Could Be King takes home the EASTAR

■ ANGLE PARK

The cold and wet conditions didn't prevent a healthy crowd from coming along to an exciting night of racing at Angle Park on April 6th with the EASTER Match Race Series being the highlight along with the Easter Cup over the 595m distance.

The EASTAR Match Race over the 530m trip has become a much-anticipated series on the calendar, showcasing eight of the best South Australian greyhounds going head-to-head in 4 enthralling match races with the overall winner of the series being the greyhound with the best overall time recorded.

The first match race was between up-and-coming star and Gawler Golden Maiden winner Could Be King for trainer Ben Rawlings and the Rob Harnas trained Molly Irish. As expected, Molly Irish began well clear of the bigger Could Be King, pinching a 4-length break to the first turn. Into the back straight, and Could Be King had shifted into top gear to loom up behind Molly Irish before powering past with what seemed like just a few giant strides! Molly Irish tried to stick with him but Could Be King was finishing far too well and went on to win the match race stopping the clock at 30.45 seconds.

The night's second match saw two Rasmussen kennelmates go head-to-head in Miss Scallywag and Victa Speed in what was seen as a very even contest on paper and it certainly played out that way. To the first turn and into the back straight, the two runners were shoulder-to-shoulder before it looked like Victa Speed was just gaining the edge to the home turn. However, Miss Scallywag dug deep and used the rail draw to her advantage and was able to draw clear in the home straight to record a two-length win in 30.97 seconds.

Up next was the overall favourite for the series Ravers Army for Tim Aloisi who was up-against 2023 Greyhound of the Year nominee Springvale Max for Gavin Harris in what turned out to be a highly competitive and entertaining race. Springvale Max jumped slightly better to gain the early edge on the rail but Ravers Army showed great strength to draw up level to the back straight. Ravers Army looked to be getting the upper hand from here and appeared every chance to pull away but Springvale Max stuck to the task using his inside position to stay with the favourite. Ravers Army used all his strength, continuing to drive to the line to win by a half-length in 30.76 seconds in what was a fantastic race and an exciting finish with the greyhounds side-by-side from start to finish.

Our final match race for the night saw Springvale Roxy for Mike Giniotis and Queen Of Scotch for Tony Rasmussen line up with their sights set on surpassing the best time which was still Could Be King's time of 30.45 seconds. Springvale Roxy began well from the inside box with Queen Of Scotch just behind and scouting wide to the first turn. Down the back straight and Springvale Roxy still managed to keep Queen Of Scotch at bay but was threatening out wide to go past the leader towards the home turn. Springvale Roxy however, wasn't going to let her get past and kicked on to win over a gallant Queen Of Scotch in the night's second-fastest time of 30.64 seconds. Queen Of Scotch was very impressive and her time of 30.73 seconds placed her third overall.

The overall winner of the series, Could Be King continues to from strength to strength for trainer Ben Rawlings with his record now standing at five wins and two placings from 9 career starts for just over \$21,000 in prizemoney. Still a youngster, the big black son of Spiral Nikita and My Kinda Song turns two on the 21st of this month and looks to have a promising career ahead.

The night's other feature race was the Easter Cup over the 595m trip, a feature that always provides an entertaining race for punters with this year's race no exception.

After two entertaining heats a few weeks ago, Vadim Roz's Yarramundi Paul was sent out as the favourite in an evenly matched final which featured 2022 Gawler Gold Cup Victa Reid for Lisa Rasmussen who set the early pace from box 6 along with Fantastic Luna for Elizabeth Chegia from box 1. With Tomato Tears for Tamica Dunn hot on their tails, Victa Reid and Fantastic Luna took it in turns out in front with who had the lead and turning into the home straight it was neck-and-neck. Fantastic Luna appeared to be gaining the upper hand half-way down the home straight before a late burst from Victa Reid saw him win the race in 34.59 seconds ahead of Fantastic Luna and Tomato Tears who was still pushing home hard for third place.

The win brought Victa Reid's record to 26 wins from 97 starts and just over \$117,000 in prizemoney earned over an impressive career.

GRADING REVIEW PANEL MEETING – FRIDAY 21ST APRIL POSTPONED

The next Grading Review Panel meeting was to be held tomorrow however this has been postponed for a few weeks.

An agenda will be sent to the panel in the coming weeks and a date and time advised then.

