Last chance for Waterloo Cup eligibility draws close

The 2024 Waterloo Cup meeting is quickly approaching with the event set to be run over two days on the weekend of September 21 and 22.

Strong recent nominations coinciding with a boost in prizemoney have seen the need for the feature meeting to return to a two-day format.

There is only one meeting left to ensure nomination eligibility for the Derby, Oaks and Waterloo Cup.

It is an existing condition that to be eligible for these events, greyhounds must have competed at at least one coursing event across the season

In addition, there is also a \$500 bonus available for any greyhound who has competed at any of two Virginia coursing meetings during the season if they are able to win the Derby, Oaks or Waterloo Cup.

“There are terrific incentives available to consider coursing, and we hope that we see numbers continue to be strong in the second half of the season,” GOTBA Chair Neil Mann said.

Prizemoney for eight-dog coursing events now aligns with prize money for time-graded track events while major increases to the Oaks, Derby and time-honoured Waterloo Cup were announced last month.

Total prizemoney for the Waterloo Cup will rise from \$4000 to \$8000 while the Oaks and Derby will increase from \$2650 to \$5000.



The next coursing meeting is Sunday, September 8 with nominations closing with GRSA on Wednesday September 4. This is the last meeting to nominate to ensure eligibility for features.

The Oaks, Derby and Waterloo Cup meeting is on the weekend of September 21 and 22 with nominations closing Wednesday September 18.

New Prizemoney (Commenced July 2024)

4 dog coursing events – first \$350, runner up \$110 [Up from first \$265, runner up \$90]

8 dog coursing events – first \$525, runner up \$160 [up from first \$380, runner up \$120]

Waterloo Cup – first \$6,000, runner up \$1,600, thirds \$200

Oaks – first \$3,700, runner up \$1,000, thirds \$150

Derby – first \$3,700, runner up \$1,000, thirds \$150

Entry conditions for Derby, Oaks and Waterloo Cup: Must have had 1 start at any Coursing venue during 2024 to be eligible for the Waterloo Cup, Oaks or Derby.

Bonus – If the winner of the Derby, Oaks or Waterloo Cup is a greyhound that has raced at two Virginia Coursing meetings during the 2024 season, a \$500 bonus will apply.

GAWLER SHOW THIS WEEKEND

This year, the Annual Gawler Show will be held this weekend, Saturday 24th and Sunday 25th August. As a result of this and the National Championships held locally, racing on Sunday night, 25th August will be at Angle Park.

Racing on Friday, 23rd August will be at Murray Bridge around the One Turn with the Murray Bridge Straight track and Angle Park racing on Saturday, 24th August due to the Nationals. Trials will be cancelled at Angle Park on this weekend also due to the Nationals commitment.

Trials will be cancelled at Gawler on Thursday, 22nd August and Monday, 26th August during this time. At the moment trials will go ahead on Thursday, 29th August at the venue but this will be dependent upon the tidying up and track maintenance progression. Trials will be conducted at Murray Bridge on Monday morning, 26th August as normal.

Racing will be at Murray Bridge on the Straight track on Wednesday, 28th August to allow more time for the Show society to remove all of their activities from the Show. There will be trials that night at Murray Bridge.

Racing will return to Gawler all going well on Friday, 30th August.

EULER BALE SETS NEW TRACK RECORD OVER 342M ON MONDAY NIGHT

The Angle Park 342m track record has been broken again for the second time in one week. On Monday, 12th August, Darcy Dakota for Kerry Stagg produced a sensational run to go 19.10 from box one and beat the previous record of 19.14 held by Craggy Island, we then saw the Robyn Mackellar trained Euler Bale smash that time standard on Monday, 19th August by .06 and run a flying 19.04 in winning by almost 8 lengths. Congratulations to all concerned.

PREFERENTIAL BOX DRAWS AT MURRAY BRIDGE STRAIGHT TRACK

GRSA has started conducting Preferential Box Draws for selected events at the Murray Bridge Straight track meetings (Maidens and Feature Cup and Championship series are excluded). These types of events are being regularly programmed Interstate under each state's conditions. Events will be specifically advertised, and trainers must advise if they want to compete in these events along with the racing trait of the respective greyhound at the time of nominating in the comments box. If trainers do not provide this information when nominating, they will not be considered for these advertised PBD events.

