NOTES FROM THE CHAIRMAN GRANTLEY STEVENS

Recently, GRSA CEO Bodelle Francis has made the difficult decision to take up a new opportunity with the Oakbank Racing Club in 2024.

Greyhound racing in South Australia has been extremely fortunate to have had someone of Bodelle's talents and commitment over the past eighteen months. She has driven improvement across our organisation and has helped steer GRSA through some significant challenges.

Bodelle has worked incredibly hard and we completely understand and respect her decision to focus more on her growing family.

It's important to clarify that Bodelle informed the Board of her decision prior to the release of the Independent Inquiry report, and as such a transition plan is already underway.

GRSA Director Ben Kavenagh has temporarily stepped off the board to assume the role of Interim CEO while our search for a new CEO commences. Ben and Bodelle will complete a thorough handover while also working on GRSA's response to the Inquiry findings with the Senior Management Team and Board.

Bodelle will conclude her time at GRSA in mid-January before commencing at Oakbank on 29 January. We're glad she is not being lost to the racing industry and wish her nothing but success in her new role.

The Premier recently announced the findings of the Independent Inquiry into the Governance of the Greyhound Racing in South Australia.

The Inquiry's report includes:

- An overview of the industry from the inquiry's point of view, highlighting a number of areas of concern.

- A list of 86 recommendations, including 14 recommendations put forward by GRSA that have been recognised and accepted.

- The conclusion that there is an urgent need for the greyhound racing industry in South Australia to reform in order to meet contemporary community expectations.

- A recommendation to establish the role of an independent Greyhound Industry Reform Inspector to oversee this reform, reporting to the Minister for Recreation, Sport & Racing; and

- A period of two years for the industry to demonstrate its achievement of this reform.

This effectively means that our industry has two years to demonstrate just how committed we are to strengthening greyhound racing in South Australia for the future.

Having had the opportunity to do a preliminary review of the report, GRSA agrees with its recommendations in principle. We are pleased that a number of recommendations from our own submission have been recognised and accepted. GRSA have already established an internal working group to start reviewing the report in more detail, raise any gueries with government, and identify any immediate opportunities for reform.

You'll notice that a number of the recommendations align with our immediate priorities or work that is already underway. Some of the evidence presented in the Inquiry's report does not reflect subsequent action taken by industry, and we look forward to addressing this with government.

It is worth noting that the Premier was very clear in his remarks that he does not want to see this important industry shut down, but that there is a very clear window for us to prove that we can change.

We welcome the challenge and are committed to ensuring that we strengthen the industry for the future. I will be sure to keep you updated as we understand the report in more detail and set a clear plan moving forward.

Finally, we would like to wish everyone a safe and happy Christmas and New Year period and for everyone to enjoy the Festival of Fire festivities.

2023 LEIGH ROGERS FINAL



2023 GROUP 3 BRIAN JOHNSTONE FINAL

Rico Nismo pulled off a big surprise in the 2023 Group 3 Brian Johnstone final, winning at massive odds and beating a talented field from box eight in a run filled with impressive race smarts.

The Bosko Stamenkovic pair of Footrot Fender and Magical Mystic finished in second and third to round out the podium places.

From the wide draw, Rico Nismo was able to avoid the early trouble and make up plenty of ground down the back straight hitting the lead in the home straight and winning in 30.84.

It continues an excellent year for Richard Pearce's kennel with Dash Of Blue winning the Shane McQueen and North vs South Challenge earlier this year. Unholy Reign for Robyn Mackellar took out the 2023 Leigh Rogers producing an excellent run to take out the final.

The Leigh Rogers Series was named for former Greyhound Racing SA Food and Beverage Manager Leigh Rogers, who passed away in 2016 after a short battle with an aggressive cancer.

From box three, Unholy Reign showed all its early speed and was able to surge to the lead and from there it was never under threat enjoying clear running out in front and winning by two lengths in 30.83 just 0.01 outside of its personal best.

It was a special night with Leigh's family on course including his three daughters, who were kindly given the trophy named for their father by Robyn after the race in a very kind and generous moment.





2023 FISCHER MOTORS COUNTRY SUMMERS OAKS AND DERBY

The recent feature event on the Murray Bridge calendar was the Country Summer Oaks and Debry which had a boosted prize pool thanks to new sponsor Fischer Motors.

