MESSAGE FROM MATT

The Golden Rules – Avoidance of Prohibited Substance Breaches

In noting that we have seen recent Cobalt and Arsenic threshold breaches, it serves as a timely opportunity for GRSA to remind participants – in their own best interests – that there are a number of Golden Rules that can help them to avoid making any such breaches (for prohibited substances generally) and which should be adhered to as principles of best practice:

- Always consult your vet to seek guidance in relation to any of the products that you are using, any associated risks, and other relevant context
- Review the range of any feeds or supplements that you typically purchase and, wherever it is reasonable to do so, replace products containing substances that could contribute to a threshold breach under the rules (eg. cobalt) with alternative products
- Observe the instructions on any products that you use and adhere strictly to those directions (having regard for prescribed amounts, frequency of administration/application, methodology for administering/applying)
- Refrain from the use of injectable treatments (eg. Vitamin B12) to any extent that is practical
- Refrain from any treatment of a greyhound on raceday other than as relates to its feeding and drinking requirements (GAR83(a)(1) treats this as a specific offence)

Our registered participants have the ultimate responsibility to ensure that greyhounds are presented free of prohibited substances. This information is offered as advice in good faith only and should not be relied upon as a defence in the event of a breach being recorded.

These Golden Rules will appear in the Integrity section of future Kennel Capers editions on an ongoing basis as a reminder for participants of this responsibility.

SA Bred sprint queen **Fabregal** had a fantastic duel with Melbourne Cup runner-up Jesaulenko finishing 2nd in the Group 2 Traralgon Cup.

In her first series since being switched to Victorian trainer Lyn Smith, Fabregal ran 2nd in the Traralgon Cup heat but ran a terrific time and drew a favourable box 1 for the final. In the final Fabregal began quick and led for most of the race before the fast finishing Jesaulenko edged her out just before the line.

Greyhound of the month for March was Molly Be Nimble for trainer Cameron Butcher who won three of her four starts highlighted by her sizzling performance in the St Patrick's Day Sprint.

The daughter of Nitro Burst and Hope's Up started the month of with two back to back wins at headquarters running 29.83 and 29.69 respectively. She then started the punters elect in the St Patrick's Day Sprint and didn't let her supporters down leading throughout in a flying 29.64 in winning by just over 1 length.

Her last start for March was at Gawler where she started a short priced favourite and was beaten in the shadows of the post after leading most of the way finishing second.

At the end of the month Molly Be Nimble's record stands at 41 starts with 20 wins and 7 placings, and earnings just under \$35,000.

Easter arrangements SA Distance and SA

A couple of important things to remember over the Easter break.

- There will be No trials Good Friday (14th April)
- There will be No trials at Angle Park on Easter Saturday (15th April)
- There will be trials at Emerley Park on Monday morning from 7am (17th April)
- The Trainers Fee for Monday night (17th April) will be paid into your bank account due to the public holiday.
- The Race Night office at Angle Park on Monday night will be closed as normal.
- Scratchings for the Gawler meeting on Tuesday 18th April will be taken between 3pm and 4pm on Monday (17th April) as per normal.
- Nominations for the Angle Park meeting on Thursday 20th April and Mt Gambier on Friday 21st April will close at 9am on Tuesday 18th April.
- Nominations for the Port Augusta meeting on Saturday 22nd April, GOTBA on Sunday 23rd April, Gawler on Sunday 23rd April and Mt Gambier on Sunday 23rd April will close at 9am on Wednesday 19th April.

Upcoming GOTBA meeting

SA Distance and SA Anniversary Cup heats this month

Feature racing continues at Angle Park this month with the running of the Heats of the SA Distance Championship over 731m and the Bargain Steel Centre SA Anniversary Cup over 515m on Thursday 20th April.

Both finals will be run the following week on Thursday 27th April which are open events worth \$14,500 for the Distance with unplaced and \$13,750 for the Sprint with the winner collecting \$10,000. The honour role for both events are a who's who of greyhound racing with last years winners Zipping Geoff winning the Distance Championship and Coorong Kid taking out the Anniversary Cup.

