## CEO'S UPDATE

### Murray Bridge Straight Track

It was really pleasing to see the level of demand for straight-track racing that was evident in the nomination levels for recent Wednesday meetings. Obviously the novelty of this form of racing, and the fact that greyhounds had the opportunity to qualify for the inaugural straight track championship final, were motivating factors behind some of the nominations that were received. Notwithstanding, the straight track meeting will now revert to an alternating fortnightly schedule (alternating with Angle Park) and it's our expectation that interest in the straight track meeting will continue to hold up strongly. The early feedback – in terms of wagering activity and positive commentary about the racing vision – indicates that punters are highly receptive to this new offering.

I would like to thank the Club Committee at Murray Bridge, various members of GRSA staff, and trainers who have already trialled or raced on the straight track for the roles that they played in helping us to get up and running.

### G-SIX and 8-DOG QUADS

From August 1, GRSA implemented a slightly amended approach to its previous G-SIX strategy by adding '8-dog' opportunities to the Quadrella legs for venues operating on the G-SIX format. There is a mix of considerations that GRSA is exploring as part of this broader trial, but our minimum requirement is that it must be able to pay for itself in terms of overall wagering activity being able to fund the additional stakemoney that is required to schedule additional races and race meeting opportunities across the week. With that base covered, these more recent changes have been aimed at trying to create more nomination opportunities at Gawler, Angle Park and Mount Gambier, but also doing so in a manner which compliments G-SIX and the broader weekly racing schedule – noting that our wagering model thrives on full [11-12 race] meetings across all venues. Again, the early signs have been relatively positive.

# Sale Graze Bindi upsets rivals to book her spot to Perth

## ■ ANGLE PARK

**In cold, wet and wintery conditions Sale Graze Bindi for trainer Tony Rasmussen caused one of the upsets of the season to win her way to Perth for the National Distance Final after she outstayed the best SA had to offer.**

A greyhound that is always running on in her races, Sale Graze Bindi began slowly but quickly pushed up on the inside to be racing third as the field entered the front straight on the first occasion looking a huge threat. Equilibrium for Troy Murray led them up early looking to recapture his very best form from 12 months ago when he was considered a staying star in the making while West On Bamboo settled into second spot. In a wide open betting race race favourites Master Chaos for Irene Rehmann and Saldana for Judi Hurley were back in the field after average beginnings. Entering the back straight after one lap Equilibrium was making every post a winner and led by just over a length from West On Bamboo with Sale Graze Bindi back in third, another length away with the trio opening up a sizable gap back to More Rum Bateman for Kevin Murnane who started to make ground out wide. Prior to turning for home Equilibrium was challenged on the inside by Sale Graze Bindi who had quickly past West On Bamboo for second and shortly after raced to the front turning for home. From a mile back More Rum Bateman swept up on the outside into second spot but couldn't bridge the gap with Sale Graze Bindi going on for a strong win. My Boy Bean also flew home along the rails and pinched third spot from West On Bamboo who battled on well into 4th just ahead of Equilibrium.

Sale Graze Bindi showed that she can stay all day and ran a solid 44.33 for the 731m journey and those who took the \$21 would have been very happy when she made her way to third in the early stages, whilst not the quickest time ever run the weather conditions played a huge part in affecting the times.



# Ebby Lamar takes out the National Sprint

**Ebby Lamar kept his perfect record from box 1 intact at Angle Park when he made it 4 from 4 from the red when he won the State Final of the National Sprint Championship at headquarters.**

In doing so he gave trainer Colin Swain one of his biggest wins of his career and will now head off to Perth against the best Australia has to offer at the Nationals.

Ebby Lamar, Canya Chase for Tony Rasmussen and Fantastic Yankee for Elizabeth Chegia were sent out as the favourites for the State Final in another high quality field. As the start was affected Ebby Lamar began well and pushed hard to the first turn with both Dyna Adria for Lisa Rasmussen and Gemtree Dynamo for Irene Rehmann also beginning smartly. Canya Chase was moderately away while Fantastic Yankee missed the kick but showed quick acceleration to push through the middle and make a line of four at the winning post on the first occasion. Racing was tight, however, Ebby Lamar made full use of the inside and ran to the front into the back straight, Dyna Adria moved to second but was quickly challenged by No Passengers around the outside for Tony Rasmussen. Off the back straight and Ebby Lamar was going strongly in the lead, No Passengers ran to second however didn't seem to be making ground quick enough while Canya Chase was beginning to motor from midfield moving to third and checking of heels as they turned for home. In the charge to the post Ebby Lamar was doing enough and went on to win by just over a length in a handy 30.43 from Canya Chase who charged home late and could have finished a touch closer if he hadn't found traffic in the run, while No Passengers held on well for third.



# A breakout win for Miss Breakout in Puppy Final

**The Champion Puppy Final at Angle Park on 18th July drew together some of the best young chasers in the State all vying for the prestigious title, however, it was the Ben Rawlings trained Miss Breakout who claimed the \$7,995 first prize.**

With plenty of early speed in the race and some run on types the positioning to the first turn was always going to be crucial. Lauren Harris had three runners in the Final in a terrific training performance and her main contender, Fly For Fun from box 3 was sent out the clear favourite with most expecting him to lead. As the boxes flew open the race changed complexion immediately with Fly For Fun fairly away and strong type Miss Breakout from box 6 pinging the lids and charging towards the front. McLaren Dazzler from the inside box for Don Foster pushed up hard along the rails while Missy Crane from the outside box for Lauren Harris came across strongly to challenge. As the greyhounds left the front straight Miss Breakout assumed the lead and looked very hard to beat. Missy Crane landed second while McLaren Dazzler, Fly For Fun, Romanowski for Lauren Harris and Dashing Dixon for Gavin Harris made a line of 4 in third spot entering the back straight. Down the back straight and Miss Breakout was in full flight being chased hard by Missy Crane and they opened up a margin back to third with Dashing Dixon getting home strongly and from a mile back Sir Truculent for Wally Harkins was warming to the task after a slow beginning. Into the front straight and Miss Breakout opened up a clear margin and was in no danger going on to win by 2.50 lengths in a slick 29.96 for the 515m journey. Missy Crane held on well for second while Dashing Dixon and Sir Truculent made plenty of late ground into third and fourth respectively only half a length away.



Miss Breakout is beautifully bred by Worm Burner out of Miss Woods and is owned and bred locally by Gino Grgurovic who was on hand to accept the winning trophy. It was terrific to have Cinderella's Commercial Cleaning on board again as sponsor for this year's Champion Puppy series and Managing Director Mark Ferdinands spoke glowingly about his sponsorship and was congratulatory to the winning connections.

## SA trio headed for Healesville

**History was made on Wednesday, 7th August at Murray Bridge when the three finalists who will represent the State in the SEN National Straight Track Final at Healesville on Sunday, 18th August was decided in the SA Final.**

On the back of four excellent heats the week before, the State Final was full of class and interest. Exciting chaser Panhandle Slim for Ray Murray was sent out the short-priced favourite however there were many with chances down the straight 350m at the Bridge.

As the start was affected Pandhandle Slim and Hot Chevy for Adam Manton wide on the track began the best while the reserve Acoustic Lee for Tony Rasmussen speared towards the rails from box 5 which gave a lovely run through to Fantastic Axel for Elizabeth Chegia. Mid-way down the straight both Panhandle Slim and Fantastic Axel looked to have the race between them while Winsome Money for Steve Coates and Hot Chevy settled down to fight it out for third place as they charged to the finishing post.



