2021 SA Stud Dog of the Year Worm Burner - 420

Worm Burner was awarded the leading SA Sire for 2021 making it a three peat of awards after he won in 2019 and 2020. In 2021 progeny of Worm Burner won an amazing 420 races, a massive 387 wins in front of his nearest rival in an astonishing year. On some occasions he sired at least half the card of racing on any given night locally. Some of his best performed greyhounds for the year included SA Derby winner Mallee Magic [10 wins] and SA Derby placegetter Gemtree Maximus [16 wins] along with Gawler 50th Anniversary Cup winner See You Smile [10 wins].

2021 SA Brood Bitch of the Year Victa Victoria - 108

Victa Victoria was awarded the Brood Bitch of the Year, with 108 winners in 2021. Her winners were out of two litters. The Cosmic Rumble litter produced a number of winners with the standout being Victa Jess [11 wins].

However it was the Fernando Bale litter that has been the standout producing 12 pups and all of them making their way to the race track. All but Victa Oreo and Victa Florence [who won last month] have won their Maiden however Oreo's win is not far away.

Standouts of the litter include Victa Haydn [15 wins] and Victa Grosso [14 wins] who are finalists for the SA Greyhound of the Year after winning multiple feature races during the season with Victa Reid [16 wins], Victa Kurt [11 wins], Victa Buzz [9 wins], Victa Mikey [8 wins], Victa Saige [8 wins], Victa Maggie [7 wins], Victa Emma [4 wins] and Victa Daryl [3 wins] rounding out the litter mates.

2021 SA Breeder of the Year Joan Shadow – 260 points

This is the twelfth time this award has been presented and was introduced to recognize the outstanding Breeder in the State. This award is decided on a point's basis for SA Bred greyhounds that have won races at Sky Racing meetings during 2021 in SA.



Joan's winners were mainly out of two litters. The Cosmic Rumble producing Victa Jess [11 wins] and the Fernando Bale litter that produced standouts Victa Haydn and Victa Grosso who are finalists for the SA Greyhound of the Year after winning multiple feature races during the season along with the other "VICTA" dogs. The 12 pups from this litter have won a total of 95 races between them.

2021 SA Owner/Trainer of the Year (Tier 3) Tim Richards - 81

Tim Richards was the leading Owner/Trainer of the Year with a total of 81 TAB winners in 2021. Tim's licence classification only allows him to train those greyhounds that he is in the ownership of, and he had a great year. Tim had good success with his greyhounds, including He's All Purpose [8 wins] which won the SA Country Cup and represented SA in the National Straight Track Championships in Qld, Two Hands George [12 wins] and first split record holder at Angel Park, He's On Fire [8 wins].

2021 TAB Leading Trainer of the Year

Tony Rasmussen – 217

Tony Rasmussen made it a six peat of training awards as he was awarded the TAB leading Trainer of the Year for the sixth year in a row, with a total of 217 winners at TAB meetings in SA during 2021 increasing from his 205 from last year.

Tony received great support again from his wife Lisa and children making it a real family business.

Many of his winners came from the litter of Fernando Bale and Victa Victoria with the "Victa" dogs winning many races however with introducing a lot of new owners into his kennel and travelling 100's of km from Gawler to Mt Gambier in placing his dogs even more winners followed.

Lisa came fourth in this year's leading trainer award with 151 wins up from her 150 from last year.

2021 SA Syndicate of the Year

"My Four Girls" Syndicate - Manager – Kerry Braun

This was the fifteenth time that this award has been presented to acknowledge an important part of our industry in Syndication. The "My Four Girls" Syndicate was formed in SA on 24th January 2020 with members including Kerry Braun, Sue Schadow, Carol Hondow, Ron Schadow and Robyn Basham. In 2021 the Syndicate won 97 races with their greyhounds winning at Gawler, Angle Park and Murray Bridge. The main performers were Victa Reid [16 wins], Victa Haydn [15 wins], Victa Grosso [14 wins] and Victa Kurt [11 wins].

