Springvale Max claims 2022 Howard Ashton

ANGLE PARK

One of the highlights of racing at headquarters in May was the running of the Group 3 Howard Ashton Final which saw a wonderful field of locally bred sprinters assembled with Springvale Max trained by Gavin Harris charging home late to claim the \$25,000 first prize.

Springvale Max was sent out a clear second favourite from box 6 with hot pot He's All Purpose starting a short priced favourite from the inside draw. Both greyhounds have been in terrific form and many believed they would fight out the feature classic which is how the race panned out. As the start was affected He's All Purpose began brilliantly as expected and led clearly to the first turn with My Mum's Value for Robert Barclay moving up strongly into second. Springvale Rex for Gavin Harris, Black Cobra for John Sargent and Mo Slater for Wendy Sebastyan were all in a line challenging for third while Springvale Max was looking to slot in just behind this group along the rails as they left the front straight. Into the back straight and He's All Purpose was leading by just under a length from My Mum's Value who was sticking with him while Springvale Max and Black Cobra battled out third however Springvale Max had found his way to the rails and began to make good ground along the paint. Off the back straight and He's All Purpose finally snuck away from My Mum's Value who was doing his best, however, the big danger loomed with Springvale Max running to a clear third with the leader well in his sights. Turning for home and as most thought it developed into a two-dog race with He's All Purpose trying to hold of the charging Springvale Max who was railing hard. Into the front straight and the run came for Springvale Max who charged through to claim a brilliant win in a flying 30.42. He's All Purpose was brave in defeat 3/4 length away with Springvale Rex getting home well for third just ahead of My Mum's Value.

The feature race is named in honour of GCA Hall of Fame member, Howard Ashton. Howard was instrumental in the professional running of Greyhound Racing in South Australia for many, many years as an Administrator of the Industry. He started his journey at Angle Park where he managed a number of roles locally along with positions nationally as the Executive Officer of GCA.

South Australia has only two other inductees in the GCA Hall of Fame, Brian Johnstone and Doug Payne, who also have races named in their honour.





Grosso adds another feature final to resume

In front of a handy crowd at Angle Park, Victa Grosso for trainer Tony Rasmussen landed another feature race win when he won the prestigious Shane McQueen Feature Final on June 2nd. The son of Fernando Bale and Victa Victoria has been a model of consistency in feature events and added the premier middle distance victory to his Group 3 Gawler Cup win back in October last year.

After winning his Heat the previous week he was sent out a strong second favourite behind interstate raider, Starlight Tyson for Janet Cottrell, with another interstate visitor, Spanish Miss for Diane Ireland on the third line of betting with Spring Harbour for Ben Rawlings.

As the start was affected most thought Starlight Tyson would show sufficient speed to cross to the lead from box 4, however, he showed terrific speed but so did Victa Grosso who drove hard from box 2 to hold out Starlight Tyson in the drive to the winning post on the first occasion. The two market leaders already opened up a gap to the chasing pack with Spring Harbour, Danyo's Mercy for Lauren Harris and Spanish Miss challenging for third spot. Into the back straight and Starlight Tyson had a slight advantage, however, Victa Grosso continued to drive hard to his inside and shortly after assumed control of the lead. Spring Harbour was holding down third with Spanish Miss getting to the inside and making good ground with the remainder of the field too far back to challenge for the placings.

Off the back straight and in a twinkling of the eye Victa Grosso accelerated away and opened up a 2 length break from Starlight Tyson who was doing his best to hang on to the leader while Spring Harbour and Spanish Miss were battling out third spot. Into the front straight and Victa Grosso had taken full control of the event and raced away for a 4 length win in a blistering 34.06 for the 595m journey from Starlight Tyson who just held second in front of a late finishing burst from Spanish Miss.

The race is named in honour of ex GRSA CEO, Shane McQueen who was a terrific greyhound administrator in WA and SA until his untimely passing in 2003.