Nearing home, Panhandle Slim was doing just enough to hold off the challenge of Fantastic Axel and went on to win by just under a length in a sizzling 19.18. The battle for third was just as absorbing with Hot Chevy battling back after being headed by Winsome Money to claim third by the barest possible margin. It was a great training performance by Ray Murray to get Panhandle Slim back to the race track after a serious injury a number of months back and win the State Final. Panhandle Slim, Fantastic Axel and Hot Chevy will now head across to Healesville in Victoria for the National Straight track Final.

The Final at Healesville will be the first ever National Straight Track Championship for greyhounds with Victoria, Queensland and South Australia having representation.

The Championship will showcase Australia's best straight track racers with \$35,500 in total prizemoney; as well as an inaugural GRV Grand Final bonus of \$14,500 to be distributed throughout first, second and third places. The top three placings from the Queensland series and top two from the Victorian series will join our local qualifiers on August 18th.

## GOTBA Oaks, Derby and Waterloo Cup in September

**Feature meetings for Coursing come up in September with the Oaks and Derby on Sunday, 1st September and the 2019 GOTBA Waterloo Cup on Sunday, 15th September at Virginia.**

The Oaks and Derby are for bitches and dogs whelped on or after 1/7/17 with greyhounds required to have competed at Coursing to be eligible. The Waterloo Cup is always a feature on the Clubs program and will wind up their 2019 season.

## Kings and Queens feature later this month

**Again this year GRSA will conduct the Kings and Queens Feature series with Heats on Thursday, 29th August and a \$7,500 Final on Thursday, 5th September in continued support of any greyhound affected by the change to the GCA Age Restricted Classics change a few years ago.**

The eligibility for this series is for dogs and bitches whelped between 1st March 2017 and 31st May 2017.

Performed Maidens are eligible [raced or qualify trialed].

It will be dependent upon nominations, however, we would like to run a dogs Heat and a bitches Heat separately with greyhounds qualifying into the Final. If there are not sufficient nominations for either sex then these Heats may be mixed as a one off Heat into a Final or a couple of mixed Heats. Special conditions apply, however, these races will be non-penalty.

- Nominations close Monday, 26th August at 9.00am with GRSA.

## Gawler Show dates and changes

**August means that it is coming up to Gawler Show time, so some Gawler meetings will be transferred to Angle Park this year.**

This year the Annual Gawler Show will be held on the weekend of Saturday, 24th and Sunday, 25th August. Racing on Friday, 23rd August will be at Angle Park on the Finish On Lure [as there are finals on this program from Heats on Wednesday, 14th August this meeting will also be a Finish On Lure meeting]. Racing on Tuesday, 27th August will be at Angle Park and will be raced with the Finish On Lure. Both meetings will carry the normal prizemoney for both these days and will be considered APD Provincial 2 for grading.

Trials will be cancelled at Gawler on Thursday, 22nd August due to Show preparations. We will hopefully have the track ready to trial again on Thursday, 29th August, but this will be dependent on the weather over the Show weekend. There will be trials at Angle Park on Wednesday, 21st August and on Saturday, 24th August.

## SA Oaks and SA Derby in September

**The Group 3 SA Oaks and SA Derby to be run in September this year will be for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st June 2017 (27 months) which has stayed the same as the last few years.**

GRSA will continue to leave the eligibility date at 27 months in support of trainers, breeders and owners of young up and coming greyhounds, however, it is important that these series' be supported by our local participants. If the series' are not supported with nominations locally and from Interstate then GRSA will have no option but to consider altering the age restriction to 30 months to ensure sufficient support for these races in 2020. In support of these series' GRSA has kept the Heats of the Oaks on the same night as the Derby with Heats on Thursday, 12th September and the Group 3 Finals on Thursday, 19th September.

# Spring Cuervo claims Greyhound of the Month

Greyhound of the Month award for July went to Spring Cuervo for trainer Troy Murray which was undefeated in all four of his starts in July.

The son of Kinloch Brae and Spring Grace started the month with a sizzling 29.77 win at headquarters in Grade 5 company before stepping up to mixed company and repeating the dose with a slick 29.83 win the week later. His next start was in Open company and again showed his ability by taking care of our best sprinters in a flying 29.78. His last start for the month was in a Heat of the Group 3 Darwin Cup where he won again and would start one of the favourites in the Group 3 final a week later.

At the end of the month Spring Cuervo's record stood at 23 starts for 10 wins and 5 placings and earnings around \$22,000.



# Alfieri produces Run of the Month at Murray Bridge

The Run of the Month for July was Alfieri for trainer Bill Wudarczyk after he produced a sizzling performance at Murray Bridge on Sunday, 21st July in a Grade 6 event over the 530m.

Starting a long odds on favourite, he flew around the Bridge in a track record performance of 29.74 after he led throughout and won by over 6 lengths.

## 'Origin-al' path to Adelaide Cup part of exciting cross-state initiatives

**Victorian and South Australian-based trainers will have a new direct path to the Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final under exciting new cross-State initiatives being introduced by Greyhound Racing Victoria (GRV) and Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA).**

The industry-first initiatives include the winner of GRSA's State of Origin series, to be held at Angle Park on 26th September, being guaranteed a berth in the \$75,000 to-the-winner Adelaide Cup Final on 11th October. The State of Origin series is run along similar lines to Sandown's Speed Star, with four Vic-trained greyhounds clashing with four locals under match race conditions.

The format sees the GRSA grader select the best four nominated greyhounds from each State and rank them from 1 to 4, with 1 being the highest rank. The head-to-head match races will pit the two number 1 sprinters from each State against each other, followed by 2 vs 2, 3 vs 3 and 4 vs 4, with the overall winning greyhound earning \$7,500. The State of Origin series was introduced in 2018 and is sure to create even greater interest among Victorian trainers in its second year with the inclusion of the massive carrot of bypassing the Adelaide Cup Heats.

A guaranteed Adelaide Cup spot isn't the only benefit awaiting the State of Origin winner. In addition to gaining direct entry into the Adelaide Cup Final, the State of Origin victor will also secure a position in the Group 3 Sandown Shootout, the four-sprinter feature to be run on 14th November.

Another innovation will see the winner of the Adelaide Cup receive automatic entry, should connections accept, into the invitation-only Group 1 Topgun at The Meadows, which will be run this year on 9th November. With positions in the Adelaide Cup and Shootout on offer, State of Origin places will be keenly sought after and the winner of Sandown's Speed Star series, to be held on 15th September, will be rewarded with one of the four Victorian spots in the Origin series.

1. Highest placed Victorian in the September Speed Star [15th September] at Sandown gains automatic entry [if they accept] into SA State Of Origin Race to represent Vic [26th September].
2. Winner of the SA State of Origin Race [SA or VIC greyhound] gains automatic entry [if they accept] into the Group 2 Shootout at Sandown [14th November].
3. Winner of the SA State of Origin [SA or VIC greyhound] will be guaranteed a spot into the Group 1 Adelaide Cup final [11th October] 2 weeks later [Bypasses the Heats].
4. Winner of the Group 1 Adelaide Cup gains automatic entry [if they accept] into the Group 1 Topgun at the Meadows [9th November].

### Conditions of the State of Origin series:

**The State of Origin Match Race series between South Australia and Victoria will be held on Thursday, 26th September.**

**Nominations close at 9am on Monday, 23rd September with GRSA.**

Eligibility as to who represents South Australia or Victoria would be based around the Nationals conditions. Greyhounds would need to be trained in either State 76 days out of the last 150 prior to the date of the race [26th September].

