Inquiry into Greyhound industry

As you would be aware by now, Premier Peter Malinauskas has announced an independent inquiry into the greyhound racing industry. Earlier this month, the terms of reference for the inquiry were finalised as well as who will oversee the inquiry.

The State Government has appointed former Victorian Police Commissioner Graham Ashton AM APM to conduct an inquiry that will investigate the:

- operations, culture, governance, and practices of the South Australian greyhound racing industry,
- nature and efficacy of our model of regulation including rules and policies, and
- relationship, if any, between that model and the operation, culture, governance, and practices of the industry.

Mr Ashton, who has an extensive background in both integrity and racing will be engaging with a number of stakeholders from our community and beyond to get a clear picture of the state of the industry. As part of this process, he will be inviting submissions from anyone who wishes to participate.

GRSA will be proactively and transparently engaging with this inquiry because we ultimately believe it will strengthen our industry for the future.

ALOISI PULLS OFF NATIONAL DOUBLE

TRAINER Tim Aloisi pulled off a rare double claiming both the SA finals of the National Sprint and Distance Championship on a fantastic night of racing at Angle Park on Thursday 10th August.

While Zipping Neutron entered the Distance final as a red-hot favourite on the back of ten straight victories, it was Ravers Army who pulled a surprise in the Sprint final overcoming an awkward box four draw to win a very even race.

Speaking after the race, Aloisi said it was a special evening to pull off the double across the two feature events.

"It is an unreal feeling," Aloisi said.

"We came hoping to win just one race and if not place and to go home with two wins it's unreal."

The double success was a thrill not only for Aloisi but also for his young family who were on course and were seen proudly posing on the dais post-race.

"Greyhound racing is a family sport, and the girls are only young and don't come every week. I work full time and run a business. I rely on family and friends and a lot of support," Aloisi said.

"It's not just me. I'm kind of a face to it and I've got a lot of friends and family that do a lot for us as well. We will all be happy and celebrate as one big team."

Aloisi's attention will now turn to planning for the National finals at The Meadows on Saturday August 26th and the trainer said he was looking forward to representing South Australia.

"I haven't planned out anything I really look one week at a time a few people asked what I was doing I said we have to win it first. So I'll sit down and plan it out," Aloisi said.

"We have always been out there and said we are strong South Australian supporters and we have always supported the sport and we always will.

"To win the Nationals as a trainer for the first time, it's an unbelievable feeling and I'm proud. I am proud of South Australia, I am proud of our racing and I still believe our top liners can compete against the other state.

"My boys will go over there. I know my dogs might not be the best but I know they'll give their best for South Australia and that's all we can ask."



FEDERAL OUTLAW SWOOPS TO STRAIGHT TRACK SUCCESS

The headline act Murray Bridge Straight Track program on Tuesday 8th August was the South Australian National Straight Track final with some of the state's best short-course stars stepping out.

With an even box draw providing many of the favourites a winning hope, it was the Ben Rawlings trained Federal Outlaw who swooped late to take out the race in 19.05 with the Ashlee Griffiths trained Cash On Delivery finishing in second.

Speaking after the race, Rawlings said he was thrilled to get the chance to represent South Australia once again in the National Straight Track final

"We have been lucky enough to go before and to go again and represent South Australia is a good thrill and Melbourne makes it a bit easier for us to travel," Rawlings said post-race.

Federal Outlaw came into the final as one of several winning chances after producing an eye-catching second from box seven finishing off strongly behind He's On Fire despite finding some trouble in the heat.

Rawlings said that he was optimistic following the box draw with his chaser better suited to the inside draw and was pleased it was able to claim the win.

"From the seven last week, he kept trying to crash over and probably bumped five or six times and only got done a neck on the line," Rawlings said.

"I thought with the draw if he could clear the two without that interference he would be right there."

"It didn't look like there was much interference and the main hopes all got their chance. It was a solid enough field and we were lucky enough to get the job done."

Rawlings and Federal Outlaw will be joined at Healesville by the Ashlee Griffiths Cash On Delivery with the top two runners earning places in the National final.

Rawlings said he was thrilled for Griffiths and was looking forward to representing SA alongside her.

"Ash's dog (Cash On Delivery) is a rocket," Rawlings said.

"She was working with us early days before she started training a few more dogs so to see her get a dog of that sort of quality and be a representative in this sort of race is good for her as well."

The National Straight Track final will be held at Healesville on Saturday morning on August 26 with the Sprint and Distance finals to be run at The Meadows that evening.

