY A at each of these meetings if they do not win more races that allowed.
- The panel agreed there will be NO retrospectivity for Grading when the shutdown of Angle Park occurs.
- The panel discussed feature races during the period of the Angle Park shutdown. The RM advised previously that it had been determined that for the Breeders 2021 series that the preludes will be conducted at Gawler and Murray Bridge [when Angle Park is shutdown] with the Group 3 Howard Ashton Final to be run at Angle Park when redevelopment has completed. The Racing Manager advised his intent to run the preludes before the Group 3 however with a date still not set for redevelopment the panel should consider running the Group 3 series at Gawler. This original idea was based on the Angle Park shutdown from 1st March. The RM advised that if the redevelopment doesn't allow racing to occur before late August/September then this could run into the Oaks & Derby where there is a 1 month cross over of dogs. It also doesn't give a lot of time for dogs to prepare on a new track and there would be a 2 ½ month gap between the last prelude and Group 3 series. The panel were mindful of the preference to be run at Angle Park and that participants had paid up for the series however they also understood the benefits of running it in the normal timeslot at Gawler. Allowing the Produce to follow this series

and allowing for all other feature races to flow as normal. The panel were leaning more to running at Gawler in normal time frames however the RM did advise this was on the agenda for the ICG panel to be discussed on Friday 19th March. He advised the GRP comments would be conveyed at that meeting.

Actions: The RM to action the above for Grading when the shutdown of Angle Park commences.

Order Of Preference Changes And Weighted Points Still Being Altered – The panel were advised from the last GRP meeting that the Order of Preference changes are close to implementation. This will mean that new SA track classifications in OOC document are

- a. City = CTA [Angle Park Thursday]
- b. Provincial = CTB & PR1 [Angle Park Monday, Gawler Sunday Murray Bridge Friday]
- c. Country = PR2 [Angle Park Tuesday, Gawler Wednesday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Mt Gambier Thursday/Sunday]

The panel were advised that the Weighted Points are also close to implementation however the RM did confirm the immediate change of greyhounds that finish between 6 and 8 get the same points as if they finished 6th so there was no difference from a 6 dog field to an 8 dog field.

Actions: The RM to action changes to Order of Preference report when finalised along with the changes to the WPS allocation for Time Graded events.

Time Rating Displayed In Ozchase – The panel were advised that the RM was working on having the Time Rating available on the Online Nominations screen where the Grades of the dogs are viewed. He advised that the rating will change after every performance as it is calculated live. He advised the panel this could take a couple of months until implemented.

The panel were happy for this to be implemented.

Submissions –

Ben Rawlings tabled a submission from Lachlan Mill. The submission referred to a Maiden greyhound being allowed to nominate for a Grade 6 event if there is no race for the greyhound. The panel generally didn't think having a Maiden dog nominate for a Grade 6 was acceptable as this could open up a lot of issues from distance of race, race wins etc. The RM suggested going back to the Maiden/1 win Grade 6 as Mt Gambier conduct on occasions and once when nominations were really short on the straight track. The panel still believed it was best for Maiden's to race in Maiden events. They suggested qualifying trials to gain a start however understood it was a straight track and number of nominations issue. The RM thanked Lachlan for his submission but advised no change to policy at present.

Late Items –

The panel discussed the Grading of Tasmanian greyhounds coming into SA and that Hobart 461m is considered their Metro Track however pays similar prizemoney to all other meetings in that State. The SPM advised that GRV rate Tasmanian form the same as Adelaide form [provincial] and that most meetings carry the same prizemoney. The panel believed that Tasmanian form at Hobart on their "Metro" track be exempted from the grading guidelines the same as Darwin form meaning that for grading purposes there is no Metro meetings in Tasmania.

Actions: The RM to action the above change excluding Tasmanian "Hobart" form from the Grading Guidelines as a Metro track.

The panel also discussed other prizemoney in other states increasing to a level that could be considered Metro stakes compared to SA prizemoney however only being run at Provincial meetings. The RM advised there are plenty of changes occurring in each state however felt the classification for now was reasonable.

The Grader advised the panel that most of his queries come from the mixing of greyhounds in races. Whilst we guard trainers for general grading greyhounds are mixed by race wins [with most wins in higher grade] which some trainers have trouble accepting. He queried was there a better way of mixing greyhounds? The SPM advised in Victoria they use Aged Prizemoney and members of the panel believed prizemoney was not a bad outcome if we wanted to change. Other members were comfortable with the Race wins as a fair way to mix greyhounds. For now the panel agreed to leave everything the same.

Next Meeting – May, August and November [days and dates TBD]

Des has a Future Star on his hands with Crazy Diva

GAWLER

Sunday night, 11th April at Gawler greyhounds brought out a good crowd again to watch great racing, which featured the Future Stars race. The Future Stars is one of many races available for younger greyhounds, with the qualification on this occasion being for SA bred greyhounds, which were whelped in 2019.