LOW GRADE FEATURE SERIES AT ANGLE PARK

The next Low Grade Feature Series at Angle Park will be a Masters Mixed series over the 530m with \$3,585 Heats on Thursday, 7th July with the \$5,150 Final on Thursday, 14th July.

• Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 4th July at 9.00am.

SATURDAY TO THURSDAY NIGHT FINALS AT ANGLE PARK

Once a fortnight GRSA will run Heats on the Saturday morning meeting at Angle Park, where they will be either (1-4 wins or 5+ wins) over the 530m.

The Heats and Finals will be 6 dog fields and non penalty. The Final will be conducted as Race 1 on the Thursday night.

The next of these will be for Saturday, 25th June for 5+ wins with the Final on Thursday, 30th June.

 Nominations for Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Wednesday, 22nd June.

INDUSTRY CONSULTATIVE GROUP MEETING THIS FRIDAY

The next ICG meeting will be held this Friday 17th June with the Agenda sent to the members earlier this week.

CLASSIC AND BREEDERS FUTURITY PAYMENTS – DUE ON FRIDAY 17TH JUNE

Owners of SA Bred greyhounds are reminded that the next batch of Futurity payments are due on Friday, 17th June 2022.

The payments due are:

Classic 2022 – Final Payment (Pups born July 20 to December 20)

This payment is for greyhounds for which the Second Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound.

Breeders 2023 – Second Payment (Pups born January 21 to June 21)

This payment is for greyhounds for which the First Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

Classic 2023 – First Payment (Pups born July 21 to December 21)

This First Payment is due for Classic 2023. All SA Bred greyhounds

born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. The First Payment is \$27.50 per pup or a "one-off" Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

To assist all owners of Futurity eligible pups, reminders were sent out the middle of last month. If you have sold a pup/s we would ask if you can forward on the information to the new owner.

LODGEMENT OF BREEDING DOCUMENTS

Recently we have had several breeding documentations lodged after the due date.

I remind participants of the due date for lodgement of documents under the Rules of Greyhound Racing. It is imperative that these documents are still lodged on time to enable GRSA to plan for the future regarding greyhound population.

Group 3 win highlights big month for Max

Greyhound of the Month for May was Springvale Max for trainer Gavin Harris, highlighted by his brilliant win in the Group 3 Howard Ashton Final in late May.

The locally owned and bred son of Barcia Bale and Springvale Bryne had four starts for the month with three wins and a second in a great month of racing. He started the month off with a solid second in a Breeders Prelude Final before he set himself for the Howard Ashton. He won his Heat by 6.50 lengths in 30.38 and then repeated the does in the Semi-Final winning by 3 lengths in 30.50. He started a strong second favourite in the Group 3 Final and produced a brilliant performance to chase down He's All Purpose in the shadows of the post to win by almost a length in 30.42.

At the end of the month Springvale Max's record stood at 38 starts for 19 wins and 10 placings and earnings around \$59,000.



A magic run claims May's Run of the Month Award

The Run of the Month for May was Mallee Magic for trainer Tony Rasmussen after his sensational performance at headquarters on Thursday, 5th May in a Mixed 2/3/4 where he went within .02 of the Angle Park track record.

After beginning brilliantly from box 4 he took up the earlier lead and from there was never challenged, racing away from his rivals to win by 6.50 lengths. He ran splits of 5.22 and 17.49 with the overall of 29.97 becoming only the second greyhound to break the 30 second barrier on the redeveloped Angle Park circuit.

GRADING REVIEW OUTCOMES

TIME BANDS FOR MASTERS AT ANGLE PARK

Since Angle Park has been redeveloped with the new distances of 342m, 530, 595m and 730m GRSA has not allocated any times for Masters events.

There subsequently has been sufficient racing at the venue for a time standard to be applied, which was approved at the most recent Grading Review Panel meeting.

The below time ratings for Masters events will now be implemented for meetings conducted from 1st July, 2022.

