Brother and sister act claim Group 3 feature

■ ANGLE PARK

It was a brother and sister feature race quinella at Angle Park on November 25 when litter mates Zinfandel Bart for Cherylee Barber and Zinfandel Nikki for Gavin Harris ran first and second in the prestigious Group 3 Brian Johnstone Final.

The siblings are owned in the same interests by Stewart and Cherylee Barber and Gavin Harris and are beautifully bred by Cherylee, being by Barcia Bale out of Zinfandel Zara who only had the 9 starts before injury ceased her racing career but not before she won 6 races including the SA Bred Doug Payne Feature and Christmas Sprint in 2017.

Race favourites for the event however were the Victorian duo of Earthworm Jim and Nike Apache trained by Keith Hellmuth with the other fourth spots filled by the Ben Rawlings team with Simply Chaos, Spring Drama, Garry's Chaos and Blue By You making up the high quality field of sprinting youngsters.

As the start was affected Zinfandel Bart came out running from box 5 and raced forward towards the lead. He was challenged on the inside by his sister, Zinfandel Nikki while Earthworm Jim tried to hold a forward position along the inside after a moderate start. Simply Chaos, Spring Drama and Nike Apache all moved to midfield as the first turn came up. Zinfandel Bart accelerated into the bend to race to a clear lead followed by "Nikki" and Earthworm Jim while Nike Apache found himself out 4 and 5 wide due to some interference.

Into the back straight and Zinfandel Bart adopted catch me if you can tactics and raced away from his rivals with Zinfandel Nikki in hot pursuit. Nike Apache ranged up along side his kennel mate Earthworm Jim as they battled out third. Off the back straight and Zinfandel Bart was not looking like being caught, Zinfandel Nikki was holding second but being challenged by Nike Apache who ran to third however went for a run to the inside of "Nikki" and clipped heels and lost ground allowing Earthworm Jim third spot on the track.

Entering the front straight and Zinfandel Bart was in no danger going down to the finishing line a clear and dominant winner by 4 lengths in a slick 30.50 for the 530m journey. His sister held on well for second while Earthworm Jim ran a handy third followed by the luckless Nike Apache back in fourth.

Zinfandel Bart was the most inexperienced greyhound in the series but showed great improvement and class being undefeated through the Heat and Semi Finals, taking out the feature Final in dominant style and claiming the \$25,000 first prize. "Bart" has now had 6 starts for 4 wins with career prizemoney of almost \$32,000.

This event was introduced in recognition of former Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club Chairman, Brian Johnstone who passed away 13 years ago. Brian was a true ambassador and great administrator for SA greyhound racing. He was involved with Angle Park from the early 1970's and served many years on the Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club Committee.



SA pair to head to the National Straight Track Champs

The best straight track greyhounds in the State gathered at Murray Bridge on December 7th chasing the \$5,000 first prize, the honour of being named the best in the State and to represent SA on the National stage in a few weeks at Capalaba in Queensland for the NSTC.

In a high quality Final the David Peckham trained Aston Olenna from Mt Gambier was sent out a warm favourite after his dominant Heat win, drawing the coveted red box and trying to complete two straight track titles in the same year. His main challengers in the market were the Tim Richards trained He's On Fire, who also won his Heat in fine fashion, Patched for Nicole Price which has been in red hot form and 2nd Reserve Urana Meat Loaf which gained a start from box 7 for Tracie Price also from the South East.

As the start was affected the wide boxed greyhounds looked to get the best of the jump with He's On Fire [6], Urana Meat Loaf [7] and Threaten [8] for Ben Rawlings racing to the lead. Aston Olenna began safely and looked to move forward in the race. Mid race Urana Meat Loaf took the clear lead from the chasing pack with Aston Olenna making ground, unfortunately he stumbled and fell ending his winning chances. Three quarters of the way through and Urana Meat Loaf was going well in the lead, He's All Purpose for Tim Richards had moved to second along the rails, Patched and Threaten were battling out third while My Name's Craig for Ben Rawlings was beginning to hit top gear from mid field as they charged to the winning post. Just prior to the line He's All Purpose had claimed Urana Meat Loaf for the lead and was being hailed the winner however from the clouds came My Name's Craig through the middle to claim the victory with a brilliant turn of foot. The son of Mepunga Blazer and Proven Scary ran a handy 19.26 for the victory, starting at the amazing odds of \$13 considering he was one of the three Heat winners from last week. He defeated He's All Purpose by a neck with Urana Meat Loaf hanging on for third a further 1½ lengths away.

My Name's Craig is owned by the Beach Worm Capital Syndicate, managed by Tyson Panagiotou and has been racing in fantastic form for the Ben Rawlings kennel. He has now won 10 races from 33 starts with 14 placings and prizemoney around \$26,000.