LOW GRADE RACE FOR THURSDAYS AT ANGLE PARK

In an effort to ensure we are running 12 races each Thursday night at Angle Park, GRSA is programming a low grade race for some Thursday nights.

These races are for Grade 5 greyhounds over 530m that have a low WPS [Weighted Points Score]. Prizemoney will be slightly less than a normal Grade 5, however, these races will be non-penalty.

There will be no guarding, no reserves and only one 8 greyhound race. This should provide encouragement for those trainers who have 500m+ greyhounds but feel they cannot compete on a normal Thursday night due to current form. We are hoping to draw from a different pool of greyhounds and GRSA would encourage trainers to nominate.

\$3,505 Special event Grade 5 [worst to best] – 530m [One 8 dog field will be graded from the Weighted Points Score table of Grade 5 pool of greyhounds worst to best grading. No guarding and no reserves. Trainers cannot nominate for this event specifically. Non Penalty]

The next programmed event is on Thursday, 31st August.

• Nominations close Monday, 28th August with GRSA at 9.00am

GRSA has also continued with the 1 – 4 win Time Graded Heats on a Saturday morning over 530m into a Thursday night Final, however, with the introduction of the race on Thursday nights, the 5+ 530m Time Graded events will only be run if insufficient nominations for the meeting [there will be no Heats for this pool of greyhounds unless specifically programmed].

GRSA will also continue running Heats at Murray Bridge, Angle Park Monday and Gawler into a Thursday night Final where the program allows to draw from a different pool of greyhounds over 500m.

VACCINATION RULE FOR RACING IN SA

Trainers are reminded that Rule 25 [Minimum Vaccination Requirements] took effect Monday, 1st May. Vaccination Certificates must be received by GRSA prior to close of nominations for affected greyhounds to be considered eligible.

ONLINE NOMINATIONS TO BE UPDATED WITH VACCINATION DETAILS OF GREYHOUNDS

OzChase will update the currency of the Greyhound's vaccination and will be displayed within Online Nominations shortly. Each Greyhound on the Currently Trained list of a trainer will include a new column displaying the latest vaccination date recorded.

It will be colour coded according to the condition outlined below:

MURRAY BRIDGE STAT TRIALS

Please be advised Satisfactory Trials at Murray Bridge on Wednesday nights will be conducted on a fortnightly basis due to staffing issues. The next fortnightly opportunity will be Wednesday, 30th August.

GAWLER SHOW THIS WEEKEND

The Annual Gawler Show will be held this weekend Saturday 26th and Sunday 27th August. As a result, racing on Sunday night will be at Murray Bridge.

Racing tomorrow [Friday, 25th August] will be at Angle Park. Trials will be cancelled at Gawler on Monday, 28th August. At the moment, trials will go ahead on Thursday 31st August at the venue but this will be dependent upon the tidying up and track maintenance progression.

Racing will be at Murray Bridge on the One Turn track on Wednesday, 30th August to allow more time for the Show society to remove all of their Show activities from the venues.

Racing will return to Gawler, all going well, on Friday 1st September.

GAWLER TRACK GRADE IN LATE AUGUST

GRSA is working on a track grade and harrow for Tuesday 29th August and maintenance on Wednesday 30th August while the Gawler venue is out of action due to the Gawler Show.

This will be weather dependant and GRSA will provide more information shortly confirming these dates.

GOTBA COURSING DATES – OAKS, DERBY AND WATERLOO CUP NEXT MONTH

Below are the GOTBA at Virginia Coursing dates until the end of the season. GRSA will continue to grade a mix of 4 and 8 dog events as the season progresses. Next month the GOTBA have programmed Preludes for the Oaks and Derby on Sunday 10th September with the Oaks, Derby and Waterloo Cup run on Sunday 24th September.

INDUSTRY CONSULTATIVE GROUP PANEL MEETING OUTCOMES – TO BE IMPLEMENTED FROM 1ST SEPTEMBER

GRSA has been publishing the change in policy and penalties to be applied from the most recent ICG meeting. These will now take affect from the race meetings to be conducted from 1st September and introduced from 1st September.

- There will only be one provisional breeders license being provided to multiple participants residing at the same residence. All other applications would be dealt with on a case by case basis. For implementation from 1st September.
- 2 in 7 starts and 7 in 28 starts rule. The ICG agreed that a 10 day stand down period would be an appropriate penalty for those that knowingly nominated greyhounds that would be ineligible due to the rule. It was suggested any further infringements could attract a monetary penalty. To clarify, any penalty would only apply once the dog had gone

around, not in instances with late scratchings etc. It is the trainer's responsibility to be aware of this rule and their implications. For implementation for meetings conducted on the 1st September onwards.