On the night the figures referred to SA bred winners for the special mentions, however, it should have included all winners. Other SA registered syndicates who had terrific success in 2021 included Board Racing [85 winners], Nineofus [61], Bazinga [60], Razza Racing [44] and Bungaloo [29].



2021 SA City Strike Rate

Tim Aloisi – 73.08%

This award is based on performances for Angle Park city meetings (City A/City B). The trainer must also have a minimum of 20 starters for the year. Tim Aloisi qualified through the performances of Stout Monelli, Lashes Monelli, Memphis Keeping, Zipping Sullivan and Run Like Jess. During 2021 Tim trained 19 winners (6 placings) from 26 starters at city meetings, giving him a winning 73.08% strike rate.



2021 Gawler Trackstar Award

Crazy Diva – 46 starts (14/9/7)

Trainer – Des Hockley

Crazy Diva raced 34 times over the Gawler 400m journey with 12 wins and 11 placings with her best time being 22.55. She ran 4th in the final of the Gawler Sprint Classic after finishing second in her heat. She was also second in the Gawler Breeders final over 400m after winning her heat. She raced 12 times over the 531m journey winning 2 races and placed on 5 occasions. She won the Gawler Future Stars final and was second in the Breeders Prelude (2) final with her best time being 30.90. She raced all year winning 30% of her races and running in the top three 65% of the time.



2021 Run Of The Year – Victa Grosso (October)

The Run of the Year was Victa Grosso for trainer Tony Rasmussen with his win in the final of the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup over the 531m on Sunday 24th October. Beginning from box four he began well in the feature final however found himself back midfield as they raced into the back straight. Victa Grosso moved to the outside and began to make quick ground as the runners turned for home. He put the accelerator jets on and raced into first place and a breathtaking victory along the inside. He won in powerful style recording a slick 30.90 in winning by 1 ½ lengths.

Victa Grosso wins this award based on the combination of the public votes where he was voted second (with 32% behind Danyo's Wylie with 42%) and votes from the GOTY Panel where he was voted first ahead of Fantastic Radley.

Stout Monelli continues on winning way

The first feature race of 2022 saw Stout Monelli for trainer Tim Aloisi make it a three peat of feature race wins with another brilliant performance in the Listed SA Sprint Championship final on January 13.

After taking out the final of the Ashes during the Festival of Fire and then the Kate's A Scandal Xmas Sprint, the son of Barcia Bale and Corona Monelli started a well supported favourite in the SA Sprint Championship and he didn't disappoint.

Jumping well from box 1, Stout Monelli withheld the challenge from Victa Grosso for Tony Rasmussen for the lead in the early stages to take control at the winning post on the first occasion. While kennel mates Mallee Magic and Victa Mikey looked to grab a forward position with Victa Haydn slotting in just of the speed all for the Rasmussen team.

Into the back straight and Stout Monelli was going strongly in the lead, quickly followed by Victa Grosso who was in hot pursuit with the two leaders opening up a break from Mallee Magic and Victa Haydn who was making good ground along the inside. It looked a two dog



race off the back straight as Victa Grosso closed onto the heels of Stout Monelli with a further 3 lengths back to Victa Haydn. Turning for home it looked like Victa Grosso was going to challenge for the lead however Stout Monelli slipped into another gear and raced away for an impressive all the way victory. He

won by 1 length from Victa Haydn who flew along the inside for second just ahead of Victa Grosso back in third. Stout Monelli's performance was highlighted by his time running a brilliant 30.17 for the 530m journey which is the quickest by an SA trained greyhound on the newly redeveloped Angle Park track.

Trengove claims another feature with It's Smudgy

The finalists for this year's addition of the John Gray on January 20 all seemed to have one thing in common and that was high speed to the first turn, so the start for the feature final was more crucial than normal.

All eyes were on the start to see who had the superior speed and as expected Springvale Maddi [box 6] and Sunset Toxic [box 8] flew the lids as the starter said go, however, first reserve Aston Marlon for South-East trainer David Peckham [box 7] also sprung the lids and charged in between the two punter elects as they accelerated out of the front straight. Aston Marlon charged to the front crossing down to the rails as they headed to the back straight while Springvale Maddi bumped with Sunset Toxic affecting their chances and giving the other competitors their chance to make ground. Mr. Ticket began to sweep around the outside as they entered the back straight with It's Smudgy finding a nice spot along the inside of Springvale Maddi who struggled to hold her position.