BREEDERS 2023 PRELUDE (2) HEATS ON 24TH APRIL

\$2,200 Heats of Prelude (2) for Breeders 2023 will be run on Monday, 24th April at Angle Park.

The series is for all greyhounds eligible for Breeders 2023 with the \$4,500 Final to be run on Monday, 1st May.

LOW GRADE RACE FOR THURSDAYS AT ANGLE PARK

In an effort to ensure we are programming 12 races each Thursday night at Angle Park GRSA have introduced a low grade race for some Thursday nights.

These races are for Grade 5 greyhounds over 530m that have a low WPS (Weighted Points Score). Prizemoney will be slightly less than a normal Grade 5, however, these races will be non-penalty. There will be no guarding, no reserves and only one 8 greyhound race. This should provide encouragement for those trainers who have 500m+ greyhounds but feel they cannot compete on a normal Thursday night due to current form. We are hoping to draw from a different pool of greyhounds and GRSA would encourage trainers to nominate.

\$3,505 Special event Grade 5 (worst to best) – 530m (One 8 dog field will be graded from the Weighted Points Score table of Grade 5 pool of greyhounds worst to best grading. No guarding and no reserves. Trainers cannot nominate for this event specifically. Non Penalty)

The next programmed event is on Thursday, 27th April.

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 24th April with GRSA at 9.00am

GRSA has also continued with the 1 – 4 win Time Graded heats on a Saturday morning over 530m into a Thursday night final however with the introduction of the race on Thursday night, in May the 5 + 530m Time Graded events will only be run if insufficient nominations for the meeting (there will be no heats for this pool of greyhounds).

GRSA will also continue running heats at Murray Bridge, Angle Park Monday and Gawler into a Thursday night final where the program allows to draw from a different pool of greyhounds over 500m.

The major race for Breeders 2023 is the Group 3 Howard Ashton. Trainers are reminded that the \$3,700 Heats will be run on Thursday, 11th May.

These will be followed by the \$4,500 Semi-Finals on May 18th and the \$37,500 Final on May 25th.

This race is for greyhounds that are eligible for Breeders 2023. Greyhounds didn't have to have compete in the Preludes to run in the Group 3 Howard Ashton. z

2023 WEBLEC ACE AND MEPUNGA BLAZER AT STUD MURRAY BRIDGE STRAIGHT TRACK CUP IN MAY

The \$14,275 Weblec Ace and Mepunga Blazer at Stud Murray Bridge Straight Track Cup Final will be run on Tuesday, 23rd May 2023.

The Heats will be conducted on Tuesday, 16th May 2023

SHANE MCQUEEN HEATS IN LATE MAY

The main 595m feature at Angle Park comes up on Thursday, 25th May with the running of the Heats of the Shane McQueen. This series has always been well supported by the Industry with three or four Heats normally run. The \$14,275 Final will be held on Thursday, 1st June.

BAYROAD QUEEN STAYERS HEATS IN JUNE

The \$6,790 Heats of the Bayroad Queen Stayer's Cup will be run over 730m on Thursday, 15th June. The \$14,275 Final will be run on Thursday, 22nd June.

ICG MINUTES UPDATE

From the last ICG meeting there was a question regarding the Finish On Lure versus Catching Pen options for our race meetings in the minutes.

GRSA advise there is no change to the current racing format of Catching Pen meetings and Finish On Lure meetings so the status quo remains.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED "ONLY"

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race] If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