- The ICG panel confirmed and supported a \$100 fine for any late Pink Card applications. For implementation from 1st September.
- The ICG panel supported all trialling to be booked through the Trial Booker process to ensure specific criteria is met. Management to investigate amending trial booker into group categories to achieve greater efficiency at the session. For implementation in the month of September.

GAWLER TRIALS TO MOVE TO ONLINE SHORTLY

As advised previously, GRSA has been working with the Gawler GRC and staff to transition the Gawler trial booking process to online like Angle Park and Murray Bridge for their Monday and Thursday morning sessions. An implementation date will be advised shortly.

RACING AND TRIALLING FREQUENCY – STARTED 1ST FEBRUARY

GRSA has adopted a new local rule in regard to frequency of racing and trialling which took effect on Wednesday, 1st February 2023. The update local rule is below -

69A Racing and trialling frequency

[1] In this rule:

Race has the same meaning given to this term in R9 of the GAR.

Trial means a satisfactory trial, or a qualifying trial as defined in R9 of the GAR.

[2] A greyhound will only be permitted to start in –

[a] No more than a combined total of 2 race and trial starts in any 7-day period; and,

[b] No more than a combined total of 7 race and trial starts in any 28-day period.

[3] This sub-rule commences on a date to be fixed by Stewards' Notice.

The intent of this rule is to monitor and regulate the frequency of races and official trials of greyhounds, to ensure adequate rest time is given between events. The rule is similar to one in effect in Western Australia. We have automated the OzChase Racing system to be able to monitor this rule. The rule is self-explanatory. A greyhound must not start more than 2 times (races or trials combined) in any 7-day period. Further, a greyhound must not start more than 7-times (races or trials combined) in any 28-day period.

Any attempt to nominate a greyhound outside these parameters will be flagged by the OzChase system. If a greyhound gains a start from reserve deeming it ineligible under this rule for its next engagement or it competes in another State prior to racing back in SA, then the greyhound will come out.

****Racing Administration staff will scratch these greyhounds acting under this rule without notification. [the responsibility rests with the trainer to ensure they do not contravene this rule]**

****For clarity if a greyhound races on Sunday, Wednesday then Sunday it will be eligible. The first day counts as day 1 and therefore resets on the Saturday.**

RECEPTIONS TO GO CASHLESS

From September 1st, GRSA and GAP receptions will be fully cashless and will accept payments via card only for all charges.

RACE BOOKS ONCOURSE

Recently due to staffing shortages and other administrative priorities, GRSA has stopped producing Race Books at our venues [except for Feature meetings and Mt Gambier which produces their own book]. Whilst the race books are free it takes significant editing to produce a final product, which can take a number of Administrative hours which is not available at present. In the short term all of our racing information is available online on the GRSA website or with other online wagering providers. GRSA is currently investigating options for form guides to be printed at the track, however, there has been nothing confirmed as yet.

DUAL LURE TO BE TRIALLED AT ANGLE PARK IN TRIAL SESSIONS

As advised in this months Kennel Capers, a dual lure will be trialled at Angle Park commencing on Tuesday, 29th August and will be for each Tuesday after, until sufficient trialling has taken place to determine the positives and negatives of the dual lure at our venues.

To manage this process trainers will need to book trials as normal. GRSA will allocate timeslots 7.15pm to 7.40pm and 7.40pm to 8.05pm each Tuesday meaning we will be trialling up to 20 trials each Tuesday night. Having two blocks of time this will assist trial staff manage the changing of the lure etc.

When booking online please book as normal in these slots and it will be assumed that you want to trial on the dual lure. If a trainer does not want to trial on the

dual lure then please book in different time slots.

When ringing up to book a trial please advise staff if you want to book a dual lure trial, bearing in mind there is only 20 trials and once gone there will not be anymore until the following week.

2023 SA OAKS AND SA DERBY FEATURES IN SEPTEMBER

The Group 3 SA Oaks and SA Derby to be run in September this year will be for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st June, 2021 [27 months].

The Heats of the Oaks will be run on the same night as the Derby again this year with Heats on Thursday, 7th September and the Group 3 Finals on Thursday, 14th September.

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 18th September at 9.00am.

2023 TAB MATCH RACE CHALLENGE – SA TAKES ON THE ALL STARS IN SEPTEMBER

South Australia will again conduct the annual Match Race Challenge in September, to be held on Thursday, 21st September during the rich Adelaide Cup Carnival.