Both My Name's Craig and He's All Purpose after running first and second in the SA Final at Murray Bridge will join two representatives from Healesville [GRV], Richmond [GRNSW], and Capalaba [Racing QLD] for the NSTC Final at Capalaba worth total prizemoney of \$37,500 [\$25,000 to the winner] on Sunday 19th December. We wish the SA greyhounds, trainers and connections the best of luck in Queensland as they do SA proud.

Also on the program will be the \$4,000 Murray Bridge Anniversary Cup run over the 530m. It is a Free For All event and Non Penalty and features a quality line up of sprinters.

CHRISTMAS FESTIVAL OF FIRE AT ANGLE PARK

Things are heating up at Angle Park during the two weeks leading into Christmas with the introduction of six rich events over the 530m, 595m and 730m distances.

Dubbed the "Festival Of Fire", the series will provide opportunities for the best 48 nominations for the 530m trip, the best 28 nominations over 595m, and the best 8 nominations for a 730m event. Separately, Heats and Final of a restricted event [0-5 wins], running from Saturday morning to Thursday night, will provide a separate opportunity for that category of runner.

The Festival of Fire series will commence on Thursday, December 16, continue into the Saturday timeslot and then culminate in 5 Finals and a special stayers event carrying a collective purse in excess of \$100,000 the following Thursday night [December 23]. As a new event, the Board has resolved that the top-up amounts for this series will sit outside the Wagering Activity Payments [WAP] model. This means that the majority of the stakemoney for the series will be additional to the guaranteed return that has already been committed to industry through the WAP model.

LOCAL MATCH RACE SERIES “THE SA EASTAR” IN APRIL

The SA Local Match Race series coined “The SA Eastar” will be held on Thursday night, 14th April (Easter) at Angle Park.

Eligibility for South Australian local greyhounds will be based around the Nationals conditions. They will need to be trained in SA 76 days out of the last 150 prior to the close of nominations.

Selection for this series will only be based around winning times at Angle Park. For greyhounds that have run over the 530m at Angle Park on any meeting since 1st November, 2021 their fastest winning time will be recognised and put them on the list for selection.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3, Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. There will be no manual selection from the Grader. The top 4 seeded greyhounds will be rewarded with more prizemoney.

The overall winner of the local Match Race series will be offered a spot in the State of Origin Match race series (SA V Vic) in September so long as it is nominated and eligible to represent SA subject to changes.

GRSA SKY WEEKLY SCHEDULE TO CHANGE FROM 1ST DECEMBER 2021

From the start of this month (December), the Sky weekly schedule of greyhound racing in South Australia has changed.

The first two Sundays of any month will routinely be scheduled at Murray Bridge with the remaining Sundays being allocated to Gawler. The primary reason for the change is about providing both of those Clubs with an accessible weekly timeslot which helps them to cultivate a strong base of local patronage.

In regard to trialling at these Clubs, when we race at Gawler on the Friday they will trial on the Thursday before. When we race at Gawler on the Sunday they will trial on the Friday before. Murray Bridge trialling dates will remain unchanged.

Group 3 win highlights a big month for Bart

Greyhound of the Month for November was Zinfandel Bart for trainer Cherylee Barber who was undefeated for the month, highlighted by his brilliant win in the Group 3 Brian Johnstone Final in late November.

The son of Barcia Bale and Zinfandel Zara had four starts for the month without tasting defeat. He started the month by winning his Maiden at headquarters over the 530m when he showed determination to come back and win after being headed. He then stepped out in the Group 3 Brian Johnstone series winning his Heat in a handy 31.07 when leading throughout. He improved in the Semi-Final, again leading throughout running a slick 30.61 before he stepped out as an eachway chance in the Final. After jumping to the front again, Zinfandel Bart proved too hard to pass in the Group 3 feature going on to win by 4 lengths in a flying 30.50 showing vast improvement throughout the month.

At the end of the month Zinfandel Bart's record stood at only 6 starts for 4 wins and earnings of just under \$32,000.



Don't Tell Lies leads all the way to award

The Run of the Month for November was Don't Tell Lies for trainer Lauren Harris for her fantastic winning performance in the Leigh Rogers Feature Final at Angle Park on Thursday, 4th November.

Beginning from box 6 the daughter of Fernando Bale and Quest For Glory pushed hard early to run to the front at the winning post on the first occasion. Taking on a high quality field of young sprinters she was hardly challenged as she led throughout and raced away with the win by over 4 lengths in a brilliant 30.32 for the 530m journey.

TRIALLING OVER XMAS AND NEW YEAR

This year Xmas day falls on Saturday, 25th December with Sunday, 26th December being Boxing Day. Due to critical staff being unavailable on the Sunday there will be NO trials at Angle Park over this weekend.

