As the year draws to a close, I would like to acknowledge the hard work and many achievements of greyhound racing in South Australia, from our hardworking participants to our dedicated GRSA staff and Board. As an industry, we have opened a refurbished track at Angle Park, launched a new customer-focused website, hosted a bumper year of racing and events and successfully cared for, trained and rehomed countless greyhounds.

Earlier this month, we were pleased to announce an overall stake money increase of 7.5% across all TAB grades and races, with an additional boost to straight track racing at Murray Bridge. Effective from 1 January 2023, the increase will total \$750,000 over a twelve month period and rebuild a foundation of prizemoney back to pre-Covid levels. While it is likely there will be a reduction in monthly Wagering Activity Payments (WAP) as a result, we hope this foundational increase will assist with rising costs and provide more certainty to participants surrounding industry returns.

It is important to note that despite this increase, our state's prizemoney levels remain well behind our interstate counterparts. Discussions have been ongoing with Government and the other codes as to what a future funding model may look like. We appreciate the solidarity and patience that you have shown in allowing us to do so.

2022 has ultimately been successful for our industry, but not without its challenges. I thank the industry for working with GRSA as we navigate these in line with our values of integrity, accountability, transparency and leadership.

I also thank you for welcoming a new CEO with open arms. There has been a lot of change in my first six months and plenty of new ideas. I am energised by that, and look forward to what 2023 has in store.

On behalf of the Board and Staff, I would like to wish you and your families a very Merry Christmas and hope that the coming year brings you peace, happiness and success.

Spring Honour makes it a spring to remember

■ ANGLE PARK

At Angle Park on November 24th in one of the most even editions of the prestigious Group 3 Brian Johnstone Final it was a greyhound with superior early speed that was able to claim the first prize. Spring Honour for trainer Greg Board was able to lead most of the way and hang on for a spirited victory in the SA Bred classic.

The son of Fernando Bale and Sheeza Nitro jumped from box 7 and was well supported on the third line of betting at \$4.40 just behind race favourites Yarramundi Turbo for Vadim Roz from box 1 and Finniss Redeem for Lauren Harris from box 3.

As the start was affected the early speed came from Finniss Redeem which ran to the front while Spring Honour cruised up alongside as they raced to the winning post on the first occasion. Tucked in behind was Finniss Surprise for Ryan Tugwell and Yarramundi Turbo while the remainder of the field looked for a spot closer to the rails. Out of the front straight and Spring Honour accelerated past Finniss Redeem to find the clear lead, and with some bumping and tightening, was able to race clear into the back straight. Finniss Surprise moved quickly to second as this duet opened up a sizeable gap back to Finniss Redeem in third and Yarramundi Turbo who gave strong chase followed by Agent Nineteen for Ben Rawlings while the remainder of the field was pretty much out of business.

Off the back straight and it looked a two dog race with Spring Honour going nicely in the lead followed by Finniss Surprise hanging on to his heels. Yarramundi Turbo raced past Finniss Redeem to take third spot but was still giving the leaders 5 to 6 lengths. Turning for home and Spring Honour was feeling the pressure as Finniss Surprise moved to the outside to challenge, back in third Yarramundi Turbo was still making ground on the leaders. As they raced down to the finish line Spring Honour gave a good kick to out last Finniss Surprise and win by $\frac{3}{4}$ length in a handy 30.71 for the 530m journey. Yarramundi Turbo closed with intent late for third only $\frac{3}{4}$ length further back.

Spring Honour is owned by the Board Racing Syndicate managed by Greg and was locally bred by the Razza Racing Syndicate managed by Lisa Rasmussen.

This event was introduced in recognition of former Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club Chairman, Brian Johnstone who passed away 14 years ago. Brian was a true ambassador and great administrator for SA greyhound racing. He was involved with Angle Park from the early 1970's and served many years on the Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club Committee.

Bobby Axelrod claims memorable feature win

On a terrific card at Murray Bridge on Sunday December 11 it was Bobby Axelrod that took out one of the features with the AGRC Murray Bridge Derby going the way of the white and brindle chaser.

It was a top field with plenty of speed engaged from some quality chasers, with Bobby just starting favourite in the race. When the boxes opened it was a hot go to the first split, but Bobby Axelrod was doing a bit too well and just got himself to the front ahead of Lochinvar Cahill. Once in front, he proved too quick as he burnt off the other to win in a best of the night 25.40 by three lengths. That was win 14 from 25 for Bobby and he is fast turning into a topline chaser here in SA!