The best four greyhounds nominated from SA will be selected

by the GRSA grader to represent SA. Victoria will already have a qualifier [if nominated] from their highest placed Victorian trained greyhound in their Speedstar series at Sandown on Sunday, 15th September. The other three best greyhounds nominated from Vic will be selected by the GRSA grader to represent Vic.

The Grader will use whatever information he has available to select those greyhounds including liaising with GRV for the Victorian selections. The SA Graders decision will be final. Those greyhounds not selected from Interstate will be given the opportunity to solo trial or race in another event on the night. Reserves will be declared with one from SA and one from Victoria depending on nominations to replace the States representative if scratched. For example the SA reserve will only replace an SA scratching.

The Grader will rate the four greyhounds from each State in order from 1 to 4 with 1 being the highest rated greyhound. The head to head matches will be decided by the two 1 rated greyhounds competing against each other and then it will be 2 v 2, 3 v 3 and 4 v 4. Prizemoney for each individual match will also reflect 1 to 4 with the 1 rated greyhounds receiving the most amount of money. However, the overall winner will still be determined based around the times the greyhounds run so all greyhounds have that opportunity.

#### PRIZEMONEY:

Winners of match races – 1 v 1 – Winner \$4,750, 2 v 2 – Winner \$4,500, 3 v 3 – Winner \$4,250, 4 v 4 – Winner \$4,000.

Overall State of Origin winner [based on overall times] \$7,500, second \$2,500, third \$1,000.

The winner of the SA State of Origin [SA or VIC greyhound] will be guaranteed a spot into the Group 1 Adelaide Cup final [11th October] 2 weeks later and will be required to by pass the Heats.

Below are details of how and where greyhounds can qualify for the \$7,500 SA Country Cup Final, to be run at Angle Park over 515 metres on Adelaide Cup G-SIX Final night Friday 11th October 2019.

## Conditions

- All South Australian Greyhound Racing Clubs outside of Angle Park will conduct heats, or nominate greyhounds from which the Greyhound Racing SA Grading Department will choose two representatives. These meetings are Gawler Provincial 2, Murray Bridge One Turn Provincial 1 or 2 and Mount Gambier Provincial 2. (Performances at Gawler Provincial 1 meetings are not eligible for consideration)
- The event is open to all South Australian greyhounds that are not above Grade 5 at Angle Park (APK City A & APM City B meetings only) over 515 metres at the time of nomination. Winner of each event takes a penalty including the final.

## Special Exceptions:

Mount Gambier Club is allowed to include non-South Australian trainers under strict conditions:

- The trainer has had starters at 15 meetings for Mt Gambier in the previous 12 months.
  - The trainer can only qualify for one of the clubs.
  - The trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 3 months.
- Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.
  - The greyhound must be SA trained (except Mount Gambier as above).
    - A South Australian trained greyhound is defined as one that has been racing in SA for a period of not less than 3 out of the 6 months immediately prior to the time of nomination.
  - The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track it is attempting to represent.
  - There will be a maximum of two heats per Club with the winners of each heat qualifying. If there is only one heat conducted then the first two placegetters will qualify.
  - The two reserves will be determined firstly by a ballot of the second placegetters from all heats. The third placegetters will then be considered by ballot if required. If a heat was not conducted at the track, then that track is not included in the ballot. Should a greyhound be withdrawn prior to the ballot, the next placed greyhound from that Club's heat will be selected.
  - Once a greyhound has qualified from a Qualifying Heat, it is not eligible to compete at another track in this series, unless there are insufficient nominations to fill the field.
  - Once qualified for the Country Cup Final the greyhound will be ineligible for the Adelaide Cup series or any other race on this Cup Final night.
  - Lead up Heats may be up to 8 greyhounds however the Final on Adelaide Cup night will be a G-SIX Final

## New transfer of ownership form to include proof of purchase

**Participants are advised that as from 1st September 2019 a new Transfer of Ownership Form is to be completed if wanting to seek grading exemptions.**

The new Form has a Proof of Purchase section, this requires purchasers to lodge documentation confirming the purchase of the greyhound or if no documentation is available then it is a requirement for the Statutory Declaration to be completed. If a Transfer of Ownership Form is lodged without the completion of this section then NO grading exemptions will be applied to the greyhound. The form is available on our website and is also included in this edition of Kennel Capers.

## GRSA trialling schedule updated

- Murray Bridge from 6pm Tuesday and 8am Friday. STAT and Qualys once a month to be run at 6.50pm – 7.15pm the same as Angle Park. Dates will be Tuesday 13/8/19 and 10/9/19.
- Gawler from 7am Monday and 7am Thursday. Thursday is STAT and Qualys every week
- Angle Park from 6pm Wednesday and 7am Saturday. STAT and Qualys every Wednesday for the corresponding Monday APM meeting (12 days later due to nominations)

## Super bonus for SA bred greyhounds

The super-bonus scheme is premised upon 100% dividend to breeders for SA Bred greyhounds. The super bonus will only be paid out to breeders residing in South Australia.

The following is a summary of the bonus by race:

**RACE SUPER-BONUS** - Adelaide Cup [515m] - G1 \$12,500, Adelaide Cup [515m] – 2ND \$5,000, Adelaide Cup [515m] – 3RD \$2,500, Adelaide Cup finalist \$1,000, BGC SA Derby [515m] – G3 \$3,500, BGC SA Derby [515m] – 2ND \$1,500, BGC SA Derby [515m] – 3RD \$750, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks[515m] – G3 \$3,500, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks[515m] – 2ND \$1,500, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks[515m] – 3RD \$750, Gawler Gold Cup [531m] - G3 \$5,000, Mount Gambier Cup [512m] - Listed \$2,500, Murray Bridge Cup [455m] - Listed \$2,500, Group 1 victory (interstate) \$10,000, Group 2 victory (interstate) \$5,000, Group 3 victory (interstate) \$2,500

## Auto sorting for grading to start next month

**GRSA advises that they have been in the process of auto sorting the Order of Preference for Grading purposes. For a long period this has been a manual process.**

This will reduce this part of the process by about 1 hour and will remove some of the discretion of the Grader because it will also incorporate all greyhounds, even those off the Order with a Weighted Points Score [WPS] table.

GRSA has made some changes to the Order of Preference which include -

- No 5 – Qualifying trials will be managed separately outside the automation
- Remove St Leger & Champion Puppy heats reference
- Remove 6 months criteria reference
- Remove Grader giving preference to performances over 400m
- Swap No 9 [Placed 2 of last 3 in City] and No 10 [One win from last 3 in City]
- Any reference about Pathway or Time Graded is removed from this file
- Update Track Classifications based on new file for WPS [Weighted Points Score]
- For WPS [Fell is considered as 4th and FTF is next available placing]

The WPS will assist with the selection of those greyhounds not on the Order of Preference so all greyhounds will effectively be sorted into an order for selection.

GRSA has the support from the GRP that when using the automation that if the order of entry by Order of Preference, Race wins or WPS is discovered to be incorrect after fields have been drawn that GRSA will not redraw the race in question [so long as the greyhound is correctly graded]. If this did occur then the affected greyhound will get first preference at its next nomination.

Implementation of this process is scheduled for Monday, 9th September barring any unforeseen delays.

This will allow for our fields to be released much sooner due to automation. GRSA requests some patience during implementation from the Industry if there are any issues that come about, however, there will be plenty of positives with this process.

