## **CEO'S UPDATE**

## **Wagering Activity Payments (WAP)**

A new stakemoney framework is in the process of being introduced which is designed to grow returns to trainers, breeders and owners whilst also remaining responsive to movements (positive and negative) in wagering activity. The finer detail of that model will be covered in separate updates, but the model is designed to grow participant returns in line with the strength of wagering activity in a given period. The overarching objective of the model is to grow industry returns by about 6-8% overall and to allocate an 'equity' share of the wagering revenue that they have generated through their own racing efforts.

Based on historical context, a monthly WAP in the vicinity of \$50,000-60,000 would not be unusual, but could be lower or higher based on wagering performance at the time. Where industry returns have previously amounted to between 45-48% of net wagering revenue, the WAP model incorporates a full-year return of 50% of the revenue outcome.

The WAP operates on a delay with the payment typically occurring by the third week of the following month. The first payment to industry – scheduled for the current week – relates to actual wagering activity in both June and July. To that extent, the WAP that is allocated this week will relate to two months of stakemoney earnings. Quite pleasingly, this initiative has coincided with a sharp uplift in wagering across July, contributing to a WAP allocation in the current week of \$355,000 (well beyond expectations and in excess of what could typically be expected of the WAP, it should be noted). We understand that this approach will require some adjustment for participants, but this early outcome points to the extent to which connections will benefit when wagering is strong.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the ICG and the Clubs for their input into this model and the terms of this transitional approach to its introduction.

### **Saturday Morning Timeslot**

GRSA is grateful for having been afforded the opportunity to be one of the states involved in the new multi-state greyhound racing offer on Saturday mornings. This is a critical growth opportunity for SA participants and one which could be expected to build each year. To leverage that opportunity, we need nominations to flow across the weekly schedule in such a way that all timeslots and venues are able to conduct a minimum 10 race card. The application of the G-SIX format to the schedule will assist that goal, but it's important for all 'metro' participants to embrace Gawler-Angle Park- Murray Bridge as a genuine three-track model. With balance in the weekly schedule will come strong wagering returns and more positive outcomes from the WAP model going forward.

The current intention is to confirm that nominations at all three tracks are holding up, further to which we will progressively return to maximum cards [12 races] at all tracks/venues. We hope that occurs within a relatively short period. In the longer term, as border restrictions are removed and local numbers lift, G-EIGHT racing will progressively return across the Quaddie legs at all meetings and venues.

These two changes, in addition to the consolidation of national tote pools around the middle of 2021, will set SA up with the strongest possible foundation for future growth and certainty.

## The Truck rolls back into town with big win

## **ANGLE PARK**

After a short stint in Victoria racing against some of the best stayers in the land, SA fans were happy to see local staying star Sir Truculent return to Angle Park and continue on his winning way for trainer Wally Harkins.

With the State Final of the Nationals for the stayers on August 13 being a best 8, Sir Truculent drew box 5 in a strong local edition of this years series. A winner of 18 of his 33 starts over the 731m journey the son of Worm Burner and Establish was sent out a short priced favourite as the start was affected. Bouncing out of the boxes early was the Gino Grgurovic trained Miss Bellawood to lead them up with Five Thirty for Lauren Harris into second and My Boy Bean for Clint Trengove into third, however, they were quickly followed through by the "Truck" showing improved box speed as he made ground quickly. As the field raced past the winning post on the first occasions there was an air of anticipation as Sir Truculent had moved to second and had Miss Bellawood clearly in his sights and as they entered the back straight he loomed up and accelerated past her to take up the lead. Miss Bellawood was sticking on well while Five Thirty was putting together a handy run in third. Up and coming stayer Vontae Mack for Ben Rawlings after a slow beginning had moved to fourth however they were all flat out chasing Sir Truculent.

As heads turned for home Sir Truculent was in no danger, going on to win in dominate fashion by 4.50 lengths in a sizzling 42.70, ahead of a game Miss Bellawood while Five Thirty returned to form with a handy third 3 lengths away.

Sir Truculent has now won 25 races with 19 placings from 56 starts and tipped over the \$100,000 in prizemoney with the feature win. He stamped himself as a star of SA racing and in good news for the local fans we will see him here for a bit longer, until later in the year when he may venture back over the border to take on the best stayers in the land. For some of the other State Final winners, one cant help think they may be happy there is no National Final this year as taking on the "Truck" in this form would be a tough ask.

