## CEO'S UPDATE

### People and History

The recent Greyhound of the Year event provides a timely reminder of how important it is for a sport to recognise its history and heritage. In addition to the various awards which were announced at the recent awards night for the 2019 calendar year, an appropriate amount of time was also allocated to recognising three stalwarts of the sport in South Australia, and to acknowledge the outstanding contribution that each has made in support of greyhound racing. That trio included Don Foster, Jane McNicholl and June Whyte, whose feats within, and service to the sport require no elaboration for those in the SA scene.

It brings me to a related topic that is bubbling away in the background. A former licensed trainer in SA, Tony Welfare, has been volunteering his time to conduct interviews with many of our more experienced (yes, sorry, that does mean 'older' in most instances!) trainers, breeders and administrators amongst others, for a future book on SA greyhound racing. Our primary objective is to capture this state's historical record and to ensure that the opportunity to do so isn't lost to us – which inevitably happens at some point – due to the passage of time.

The next steps in this initiative will involve the process of editing the hours and hours of tape which will have been compiled at that point into a publishable format. At the same time, we will also need to put out a 'call to action', seeking photographic records from registered participants and others close to the sport which will drive the visual aspect of the book. I would anticipate the use of mobile scanners at race meetings in support of that exercise to remove the risk of people having to entrust their valuable photos to GRSA for any given period of time.

I hope that anyone who is approached by Tony will invest confidence in the process and become involved. This is a really important initiative, and one which [I hope] will provide those who read the final document – some time from now – with a great sense of pride and a deeper appreciation of our identity.

### **2019 SA Stud Dog of the Year WORM BURNER - 144**

Worm Burner was awarded the leading SA Sire for 2019. In 2019 progeny of Worm Burner won 144 races, amazingly 122 wins in front of his nearest rival in a dominant year. His best performed greyhound was Coorong Lucy which won 14 races including a heat of the 2019 SA Oaks and the heat and final of the Leigh Rogers Grade 6 feature. Other handy performers included Miss Takiri [13 wins] and Kisses For Cloda [13 wins].

### **2019 SA Brood Bitch of the Year VICTA VICTORIA - 92**

This was the second year that Victa Victoria has won Brood Bitch of the Year, with 92 winners in 2019 compared to 69 last year. Her winners were out of the El Grand Senior litter, which produced 9 pups and the Cosmic Rumble litter, which produced 7 pups.

These included Victa Caleb winner of 18 races including the Anniversary Cup at Gawler, a heat of the Gawler Sprint Classic [3rd in final] and he was second in a heat of the SA St Leger [8th in final] while Victa Kylie winner of 15 races and starred at Gawler over the 400m. Victa Ashley [9 wins], Victa Norman [9 wins] and Victa Boris [9 wins] also had outstanding performances during the year.

### **2019 SA Breeder of the Year JUDI HURLEY – 117 POINTS**

This was the tenth time this award has been presented and was introduced to recognize the outstanding eligible Breeder in the State. This award is decided on a point's basis for SA Bred greyhounds that have won races at Sky Racing meetings during 2019 in SA.

Judi had a terrific year with her brood bitch's which included Emerley Seniorita and Emerley Avenue. The Emerley Seniorita litter with Magic Sprite produced Madam Onyx [8 wins] while her litter with Zero Ten produced the likes of Emerley Zero [11 wins], Emerley Fabbro [7 wins] and Emerley Judge [4 wins]. Emerley Avenue's litter with Humdrum and produced exciting youngsters Slippery Jack [7 wins] and Emerley Hummer [7 wins].

### **2019 TAB Leading Trainer of the Year TONY RASMUSSEN – 177**

Tony Rasmussen made it a quadrangle of training awards as he was awarded the TAB leading Trainer of the Year for the fourth year in a row, with a total of 177 winners at TAB meetings in SA during 2019 increasing from his 168 from last year. Tony received great support again from his wife Lisa and children making it a real family business.

Interestingly Lisa came in forth in this year's leading trainer award with 131 wins up from her 114 from last year. Daughter Tara also joined the training ranks winning her first race as a trainer at Murray Bridge on 14th July with Missing Queen and training 9 winners in total. The Rasmussen family trained an outstanding 317 winners for the year.



### **2019 SA Owner/Trainer of the Year (Tier 3) CAMERON BUTCHER - 64**

Again Cameron Butcher was the leading Owner/Trainer of the Year with a total of 64 TAB winners in 2019. Cameron had good success with his greyhounds, highlighted by two of his stars Time's Right [15 wins] and Coorong Lucy [14 wins] being nominated as finalists for this year's 2019 GOTY. Cameron usually races in partnership with his wife Yvonne and daughter Karen. Cameron also had a number of young greyhounds hit the track this year which no doubt have a bright future.