Off the back straight, Aston Marlon was in full flight opening up a nice 3 length break on his rivals however turning for home, the petrol meter started to show empty and It's Smudgy raced to the front along the inside while Mr. Ticket also staked his claim out wide. The race home was on with It's Smudgy doing a little bit the better on the line to win by 1



length from Mr. Ticket. Alfieri for Bill Wudarczyk, flashed home along the inside to grab third ahead of Weblec Blade who worked home well while Aston Marlon faded into fifth spot.

It's Smudgy ran a handy 30.75 for the 530m journey and the daughter of Worm Burner and Batty Allen whilst long regarded as a short course greyhound has shown she is on the fast track to city class after this brilliant 530m win.

LOW GRADE FEATURE SERIES AT ANGLE PARK

The next Low Grade Feature Series at Angle Park will be an Open Maiden over the 530m with \$2,465 Heats on Thursday, 3rd March with the \$5,150 Final on Thursday, 10th March.

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 28th February at 9.00am.

MURRAY BRIDGE AND GAWLER TO SWAP ON 15TH & 16TH MARCH

The Murray Bridge Straight Track meeting scheduled for Tuesday, 15th March will now be run on Wednesday, 16th March with Gawler moving from the 16th March to the 15th March.

This will allow one day between the Murray Bridge Cup Heats meeting on Monday, 14th March and the Straight Track for venue maintenance.

The date changes are listed below -

Delete: Murray Bridge – Tuesday, 15th March 2022 [TAB] Day
Add: Gawler – Tuesday, 15th March 2022 [TAB] Day

Delete: Gawler – Wednesday, 16th March 2022 [TAB] Day
Add: Murray Bridge – Wednesday, 16th March 2022 [TAB] Day

LAUNCHING PAD SA SERIES BEGINS ON 10th MARCH

Again this year the Sandown GRC offered sweepstake tickets into the rich Launching Pad Series.

There are special conditions on the race, being for greyhounds that have won between 1 and 6 races and have not had more than 30 starts at close of their nominations.

The Heats will be run at Sandown over the 515m on Thursday, 31st March with the Semi-Finals on Thursday, 7th April with the \$150,000 to the winner Final run on Thursday, 14th April. GRSA was able to secure a ticket and will give one greyhound the opportunity to compete in this lucrative series. We will run a Heat and Final series to determine who will make the Launching Pad Heats on 31st March.

Our Heats will be run on Thursday, 10th March over the 530m at Angle Park for greyhounds that have won 1-4 races and no more than 28 starts at time of nominations. The Heats will be worth \$3,585 and will be Non Penalty events. The Final will be run at Angle Park on Thursday, 17th March over the 530m with prizemoney of \$5,150 and will also be Non Penalty.

The winner of the Final will take their spot in the Launching Pad Heats two weeks later, however, if the winner for whatever reason cannot take their spot then the next qualified greyhound will be given that spot.

GRSA has restricted the series to 1-4 wins and 28 starts in case a greyhound wins both the Heat and Final so this will still keep them eligible. If greyhounds win outside the series this may deem them ineligible for the Sandown series. We have also made our Final two weeks before the Launching Pad Heats at Sandown to give the trainer an opportunity to get across the border and trial for the big race.

- Nominations close with GRSA for the SA Heats at 9am on Monday, 7th March.

MURRAY BRIDGE AND MOUNT GAMBIER CUPS IN MARCH/APRIL AT GROUP 3 LEVEL WITH BIG BONUSES

It will be a big couple of months of racing in March and April for the Murray Bridge and Mount Gambier Clubs when they conduct their Cup meetings.

The previously listed races will now offer \$25,000 to the winner for this years events. Each of our three country Clubs will now hold Group status for their premier events.