## Shadow Mist shows his class in the Sprint Final

#### ANGLE PARK

All eyes turned to the SA Sprint Final of the Nationals when exciting sprinter Shadow Mist, trained by Lauren Harris was sent out a short priced favorite after a blistering 29.33 win in the Heats.

The son of Dyna Double One and Diva's Shadow has been in hot form since arriving in SA, winning 8 of his 10 starts for the Harris kennel, with many suggesting he could be ready to take the mantle away from SA's darling of the track, Coorong Lucy as the State's best sprinter.

Those questions were answered in the affirmative when Shadow Mist flew out of the boxes when the start was affected running a flying 4.40 to the post and then sizzled down the back straight in a slick





16.61, before cruising home to victory in a sharp 29.39 after leading throughout. He won by 4.50 lengths ahead of Blister for Chris Jaensch who ran another solid race and continues to be one of the most improved sprinters in the State while it was great to see Axel Footluce for Ken Trowbridge, who has been injury plagued over his career, return to good form with a nice third after getting a run from reserve.

Shadow Mist has now won 19 races from



43 starts, with 10 minor placings and just under \$55,000 in prizemoney. There will be some big decisions ahead for the Harris kennel and connections with Shadow Mist now booking a spot in the Semi-Finals of the Million Dollar Chase at Wentworth Park after winning the State Final, if they nominate. This series clashes with the Group 1 Adelaide Cup on 9th October so to chase a million dollars or win a Group 1 in your home State is definitely some food for thought.

## Suspense State Straight Championships for Corby

## MURRAY BRIDGE

A fair crowd was on hand at the Murray Bridge straight track for the SA Straight Track Championship on Wednesday August 5th with the Kirin Corby trained Suspense claiming the 2020 title.

Air Marshall (B1) and Suspense (B8) both jumped well as did Friday Frothies who pushed up from box 7. Suspense managed to get down to the rail and find his way to the front as he broke away from the pack.

With 100 metres to go Suspense was in no danger and all eyes were on the minor placings where Air Marshall held on for the silver medal with Woodside Jester taking the bronze and then a wall of dogs behind them.

Suspense aka "Spencer" is turning into somewhat of a straight track specialist. After sustaining a back leg injury as a pup, he's not a fan of going around the bends but give him a nice straight run and look out!

The win takes his race record to 7 starts for 4 wins and 2 seconds and also gave Kirin, the smiling assassin, another big chunk of a trophy to add to, what must be, a pretty impressive collection!



## Saturday Morning Racing and Changes to the Weekly Racing Schedule

#### MEDIA RELEASE

As part of the introduction of the fortnightly Saturday morning timeslot, GRSA consulted with industry stakeholders regarding the manner in which the schedule of racing could be refined to ensure the right flow of nominations across all weekly meetings.

The following is a summary of the changes that will be implemented in conjunction with the introduction of the Saturday morning racing initiative:

#### **G-SIX Racing Format**

Racing will be conducted in the G-SIX format across all venues and meetings, with the following exceptions:

- Specific feature and group races
- Staying races [643m+ races]
- When an 8-dog final is advertised

It should be noted that feature and group races may be conducted with G-SIX heats at the Graders discretion.

#### **Number of Races Per Meeting**

From Monday 17th August, race meetings which are programmed for the three days either side of a scheduled Saturday morning meeting will initially be limited to 10 races. For all other meetings across the fortnight, a maximum of 12 races will be permitted.

Angle Park trials will be conducted on the Sunday morning from 8am when there is a Saturday morning race meet that week.

## 3-Week Wednesday Cycle of Murray Bridge Straight Track and Angle Park

From Thursday August 20th, our Wednesday meetings run according to the following 3-week cycle:

- Week 1: Murray Bridge Straight Track
- Week 2: Murray Bridge Straight Track
- Week 3: Angle Park

This 3-week Wednesday cycle will also allow GRSA to program more heats and finals for the Murray Bridge Straight Track.

#### **Grading of Saturday Morning Racing**

The Saturday mornings at Angle Park will be graded as Provincial 2 meetings, run into the catching pen and initially be timegraded events, with specific conditions advertised in the all tracks calendar. The introduction of time grading on Saturday mornings will support the broader weekly racing schedule.