### **2019 SA Syndicate of the Year "RAZZA RACING" Syndicate Manager – Lisa Rasmussen**

This was the thirteenth time that this Award had been presented to acknowledge an important part of our industry in Syndication. The "Razza Racing" Syndicate was formed on 12th October 2018 with members including Tony, Jake and Tara Rasmussen along with Tayla Pidgeon. The Syndicate owned 20 greyhounds in 2019 winning 71 races between them. The main performers were Nirimba Pirate [12 wins], Where's Sparky [7 wins], Cawbourne Swade [6 wins] and Little Earner [6 wins].

### **2019 SA City Strike Rate KIRIN CORBY – 36.48%**

This award is based on performances for Angle Park city meetings [City A/City B]. The trainer must also have a minimum of 20 starters for the year. This was back to back wins for Kirin who qualified through the performance of exciting but injury prone sprinter Querencia who won 6 races from his 6 starts including the Group 3 Howard Ashton final along with Eedee Keepsake and Emmy Gray with 6 wins each. During 2019 Kirin trained 27 winners from 74 starters at city meetings, giving her a 36.48% strike rate.

### **2019 Gawler Trackstar Award VICTA KYLIE – 29 starts (13/4/2)**

Victa Kylie had all of her 29 starts for the year at the Gawler venue and over the 400m journey with her best time being 22.67. She made the final of the Gawler Sprint Classic on Gawler Cup final night in November after winning her heat, finishing in 7th position in the final. She won an amazing 44% of her starts at Gawler and was placed in 73% of her races showing her wonderful strike rate and consistency during the year.

### **2019 Run Of The Year SHIMA BREEZE (January)**

The Run of the Year was Shima Breeze for her brilliant performance at Angle Park in the listed SA Sprint Championship final at Angle Park on Thursday, 17th January 2019. Owned by Matt Lehman and Tim Aloisi and being trained by Tony Rasmussen at the time, she led her rivals a merry dance pouncing on the early lead and never giving her opposition a chance. She stopped the clock in a brilliant 29.30 for the 515m journey in winning by 7.25 lengths with sizzling splits of 4.30 and 16.55.

Shima Breeze won this award based on the combination of the public votes where she was voted first and votes from the GOTY Panel where she was also voted first.

## Gawler Breeders 2020 – Heats later this month

The first part of the Breeders 2020 series kicks off with Heats on Friday, 28th February over the 400m. The Final will be run on Sunday, 8th March 2020. This series is for SA Bred greyhounds paid up for Breeders 2020.

- Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday, 24th February.

## Launching Pad SA Series begins on 5th March

Again this year the Sandown GRC offered sweepstakes tickets into the rich Launching Pad Series.

There are special conditions on the race, being for greyhounds that have won between 1 and 6 races and have not had more than 30 starts at close of their nominations.

The Heats will be run at Sandown over the 515m on Thursday, 26th March with the Semi-Finals on Thursday, 2nd April and the \$150,000 to the winner Final run on Thursday, 9th April. Greyhound Racing SA was able to secure a ticket and will give one greyhound the opportunity to compete in this lucrative series. We will run a Heat and Final series to determine who will make the Launching Pad Heats on 26th March.

Our Heats will be run on Thursday, 5th March over the 515m at Angle Park for greyhounds that have won 1-4 races and no more than 28 starts. The Heats will be worth \$3,855 and will be Non Penalty events. The Final will be run at Angle Park on Thursday, 12th March over the 515m with prizemoney of \$5,545 and will also be Non Penalty.

The winner of the Final will take their spot in the Launching Pad Heats two weeks later, however, if the winner for whatever reason cannot take their spot then the next qualified greyhound will be given that spot.

GRSA has restricted the series to 1-4 wins and 28 starts incase a greyhound wins both the heat and final so this will still keep them eligible. We have also made our Final two weeks before the Launching Pad Heats at Sandown to give the trainer an opportunity to get across the border and trial for the big race.

- Nominations close with GRSA for the SA Heats at 9am on Monday, 2nd March.

## Murray Bridge and Mount Gambier Cups in March/April with big bonuses

It will be a big couple of months of racing in March and April for the Murray Bridge and Mount Gambier Clubs when they conduct their Cup meetings.

The Murray Bridge Cup series will be run in early March, with the 2020 Daish Irrigation & Fodder Murray Bridge Cup Final to be run on Sunday, 15th March over the 455m. The Cup is a listed event and will carry \$22,000 in total prizemoney with \$15,000 to the winner.

On Friday, 6th March [a day meeting as the Murray Bridge Speedway is on the Sunday night, Murray Bridge and Gawler have swapped] the Club will conduct the Daish Irrigation & Fodder Murray Bridge Cup Heats worth \$2,500 with a strong line up of contenders expected.

