2017 UBET National **Sprint and Distance Championships State Finals preview**

ANGLE PARK

Another fantastic night of racing at headquarters on the 3rd of August where the State Finals of the National Sprint and Distance were determined with the winners tonight to represent South Australia in Queensland at the end of the month.

The Sprint heats were first with High Eden Frost for Jan Jones setting the tempo of the night with a brilliant performance in leading most of the way. Making full use of the inside box the son of Banjo Boy and Zardae was able to kick through and lead and run his rivals ragged in a slick 29.78 winning by 3 lengths from Shimatron and Tommy's Tune.

The challenge was then set for leading local sprinter On Fire to see what he could do in the second heat and he didn't disappoint. The Cameron Butcher trained flyer began well from box 2 and settled third early before sprouting wings down the back straight and hitting the front, from there he also raced away to win in easy fashion. The son of Bekim Bale and Alana Blues won by just over 3 lengths in a sizzling 29.54 from Cairnlea Kenny and Aston Amon and firmly established himself again as the leading chance for SA.

The box draw has created even more interest with On Fire drawing the inside box. The last time he drew the red he was spat out the back in a 5 dog field and had to run a massive race to get over the line so the start will play a huge part in the high quality final on August 10th.

There were only 7 runners for the Distance heat with all starters progressing through to tonights State Final however it gave an indication on what we could expect. Purpose Driven for Cameron Butcher was very professional in his win running a solid 43.51 in winning by just over 3 lengths. The son of Bekim Bale and Alana Blues has been in super form and showed that he will be hard to beat tonight and will hopefully be looking to join his brother, On Fire at the National Championships. However race favourite Bogie Bekim who was returning from a spell showed he will likely gain plenty of benefit from the run. The Group 1 winner for Ben Rawlings ran a solid second but never really changed gears throughout which is normally a feature of this brilliant stayer. If he finds his customary dash and acceleration, we are in for a thrilling final. Not to forget about Springvale Carla who made the step up to the Open staying ranks with super run to grab third. Gavin Harris can always find a good stayer and it looks like he has found another one.

Rhynstone Teddy looks a champion in the making

ANGLE PARK

The Champion Puppy Final was held at Angle Park on the 20th July with an outstanding field of young chasers gathered together with Paula Hearnden qualifying half the field for the prestigious event.

There were four clear favourites in the market with the Petar Jovanovic trained Cairnlea Gump out of the 1 box, race favourite Rhynstone Teddy for Stuart Ellis next door to him, while the popular pick from the Hearnden kennel was Long Gully Pete in the 5 and the Con Haagmans trained Cooper Scooper was also well in the market despite drawing the pink.

The race began with Long Gully Helen spearing to the front from box 4 closely followed by kennel mate Long Gully Pete and Cairnlea Gump who was pushing up on the inside. Rhynstone Teddy was average away and lobbed midfield while Cooper Scooper bombed the start and was back last early. As the greyhounds raced down the back straight Long Gully Helen was still giving plenty of cheek but was coming under pressure from her rivals while both Rhynstone Teddy and Cooper Scooper began



to make ground. As heads turned for home Long Gully Pete had the better of his kennel mate and ran to the front looking all over the winner with Cairnlea Gump in hot pursuit while Rhynstone Teddy moved to the outside and began to sprout wings. As the top line up of young chasers charged to the finish line Rhynstone Teddy bloused Long Gully Pete right on the line in a stirring finish, winning by a head in a solid 30.15. "Pete" was brave in defeat while Cairnlea Gump was close up in third. Cooper

Scooper gave an eye catching performance in making up many lengths over the final 200m to finish in 4th position only 3 ½ lengths away from the winner.

Rhynstone Teddy is by Paw Licking out of Pearls' Bonnie and was locally bred by Paul Bodsworth. He is owned and trained by Stuart Ellis, giving Stuart one of his biggest wins of his career. Rhynstone Teddy has now won 5 races from his 9 lifetime starts including 3 minor placings and prizemoney of just over \$13,000.

Gawler Show dates and changes

August means that it is coming up to Gawler Show time, so some Gawler meetings will be transferred to Strathalbyn and Angle Park this year.

This year the Annual Gawler Show will be held on the weekend of Saturday 26th and Sunday 27th August. Racing on Sunday night 27th August will be at Strathalbyn. Racing on Tuesday 29th August will be at Angle Park with this meeting being an Angle Park Provincial (APD) fixture with normal Tuesday prizemoney and will be raced with the Finish On Lure.

Racing on Friday 27th August will be at Mount Gambier.