305M MASTERS AT MOUNT GAMBIER

Time band for Mount Gambier 305m Masters-

Previously GRSA had been using a policy for Masters events at Mount Gambier utilising the 277m distance, however, we had not adjusted this for the 305m until there was sufficient racing. At the most recent Grading Review Panel meeting it was decided to make the below changes and implement. The below policy will now be implemented for meetings conducted from 1st July 2022-

305m Masters Policy for Mount Gambier – With Mount Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events, however, factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week. The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.

TIME RATINGS FOR FIRST STARTERS

As previously advised, it is the intent for the Time Rating for first starters to be varied from 10 to 8 after the most recent Grading Review Panel meeting.

There needs to be a programming change in OzChase and at present this has not been finalised. GRSA will advise an implementation date once the changes are ready to take effect.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY AND NORMAL TRIALS – TIMING FOR BOOKINGS

Trainers are reminded of their requirements when booking Satisfactory Trials and normal trials at Mount Gambier. Mount Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays which need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

Normal trial bookings need to be done by 4pm the day before for both Wednesday and Saturday. They will not be accepted after this time. Effective immediately.

GRSA is working with the Club regarding an online trial booking system which would help the management of these normal trials.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.

2022 GAWLER BREEDERS HEATS ON JULY 1

After the Group 3 Howard Ashton Final last month the Gawler Breeders over 531m will be run on Friday, 1st and 8th July for those greyhounds that are eligible for Breeders 2022.

Please see the July issue of the All Tracks Calendar when released to confirm the closing date of nominations.

CHAMPION PUPPY IN JULY

The Champion Puppy series is for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st July 2020.

The Heats will be worth \$5,595 to be run on Thursday, 14th July with the Final worth \$14,275 to be run on Thursday, 21st July.

 Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Monday, 11th July

TRIAL DAYS FOR GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE

Gawler trial on Monday and Thursday mornings and there will be no rotation due to racing.

Murray Bridge will trial on Monday morning and will not trial on Thursday morning for the Straight Track. These are on Wednesday nights with the One Turn trial session. During non daylight saving Straight track trials will start at 4.30pm with the One Turn at 5.30pm. During Daylight saving the Straight track will start at 5.30pm with the One Turn 6.30pm.

Any changes to this will be advised to industry via text message and social media.

2022 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS IN NEW SOUTH WALES

The GCA National Championships are just around the corner. The National Finals this year will be held at Wentworth Park in NSW and are to be conducted on Saturday, 29th August.

Both the National Sprint and National Distance Finals will carry prizemoney of \$75,000 to the winner.

The State series' for SA will be held at Angle Park on Thursday, 4th August for the Sprint Heats over 530m with the State Final of the Sprint and one-off Final over 730m of the Distance on the 11th August.

In an effort to support this series ALL States will be conducting their Finals on the same night to be run within a two hour period.

• Nominations this year will close at the normal time with GRSA which will be at 9am on Monday, 1st August

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Wednesday, 18th May 2022. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

NATIONAL STRAIGHT TRACK CHAMPIONSHIPS ALSO IN NSW

The National Straight Track Championship this year will be held at Richmond on Saturday morning, 29th August —with the winner receiving \$25,000, so all the National Finals will be held on the same day.

This year SA will have two dogs represent the State in the series with QLD, NSW, VIC and SA challenging for the title.

To enable the Straight Track series to align with the circle and the other States our Heats will be held at Murray Bridge on Tuesday, 2nd August with our Final on Tuesday, 9th August. Prizemoney for the SA Straight track Final will be elevated to \$10,000 to the winner and align with the other three States.

It is important that trainers are aware that these series' for the circle and straight track are run at the same time so you need to be aware when nominating and the qualifying criteria.

• Nominations will close at the normal time with GRSA which will be at 9am on Thursday, 28th July

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Saturday, 14th May 2022. Once again, if unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS FOR MURRAY BRIDGE

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night at approximately 5.15pm (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials).

Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Tuesday).

NOMINATIONS FOR SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Recently we have had several trainers nominating online using the Qualifying Trial meeting for Satisfactory Trials.

The online Qualifying Trial meetings are for trainers to nominate their greyhound which they wish to improve on the Order of Choice for the upcoming meeting only. Trainers, whom have a greyhound that is required to complete a Satisfactory Trial, are required to contact the offices of GRSA and provide the relevant details. By contacting the office, you will be advised of any further requirements that are needed for the Satisfactory Trial.

GOTBA COURSING DATES

GOTBA at Virginia Coursing dates until the end of their season have been released.

Sunday June 19, July 3, July 17, August 14, August 28, September 11, September 25 and October 9.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED "ONLY"

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their Grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

DAISH IRRIGATION & FODDER VOUCHERS FOR MURRAY BRIDGE

The Murray Bridge GRC has secured some \$100 vouchers from their sponsor Daish Irrigation & Fodder to be used on Heat and Final series' over the next 12 months.

In the All Tracks calendar these races will be highlighted which is a terrific initiative of the Murray Bridge GRC.

Breeders Support Program – important update from July 1

At the most recent ICG meeting our local breeding numbers were discussed. After considering how many litters are currently being bred, the panel decided to make an alteration to how many Breeder Rebates will be available each financial year.

For any Breeder Rebate application lodged (at Litter Registration time) from July 1 2022 to June 30 2023, GRSA will only rebate two Litters fully and if there is a third litter, this will be at a half price rebate. If a Breeder has a fourth litter there will be no claim available. It will be up to the Breeder to determine which 2½ Litters they would like the Breeders Support Claim for in the 12 month period. Please contact Racing Manager, Shaun Mathieson at GRSA for further information.

Below are the current Breeders Support Conditions -

Details regarding the Breeders Support Program for litters registered in SA. It is crucial that GRSA receives receipts for actual and verifiable expenses relating to litters whelped for items below or else no support payment can be provided: Claims will be a Maximum of \$2,000 with FSI and Pup payment in addition.

Stud/Sire Fee 50%, up to \$2,000 rebate (Commercial) (receipts required)

Owned Sire Fee Set amount of \$250

This section maximum of \$2,000

Veterinary & Transport Costs Maximum \$800 (receipts required)

Vaccination Costs \$60 (per pup)

The limit of the support as it relates to the [50%] contribution to the stud/sire fee component is equivalent to the full support value of \$2,000. The limit of the support as it relates to 'other' expenses is \$1,000. Excluded expenses include veterinary [preconception], rearing, breaking in or pre-training costs.

GRSA online trial booking system FAQs

Below are details regarding the Trial Booker process. GRSA is working at getting all tracks in SA on the online booking process to assist with clubs, staff and participants at trial sessions.

Below is examples provided a few years ago so the dates and distances will have changed, however, will give industry a good idea when they log on to the Trial Booker which they can do through the GRSA website.

How do I register an account to book public trials online?

Visit www.trialbooker.com, click on the "register an account" link and fill in the appropriate details.

How do I book a specific trial online?

To book 4 trials, click Book 4:



As soon as you have pressed the Book button, those trials are booked and yours to keep. You then customise the distance, number of dogs, and type for each trial, and confirm them

Field Trials

Existing field trials will appear in each block. To book a dog in an existing field trial simply click the Book 1/2/3 button.



If there are no available field trials of the distance and type you require then feel free to create one yourself. Simply book a slot as-per-normal and select Maiden Field or Performed Field, as shown below.



Note: booking a dog or several dogs in a field trial counts as 1 trial towards your 4 trial maximum.

When do trial bookings commence each week?

Bookings for meetings will commence at 11.30am the working day prior to the trial session [henceforth known as "booking opening time"].

Is there a limit to how many trials I can book online?