Conditions -

- PBD racing to be introduced for advertised race events at the Murray Bridge Straight track as from August 1, 2024
- Three racing traits – R = Rail, M = Middle, W = Wide
- The Trainer nominates the racing trait of the greyhound relating to box rise and 50m after the start
- This is reviewed by Stewards/Grading teams
- Box draws via OzChase which can now accommodate an automated process where greyhounds can be grouped by trait and then automatically box drawn
- Grading of each race event will be done under normal grading and programming guidelines
- There will be No Reserves for these events

KINGS AND QUEENS FEATURE HEATS – NOMINATIONS CLOSE ON MONDAY 26TH AUGUST

Again this year GRSA will conduct the Kings and Queens Feature series with \$5,810 Heats on Thursday, 29th August and a \$7,500 Final on Thursday, 5th September in continued support of any greyhound affected by the change to the GCA Age Restricted Classics change quite

a number of years ago. The eligibility for this series is for dogs and bitches whelped between 1st March 2022 and 31st May 2022. Performed Maidens are eligible (raced or quality trialed). Depending upon nominations we would like to run a dogs Heat and a bitches Heat separately with greyhounds qualifying into the Final. If there are not sufficient nominations for either sex, then these Heats may be mixed into a couple of mixed Heats. Special conditions apply; however, these races will be non-penalty.

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 26th August at 9.00am with GRSA.

2024 SA OAKS AND SA DERBY FEATURES IN SEPTEMBER

The Group 3 SA Oaks and SA Derby to be run in September this year will be for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st June, 2022 (27 months).

The Heats of the Oaks will be run on the same night as the Derby again this year with Heats on Thursday, 12th September and the Group 3 Finals on Thursday, 19th September.

The Dates are:

SA Oaks (Group 3): \$5,810 Heats – Thursday, 12th September \$35,000 Final – Thursday, 19th September

SA Derby (Group 3): \$5,810 Heats – Thursday, 12th September \$35,000 Final – Thursday, 19th September

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 9th September at 9.00am.
- Trainers are reminded of the Vaccination eligibility for racing in South Australia

LOW GRADE SERIES AT ANGLE PARK

The next Low Grade Feature Series at Angle Park will be a Restricted (0-8 Wins) series over the 595m with \$4,420 Heats on Thursday, 19th September and the \$5,810 Final on Thursday, 26th September.

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 16th September at 9.00am.

2024 TAB MATCH RACE CHALLENGE – SA TAKES ON THE ALL STARS IN SEPTEMBER

South Australia will again conduct the annual Match Race Challenge in September, to be held on Thursday, 26th September during the rich Adelaide Cup Carnival.

GRSA has kept the conditions of the series the same as last year to be “SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS” to ensure that the Angle Park TAB Match Race Challenge attracts the best greyhounds possible.

It will be four (4) SA greyhounds taking on the four (4) best nominated greyhounds from anywhere in Australia.

GRSA will still guarantee the winner of the TAB Match Race Challenge direct entry into the \$100,000 to the winner Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final on Friday, 11th October (bypassing the Adelaide Cup Heats). The winner of the Match Race series is considered qualified for the Group 1 Adelaide Cup and will not be eligible to compete in another series.

- Nominations close at 9am on Monday, 23rd September with GRSA.

Conditions of the TAB Match Race Challenge – SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS:

Eligibility as to who represents South Australia or All-Stars will be based around the National Championships domiciliary clause. Greyhounds need to be trained in the State they wish to represent for 76 days out of the last 150 days prior to the date that nominations close (23rd September).

The best four (4) greyhounds nominated from SA will be selected by the GRSA Grader to represent “SA’s Best”. The best four (4) greyhounds nominated from Interstate will be selected by the GRSA Grader to represent “the All-Stars”.

The Grader will use whatever information he has available to select those greyhounds including liaising with other State bodies as required. The SA Grader’s decision will be final.

Those greyhounds not selected from Interstate will be given the opportunity to solo trial or race in another event on the night.