#### Weekly Schedule - Future Objective

As border restrictions lift and movement across the state borders begins to flow, our objective is to progressively move towards the following outcomes [in the order listed]:

- 12 races at all meetings
- 8-dog quads at all meetings

The Saturday morning timeslot constitutes an important growth opportunity for greyhound racing in South Australia. These measures will ensure an optimal flow of nominations across all venues from the introduction of Saturday racing.

## Mount Gambier – response to border restrictions from September 1

### ■ MEDIA RELEASE

The Mount Gambier Club and GRSA have been in close discussion over recent days regarding the extent to which available greyhound nominations present a challenge for racing at the venue beyond the running of the Mt Gambier Cup on August 30, until such time as Victorian border restrictions are lifted. Victorian nominations normally account for a majority of the weekly starters at Mt Gambier meetings.

In what has been the most challenging of years, the Club had worked hard to maintain its Thursday racing opportunity, but the more recent issues in Victoria and the extension of border restrictions have come as a further blow to the region.

GRSA is committed to continuing to support the Club through this difficult time and, to that extent, have approved a support package for the region in an effort to provide some comfort and certainty to key stakeholders in the region. The following arrangements will come into effect from September 1. The intention is that they will remain in place until the borders have opened and the normal schedule of racing at Mt Gambier – Thursday and Sunday race meetings – has re-commenced:

A (notional) minimum of 40 greyhounds will be required for a Thursday race meeting to automatically proceed. In the event that the minimum level of nominations is not met, and further to discussion between GRSA and the Club, a decision may be made to cancel that meeting. In the event that a meeting is

cancelled, the following package will be applied to support registered trainers and breeders in the region for that week in lieu of a racing opportunity.

- \$4 payment per greyhound per day (includes pups and retirees) for all registered premises
- \$150 special payment for trainers to travel to Murray Bridge, Angle Park or Gawler
- Preferential trialling opportunities at northern tracks (where possible) on race-days

The decision to push forward with racing in the region with a reduced race meeting was made with the support of Tabcorp and Sky Racing, having regard for the unusual pressures that COVID-19 restrictions have indirectly placed on some regional areas.


GRSA Chairman Grantley Stevens expressed his eagerness to see Mt Gambier to return to its traditional schedule of racing. "For the sake of clarity, we are all desperately keen to see the border restrictions come down based on a Victorian recovery and for Mt Gambier greyhound racing to rebound. This support scheme is intended as an interim measure only to support the Mt Gambier region in lieu of a return to 'normal'. The southeastern region is a vital cog within the broader SA model."

The Club will conduct the heats and final of the 2020 Mt Gambier Cup on August 23 and 30.

## 2020 Heats Bourne Kennels Mount Gambier

Five Heats of the Bourne Kennels Listed Mount Gambier Cup Heats will be held, Sunday 23rd August, with some of the most exciting chasers contesting this time honoured event.

The likes of Rajasthan, Holy Reign, Silent Jacko, Almighty Stripe, Sunset Milo, Call Me Billy, Galactic Athena, Cawbourne Terry and Volcanic Lava will all do battle throughout the day. With 5 Heats the winners and three fastest second placegetters will all qualify for the \$14,275 Final (\$10,000 to the winner) on Sunday, 30th August. The box draw for the Final will be conducted oncourse on Sunday shortly after the final Heat has been conducted. To support the Bourne Kennels Mount Gambier Cup Final, there will be a Consolation for greyhounds that competed in the Heats (trainers will need to renominate for this event). On Sunday there will be two Heats of the Formula 400 Open Feature over 400m with the Final also run on Cup Final day, Sunday 30th August.

With only 8 nominations for the Maiden event over 512m, The Produce Store Feature Maiden will also be conducted on Cup Final day with fresh nominations.

As part of the linking between the Murray Bridge Cup series and Mount Gambier Cup series, GRSA had provided a bonus if the same trainer could win both series and also if the same greyhound could win both. Whilst the Murray Bridge Cup was run in March and won by the Tony Rasmussen trained Hot Sophie, GRSA will still honour these bonuses with Tony chasing \$5,000 if one of the greyhounds he trains can with the Mount Gambier Cup.

## Remote trainers fee to assist Mount Gambier meeting

With continuing border restrictions affecting participation in the South East due to COVID-19, GRSA have decided to support the Mount Gambier meetings knowing the importance to be racing on a weekly basis during this time.