2015 AGRC/Greyhound Racing SA Greyhound Auction – Racing Dates

The Main race series for greyhounds that were purchased through the 2015 Auction will be \$4,590 Heats run on Thursday 8th June. The \$26,000 Final will be run on Thursday 15th June 2017.

Prizemoney for the Main Series Final is \$16,000, \$5,000, \$2,500, unplaced \$500

Nominator bonus payment at \$3,500, \$2,500, \$1,500.

In a lead up to the main series there will be a heat and final run at Angle Park over the 388m in May.

The \$1,025 heats will be run on Wednesday 3rd May with the \$3,000 final the week later on Wednesday 10th May.

Nominator bonus payment for this final is \$400, \$200, \$100.

There will be another series to be run in July or August over 515m for \$1,130 heats and then the final is worth \$5,000. These dates are yet to be confirmed.

2017 AGRC/Greyhound Racing SA Greyhound Auction

The Greyhound Auction will be held on the 29th October 2017 making it the 4th one since its reintroduction.

The conditions have changed from last year due to breeding numbers and processes.

The main changes are -

• Extension of dates for eligible pups – increased to 1st October 16 to 31st June 17

• This will be a Reserve Auction with the vendor to pay commission on Reserve price if passed in to be eligible for the Race Series.

There will be more information in the coming weeks.

• The main race series Heats and Final are scheduled for June 2019. One month before (May) there will be a Wednesday 388m series with Heats and Final for pups sold at the auction. There will also be a Wednesday heats 515m and Final Thursday night 515m held in July the month after the main race series

2017 Group 3 Howard Ashton

The major race for Breeders 2017 is the Group 3 Howard Ashton. Trainers are reminded that the heats will be run on Wednesday 17th May.

These will be followed by the Semi- Finals on May 25th and the \$37,500 Final on June 1st. Total prizemoney for heats and semis will be determined by the number of races run.

The race is for greyhounds that are eligible for Breeders 2017. Greyhounds don't have to have competed in the Preludes to run in the Group 3 Howard Ashton.

Booking on line for Saturday morning trials at Angle Park

GRSA has introduced the Online Booking process for Saturday morning trials.

Bookings are taken as per normal by phone and online at 12.30pm on the Thursday before. Like Tuesday night these will be timeslots giving participants guaranteed bookings and allowing a smoother process. Trials on Saturday mornings start at 7.00am as normal with 25 minute blocks likely to go to around 10.30am. GRSA will monitor the bookings and attendance and may vary conditions and timeslots as required.

Booking of Tuesday night trials at Angle Park

Please be advised to encourage participants to use the online booking facility for Tuesday night, trials have opened up for bookings an hour earlier than phone bookings. You will therefore, be able to book online from 11.30am on the Monday prior to Tuesday night trials.

Our GRSA staff is available to provide support and training for those participants who require it, please contact GRSA to organise.

This came into effect from Tuesday 22nd November trial session.

For participants who wish to continue to book via the telephone please ensure you follow the below directions:

- 1. DO NOT phone prior to 12.30pm as NO calls will be placed on hold and your call will not be answered prior to 12.30pm. By calling prior to 12.30pm you are actually inconveniencing yourself as you may be disconnected or directed to another area as the telephone system will not let you que for a long period of time.
- 2. Ensure you know exactly what type and number of trial/s you require.
- 3. No other queries will be answered to ensure a timely manner of answering the calls that are in que for booking trials.
- 4. Please understand that our staff provides you with the best possible and earliest time available so they will not enter into a debate about the reasons why.
- 5. DO NOT book more trials than required. GRSA will be monitoring this situation and if required action may be taken against offenders.

Black caps now available from GRSA

Along with the white caps GRSA has now approved that black caps can be worn by participants.

Both black and white caps with GRSA logos are available from GRSA at a cost of \$10.

From the Stewards

Clipping toenails

Recently Stewards and on-track veterinarians have noticed an increase in greyhounds being presented for racing with long nails.