With a booked out Doyle's Function Centre, three features were run including the 2023 Murray Bridge Anniversary Cup over the 530m journey which was taken out by the Adrien Chevalier-trained Man Of Substance who won in 30.18.

Race six on the card was the Fischer Motors Summer Oaks, which was taken out by the Liz Chegia trained, Fantastic Ada. Spearing to the early lead with a 7.93 first section. While Fantastic Ada went a bit wide around the turn, she was able to find a kick and win by two and a half lengths in 25.62. Purified finished second for Lauren Harris while Fantastic Helga also for the Chegia team finished in third.

Race eight was the Country Summer Derby which was taken out by the Don Turner trained Know I'm One.

Showing plenty of early speed, Lockaba Rocket and Know I'm One matched it in the early speed battle before Know I'm One was able to find an early advantage with some trouble in behind.

While enjoying a break in the home straight, Know I'm One tired late with Lockaba Rocket closing in but was unable to close the gap with Know I'm One holding on to win in 25.88 ahead of Lockaba Rocket with Murphy McLaren finishing in third place.

HEATS SA SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP NEXT MONTH

Owners and Trainers are reminded of the domiciliary clause on the SA Sprint Championship coming up in January. To be eligible, a greyhound must have been domiciled in SA for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the time fixed for the finalising of nominations and drawing of fields. [Nationals policy adopted] The date going back 76 days is 19th October as nominations close on Tuesday, 2nd January 2024.

The \$5,810 Heats are scheduled to be run on Thursday, 4th January, with the Final to be run on Thursday, 11th January. Total prizemoney for the listed Final will be \$22,000.

JOHN GRAY FINAL IN JANUARY

The time-honoured John Gray series will be held in January with \$4,050 Heats run on Thursday, 11th January and the \$14,275 Final on Thursday, 18th January.

The series is for Grade 5 greyhounds over the 530m journey.

SA BRED DOUG PAYNE FEATURE ON JANUARY 25TH

ST LEGER HEATS ON THURSDAY 1st FEBRUARY

LAUNCHING PAD SA SERIES BEGINS ON 22nd FEBRUARY

Again, this year the Sandown GRC will offer a sweepstake ticket into the rich Launching Pad Series.

There are special conditions on the race, being for greyhounds that have won between 1 and 6 races and have not had more than 30 starts at close of their nominations.

The Heats will be run at Sandown over the 515m on Thursday, 14th March with the Semi-Finals on Thursday, 21st March and the \$150,000 to the winner Final run on Thursday, 28th March. GRSA will secure a ticket and will give one greyhound the opportunity to compete in this lucrative series. We will run a Heat and Final series to determine who will make the Launching Pad Heats on 14th March.

Our Heats will be run on Thursday, 22nd February over the 530m at Angle Park for greyhounds that have won 1-4 races and no more than 28 starts at time of nominations. The Heats will be worth \$4,050 and will be Non Penalty events. The Final will be run at Angle Park on Thursday, 29th February over the 530m with prizemoney of \$5,810 and will also be Non Penalty.

The winner of the Final will take their spot in the Launching Pad Heats two weeks later, however, if the winner cannot take their spot (would need to be confirmed by GRSA as a satisfactory reason) then the next qualified greyhound will be given that spot.

GRSA has restricted the series to 1-4 wins and 28 starts incase a greyhound wins both the Heat and Final so this will still keep them eligible. If greyhounds win outside the series this may deem them ineligible for the Sandown series. We have also made our Final two weeks before the Launching Pad Heats at Sandown to give the trainer an opportunity to get across the border and trial for the big race.

HEATS GAWLER CLASSIC 2023 – 531m

The Heats of the Gawler Classic 2023 over 531m will be run on Sunday, 31st December with the \$4,500 Final on Friday, 5th January. This series is for greyhounds paid up for Classic 2023.

FEATURE GOLDEN MAIDEN SERIES IN JANUARY WITH FINAL WORTH \$10,000

The Feature Golden Maiden Series will be held in January over the 531m journey. The \$1,640 Heats will be run on Sunday, 21st January with the \$10,000 Final on Sunday, 28th January.

Nominations for the Heats close Wednesday, 17th January 2024 with GRSA at 9.00am.

GAWLER BREEDERS 2024 HEATS IN FEBRUARY

The first part of the Breeders 2024 series kicks off with \$1,600 Heats on Sunday, 18th February over the 400m [Short Course].