Yes: 4. If you wish to reserve more than 4 trials a session then you must phone the office as per normal. For example, in the screenshot below, it indicates that you can book 3 more trials using TrialBooker without phoning.

Why am I limited to 4 trials in one block?

Can I cancel a trial booking online? Yes: Press the X button and confirm

Will I receive a confirmation to confirm my online trial booking?

Your trials are reserved for you as soon as you press the "Book 4" button (or "Book 4" or whichever it may be). You must then confirm the details of those trials (distance, number of dogs etc.). There will be a summary of your bookings in each session on the Home page.

Can I book trials for other licensees? No—under no circumstances may you book trials for anyone other than yourself using TrialBooker. Dogs must be brought in and paid for by the person whose name they were booked under. If you wish to share a non-field trial with another trainer you must book over the phone.


How can I book a trial if I don't have access to a computer?

You can still book trials by calling the office after booking opening time.

Time grading rating available online

Time Ratings for greyhounds are now displayed online when trainers go to nominate a greyhound. It is displayed in the area the grades of the dogs are displayed.

This will allow trainers a clear understanding of their greyhounds rating prior to nominating for a Time Graded meeting.



Online scratchings now available

A reminder to trainers that scratchings out of drawn race meetings is available through the OzChase system. This provides flexibility for trainers during their busy schedules. Trainers can still phone scratching's through as normal.

Once a scratching has been lodged, GRSA will consider this greyhound as requiring to be removed and will be published as soon as received on the next work day.


Any Late Scratching's cannot be made via online and will have to be phoned through to the stewards.

Please see right for the process of making a scratching via OzChase -

To request that a greyhound is scratched from a race, a trainer can select the 'Scratch Greyhound' action.

A greyhound can be selected from the dropdown on the screen. Once selected, the details related to this greyhound (ear brands, certificate number and microchips) will be displayed.

The meeting list presented to the trainer for selection will show those meetings where the selected greyhound has been allocated as a runner or reserve. If the greyhound has multiple starts at the meeting, then all races for this greyhound will be listed against the appropriate meeting entry.



The email notification sent to the Trainer and Grader will list the meeting and race details as shown in the example below:

LOCAL RULE AMENDMENTS – DISCIPLINARY PROCESS

At its meeting on 2 June 2022, the GRSA Board approved amendments to Division 22 of the Local Rules.

Historically, serious breaches of the rules of racing were always referred to the Integrity Hearings Panel (IHP). With the amendments, some breaches of the Local Rules that are still considered serious can now be heard by Stewards. The effect is that Stewards now have the full range of penalties available to them. This will streamline the disciplinary process and free up the IHP to hear those matters considered sufficiently serious for the panel to hear and determine.

RULE AMENDMENTS

It is vital that you keep up to date with the rules of racing that are available on the GRSA website.

A claim of not knowing a rule is not a defence when the rule is publicly available. Below is a summary of some very important amendments -

Local Rules

Part 3 is the new concept of penalty notices. From now, some offences under the rules of racing will be dealt with on the spot by penalty notice. The penalty notice allows a fine up to \$499.00 payable in 14 days or via a payment plan. Like police expiation notices, if you dispute the notice, you can elect to have the breach dealt with by an inquiry, but note an inquiry is not limited to just fines. Also, if Stewards or Welfare Officers are of the opinion the breach is serious enough that a fine is not adequate, they can elect to issue an on-the-spot inquiry notice. An on-the-spot inquiry notice allows the option to suspend greyhounds or people, pending the determination of an inquiry.

Part 4 outlines the matters that GRSA consider for registration – suitability matters. This includes a fit and proper person test to make it clear what GRSA use to assess all new, renewing and variations to registration. Please note the requirements to produce a current police check.

Part 5 introduces a right of review and amalgamates several review processes that GRSA presently use.

The following are some other key changes to the local rules –

- L5 new general offence of contravene requirement of a GRSA officer.
- L29 amended identification and location of inactive greyhounds (so GRSA may require a person in possession of a greyhound to update GRSA on the greyhound (e.g. racing or breeding greyhounds)).