Reserves will be declared, with one (1) from SA and one (1) from Interstate (dependant on nominations), which will replace the SA or All-Stars representative as required.

For example the SA reserve will only replace an SA scratching.

The Grader will rate the four (4) greyhounds from SA and the four (4) from Interstate in order from 1 to 4, with No.1 being the highest rated greyhound from each group. The head-to-head matches will be decided by the two No. 1 rated greyhounds competing against each other and then it will be 2 v 2, 3 v 3 and 4 v 4.

Prizemoney for each individual match will also reflect the seeding of greyhounds from 1 to 4, with the No. 1 rated greyhounds racing for the most prizemoney in the head-to-head races. However, the overall winner of the race will still be determined on actual race times run by each greyhound (to three decimal places only).

Prizemoney for each pairing: • 1 v 1 – Winner \$4,750, Runner Up \$500 • 2 v 2 – Winner \$4,500, Runner Up \$500 • 3 v 3 – Winner \$4,250, Runner Up \$500 • 4 v 4 – Winner \$4,000, Runner Up \$500

Prizemoney for the overall placings for TAB Match Race Challenge (based on overall times): • 1st – \$7,500 • 2nd – \$2,500 • 3rd – \$1,000

2024 SA COUNTRY CUP CONDITIONS STARTING IN LATE SEPTEMBER

Below are details of how and where greyhounds can qualify for the \$8,500 SA Country Cup Final, to be run at Angle Park over 530 metres on Adelaide Cup Final night Friday, 11th October 2024 as a G-SIX. GRSA have kept the changes to the conditions from last year to encourage more support for the series with the heats at each venue increased to \$4,000 each.

Conditions:

- All South Australian Greyhound Racing Clubs outside of Angle Park will conduct Heats or nominate greyhounds from which the Greyhound Racing SA Grading Department will choose two representatives. These meetings are Gawler Provincial 1 & 2, Murray Bridge One Turn Provincial 1 and Mount Gambier Provincial 1 & 2.

- The event is open to all South Australian greyhounds that are not above Grade 5 at Angle Park (APK City A meeting only) over 530 metres at the time of nomination. This condition is not applicable to the Mount Gambier representatives. Winner of each event takes a penalty including the Final.

Special Exceptions:

Mount Gambier Club is allowed to include non-South Australian trainers under strict conditions:

- The Interstate trainer has had starters at 10 meetings for Mt Gambier in the previous 12 months.

- The Interstate trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 2 months.

- Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.

- The greyhound must be SA trained (except Mount Gambier as above).

A South Australian trained greyhound is defined as one that has been racing in SA for a period of not less than 2 out of the 6 months immediately prior to the time of nomination.

- The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track it is attempting to represent.

- There will be a maximum of two Heats per Club with the winners of each Heat qualifying. If there is only one Heat conducted, then the first two placegetters will qualify.

- The two reserves will be determined firstly by a ballot of the second placegetters from all Heats. The third placegetters will then be considered by ballot if required. If a Heat was not conducted at the track, then that track is not included in the ballot. Should a greyhound be withdrawn prior to the ballot, the next placed greyhound from that Club's Heat will be selected.

- If a greyhound does not qualify from a Qualifying Heat it is eligible to compete at another track in this series so long as meets that tracks criteria.

- Once a greyhound has qualified from a Qualifying Heat, it is not eligible to compete at another track in this series, unless there are insufficient nominations to fill the field.

- Once qualified for the Country Cup Final the greyhound will be ineligible for the Adelaide Cup series or any other race on this Cup Final night.

- Lead up Heats may be up to 8 greyhounds however the Final on Adelaide Cup night will be a G-SIX Final.

2024 TAB ADELAIDE CUP TO RACE ON FRIDAY 11TH OCTOBER

Thanks to the support of Greyhound Racing New South Wales this year, South Australia will be able to run our premier Group 1 meeting on Friday, 11th October. SA will swap meetings with NSW so we can race in the evening. We will have full Sky 1 coverage for this meeting.

Murray Bridge will race on the Thursday night before the Cup (10th October) retaining our normal night time Sky 1 slot.

GRSA is very appreciative of GRNSW for assisting us this year with this scheduling change which would not have happened without their support.