Trials will be cancelled at Gawler on Wednesday 23rd August and Thursday 24th August due to the Show preparations. We will hopefully have the track ready to trial again on Wednesday 30th August, but this will be dependent on the weather over the show weekend. There will be trials at Angle Park on Tuesday 22nd August and on Saturday 26th August.





On Fire makes it a hat-trick of monthly awards



Greyhound of the Month for July was again the Cameron Butcher trained On Fire who made it three in a row for the monthly awards.

It was quite a bit tougher this month with the likes of Whispering Soul,

Rhynstone Teddy, Dream A Little, Striker Klinsman and Purpose Driven all challenging however the son of Bekim Bale and Alana Blues was given the nod by the judges. On Fire had 4 starts at headquarters in Free For All company with three wins and a second. He was amazing when coming from last to win early in the month running 30.01 and then

blitzed his rivals in a sizzling 29.56. He backed that up with a 29.74 win before his run of 13 consecutive wins came to an end at the hands of High Eden Frost when he was far from disgraced in running second.

At the end of the month On Fire's record stands at 43 starts with 27 wins and 12 placings with earnings around \$105,000.

The Run of the Month for July was again awarded to the Cameron Butcher trained On Fire but this time it wasn't about the time that he ran but the amazing performance he put up to win.

In a 5 dog field it seemed to be just a procession for the Cameron Butcher flyer on Thursday 6th July however after an okay beginning from box 1, the star chaser got shuffled back to last and then was checked.

His \$1.20 starting price all of a sudden looked like 20/1! Greyhounds seldom recover from that kind of early interference however he balanced up and began to make ground in a high quality field. Turning for home



On Fire was powering home and swooped upon his rivals to go on and win by 1 length in a solid 30.01. The

performance was definitely one not to be missed and not surprisingly was voted the best for July.

Coffex Coffee SA Oaks & BGC Industrial **Cleaning Supplies SA Derby**

Owners and trainers are reminded that the Oaks & Derby at Angle Park are fast approaching. A reminder to trainers about the eligibility and conditions of both these series which has our races listed as one of the few AGRA Age Restricted Classics for the season.

The whelping date of both the Oaks and Derby is for greyhounds whelped 27 months prior to the heats so to be eligible for both series your greyhound will have to be whelped on or after 1st June 2015. The other requirement is that Maidens are ineligible so your greyhound has to have won a race. The series are two week series with Open Heats and a Final. The Dates are:

Coffex Coffee Oaks (Group 3):

\$4,590 Heats x 8 – Thursday 7th September \$35,000 Final - Thursday 14th September

• Nominations close Monday 4th September at 9.00am.

BGC Industrial Cleaning Supplies SA Derby (Group 3):

\$4,590 Heats x 8 - Thursday 14th September \$35,000 Final - Thursday 21st September

2017 SA Country Cup

Below are details of how and where greyhounds can qualify for the \$7,375 SA Country Cup Final, to be run at Angle Park over 515 metres on Adelaide Cup Final night Friday 13th October 2017.

Conditions:

• All South Australian Greyhound Racing Clubs outside of Angle Park will conduct heats, or nominate greyhounds from which the Greyhound Racing SA Grading Department will choose two representatives. These meetings are Gawler Provincial 2, Strathalbyn Provincial 2, Mount Gambier Provincial 2 and Port Augusta Country. (Performances at Gawler Provincial 1 meetings are not eligible for consideration)

The event is open to all South Australian greyhounds that are not above Grade 5 at Angle Park (APK City A & APM City B meetings only) over 515 metres at the time of nomination. Winner of each event takes a penalty including the final.

Special Exceptions:

Mount Gambier and Port Augusta Clubs are allowed to include non-South Australian trainers under strict conditions:

- The trainer has had starters at 5 meetings for Pt Augusta and 15 meetings for Mt Gambier in the previous 12 months.
- The trainer can only qualify for one of the clubs.
- The trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 3 months.
 - · Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.
 - The greyhound must be SA trained (except Mount Gambier & Port Augusta as above).
 - o A South Australian trained greyhound is defined as one that has been racing in SA for a period of not less than 3 out of the 6 months immediately prior to the time of nomination.
 - The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track it is attempting to represent.
 - There will be a maximum of two heats per Club with the winners of each heat qualifying. If there is only one heat conducted then the first two placegetters will qualify.
 - The two reserves will be determined firstly by a ballot of the second placegetters from all heats. The third placegetters will then be considered by ballot if required. If a heat was not conducted at the track, then that track is not included in the ballot. Should a are vhound be withdrawn prior to the ballot, the next placed greyhound from that Club's heat will be selected.
 - Once a greyhound has qualified from a Qualifying Heat, it is not eligible to compete at another track in this series, unless there are insufficient nominations to fill the field.
 - Once qualified for the Country Cup Final the greyhound will be ineligible for the Adelaide Cup series or any other race on this Cup Final night.