For those trainers that live more than 150 kilometres from Mount Gambier and travel to these meetings they will receive an additional \$75 payment to their normal Trainers Fee. The fee will be capped at one payment per registered premises and will continue until the borders are open.

## Kings and Queens Feature Heats later this month

Again this year GRSA will conduct the Kings and Queens Feature series with Heats on Thursday, 27th August and a \$6,430 Final on Thursday, 3rd September in continued support of any greyhound affected by the change to the GCA Age Restricted Classics change a few years ago.

The eligibility for this series is for dogs and bitches whelped between 1st March 2018 and 31st May 2018.

Performed Maidens are eligible (raced or qualy trialled).

It will be dependent upon nominations, however, we would like to run a dogs Heat and a bitches Heat separately with greyhounds qualifying into the Final. If there are not sufficient nominations for either sex then these Heats may be mixed into a couple of mixed Heats. Special conditions apply, however, these races will be non-penalty.

• Nominations close Monday, 24th August at 9.00am with GRSA

#### Gawler Classic 2020 (short course) in late August

The Heats of the 2020 Gawler Classic [Short Course – 400m] will be run on Friday, 28th August. These Heats are for SA Bred greyhounds which have been paid up for Classic 2020. The \$3,000 Final will be run on Friday, 4th September.

• Nominations for the Heats close at 9am on Tuesday, 25th August.

## Defy produces big month of racing in July

July's Greyhound of the Month was Defy for trainer Troy Murray after an outstanding month of racing which included 5 wins from his 6 starts.

The son of Keybow and Velocity Storm is only new to SA racing and took a few starts to wind up. He put the writing on the wall for what was to come in early July with a super second behind Boom Down at Gawler over the 643m in slick time. He then went on a winning streak of 5 in a row with 3 victories over the 600m at Angle Park, all in sub 35 seconds, a strong win at Gawler over the 643m again in fast time and a last to first victory at headquarters over the 515m.

At the end of the month Defy's record stood at 53 starts for 24 wins and 17 placings and earnings around \$70,000, stamping himself as one of the most exciting chasers in the State.



## Sir Truculent keeps on delivering great runs

The Run of the Month for July was again won by the Wally Harkins trained Sir Truculent for his sizzling win at Angle Park in a Free For All event on Thursday, 2nd July over the 731m.

Having already won the Run of the Month award for the two previous months, SA's staying star may have even out done those performances on this night. As a red hot favourite he again powered past his rivals mid race to go on and win in fine style by 6.50 lengths in an amazing 42.66. This time was only .16 outside of the track record held by Arvos' Athena set in 2004.





Participants are able to purchase their very own red vests for \$20 however GRSA will always have some available. These vests look very smart and come up particularly well on Sky Racing promoting SA Racing so with that in mind the long parade coats have been phased out of action with participants required to have a black or navy jumper available to be worn under the vests.

## GRSA plan to disseminate scratchings in a more timely manner

Historically, it has been GRSA's standard practice to wait until after the appointed scratching time to officially release all the scratchings.

GRSA would not release any scratchings for a meeting until this time. However, in the current climate with many wagering organisations wanting to open markets early on our races, they are not able to do so due to greyhounds potentially being scratched for injury, illness, ineligibility etc. This can affect potential revenue back to the industry with persons not able to invest, or investing and having the market alter when scratchings are finalised. This will also provide greater transparency for trainers, staff and our business.

For a trial period of 3 months it will be GRSA's intention upon receiving a scratching from a trainer to input this into OzChase at that time, which will then be made public through the GRSA website. Once the greyhound has been scratched by the trainer and made public it is considered as being withdrawn. This is not uncommon practice with other States doing the same thing. For greyhounds that become ineligible for a race meeting due to winning a Maiden event, racing on consecutive days, offending during the run or being injured on the night etc and engaged in another race meeting, GRSA staff will automatically scratch the greyhound (as it is ineligible) at either the completion of the meeting when finalised by the stewards or the next working day. We have always encouraged trainers to scratch these grevhounds that have become ineligible for their next engagements, however, this is not always the case with staff waiting to withdraw them at the appointed time. For trainers in certain circumstances that may wish to appeal an offence with their greyhound engaged in another event then they would be required to flag that intent with the stewards on the day.