With New Years Day falling on Saturday, 1st January there will be NO trials at Angle Park on this day, however, they will be moved to the Sunday, 2nd January.

ICG MEETING NEXT FRIDAY

MOUNT GAMBIER NOMINATIONS – CROSS BORDER ONLY EFFECTIVE MONDAY 6TH DECEMBER

With the recent update by the SA Government over the weekend of 4th and 5th December regarding Interstate persons requiring to test on entry into SA then isolate prior to a negative result being confirmed before attending the race track, GRSA will only accept nominations from those with a Cross Border Exemption (as a cross border community member) effective immediately, Monday 6th December.

GRSA is hopeful that the restrictions for those Interstate participants is reduced in the coming weeks to ensure ALL Interstate trainers can participate at our Mount Gambier meetings.

GRSA & GAP OFFICE TO CLOSE AT 1PM ON XMAS EVE (24TH DECEMBER)

Please be advised that the GRSA Administration and GAP Office's will close at 1pm on Friday, 24th December [Xmas Eve].

Can participants ensure all your GAP and Administrative business is taken care of prior to close on this day.

SA BRED FUTURITY PAYMENTS – DUE FRIDAY 17TH DECEMBER

The next batch of futurity payments are due on Friday, 17th December and there are three series for which payments need to be made. Forms have been sent out for those eligible greyhounds.

The payments due are:

Breeders 2022 – Final Payment - Pups Born Jan 20 to June 20

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound.

Classic 2022 - Second Payment - Pups Born July 20 to Dec 20

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payments have been made. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

Breeders 2023 – First Payment - Pups Born Jan 21 to June 21

The First Payment is due for Breeders 2023. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment.

The First Payment is \$27.50 per pup or a "one-off" Final payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

2022 GAWLER PRODUCE STAKES

After nominations were closed for the 2022 Gawler Produce Stakes there were 119 nominations. We will have guaranteed Final stakemoney of \$22,000 with an estimate for the total series prizemoney around \$40,000.

The series is for greyhounds whelped in 2020. The racing dates for this series will be Heats on Friday, 10th June 2022, Semi-Finals on Sunday, 19th June and the Final on Sunday, 26th June 2022.

The second lot of payments will be due on the Friday 28th January 2022 with the third and final payment due on the Friday, 1st April 2022.

GREYHOUND OF THE YEAR ON SATURDAY 5TH FEBRUARY AT ANGLE PARK AGAIN THIS YEAR

The date has been set for the Greyhound of the Year function at Angle Park again this year on Saturday night, 5th February 2022.

The GOTY awards night is always a great night and this is anticipated to be extremely exciting with another wide open count for the top awards. It's a night not to be missed.

Please note that the Saturday Morning race meeting will be conducted at Gawler on this day to allow the set up at Angle Park.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED “ONLY”

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that “Only” would be disregarded over all distances and the grading be left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put “Only or no start or leave me out” then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

DAISH IRRIGATION & FODDER VOUCHERS FOR MURRAY BRIDGE

The Murray Bridge GRC has been able to secure some \$100 vouchers from their sponsor Daish Irrigation & Fodder to be used on Heat and Final series’ over the next 12 months.

In the All Tracks calendar these races will be highlighted which is a terrific initiative of the Murray Bridge GRC.

COVID-19

A lot has happened since my last article in the COVID-19 space. Since SA reduced border restrictions on 23 November 2021, it released guidance to businesses for assessing the risk of COVID exposures in general businesses and venues. The advice, comprising a matrix of variables, must be used by businesses to assess the level of exposure [and type of response] should a COVID-19 transmission event occur. The considerations include –

- Is the Contact [the person exposed] vaccinated?
- Was the contact actual touch, under 1.5m or over 1.5m?
- Was the duration of the contact less than 1 minute, less than or more than 15 minutes?
- Did the contact happen outdoors or indoors [and if indoors, what is the area of the space]?
- Was the Case [the person carrying COVID-19] or the Contact wearing masks?

The range of results, being the type of response to the exposure) could be that the Contact need not do anything, up to quarantining for 14 days.

Being vaccinated or not is a major part of the process and determines if the Contact can continue with no further restrictions or must at least isolate until a negative COVID-19 test. By way of example – person A is unvaccinated. Person B is vaccinated. A and B talk to person C who is carrying the virus. They both talk to C for 3 minutes and are under 1.5m apart with all wearing masks. They are inside a venue. Under the assessment matrix, person A is considered an unvaccinated close contact and must quarantine for 14-days. Person B is considered casual contact and only quarantines until a negative COVID-19 test. You see practical examples of this on the SA Health COVID-19 website.

If you apply the above example to a real-world situation, for example a kennel house, it is clear that an exposure in that location could take out the majority of participants and staff at one exposure event. For those who are quarantining for 14 days, this is a significant burden for them and the ability for GRSA to run meetings for that period is jeopardised.