Kings and Queens Feature later this month

GRSA introduced the Kings and Queens Feature series this year with Heats on Thursday 31st August and a \$6,000 Final on Thursday 7th September in support of those greyhounds affected by the change to the AGRA Age Restricted Classics from 30 months back down to 27 months for this year's Oaks and Derby.

The eligibility for this series is for dogs and bitches whelped between 1st March 2015 and 31st May 2015.

Performed Maidens are eligible (raced or qualy trialled).

It will be dependent upon nominations, however we would like to run a dogs heat and a bitches heat separately with greyhounds qualifying into the final. If there are not sufficient nominations for either sex then these heats may be mixed as a one off heat into a final or a couple of mixed heats. Special conditions apply however these races will be non-penalty.

Nominations close Monday 28th August at 9.00am with GRSA.



As part of the 2015 Greyhound Auction there is one more series to take place.

This series will have heats on Monday 18th September with the \$5,000 final on Monday 25th September over the 515m. This series is for those greyhounds sold through the 2015 Greyhound Auction.

MYOZCHASE INTRODUCTION

In June GRSA went Live with MyOzChase which provides an easy way for participants in the Greyhound Racing Industry to perform transactions online that previously had to be completed manually via paper-based Forms.

The portal available on the GRSA website will also improve communications between participants and Greyhound Racing Controlling Bodies.

MyOzChase will initially be offering the following functionality to users who register, obtain a log-in and complete a once-off identity verification prior to transacting online with their Controlling Body:

- Online updates of personal details
- View all their associated greyhounds (as an Owner, Trainer, Custodian, etc.)
- Submit Notifications of Retirement for greyhounds
- Submit Trainership and/or Kennel changes for greyhounds (replacing the current Kennel Notification or Notice of Training / Removal Form) *Please note should you wish to transfer a previous Victorian trained greyhound into your kennel you will need to do this via the Online Nomination portal.

Breeders support updates

In September last year in response to inquiries about the changes to the Breeders Support Program taking affect in April 2016 Greyhound Racing SA advised the changes below.

These changes are in support of breeder viability and continues increased spending on animal welfare and integrity initiatives.

Changes listed below:

Breeder Support Program

The following changes to the Breeder Support Program have been implemented:

- 1. Combined claim limit of \$800 for all veterinary and transport expenses
- 2. Removal of the advanced application process for the breeders rebate now that both sires and

breeding females must be registered

3. Removal of the cap on litters in anticipation of national (tiered) breeder licensing

SA Bred Maiden Payment

The SA bred maiden payment rewards participants that get a greyhound to the track to win a race. GRSA

has committed to dramatically increase this payment from \$175 to \$1,000 (\$500 breeder/\$500 owner)

on 1st July, 2017. This will result in all greyhounds that are whelped in 2016 being eligible for this support. (GRSA will back date any payments missed over the last few months)

2017 AGRC/GRSA Greyhound Auction on 29th October

The Greyhound Auction will again be held in October 2017 to be conducted on Sunday 29th October.

Nomination Forms for the Auction will be sent out shortly to Breeders/Owners and will be available from GRSA. The closing date is 4pm on Friday 18th August 2017. The conditions have changed from last year due to breeding numbers and processes.

The main changes are -

- Extension of dates for eligible pups increased to 1st October 16 to 30th June 17
- This will be a Reserve Auction with the vendor to pay commission on Reserve price if passed in to be eligible for the Race Series.

Whelping Dates: 1st October 2016 to 30th June 2017

Entry Fee: \$50 per pup (non-refundable)

Commission: 11%

Minimum Upset Price: \$500 Fees to Enter Race Series: Nil

Race Series Dates: June 2019 (Greyhounds 23-32 mths old)

Race Series Stakes: 1st- \$16,000, 2nd-\$5,000, 3rd-\$2,500, Unpl- \$500 (if more than 50 pups)

Breeder/Nominator Bonuses: 1st-\$3,500, 2nd-\$2,500,

3rd- \$1,500 (if more than 50 pups)

Special Conditions:

- Greyhounds purchased through the auction that are not SA Bred will be allowed the same grading exemptions in regards to Grade 6 and Juvenile races as locally bred greyhounds
- The main race series Heats and Final are scheduled for June 2019. One month before (May) there will be a Wednesday 388m series with Heats and Final for pups sold at the auction. There will also be a Wednesday heats 515m and Final Thursday night 515m held in July the month after the main race series



Grading Review Panel – Friday 1st September

The next Grading Review Panel will be held on Friday 2nd September.