Greyhounds need to have their nails clipped regularly. Long nails during racing can cause injury to your greyhound and others in the event. It is the Trainers responsibility to present a greyhound fit for racing. If in doubt, speak to your veterinary surgeon.

Locked medication cabinets

All Trainers are reminded to ensure all medications are kept in a locked container, cabinet or cupboard.

Animal Welfare check this during kennel inspections. Failure to comply may result in fines being issued.

Licensing reminder

Just a friendly reminder that licensing of new and upgraded licences can take some time.

At times, Stewards may require further information such as clearances from other racing jurisdictions, National Police Clearances, face-to-face interviews or other information in support of applications. Please lodge all paperwork in a timely manner and allow time for processing.

Smoking in the Angle Park Trainers car park

GRSA reminds Trainers and handlers using the Angle Park carpark that smoking is not permitted.

New signs will be erected shortly.

Inquiries and notifications

Mr. Scott Feltus – Stewards inquiry 29/03/17 – GAR 86(o) – misconduct in relation to behaviour and language used on track following an event at the Gawler race meeting on 7 March 2017. Mr. Feltus was found guilty and was fined \$250. Suspended fine of \$400 now activated for offending under same portion of the Rule.

Mrs. Rebecca Mcauley-Fry – Stewards inquiry 29/03/17 – GAR 86(o) – misconduct in relation to behaviour and language used on track following an event at the Gawler race meeting on 7 March 17. Mrs. Mcauley-Fry pleaded guilty and was fined \$250. **Mr. Tracie Price** – Notice of positive swab – greyhound FLYING FLUTTER was found to have PHENOBARBITONE in a urine sample following an event at Mount Gambier on 22 January 2017. Inquiry to be scheduled at a date to be fixed.

Mr. Robert Halliday – Racing Appeal Tribunal 04/04/17 - GAR 83(2) – failed to present the greyhounds HOMER and REDDA free of any prohibited substances (COBALT) for events at Mount Gambier on 9 September 2016 and 14 October 2016. Mr. Halliday's penalty of six (6) months disqualification was held with three (3) months suspended for a period of 24 months on the condition he does not re-offend under this Rule.

Mrs. Wendy Matcott – Stewards inquiry 24/03/17 – GAR 86(o) – negligence in that she failed to ensure the correct greyhounds were presented for an event at the Angle Park race meeting on 28 February 2017. Mrs. Matcott was found guilty and was fined \$2,000; with \$1,000 suspended for a period of 24 months on the condition she does not reoffend under this Rule.

Ms. Elly Matcott – Stewards inquiry 24/03/17 – GAR 86(o) – negligence in that she failed to ensure the correct greyhounds were presented for an event at the Angle Park race meeting on 28 February 2017. Ms. Matcott pleaded guilty and was fined \$300; which was wholly suspended for a period of 24 months on the condition she does not reoffend under this Rule.

Ms. Debbie Oliver – Stewards inquiry 24/03/17 – GAR 86(o) – negligence in that she failed to ensure the correct greyhounds were presented for an event at the Angle Park race meeting on 28 February 2017. Ms. Oliver was stood down for four (4) weeks; with three (3) weeks of that penalty being suspended for a period of 24 months on the condition she does not reoffend under this Rule. Ms. Oliver was also placed on reduced duties and counselled in relation to her work.

Mr. Lance Simpson – Stewards inquiry 23/03/17 - GAR 86(f)(iii) – published comments on Facebook from his social media 'handle' which in the opinion of the Stewards were contemptuous in relation to a decision made by GRSA. Mr. Simpson pleaded guilty and was fined \$200.

Mr. Brodie Jessup – Stewards inquiry 21/03/17 – GAR 83(2) – failed to present the greyhound ASA FLYING SPUR free of any prohibited substances (DESMETHYLVENLAFAXINE) for an event at Angle Park on 15 December 2016. Mr. Jessup pleaded guilty and was disqualified for a period of three (3) months. Mr. Jessup has lodged an appeal.