This is why being vaccinated is a cornerstone of the assessment process.

Subsequently, the GRSA Board implemented a COVID-19 vaccination policy, operational from Boxing Day 2021. It requires evidence of a 1st COVID-19 vaccination. In implementing this policy, GRSA had to consider many variables to try to achieve the best fit for everyone – work, industry and patron/spectators. Some of these were:

- Our customer facing operations [racing and hospitality];

- Aged and vulnerable customer demographic;
- Contact with a wide [and unknown] demographic in the community in so far as health is concerned;
- Small, highly mobile workforce with presence at multiple venues;
- Racing has vital economic significance to SA;
- The health and well-being to the SA community is vital [as we serve the community];
- Since 23/11/2021, there is community transmission that is consistent with SA Health modelling;
- As late as 4/12/21, the SA Government reinforced the need for vaccination due to the new variant;
- The push for vaccination is not limited to certain people or workforces. It is the entire community;
- GRSA has close contact with interstate [and vulnerable interstate] people at higher risk;
- Premier Marshall, on 4/12/2021, said: "We [have] to be flexible. This is a disease which loves indecision";
- The Chief Health Officer, on 4/12/2021 said: "Until the whole world is vaccinated, we will continue to have opportunity for variants of concern";
- SA moved from an elimination to suppression model that relies heavily on people [and businesses] to monitor their own exposure risks and manage them;
- Between employees, industry, patrons and employee-industry members, it is extremely difficult and unreasonable for GRSA to try to manage multiple and remarkably different requirements on vaccination.

GRSA, however, recognises that it is also difficult to have a one size fits all approach to these things. Therefore, if you are a registered person and you feel you need to apply for an exemption, there is a process to do so. These are considered on a case-by-case basis, so it is impossible to give you a list of circumstances where an exemption would be considered. But the process starts with the application so we can fairly consider all options. Please follow the steps on the application form to correctly lodge your application. GRSA will not consider verbal or email requests for exemptions. Please use the application form.

Information about the announcement can be found on our website, under the News tab. The policy can be found on our website under the Integrity tab, then select Rules and Policies and scroll to the Policies heading. The link is the COVID-19 Response Policy. If you believe you are eligible for an exemption, you must make an application on the form available from our website, under the Industry tab, then select Forms and scroll to the Applications heading. Under

Applications, the link is Application for Exemption to COVID-19 Vaccination Policy.

QR CODE CHECK IN

Thank you to everyone doing great work checking in to our venues. In coming weeks, to assist GRSA to implement the COVID-19 reopening roadmap, you may be asked to check in more than once. For example, if you attend a special event, you may be asked to check in to our venue and then check in to the event. This is to assist us to better determine where an exposure occurred. Please remember that GRSA does not have access to your QR Code check in data (via the mySA.gov app). It is only working with SA Health that we are put in the picture on managing an exposure.

TRACK INJURY REBATE SCHEME (TIRS)

There is an updated Track Injury Rebate Scheme policy (that can be found on the webpage, under Integrity, then Rules and Policies and then under the Policies tab). You can use the current TIRS forms for any application.

This Scheme applies to all registered persons and greyhounds, where that greyhound is injured at a meeting in South Australia, and the circumstances of the injury meet the eligibility criteria of the Scheme (called Eligible Injuries).

The Scheme now allows -

[a] 100% of the reasonable treatment costs for the Surgical Procedure (defined) for the Eligible Injury up to a maximum GRSA payment of \$1200.00; and,

[b] \$50.00 per week towards the rehabilitation of the greyhound for the duration of the rehabilitation period prescribed by the Veterinarian, up to a maximum of six (6) weeks [\$300.00]; or,

[c] 100% of the reasonable treatment costs for the Off-Course Treatment for the Eligible Injury up to a maximum GRSA payment of \$200.00. [Note – the rehabilitation payment does not apply to Off-Course Treatment].

[Applicants can apply to GRSA for funding by –

[i] Fully completing the TIRS Application Form; and,

[ii] Proving any supporting documentation required by GRSA including –

A. All clinical notes from the Veterinarian;

B. Itemised invoices for veterinary treatment, with receipts for either the full amount of the Veterinarian's invoice; or, [where applicable] the Gap-fee.

Application for funding under the Scheme must be submitted to GRSA by email or post to Animal Welfare (that administer the Scheme).

GRSA will notify the Applicant he/she is eligible to receive treatment and/or rehabilitation funding under the Scheme and will make a single lump sum payment of the treatment and rehabilitation funding either –

A. To the Applicant in full; or,

B. To the veterinary surgeon for treatment (up to \$1,200.00 for Surgical Procedures or \$200.00 for Off-Course Treatment) and to the Applicant for rehabilitation funding (where it relates to Surgical Procedures). It is the responsibility of the Applicant to satisfy all costs due to the Veterinarian that are over \$1,200.00 for Surgical Procedures or \$200.00 for Off-Course Treatment (the Gap-fee).