The panel will be mainly concentrating on Time Grading and Pathway Racing so if participants will like to provide submissions for the Agenda please do so by Friday 18th August. Please email shaun.mathieson@grsa.com.au with submissions.

Trial dates for Strathalbyn

All bookings for normal trials will be taken by the Club. As they do on Wednesday nights they will now also take the bookings for Friday nights.

You can book trials via text MSG / or call Yvonne King at the Club on 0407 334 349 between 9am and 11am on the day of the trials. All qualifying trials will need to be booked through GRSA as per normal by 12.30pm on the day of the Qualy trials. GRSA thanks the support of Yvonne and the Strathalbyn GRC in regard to these changes. Please note there will be no qualifying trials in August due to the increased racing at the venue.

Like Tuesday night, these will be timeslots giving participants guaranteed bookings and allowing a smoother process.



Chief Steward appointment

GRSA has recently appointment Des Jonas to the position of Chief Steward.

Des has a long association as a thoroughbred racing Steward and has been part of the GRSA Stewards panel for several months.

Inquiries and notifications

Mr. Stephen Bartholomew – Stewards inquiry 26/07/17 – GAR 83 (2) – Failed to present the greyhound HARSHLY JUDGED free of any prohibited substance (ARSENIC) for an event at Mount Gambier on 19 February 2017. Mr. Bartholomew pleaded guilty and was suspended for a period of four (4) months; wholly suspended for 24 months on the condition he does not re-offend under the same Rule and was fined \$1,500. HARSHLY JUDGED was disqualified from the event.

Mr. Tim Dunn – Stewards inquiry 19/07/17 – GAR 86(p) – Disobeyed the lawful order of an official at the Angle Park race meeting on 29/06/17. Mr. Dunn was found guilty and was fined \$250.

Mr. Tony Rasmussen – Stewards inquiry 15/06/17 and 24/07/17 – GAR 86(o) – Misconduct in relation to an inappropriate comment towards another trainer at the Angle Park race meeting on 15/0517. Mr. Rasmussen pleaded guilty and was fined \$200; as well as \$200 activated from a previous offence under this Rule.

Mr. Neil Rawlings / Mr. Matthew Lehman – Stewards inquiry 05/06/17 and 18/07/17 – Misconduct in they both engaged in a verbal altercation at the Angle Park race meeting on 18/05/17. Mr. Rawlings pleaded guilty and was fined \$400. Mr. Lehman pleaded guilty and was fined \$400.

Mr. Donald Turner – Stewards inquiry 14/07/17 – GAR 100 – Breached the Rules prescribed whilst serving a period of disqualification. Mr. Turner's disqualification of four (4) months was backdated to recommence from 01/05/17.

Mr. David Williams – Stewards inquiry 20/07/17 – GAR 86(f) (iv) – Contemptuous and improper behaviour towards the on track Veterinary Surgeon at the Mount Gambier race meeting on 30/07/17. Mr. Williams pleaded guilty and was fined \$250.

The Golden Rules

Avoidance of Prohibited Substance Breaches

In noting that we have seen recent Cobalt and Arsenic threshold breaches, it serves as a timely opportunity for GRSA to remind participants – in their own best interests – that there are a number of Golden Rules that can help them to avoid making any such breaches (for prohibited substances generally) and which should be adhered to as principles of best practice:

- Always consult your vet to seek guidance in relation to any of the products that you are using, any associated risks, and other relevant context
- Review the range of any feeds or supplements that you typically purchase and, wherever it is reasonable to do so, replace products containing substances that could contribute to a threshold breach under the rules (eg. cobalt) with alternative products
- Observe the instructions on any products that you use and adhere strictly to those directions (having regard for prescribed amounts, frequency of administration/application, methodology for administering/applying)
- Refrain from the use of injectable treatments (eg. Vitamin B12) to any extent that is practical
- Refrain from any treatment of a greyhound on raceday other than as relates to its feeding and drinking requirements (GAR83(a)(1) treats this as a specific offence)

Our registered participants have the ultimate responsibility to ensure that greyhounds are presented free of prohibited substances. This information is offered as advice in good faith only and should not be relied upon as a defence in the event of a breach being recorded.