Earlier it was the girls version, with the AGRC Murray Bridge Oaks going the way of the Tony Rasmussen trained Victa Marli. The speed that Victa Marli has consistently shown was once again on display as the dark brindle bitch quickly set up a lead from box seven with a hot 7.93 first split. Once in front, it was effortless, as she strolled away for a comfortable 4 length win in 25.56. Not only did Tony take out the Oaks but he picked up another two winners in the form of littermates Victa Alby and Victa Kerle, were both terrific in their grade 6 wins over the 395m distance.

Ben Rawlings has got the kennel going super and that continued on the night with an early treble. Ben's third winner was in one of the other features, the Anniversary Cup with Spring Phoebe. From box seven, she didn't leave the best and had to do some work early to get herself up to the front, but once she hit the lead around the turn, she wasn't for catching as she won by a length in 30.20.



GRSA announces prizemoney increases

Greyhound racing in South Australia will benefit from a return to pre-COVID prizemoney levels following an overall stake money increase of 7.5%, equally distributed across all TAB grades and races.

Effective from 1 January 2023, the increase will total \$750,000 over a twelve-month period, rebuilding a foundation of base level prizemoney across the industry.

"We are pleased to announce a modest increase in prizemoney in line with the ongoing growth that our industry is continuing to drive," GRSA Chair Grantley Stevens said.

"While revenue remains consistent post-COVID, we expect this will stabilise as we navigate a new normal and the rising cost of living.

"We understand participants are feeling the pressure of those rising costs and we wish to continue to provide this increased support at all levels of racing to ensure best practice care for our dogs."

While the increase in base stake money levels will likely result in a reduction in monthly Wagering Activity Payments (WAP), it will provide more certainty to participants surrounding industry returns.

The prizemoney increase will be felt across all grades of greyhound racing in South Australia and will extend from Angle Park to regional tracks at Mount Gambier, Gawler and Murray Bridge.

Races held at Murray Bridge's straight track will enjoy an additional funding boost, taking the total prizemoney increase at the track to 20%.

"Murray Bridge is home to one of just four straight tracks in the country, and we understand the importance of investing in that point of difference," Mr Stevens said.

"Straight track racing continues to gain in popularity and Murray Bridge is a model for this form."

Mr Stevens said the prizemoney increase was reflective of GRSA's ongoing commitment to its participants and animal welfare.

"Prizemoney is the lifeblood of our industry; it supports our participants and ensures confidence and growth in an industry that continues to go from strength to strength," he said.

"While the Board has been mindful to ensure this increase is reflected at all grades and TAB tracks in South Australia, our state's prizemoney remains well behind our interstate counterparts.

"Without continued reinvestment, we risk losing that momentum as well as the vibrant communities and thousands of jobs created by this important industry."

SA BRED FUTURITY PAYMENTS – DUE TOMORROW (FRIDAY 16TH DECEMBER)

The next batch of futurity payments are due tomorrow (Friday, 16th December) and there are three series for which payments need to be made. Forms have been sent out for those eligible greyhounds.

The payments due are:

Breeders 2023 – Final Payment - Pups Born Jan 21 to June 21

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound.

Classic 2023 - Second Payment - Pups Born July 21 to Dec 21

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payments have been made. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

Breeders 2024 – First Payment - Pups Born Jan 22 to June 22

The First Payment is due for Breeders 2024. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment.

The First Payment is \$27.50 per pup or a "one-off" Final payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

GRSA & GAP OFFICE TO CLOSE AT 3PM ON FRIDAY DECEMBER 23

Please be advised that the GRSA Administration and GAP Office's will close at 3pm on Friday, 23rd December.

TRIALLING OVER XMAS AND NEW YEAR

This year Xmas day falls on a Sunday with Monday, 26th December being Boxing Day.

There will be no trials on Xmas Day and due to critical staff being unavailable on the Monday there will be NO trials at Gawler or Murray Bridge. There will be trials at Angle Park on Tuesday night, 27th December and on Saturday morning, 31st December as normal.

Over the New Year period there will be NO trials on Monday, 2nd January at Murray Bridge and NO trials at Gawler on Monday, 2nd January and Thursday, 26th January, once again this is due to staffing availability on these public holidays.

KATE'S A SCANDAL XMAS SPRINT ON THURSDAY 29TH DECEMBER

On Thursday, 29th December the feature at Angle Park will be the \$14,275 Kate's A Scandal Xmas Sprint Free For All (N/P) over the 530m.

Nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am on Friday, 23rd December.

HEATS GAWLER CLASSIC 2022 – 531M ON FRIDAY 30th DECEMBER

The \$2,200 Heats of the Gawler Classic 2022 – 531m will be run on Friday, 30th December with the \$4,500 Final on Friday, 6th January. This series is for greyhounds paid up for Classic 2022.

Nominations for the Heats close Wednesday, 28th December with GRSA at 9.00am.

SA SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP IN JANUARY

Owners and Trainers are reminded of the domiciliary clause on the SA Sprint Championship coming up in January. To be eligible a greyhound must have been domiciled in SA for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the time fixed for the finalising of nominations and drawing of fields. (Nationals policy adopted) The date going back 76 days is 16th October as nominations close on Friday, 30th December 2022.

The \$5,535 Heats are scheduled to be run on Thursday, 5th January, with the Final to be run on Thursday, 12th January. Total prizemoney for the listed Final will be \$22,000.

- Nominations close on Friday, 30th December 2022 at 9.00am with GRSA.

JOHN GRAY FINAL IN JANUARY

The time-honoured John Gray series will be held in January with \$3,855 Heats run on Thursday, 12th January and the \$14,275 Final on Thursday, 19th January.

The series is for Grade 5 greyhounds over the 530m journey.

- Nominations for the Heats close on Monday, 9th January 2023 at 9.00am with GRSA.

FEATURE GOLDEN MAIDEN SERIES IN JANUARY WITH FINAL WORTH \$10,000

The Feature Golden Maiden Series will be held in January over the 531m journey. The \$1,560 Heats will be run on Sunday, 15th January with the \$10,000 Final on Sunday, 22nd January.

Nominations for the Heats close Wednesday, 11th January 2023 with GRSA at 9.00am.

Spring Honour wins Greyhound of the Month



Greyhound of the Month for November was Spring Honour for trainer Greg Board who had four starts for the month, winning two and running second in the other two, with the highlight being the Group 3 Brian Johnstone Feature Final on Thursday, 24th November.

The son of Fernando Bale and Sheeza Nitro is locally bred by Razza Racing Syndicate managed by Lisa Rasmussen and owned by the Board Racing Syndicate managed by Greg. He started the month off with a terrific second in the highly regarded Leigh

Rogers Grade 6 Feature Final at Angle Park. He then stepped out in the Heats of the Brian Johnstone winning in 30.79 and then running second in the Semi-Final. Qualifying as one of the leading contenders for the Group 3 feature he showed wonderful early box speed to lead the field as they left the front straight on the first occasion. He showed plenty of determination to hang on in the concluding stages to claim his maiden Group victory.

At the end of the month Spring Honour's record stood at 21 starts for 8 wins and 9 placings and earnings just over \$38,000.

Quality win gives Top Quality monthly award

The Run of the Month for November was the Ben Rawlings trained sprinter, Top Quality which won in brilliant fashion on Thursday, 10th November in mixed 3/4 company at headquarters.

He flew out of the boxes from 2 to lead easily in a slick 5.18 first split and from there the margin back to the rest of the field grew and grew. He went 17.45 off the back straight and raced away to win by 8 lengths in a blistering 30.28.

ICG ACTION ITEMS FROM LAST MEETING EFFECTIVE 1ST JANUARY 2023

From the last ICG meeting below are action items that take effect from 1st January 2023 –

- The Group agreed for the reintroduction of the naming fee of \$55 +GST for SA namings.
- The Group agreed to remove SA Bred Scheme payment of \$27.50 from Part B of the Breeders Support Program [which generally is not required anyway].

SATURDAY TO THURSDAY NIGHT FINALS AT ANGLE PARK

Once a fortnight GRSA run Heats on the Saturday morning meeting at Angle Park, where there will be either (1-4 wins or 5+ wins) over the 530m and will be Non Penalty events, run as 8 dog fields. The Final will be conducted as Race 1 on the Thursday night.

Trainers should be mindful that if you have a greyhound in a Heat and it qualifies for the Final that the greyhound will be ineligible to compete in the Final if it is engaged to race the day prior [Wednesday].

The next lot of Heats will be run in January on Saturday, 7th January for 1-4 wins with the 8 dog Final on Thursday, 12th January.

This will be followed by Heats on Saturday, 21st January for 5+ wins with the 8 dog Final on Thursday, 26th January.