Run over the 531m journey, a full field of eight runners was engaged. Crazy Diva jumped away the best from box 1, to take an early lead from Missing Grace [2] and Way Too Much [3] trying to push through. Around the first turn, Crazy Diva was able to kick away from the others, opening up a handy three length break down the back straight. Frodo Baggins [6] started to run on from midfield and looked some chance to challenge the leader, but was not able to narrow the margin, leaving Crazy Diva with a comfortable win by nearly four lengths. Gemtree Maximus [8] made up some ground after running into trouble on a couple of occasions, to finish second for Paul Rehmann of Murray Bridge, with Concede [7] racing into third spot for Clint Trengrove of Lewiston.

Crazy Diva is trained by Lewiston based Des Hockley and is raced by the Bazinga Syndicate, managed by his partner Renata Maruszczuk. Crazy Diva is from the third litter out of Just Crazy, but Renata was unable to attend as she was caring for a newly whelped litter from Crazy Again, a daughter of Just Crazy. Des was appreciative of the assistance on the night from Brenda Oakey, who has greyhounds of her own with Des, and is

always willing to lend a hand.

Des has had a lot of success with Crazy Diva, which has now notched up 12 wins and 5 placings from just 22 starts. Crazy Diva had run second to her littermate Far More Crazy at the recent Gawler Breeder's Classic, but this time she took out a feature in her own right. The litter overall has been very successful, with eight of the litter of nine having won at least a race.

The next feature event for young greyhounds is the Produce Series, to be run at Gawler in July, and Des is hopeful that three from this litter, Crazy Diva, Far More Crazy and Sometime Crazy, will be at their best to

contest the Series. Looking to the future, Des has a seven month old litter from top stud dog Fernando Bale from Qomie Bale to follow on. Interestingly, Des chooses to educate all his dogs through to the racing stage, and he can be proud of the results he receives at the track.

With the closure of Angle Park track for four months due to a major upgrade, there are plenty of opportunities to enjoy greyhound racing at Gawler in the coming months. During this period, there is racing on Tuesday and Friday afternoons, as well as the popular Sunday nights, and for something different, racing on alternate Saturday mornings from May.

Sometimes you never know where a good one's coming from

It was back in 2008 that Nathan Wilson and his wife Kerri, along with his sister Melissa and her husband Ken Trowbridge, first became interested in greyhound racing.

One of their first greyhounds was a pup by Hallucinate out of a dam called Scarlett, who to be fair, never really set the world on fire when winning four low-grade races from 50-odd starts.

Their purchase did later hit the track, although once again to be fair, without really setting the world on fire. In fact, on debut at Angle Park in June 2010 the then-named Foot Luce was beaten by 28 lengths.

A couple of months later she did win her maiden at her second start at Angle Park in 30.63 seconds. Three unplaced runs followed at Angle Park, Gawler and Port Pirie before a final run at the now-closed northern track resulted in a 32 lengths defeat and signalled her retirement.

But the decision in 2012 to mate Foot Luce with Vapour Whirl turned out to be one of the best decisions the two couples ever made.

"This turned out to be an unbelievable litter. Winning more than half a million dollars, there were six city winners and multiple Group finalists," the Pinnaroo-based Wilson said.

Foot Luce unfortunately died after her first litter due to a snake bite but she did leave some very nice females, including Oakvale Destiny who won 17 races and close to \$280,000 in stakemoney. And the line has subsequently thrown on.

Wilson was at Tara Raceway on Sunday, April 11 for the Commercial Hotel Mount Gambier Cup [512 metres] with Oakvale Style, the daughter of Fernando Bale and Oakvale Destiny drawing box five in the final Heat.

Lining up on the back of consecutive 515 metres wins at Angle Park, both in close to best of night times, Oakvale Style found herself with plenty to do down the back before working

Second placegetters in the cup Heats were lining up for a spot in the Final. However, with only one spot in dispute it came down to the decimal point – Oakvale Style getting the nod and Nathan Wilson now hoping his 13-race winner can go one better in the Cup Final.

Trainers are advised that Satisfactory Trials on these days **ONLY** will be approved.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Tuesday, Wednesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these days fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
4. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
5. Trials will be 455m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
6. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
7. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
8. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
9. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races there will be NO trials.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

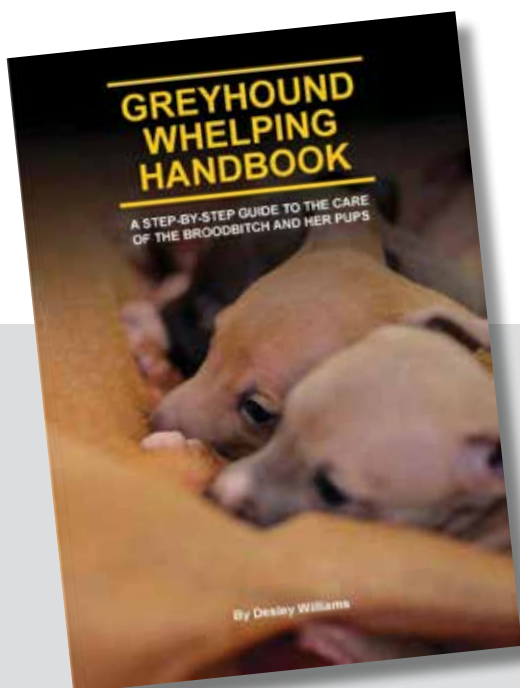
Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.