With the Million Dollar Chase changing AGAIN to race on top of the Group 1 Adelaide Cup this year, GRSA has kept the conditions of the series the same as last year to be “SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS” to ensure that the Angle Park TAB Match Race Challenge attracts the best greyhounds possible.

It will be four [4] SA greyhounds taking on the four [4] best nominated greyhounds from anywhere in Australia.

GRSA will still guarantee the winner of the TAB Match Race Challenge direct entry into the \$100,000 to the winner Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final on Friday, 6th October [bypassing the Adelaide Cup Heats]. The winner of the Match Race series is considered qualified for the Group 1 Adelaide Cup and will not be eligible to compete in another series.

- **Nominations close at 9am on Monday, 18th September with GRSA.**

Conditions of the TAB Match Race Challenge – SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS:

Eligibility as to who represents South Australia or All-Stars will be based around the National Championships domiciliary clause. Greyhounds need to be trained in the State they wish to represent for 76 days out of the last 150 days prior to the date that nominations close [18th September].

The best four [4] greyhounds nominated from SA will be selected by the GRSA Grader to represent “SA’s Best”. The best four [4] greyhounds nominated from Interstate will be selected by the GRSA Grader to represent “the All-Stars”.

The Grader will use whatever information he has available to select those greyhounds including liaising with other State bodies as required. The SA Grader’s decision will be final.

Those greyhounds not selected from Interstate will be given the opportunity to solo trial or race in another event on the night.

Reserves will be declared, with one [1] from SA and one [1] from Interstate [dependant on nominations], which will replace the SA or All-Stars representative as required.

For example the SA reserve will only replace an SA scratching.

The Grader will rate the four [4] greyhounds from SA and the four [4] from Interstate in order from 1

to 4, with No.1 being the highest rated greyhound from each group. The head-to-head matches will be decided by the two No. 1 rated greyhounds competing against each other and then it will be 2 v 2, 3 v 3 and 4 v 4.

Prizemoney for each individual match will also reflect the seeding of greyhounds from 1 to 4, with the No. 1 rated greyhounds racing for the most prizemoney in the head-to-head races. However, the overall winner of the race will still be determined on actual race times run by each greyhound [to three decimal places only].

Prizemoney for the overall placings for TAB Match Race Challenge [based on overall times]: • 1st – \$7,500 • 2nd – \$2,500 • 3rd – \$1,000

TAB ADELAIDE CUP TO RACE ON FRIDAY 6TH OCTOBER

Thanks to the support of Greyhound Racing Victoria, South Australia will be able to run our premier Group 1 meeting on Friday, 6th October. SA will swap our Friday Day meeting with Victoria’s night meeting so we can race in the evening. Due to programming some of the races early on the program will be on Sky 2, however, our Group 1 Adelaide Cup and feature races will be on Sky 1 with the Cup to be run slightly later than normal to accommodate Sky Racing scheduling.

Murray Bridge will race on the Thursday night before the Cup [5th October] retaining our normal night time Sky 1 slot. In past years this meeting was run in the twilight on Sky 2.

GRSA is vry appreciative of GRV for assisting with this scheduling change which would not have happened without their support.

2023 SA COUNTRY CUP CONDITIONS

Below are details of how and where greyhounds can qualify for the \$7,500 SA Country Cup Final, to be run at Angle Park over 530 metres on Adelaide Cup Final night Friday, 6th October 2023 as a G-SIX. GRSA have made some slight changes to the conditions to encourage more support for the series.

Conditions

- All South Australian Greyhound Racing Clubs outside of Angle Park will conduct Heats or nominate greyhounds from which the Greyhound Racing SA Grading Department will choose two representatives. These meetings are Gawler Provincial 1 & 2, Murray Bridge One Turn Provincial 1 and Mount Gambier Provincial 1 & 2.
- The event is open to all South Australian greyhounds that are not above Grade 5 at Angle Park [APK City A meeting only] over 530 metres at the time of nomination. This condition is not applicable to the Mt Gambier representatives. Winner of each event takes a penalty including the Final.

Special Exceptions:

Mount Gambier Club is allowed to include non-South Australian trainers under strict conditions:

1. The Interstate trainer has had starters at 10 meetings for Mt Gambier in the previous 12 months.
 2. The Interstate trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 2 months.
- Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.
 - The greyhound must be SA trained [except Mount Gambier as above].
 - o A South Australian trained greyhound is defined as one that has been racing in SA for a period of not less than 2 out of the 6 months immediately prior to the time of nomination.
 - The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track it is attempting to represent.
 - A greyhound can only be drawn into one of the club venues
 - There will be a maximum of two Heats per Club with the winners of each Heat qualifying. If there is only one Heat conducted, then the first two placegetters will qualify.
 - The two reserves will be determined firstly by a ballot of the second placegetters from all Heats. The third placegetters will then be considered by ballot if required. If a Heat was not conducted at the track, then that track is not included in the ballot. Should a greyhound be withdrawn prior to the ballot, the

next placed greyhound from that Club's Heat will be selected.