## Grading changes from Grading Review Panel

**The main change from the GRP was that when a greyhound comes to SA from Interstate for its first start that if it has won 4 or less races it should be considered a Grade 6 even if it has won Grade 5 races [Metropolitan Grade 5 races - 460m – 590m] in their State will affect Grade 6). There will be no retrospective grading for greyhounds already in SA with a starting date 9th September.**

Updated part of the guidelines which includes the changes to Metropolitan distance ranges of tracks.

### GRADING OF INTERSTATE GREYHOUNDS

Greyhounds owned or trained Interstate will be graded on their current city grade on the track/or tracks from the State in which they are owned or trained.

### PURCHASING OF INTERSTATE GREYHOUNDS

Greyhounds purchased from Interstate into 100% South Australia Ownership which are currently higher than a Grade 5 Interstate [over any distance] on a Metropolitan track will initially be graded into Grade 5 events, provided that the Transfer of Ownership together with the proof of purchase is lodged with GRSA prior to close of nominations. There will be no retrospective grading once the Transfer of Ownership has been approved.

### GRADE 6 ELIGIBILITY

Non- SA Bred greyhounds from Interstate that have won five or more races at any track are not eligible for Grade 6 Grade. However, if a greyhound has won a Metropolitan Grade 5 or above between [460m – 590m] they are not eligible.

SA Bred greyhounds that have been trained Interstate and are transferred back to an SA trainer, will revert to their eligible grade at each track in SA, however, if they have won a Grade 5 or above event at any Metropolitan meeting [460m – 590m] they will be ineligible for Grade 6 events.

## Syndication interest from trainers

**Greyhound Racing SA is interested in gaining feedback from trainers who would be interested in having their details made available to any prospective syndicate groups.**

GRSA receives a number of queries from owners about getting involved with their friends however it is quite hard for them to find a trainer. # Weighted point score table

All greyhounds will also have a WPS calculated based upon the WPS table.

There is no age criteria on the start dates when calculating the WPS. The WPS must be calculated on the greyhound's last 5 Race starts. If the greyhound has not competed in 5 Races, the pro-rata WPS will be applied.

## Pro-rata WPS

Greyhounds that have not yet competed in five (5) starts are allocated points on a pro-rata or an average over five (5) starts with a weighting of 80% applied to the "pro-rata" points.

To calculate the points of a greyhound that has not competed in five (5) starts:

1. divide the greyhound's total points by the amount of starts it has competed in
2. multiply the new average by the difference between 5 and the number of actual starts and apply the 80% discount weighting
3. add the result to the actual points earned from the greyhound's starts.

Examples for working out the points of greyhounds using this method:

**One Start** = 36 points  $36 / 1 = 36$ ;  $36 \times 4 = 144 \times 0.8 = 115$ ;  $115 + 36 = 151$  points

**Two Starts** = 46 points  $46 / 2 = 23$ ;  $23 \times 3 = 69 \times 0.8 = 55$ ;  $55 + 46 = 101$  points

**Four Starts** = 84 points  $84 / 4 = 21$ ;  $21 \times 1 = 21 \times 0.8 = 16$ ;  $16 + 84 = 100$  points

## Presentation of greyhound at kennelling time

**Trainers are reminded to ensure they are aware of and adhere to kennelling times set by the Controlling Body.**

Recently there have been occasions where greyhounds have been presented for kennelling after the advertised kennel closing time and trainers have expected their greyhounds to have been kennelled. Stewards refer trainers to GAR 31 (in particular part 4, as highlighted below) which reads:

### **R31 Presentation of greyhound for racing and kennelling time**

[1] The handler of a greyhound drawn for an Event shall present the correct greyhound to the Stewards at or before the time specified in sub-rule 2.

[2] Unless otherwise specified, a greyhound drawn for an Event shall be in the hands of the Stewards not later than 45 minutes before the advertised starting time of the first Event of the meeting or qualifying trial.

[3] The Stewards may alter the kennelling time referred to in sub-rule [2] if deemed necessary.

[4] A greyhound not presented pursuant to sub-rule [2] shall not be allowed to compete in the Event for which it has been drawn and shall be prohibited from competing in any Event for a period of not less than 28 days commencing on the date on which the failure to comply with sub-rule [2] occurred, provided however that the Stewards or Controlling Body may revoke or vary such order of prohibition.

Stewards ask that trainers are proactive to ensure greyhounds are kennelled prior to the advertised closing time – just being on course by that time does not guarantee you will be permitted to kennel and race. Stewards will be monitoring this and issuing penalties in cases of non-compliance.

## MBR race day trials

**Participants should be aware that if they are intending to trial on race day at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is racing that day i.e. Sunday u-shaped track meeting, then only that track is available for trials as that will be the only track prepared.**

The race day policy has been updated to reflect this.

## Bleach for cleaning kennels

**Bleach is a common product used to clean and disinfect surfaces such as kennel houses.**

It is important that bleach is diluted prior to use as per the manufacturer's instruction to ensure the safety of humans and canines.

Bleach:

- Is corrosive and caution should be taken when using it

as it can react with biological tissues, causing irritation and cell death. Reactions are most severe on sensitive tissues such as the respiratory system and eyes.

- Should not be mixed with other household cleaners as the mixture may result in the release of chlorine gas. When chlorine gas contacts moist tissues (i.e. eyes and lungs) hydrochloric acid results, this damages airways, can cause asphyxiation and can result in death.

When using bleach, the following is critical:

- There must be adequate ventilation to ensure safety of humans and canines;
- Contact time on surfaces must be adequate to have time to kill germs, viruses etc. Contact time should be at least five (5) minutes;
- Greyhounds - should be removed from housing areas when cleaning.

Signs of bleach related illness:

- Reddened, irritated or teary eyes
- Mild irritation to skin
- Irritation of the respiratory system

Veterinarians recommend the following alternatives to bleach:

- Virkon S
- F10SC Veterinary Disinfectant

Any questions about bleach and cleaning kennels can be directed to the Animal Welfare department.

## Reminder – free carpet squares for bedding

**All trainers are offered free carpet squares for kennel bedding through the relationship the Animal Welfare team has with Discount City Carpets and Carpet Call.**

The carpet will be cut to approximately 1000 x 600 and we can help arrange collection from Angle Park or Mount Gambier. If you are interested in this, please phone the Animal Welfare team or ask about this service at your next kennel inspection.

## The Golden Rules

Since the introduction of cobalt and arsenic thresholds, all participants should be reminded – in their own best interests – that there are a number of Golden Rules that can help them to avoid making any such breaches (for prohibited substances generally) and which should be adhered to as principles of best practice:

- Always consult your vet to seek guidance in relation to any of the products that you are using, any associated risks and other relevant context
- Review the range of any feeds or supplements that you typically purchase and, wherever it is reasonable to do so, replace products containing substances that could contribute to a threshold breach under the rules [eg. cobalt] with alternative products
- Observe the instructions on any products that you use and adhere strictly to those directions [having regard for prescribed amounts, frequency of administration/ application, methodology for administering/applying]
- Ensure a greyhound is never administered any treatment on race day other than as relates to its feeding and drinking requirements [GAR83[A][1] treats this as a specific offence]
- Refrain from the use of injectable treatments [eg. Vitamin B12] to any extent that is practical, including ensuring a greyhound is not administered any injectables the day before an event

Our registered participants have the responsibility to ensure that greyhounds are presented to the track free of any prohibited substances. This information is offered as advice in good faith and should not be relied on as a defence in the event of a breach occurring.