The \$3,000 Murray Bridge Cup Heats will be conducted on Monday, 14th March with the \$36,000 [Group 3] Final to be run on Sunday night, 20th March. Also on the program will be -

\$3,000 Murray Bridge Cup Consolation – 455m [Trainers must renominate]

\$5,000 Special Event Feature [N/P] – 680m

\$4,000 Special Event Feature [N/P] – 530m

\$3,000 Special Event Feature [N/P] – 395m

We will also run two Straight Track Events on the night which will be Heats ONLY for \$1,000 each - Special Event – 350m [N/P] to be run at the start of the meeting [\$3,000 Final Tuesday, 29th March].

- Nominations for Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Thursday, 10th March.

The \$3,000 Mount Gambier Cup Heats will be run on Sunday, 3rd April with the \$36,000 [Group 3] Final on Sunday, 10th April.

- Nominations for Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Tuesday, 29th March.

GRSA will link bonuses to both of these events, which will include a \$5,000 bonus if the same dog can win both the Murray Bridge Cup and Mount Gambier Cup and a \$5,000 trainer bonus if the same trainer can win both Cups [SA or Interstate or different dogs].

STOUT MONELLI CLAIMS SECOND GOTM IN A ROW

Greyhound of the Month for January was Stout Monelli for trainer Tim Aloisi, making it back to back awards for the son of Barcia Bale and Corona Monelli after he collected the December award, his highlight performance in January being a dominant display in the SA Sprint Championship Final.

He had three starts for the month with two wins and a fourth place. He started the month off with the fourth in a Heat of the listed SA Sprint Championship and some thought he was a touch disappointing, however, after drawing box 1 in the Final he showed his true class. He pounced on the early lead and from there was never headed running a brilliant 30.19 for the 530m journey in winning by 1 length against the best sprinters in the State. He then rounded his month off with a slick win on a Monday night at headquarters running a flying 30.15, equalling the second fastest time recorded on the track over the 530m.

At the end of the month Stout Monelli's record stood at 46 starts for 25 wins and 14 placings and earnings just under \$230,000.



BUZZ ALONG BREAKS RECORD AND CLAIMS FEBRUARY AWARD

The Run of the Month for January was Buzz Along for trainer Ossie Chegia after he set a new track record over the 595m at Angle Park on Thursday, 27th January.

He showed good speed early to be the surprising leader in a competitive field, however, with his strength he was always going to be hard to run down. He ran splits of 8.52 and 21.27, finally stopping the clock at 34.00 in winning by 6 lengths. He broke the previous best time by .06 which was held by staying star, Sir Truculent. The greyhound has now been transferred to NSW so it will be interesting to see how he goes over the staying trips on the eastern seaboard.

The Series is for all greyhounds eligible for Breeders 2022 with the \$4,500 Final to be run on Monday, 28th March.

LOCAL MATCH RACE SERIES “THE SA EASTER” IN APRIL

The SA local Match Race series coined “The SA Easter” will be held on Thursday night, 14th April (Easter) at Angle Park.

Eligibility for South Australian local greyhounds will be based around the Nationals conditions. They will need to be trained in SA 76 days out of the last 150 prior to the close of nominations.

Selection for this series will only be based around winning times at Angle Park. For greyhounds that have run over the 530m at Angle Park at any meeting since 1st November, 2021, their fastest winning time will be recognised and put them on the list for selection.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3, Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. There will be no manual selection from the Grader. The top 4 seeded greyhounds will be rewarded with more prizemoney.

The overall winner of the local Match Race series will be offered a spot in the State of Origin Match race series [SA V Vic] in September so long as it is nominated and eligible to represent SA subject to changes.

The night itself will be very much like an Adelaide Cup atmosphere with plenty of entertainment for families as we celebrate 50 years at Angle Park. The feature Anniversary Cup Final, offering \$50k to the winner will be sure to provide a high quality line up of sprinters, locally and interstate, with Heats for this event on Thursday, 22nd April. Coinciding with the Anniversary Cup Final is the SA Distance Championship Final worth \$10k to the winner with Heats also run on Thursday, 22nd April.

Other changes will be the Gawler Friday meeting on 29th April will now be run on Thursday, 28th April in the twilight timeslot.