On Final night the Club will not only feature the \$22,000 Daish Irrigation & Fodder Murray Bridge Cup Final it will also feature a \$3,000 Consolation of the Cup which trainers will need to renominate for, a \$4,000 Special Event over the 530m [N/P], a \$3,000 Special Event over the 395m [N/P].

- Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday, 2nd March.

The Mount Gambier Cup carnival will be run over two weeks, highlighted by the 2020 Bourne Kennels Mount Gambier Cup Final on Sunday, April 5. The Cup is a listed event and will carry \$22,000 in total prizemoney with \$15,000 to the winner.

On Sunday, 29th March the Club will conduct the Bourne Kennels Mount Gambier Cup Heats with 8 terrific Heats anticipated. The Club will also be running Heats of The Produce Store Feature Maiden over 512m.

On Sunday, 5th April the Club will not only feature the \$22,000 Bourne Kennels Mount Gambier Cup Final it will also feature a Consolation of the Cup, which trainers will need to renominate for, The Produce Store Maiden Final, along with feature events over 400m, 600m and 732m.

It looks to be a superb two weeks of racing in the South East of the State.

- Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Tuesday, 24th March.

GRSA will continue a couple of bonuses to link both events which will include a \$5,000 bonus if the same dog can win both the Murray Bridge Cup and Mount Gambier Cup and a \$5,000 trainer bonus if the same trainer can win both Cups [SA or Interstate or different dogs].

# Coorong Lucy following in Dad's footsteps

Greyhound of the Month for January was Coorong Lucy for trainer Cameron Butcher who won three of her four starts for the month which included two feature events.

The daughter of Worm Burner and Molly Be Nimble started the month off with a strong win in the Murray Bridge Oaks Final where she dug deep to win as a short priced favourite. She headed back to headquarters where she was far from disgraced in her Heat of the Listed SA Sprint Championship where she ran third. She made amends in the Final defeating a hot line up by over 12 lengths when she was able to lead throughout and run a blistering 29.52 for the 515m journey. She finished the month off with an easy win in Juvenile company, again running sizzling time.

At the end of the month Coorong Lucy's record stood at 25 starts for 17 wins and 6 placings and earnings around \$55,000.



# Zippering Galon fires around Angle Park in near record time

The Run of the Month for January was the Ben Rawlings trained Zippering Galon for his fantastic performance at Angle Park over the 731m on Thursday, 9th January.

A recent addition to the Rawlings kennel, he created a huge impression when he led most of the trip running splits of 16.31 and 29.52 with an amazing overall time of 42.70, this was only .2 outside the track record. His time recorded was as fast as any stayer had gone in the last 10 years.



## Murray Bridge trial changes in March

**In March due to the speedway being conducted on Sundays at Murray Bridge on two occasions we will have two Fridays at Murray Bridge during the month and two Sundays at Gawler.**

These dates will be Friday 6th and 27th March for Murray Bridge and Sunday night for Gawler on 8th and 29th March. With this being the case the trial days will be swapped with Gawler trialling on Friday 6th and 27th and Murray Bridge trialling on Thursday 5th and 26th March.

GRSA also advise that from March there will no longer be officiating staff available to clear greyhounds for Satisfactory trials and Qualifying Qualy trials on the fortnightly Tuesday nights at Murray Bridge.

GRSA will send an official to Murray Bridge on a monthly basis on a Friday morning trial session, which has both tracks trialling. This presents an opportunity to also include the Straight Track for Qualifying and Satisfactory Trials. The trial session for March will be Friday, 20th March.

## Breeders 2020 Prelude (1) heats on 23rd March

**Heats of Prelude (1) for Breeders 2020 will be run on Monday, 23rd March at Angle Park.**

The Series is for all greyhounds eligible for Breeders 2020. The Final will be run on Monday, 30th March.

Prizemoney will be determined after nominations close.

- Nominations close Wednesday, 18th March with GRSA at 9.00am.

## 600m Easter Cup heats coming up on April 2

**The \$4,560 Heats of the Mixed 3/4/5 Easter Cup will be run over 600m for a \$7,750 Final on Thursday, 9th April.**

- Nominations for the Heats close on Monday, 30th March at 9.00am with GRSA.

## Easter features at Gawler on Easter Monday

**Easter racing comes to Gawler in April with both the Gawler Future Stars Final and Gawler Easter Sprint programmed on Monday, 13th April.**

The Gawler Future Stars Heats will be conducted for SA Bred greyhounds whelped in 2018 on Friday, 3rd April over the 531m with a \$4,500 Final on Easter Monday. Also on Easter Monday will be the Gawler Easter Sprint for Grade 4 and Grade 5 greyhounds over the 531m worth \$3,500. It's going to be a terrific night of racing on the Monday night over the Easter break.