Mr. Oswald Chegia – Notice of positive swab – greyhound SHEZ ROCKING was found to have ARSENIC in a urine sample following an event at Angle Park on 11 January 2017. Inquiry to be scheduled at a date to be fixed.

Changes to track maintenance schedule

Over the past few months the Maintenance Department has sought to refine their track harrowing schedule to achieve the most consistent and safe racing surface possible for race meetings.

During this period, the harrowing of the surface has been completed on a more regular basis and the results from an injury perspective have been extremely promising.

As a result of these investigations, changes have been made to the harrowing schedule of both Angle Park and Gawler, which can be found below.

Given the frequency of this work, it is no longer our intention to advise participants every time a medium harrow has been performed on either track.

Angle Park

- Medium depth harrow monthly (last Friday of month)
- Full track turnover and level annually



Gawler

- Medium depth harrow fortnightly (on Thursday)
- Full track turnover and level annually

Obviously the scheduling of this work will be weather dependent and GRSA will still advise of major works being undertaken to the racing surface.

Mobilong Prison GAP facility nearing completion

Works to construct a GAP facility at the Mobilong Prison in Murray Bridge have escalated, with the building works nearing completion.

The facility is a joint venture between GRSA and the Department of Correctional Services and when completed will have capacity to house 16 greyhounds at any given time.

GRSA expects handover of the new building to occur at some point in the next few weeks before greyhounds being fostered out into the Prison.





Expansion of alternative lure trials

For several weeks GRSA has been conducting a limited trial of the blue, yellow and white lure (pictured right), which is currently in use in Victoria, WA and NSW.

Whilst the initial trial has been well received by those trainers participating, the lack of widespread participation has limited the volume of feedback required for GRSA to decide upon the future of the lure.

As a result, GRSA will conduct two full trial sessions using only the new lure. These will occur on consecutive Angle Park Saturday morning trial sessions on 22nd and 29th April, 2017.

GRSA recognises that trainers may be reluctant to participate in the trial, therefore the decision has been made to make these completely free sessions.

Following these full trial sessions using the alternative lure, GRSA will then invite feedback from trainers which will then be discussed by the Industry Consultative Group (ICG) at their next meeting on Friday 5th May, 2017.

The intention of these trials is to explore why the blue, yellow and white lure would be unsuitable for introduction in SA. Local greyhounds competing interstate have performed well behind this type of lure (Worm Burner and Bogie Bekim) which suggests greyhounds will adapt quickly to the different lure type.

The Tuesday night trials with the new lure will continue on the 18th April but will cease from the 25th April with trialling on the Saturday morning.

Meet our Foster Carers Hans



Our Foster Carers are a vital part of what we do and we appreciate all their efforts helping our gorgeous greyhounds get settled into new homes. We thought we would ask our Foster carers about their experiences and hopefully give some insight into how it all works for those thinking about giving it a go. This editions profile is Hans, who is both a foster carer and a trainer, and absolutely loves greyhounds!

How did you find out about GAP SA?

I adopted my first dog through GAP SA called Victor (Victor Big Boy- Ron Shadows dog), after which I decided to get into training them.

Why did you become a foster carer?

I wanted to ensure the best for my own dogs and make sure they are really ready to go out as a pet. I enjoyed fostering so much that I started fostering not only my own dogs but other peoples as well.

How many dogs have you fostered?

3 - Timmy, Slurpy/Wilson and Markus - I'm ready for my next in a couple of week's time.

What do you love about greyhounds?

They are very peaceful natured dogs. They have such a chilled out temperament. I have had a lot of dogs, all types of breeds throughout my life and I believe that greyhounds are great because they are so human-like and are so sensitive to people and what's going on around them.

Any advice for first time foster carers?

Just that they should go for it and not over think the experience to much. Some people find that fostering is harder because they are over thinking it too much. They will need to allow the greyhounds time to adjust and some may have anxiety in their adjustment period so they will need to be calm and easy going about it, as they are adjusting to another place.

Hans also mentioned that he has been enjoying fostering a lot and that he may even like it more than training! He said that it is so rewarding to make a difference and help set up a greyhounds life.