GOTY AWARDS NIGHT ON SATURDAY 25TH FEBRUARY CONFIRMED WITH SOME RACING DATE CHANGES

Please be advised that Greyhound Racing SA have swapped dates with Gawler and Angle Park for Saturday, 4th February 2023.

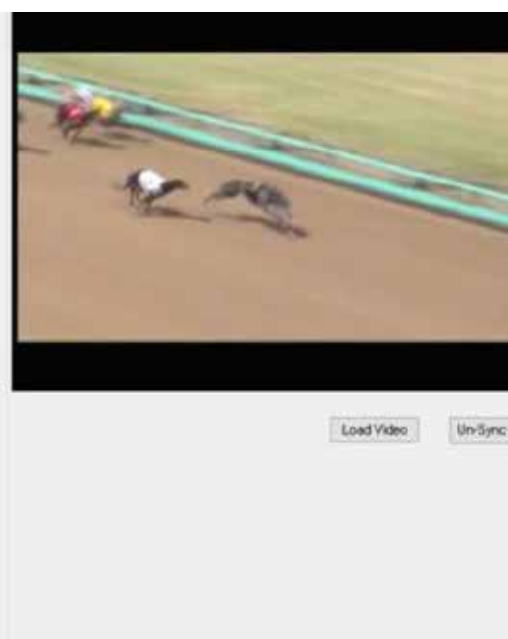
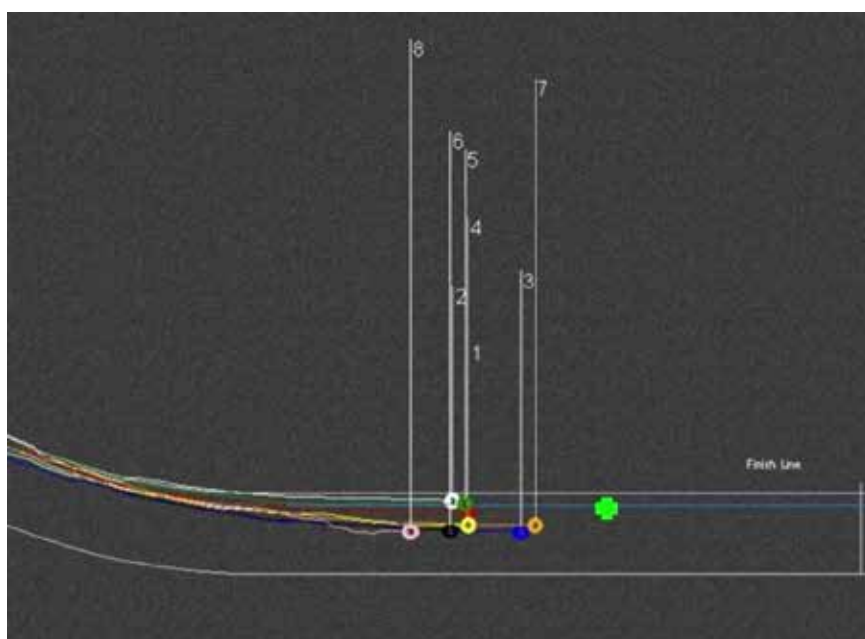

REVIEW OF TRIALS

Thank you to all those who sent me submissions thus far on the trial procedure review.

GRSA is still working through a solution to on-track safety with SafeWork SA. As you may recall, SafeWork SA issued a notice to us to conduct a review of safety systems with respect to on-track presence viz. the moving lure. At present, GRSA has restricted movement on-track, to give effect to the SafeWork SA guidance and expectations for on-track safety while they monitor the situation. To now, we continue to work with SafeWork SA in order to come to a mutually acceptable process for on-track presence, especially around the catching pen gate. We are looking at some minor engineering work to have the gate operation improved.

I will provide an update as soon as I can.

ROLE CHANGE

Recently, GRSA reviewed various roles within the senior management team. As a result, my role has changed. The animal welfare team moved to the Chief Steward, and I took on human resources and work health and safety. I keep my other roles. So, for animal welfare queries, please speak to the Chief Steward or the welfare team.

Kennelling

Please be mindful during kennelling to advise your greyhounds' name and race number upon presentation. This will help keep the process moving in a timely manner.

Reminder – Identification/weight cards

Where you have presented a greyhound to be checked off at its first start, do not forget to retrieve its Identification and Weight Card from Stewards before leaving. There have been many occasions of late where documents have been left behind which has the potential to cause problems as you are required to be in possession of your greyhounds' ID whenever it is presented to race.