- Nominations for the Gawler Future Stars Heats close at 9.00am on Monday, 30th March.

## “Estar” Match Race series in April

**The “Estar” Match Race series will be held on Thursday night, 9th April (Easter) at headquarters.**

This event is for South Australian local greyhounds with selection for the series based around winning times for greyhounds that have run over the 515m at any Angle Park meeting since 1st December, 2019 along with those that have trialled (see trialling conditions below) to set a time.

It will be an exciting night with innovative coverage from inside the boxes and around the track for each match race. There will be specific greyhound rugs for each greyhound adding to the promotion around the Easter theme.

Prizemoney for each match will be between \$4,500 and \$3,000 with GRSA adding \$500 for each greyhound which places second in their match. The overall winner will collect \$6,000.

Listed below is the current list of greyhounds (subject to domiciliary eligibility) that have won and broken 29.90 seconds at Angle Park since 1st December, 2019. GRSA will separate equal times to a third decimal point if required closer to the event.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3, Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. There will be no manual selection from the Grader.

The overall winner of the local Match Race series will be guaranteed a spot in the State of Origin Match race series (SA V Vic) in September so long as it is nominated and eligible to represent SA.

### Prizemoney for the match races –

Winners receive - Match 1 – 1 v 4 \$4,500, Match 2 – 2 v 3 \$4,000, Match 3 – 5 v 8 \$3,500, Match 4 – 6 v 7 \$3,000.

Runner Ups receive - \$500.

Overall SA Easter winner (based on overall times) - \$6,000, second \$2,500, third \$1,500.

- Nominations close Monday, 6th April with GRSA at 9.00am.



### 'Easter' Trialling conditions

Trials will be conducted Thursday, 19th March, Thursday, 26th March and Thursday, 2nd April at the Angle Park race meetings over the 515m.

There will be up to eight trials conducted each night, with a maximum of two dogs per trial and a total of 8 greyhounds trialling per night. These trials will be run between races at the discretion of the Stewards. Trainers must book these trials with Greyhound Racing SA by 11.00am on the day.

All greyhounds will be eligible to trial, whether on the current list of greyhounds that have broken 29.90 seconds in winning since 1st December, 2019 at Angle Park to improve their position or haven't won over the 515m from 1st December, 2019 at the absolute discretion of the Grader. Local eligibility conditions still apply. Each greyhound will only be allowed to trial once in an effort to improve their position or obtain a spot on the list.

## Murray Bridge Straight Track Cup confirmed in May 2020

**GRSA advises that the inaugural Murray Bridge Straight Track Cup Final will be run on Wednesday, 27th May 2020 worth \$7500/\$2140/\$1070.**

The Heats will be conducted on Wednesday, 20th May 2020.

## Accell Therapy mat moved into Vet clinic

**Management has moved the Accell Therapy mat into the Vet Clinic to provide a greater opportunity for it to be used.**

It is recommended that a greyhound derives benefit with a 15 to 20 minute session and is generally for recovery from racing or injury. Please do not hesitate to ask when next in the Vet Clinic at GRSA.

## Time Graded and Pathway events (reserves)

**The GRSA Racing Department wishes to advise of an update to the process of allocating reserves for Time Grading (worst-to-best) meetings.**

Currently the Time Grading methodology does not allow for the allocation of reserves to the majority of races, therefore increasing the likelihood of reduced field sizes.

Under the new methodology, greyhounds will be grouped into races according to their Time Rating, including the reserves:

- 8 greyhounds for G-SIX racing (6 in the field plus 2 reserves)
- 10 greyhounds for traditional 8 dog racing (8 in the field plus 2 reserves)

A random draw will then be conducted to determine the two reserve greyhounds. If only one race then reserves as per Time Rating Rankings. This process is demonstrated in a table available on the GRSA website.

This change has been implemented for all Time Grading meetings from 1st January, 2020.

## Changes to Mount Gambier Time Grading

**After consultation with industry and local participants from the Mount Gambier region, GRSA will continue the trial of the Best to Worst format for the Mount Gambier Thursday meetings.**

GRSA has made this change to accommodate the strong nominations for this venue and attempting to give all greyhounds of all abilities the opportunity to compete. This will generally be run on a fortnight basis however if there are not 12 races being conducted for all meetings GRSA will consider reviewing this process.

Conditions for the Best to Worst meetings will be based on the greyhounds Time Rating. There will be a limit of 5 as to how fast a greyhound can be rated. Greyhounds rated 4.75 to 1 will not be eligible for this meeting but will be given preference into the Sunday meeting of that week so long as they nominate and there is a race available. Under this format GRSA will be able to include reserves for all races under the discretion of the grader. The more than 50% of fastest rated greyhound eligibility clause will not refer to Best to Worst Time Graded events.