The \$3,300 Final will be run on Sunday, 25th February 2024. For SA Bred greyhounds paid up for Breeders 2024

MOUNT GAMBIER SUMMER CLASSIC ON SUNDAY 21st JANUARY WORTH \$10,000

GRSA advise that the \$10,000 Mt Gambier Summer Classic Final over the 512m will be run on Sunday, 21st January.

Heats will be run on Sunday, 14th January. Special Event for all dogs and bitches whelped on or after 1/1/2022. If insufficient nominations for 2 or more Heats a one-off Final will be run on Sunday, 21st January with preference to original nominations.

MURRAY BRIDGE SPRINT CLASSIC ON SUNDAY 14th JANUARY WORTH \$10,000

GRSA advise that the \$10,000 Murray Bridge Sprint Classic Final over the 395m will be run on Sunday, 14th January. \$2,095 Heats will be run on Sunday, 7th Januray.

GROUP 3 MURRAY BRIDGE CUP ONE WEEK LATER IN MARCH

The Murray Bridge Cup series has been moved back one week in March 2024. The series was due to be run on Sunday, 3rd and 10th March, however, the Speedway across the road has one of their main meetings for the year now scheduled on March 10, the same night as the Cup Final was due to be run. It is preferred that the greyhounds do not race at the same time as the speedway, especially in competition with the Clubs only Group 3 feature event of the year.

After consultation with the Murray Bridge GRC and Gawler GRC it was agreed to make the below

changes –

• Gawler will now race on Sunday night, 10th March [Public Holiday]

• Murray Bridge will now race on Monday night, 11th March for the Heats (Public Holiday)

• Angle Park will now race on Friday, 8th March

Due to the movements above GRSA will also change

• Gawler to race on Friday, 15th March

• Murray Bridge to race on Sunday night, 17th March for the Group 3 Final

This will mean that the Heats of the Group 3 Murray Bridge Cup will be on Monday night, 11th March and the \$36,000 Group 3 Murray Bridge Cup Final will be run on Sunday, 17th March

AGRC GRADE 6 LOW GRADE FEATURE IN JANUARY

The next low grade series at Angle Park is a Grade 6 series over 530m with \$3,680 Heats on Thursday, 18th January with the \$5,810 Final on Thursday, 25th January. AGRC sponsors with \$500 to owner and \$500 to trainer if winner of Final is an AGRC Member.

MAIDEN/GRADE 6 LOW GRADE FEATURE IN FEBRUARY

The low grade series in February at Angle Park is a Maiden/Grade 6 series over 595m with \$4,050 Heats on Thursday, 15th February with the \$5,810 Final on Thursday, 22nd February.

• Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 12th February at 9.00am.

GOTY AWARDS NIGHT ON SATURDAY 3RD FEBRUARY

Please be advised that Greyhound Racing SA will hold the Annual Greyhound of the Year awards night on Saturday, 3rd February 2024 to be held at Angle Park.

JUNE'S GRADING REVIEW PANEL MEETING OUTCOMES – MAIN POINTS

• GRSA will allow one extra Grade 6 over another distance for City A Thursday meetings bringing this into line with all tracks in SA. No retrospectivity regarding this change. Implemented

• GRSA has removed the condition where once a greyhound has won a Grade 5 or higher event on a City A meeting that the greyhound will lose all Grade 6 events at all other tracks. This means a greyhound could be a Grade 4 or Grade 3 over 530m on a Thursday City A meeting and will still be able to win Grade 6 events at other tracks. No retrospectivity

regarding this change. Implemented

• GRSA will now allow a greyhound after winning a Grade 5 Masters event in faster time than the time standard to get back into Masters with 2 runs in a Grade 5 at the track and distance, it doesn't matter if they are placed or unplaced just so long as there are two starts out of Masters. This has been changed from being just unplaced to get back. Implemented

STAYING EVENTS TO MOVE TO 5 RUNNERS AS A MINIMUM FROM JANUARY 2024

For a number of years GRSA has supported our staying ranks by running these events with a minimum of 4 runners. GRSA has tried to encourage this pool to grow at the expense of other events on a program, even with such small numbers. However, from meetings drawn in January 2024 any staying event programmed will need to be a minimum of 5 runners to be considered in the program. This will affect the Angle Park 730m, Murray Bridge 680m and Mt Gambier 732m.

GRSA will continue to review processes in relation to the field size and scheduling.