The benefits of this change will provide -

- Transparency across our meetings
- Correct information in real time
- Wagering companies can field up to date markets
- Allows punters to wager with confidence
- Allows for wagering dollars not to be tied up until after the 'All Clear 'of a race if a selection was scratched

This will take effect from Monday, 24th August 2020.

## Murray Bridge Slipping Track now available

## Grading Review Panel main outcomes from meeting

**MASTERS EVENTS (GRADE 5 AND MIXED)** - For City A, City B and Prov 1 Masters events the greyhounds 4yo and older will be selected on form with the greyhounds between 4 and 3  $\frac{3}{4}$  still on age. For Masters events conducted at Prov 2 meetings ALL greyhounds will be selected on age.

For the main Masters races which we normally run at the Angle Park Monday and Gawler Friday meetings, these will be on form for 4yo and older and for Gawler Tuesday and Angle Park Wednesday meetings it will be on age. All other conditions still remain like time standards etc.

#### Effective from nominations closing on Monday, 20th July 2020.

**MAIDENS** - if there are not 6 or more Maidens nominated, then the race should not be conducted unless specifically needed to make up a program.

#### Effective from nominations closing on Monday, 20th July 2020.

**HEATS TO FINALS** - Where there are insufficient nominations to run Heats of an advertised event [less than 10 nominations normal events, middle distance and staying events], the event will be conducted as a one-off Final on the date when the Heats were scheduled. If the event is considered a feature event like the Stayers Cup for example or a memorial race, the one-off Final will be conducted on the date of the original Final and a normal graded event conducted at the Heat meeting.

## Effective from nominations closing on Monday, 20th July 2020. TIME GRADING —

All Time Grading for all Clubs in SA to be uniform with groupings [Maiden/1-4 wins/5+ wins].

For Time Grading events when there are two or more races, then the lowest rating time dogs (the fastest dogs for this grouping) are declared the reserves.

If a greyhound is a reserve for a Time Grading event and does not gain a start then they will automatically get a start in the next Time Graded meeting (no matter the track) so long as they are nominated.

Effective from nominations closing on Monday, 20th July 2020.

## **GOTBA** coursing to start in September

Approval has been given by the GRSA Board for GOTBA to conduct three Coursing meetings this year at Virginia.

Unfortunately due to COVID-19 the Club have not been able to Course from the usual April to September race dates.

After liaising with the Club the below dates have been advised for Virginia Coursing.

Instead SA will still run a Match Race series for the best greyhounds nominated

#### **Conditions -**

- 515m Special Event No Penalties Apply Best 8 greyhounds in match race conditions
- 4 match races worth \$2,500 \$3,250 each (runner-up \$350) with overall winner receiving \$5,000, 2nd place \$1,430 and 3rd place \$715.
- Nominations close Monday 21st September at 9am.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3, Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. The Grader will then have to randomly draw the boxes [1 or 3] that each greyhound starts from. The most prizemoney will be allocated to the highest rated match.

GRSA will also have exclusive footage from inside the boxes of the greyhounds with has been a real highlight in past years.

GRSA conducted the Eastar Match Race series in April where Alfieri won for Bill Wudarczyk in a sizzling 29.54. As part of that series, for winning, Alfieri would be guaranteed a spot as an SA representative in the State Of Origin. Whilst that series has been postponed GRSA will honour this condition with accepting Alfieri as one of the 8 greyhounds for the SA Match Race series so long as he is nominated.

GRSA will continue the condition that the overall winner of the SA Match Race series will be guaranteed a spot in the Group 1 Adelaide Cup on Friday, 9th October.

Marlee Jaye showed brilliant early speed for Liz Harley to lead from box 1 as the field reached the winning post on the first occasion. As they left the front straight Marlee Jaye led easily with Coorong Nugget moving into a clear second while the majority of other runners were caught up in some interference on the first turn affecting their chances. As the field settled it looked a two dog race as they entered the back straight with Marlee Jaye in the lead hotly pursued by Coorong Nugget and a big margin to Oakvale Blue who swepped into third for Nathan Wilson. Express Eve for Kirin Corby, Oakvale Style for Nathan Wilson and Major Major were able to balance up and began to make steady progress from midfield but a long way of the leading division. Off the back straight and Marlee Jaye was coursing wide in the lead and presented a beautiful inside run for Coorong Nugget who charged to the front and raced away looking all over a winner. Into the front straight and Coorong





Nugget was in no danger going on to record a strong 29.71 win by 6 lengths. Marlee Jaye went via the cape turning form home allowing Oakvale Blue to charge into second and the luckless Major Major flying home for third while she clocked in fourth.