## Council dog registrations

**Dogs and Cats Online (DACO), the central database for all dog registrations in South Australia, has generated a mail out of renewals across the State.**

Now is a really important time to ensure greyhounds that have left or entered your kennel are updated as it is the responsibility of the trainer or breeder of greyhounds to transfer sold, retired or greyhounds that have transferred kennels to be removed from their council 'list'.

In the first instance, any questions or issues with dog registration should be referred directly back to your local council. Several councils have contacted GRSA looking for assistance with participants who have had difficulty registering greyhounds this year and we will assist if we can, but ultimately council needs to manage their registrations.

It is a requirement of holding a trainer and/or breeder licence with GRSA that you comply with legislative requirements of dog registration and this forms part of a registered kennel address being approved by GRSA to house greyhounds.

GRSA also monitors the prices set by council of individual greyhound and dog permit rates. Prior to registration time, we approached the LGA to lobby for a uniform approach to fee-setting. Now we are working with individual councils with higher than average greyhound registration rates to seek financial relief for our participants in those areas.

## Murray Bridge Straight Track is off and racing

**It was an historic moment for greyhound racing in South Australia last month, with the commencement of the first nationally broadcast SA straight track race meeting at the new Murray Bridge racing facility.**

The first meeting was a renowned success, with all infrastructure and systems standing up to racing for the very first time. Congratulations to Christine Costa and Bosco Stamenkovic on being the first to train a winner on the new track with Halfeti Rose.

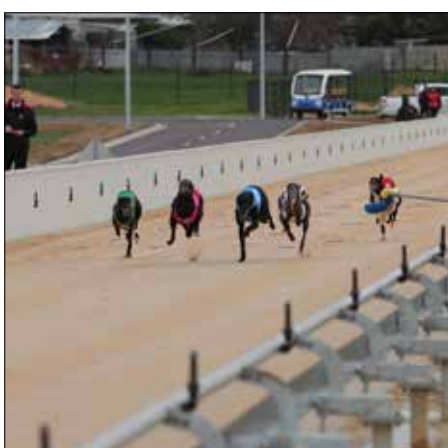
Whilst the delays in getting the straight track off and running were frustrating, mostly due to the development of the new Steriline remote/battery operated lure, they were probably a blessing in disguise, as it has allowed for the continued development and fine tuning of the lure.

The decision to close off the 300m chute start was decisively made by management and the works required to facilitate that change were made adhering to some very tight timeframes. Congratulations must go to the maintenance team down at Murray Bridge - Darren Pearce, Peter Duthie and Peter Lee for their efforts in this regard.

A special mention to the team from Steriline Racing who managed to design, engineer, construct and install the crane system within a three week period from initial discussions from representatives of GRSA. The end result is a highly functional system, albeit one that will require further development to meet GRSA's final expectations.

Head of Maintenance Terry Winder was also instrumental in ensuring the crane installation project ran on time and that GRSA were ultimately able to meet its commitments to the National Straight Track Championships, the Final of which will be held this coming Sunday at Healesville.

Like any new track there is going to be the initial period where staff and participants are going to need to become familiar with the new track and as such patience as always will be required until these processes are bedded down.

In regards to the straight track racing surface, whilst it has been down for many months, the introduction of high volume trialling and racing still requires the team to familiarise themselves with the ongoing preparation process. As the seasons change, the learning will continue however the goal will always remain – to provide a safe and consistent surface for all

trialling and racing.

At this current point there are no outstanding items to be completed at Murray Bridge, however, GRSA is investigating the possibility of a dedicated slipping track on the southern boundary and additional vegetation and tree planting to provide windbreaks at the venue.



# Mount Gambier kennel house project set to begin

**The project to refurbish the current Mount Gambier kennel house is scheduled to commence this Friday (16/8). The project will involve a complete strip out of existing kennel house, with the main aim of replacing the current brick/concrete kennels with modern stainless steel equivalents.**

Racing will continue throughout the project with a temporary kennel house building being erected and the new stainless kennels being configured into race bays. The existing pre-meeting area and veterinary room will continue to be used throughout the project, with the majority of work occurring in the main kennel area.

There may be some minor disruptions or changes to logistics throughout race meetings and trials and we again ask for patience from participants in dealing with these interruptions.

The project is scheduled to run for approximately six weeks, however this is dependent on the availability and the progress of contractors in undertaking the necessary works. GRSA is confident that the project will run on time.

Special thanks to MGGRC Maintenance Officer Tim Manterfield for the assistance he has provided in organising contractors and managing the project at a local level. Tim will be busy throughout the project undertaking some of the works whilst continuing his normal roles to facilitate trials and racing.

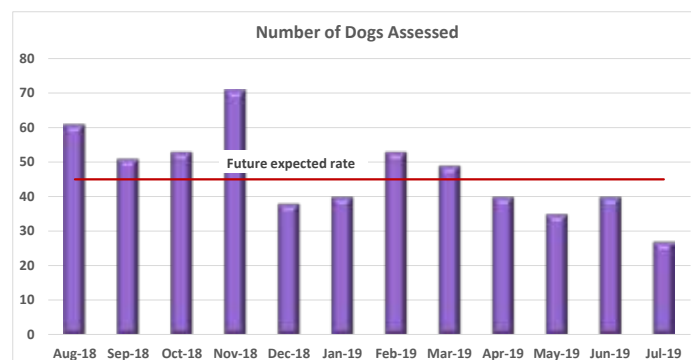

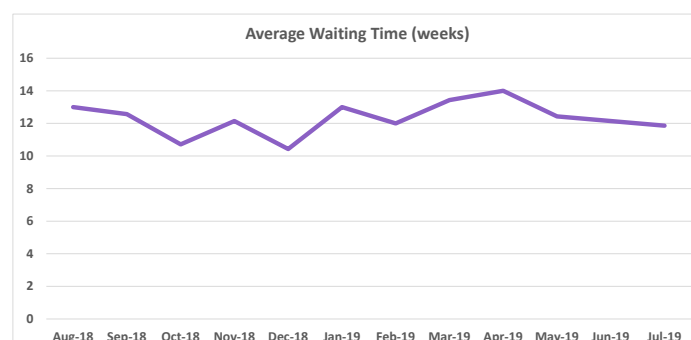
# Latest updates from GAP

# Dimora's no flash in the pan

**Popular local greyhound man Bernie Bouchier must surely have a reserved sign on that coveted seat close to the log fire in the Tara Raceway clubrooms.**

There he was again on Sunday 11th August perched comfortably in the best seat in the house as he awaited the running of the Gambier Vets Mixed Stake (400 metres), a more than handy race that included Dimora Flash, raced by his son Kevin.

"How's Dimora Flash going in the Greyhound of the Year?" he asked. He probably knew but we humoured him anyway and told him she was still leading the way by five points over Cryer's Plugger.

Actually, the four-year-old daughter of Cosmic Rumble and the inaugural Winter Classic winner Stylish Moment has been a model of consistency this year – going into the race with seven wins, eight seconds and three thirds at Tara Raceway.

For all her consistency, though, it had been a couple of months since Dimora Flash had last won, her Glencoe trainer Dean Fennell well aware of just how competitive the top grade short course events are.

But this Sunday was Dimora Flash's day, the black bitch leading all the way from box three at the nice odds of \$7 when defeating Our Man Zed by a length in 23.14 seconds and now

eight points clear of Black Spring, who ran second later in the day, in the GOTY.