These Golden Rules will appear in the Integrity section of future Kennel Capers editions on an ongoing basis as a reminder for participants of this responsibility.

ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS - NOW WEEKLY

Angle Park Qualifying Trials are run weekly on Tuesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting and the Wednesday APD meeting. Trainers must be specific on their nominations about which day they are trialling for and what distance. (ie Wed 388m, Mon 515, Mon 600m etc)

Tuesday Angle Park Qualifying dates are:

August 15th (No Trials)

August 22nd (for APM Monday meeting on 28th August – for APD Wednesday meeting on 30th August)

August 29th (for APM Monday meeting on 4th September – for APD Wednesday meeting on 6th September)

September 5th (for APM Monday meeting on 11th September – for APD Wednesday meeting on 13th September)

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Tuesday of the meeting.

NOMINATING ONLINE FOR QUALIFYING TRIALS

For Angle Park, Gawler and Strathalbyn qualifying trials the nominations must be lodged with GRSA by 12.30pm on the day of the meeting. To nominate online however you can only do this up until 11.59pm the day before. Due to a system security policy you cannot nominate on the day for these trials online. Please contact our staff if you have any issues with these nominations prior to them closing.

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number.

POLICY FOR TRIALS IN PLACE

Remember trials will only be taken from -

- * 12.30pm Monday for Angle Park Tuesday nights
- * 12.30pm Tuesday for Gawler Wednesday nights
- * 12.30pm Thursday for Angle Park Saturday morning (day earlier due to being morning trials)
- * For Public Holidays it will be the working day before ie if Monday is a Public Holiday then bookings taken on the Friday

trial days that are not booked in with GRSA remain the same process (ie Gawler Thursday)

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK AND GAWLER BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

RACE MEETING TRIAL POLICY

Angle Park Monday & Wednesday along with Gawler Tuesday, Friday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the Race Meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than 8 greyhounds nominated.

- 1. Reserves at the Meeting that do not obtain starts.
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located in an area affected by track closures.
- 3. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged.
- 4. Satisfactory trials.
- 5. Other greyhounds.

PROCEDURE/CRITERIA

- 1. For Monday nights trainer to contact GRSA between 10.00am and 11.00am on the Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching line.
- 2. For Angle Park Wednesday, Gawler Tuesday & Friday trainer to contact GRSA between 4.00pm and 4.30pm on the day before.
- 3. For Gawler Sunday trainer to contact GRSA between 8.00am and 9.00am on the scratching line to nominate.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds Trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards allot the Box for the Greyhound.
- 6. Trials will be 515m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension or not cleared to race are not eligible to be nominated (these trials are conducted as if they are at a race meeting so all greyhounds need to be eligible at nomination time).
- Greyhound registration certificate or cards must be produced at kennelling time.

 Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilize the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave OR trainers with no other greyhounds will be free to leave following their trial.

If there are 12 races at Angle Park or Gawler there will be NO trials.

The Vet Clinic at these meetings cannot be used to accommodate any greyhounds to allow for extra trialling greyhounds. This policy has been introduced so that participants book in under the policy. The Vet Clinic needs to be available for the Vet and Stewards at race meetings

EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY-

- Thursday nights are kept available for the option for Interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead up to our Group races and also local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead up
 to a feature race upon request and they will take one of
 the eight kennels available for trialling ahead of the policy
 and sit separately to the 4 dog trials. Feature races are
 considered to be Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks,
 Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA
 Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country
 Cup, National Finals & any Group race Interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event and nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy.
- If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between this will be conducted as a solo trial and sit separately to the 2 four dog trials.

It is extremely important that trainers book in to trial at these race meetings. If unable to book in at these times then please contact GRSA where permission may be given to accept a booking outside of these times. .

GAWLERQUALIFYING TRIALS AT GAWLER

Qualifying trials are held every Wednesday for the corresponding Tuesday.

MURRAY BRIDGE

Trials are held on SUNDAY MORNINGS, from 9am to 10.30 am. Bookings MUST be sent via Telephone to Kay Burns 0437 497 554 or Bob Harris 0410 668 682 or email to burnsron1@bigpond.com. If there are no bookings there will be no trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER

The Mt Gambier GRC committee advises that satisfactory trials can be run in the summer months under the criteria below.

- 1. On race days when there are less than 12 races.
- On race days with 12 races when the temperature is 30 degrees or less trial can be run before the first race but greyhounds must leave the track straight after the trial to head back to their home kennel.
- 3. On a Saturday trial session when stewards are available.


ANGLE PARK VET SURGERY