## **GRSA 2020 SA Country Cup**

Below are details of how and where greyhounds can qualify for the \$6,430 SA Country Cup Final (G-SIX), to be run at Angle Park over 515 metres on Adelaide Cup Final night Friday, 9th October 2020.

#### **Conditions:**

- All South Australian Greyhound Racing Clubs outside of Angle Park will conduct Heats, or nominate greyhounds from which the Greyhound Racing SA Grading Department will choose two representatives. These meetings are Gawler Provincial 2, Murray Bridge One Turn Provincial 1 and Mount Gambier Provincial 2. [Performances at Gawler Provincial 1 meetings are not eligible for consideration]
- The event is open to all South Australian greyhounds that are not above Grade 5 at Angle Park (APK City A & APM City B meetings only) over 515 metres at the time of nomination. Winner of each event takes a penalty including the Final.

There are no Special Exceptions this year as ALL greyhounds must be SA trained to be eligible:

- A South Australian trained greyhound is defined as one that has been racing in SA for a period of not less than 3 out of the 6 months immediately prior to the time of nomination.
- The trainer can only qualify for one of the Clubs.
- The trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 3 months.
- Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.
- The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track it is attempting to represent.
- There will be a maximum of two Heats per Club with the winners of each Heat qualifying. If there is only one Heat conducted then the first two placegetters will qualify.
- The two reserves will be determined firstly by a ballot of the second placegetters from all Heats. The third placegetters will then be considered by ballot if required. If a Heat was not conducted at the track, then that track is not included in the ballot. Should a greyhound be withdrawn prior to the ballot, the next placed greyhound from that Club's Heat will be selected.
- Once a greyhound has qualified from a Qualifying Heat, it is not eligible to compete at another track in this series, unless there are insufficient nominations to fill the field.
- Once qualified for the Country Cup Final the greyhound will be ineligible for the Adelaide Cup series or any other race on this Cup Final night.
- Lead up Heats may be up to 8 greyhounds, however, the Final on Adelaide Cup night will be a G-SIX Final

## **Dress Code amendments**

The GRSA Dress Code Policy has been amended. The most notable changes are the inclusion of black dress jeans and chinos with beanies being added as acceptable headwear.

Stewards will be monitoring dress standards more closely, please approach them if you need to seek clarification.

## **Dress Code Policy**

Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) is committed to upholding the Rules of greyhound racing.

GRSA has a dress code policy for all persons parading greyhounds. The dress code is to be complied with at all GRSA TAB race meetings.

#### **Dress Code is as follows:**

- Black pants, black dress jeans or black dress chinos.
- Black enclosed shoes (all black).
- Black or navy jumper.
- Collared white shirt.
- White polo shirt.
- GRSA polo shirt.
- GRSA black shorts black socks and shoes must be worn with shorts.
- Approved head wear GRSA baseball cap or GRSA beanie.

Trousers, etc., must not be faded or torn and must have regular cuffs (no elastic cuffs).

No cargo pants, tracksuit pants or leggings permitted.

Jumpers must be plain and not contain branding, stripes or contrasting colours.

Any person failing to comply with the dress code with not be permitted to parade greyhounds, and may be guilty of an offence in accordance with GAR 86 (z) which reads:

#### **R86Offences**

A person (including an official) shall be guilty of an offence if the person-

(z) being an owner, trainer or registered person in charge of a greyhound fails to comply with the dress standards of a Controlling Body or club;

HANDLERS ARE TO REPORT UNCLEAN PARADE VESTS WHICH WILL BE TAKEN OUT OF CIRCULATION IMMEDIATELY UNTIL CLEANED.

## Catcher/Attendant minimum age

Thanks to the many people who contacted me in support of a revision of minimum age for Catchers and Attendants.

In response GRSA have reduced the minimum age for an Attendant to 16 years and a Catcher to 14 years. Applications may be accepted under special circumstances from persons under these ages at the entire discretion of Stewards. The new policy takes effect immediately. Please be aware of the following South Australian Government advice if considering applying:

There is no minimum working age in South Australia. However, if you are thinking of employing a young worker be aware that:

- a child of compulsory school age (between 6 and 16 years of age) cannot be employed during school hours
- a child may not work at a time, such as late at night or early in the morning, that is likely to render them unfit to attend school or obtain the proper benefit from attendance.