Please contact the GRSA Grader for further information about Time Graded events.

## Auto-sorting for grading up and running

**GRSA advises that the auto sorting of the Order of Preference for Grading purposes has started.**

This process will reduce this part of the process by about 2 hours and does remove some of the discretion of the Grader because it will also incorporate all greyhounds, even those off the Order with a Weighted Points Score (WPS) table.

The WPS will assist with the selection of those greyhounds not on the Order of Preference so all greyhounds will effectively be sorted into an order for selection.

GRSA has the support from the GRP that when using the automation that if the order of entry by Order of Preference, Race wins or WPS is discovered to be incorrect after fields have been drawn that GRSA will NOT redraw the race in question (so long as the greyhound is correctly graded). If this did occur then the affected greyhound will get first preference at its next nomination.

GRSA will publicise the Order of Preference and WPS document once grading of each meeting is completed to be posted on the GRSA website similar to the Time Grading report.



## Weighted Point Score table

All greyhounds will also have a WPS calculated based upon the WPS table. There is no age criteria on the start dates when calculating the WPS. The WPS must be calculated on the greyhound's last 5 Race starts. If the greyhound has not competed in 5 Races, the pro-rata WPS will be applied.

### Pro-rata WPS

Greyhounds that have not yet competed in five (5) starts are allocated points on a pro-rata or an average over five (5) starts with a weighting of 80% applied to the "pro-rata" points.

To calculate the points of a greyhound that has not competed in five (5) starts:

1. divide the greyhound's total points by the amount of starts it has competed in
2. multiply the new average by the difference between 5 and the number of actual starts and apply the 80% discount weighting
3. add the result to the actual points earned from the greyhound's starts.

### Examples for working out the points of greyhounds using this method:

**One Start** = 36 points  $36 / 1 = 36$ ;  $36 \times 4 = 144 \times 0.8 = 115$ ;  $115 + 36 = 151$  points

**Two Starts** = 46 points  $46 / 2 = 23$ ;  $23 \times 3 = 69 \times 0.8 = 55$ ;  $55 + 46 = 101$  points

**Four Starts** = 84 points  $84 / 4 = 21$ ;  $21 \times 1 = 21 \times 0.8 = 16$ ;  $16 + 84 = 100$  points

The full table of tracks and classifications is available on the GRSA website and published in the last editions of kennel capers.

## Winning Grade 6 races in order

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue. For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance.

If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

## Re grading for all tracks and distances

Re grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

## Gawler Satisfactory and Qualifying trials

A reminder to trainers that Satisfactory trials and Qualifying trials are conducted at Gawler on Thursday mornings weekly.

## Breeders Support Program rebate

A reminder to participants that when lodging a Breeders Support Program Rebate Claim Form that it is crucial that GRSA receives receipts for actual and verifiable expenses relating to the relevant litter.

Items listed in the table below show when receipts are required. If there are no receipts attached to the Claim Form then no support payment can be provided. Claims will be a maximum of \$2,000 with FSI and pup payments additional.

## Conditions of heats for SA racing

The Grading department makes every effort to run two or more Heats of advertised events for feature races, however, on occasions there are only enough nominations for one Heat.

The Grader will grade this event as one Heat with the same greyhounds competing in the Final. Reserves for this one off Heat that do not gain a start will be also be eligible for the Final.

This condition has been in place for some time for local Heats and Finals, however, the Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club has previously raced under different conditions for these events. Effective immediately the Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club will use the same format for Heats and Finals that are used locally with a one off Heat conducted and those greyhounds progress to the Final.

It is extremely important that trainers are aware of this condition to ensure they will be engaged for the Final if one Heat is conducted.

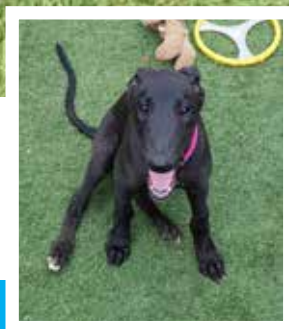

## Review of Satisfactory Trial Policy – to be effective 1 March 2020

**Stewards have recently reviewed the Satisfactory Trial Policy in order to provide a more manageable process for trainers and GRSA staff.**

Most notably the policy will support trainers by reducing some Satisfactory Trials from field trials to solo trials including:

- Unsatisfactory performance;
- Injury;
- Turned in boxes;
- Unraced for 6 months.

Further additions include a distance chart for clearances to assist trainers, Veterinary clearance certificate requirements and information on straight track/circle track clearances.

The revised Policy takes effect from 1 March 2020. Trainers are encouraged to approach Stewards to seek clarification if required. A copy of the policy is available in the following pages and on the website under Integrity – Rules and Policies.