TRIALLING OVER XMAS AND NEW YEAR

This year Xmas day falls on a Monday with Tuesday, 26th December being Boxing Day. There will be NO trials on Xmas Day and NO trials at Angle Park on Tuesday night. There will be trials at Murray Bridge on Wednesday, 27th and Gawler Thursday, 28th December as normal.

There will be NO trials at Angle Park on Sunday, 31st December due to staffing availability.

Over the New Year period there will be NO trials on Monday, 1st January at Murray Bridge and NO trials at Gawler on Monday, 1st January.

NO TRIALS AT MURRAY BRIDGE ON 15th AND 22nd JANUARY

Please note that there will be No Trials at Murray Bridge on Monday, 15th January and Monday, 22nd January due to staffing issues.

MURRAY BRIDGE SCRATCHINGS TUESDAY 26TH DECEMBER

Due to Xmas Day on Monday, we will have to finalise the scratchings for the Murray Bridge Straight Track run on Tuesday, 26th December at the same time as Gawler on Sunday (8am – 9am on Sunday, 24th December).

2024 GAWLER PRODUCE STAKES – NOMINATIONS RE-EXTENED TO FRIDAY 5TH JANURAY

GRSA advises that the nominations for the 2024 Gawler Produce have been re-extended until close of business next Friday, 5th January. There were 77 nominations after the first extension and the series will need around 100 nominations to ensure Heats, and Semi-Finals. Due to this re-extension the second payment will also move to Friday, 9th February. Please contact GRSA for further information if required.

INDUSTRY CONSULTATIVE GROUP PANEL MEETING OUTCOMES – IMPLEMENTED FROM 1ST SEPTEMBER

GRSA has been publishing the changes in policy and penalties to be applied from the ICG meeting and introduced from 1st September.

• There will only be one provisional breeders license being provided to multiple participants residing at the same residence. All other applications would be dealt with on a case by case basis. For implementation from 1st September.

• 2 in 7 starts and 7 in 28 starts rule. The ICG agreed that a 10 day stand down period would be an appropriate penalty for those that knowingly nominated greyhounds that would be ineligible due to the rule. It was suggested any further infringements could attract a monetary penalty. To clarify, any penalty would only apply once the dog had gone around, not in instances with late scratchings etc. It is the trainer's responsibility to be aware of this rule and their implications. For implementation for meetings conducted from the 1st September.

• The ICG panel confirmed and supported a \$100 fine for any late Pink Card applications. For implementation

from 1st September.

• The ICG panel supported all trialling to be booked through the Trial Booker process to ensure specific criteria is met. Management to investigate amending trial booker into group categories to achieve greater efficiency at the session.

TRIAL BOOKER NOW INCORPORATING GAWLER THURSDAY TRIALS

Gawler online nominations for Thursday mornings started a few weeks ago. Please be mindful that bookings will close 3 pm the day prior (Wednesday) with GRSA administration staff overseeing the bookings as normal. GRSA has increased the number of bookings for each Gawler session from 4 to 6 trials per trainer. This is to assist trainers with greyhounds which trial one after another.

ShortlY we will turn our attention to the Monday trial session which will require our race day and offsite staff to manage.

TO MBGRC REGISTERED TRAINER MEMBERS

On behalf of the MBGRC Committee:

The MBGRC Committee wish to advise the MBGRC Registered Trainer Members that you must book your trials, otherwise you may be disappointed when the Murray Bridge Greyhound Racing track staff refuse to trial your greyhounds. Being a dual track facility, the Murray Bridge track staff require prior notification advising names of trainers booked for trials, at what time and on which track.

There are still a few MBGRC Registered Trainers yet to pay this year's (2023/2024) members renewal fee, trainers who are not members of the MBGRC are required to pay \$10 for each trial.

VACCINATION RULE FOR RACING IN SA

Trainers are reminded that Rule 25 (Minimum Vaccination Requirements) took effect Monday, 1st May. Vaccination Certificates must be received by GRSA prior to close of nominations for affected greyhounds to be considered eligible.