Once an application has been approved by GRSA and funding paid to the Applicant (and/or the Veterinarian); GRSA may place a penalty on the greyhound in the OzChase system that will prevent the greyhound from being nominated for meetings.

The above is a summary of the key points of the policy. For full details, please refer to the policy.

MIXING MEDICATIONS

An Industry member very helpfully let me know about a recent GWIC (NSW) Disciplinary Action Decision in the matter of Jason Carter (decided 10 November 2021). Mr Carter faced charges of providing medication to greyhounds that resulted in undue suffering. The penalty was a 6-month disqualification.

Mr Carter treated some greyhounds for parasites. Mr Carter used Equimax (a brand of Ivermectin) for worms and Comfortis for fleas. The result of administering these medications were that the dogs died, due to the levels of toxicity produced using the products.

The takeaway from this is, please always be mindful –

- Do not use medication or treatments that are not meant for animals other than dogs;
- Use extreme caution mixing treatments – see your vet;
- Remember the treatment might – intended or not – result in a positive substance detection – see your vet.

Six important rule changes

The new Greyhounds Australasia National Rules have now been endorsed by the GA Board. The updated rules will come into effect on Monday 31st January 2022.

Following are some of the rule changes that would be of particular importance to industry. We ask all participants to read the summary of important changes. These rules are outlined below and on the following page.

SIX IMPORTANT RULE CHANGES

30 [NP] Similar to WA LR105A	Barking Muzzles prohibited	This is a new provision which, except for a veterinarian using a Barking Muzzle for the sole purpose of examination or treatment, and except in circumstances approved by a Controlling Body, makes it an offence for a person to use a Barking Muzzle on a greyhound.
145[3] [83A[3]]	Treatment prior to an Event	Rule 145[3] uses the terminology used in other racing codes of "clear day" (which the relevant definition in rule 9 defines as "a 24 hour period from 12.00am to 11.59pm") as opposed to "day prior to the day of an Event" [see existing 83A[3]], so that rule 145[3] reads: "No person without the permission of the Stewards may administer or cause to be administered any injectable substance to a greyhound at any time during the one clear day prior to 12.00am on the day of an Event that it is nominated to compete in."
159[7] [NP]	Offences relating to luring and baiting	This new provision provides that the luring and baiting offences contained in subrules 159[1], [3] and [5] are "absolute liability" offences, such that the references to "live animal", "animal carcass", "part of an animal" and "animal material" refer to the fact of the existence of each of those conditions, whether or not the charged person knew or believed of the applicable condition. Absolute liability offences do not permit a defence of "honest and reasonable mistake of fact" being relied on. Absolute liability for these offences is consistent with a stronger regulatory approach for these extremely serious matters that have the ability to significantly damage the reputation and ongoing longevity of greyhound racing.