Qualifying Trials

Trainers are reminded that Qualifying Trials are treated identically to Races under the rules, being an "event".

Event means the competitive pursuit by one or more greyhounds of a lure at a racecourse, and includes a race, a Series, a qualifying trial, and in the case of a coursing meeting a "course". An Event does not include a satisfactory trial; it does not include any kind of trial other than a qualifying trial.

Therefore, the Trainer of a greyhound not presented for a Qualifying Trial may be guilty of an offence under Rule 86. The standard penalty for this offence is a \$100 fine to the Trainer and a 28 day stand down period for the greyhound nominated. Stewards will monitor and enforce this rule forthwith.

86 Kennelling time

[1] Unless otherwise directed by the Stewards, the handler of a greyhound drawn in an Event must present the correct greyhound to the Stewards not later than 45 minutes before the advertised starting time of the first Event of the relevant meeting.

[2] The Stewards may alter the standard kennelling time referred to in subrule [1] of this rule if they think fit.

[3] If a greyhound is not presented within the time frame referred to in subrule [1], or within the time frame referred to in subrule [2] of this rule if the standard kennelling time is altered, it is:

- not permitted to compete in the Event for which it has been drawn; and
- prohibited from competing in any Event for a period of not less than 28 days commencing on the date on which the failure to comply with this rule occurred, unless a Controlling Body or the Stewards order otherwise and/or make a direction revoking or reducing that period of time.

Damage to Chasers

On the 12th November, Chaser's restaurant suffered significant storm damage with 16 glass panels blowing out.

The result was most of these glass panels shattered, spreading glass shards over a wide area. A large-scale clean-up was initiated on the same day along with temporary work to sure up and make the building safe. Subsequently a structural engineer inspected the site and confirmed it was safe to continue operations in the venue.

After a lot of work in the background, GRSA is pleased to announce we've cleared the final insurance hurdle and are now moving towards the rectification of the venue.

Immediately obvious will be the scarification of the lawn areas in front of Chaser's – this was carried out as a safety measure to ensure any glass that potentially made it that far was captured and has been followed up with a thorough inspection of the area. Additionally, the carpet in front of the kennel house and breezeway ramp has been replaced.

From Friday, 9th December, glaziers will be on site to begin removing and re-installing the new glass panels in Chasers. In parallel to this work and beginning on Monday, 12th December, all carpet in Chasers will be replaced.

These teams will be working Monday to Friday 6am – 5pm along with weekends to fast track the work with an expected



completion date around the 23rd December. GRSA will schedule the work around racing/trials as much as possible to minimise the impact to operations but there may be some minor disruptions with some areas sectioned off during this period.

We greatly appreciate your understanding and patience during this period and look forward to the updated look of the venue and returning to 'normal' business.

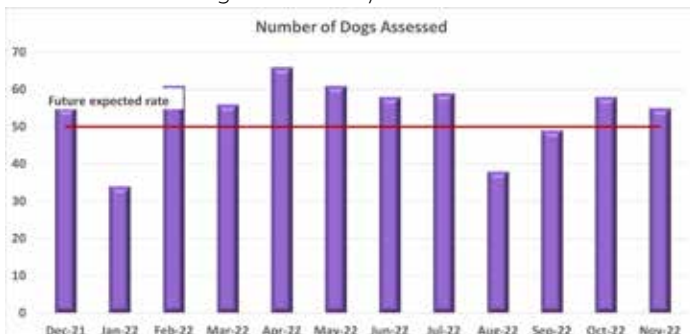

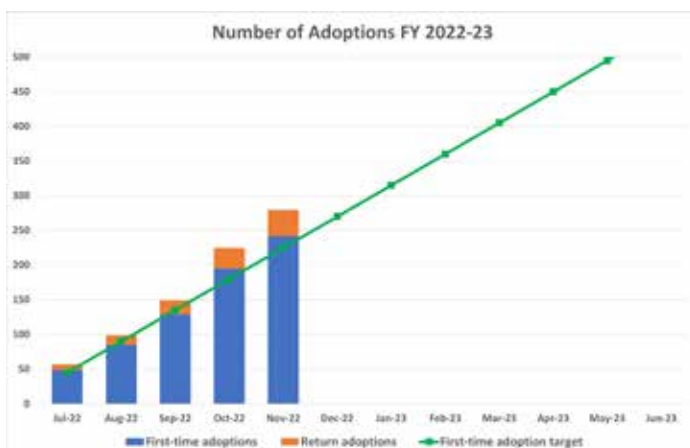
Latest updates from GAP

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:30pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

GREYHOUND RACING SOUTH AUSTRALIA GRADING REVIEW PANEL MEETING

Held at the offices of GRSA at 55 Cardigan St, Angle Park on Friday 25th November, 2022

Meeting commenced at 10.32am. Shaun Mathieson, Racing Manager, thanked those attending the meeting today.