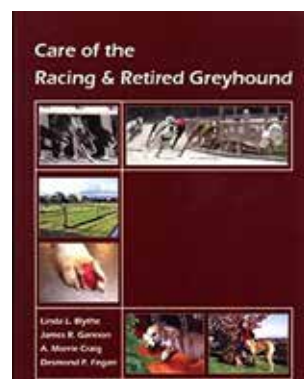

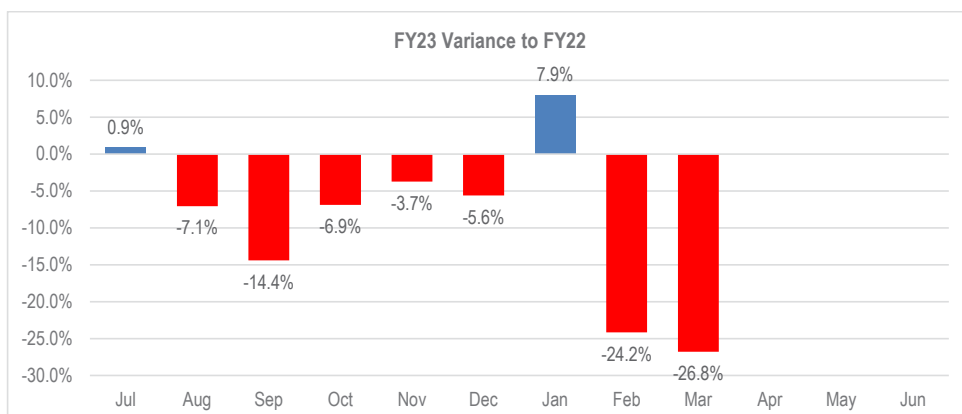

WAP announcement for March 2023

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) advises participants that there is no Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of March 2023.

As participants are aware, the WAP calculation is based on the net wagering revenue generated each period. As can be seen from the chart below, wagering revenue has fallen dramatically in February and March [compared to the previous financial year]. The combination of increased base stakemoney (which started from 1st January 2023) and reduced revenue has resulted in there being no WAP payable.

Murray Bridge Cup highlights big month for Panorama



Greyhound of the Month for March was Panorama for trainer Ben Rawlings who had three starts for the month with two wins with the highlight being the Group 3 Murray Bridge Cup final victory early in the month.

The daughter of Fernando Bale and Panamera started the month off in the Heats of the Group 3 Murray Bridge Cup where she was able to hold off a late challenge and win in a solid 25.82 for the 455m journey. She then went to another level in the final where

she led easily to the first turn and gave nothing else a chance running a slick 25.49 in winning by just under a length.

She then headed to Mt Gambier with a \$10,000 bonus on offer if she could capture the Murray Bridge/Mt Gambier double however she was luckless in her heat running fifth.

At the end of the month Panorama's record stood at 57 starts for 21 wins and 16 placings and earnings just below \$92,000.

Sister Roberta claims award with sizzling win

The Run of the Month for March was the Tracie Price trained sprinter, Sister Roberta for her brilliant win at Mt Gambier in Grade 5 company over the 512m where she led and ran brilliant time.

First up for the kennel and starting from box 1 she showed sizzling early pace to lead early and from there was never headed. She went onto record a blistering 29.39 in winning by 7.50 lengths.



Titan Blazer blitzes them in Mount Gambier Cup

■ MOUNT GAMBIER

The 2023 Group 3 Mount Gambier Cup has gone the way of an interstate raider, with the Daniel Gibbons trained Titan Blazer proving a bit too classy for the strong field, in front of a monster crowd trackside on Sunday April 2nd.

It was a complete performance from the son of Mepunga Blazer, as he was able to handle a sticky box five draw with a fantastic display of speed and tenacity.

The winning time of 29.36 is extremely fast and goes to show what sort of quality it required to win this year's race. Running behind Titan Blazer was the Dave Peckham trained Lochinvar Cahill and Sister Roberta for Tracie Price, who rounded out the placings.

Last year, Titan Blazer came over for the Mount Gambier Cup and ran a sound third in his heat, with that run somewhat paving the way for the chaser to come over again for this year's edition.

"Well, he was in it last year. I knew a couple of months ago that I was going to go back up again, just because I love racing there and the dogs have gone pretty good there. I'm also training Mr. Anderson for Jason Newman and he kind of wanted him brought up for it as well, so I thought I might as well through a few in," said Gibbons.

With the winning time being particularly fast for Titan Blazer, it should not come as a surprise, given some of the times that he has been able to run across the country throughout his career, which include a 29.24 at Sandown Park, a 29.74 at The Meadows and a 23.60 at Bendigo.

"I've always known that he can run good time, it's just whether he can get the start right which he did. Once I saw him in front going around the first turn I knew he would be hard to beat after that."

Gibbons and the family were in Bali, which will prove a timely celebration point, but there was a unique viewing spot for the race, with Daniel and his wife, Rebecca, watching the race in the line whilst waiting to board the plane.

"We watched it on our phones while lining up to board the plane! We were cheering him home and had people looking at us like we were idiots!" exclaimed Gibbons

"We will be enjoying cocktails and food by the pool!"