127 [69, 69A]	Period of suspension to be imposed for marring or failing to pursue	<p>Rule 127 is a new rule that deals with the period of suspension to be imposed for marring or failing to pursue. The rule reads:</p> <p>“Subject to rule 125 [69B], where, in the opinion of the Stewards, a greyhound is found to have marred or failed to pursue the lure during an Event the Stewards must impose a period of suspension in respect of the greyhound, which is to be recorded as part of the identification record as follows:</p> <p>(a) in the case of a first offence, 28 days at the track where the offence occurred and until the completion of a satisfactory trial; or</p> <p>(b) subject to rule 128[70], in the case of a second offence, 28 days at all tracks and until completion of a satisfactory trial; or</p> <p>(c) in the case of a third or subsequent offence, three months at all tracks and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.”</p> <p>This is a substantial change to the marring and failing to pursue penalty structure. Previously, a first offence was a suspension for 28 days [at the track where the offence occurred] and the completion of a satisfactory trial, a second offence a suspension for three months [at all tracks] and the completion of a satisfactory trial, and a third or subsequent offence was 12 months suspension [at all tracks] and until the completion of a satisfactory trial. The new rule proposes that the first offence be a suspension of 28 days at the track where the offence occurred and the completion of a satisfactory trial. A second offence is a suspension of 28 days at all tracks and the completion of a satisfactory trial. The third or subsequent offence is a three months suspension at all tracks and the completion of two satisfactory trials.</p> <p>The rationale behind this amendment is to enable greyhounds a better opportunity to continue racing should the greyhound be a repeat offender under these rules.</p> <p>Failing to pursue by reason of injury [Rule 125 [rule 69B]] will still apply if applicable for the first failing to pursue offence only. The term ‘suspension’ [in Rule 125 [rule 69B]] has been replaced with the term ‘stand-down’.</p> <p>Marring and failing to pursue penalties are no longer dealt with separately, they are now combined. A greyhound’s first penalty may be for failing to pursue, its second for marring, and third for failing to pursue, or any combination of the two.</p>
159 [Compare with rule 86B, NP, 86C(4) and 86C(5)]	Offences relating to luring and baiting	<p>There is significant change that has been made to the way in which luring and baiting offences are dealt with in new rule 159 [the main new provision dealing with luring and baiting] compared to existing rule 86B. In relation to that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> all offending under existing rule 86B [1] involving either a live animal, animal carcass or part of animal require a mandatory minimum 10 years disqualification, which penalty can be reduced if there is a finding of a “special circumstance” being in existence. there are now in the new rules to be three tiers of seriousness of offending [respectively dealt with at subrules (1), (3) and (5) of rule 159], which have differing potential consequences in terms of penalty. These are, simplified: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> subrule (1) - relevant offences involving a “live animal”: minimum life disqualification [DQ], and that penalty is unable to be reduced; subrule (3) - relevant offences involving an “animal carcass or part of an animal”: starting point minimum 10 years DQ; that minimum DQ period can be reduced to a lesser DQ period if one or more special circumstances are found to exist at the time of the offence; subrule (5) - relevant offences involving anything containing “animal material” – starting point minimum penalty of a DQ [but for no required specific period], and the starting point minimum penalty of a DQ can be reduced to a lesser penalty totally within the decision maker’s discretion if one or more special circumstances are found to exist at the time of the offence. there are explanatory “Notes” after subrules (3) and (5) which respectively inform the reader that “part of an animal” includes “skin, hair, bone, blood, faeces, urine or flesh”, and that “animal material” means “any processed and/or tanned and/or cured skin or hide of an animal and does not include anything that contains animal bone, blood, faeces, urine or flesh”; in subrule (4) there is now explanation in relation to what “special circumstances” can and cannot include – the matters that may be special circumstances [for the purpose of subrules (3) and (5)] are those that exist at the time of the offending and relate to the objective nature of the offending, and it is also made clear that they do not include subjective matters like the contribution that a person may have made to the greyhound racing industry, or the impact of a DQ on a person’s livelihood.
174 [NP and 95]	Penalties	<p>This rule specifically provides that a “reprimand [sometimes known as a warning or caution]” is a specific type of penalty which can be imposed by a Controlling Body or the Stewards.</p>

Transition to Synthetic Lure

At the Greyhounds Australasia (GA) meeting in July, GRSA gave a commitment to the other States to transition to a synthetic lure, becoming the last remaining state to do so.

Since that time, management has been investigating various synthetic lure options to replace the existing blue, yellow and white sheepskin, which is currently in use at all SA tracks for races and trials.

These investigations initially attempted to replicate the look of the existing lure with a fake sheepskin, however, it quickly became apparent that sourcing a material that was durable enough to withstand finish-on races and trials was going to be difficult.

The outcome of this search has ultimately lead management back to the lure that is currently in operation in four states, the lure otherwise known as the 'Octopus', currently in use in NSW, Queensland, WA and Tasmania.

The advantage of this type of lure is that [a] it is easily sourced, [b] we know that it is accepted by participants and it works, and [c] it provides for some consistency across multiple States in terms of the presentation of the lure.

GRSA is now committed to this lure for rollout at some point in January, with the actual specifics of the rollout being discussed over the coming weeks, including at the ICG meeting next week.

Whilst GRSA has committed the local industry to this lure in the short-term, it is expected that a review process will take place on a regular basis [via the ICG] which could discuss alternatives if participants are not satisfied with the new lure.

Over the next week, examples of the Octopus lure will be distributed to all SA Clubs for display in their patron buildings, to give participants the opportunity to view the new lure prior to its use for trials and races.

GRSA is still investigating supply of smaller lure that can be used for home training purposes and will advise accordingly once some options have been sourced.

WAP payment update for October 2021

The Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of October 2021 amounted to \$306,000, taking total payments for the year past \$1 million.

It is the fourth strong monthly result in a row; however, there are some signs that wagering is beginning to reduce now that New South Wales and Victoria have lifted COVID restrictions. GRSA obviously hopes for continued strength in wagering, but will be looking closely at any trends that can be gleaned from the November results.

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney.

If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

Example to help participants understand the WAP they receive

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dogs(s). The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

Assumptions:

In this example, assume the owner/trainer received **\$1,000** in prizemoney for any/all races for the month.

In this the total prizemoney (paid to all participant) is **\$700,000**.

In this example, the total WAP is **\$50,000**.