- Once a greyhound has qualified from a Qualifying Heat, it is not eligible to compete at another track in this series, unless there are insufficient nominations to fill the field.
- Once qualified for the Country Cup Final the greyhound will be ineligible for the Adelaide Cup series or any other race on this Cup Final night.
- Lead up Heats may be up to 8 greyhounds however the Final on Adelaide Cup night will be a G-SIX Final

HEATS CLASSIC 2023 PRELUDE (2) AT ANGLE PARK IN OCTOBER

The \$3,700 Heats of Classic 2023 Prelude [2] will be run on Thursday, 12th October with the \$4,500 Final on Thursday, 19th October over the 530m. For SA Bred greyhounds whelped July 21 to December 21 and paid up for Classic 2023.

2023 GAWLER CUP CARNIVAL KICKS OFF ON MONDAY 23RD OCTOBER

The Gawler Gold Cup carnival will be run over two meetings this year. The Gawler GRC has been in consultation with the Thoroughbreds and Harness Racing in the region and has made a mini carnival again this year with all three codes running their main races for the year around the same time called the "Gawler Carnival of Cups".

Our carnival will kick off on Monday, 23rd October with \$3,000 Heats for the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup over the 531m along with \$1,995 Heats of the Gawler Sprint Classic for open 400m greyhounds and the \$2,760 Heats of the "Bothing" Gawler Stayers Cup for open 643m greyhounds.

The Group 3 Gawler Cup Final will be run on Sunday night, 29th October worth \$36,000 in prizemoney with the winner to receive \$25,000. This night will include

the \$8,000 Gawler Sprint Classic Final, the \$8,500 Final of the Bothing Gawler Stayers Cup and there will be a Consolation for the Gawler Gold Cup.

Nominations for the Gawler Cup Heats, Gawler Sprint Classic Heats and Bothing Stayers Cup close with GRSA at 9.00am on Thursday, 19th October

Change of venues to accommodate the Gawler Cup Heats in October

Please note with the Gawler Cup Heats this year being conducted on Monday night, 23rd October our normal schedule will change slightly.

Angle Park will run on Friday, 21st October with a day meeting at City B class while Sunday night, 22nd October will be a Murray Bridge Prov 1 meeting around the One Turn. Please check the October All Tracks calendar for programmed events when released.

ANGLE PARK AND TOWNSVILLE TO SWAP MEETINGS AGAIN THIS YEAR

Greyhound Racing SA have liaised with Racing Queensland about swapping a Saturday morning meeting in December for our Festival of Fire meeting allowing Angle Park to run on Saturday, 16th December and Saturday, 23rd December with Townsville racing on Saturday, 2nd and Saturday, 9th December.

We have also swapped our Saturday, April 27th, 2024, to assist Queensland with Saturday, 30th December. This will mean we will be racing four Saturdays in a row towards the end of December on 16th, 23rd, 30th December and 6th January all during school holidays.

Racing Queensland liaised with GRSA to swap a Saturday meeting in August to free up the day after their Townsville Cup meeting on Friday, 25th August. This will mean Angle Park will race on Saturday, 19th August and Saturday, 26th August with Queensland racing on Saturday, 2nd September and Saturday, 9th September.

Please be mindful of these changes in the All tracks calendar and our racing dates.

The Angle Park trials will remain on Sundays when we race on the Saturday, however, when we don't race on the Saturday the trials will be on the Saturday morning as normal.

JUNE'S GRADING REVIEW PANEL MEETING OUTCOMES – MAIN POINTS

- GRSA will allow one extra Grade 6 over another distance for City A Thursday meetings bringing this into line with all tracks in SA. No retrospectivity regarding this change. Implemented

- GRSA has removed the condition where once a greyhound has won a Grade 5 or higher event on a City A meeting that the greyhound will lose all Grade 6 events at all other tracks. This means a greyhound could be a Grade 4 or Grade 3 over 530m on a Thursday City A meeting and will still be able to win Grade 6 events at other tracks. No retrospectivity regarding this change. Implemented

- GRSA will now allow a greyhound after winning a Grade 5 Masters event in faster time than the time standard to get back into Masters with 2 runs in a Grade 5 at the track and distance, it doesn't matter if they are placed or unplaced just so long as there are two starts out of Masters. This has been changed from being just unplaced to get back. Implemented

CURRENT MASTERS TIMES AND POLICY

- For greyhounds 3¾ years and older. 4yo and older will get preference. City A, City B and Prov 1 meetings are done by form for 4yo and older and then greyhounds will only get in from under 4yo to 3¾ yo in age from oldest to youngest. Prov 2 meetings are all done on age from oldest to youngest regardless of form for all ages.