With 25 career wins from 69 starts and a tidy \$244,000 in the bank for Titan Blazer, the now three-and-a-half-year-old will continue to be placed in suitable races when they come around.

"We will just keep racing him, he loves racing but we just need to take it easy with him getting older. We might try for the Geelong Cup next," said Gibbons.

On a fantastic card of racing, some other highlights were the 400m Open Sprint Final which went the way of Nitrogen Outlaw who was simply dominant, leading all the way in a red hot 22.82. The Mount Gambier Cup Consolation race went to the Renee Kenyon trained Blackpool Ryan, with box one proving to be a race winning advantage as he took out the consolation in 29.77.

The Chairman welcomed new members, Dr Greg Moore and Keaton Bond.

2 NOTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

The Minutes from the ICG Meeting held on Friday 9 September, 2022 were noted as a true and correct record.

3 BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

3.1 Sustainable Breeding Levels

Members expressed concern that current breeding levels were too low, noting previous large breeders were no longer breeding and with the impending departure from the state of another breeder it poses issues. The RM noted strategies implemented to reduce breeding including removal of rebate and suggested there may have been a slight over correction. Members noted the natural ceiling to breeding numbers, less rearing opportunities in SA and that larger breeder numbers have reduced. The RM suggested a drop in breeding numbers was more than expected. The Chairman suggested with the current racing schedule, a breeding level around 500 would be sustainable. Some members suggested they were not necessarily concerned with current levels. Discussion around up and coming breeders, and the opportunity for animal welfare to work with these persons on increasing their operation. The Chairman questioned the group on how GRSA can assist with the whole cycle of breeding including rearing. Members suggested discussion with Government around licensing would be beneficial. Members suggested issues with GAP run hand in hand with breeding issues, they believed there should not be restrictions on breeders, rather restrictions on number of dogs that can go through GAP, with interstate dogs to be returned to that state for retirement.

Action: For the Board to consider rearing opportunities in South Australia.

3.2 Limited Monthly Starts

The Group noted the update.

3.3 Digital Transformation and Broadcast Enhancement (Isolynx)

The Chairman noted the roll out of Isolynx and the benefit of installation at all tracks in SA. Members questioned timeframes of data availability including first sectional split at the 730m boxes for the 342m start. The CEO noted the large amount of data to process and advised a meeting with Brooks is scheduled within two weeks with a further meeting with industry following this to identify needs of both punters and industry. Members noted the work they believed was required to automate the process and the CEO thanked Members for their offer of assistance. Members questioned if data would be used by Stewards to determine instances of failing to pursue. The COS advised this wouldn't be taken in to consideration with Stewards. Members further questioned if the speed of head on replay could be slowed

down.

3.4 AGRC Syndicate Dog – Weblec Rebel

The Group noted the update.

3.5 Tara Tipsters

The Group noted the update. Members noted new members from Adelaide to the group and intent to increase the number of charities supported in 2023.

3.6 Mt Gambier Population

Members of the Board noted an upcoming meeting with Management to discuss outcomes of the working group. It was noted the intent for the strategies to be rolled out to coincide with the Mt Gambier Cup in late March/early April. Members questioned if the area would be suitable for rearing opportunities. It was suggested it would be suitable noting the cost and availability of land, council support, opportunities with Victoria and many other benefits. Members noted the need for support and mentorship which would be undertaken through the club. It was highlighted to the group that licensing barriers are difficulties to becoming a trainer. The COS requested any information regarding licensing be fed back to him to enable his department to review processes. Members suggested concessions could be made for new licenses considering the intended close mentorship with the club.

3.7 Online Trials/Coursing in OzChase

The RM provided an update. Some members suggested an additional trial session was required at Gawler. Some members suggested an online booking system for Gawler would be beneficial, noting trainers needed to ensure they arrived on time to assist with process. Members requested a trial schedule be published at tracks. Members further requested a trial mobile phone be made available to those staff running trial session for trainers to make contact with if needed.

3.8 Blinkers/Satisfactory Trials

The Group noted the update.

3.9 McQueens Car Park

The Group noted the update. Members questioned if there was an opportunity to include cooling surface on asphalt in trainers' car park and/or utilisation of water truck on hot days.

Management committed to looking into this.

Action: IFM to investigate options for asphalt coatings on trainers' car park and/or utilisation of water truck on hot days.