1. Minutes From Previous Meeting

The panel approved the minutes from the previous GRP meeting held on 4/04/22.

2. Business Arising

The Racing Manager provided an update to the panel on those items introduced from the last meeting. The panel discussed a number of those items in detail.

Grade 6 Non SA Bred Maximum of 12 Lifetime Wins – The RM advised as a standing item the Grade 6 conditions will remain on the agenda for any new discussion. The panel and management agreed that there were no clear issues at present and agreed no changes were necessary.

Mixing Of Races – The RM confirmed that the general mixing of races was done by race wins. He advised the Grader continues to receive queries from trainers regarding this process particularly for Grade 5 greyhounds being mixed. Some members suggested some possible options like not guarding at all, or only count the wins in the last 12 months rather than the career however for the most part they were comfortable that the fairest way to separate was on career race wins. No further action required.

Guarding of Owners – The panel reconfirmed their support in guarding trainers for normally graded events and Owners and Trainers for Heats and Finals. No further action required.

Performance Trials – The RM liaised with Victoria, NSW, QLD and WA for their process and provide the panel with an update. QLD are like SA and do not have performance trials,

WA require all greyhounds to compete in at least one qualifying trial before their Maiden, including a greyhound that is still a maiden that has been transferred to WA. NSW do not have any requirement at present however was a prerequisite some years ago. In Victoria there is no requirement. The RM advised there were still some staffing issues and also the progression of Isolynx that could assist in considering performance trials. The some of the members were still supportive of considering performance trials however based on the feedback from interstate and management were comfortable at present with the current process.

Isolynx Update – The RM advised the panel that they now will notice that the speeds of the greyhounds are being displayed at our race meetings. He advised that currently the data is not available and is just being stored. He advised Brooks Group who manages ISO Lynx are currently building an Interface which they presented at the August Nationals which may be available in December which would assist with this information being made available to Trainers, Owners, General Public, Corporates etc.

The panel were keen to see what information could be available as kph on our vision is ok visually but doesn't offer any real data. They were extremely keen to see what could be made available. The RM advised he would send the group some information about the interface. The RM advised that there is plenty of potential with the data for Blue Sky thinking however is taking time to be available advising that states interstate have been using Isolynx for a few years and they have not released any data. Some members asked if the Brooks presentation could be made available to them to assist with the understanding of what is possible.

Actions:

The RM to provide the presentation from Brooks at the Nationals to members of the GRP.

ANGLE PARK – Thursday night extra race – The RM confirmed with the panel that the extra race Thursday nights which comes from the Saturday heats is now an 8 dog field and has enabled 12 races to be run at Angle Park on a consistent basis which the panel supported.

The RM advised with breeding numbers increasing GRSA are looking at making some changes in the initial stage to the G-SIX / 8 – Dod Quad format bearing in mind the impact increasing some meetings could have on the weekly schedule. He advised that GRSA is looking at increasing City A Angle Park meetings to full 8 dog fields being our premier meeting with the most amount of prizemoney paid out. They are also looking at increasing ALL Time Graded meetings and events to 8 dog fields to give this pool of greyhounds [the most nominated] a racing opportunity [basically APD Saturday once a fortnight, Gawler Wednesday basically once a month, Mt Gambier Thursday once a week and split meetings at Murray Bridge straight and any other meeting this may occur at.]

The RM advised however that Maidens would be excluded from this and remain as 6 dog fields. He advised this would be a staggered process as not to affect the weekly schedule.

Members understood the request however would prefer if the programming was all 8 dog fields or all 6 dog fields as the mixed approach can be confusing. Members suggested was there any options for another race meeting which the RM advised GRSA is looking at all possibilities and what options could be available. It was suggested we could run more races like 13 due to kennel space. The RM took all this information as feedback. Members felt that Time Grading could go to once every 6 weeks at the straight track due to the increased numbers. The RM advised he would look at this in programming. The panel were supportive of the initial change requested to fields.