ONLINE NOMINATIONS UPDATED WITH VACCINATION DETAILS OF GREYHOUNDS

OzChase have update the currency of the Greyhound's vaccination and it is displayed within Online Nominations. Each Greyhound on the Currently Trained list of a trainer will include a new column displaying the latest vaccination date recorded. It will be colour coded according to the condition outlined below:

CURRENT MASTERS TIMES AND POLICY

• For greyhounds 3³/₄ years and older. 4yo and older will get preference. City A, City B and Prov 1 meetings are done by form for 4yo and older and then greyhounds will only get in from under 4yo to 3³/₄ yo in age from oldest to youngest. Prov 2 meetings are all done on age from oldest to youngest regardless of form for all ages.

• Dates are exact so going back 4yo and $3\frac{3}{4}$ from the date of race. le date of race run on 20/11/22 - 4yo would be 20/11/18 whelping.

• Time restrictions if a greyhound wins a Grade 5 Masters race in a faster time than published and it will have to have 2 runs (placed or unplaced) in normal company at that class of meeting before being eligible at that class of meeting.

• The Grader will look to grade a Grade 5 Masters event on every program over a distance if enough dogs are nominated regardless if it is advertised in the All Tracks calendar.

• All races Non Penalty.

If a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading. If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs, only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters (ie Grade 2/3 & 4) we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event.

305m Masters Policy for Mt Gambier – With Mt Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events, however, factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance. There will still be a Time Standard applied based on the published table being 17.75. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week. The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month.

These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner & \$150 to the Breeder.

At the ICG meeting in January the SA Bred Bonus scheme was tabled for discussion where when we have 200 or more SA bred winners we go over budget and there is no monthly payment for the Owner of Breeder separate to the \$225. It was discussed that this was happening more regularly with more racing and more SA Bred greyhounds winning events. It was suggested increasing the base amount from \$225 and removing monthly payments, therefore, reducing monthly administration of the scheme. The Board advised changes to be implemented from 1 July 2023, however, kept the base amount at \$225 due to the increased numbers and racing opportunities. Due to this change the SA bred winners will no longer be listed in Kennel Capers each month.

For the month of July there were 203 winners, August there were 197, September there were 196, October 226 and November 209 [we are 31 winners over budget]

When do trial bookings commence each week?

Bookings for meetings will commence at 11.30am the working day prior to the trial session [henceforth known as "booking opening time"].

Is there a limit to how many trials I can book online?

Yes: 4 (Gawler is 6). If you wish to reserve more than 4 trials a session then you must phone the office as per normal. For example, in the screenshot below, it indicates that you can book 3 more trials using TrialBooker without phoning.

Why am I limited to 4 trials in one block?

In short: to prevent abuse of the system. To book more phone the office after booking opening time.

Can I cancel a trial booking online? Yes: Press the X button and confirm.



Will I receive a confirmation to confirm my online trial booking?

Your trials are reserved for you as soon as you press the "Book 4" button (or "Book 4" or whichever it may be). You must then confirm the details of those trials (distance, number of dogs etc.). There will be a summary of your bookings in each session on the Home page.

Can I book trials for other licensees? No—under no circumstances may you book trials for anyone other than yourself using TrialBooker. Dogs must be brought in and paid for by the person whose name they were booked under. If you wish to share a non-field trial with another trainer you must book over the phone.

How can I book a trial if I don't have access to a computer?

You can still book trials by calling the office after booking opening time.

At the end of the month Adhana Rico's record stood at 60 starts for 19 wins and 21 placings and earnings around \$134,000.



The Run of the Month for November was the Gavin Harris trained Lena Jinx for her sensational track record performance at Angle Park on Thursday, 16th November over the 730m journey in a Free For All staying event. Taking on the king of stayers in Zipping Neutron, she quickly jumped to the front in a small field, from there she gave nothing else a chance winning by over 7 lengths. The time had to be fast because "Neutron" could only manage third place so when the 42.29 was semaphored it made sense that she smashed the track record by around three lengths.

Please remember to book in your greyhound's vet work AFTER you submit the GAP placement form.

Payment of placement fees

The \$60 placement fee is due at the time the placement form is submitted, payment can be made by either completing the card details on the form or by paying in cash. The placement form will only be processed, and the greyhound placed in GAP, once payment has been received

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

We continue to look to increase these further in order to offer a wider variety of times to meet participants varying requirements. The following graph depicts the number of assessments that have been occurring on a monthly basis.

RACING REPORT



QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during nondaylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start

2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track

3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

- 1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
- For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- 6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
 Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
- 10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.

Thinking of making changes to your kennels?

Some changes to your kennels may need Council approval.