4 AGENDA ITEMS

4.1 ICG Panel Members

The Group noted the update.

4.2 Murray Bridge Sand Issues

The IFM provided an update and the Chairman noted Management were carefully considering options to ensure any solution is the correct solution.

4.3 Hot Weather and Transport Policy

The CEO sought feedback from the Group on reducing the temperature in the hot weather policy. It was advised in the event of hot weather, we would want to see the dogs return to normal body temperature within 30 minutes of racing, and to decide on what temperature this would be at would require testing of dogs temperature during racing. It was suggested education on how to cool dogs down and air flow within vehicles and trailers would be beneficial. It was noted misters were not effective. Members suggested there was greater risk of losing meetings/races if temperature was reduced. Members suggested reducing the temperature would benefit Mt Gambier, especially regarding ensuring kennelhouse is kept cool. Management will consider comments in review of policy.

4.4 GAP Kennels

The Group noted the request, however also noted current restrictions. Members questioned if the scheme could apply to current dogs in kennels that are awaiting entry to GAP. Members echoed prior comments around restrictions being applied to entry into GAP. The COS took on notice the members comments on the quality of interstate imports and potential to have

restrictions, conditions applied to imports. The Chair requested management investigate GAP Victoria process with kennels.

Action:

4.5 Lure Noise

The IFM provided an update to investigations and sound level readings taken on lures at Angle Park at various points of the track with further readings to be taken at other tracks. Discussion around types of robust solutions that will be investigated further.

4.6 SA Bred Bonus Scheme

The RM provided an update and requested feedback from the group noting the lower monthly amounts being received. It was suggested increasing the base amount from \$225 and removing monthly payments, therefore reducing monthly administration of scheme. The Chairman suggested changes be implemented from 1 July 2023 following consideration of the Board.

4.7 Injury Data Update

The COO provided an explanation of injury data to the group.

4.8 Dress Code

The CEO provided an update to the Group regarding dress code with participants able to wear their own clothes to fit within the dress code under the blue vests as branded GRSA attire will no longer be provided. Discussion around blue vests, the group requested larger sizes be provided.

4.9 Industry Communication

The CEO provided an update regarding industry communication and the removal of the industry Facebook page. Members noted their concerns with the removal of the industry Facebook page. Other members echoed these concerns. Some members agreed that the Facebook page served multiple purposes other than communication from GRSA. The CEO took the comments from Group on notice and committed to Management investigating alternative communication options. The CEO questioned the Group on the relevance and need for Kennel Capers. Some members advised that the publication was relevant and useful for industry.

4.10 Pink Card Approval When on Season

The RM provided background to issue and requested feedback from the Group. Members suggested a late fee be applied to any of these cases. The Group suggested communication to industry on process in conjunction with late fee

5. OTHER BUSINESS

5.1 Members questioned whether the process of hand slipping can resume. The COS advised this direction resulted from SafeWork SA investigation. The IM advised that following sign off from SafeWork SA we were hopeful that previous practices can resume, noting delay in process but it was making good progress.

5.2 Members requested the same lure as is used at Angle Park be available for sale, noting current version for sale is different. Management committed to following up on this.

5.3 Members questioned status of finish on lure discussion. The CEO advised it will remain as status quo pending outcome from SafeWork SA.

5.4 Members questioned the delay in the publication and transparency of inquiries and fines. The IM advised seven inquiries to be published imminently with a further IHP hearing to be held shortly which will bring all enquiries and publication of results up to date.

5.5 Members questioned Stewards process with dealing with unwanted behaviour. The COS noted issues with conflicting information and limitations around this. The IM echoed this. Members referenced issues they had experienced and noted support received and positive outcomes.

5.6 Members questioned the ability for an automated process for payment of fines.

5.7 Members questioned whether minimum bet law changes were being addressed. The CEO advised discussions have commenced with corporate bookmakers.

5.8 Members questioned the status of discussions around the Point of Consumption tax. The Chairman advised current

discussions with Tabcorp were being held and awaiting confirmation for a meeting with government.

5.9 The Group questioned the unauthorised use of drones. The Chairman advised Management were obtaining legal advice in regard to this.

5.10 Members questioned a rumour regarding 12 trainers being restricted on kennel numbers. The COS advised that this was not true however animal welfare staff were working with trainers with ongoing or repeated issues on acceptable and manageable number of kennels and dogs.