## Retirement to GAP and other adoption programs

When completing retirement forms please ensure that the correct retirement option is being selected.

Many licensed people have unintentionally lodged forms stating they have retired greyhounds to GAPSA [2] when they have actually retired the greyhound to another adoption program [6] such as Bridging The Gap. Please contact Animal Welfare if you are unsure which option to select or if you believe you have mistakenly retired a greyhound incorrectly.

## Changes in retirement after lodging a retirement form

If a retirement form has been lodged with GRSA but the details have since changed you are required to update GRSA and provide an additional retirement form.

An example is having submitted paperwork to advise a greyhound will be retired to GAP but after lodging the form you have retired the greyhound privately (to a third party) or via another adoption program.

## Changes of roles within Integrity department

GRSA has changed some roles in recent weeks within the Integrity Department which has now been split into two roles.

The Chief Steward, Des Jonas, heads up the Stewarding team as well as Licencing. A new face, Derek Kordick, is now the Risk and Compliance Manager, heading up the Welfare Compliance team, as well as some other roles, such as inquiries for serious rule breaches and similar issues relating to regulation within the industry.

The aim of Risk and Compliance is to continue property inspections and act on welfare concerns, as was previously done. In addition to regulation, the expanded aim is to help educate and promote best practice by the industry in relation to greyhound husbandry.

Every month in Kennel Capers, Derek will write about topics and projects that may be of interest to you. For example, one such project is to look at ways GRSA can assist the industry to navigate the various Government requirements to keep greyhounds. There are a number of layers to get through, from State and Local Government, relating to keeping greyhounds.

## **Completion of Major Projects**

In the past month, GRSA has brought three important projects to a conclusion:

- Angle Park Vet Clinic
- Murray Bridge Slipping Track
- GAP Kennels at Angle Park

The Angle Park Vet Clinic will be handed over in the last week of August and GRSA is excited to see operations move away from the existing location which can be problematic.

Greg and Daniella are also very keen to move into the new building, with the more prominent location providing a great opportunity for the business.

The Murray Bridge slipping track has been operational for a number of weeks now and the feedback from participants has been excellent.

Just a reminder to participants using the track to (a) show caution when driving along the access road, and (b) clean up after your greyhounds if they empty out on the track.

reception or see MBGRC Maintenance Manager Darren Pearce down at the Club.

The other project which is extremely important, but a little more operational, is the installation of nine kennels at Angle Park for the Adoption Program.

These facilities will allow the GAP team greater flexibility in the logistical requirements relating to greyhound movement, which will hopefully flow on to a more efficient overall operation.

## Dual Lure – Options for GRSA

The subject of dual lures was discussed at the recent Industry Consultation Group (ICG) meeting.

It was resolved that GRSA not pursue a dual lure setup in South Australia, as the group felt that the existing hoop lure and tri-colour sheepskin was working well.

The challenge for the dual lure is finishon races and trials, noting that in Victoria they (a) do not use a dual lure for finish on races at Geelong, and (b) use dedicated lures at arm trial sessions.

GRSA will continue to monitor lure development Interstate and may raise this topic with the ICG in the future if required.




## **Latest updates from GAP**

## Do you have a small dog?

Do you or someone you know have a small dog that could benefit from some socialisation and company during the day?

GAP SA is looking for small dogs to help with their green collar and first point assessments.

Your dog will be well looked after with plenty of pats and treats throughout the day. They will assist with either green collar assessments for dogs that have been living with foster carers or for greyhounds entering the program.

During assessments, greyhounds will be muzzled, on a leash and handled by an experienced assessor and handlers. All dogs will be walked around together in a secure testing area for approximately 5-10 mins to assess the greyhound's reaction to the small dog. If the greyhound is reacting well we will allow them to approach and sniff the small dog.

We are looking for dogs that are generally social and happy meeting other dogs and ones that walk well on a lead. Sessions are rostered at least a month in advance and are generally around two to four hours in length.