GRSA SKY WEEKLY SCHEDULE CHANGES

A reminder to trainers that with the Sky weekly schedule of greyhound racing in South Australia for Gawler and Murray Bridge changing for the first two weeks of the month that this will affect Gawler trialling days.

When we race at Gawler on the Friday the trials will be moved to the Thursday before and when we race at Gawler on the Sunday they will trial on the Friday before. Murray Bridge trialling dates will remain unchanged.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED “ONLY”

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that “Only” would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put “Only or no start or leave me out” then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their Grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins, trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria, the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

DAISH IRRIGATION & FODDER VOUCHERS FOR MURRAY BRIDGE

The Murray Bridge GRC has been able to secure some \$100 vouchers from their sponsor Daish Irrigation & Fodder to be used on Heat and Final series’ over the next 12 months.

In the All Tracks calendar these races will be highlighted which is a terrific initiative of the Murray Bridge GRC.

Corby wins fourth Doug Payne Feature

■ ANGLE PARK

The 2022 SA Bred Doug Payne Feature was run on January 27 at Angle Park in warm, humid conditions with trainer Kirin Corby taking out her 4th edition of the series when high speed sprinter Harbor Blues was able to lead throughout for a stirring victory.

Kirin previously won this race in 2003 with gun sprinter Lion Hearted, in 2008 with Cool Keepsake and with Fabwik in 2018, no doubt targeting this race with her SA bred sprinting stars over the years.

The son of Worm Burner and Harbor Missing was sent out on the third line of betting behind litter mates Victa Grosso and Victa Haydn for Tony Rasmussen. As the start was affected Harbor Blues bounced out of box 2 to quickly assume the lead with the third of the litter mates, Victa Kurt for Lisa Rasmussen ranging up alongside as they headed out of the front straight. The third of Tony's runners Hot Spartan was positioned nicely in behind while Victa Grosso found a nice spot in fourth but ran wide on the first turn losing valuable ground. Into the back straight and Harbor Blues was low flying in the lead with Victa Kurt doing a good job to stay in touch in second. Hot Spartan moved to third while Victa Haydn moved to the inside of Victa Grosso a long way off the lead while rounding out the elite six was Archman for Petar Jovanovic who brought up the rear.

Off the back straight and Harbor Blues was looking like the winner with Victa Kurt holding a strong second. Hot Spartan was beginning to the challenge for third by Victa Haydn and Victa Grosso who were both motoring home.

Turning for home and Victa Kurt raised one last challenge to Harbor Blues, however, he was unable to close the margin with Harbor Blues going on for a brilliant all the way win. Victa Haydn charged down the outside to grab third while Hot Spartan just held off Victa Grosso along the inside for fourth.

Harbor Blues ran a brilliant 30.42 for the 530m journey with splits of 5.23 and 17.55 and is owned and bred by Kirin.



NEW LOCAL RULES

As you know, the new, national Greyhounds Australasia Rules rollout was delayed to around May 2022.

We have been working on transitioning our local rules, so they are compatible with the new, national rules. Our new local rules are now in effect [from 1 February 2022]. We continued with the rollout because our local rules were re-written to be flexible enough to be compatible with the old and new national rules. We also had some important updates that have been in the works for a long time and needed to be implemented now and not in May.

The new local rules are written to make the transition from the old local rules as painless as possible. For example, the old local rules [called the old, local regulatory rules], are now in Schedule 1 of the new rules. Following GA guidelines, the local rule designation "LR" has been changed to "L", but you will see that the rule number is the same. Similarly, the old Coursing Rules [CR] as now a part of the local rules, but the old "CR" rule number is included to help with the transition.

There are some new parts to the local rules. Local rules 1-4 of the rules explain how the new local rules relate to the national rules. Rule 5 is a general offence provision of failing to comply with a requirement. Rule 6 establishes the Schedules that are a part of the local rules.

There are three additional schedules.