- L35 confirming greyhounds must be kept by registered persons and on registered premises (e.g. only an appropriately licenced person can keep or train a greyhound).
- L36 new rules dealing with greyhounds of a deceased estate (to allows GRSA to temporarily house greyhounds with relatives or other registered persons, while the early stages of the estate are sorted out).
- L38 confirming notices of whelping must include all pups whelped (this is to make clear that all pups, even still-born, must be recorded at this time to assist with GRSA data matching processes throughout the life cycle of greyhounds of that litter).
- L47- new, specific offence of being disorderly on a racecourse or premises of a club (this is in addition to any breach under GAR 86).
- L90 confirming power of GRSA to require further details about matters relating to greyhound racing (before and during an inquiry, for example, further information to process notifications lodged under GAR 106.. These types of requests are now requirements).
- L92- new facilitation of proof provisions to make IHP hearings more efficient (for example, without challenge, GRSA can prove a prohibited substance is listed as such. This provision can be rebutted under election by the registered person).
- L94 new guiding principles to be considered on penalty (to assist panels to consider the relevant factors for and against a registered person).
- L100 confirming reasonable time for disqualified person to transfer greyhound (out of their custody should they become disqualified).
- L130 revised rehoming obligations (including notice of intention to euthanise that is presently part of the Animal Welfare Policy 2021)
- L131 new, serious offence of ill treatment of greyhound.
- L132 new offence of threaten detriment to greyhound.

KENNEL HOUSE WHITE BOARDS

White boards have been placed at prominent positions inside the kennel houses at Angle Park, Gawler and Murray Bridge.

Stewards will make note on these boards of all greyhounds required to undergo a post-race Veterinary examination or Participants who are required by Stewards. Participants are directed to view the whiteboard and seek clearance from Stewards [in the Stewards Room] prior to leaving the race meeting if you or your greyhound's name is on the board. Please do not ask kennel house staff. Failure to obtain clearance from Stewards may result in you having to return to the track if required.

SATISFACTORY TRIAL POLICY

GRSA's Satisfactory Trial Policy has been updated to reflect the new rules and revised race distances at Angle Park.

There have also been minor adjustments made to qualifying times at Mt Gambier. The policy can be viewed on the following page and on the GRSA website.

DRESS CODE

Stewards remind participants to comply with the GRSA Dress Code printed below. All elements of the code must be adhered to, but your attention is directed to the highlighted text below:

Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) is committed to upholding the Rules of greyhound racing.

GRSA has a dress code policy for all persons parading greyhounds. The dress code is to be complied with at all GRSA TAB race meetings.

Dress Code is as follows:

- Black pants, black dress jeans or black dress chinos.
- Black enclosed shoes (all black).
- Black or navy jumper
- Collared white shirt
- White polo shirt
- GRSA polo shirt
- GRSA black shorts black socks and shoes must be worn with shorts
- Approved head wear GRSA baseball caps or GRSA beanie.

Trousers, etc., must not be faded or torn and must have regular cuffs (no elastic cuffs).

No cargo pants, tracksuit pants or leggings permitted.

Jumpers must be plain and not contain branding, stripes or contrasting colours.

Any person failing to comply with the dress code will not be permitted to parade greyhounds, and may be guilty of an offence in accordance with GAR 86 (z) which reads:

R86 Offences

A person (including an official) shall be guilty of an offence if the person-

 (z) being an owner, trainer or registered person in charge of a greyhound fails to comply with the dress standards of a Controlling Body or club;

HANDLERS ARE TO REPORT UNCLEAN PARADE VESTS WHICH WILL BE TAKEN OUT OF CIRCULATION IMMEDIATELY UNTIL CLEANED.

GRSA reserves the right to alter this policy at any time.