The RM to increase City A Angle Park meetings to full 8 dog fields, all Time Graded meetings and events to 8 dog fields. Maidens to remain as 6 dog fields. Everything else to remain

under current programming. Effective immediately.

MIDDLE DISTANCE NOMINATIONS AND FIELDS – The panel discussed middle and staying distance generally about the integrity side of things and suggested that maybe to encourage more stayers that prizemoney should be tiered. The panel suggested that if standard grading of a field of 5 to 8 is drawn then normal budgeted money will be paid. However if 4 runners then this should be \$1k less for City A prizemoney. It was also suggested maybe it should be at the 595m prizemoney however they felt reducing for 4 runners would encourage more nominations. The RM advised that he will look at a possible tiered breakdown for staying events and advise the panel. Middle distance would stay at 5 runners with no change. Daniel Grgurovic provided a submission in support of staying events and that the minimum of 4 should not change in support of this pool of greyhounds.

The panel were asked if they supported GRSA putting all greyhounds in 730m events and 680m events at Murray Bridge regardless of class which is the current policy unless a trainer is specific on their nomination. The panel agreed to and supported this for all staying events.

The panel suggested that when considering any prizemoney changes that a FFA over 530m should be worth the same as 595m or 730m at Angle Park for example. The RM took their comments for future reference.

The RM to look at a tiered structure for staying events in regard to 4 or 5 starters for possible implementation.

TIME BANDS FOR TRACKS AND DISTANCES – The RM advised the panel that GRSA had been made aware of changes to tracks in other states which has affected their starting distances. Some have been racing for up to 12 months. He advised the Time Grading report accommodates this by disregarding the performance and using the next start (just like a race fall) however this could mean that some starts are not being considered and not being a true reflection on the greyhound's current performance. He advised he is going through the tracks and distances and will add in the likes of Grafton 350m and 450m and Casino 300m which were not there. The panel were comfortable that this was being addressed.

They suggested that possibly the 342m time ratings needed to be reviewed as they felt greyhounds were running quicker than their ratings. The RM to consider this during the updates.

MT GAMBIER 305M – The RM advised that recently the Mt Gambier GRC with the support of GRSA changed the selection of 305m events on Sundays. He advised where previously 305m races were on the all tracks calendar so the club were finding that the 400m distance nominations were being pushed out. The Clubs preference is for 400m and above races receive preference and then the 305m run in preference order of Young Star Maiden, Juvenile & Masters if required. This has meant that not many 305m events are being run on Sundays however the Club have advised and advertised that there will be a 305m Time Graded event on Thursday each meeting if trainers nominate. The panel were comfortable with this approach being mindful that the 305m distance still needs to be available.

The panel did suggest that Maidens run over 305m on Sundays should be graded on form and not youngest to oldest resulting in some trainers having a full litter in one event. The RM will

advise the club of their recommendation.

Lachlan Mill submission previously – It would be great to get some videos on the Website or Facebook regarding the process of grading and the reasons why we might be delayed in releasing the fields. The RM advised it would be his intention to implement some clips on social media to assist participants in understanding grading and the grading process better.

The RM advised that he has not actioned this as yet.

Late Items previously - Some members requested that Maidens for Feature races (ie Brian Johnstone and Howard Ashton) need to do a qualifying trial before being eligible for these series. The RM advised that at this time there is no requirement for trialling however did advise that the current Brian Johnstone series where we had 5 heats had no Maidens engaged. The panel were comfortable for no changes at present unless performance trials were to be introduced.

3. Agenda Items

SA Country Cup – The RM advised the panel that he had multiple feedback regarding the Country Cup series and whether or not it is still relevant. He questioned with the reduction in County venues over the last 10 years is the likes of Mt Gambier disadvantaged up against Gawler and Murray Bridge. Would there be more relevance for a Mt Gambier to Angle Park on Cup night. Should Gawler be restricted to Prov 2 greyhounds or open to Prov 1 greyhounds? He advised that the Grader generally has to leave a few greyhounds out as they don't meet the published criteria. He asked the panels thoughts of the series. Members suggested there was still relevance in the series and it really depends what kind of greyhounds you have in the kennel at the time. They were happy for the conditions to be reviewed however would like to see it continue.

Actions:

The RM to review conditions of the County Cup and provide any changes to the panel for consideration.

Gawler Feature Race Concept – The RM advised that he had received a new concept for a Feature series at Gawler. He advised whilst nothing is budgeted for, new race series are always worth considering. He provided the panel with the details that looked at match racing, wild card races, picking your own box and slot racing etc. The panel were happy for progression of a new series with the finer points to be detailed. The proposal to be sent to the panel for their thoughts.