Schedule 2 is a new concept of penalty notices. From now, some offences under the rules of racing will be dealt with on the spot by penalty notice. The penalty notice allows a fine up to \$499.00 payable in 14 days or via a payment plan. Like police expiation notices, if you dispute the notice, you can elect to have the breach dealt with by an inquiry, but note an inquiry is not limited to just fines. Also, if Stewards or Welfare Officers are of the opinion the breach is serious enough that a fine is not adequate, they can elect to issue an on-the-spot inquiry notice. An on-the-spot inquiry notice allows the option to suspend greyhounds or people, pending the determination of an inquiry.

Schedule 3 outlines the matters that GRSA consider for registration – suitability matters. This includes a fit and proper person test to make it clear what GRSA use to assess all new, renewing and variations to registration.

Schedule 4 introduces a right of review and amalgamates several review processes that GRSA presently use. Schedule 4 will be operational shortly once the framework for the process is established.

The following are some other key changes to the local rules –

- Rule L5 – new general offence of contravene requirement of a GRSA officer.

- Schedule 1 L28A – confirming greyhounds must be kept by registered persons and on registered premises [e.g. only an appropriately licenced person can keep or train a greyhound].

- Schedule 1 L28B – new rules dealing with greyhounds of a deceased estate [to allow GRSA to temporarily house greyhounds with relatives or other registered persons, while the early stages of the estate are sorted out].

- Schedule 1 L29 – amended identification and location of inactive greyhounds [so GRSA may require a person in possession of a greyhound to update GRSA on the greyhound [e.g. racing or breeding greyhounds]].

- Schedule 1 L30 – confirming notices of whelping must include all pups whelped [this is to make clear that all pups, even still-born, must be recorded at this time to assist with GRSA data matching processes throughout the life cycle of greyhounds of that litter].

- Schedule 1 L37A – new, specific offence of being disorderly on a racecourse or premises of a club [this is in addition to any breach under GAR 86].

- Schedule 1 L77 – confirming power of GRSA to require further details about matters relating to greyhound racing [before and during an inquiry, for example, further information to process notifications lodged under GAR 106.. These types of requests are now requirements].

- Schedule 1 L78A – new facilitation of proof provisions to make IHP hearings more efficient [for example, without challenge, GRSA can prove a prohibited substance is listed as such. This provision can be rebutted under election by the registered person].

- Schedule 1 L79A – new guiding principles to be considered on penalty [to assist panels to consider the relevant factors for and against a registered person].

- Schedule 1 L85 – confirming reasonable time for disqualified person to transfer greyhound [out of their custody should they become disqualified].

- Schedule 1 L114 – revised rehoming obligations [including notice of intention to euthanise that is presently part of the Animal Welfare Policy 2021]

- Schedule 1 L114A – new, serious offence of ill treatment of greyhound.

- Schedule 1 L114B – new offence of threaten detriment to greyhound.

These new offences have been available to GRSA under other provisions in the GARs and LRs; however, these new rules make it clearer what the offence is and what GRSA's expectations are.

DISQUALIFIED AND WARNED OFF PERSONS – WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR YOU?

The GARs define a warned off person as the same as a disqualified person. A disqualified person is a person who is disqualified by the Controlling Body or Stewards or pursuant to the Rules of any approved controlling authority or thoroughbred, harness or greyhound racing club.

Greyhound racing means everything and anyone who participates, at any level, at any time, with any activity associated with greyhounds or racing and includes, but is not limited to –

[a] the keeping of greyhounds which are in the care or custody of registered or other persons;

[b] the registration or breeding of greyhounds;

[c] any matter or thing connected to greyhound racing.

Rule 86[ah] of the GARs states that any person shall be guilty of an offence if they, as a registered person or person associated with greyhound racing, associates with a disqualified person for the purposes of greyhound racing.

What all this means is, as a registered person, if you associate with a person who is disqualified or warned off, for the purposes of greyhound racing, you commit a breach of the rules. It does not mean you cannot have any contact – the rules of greyhound racing are not there to control who you see outside racing, but you cannot – categorically – associate for the purposes of greyhound racing. This can include assistance with training, consultation, advice, assessments, examinations, or anything else that relates to your activity with greyhounds. Please be mindful of this.