## Adelaide-based syndicate holds strong hand in cup Heats

### MOUNT GAMBIER

The Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club's 40th Mount Gambier Cup has held up particularly well with five heats to be run over 512 metres on Sunday's 23rd August's 12-race program at Tara Raceway.

And the Adelaide-based syndicate of Tim Aloisi, Matt Lehman, Damien Bates and Mick McSorley looks to hold a strong hand with Rajasthan, Ask Me Now, Dyna Virion and Kipling.

Rajasthan and Kipling, previously trained in Victoria by Rob Camilleri, are currently with caretaker trainer Aloisi who is based at Munno Para West. Camilleri was at Tara Raceway for last year's cup, running second to Galactic Athena with Slingshot Hammer.

Kipling, a son of Fernando Bale x Some Kinda Girl, is a quick greyhound and looks one of the top chances in this year's cup. In June he broke the Horsham 410 metres track record with a run of 22.84 seconds.

Drawn in box five in the fourth heat, Kipling will clash with Zipping Dodge, a winner of his only two starts at Tara Raceway, and Galactic Athena, winner of last year's cup in race record time.

Galactic Athena's appearance in this year's cup will create plenty of interest as she will be attempting to become the first back-to-back winner of the event for Moorak owner Robert Chuck and trainer Steve Bartholomew of Worrolong.

Rajasthan, a son of Kinloch Brae and Telling You, has drawn box one in the first Heat and there wouldn't be too many greyhounds to have gone around Tara Raceway that have banked more money than this bloke.

A winner of 35 races from 104 starts, Rajasthan has collected \$390,000 in stakemoney, \$175,000 of that coming as a result of his upset win in the 2019 Group 1 Sandown Cup Final (715 m).

Rajasthan was bred at Nambrok by Lyn Smith who in 2018 reached the Mount Gambier Cup Final with Megellas Fairy.

Ask Me Now, trained at Trott Park by Bates, resumed at Angle Park over 515 metres recently after a two-month break, clocking a personal time of 29.99 seconds when running a two lengths second behind Cawbourne Scar.

The son of Oaks Road x Tarks Nemesis will jump from box four in the second Heat which includes one of the better local hopes in the Nineofus Syndicate's Silent Jacko, trained by the cup's sponsor, David Peckham of Allendale East's Bourne Kennels.

Peckham also trains Dyna Virion, who has drawn box one in Heat three of the cup. The 41 kilograms son of US sire KC And All has raced only once at Tara Raceway for an impressive win last month over Jervois Boy in a quick 29.67 seconds.

Drawn alongside Dyna Virion is Sunset Milo (My Bro Fabio x Jewel Action), raced by Aloisi and Lehman and also currently being trained by the former. The 14-race winner will be having his first SA start after having previously run some quick times at Cannington and Mandurah in WA.

Three years after winning the Mount Gambier Cup with her terrific bitch Fabregal, Lewiston trainer Robyn Mackellar returns with Holy Reign and Ashby Mayhem.

After her cup win, with Mackellar scaling down her operation, the daughter of Fabregas x Allinga Aye Jay was transferred to Lyn Smith. Fabregal ended her racing career with 46 wins and \$214,000 in

Holy Reign has some more than handy form at Angle Park and Gawler to her name while Ashby Mayhem did much of her early racing at Tara Raceway for Penshurst trainer Brendan Bunworth prior to being purchased by Mackellar.

In fact, as far back as March, Ashby Mayhem was being touted as a Mount Gambier Cup hope after she had defeated Perseverance at Tara Raceway by nine lengths in a best of day time of 29.47 seconds

#### QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday (drawn Thursday) or Wednesday (drawn Friday) meetings.

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the Tuesday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations for both of these qualifying trials close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Wednesday.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held on a monthly basis at a Friday morning session, which has both tracks trialling. The next session will be Friday, 11th September Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Thursday prior.

## ANGLE PARK

#### SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

### **BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS**

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

## POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

### **Policy Background**

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

## **Race Meeting Trial Policy**

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Tuesday and Friday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the race meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be

selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

- 1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
- 3. Satisfactory trials

#### Procedure/criteria

- 1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA by midday on Monday to nominate. Should the
  - Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
- 2. For Gawler Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before.
- 3. For Murray Bridge Wednesday, the trainer is to contact
  - GRSA by 4.30pm the day before. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- 6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- 9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
  - Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
- In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

### **Exceptions to this policy**

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

## MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.