- Dates are exact so going back 4yo and 3¾ from the date of race. I.e date of race run on 20/11/22 – 4yo would be 20/11/18 whelping.

- Time restrictions if a greyhound wins a Grade 5 Masters race in a faster time than published and it will have to have 2 runs [placed or unplaced] in normal company at that class of meeting before being eligible at that class of meeting.

- The Grader will look to grade a Grade 5 Masters event on every program over a distance if enough dogs are nominated regardless if it is advertised in the All Tracks calendar.

- All races Non Penalty.

If a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading. If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs, only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters [ie Grade 2/3 & 4] we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event.

305m Masters Policy for Mt Gambier – With Mt Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events, however, factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance. There will still be a Time Standard applied based on the published table being 17.75. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week. The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED “ONLY”

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that “Only” would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as

this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put “Only or no start or leave me out” then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month.

These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner & \$150 to the Breeder.

At the ICG meeting in January the SA Bred Bonus scheme was tabled for discussion where when we have 200 or more SA bred winners we go over budget and there is no Monthly payment for the Owner of Breeder separate to the \$225. It was discussed that this was happening more regularly with more racing and more SA Bred greyhounds winning events. It was suggested increasing the base amount from \$225 and removing monthly payments, therefore reducing monthly administration of the scheme. The Board advised changes to be implemented from 1 July 2023, however, kept the base amount at \$225 due to the increased numbers and racing opportunities. Due to this change the SA bred winners will no longer be listed in Kennel Capers each month.



RISK AND COMPLIANCE

INQUIRY INTO SA GREYHOUND RACING

The last couple of months have been difficult for the sport and I am sure you wonder what the future holds. During these times it is more important than ever that you look out for one another.

As you are probably aware, the South Australian government commissioned an inquiry into the SA greyhound industry headed by former Victoria Police Chief Commissioner Mr Graham Ashton.

The precise nature of the inquiry is yet to be settled; however, GRSA will do everything to assist where requested. Some further information can be found here - Independent Inquiry into the Governance of the Greyhound Racing Industry in South Australia | Office for Recreation, Sport and Racing [orsr.sa.gov.au].

I urge you to keep up to date with the inquiry and, where invited, make a submission about your sport.

CONDUCT

It is important that we, as a sport, always conduct ourselves in a proper manner. This is both at the racetrack and at your kennels. Recent events highlight exactly why the welfare team spend many hours visiting kennels, aiming to visit all kennels during the year.

RACETRACK SAFETY

Please remember to stay safe in and around the racetrack, especially at trials. Always stay vigilant and follow directions to prevent accidents and injuries.

SOME IMPORTANT POINTS

UNDERSTAND THE LURE

The lure is a mechanical device that travels along the path of the inner racetrack rail, controlled by a lure driver. The lure can travel very fast. The lure can start, stop, and change its speed at any time and without warning.

BEFORE THE TRIAL

Before participating at a trial, you must listen to, or read, any safety briefing and note warning signs on the racetrack. Only use the designated gates to move between areas. Never use the lure chute on a catching pen gate as a thoroughfare or jump any fences or inner rails. Where chains are in place to stop movement, do not move them without direction.

STAY CLEAR OF MOVING PARTS

You must not walk onto the racetrack surface unless under the direction and supervision of a GRSA official. You must never approach the lure, or approach or stand in the path of travel of the lure [which is within two (2) metres of the inner rail] at any time.

COMMUNICATION IS KEY

If you ever see something that you think is a hazard, while the lure is moving, yell out –

STOP LURE. STOP LURE. STOP LURE.

BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS

Stay alert to your surroundings. Avoid distractions like mobile phones or personal conversations that might divert your attention from the lure.

Remember, your safety and the safety of those around you are of utmost importance. By following these guidelines and respecting the rules and directions around the lure, we can create a safer and more productive environment for everyone. Let's all work together to stay safe!

INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES

PAUL MULLINS

GRSA have been working with Steriline and requested the following features be included in their next generation lure controller:

1. Modified lure control

- A new 'test mode' which allows the lure driver to enable a 'walking speed' mode [i.e. 4km/h]. This will permit participants to be near the lure safely when training young dogs.
 - A new safety feature to indicate to the lure operator that the lure motor is active or isolated. This allows track staff to safely approach the lure in its armed state.
 - Audible alarms to assist the lure driver with various aspects of operation, allowing them to maintain visual contact with the lure and not need to look at the controller display for feedback. This is not dissimilar to the audible alarms in a motor vehicle.
 - Inclusion of a lure speaker control to enable/disable the electronic lure noise from the controller.
- Steriline have commissioned production of 50 controller units but are currently still finalising the firmware. Once this has been completed, GRSA will be in a better position to announce the dates for introduction but expectation is mid-Q3 2023.

2. Electronic Lure Noise

Since the introduction of the Steriline SafeChase lure system at Angle Park, GRSA have received feedback that the lure does not make enough noise to attract the dogs compare to the old, cable driven system. This feedback has been passed on to Steriline who have responded by designing an electronic lure 'squeaker' which will be integrated inside the lure housing.

The initial testing has been well received; therefore, they are now working on the pre-production electronic squeaker. Through the good relationships GRSA have built with the designers of the SafeChase system, we have been asked to help test this system and provide direct feedback from the participants to further improve the design.

Because this is still in the prototype phase, Steriline do not have a firm roll out date, but expectation is sometime within Q3 of 2023. GRSA will update this timing as we know more.



DASH OF BLUE

Greyhound of the Month for July was Dash Of Blue for trainer Richard Pearce, making it back to back awards for the son of My Redeemer and Dashing Dee Dee, but this time winning in his own right.

Dash Of Blue had three starts for the month winning all three races and going through the North V South Challenge undefeated. He started the month off with a super 30.56 win at Gawler over the 531m in round 1 of the North V South Challenge.

He won round 2 as well at Murray Bridge running 29.71 in winning by 8.50 lengths over 530m and then clean swept the series by winning the Final back at Gawler in 30.86 when he had to work hard for the win coming from just off the speed.

At the end of the month Dash Of Blue's record stood at 38 starts for 14 wins and 14 placings and earnings just under \$38,000.

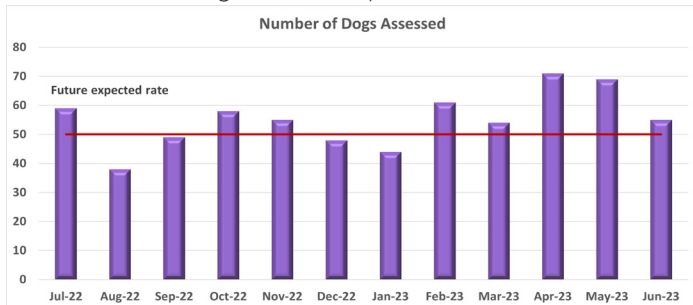

After racing up on speed he took over during the later part of the event to race away in a powerful performance. He smashed the previous track record by .31 second.

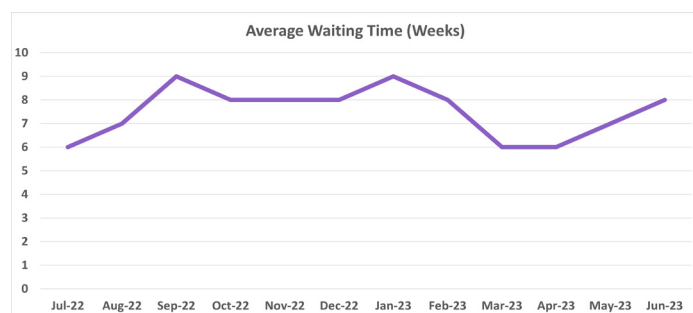
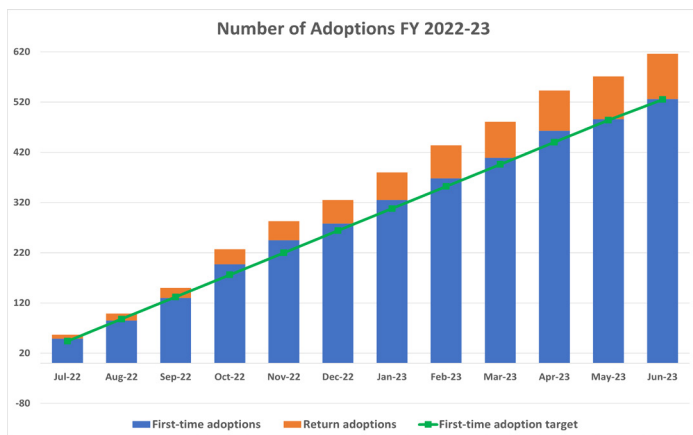
Latest updates from GAP