TUESDAY NIGHT MEETINGS ON THE CALENDAR

Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) announced the introduction of Tuesday night meetings at Angle Park, which started a few months ago. The Tuesday night meetings are designed to meet demand, providing more racing opportunities for lower class greyhounds within SA. The meetings are time graded, with 10 races of six dog fields. The meetings operate in tandem with Saturday morning race meetings which will target greyhounds of the same class with the racing distance at both race meetings restricted to 342m. The Tuesday meetings will provide a further outlet for greyhounds that are nominated for the Saturday mornings and are not provided with a starting opportunity. Greyhounds falling into this category will be granted preference rights if nominated for the subsequent Tuesday night meeting.

With Saturday morning and Tuesday night meetings being restricted to 342m nominations, opportunities for 530m time graded greyhounds will be programmed for other Angle Park dates. Trainers are encouraged to familiarise themselves with the details for the Tuesday night meetings, changes to the Saturday morning meetings and updated trialling times for Angle Park.

Tuesday night meetings

Weekly Tuesday night meetings at Angle Park (commenced May 14, 2024) have been time graded, Provincial 2 class, restricted to 10 races of six dog fields with reserves over 342m only. Groupings will be 'Worst to Best' with maidens, 1-4 wins and 5+ wins. Grading procedures for Tuesday nights will grant preference rights to any greyhound nominated at the immediately prior Saturday morning meeting but not provided with a separate starting opportunity at the Tuesday night meeting when fields were drawn, provided the said greyhound is re-nominated for the Tuesday night meeting. Greyhounds in this category include those listed as a reserve and not placed in another starting field at the time of box draw for the Saturday morning meeting and greyhounds that were nominated but were not graded to start in a field or listed as a reserve. Any greyhounds placed in a starting field at the time of box draw for a Saturday morning meeting will be considered last if nominated for the immediately following Tuesday night meeting. This will ensure the greatest number of greyhounds are provided with the opportunity to compete at either the Saturday morning or Tuesday night meeting.

The meetings will be graded with reserves where nominations permit. Nominations will close for the Tuesday night on the Friday before at 9am with GRSA. The meeting will start at approximately 6pm SA time.

Saturday morning meetings

The fortnightly Saturday morning meetings, as from May 11, will remain a time graded meeting but will be restricted to 10 races of six dog fields with reserves over the 342m only.

Reserves at Saturday morning meetings will, where possible, be graded to a 'cascading' format. For example, if there are four races of one pool of greyhounds then the reserves of the first race will also be included in the second race as starters, the reserves for the second race will also be included in the third race as starters and so on.

RACING AND TRIALLING FREQUENCY REMINDER

GRSA adopted a new local rule regarding frequency of racing and trialling which was implemented on Wednesday, 1st February, 2023.

Rule 69A Racing and trialling frequency

[1] In this rule:

Race has the same meaning given to this term in R9 of the GAR.

Trial means a satisfactory trial, or a qualifying trial as defined in R9 of the GAR.

[2] A greyhound will only be permitted to start in [a] No more than a combined total of 2 race and trial starts in any 7-day period; and,

[b] No more than a combined total of 7 race and trial starts in any 28-day period.

[3] This sub-rule commences on a date to be fixed by Stewards' Notice.

The intent of this rule is to monitor and regulate the frequency of races and official trials of greyhounds, to ensure adequate rest time is given between events. The rule is similar to one in effect in Western Australia.

We have automated the Ozchase Racing system to be able to monitor this rule. The rule is self-explanatory.

A greyhound must not start more than 2 times (races or trials combined) in any 7-day period. Further, a greyhound must not start more than 7-times (races or trials combined) in any 28-day period.

Any attempt to nominate a greyhound outside these parameters will be flagged by the OzChase system. If a greyhound gains a start from reserve deeming it ineligible under this rule for its next engagement or it competes in another state prior to racing back in SA, then the greyhound will come out.

**Racing Administration staff will scratch these greyhounds acting under this rule without notification (the responsibility rests with the trainer to ensure they do not contravene this rule).

**For clarity if a greyhound races on Sunday, Wednesday then Sunday it will be eligible. The first day counts as day 1 and therefore resets on the Saturday.