5.11 Members advised they received notification that from 1 January 2024, the WA government were banning surgical insemination. The Chairman advised this topic would be on Greyhounds Australasia Board and CEO's agenda.

5.12 Members questioned the status regarding bullrings. The Chairman advised there were ongoing discussions being held with the Board.

NOTIFICATION OF GREYHOUND MOVEMENTS

This month I want to revisit the requirements and processes for notifying GRSA of movements of greyhounds. It is vital – and a requirement under our rules of racing – that we keep track of registered greyhounds from their whelping; through their racing career; and, into to retirement.

A studmaster or Artificial Insemination Technician must, within 14 days of the first service of a breeding female, notify a Controlling Body [GAR 61].

The owner of a breeding female, or a person otherwise authorised as being in charge of a breeding female, must notify the result of a service to GRSA within 14 days of whelping; or within 14 days of the due whelping date, calculated as 63 days after the date of service [GAR 71].

A registered person must as soon as possible notify GRSA that a greyhound has come into, or left, the person's care or custody and in each of those cases including as a result of a greyhound having its ownership transferred [GAR 34].

An owner who purchases or otherwise acquires a greyhound must within 10 days lodge with GRSA a completed, prescribed transfer of ownership form signed by the previous owner [GAR 37].

Applications for naming a greyhound may be made by an owner after a greyhound has attained 12 months of age, by lodging with the Controlling Body where the greyhound was whelped [GAR 48].

The owner or person responsible for a greyhound must notify GRSA where the greyhound is domiciled within 10 days, if that greyhound has been retired as a pet, been transferred to an adoption program, or been exported or surrendered to another agency; or, if that greyhound has been humanely euthanased by a veterinarian. It is a mandatory requirement under the rules of racing to include a veterinary certificate of euthanasia when lodging the relevant documentation for any greyhound that has been euthanased by that veterinarian; or, as soon as possible and prior to disposal of the greyhound, where a greyhound otherwise becomes deceased (including suddenly or unexpectedly), and the owner or person responsible for the greyhound must provide GRSA with information detailing the circumstances giving rise to the death, to the satisfaction of GRSA [GAR 22].

Note that GRSA has strict requirements relating to euthanasia of greyhounds in the Local Rules [rule 130], that reverses the post-10 days notification (in GAR 22) of euthanasia to pre-10 days notification.

The owner must notify GRSA where the greyhound is domiciled, in writing and within 10 days, if that greyhound has been retired from racing with an intention to be used for breeding purposes [GAR 23].

The relevant forms are GAR106D, GAR106E and GAR106R found on our website.

When you complete a retirement form [GAR106R] within 10 days of your greyhound being retired, you must advise who and where the greyhound was retired to. This can include an intention to breed (note there are additional rules); retirement to yourself (or another connection) as a pet; another person or agency; export (note there are additional rules); or, the Greyhounds As Pets Program. You must nominate, for another (third party) person, their full name, address, phone number, email and signature of the new owner, as well as attach the sterilisation certificate (if not breeding). Once GRSA receives the form, we confirm that the greyhound's details on our records match those on the form. This includes identification (gender, colour, DOB, microchip and ear brand), ownership/trainership.

GRSA also contacts the new owner to see how the greyhound is going and provide general advice for any questions they may have. GRSA's retirement guide is available to them detailing a variety of information including the muzzle exemption process (as they are not proceeding through the GAP SA program). GRSA also, liaises with council registration authorities and the Dog and Cat Management Board (via databases) to confirm transfers. If the greyhound remains with a registered person, that retired greyhound remains subject to the rules of racing, post-retirement. This is important to remember, because greyhounds are defined as a canine of the greyhound breed which is registered pursuant to the rules of a Controlling Body; is retired but under the care of a registered person; and, includes the offspring conceived from the result of a service between a breeding female and a sire. GRSA will confirm the whereabouts of all greyhounds on a registered person's property, during routine or investigative kennel inspections, authorised under the rules of racing [GAR 13 16].

Amendment to Greyhounds Australasia Rule 25 [Minimum Vaccination Requirements]

Amendment to Greyhounds Australasia Rule 25 [Minimum Vaccination Requirements]

Please note that the length of time that a greyhound is prohibited from racing following vaccination has been reduced from 7 to 5 days.