## New policy – Bedding at Race Meetings and Trials

**A new policy has been approved to ensure all greyhounds are provided with warm, clean, vermin-resistant bedding when kennelled at SA tracks during race meetings and trial sessions.**

This Policy takes effect from 1 March 2020. Trainers are encouraged to approach Stewards to seek clarification if required. A copy of the policy is available in the following pages and on the website under Integrity – Rules and Policies.

## New policy – Return to Racing from Retirement

**A new policy has been approved to formalise the process for when enquiries are made to return a retired greyhound to racing.**

This Policy takes effect from 1 March 2020. Trainers are encouraged to approach Stewards to seek clarification if required. A copy of the policy is available in the following pages and on the website under Integrity – Rules and Policies.

## DNA testing for breeding females

There is currently some misinformation being circulated by industry participants regarding the testing and processing time for DNA for breeding females. It is a requirement of the GRSA Registration of a Breeding Female that the DNA is returned prior to a pink card being issued.

For some background, after the only Australian DNA laboratory which tested animals removed this service, Greyhounds Australasia (which includes GRSA) accepted a new DNA testing laboratory. The new laboratory contracted to undertake this work is in New Zealand.

Breeders should note the following information has been confirmed by Greyhounds Australasia in relation to DNA testing:

- The normal postal time to New Zealand is four (4) business days;
- Normal laboratory processing and results return within ten (10) business days;
- This is no longer than the service that was provided by the previous DNA testing facility;
- The bushfires in December 2019 in many areas of Australia did impact Australia Post delivery times to some degree;
- The customer service provided by the laboratory has been unfaultable and respond to enquiries quickly;

Both GA and GRSA always encourage participants who are thinking about breeding with a particular greyhound to consider getting the DNA tested while that greyhound is still actively racing.

## Animal Welfare Alert – Illness in Greyhounds

Greyhound Racing SA (GRSA) is notifying participants of a recent outbreak interstate of illness amongst the greyhound population. Whilst GRSA is not currently aware of any cases in this state, participants are reminded about the need to closely monitor the health of greyhounds in their care.

Trainers are advised to monitor their greyhounds for the following symptoms of illness:

- Vomiting;
- Diarrhoea;
- Elevated temperature;
- Lethargy

Participants who suspect a greyhound of displaying these symptoms should isolate the greyhound, disinfect their kennels and contact their Veterinarian for advice. Stewards should also be notified of any greyhounds displaying these symptoms.

**Miss. Kiah Hurley** – Notice of positive sample – greyhound WITCHIE'S GAS was found to have prohibited substance PROCAINE in a urine sample following an event at Angle Park on 18 November 2019. Inquiry to be scheduled at a date to be fixed.

**Mr. Neil Mann** – Notice of positive sample – greyhound IKE THE VIKING was found to have prohibited substance PROCAINE in a urine sample following an event at Gawler on 3 November 2019. Inquiry to be scheduled at a date to be fixed.

**Mr. Neil Mann** – Notice of positive sample – greyhound MISAFFECTION was found to have prohibited substance SOTALOL in a urine sample following an event at Gawler on 16 December 2019. Inquiry to be scheduled at a date to be fixed.

**Mrs. Joan Schadow** – Integrity Hearings Panel 26/11/19 and 11/12/19

Pleaded not guilty to three charges: Charge 1 - GAR 86B(1)(f) - Procured a person [Mr. Ronald Schadow] to commit conduct related to luring and baiting; Charge 2 - GAR 86B(1)(b) - Was in possession of two fox tails at her registered kennel address for the purpose of luring and baiting;

Charge 3 - GAR 86(e) - Failed to attend an inquiry when directed to do so. Penalties issued by Integrity Hearings Panel [IHP] for Charge 1 and 2 was a ten [10] year disqualification and for Charge 3 was a six [6] month suspension [to run concurrently with the period of disqualification] and a fine of \$750. Mrs. Schadow's disqualification began at midnight 29/01/20.

**Mr. Ronald Schadow** – Integrity Hearings Panel 26/11/19 and 11/12/19

Pleaded not guilty to three charges: Charge 1 - GAR 86B(1)(b) - Was in possession of two fox tails at his registered kennel address for the purpose of luring and baiting; Charge 2 - GAR 86B(1)(a) - Used a fox tail for the purposes of luring and baiting; Charge 3 - GAR 86(e) - Failed to attend an inquiry when directed to do so. Penalties issued by Integrity Hearings Panel [IHP] for Charge 1 and 2 was a ten [10] year disqualification and for Charge 3 was a six [6] month suspension [to run concurrently with the period of disqualification] and a fine of \$750. Mr. Schadow's disqualification began at midnight 29/01/20.