Commencing racing two years ago, she has now started on 65 occasions for 12 wins and 27 minor placings, a delighted Bouchier saying after last Sunday's win that he was now seriously considering breeding with Dimora Flash after she had finished racing.

# Breeding for success

## ■ GAWLER

At Gawler greyhounds on Friday 26th July, the feature race was the 2019 Gawler Breeders Final, which is part of a series of events for SA bred greyhounds, whelped in the first six months of 2017.

In the 531m event, and heading out of the straight the first time, Bailey Rocks from box 5 showed the way, to lead from Emerley Fabbro [1] and Allinga Jess [4]. Around the first turn, Bailey Rocks was able to cross to the rails, and open up a handy five length break on the opposition, headed by Allinga Jess. The field was unable to gain any ground on the leader, with Bailey Rocks going on to win comfortably by 4 lengths in the time of 31.00 secs. Littermates Allinga Jess and Allinga Mal [7], finished second and third respectively, for Yvonne King of Langhorne Creek.

Bailey Rocks is prepared by Alberton trainer Bill Wudarczyk, who races her in partnership with Kirin Corby. Bill said he wasn't that confident before the race, as Bailey Rocks needs to lead, as she can find trouble if caught back on the rails. But today's win exceeded Bill's expectations, taking her tally to 7 wins and 6 placings from 24 starts.

Bailey Rocks is a member of a great litter that Bill whelped from Rhonda Rocks, a

breeding female that he leased for one litter of pups. As part of the deal, Bill and Kirin received five pups, and all have been winners. The best performed of the litter, Sennachie, has put SA racing firmly on the map and is the toast of Australian racing, having recently won two Group 1 races, the Brisbane Cup and the Maturity Classic in Melbourne. Sennachie has now won 14 races, with 5 placings from just 22 starts, for \$488,000 in stakemoney. The mother Rhonda Rocks only had two starts with one good win, but as the trainer, Bill saw enough

to convince him to pursue the chance to breed a litter.

Bill started his racing interest "not too seriously" way back in 1971, but took it to a higher level after he retired in 2001. Greyhound racing provides great enjoyment for Bill, as he likes the greyhounds themselves, the social aspects, as well as the exercise and routine. Bill said that "to get a good dog is a blessing", but to be involved with the best litter he has had, must be exceptional.

# TRIALS

## ANGLE PARK

### ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

Under the new schedule Angle Park Qualifying Trials will be run weekly on Wednesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting (12 days later due to nominations). With 388m racing now available on Monday nights trainers can qualify for all distances.

**Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Wednesday of the meeting.**

#### SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

#### BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to [trialbooker.com](http://trialbooker.com), create an account and book your own trials.

### POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

#### Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

#### Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Tuesday and Friday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the race meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

#### Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA by midday on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Gawler Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before.
3. For Murray Bridge Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

## Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

# MOUNT GAMBIER

The Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club will conduct satisfactory trials under the criteria below:

1. On race days only when there are less than 12 races scheduled
2. These trials must be booked with GRSA by 4.30pm the day before a mid-week meeting and 4pm on the Friday prior if a Sunday meeting.

GRSA reserves the right to alter or amend this policy at any time.

# GRADING GUIDELINES/ GRADING & HANDICAPPING RULES OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA

## ELIGIBILITY effective 9.9.19

### MAIDEN

For greyhounds that have not won any flat race, heat or final of same, where greyhounds race behind an artificial lure, except where such meeting is held under the coursing ties method by clubs registered with the Authority for the purpose of conducting Coursing meetings otherwise than by way of a "walkover".

### JUVENILE

A greyhound is a Juvenile until and including the last day of the month corresponding to its whelping in the second year thereafter and shall remain a Juvenile for any race which was programmed to be run within that period, but was postponed to a subsequent date after that period and, where a greyhound is a Juvenile for a heat of any event, it shall remain a Juvenile after that period for all races leading to and including the final of that event.

Greyhounds classified as Juveniles shall be eligible to win two [2] such events, or in the case of 'Beat the Grader', a greyhound may win three [3]. The exception is SA Bred greyhounds classified as Juveniles shall be eligible to win six [6] events, or in the case of 'Beat the Grader' a greyhound may win seven [7]. Upon winning their maximum Juvenile's greyhounds remain eligible to complete their future engagements.

A Maiden can be nominated for these events, provided it has competed in an official qualifying trial or race. If a Maiden greyhound were to win a Juvenile event, that win would count as its Maiden win and it would still be eligible to win a further two [2] Juvenile events [3 with 'Beat the Grader' win] or if SA Bred a further six [6] Juvenile events [7 with 'Beat the Grader' win].

### GRADE 6

All Grade 6 greyhounds remain eligible to complete their future engagements.

For greyhounds that have not won a Grade 5 or above at the track at the time of nomination.

However a greyhound will be ineligible for Grade 6 events if it has won an APK Grade 5 or above event over 515m. [5NP races in SA are exempt].

### Non-SA Bred Greyhounds:

For City A [APK only] track, Non SA Bred greyhounds are eligible to win one [1] Grade 6 [2 with a 'Beat the Grader' win] at that track. Non-SA Bred Greyhounds are eligible to win two [2] Grade 6 [3 with a 'Beat The Grader' win] at all other tracks in South Australia over different distances. There will be no retrospective grading for meetings graded from 10th February 2019. Once a greyhound wins its fourth Grade 6 [5 with a 'Beat the Grader' win/s], at any tracks where it is still eligible for Grade 6 grade, it will revert to a Grade 5.

### SA Bred Greyhound

For City A [APK only] track, SA Bred greyhounds are eligible to win one [1] Grade 6 [2 with a 'Beat the Grader' win] at that track. At City B & Provincial Tracks [APM, APD, Gawler, Murray Bridge & Mount Gambier] SA Bred greyhounds can win one [1] Grade 6 [2 with a 'Beat the Grader' win] over 2 different distances at that track. There

will be no retrospective grading for meetings graded from 10th February 2019. At Country Tracks, SA Bred greyhounds can win one [1] Grade 6 [2 with a 'Beat the Grader' win] over each distance at that track. Once a greyhound wins at total of 12 races at any tracks where it is still eligible for Grade 6 grade, it will revert to a Grade 5.

For the purposes of this Grading Rule, Angle Park City A, City B and Provincial 2 are considered as "different tracks" the same as Gawler Provincial 1 and Gawler Provincial 2. Winning a Heat and Final are considered as one [1] Grade 6 win.

### GRADE 5

For greyhounds that have won a Maiden and greyhounds returning from Grade 4.

### GRADE 4

For greyhounds that have won a Grade 5 and greyhounds returning from Grade 3.

### GRADE 3

For greyhounds that have won a Grade 4 and greyhounds returning from Grade 2.

### GRADE 2

For greyhounds that have won a Grade 3 and greyhounds returning from Grade 1.

### GRADE 1

For greyhounds that have won a Grade 2.

### MIXED

For greyhounds that are Grade 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5.

Grades are mixed in consecutive order [E.g. 2/3, 2/3/4].

### OPEN & FREE FOR ALL

For greyhounds that are Grade 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5.

## PENALTIES & AWARDS

### PENALTIES

Winners advance one [1] grade.

### AWARDS (All Distances)

All tracks – Two [2] times unplaced drop to next lower grade.

### BEAT THE GRADER

A greyhound that is dually nominated under the 'Beat the Grader' system and wins at the first meeting, shall not be eligible for a drop back in grade if unplaced at the second meeting.

### OPEN & MIXED EVENTS

Penalties and awards apply.

### SPECIAL EVENTS

Winners – Not penalised.