GAR 25 Minimum Vaccination Requirements

Summary:

Greyhounds Australasia [GA], through the GA Integrity Committee, has become aware of revised opinion of control bodies in relation to the stand down period applied under GAR 25 [6] to Greyhounds post administration of a vaccination.

RWWA also advised that a Local Rule was introduced [LR 25] in February 2023, to amend the mandatory stand down period from seven days to five days within Western Australia. Veterinary advice has endorsed the variation to five days and that it does not negatively impact the best interests of the greyhound's welfare.

Following consultation with the respective control bodies, Greyhounds Australasia advise an amended GAR 25[6] to reduce the seven-day exclusion period to five days, as follows.

Amended GAR 25 [6]:

25 Minimum Vaccination Requirements

[6] Unless a Controlling Body determines otherwise, a greyhound must not compete in any
[a] Event within five days of the date it was administered a vaccine.

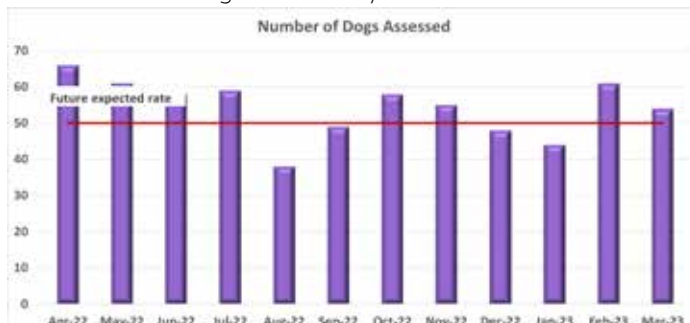
MEET WITH DES FEGAN

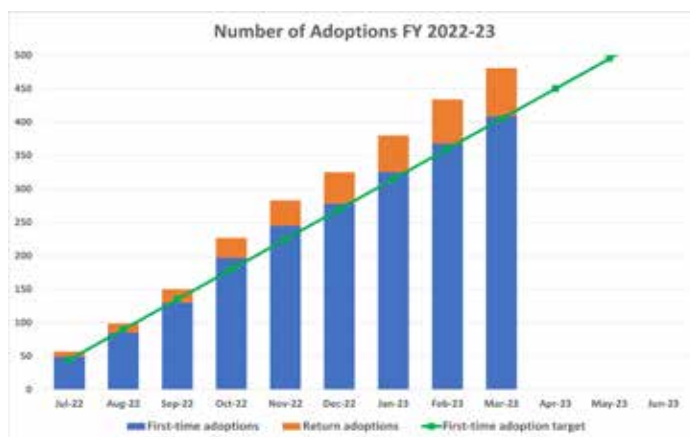
Latest updates from GAP

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialed after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:30pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

RACING REPORT

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

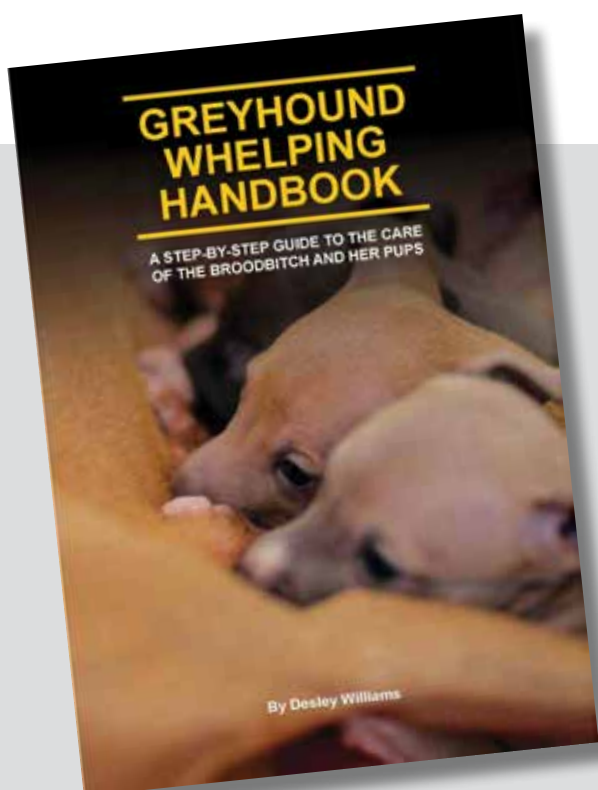