CURRENT MASTERS TIMES AND POLICY

- For greyhounds 3¾ years and older. 4yo and older will get preference. City A, City B and Prov 1 meetings are done by form for 4yo and older and then greyhounds will only get in from under 4yo to 3¾ yo in age from oldest to youngest. Prov 2 meetings are all done on age from oldest to youngest regardless of form for all ages.
- Dates are exact so going back 4yo and 3¾ from the date of race. ie date of race run on 20/11/22 – 4yo would be 20/11/18 whelping.
- Time restrictions if a greyhound wins a Grade 5 Masters race in a faster time than published and it will have to have 2 runs (placed or unplaced) in normal company at that class of meeting before being eligible at that class of meeting.
- The Grader will look to grade a Grade 5 Masters event on every program over a distance if enough dogs are nominated regardless if it is advertised in the All Tracks calendar.
- All races Non Penalty.

If a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading. If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters (ie Grade 2/3 & 4) we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event.

305m Masters Policy for Mt Gambier – With Mt Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events, however, factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance. There will still be a Time Standard applied based on the published table being 17.75. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week. The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.

MAIDEN SELECTION CRITERIA

As determined through the Grading Review Panel the entry criteria for Maidens into an event will be Order of Preference, Maidens with a placing in their last two starts using WPS, First starters then other Maidens using WPS.

GRADING UPDATE REMINDERS

- GRSA allow one extra Grade 6 over another distance for City A Thursday meetings bringing this into line with all tracks in SA.
- GRSA removed the condition where once a greyhound has won a Grade 5 or higher event on a City A meeting that the greyhound will lose all Grade 6 events at all other tracks. This means a greyhound could be a Grade 4 or Grade 3 over 530m on a Thursday City A meeting and will still be able to win Grade 6 events at other tracks.
- GRSA allow a greyhound after winning a Grade 5 Masters event in faster time than the time standard to get back into Masters with 2 runs in a Grade 5 at the track and distance, it doesn't matter if they are placed or unplaced just so long as there are two starts out of Masters. This was changed from being just unplaced to get back.

VACCINATION RULE FOR RACING IN SA – REMINDER

Trainers are reminded that Rule 25 (Minimum Vaccination Requirements) took effect Monday, 1st May, 2023. Vaccination Certificates must be received by GRSA prior to close of nominations for affected greyhounds to be considered eligible for nominating. It is also imperative that once the greyhound has been vaccinated the paperwork is lodged by yourself as soon as possible. Trainers are also reminded that they must not have their greyhound vaccinated within 5 days of racing. Should this occur, the greyhound will be scratched from its engagement or if paperwork lodged after an engagement and discovered the greyhound raced inside the 5 days then the matter will be referred to the stewards.

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month.

These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner & \$150 to the Breeder.

The SA Bred Bonus scheme is continuing to go over budget with the number of SA Bred winners increasing. For the month of July 2023 there were 203 winners, August 197, September 196, October 226, November 209, December 218, January 218, February 194, March 179, April 197, May 203, June 190 and July 2024 224. This means that we were over budget for the last financial year by 30 winners [\$6,750]. This year we are 24 winners over budget [\$5,400].

EARLY RACE REQUEST – GREYHOUNDS AFFECTED IN KENNEL HOUSE

Effective immediately GRSA will introduce the process where a greyhound is adversely affected by being in the kennel house for an extended period, a form completed by the oncourse vet and stewards confirming an early race requirement where possible will be accepted.

Stewards will have these forms available at each race meeting and once completed will be provided to the Grading department. It is expected that the trainer will advise in the race comments when nominating that this greyhound requires an early race where possible to ensure the Grader can manage the race program.

The Grader has many things to consider when managing the race program like Maiden and Juvenile events, Presentation Races, 8 dog Quaddie events etc. Where possible the Grader will attempt to place greyhounds within the program when a Trainer is travelling a significant distance with their greyhounds, where a Trainer only has one greyhound engaged and also when a Trainer has a number of greyhounds in a single event.