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

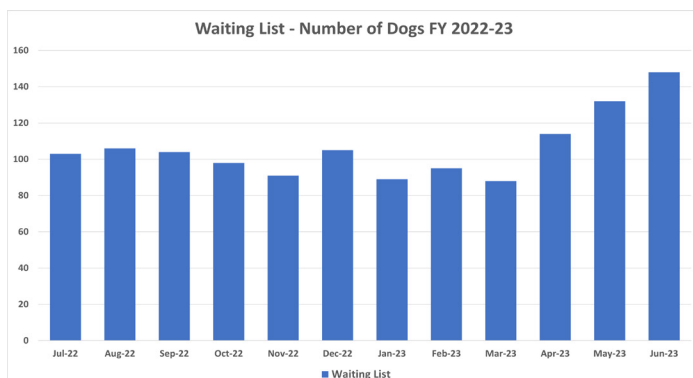

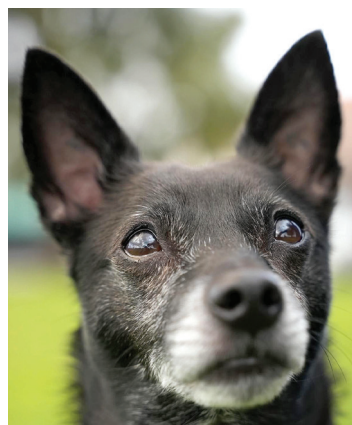
Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialed after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

Greyhound Racing SA advises that no Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) will be made for July 2023.

As participants are aware, the WAP calculation is based on the net wagering revenue generated each period. Wagering revenue for July 2023 was 8.6% lower in comparison to same month from the previous financial year. As listed in the calculation below total payments to participants exceeded the 50% WAP benchmark return and thus no payment will be made for July 2023.

GRSA will continue to monitor revenue trends closely and notes that this reduction in revenue is being felt across all racing jurisdictions. It is considered the reduction is an indication of the negative impact that high inflation and interest rates are having on the disposable incomes of the wagering public.

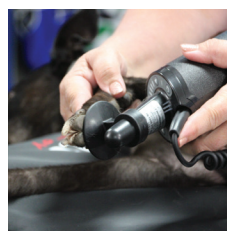

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

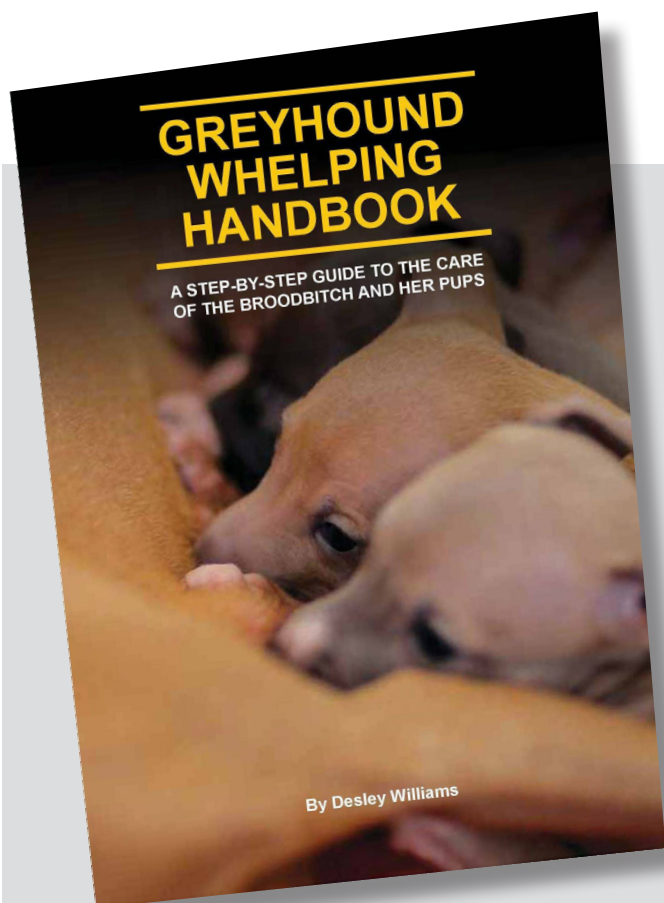