## Bedding at Race Meetings and Trials Policy

**Board Approval: February 2020**

**Next Review: January 2022**

### Policy Background

This policy outlines the requirements for greyhounds being kennelled at all South Australian tracks during race meetings and trial sessions.

### Application of the Policy

All greyhounds kennelled at South Australian tracks must be provided at all times with appropriate warm, clean, vermin resistant bedding in line with the South Australian Greyhound Industry Animal Welfare Policy.

Failure to provide suitable bedding for greyhounds kennelled during race meetings and trials to the satisfaction of Stewards will result in action being taken against the responsible person(s) at the time.

GRSA reserves the right to alter or amend this policy at any time.

# Satisfactory Trial Policy

Board Approval: February 2020 | Next Review: January 2022

## Policy Background

The purpose of this policy is to detail the procedure for a greyhound undertaking a satisfactory trial.

## Application of the Policy

A "satisfactory trial" means a trial required to be performed by a greyhound to the satisfaction of Stewards pursuant to Rule 72.

The chart below lists the type of satisfactory trials, associated field types and numbers:

## Procedures:

- The trainer must contact GRSA Racing department to give details of the satisfactory trial required. In the instance the satisfactory trial is for Mount Gambier, a booking must be made directly with the club.
- GRSA will determine the time the greyhound is required to run. The Steward[s] on duty during the trial may adjust the time at their discretion i.e. dependent on track conditions, etc.
- Stewards will allot the box for the greyhound.
- In order to be cleared to race at any distance, greyhounds must trial over a similar distance to that at which it offended. Please refer to the chart below for applicable track, distances and times.

Stewards will accede to a request from a trainer to trial a greyhound over a shorter distance than that at which the penalty was placed on them. The successful trial distance will be recorded for the greyhound's requalification and will only permit the greyhound to be nominated for races up to that distance. Greyhounds must trial and requalify over a longer distance to be permitted to race over further.

- A Veterinary Certificate of Fitness must be obtained and lodged prior to competing in an unraced for more than six [6] months trial, returning from retirement trial or when requested by Stewards.
- Greyhounds that re-offend may have their nomination refused for future trials at the discretion of the Stewards.
- The provisions of GAR 72 and GAR 77A apply.
- Satisfactory Trials ordered under GAR 69 [Marring], GAR 69A [Failing to pursue], GAR 69B [Failing to pursue by reason of injury] and GAR 71 [Unsatisfactory performance] must be performed at the track where the offence occurred to obtain clearance at all tracks. For clearance at all tracks except the track where the offence occurred the trial may be performed at any venue.

i) If a greyhound is ordered to undergo a Satisfactory Trial on a circle track and successfully completes a Satisfactory Trial on a straight track, it will be cleared for straight track racing only.

j) If a greyhound is ordered to undergo a Satisfactory Trial on a straight track and successfully completes a Satisfactory Trial on a circle track, it will be cleared for circle track racing only.

# Return to Racing Policy

Board Approval: February 2020 | Next Review: January 2022

## Policy Background

Greyhound Racing SA (GRSA) is committed to ensuring the best animal welfare outcomes at all stages of every greyhound's lifecycle. As such, this policy outlines the minimum requirements which must be satisfied in the event that an owner of a retired greyhound intends to return it to racing.

## Application of the Policy

A "retired greyhound" refers to a greyhound which has had its registration to race relinquished. The description incorporates both unraced and raced dogs and applies to locally bred and imported greyhounds. A greyhound is deemed 'retired' if the below Rule has been satisfied:

## R106 Proper care (welfare) of greyhounds

- At any time after the notification of the result of service pursuant to Rule 136, the last registered owner of the greyhound at the relevant time, shall notify the Controlling Body by lodging the prescribed form:

[a] within ten working days, if that greyhound has transferred ownership, been retired as a pet or a breeding greyhound, been transferred to an adoption program, exported or surrendered to another agency;

[Amended - 01.09.15]

Where an owner intends to return a retired greyhound to racing, an application must be made to GRSA, consisting of the following:

- A letter from the last registered owner of the greyhound outlining to the satisfaction of Stewards the reasons why the greyhound should be allowed to return to racing; and
- A Veterinary Certificate of Fitness for the greyhound signed by a Veterinarian registered with the Veterinary Surgeons Board of South Australia

Factors considered by Stewards in relation unretiring a greyhound include (by are not limited to):

- Whether the greyhound has been in the care of a third party or unregistered person since retirement;
- The veterinary history for the greyhound;
- Previous performance history;
- The previous reasons declared for retirement

Stewards will then consider suitability to continue the application. If approved to continue:

- The greyhound must complete a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with the GRSA Satisfactory Trial policy (if the greyhound is unraced for more than six [6] months it must comply with the provisions of GAR 77A regardless).