Unplaced greyhounds – Awards apply.

### FREE FOR ALL EVENTS

Winners – Not penalised.

Unplaced greyhounds – Awards apply.



## FEATURE EVENTS

Where heats and finals are run, a greyhound winning a heat and/or final is penalised only one [1] grade.

Unplaced runs in these events count as only one [1] run towards a drop back in grade.

## RE-GRADING

Re-grading will occur for short course, middle and staying events at these tracks for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds. At Angle Park over 388, 600m and 731m a trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. At Gawler over 400m & 643m a trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. The same applies for Murray Bridge & Mt Gambier. If having met these criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

For the purposes of this Grading Rule, Angle Park City A, City B and Provincial 2 are considered as "different tracks" the same as Gawler Provincial 1 and Gawler Provincial 2.

## INTERSTATE GREYHOUNDS

### GRADING OF INTERSTATE GREYHOUNDS

Greyhounds owned or trained interstate will be graded on their current city grade on the track/or tracks from the state in which they are owned or trained.

### PURCHASING OF INTERSTATE GREYHOUNDS

Greyhounds purchased from Interstate into 100% South Australia Ownership which are currently higher than a Grade 5 Interstate [over any distance] on a Metropolitan track will initially be graded into Grade 5 events, provided that the Transfer of Ownership together with the proof of purchase is lodged with GRSA prior to close of nominations. There will be no retrospective grading once the Transfer of Ownership has been approved.

### GRADE 6 ELIGIBILITY

Non- SA Bred greyhounds from interstate that have won five or more races at any track are not eligible for Grade 6 Grade. However if a greyhound has won a Metropolitan Grade 5 or above between [460m – 590m] they are not eligible.

SA Bred greyhounds that have been trained interstate and are transferred back to an SA trainer, will revert to their eligible grade at each track in SA however if they have won a Grade 5 or above event at any Metropolitan meeting [460m – 590m] they will be ineligible for Grade 6 events.

# GREYHOUND RACING SA GRADING GUIDELINES

Effective – 9th September

### ORDER OF PREFERENCE – CITY & PROVINCIAL TRACKS

1. Last start winner at the track and distance at the previous corresponding meeting.
2. Last start winner [city].
3. Last start placegetter at the track and distance at the previous corresponding meeting.
4. Last start placegetter [city].
5. Qualifying heat winner at the track and distance, relevant to the meeting being graded.

6. Downgrade: A greyhound after becoming eligible for a downgrade is entitled to one race start except in the case of 'Beat the Grader' where two race starts are permitted in its correct grade or grades if possible. This applies to greyhounds nominated in Grade 5 up to Grade 2 only.
7. The Grader may include here any greyhound that in his opinion is entitled to be graded into the field based on its overall record and/or recent performance/or performances in feature events, or greyhounds with equal qualifications.
8. Two wins from last three starts [city].
9. One win from last three starts [city].
10. Placed two out of last three starts [city].
11. Last start winner [provincial].
12. Two wins from last three starts [provincial].
13. Last start winner [country].
14. Last start placegetter [provincial].
15. Placed one out of last three starts [city].
16. Two wins from last three starts [country].
17. One win from last three starts [provincial].
18. Placed two out of last three starts [provincial].
19. Reserve greyhounds that did not obtain a start at the previous corresponding meeting [same distance and grade].

# GRADING REVIEW PANEL

Meeting commenced at 11.07am. Shaun Mathieson, Racing Manager, thanked all for attending. The panel were advised that the Members of Company had recommended Mike Wittholz to come onto the panel from the Gawler GRC in the position as Club Representative on the GRP replacing Barry Shepherd to which he had accepted. The RM welcomed Mike to the panel advising it will be for a 2 year term in the first instance.

## Minutes From Previous Meeting

The panel approved the minutes from the previous GRP meeting held on 16/11/18.

## Business Arising

The Racing Manager provided a verbal update to the panel on the progress of the below items.

**Claiming Races** – The RM advised Claiming Races have also been discussed at the most recent ICG meeting where it was noted that greyhounds could now be claimed in a meeting rather than in a specific race which previously was not supported by industry. The RM advised this new process has also seen zero support. The RM advised the ICG noted the success of claiming races at harness and suggested its popularity was due to the benefit of downgrades. It was suggested introducing a downgrade option and a maximum claiming price to increase interest. The GRP noted the issues around Claiming races with a number of forms needing to be completed and also that other codes policy will not work for greyhound racing for this type of event. The GRP recommend these races not be programmed any more.

**Murray Bridge Straight Track** – The RM advised due to some minor delays the Murray Bridge Straight track should commence on Wednesday 19th June and every fortnight after that on the current schedule pending no further delays. The RM advised they will race over the 300m and 350m with all greyhounds' grades starting as if they had never raced at the venue. The RM advised there will be National Straight Track Championship with Vic and Qld in July/August with local heats over the 350m. The SPM advised the 300m start will have to be changed from a chute to movable boxes onto the track as requested by the GRSA Board. He advised there was a current tender process going on in Vic which would be completed shortly which will then allow for him to purchase equipment. This should not delay the start of racing.

**Murray Bridge Trialling Schedule** – The panel advised the GRP that at the most recent ICG meeting management questioned the Group regarding their preference to the trialling schedule at Murray Bridge ie trialling on both tracks, alternating between circle and straight track noting they were unable to trial on the straight at night. It was noted the group's preference was for half hour segments alternating between tracks. The GRP confirmed this as their preference.

The RM advised that the ICG panel suggested moving Angle Park trials to Tuesday night, Gawler to Wednesday and Murray Bridge on Friday. The panel suggested preparation between Friday and Sunday at Murray Bridge would be limited. Some Members were comfortable with Angle Park trials on Wednesday and Saturday. The panel requested a night trialling session at Gawler. The GRP advised that preferably they would like a night time session at Gawler which would assist trainers for nominating the next day. They suggested could GRSA consider trialling after race meetings as they do in Victoria. It was suggested could extra kennels be available at race meetings when there are 12 races as trials cannot be conducted. There were many suggestions however with 6 dog racing currently

being trialled it was agreed to not make any changes until the calendar of racing and trialling was more settled.

## Agenda Items

**Adelaide Cup Series (Joint Promotion with Victoria)** – The RM asked for comment about the recent Media Release from GRSA and GRV regarding the joint promotion of feature races during our Adelaide Cup Carnival to offset the effect of the Million Dollar chase in SA and Vic. The conditions were -

1. Highest placed Victorian in the September Speed Star [15th September] at Sandown gains automatic entry [if they accept into SA State Of Origin Race to represent Vic [26th September].
2. Winner of the SA State of Origin Race [SA OR VIC greyhound] gains automatic entry [if they accept] into the Group 2 Shootout at Sandown [14th November].
3. Winner of the SA State of Origin [SA OR VIC greyhound] will be guaranteed a spot into the Group 1 Adelaide Cup final [11th October] 2 weeks later [By passes the Heats].
4. Winner of the Group 1 Adelaide Cup gains automatic entry [if they accept] into the Group 1 Topgun at the Meadows [9th November].

The panel advised that local Owners and Trainers would like this concept. They confirmed that SA trained would refer to domiciliary clauses the same as the Nationals. Members questioned whether the Adelaide Cup would be a 6 dog field. The RM advised this was not the case for this year.