Jamie had his second win of the day in race 10 over 400m with Signal Pete running down Emerley Avenue on the line trained by Judi Hurley, winning by a nose in a time of 22.79 seconds.

Jamie lives and trains his greyhounds just outside of Mildura at Merbein South and travels weekly over the border to race his greyhounds. Jamie said that his wife does a mountain of work to prepare the kennel while he is travelling to race his greyhounds. Trained by Roz at Victor Harbor, the fawn dog arrived in SA in September

last year, but some bad luck with injury, and then a serious grass seed issue which required surgery has held him back.

As the months rolled on, Vadim Roz was questioning his decision to take the dog on, but he had faith and didn't want to give up. The final hold up came when he was waiting to receive the naming papers back, but Should Be Wise finally made it to the track at 2 years and 9 months of age. Given all that, plus the poor box draw and the ability of the opposition, Vadim Roz was not that confident of a first up win, but he was relieved after the win. Vadim Roz is enjoying the greyhound scene and likes to work with a small team of up to 8 greyhounds. Should Be Wise has vindicated Vadim Roz's persistence

Consistent trio breakthrough for wins

MOUNT GAMBIER

It took a while, but consistent greyhounds Bekim Lucy's, Indi's Fancy and Jaeda Sienn finally broke through for their first wins when successful at Tara Raceway on Friday 7th April.

Bekim Lucy's, after two thirds and three fourths at her past five starts, looked well placed from box three in the JB Irrigation Maiden Stake over 512 metres. Down the back straight, though, the November 2014 daughter of Bekim Bale and Lucy's Moment still had plenty of work to do when a distant fourth behind Morris Peer, race favourite Bushman's Mate and My Dad's Dream.

But off the back Bekim Lucy's, having her thirteenth race start, moved out to make her run before finishing strongly in the home straight to defeat Bushman's Mate and Morris Peer by 21/4 lengths in 30.67 seconds.

The win was the first leg of a double for the litter with Dimora Bekim, trained at Compton by Tracie Price for Kevin and Bernie Bouchier, leading all the way in the Berringa Park Stake (400 m) and clocking 23.28 seconds, well under the Pathway time standard of 23.69 seconds.

Bekim Lucy's was purchased by Mount Gambier owner-trainer Willie Vossen as a pup from Price, together with litter sister Cee Jay's Heart, who he races in partnership with Jodie Freeman.

With eight minor placings from 11 starts, and box one thrown in for good measure, surely the Rock's Retreat Stake (400 m) was Indi's Fancy's chance to open her winning account for Cashmore trainer Ben Boers.

She had run a distant second behind a pretty smart one in Galactic Spirit

– now three from three after another win on Friday – at her previous start but there certainly didn't appear to be any greyhounds of that calibre in this maiden event.

That's the way it turned out with Indi's Fancy virtually leading all the way to defeat first starter Summer Raine by 2½ lengths in 23.85 seconds and give Boers his first winner as a trainer since Lots Of Yap won at Tara Raceway in late November 2015.

By Swift Fancy out of Indi's My Girl – a winner of three races at Cannington and Mandurah – Indi's Fancy was a giveaway via the internet site Greyhound-Data.

"Actually, she wasn't the one I actually rang up about when making original contact," Boers said. "That one had gone but they did have an unnamed bitch (later to be named Indi's Fancy) they reckoned was too good for GAP that I could have if I was interested."

It was a similar story for Jaeda Sienn who led all the way from box seven to defeat first-starter Colden Blu Boy by 4½ lengths in 23.58 seconds in the Greyhound-Data.com Maiden Stake over 400 m.



By Cosmic Chief out of White Butterfly, Jaeda Sienn is trained at Mumbannar by Monty Wilson who also trained White Butterfly, still a maiden upon retirement after racing on 19 occasions at Horsham and Warrnambool for 11 minor placings.

However, her litter was more than handy and included New Tibur (\$79,000 in prizemoney) and Soho Rhythm (\$55,000).

And it appeared as though Jaeda Sienn – with four minor placings to her name – was heading down the same path as her dam when she lined up for start number 15 on Friday.