Actions:

The RM to format the details for a new race series at Gawler and then seek some approval to implement if the members and club agree.

4. Submissions

The panel discussed submissions from Seamus McAuley 26/7/22 - Several races listed in the racing calendar have recently failed to eventuate due to a lack of nominations. The 2022 Gawler Easter Sprint (530m) feature being one of the most prominent examples. Can consideration be given to implementing the changes below to help alleviate this situation :

- Advise trainers when low nomination counts occur for any calendar listed events.

The RM advised when nominations close that is when an extension occurs. He did advise when a feature series is coming up he will look to send a txt out advising the nominations for the meeting and what feature races are on the day or two before. The panel were comfortable with this process.

- Explore the possibility of the Online Nominations system being enhanced to provide trainers with a break-down of the nomination count for each distance/grade and any particular feature. The nomination count currently displayed is for each distance only and is not of much help.

The RM advised this does need to be addressed specifically about preferences. The nomination count adds up all preferences so there might be 100 nominations for a meeting online however it advises there are 130 nominations which is not correct. Her advised he will get this part fixed first. The RM advised that if the program was broken up into races like a grade 5 530m , a 342m Maiden etc then trainers could nominate straight into these races and it would be a truer reflection of what is nominated where however that would mean for every meeting a program would have to be done prior to nominations closing. This would be an extreme amount of work bearing in mind trainers will still nominate where they want to race not just because a race is in the calendar.

Actions:

The RM to change the preferences online so the numbers are correct. The RM to consider the possibility of programming all events in Ozchase so trainers can nominate directly into these races.

- Priority being given to putting on the races listed in the calendar versus alternatives.

The RM advised so long as there is enough nominations any specific events in the All Tracks calendar will be given preference where possible to normal graded events.

The panel discussed a submission from Kim Johnstone 16/11/22 -

I think a last start placing provincial 2 should be on the order of choice somewhere, perhaps 19 and then reserve 20?

The panel discussed this and agreed that a last start placegetter should be on the Order. The RM advised he will look at the program and see if it can fit at the end or with another preference.

Actions:

The RM to liaise with Ozchase and make the change to the Order of Choice program once a spot is determined for a last start placegetter Prov 2 meeting.

The RM asked the panel about a submission from the Grader regarding Maidens and their Order of Entry. Currently the order of entry for Maidens are if a dog is on the Order, then first starters then using the WPS. The grader identified that on occasions Maidens with placings in their last three starts who are not on the Order are being left out in preference to a first starter. The panel agreed to make a change where the entry criteria for Maidens will be Order of Preference, Maidens with a placing in their last two starts using WPS, First starts then other Maidens using WPS.

Actions:

The RM to change the way Maidens are included in events, as above effective immediately.

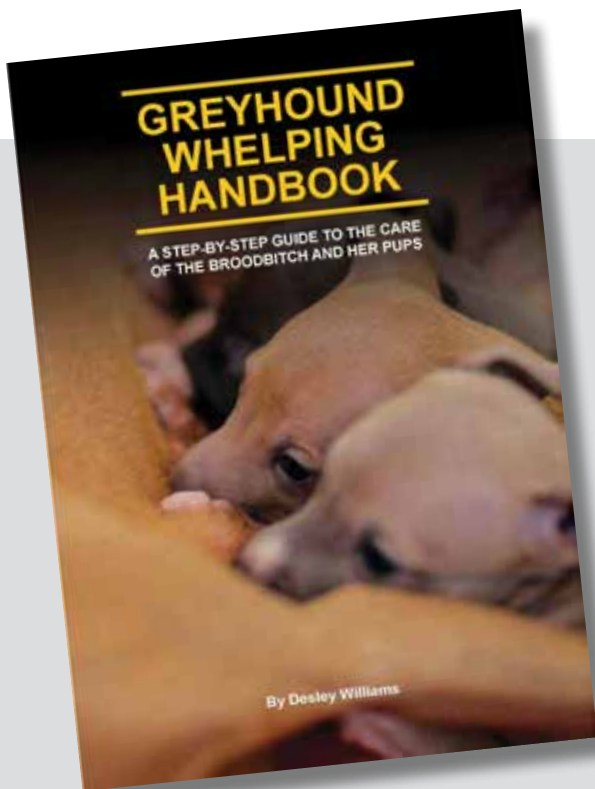