In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of **\$71.43**, calculated as:

$$\text{\$1,000} \div \text{\$700,000} \times \text{\$50,000} = \text{\$71.43}$$

Participants should note that:

- WAP is not payable for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000];
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

GAP kennelling fee payment process change

Please note that as of 1st August 2021 the GAP kennelling payment process has changed for a trial period of three months.

The changes are as follows:

Instead of making a weekly payment of \$33 per dog, the new kennelling fee will be a flat amount of \$50 per dog, irrespective of the time period the greyhound will spend at the GAP kennels.

Participants who would like their greyhounds placed in the GAP kennels will be requested to pay the \$50 at the time when the placement form is filled in and the \$60 placement fee is paid.

This means that for greyhounds that are to be kennelled with GAP an upfront payment of \$110 will be requested. After that, participants will not need to make any additional payments for their dogs in the GAP kennels. Noting that prior to foster care dogs spend an average of 4 weeks in kennels, this change is expected to generate a saving of \$82 per dog for participants.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

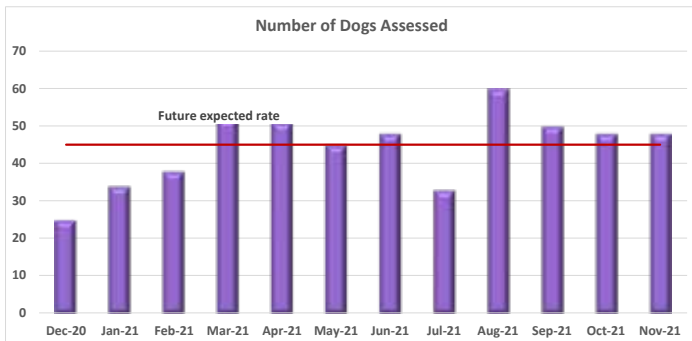

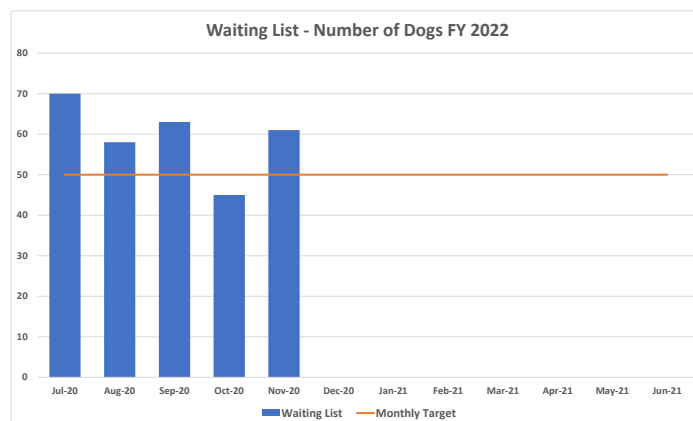
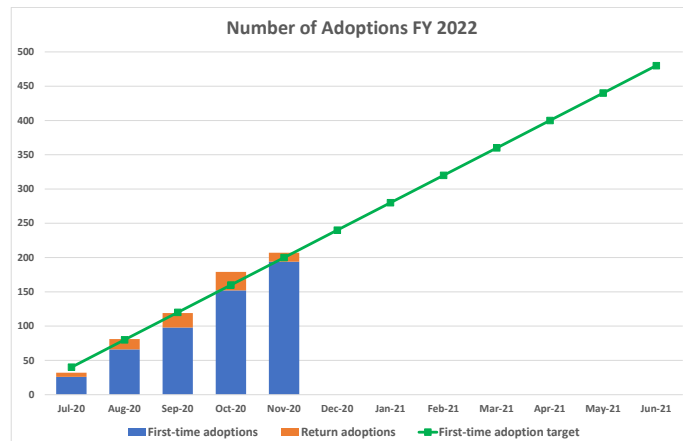
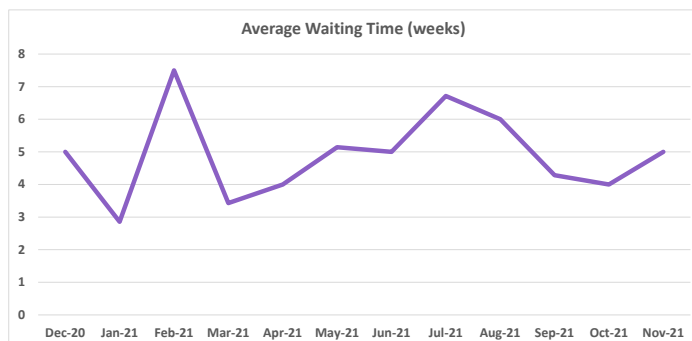
Latest updates from GAP

Terrific Beatific answers the challenge

■ MOUNT GAMBIER

Weather-wise, the Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club couldn't have hope for a better day than on Sunday, 28th November for the running of its inaugural South-East Hoteliers Day at Tara Raceway.