But, according to Wilson, several 512 metre runs had really toughened her up and after finding the front she was always going to be hard to run down.

Jaeda Sienn was actually reared by him and wife Jen on a one-forone basis with Friday a pretty good day for the Wilsons who also led in three seconds – Bushman's Mate, Bushman's Shadow and Kylan Brae.

As a result, Monty Wilson, after Friday's meeting, had worked his way into the top 10 on the Leading Trainers list.

TRIALS ANGLE PARK

ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS - NOW WEEKLY

Angle Park Qualifying Trials will now be run weekly on Tuesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting and the Wednesday APD meeting.

Trainers must be specific on their nominations about which day they are trialling for and what distance. (ie Wed 388m, Mon 515, Mon 600m etc).

Tuesday Angle Park Qualifying dates are:

April 18th (for APM meeting on 24th April – No Qualys for APD Wednesday on 26th April)

April 25th (for APM meeting on 1st May – for APD Wednesday on 3rd May)

May 2nd (for APM meeting on 9th May – for APD Wednesday on 10th May)

May 9th (for APM meeting on 16th May – for APD Wednesday on 18th May)

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Tuesday of the meeting.

NOMINATING ONLINE FOR QUALIFYING TRIALS

For Angle Park, Gawler and Strathalbyn qualifying trials the nominations must be lodged with GRSA by 12.30pm on the day of the meeting. To nominate online however you can only do this up until 11.59pm the day before. Due to a system security policy you cannot nominate on the day for these trials online. Please contact our staff if you have any issues with these nominations prior to them closing.

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number.

POLICY FOR TRIALS IN PLACE

Remember trials will only be taken from -

- * 12.30pm Monday for Angle Park Tuesday nights
- * 12.30pm Tuesday for Gawler Wednesday nights
- * 12.30pm Thursday for Strathalbyn Friday nights
- * 12.30pm Thursday for Angle Park Saturday morning (day earlier due to being morning trials)

* For Public Holidays it will be the working day before ie if Monday is a Public Holiday then bookings taken on the Friday

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK AND GAWLER BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

RACE MEETING TRIAL POLICY

Angle Park Monday & Wednesday along with Gawler Tuesday, Friday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the Race Meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than 8 greyhounds nominated.

- 1. Reserves at the Meeting that do not obtain starts.
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located in an area affected by track closures.
- 3. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged.
- 4. Satisfactory trials.
- 5. Other greyhounds.

PROCEDURE/CRITERIA

- For Monday nights trainer to contact GRSA between 10.00am and 11.00am on the Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching line.
- 2. For Angle Park Wednesday, Gawler Tuesday & Friday trainer to contact GRSA between 4.00pm and 4.30pm on the day before.
- 3. For Gawler Sunday trainer to contact GRSA between 8.00am and 9.00am on the scratching line to nominate.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds Trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards allot the Box for the Greyhound.
- 6. Trials will be 515m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension or not cleared to race are not eligible to be nominated (these trials are conducted as if they are at a race meeting so all greyhounds need to be eligible at nomination time).
- 8. Greyhound registration certificate or cards must be produced at kennelling time.

9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilize the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave OR trainers with no other greyhounds will be free to leave following their trial.

If there are 12 races at Angle Park or Gawler there will be NO trials.

The Vet Clinic at these meetings cannot be used to accommodate any greyhounds to allow for extra trialling greyhounds. This policy has been introduced so that participants book in under the policy. The Vet Clinic needs to be available for the Vet and Stewards at race meetings

EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY-

- Thursday nights are kept available for the option for Interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead up to our Group races and also local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead up to a feature race upon request and they will take one of the eight kennels available for trialling ahead of the policy and sit separately to the 4 dog trials. Feature races are considered to be – Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals & any Group race Interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event and nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy.
- If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between this will be conducted as a solo trial and sit separately to the 2 four dog trials.

It is extremely important that trainers book in to trial at these race meetings. If unable to book in at these times then please contact GRSA where permission may be given to accept a booking outside of these times.