**SA Owned Races** – The RM advised the panel that at a previous ICG meeting they requested these SA Owned and SA Bred races continue in the All Tracks calendar which the GRP were supportive of. The RM advised to accommodate any ownership queries GRSA will now have a Proof of Purchase on the Transfer of Ownership forms which will ONLY have to be completed if the new owners are requesting grading benefits back to a Grade 5 in SA. The RM to implement as soon as possible.

**G-SIX Implementation** – The RM advised the panel with the introduction of G-SIX on the 2nd May for a 3 month trial period what were the panel's thoughts regarding the concept with the RM advising signs were positive from a wagering and cleaner racing point of view. They advised with more races could more races be run [14 races] at meetings and would GRSA consider split kennelling. The RM advised that we could not accommodate more races and split kennelling had been discussed before and GRSA was not taking this approach. The SPM advised that with 6 dog racing he would look at reconfiguring kennel bays to allow for some extra kennel space if the trial was implemented fully.

The panel asked why was Murray Bridge One Turn or Straight track not involved in the G-SIX concept. The RM advised as they are brand new venues there is not previous data to support a change to 6 dog fields plus these venues are brand new and less conducive to race interference. During the trial the other three tracks have significant data prior to 6 dog fields so GRSA can see the positives or negatives more clearly.

The RM advised that GRSA had considered numbers 1,2,3,4,5,6 like they do in the UK however there are significant issues with Ozchase, Fastrack, the NDR etc and the flow of information throughout Australia for different boxes. The RM advised that we would use 1,2,4,5,7,8 during the trial however would keep our options open for the future. The Panel were comfortable with this approach during the trial.

The RM advised that if the trial continued that the option of preferential box draws could be trialled in 6 dog events. He asked the panel who would be best to advise if the greyhound was a railer, straight or wide runner? After some discussion it was agreed that the trainer would be the best person to advise the racing

traits of their greyhound however were mindful of the integrity implications of this approach.

**Easter Feedback** – The RM requested some feedback from the panel regarding the local Match Race series which was conducted on 18th April named the Easter. This series was a time based series compared to the State of Origin in September which is based around selection criteria by the Grader for SA and VIC. The panel were supportive of the series in its current form however consider whether the local greyhounds should be guarded. The RM advised that as this is time based and trainers can see where greyhounds sit in a lead up to the series that for this race there should be no guarding.

**Grade 6 Review** – The RM advised the panel that he felt it was necessary to reform the Grade 6 classification and eligibility conditions. Due to different grades interstate and changes locally he believed it is quite hard for most trainers to understand the Grade 6 conditions. The panel had a detailed discussion around the Grade 6 policy being mindful that it has been tinkered with regularly over the years due to changes locally and interstate. Issues that were raised were -

- 12 Lifetime wins and then is not eligible for Grade 6.
- Winning a Grade 5 on a Thursday night over 515m you are no longer eligible for Grade 6 anywhere
- RW, Novice, SE, Grade 6 and 7 do not affect Grade 6 races
- Winning a Grade 5 for \$200 in NSW will mean a greyhound is not eligible.
- Time Grading and Pathway Non Penalty races
- Win a Grade 6 race interstate should count locally

After much consideration the panel directed that one change to be implemented. The panel agreed that when a greyhound comes to SA from Interstate for its first start that if it has won 4 or less races it should be considered a Grade 6 even if it has won Grade 5 races [Metropolitan Grade 5 races (460m – 590m) in their state will affect Grade 6]. There will be no retrospective grading for greyhounds already in SA with a starting date 1st September.

**Automated Grading Process** – The RM advised that the automated sorting of the Order of Preference is near completion. This should reduce this part of the process by about 1 hour. The RM advised for this process to be quickened up and to remove some of the discretion of the Grader the below items need to be introduced –

Order of Preference updated

- No 5 – Qualifying trials will be managed separately outside the automation
- Remove St Leger & Champion Puppy heats reference
- Remove 6 months criteria reference
- Remove Grader giving preference to performances over 400m
- Swap No 9 [Placed 2 of last 3 in City] and No 10 [One win from last 3 in City]
- Any reference about Pathway or Time Graded is removed from this file
- Update Track Classifications based on new file for WPS [Weighted Points Score]
- Add WPS on document [Fell is considered as 4th and FTF is next available placing]

The RM advised that the WPS will assist with the selection of those greyhounds not on the Order of Preference so all greyhounds will effectively be sorted into an order for selection.

The RM advised that he required the support from the GRP that when using the automation that if the order of entry by Order of Preference, Race wins or WPS is discovered to be incorrect after fields have been drawn that GRSA will not redraw the race in question [so long as the greyhound is correctly graded]. The GRP were comfortable with this approach. They requested that if this adversely affected a

greyhound then that greyhound should get first preference at its next nominations. The RM advised this would be implemented. The panel advised prior to implementation that all documentation be provided to industry and requested that the report for each race be made available similar to the Time Grading report.

The panel were advised that long time grader Greg Barber would be moving into a stewarding role and that this automated sorting was a priority for grading of fields going forward.

## Late Items

**Kim Johnstone (regarding nomination flow, schedule and nomination closing days)** – The schedule was discussed earlier in the agenda so no further comment required. Kim advised about some meetings closing on the same days which may draw from the same pool of dogs. The RM advised that consideration to moving meetings around may be possible if the grading process is quickened by automation of sorting. The panel were comfortable to see how things progress.

**Ryan Tugwell (regarding High Grade greyhounds)** – Ryan advised that a greyhound that is high grade should be given a run ahead of other greyhounds regardless of form. The GRP advised that the Order of Preference is always used and if a greyhound is not on the Order regardless of grade then they would be made reserve of left out. The GRP were supportive of the grading in this instance however suggested that the RM promote the downgrade process to industry for those high grade greyhounds that may not be able to get a race.

**Scott Feltus (regarding Grade 5 Masters races)** – Scott suggested that a Grade 5 Masters be programmed every Thursday night just like a Maiden. Some trainers may not be aware that the grader will consider a Grade 5 Masters regardless which also refers to Juveniles. The RM was advised to start publishing more Grade 5 Masters events on the All Tracks calendar to encourage nominations.

**Michael Jaensch** – Correspondence was received from Michael Jaensch regarding an SA Bred Grade 6 greyhound being trained by an interstate trainer racing in SA going to Victoria and winning a Grade 5 event and then coming back to SA and changing to a Grade 5. He believed this should not affect the greyhounds grade. He was advised that as an interstate dog winning a Grade 5 this will affect the remaining Grade 6 events however if the greyhound was changed into an SA trainer then this greyhound's grade would not be affected. He was advised that GRSA has been consistent in this approach. The GRP supported the graders decision however advised that if the greyhound transfers back to an SA trainer it should be a Grade 6 dog. The RM to confirm an acceptable time frame for this to occur.

## Other Items –

The RM requested feedback from the panel regarding the Breeders and Classic series at Gawler. Historically they are not well supported due to them being at the end of each series after the Group 3 final. The RM suggested that they move to the start where the Breeders and Classic series are held at Angle Park prior to the Group 3 final. The panel were supportive of this.

Petar Jovanovic suggested Oaks and Derby series should be run at Murray Bridge to add to their feature events along with more Feature Heats and Finals. The RM to consider these races in the calendar with the MBGRC.

The panel were advised that the 680m boxes at Murray Bridge would not be installed at this time due to the current lack of support for 530m racing.

The panel brought up the option of swapping Angle Park and Gawler for Monday and Tuesday allowing for Gawler to race on Monday night. The RM advised that at this time there was no intent to change however this could be something the Gawler GRC may want to direct to the CEO.