RACE WELL SUBSTANCE VALIDATOR – NOW AVAILABLE ON YOUR APP STORE

The Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission (GWIC), NSW, released an app named Race Well Substance Validator. GWIC kindly offered access to this app to the general greyhound racing industry and we thank them for their work and generosity.

The app can install on your preferred mobile device (see below) and be a reference source for guidance on certain substances. As you know, some substances that are intended for treatment or supplements will be, on a test, identified as a prohibited or permanently banned substance. The rule relating to presenting a greyhound not free of a prohibited substance is extremely rigid and strictly applied.

You can download the app from your preferred app store, for your mobile device. Head over to your app store and search "Race Well". The app is yellow, green and white, with a white tick icon. As standard, the use of the app comes with terms and conditions. These terms and conditions, together with information on the app, can be found here:

GRSA will be guided by these terms and conditions when considering the use of Race Well.

It is important to note that the app is for guidance only. GRSA relies on laboratory test results and scientific

classification of substances as evidence in related Inquiries. Just because a substance is not on the Race Well database does not mean it is not a prohibited or permanently banned substance.

Race Well results (for, against or absent) will not be considered an excuse for a breach of the relevant rules. You should always seek professional advice from a veterinarian if you are in any doubt about a substance.

Further, you need to record the use of the therapeutic substance in your treatment records books and therapeutic substances must have on the label, an APVMA number. This is a formal record of the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority.

You must keep all substances in their original packaging and, where prescribed by a veterinarian, keep legible the prescription label.

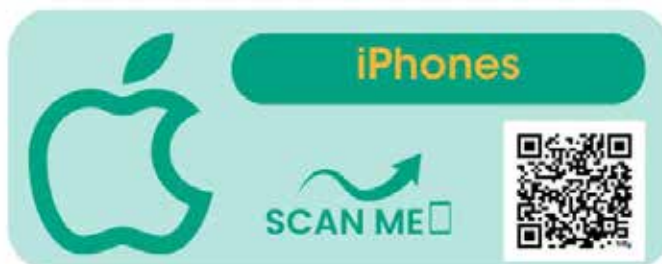

There are two joint winners of the Run of the Month for July as voted by the GOTY panel. The first is the Liz Chegia trained Fantastic Spike for his win in Open company over the 530m at Angle Park on Thursday, 18th July. The son of Superior Panama and Fantastic Flossy began well from box 3 to take up a forward position just off the speed and down the back straight he ran to a clear second. His power kicked in turning for home when he raced away from his rivals in a blistering 30.36 in winning by an ever increasing 4.25 lengths.

The second of our joint winners is Cash On Delivery for trainer Cameron Forshaw for his brilliant win at Angle Park on Monday, 22nd July over the 342m when he went within .01 of the track record. After showing brilliant early speed the son of Zambora Brockie and Shilo was able to race away from his rivals to win by 6.75 lengths in a sizzling 19.15.

Greyhound of the Month for July was Zinfandel Trace for trainer Gavin Harris, who had three starts for the month for two wins and a second with the highlight being victory in the prestigious Champion Puppy final at Angle Park on Thursday, 18th July.

The daughter of Barcia Bale and Zinfandel Zara started the month of with a strong second in the heats of the Champion Puppy before starting one of the favourites for the feature final. She proved her class in the feature final winning by 2 lengths in a slick 30.51. Zinfandel Trace rounded the month off with a brilliant win at headquarters in Juvenile company winning by 2.50 lengths in 30.46 over the 530m.

At the end of the month Zinfandel Trace's record stood at 9 starts for 6 wins and 3 placings and earnings around \$36,000.

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialed after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

We continue to look to increase these further in order to offer a wider variety of times to meet participants varying requirements.

The following graph depicts the number of assessments that have been occurring on a monthly basis.