At this point, Stewards will approve or deny the application. If approved, the greyhound's status will be returned to 'named' allowing the trainer to nominate the greyhound. A greyhound will only be approved (if at all) for a return to racing on one [1] occasion. Any subsequent application for a greyhound that has already returned to racing on one [previous] occasion will not be considered.

GRSA reserves the right to request further information if required.

GRSA reserves the right to alter or amend this policy at any time.

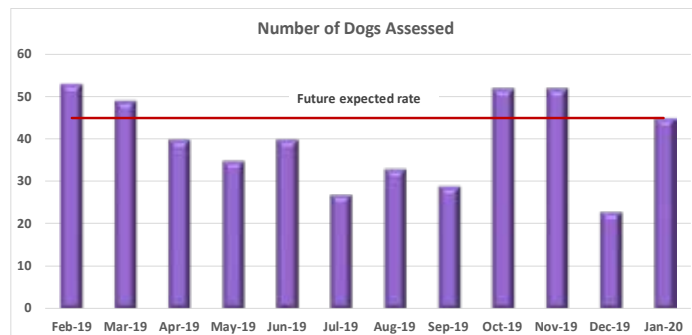
When booking your dog in please keep in mind the following:

- Please bring the greyhound's race card to the assessment.

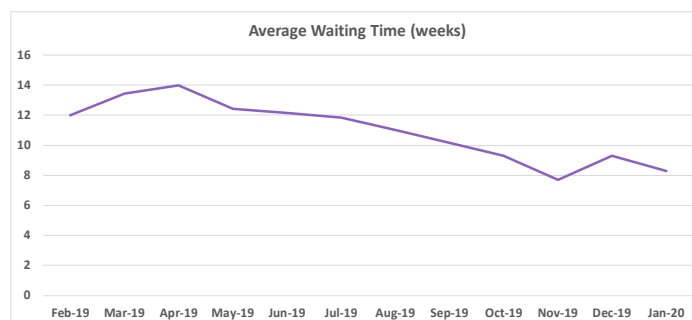
## Latest updates from GAP

# Trainer's biggest day out ever at the track

There had been bags of five winners in the past for Allendale East greyhound trainer David Peckham but he went one better at Tara Raceway Sunday, 16th February when Bourne Maximum, Call Me Billy, Fabs You Go, Squishy Pea, Dyna Carnie and Bourne Blackjack were successful.

And it was Call Me Billy who was the quickest of the three Summer Classic heats (512 metres), leading all the way to defeat Elle Limes by 3¾ lengths in 30.07 seconds while the winner's litter sister, the Peckham-trained Sweet On Me, is also through to the final after running second to the Tracie Price trained Rocketline in 30.14 seconds.

Peckham's six winners on the 12-race card equalled the record effort of Price, who on Sunday, September 20, 2015 was successful with Fear The Rascal, Pam's Boy,

## Great win for young trainer

Magnet Force's recent second win at Tara Raceway on Sunday, 9th February and third overall for Murtoa owner-trainer Josh McDonald, once again resulted in 25 per cent of the prizemoney being donated to the Wimmera Southern Mallee Rural Outreach program.

The Rural Outreach program is a consortium of 11 agencies with the lead agency through the Edenhope Memorial and District Hospital, the community-based program helping people in psychological and situational distress.

Purchased as a pup by McDonald, who also reared and then broke-in Magnet Force, the black bitch was named by him in memory of Brad "Magnet" Hall, a mate who died 12 months ago at the age of 42.

By Peter Rocket, Magnet Force is out of nine-race winner Maisy Mac and a litter sister to Zambora Brockie. On the back of a luckless fifth behind Akuma Fireball the previous week, Magnet Force was always handy from box eight in the 400 metre sprint, finishing strongly in the home straight to defeat Our Menace and the early leader Serene Rose in 23.34 seconds.

This was another special win for the 36-year-old McDonald, who has been involved in the sport for only two years and who immediately after the race warmly embraced his nine-year-old son Logan.

Paula suggested Bob Isaacson because of his training experience and "being a good bloke", so Bob was contacted and took on the role.

Missy Two Toes was named after the two white toes that she has on her otherwise black foot. Things have worked out well and she has now won six races, along with eleven placings from her 35 race starts. This win made it two in a row, with the previous one coming at Angle Park. Ruth said straight after the race that "it's awesome",

# TRIALS

## ANGLE PARK

### ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

Under the new schedule Angle Park Qualifying Trials will be run weekly on Wednesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting (12 days later due to nominations). With 388m racing now available on Monday nights trainers can qualify for all distances.

**Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Wednesday of the meeting.**

#### SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

#### BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to [trialbooker.com](http://trialbooker.com), create an account and book your own trials.

### POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

#### Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

#### Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Tuesday and Friday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the race meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

#### Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA by midday on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Gawler Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before.
3. For Murray Bridge Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.