Eight local hotels – Jens, Pines, Park, South Eastern, South Aussie, Gambier, Commercial and Federal – were represented at the 11-race meeting. And, following the running of races carrying their names, seven hotel representatives each drew a box number in the Licensed Victuallers Challenge.

As it turned out, the Federal Hotel Stake was the last of the eight races to be run, the hotel having no choice but to accept the six. Certainly not the best of boxes but their supporters heartened by the fact that it was Beatific carrying the green rug.

Raced by Steve Williams' Queensland-based Velocity Lodge, Beatific, a son of Fabregas x Velocity Willow, had won three races at Tara Raceway from five starts since joining Jason Newman's Moorak kennels in October.

So when the black dog rounded the first turn in front in the 512 metres LVC, and with smart Adelaide greyhound Meet Joe Black in hot pursuit, the stage had been set for an interesting tussle.

But the \$7 chance Beatific was simply too good. Defying the opposition to run him down, he defeated odds-on favourite Meet Joe Black by two lengths with a further four lengths back to Midnight Daisy in a best of day 29.82 seconds.

"It's great to win my first piece of hardware," said an appreciative Newman, referring to the winner's trophy, at the presentation.

The win was the middle leg of a treble for Newman – his second for November. Boogie Woogie had been successful earlier in the day in the South Aussie Hotel Stake (400 m) and Departure Gate later in the Exchange Printers Mixed Stake (600 m).

And receiving the LVC trophy on behalf of the Federal Hotel was venue manager Amy Bromley who thanked the Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club for what had been a thoroughly enjoyable day.

The driving force behind the inaugural South-East Hoteliers Day was MGGRC president Noel Perry who said the effort that had been put into the day had

been worthwhile.

"We had good support from the hotels involved and the meeting attracted a good crowd. One of the pleasing aspects was the number of first-timers at the track. Many couldn't believe just how good the Tara Raceway amenities are.

"I think we can now build on today's Hoteliers' Day and with their continued support make next year's Licensed Victuallers Challenge an even bigger and better event."

Perry said the club also needed to express its thanks to MC Kevin "KD" Douglas for his efforts throughout the day.

"KD has been great for our club and this Sunday was no different. He was his usual professional self at the presentations and also took time to explain the intricacies of greyhound racing to the many first-timers on course."

It was on July 28 and 29, 1986 that the Licensed Victuallers' Coursing Club of SA

conducted the final meeting in SA – the time-honoured 32-dog stake run over two days at Mintaro.

Dating back to the 1860s, coursing was actually the origin of racing as we know it today – greyhounds chasing a mechanical lure with the outcome determined solely by speed.

The Licensed Victuallers Challenge was a far cry from that final meeting at Mintaro all those years ago. In fact there were plenty who had never heard of the Licensed Victuallers.

But there would have been a few at Tara Raceway who still remembered what it was all about.

This was a time when greyhound owners and trainers, bookmakers, punters and city and country folk – and, of course, an abundance of hoteliers – made the annual pilgrimage to one of the coursing grounds dotted around SA to celebrate the Licensed Victuallers Cup.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Friday (drawn Tuesday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Tuesday).

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

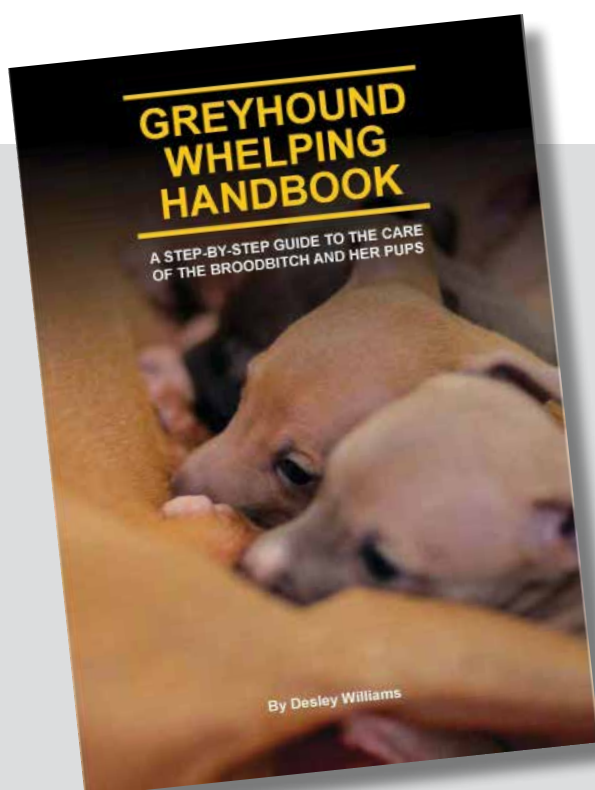