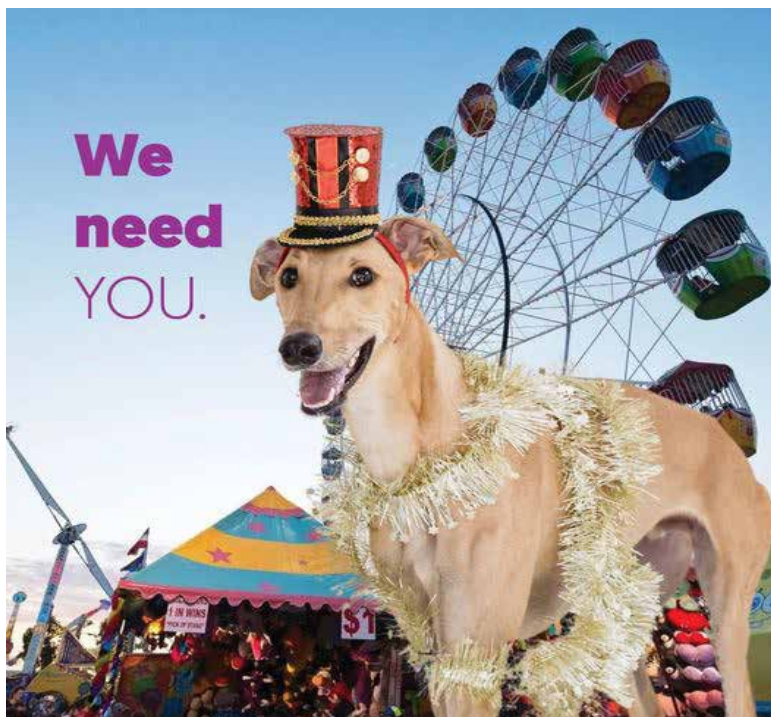
Payment of placement fees

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

RACING REPORT

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

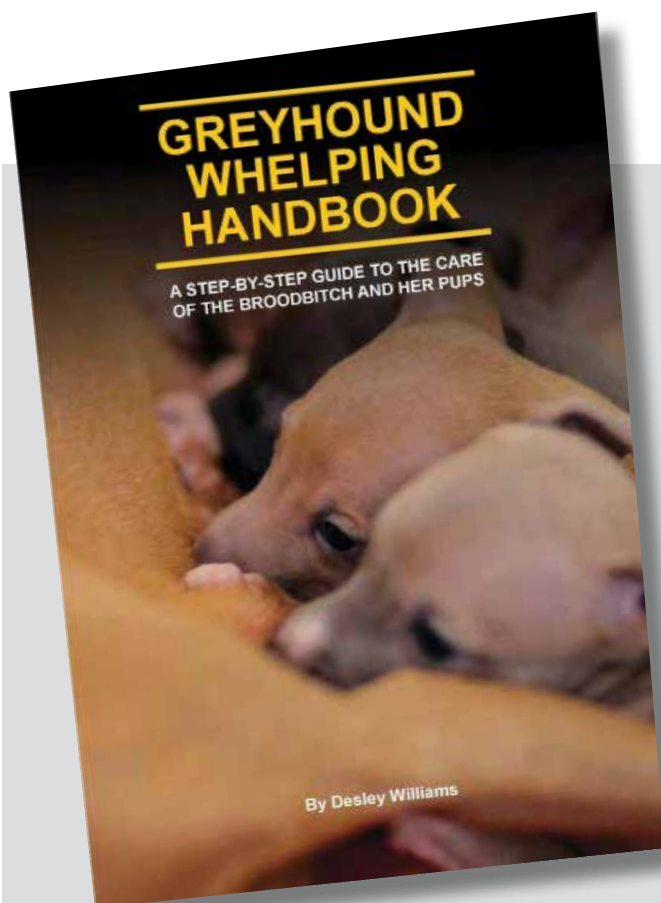

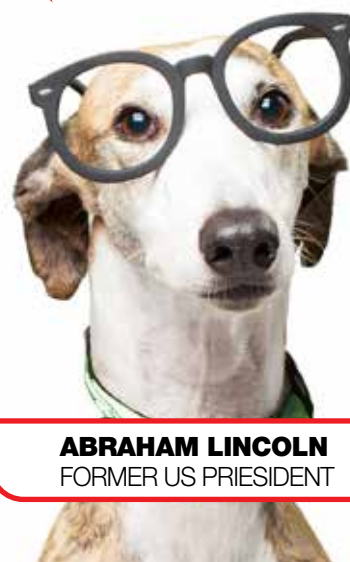