SATISFACTORY TRIAL POLICY

Version number: 3.0–2022 - Board approval: February 2020 Last review: May 2022 - Next review: January 2024

Policy Background

The purpose of this policy is to detail the procedure for a greyhound undertaking a satisfactory trial.

Application of the Policy

A "satisfactory trial" means a trial required to be performed by a greyhound to the satisfaction of Stewards pursuant to Rule 132.

The chart to the right lists the type of satisfactory trials, associated field types and numbers:

Procedures:

- a) The trainer must contact GRSA Racing department to give details of the satisfactory trial required. In the instance the satisfactory trial is for Mount Gambier, a booking must be made directly with the club.
- b) GRSA will determine the time the greyhound is required to run. The Steward(s) on duty during the trial may adjust the time at their discretion i.e., dependent on track conditions, etc.

- c) Stewards will allot the box for the greyhound.
- d) To be cleared to race at any distance, greyhounds must trial over a similar distance to that at which it offended. Please refer to the chart above right for applicable track, distances, and times.

Stewards will accede to a request from a trainer to trial a greyhound over a shorter distance than that at which the penalty was placed on them. The successful trial distance will be recorded for the greyhound's requalification and will only permit the greyhound to be nominated for races up to that distance. Greyhounds must trial and requalify over a longer distance to be permitted to race over further.

- e) A Veterinary Certificate of Fitness must be obtained and lodged prior to competing in an unraced for more than six [6] months trial, returning from retirement trial or when requested by Stewards.
- f] Greyhounds that re-offend may have their nomination refused for future trials at the discretion of the Stewards.
- g) The provisions of Rule 132 and Rule 135 apply.
- h) Satisfactory Trials ordered under Rule 123 [Marring], Rule 124 [Failing to pursue], Rule 125 [Failing to pursue by reason of injury] and Rule 129 [Unsatisfactory performance] must be performed at the track where the offence occurred to obtain clearance at all tracks. For clearance at all tracks except the track where the offence occurred the trial may be performed at any venue.
- i) If a greyhound is ordered to undergo a Satisfactory Trial on a circle track and successfully completes a Satisfactory Trial on a straight track, it will be cleared for straight track racing only.
- j] If a greyhound is ordered to undergo a Satisfactory Trial on a straight track and successfully completes a Satisfactory Trial on a circle track, it will be cleared for circle track racing only.

GRSA reserves the right to alter or amend this policy at any time.

New GRSA website launched in May


The website redevelopment is over a month old now, with a lot of work and amendments having been completed in the past 4 weeks.

WAP payment update for May 2022

The Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of May 2022 was \$74,000, taking total payments for the year to nearly \$2.0 million. GRSA has been predicting a re-calibration of wagering revenue for some time and that softening of revenue now appears to be taking place. GRSA will continue to monitor and report on wagering trends.

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.



Example to help participants understand the WAP they receive

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dogs(s). The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

Assumptions:

In this example, assume the owner/trainer received \$1,000 in prizemoney for any/all races for the month.



In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of \$71.43, calculated as:

 $$1,000 \div $700,000 \times $50,000 = 71.43

Participants should note that:

- WAP is not payable for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000];
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

Cryer's Spring gives former trainer a winning farewell

MOUNT GAMBIER

Margaret Cryer, formerly of Apsley, informed the Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club recently that her husband, Tom, had passed away on the Sunday prior in an Edenhope nursing home at the age of 89.


GAP kennelling process

The kennelling fee is a flat amount of \$50 per dog, irrespective of the time period the greyhound will spend at the GAP kennels.

Participants who would like their greyhounds placed in the GAP kennels will be requested to pay the \$50 at the time when the placement form is filled in and the \$60 placement fee is paid.

This means that for greyhounds that are to be kennelled with GAP an upfront payment of \$110 will be requested. 




As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.



QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night at approximately 5.15pm (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4)

greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

- 1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
- 3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

- For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
- 2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
- 3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
 - Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
- 10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race

meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.