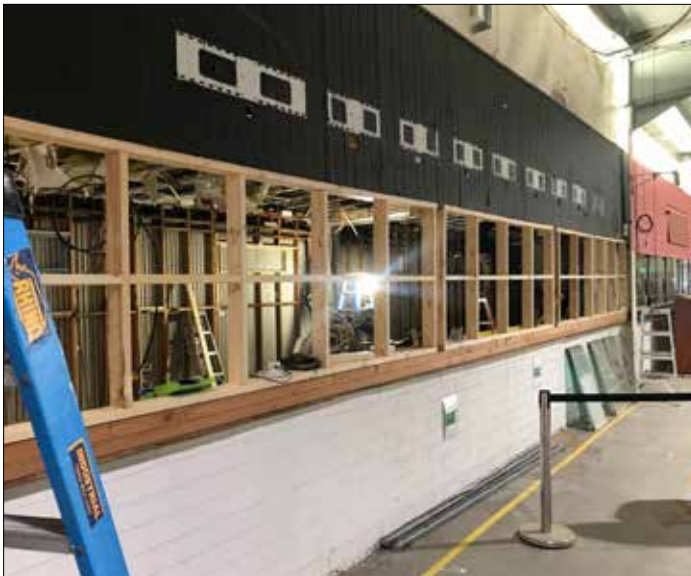
GAP ADMINISTRATION REFURBISHMENT

Participants may have noticed the GAP offices have been closed recently as we undertake a refurbishment of the area.

The project will see a complete refit of the building, to modernise the offices and accommodate a potential expansion of resourcing in the coming years.

The GAP team has been temporarily relocated to the old Angle Park Vet Clinic and it is business as usual as they operate out of this building for the next 4 to 6 weeks.

Those attending site wishing to see the GAP team should see GRSA reception in the first instance.



ANGLE PARK TRACK PREPARATION

The maintenance team at Angle Park continue to improve their understanding of the new surface as they prepare the track for races and trials.

This refinement process seeks to present the track in the safest and most consistent way and the team is experimenting with different methods to achieve this.

Trainers may have noticed the team using the sprinklers in between races to keep the moisture in the track towards the back end of the meeting.

This is something we are keen to continue and develop as the team become more experienced with this process, either by irrigation system or water cart.

At regional tracks, the addition of new irrigation equipment will allow better and more consistent mid-meeting watering.

The maintenance team will explore how to best achieve this in the coming months.

WAP payment update for December 2021

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) advises that there was no Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of December 2021.

The result is a consequence of a 38% reduction in net wagering revenue from October to December. As forewarned in previous months, wagering revenue had been showing signs of softening; an outcome that is manifesting now.

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney.

If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

Example to help participants understand the WAP they receive

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dogs(s). The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

Assumptions:

In this example, assume the owner/trainer received **\$1,000** in prizemoney for any/all races for the month.

In this the total prizemoney (paid to all participant) is **\$700,000**.

In this example, the total WAP is **\$50,000**.

In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of **\$71.43**, calculated as:

$$\text{\$1,000} \div \text{\$700,000} \times \text{\$50,000} = \text{\$71.43}$$

Participants should note that:

- WAP is not payable for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000];
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

Summer of Racing Campaign

The 'Summer of Racing' campaign has been rolled out through December and January with the goal of increasing on course patronage at each venue throughout these periods.

The major issue for the campaign was that approximately half way through the 8-week campaign (from Boxing Day), substantially stronger COVID-19 restrictions were brought in, severely hampering capacity numbers at each venue. This is illustrated most by Chasers Restaurant being limited to 145 patrons and Murray Bridge being limited to 52 patrons. In addition, case numbers began to surge into the thousands each day from late December, which seen much of the general public steering clear of hospitality venues. We however did see strong patronage across each of our venues throughout December, also with major uplift in sales across most of the venues from a hospitality perspective, comparing against previous year.

Golden start to career for Willow

Sunday January 23 saw the running of the Gawler Golden Maiden Series Final.

SA's leading greyhound trainer Tony Rasmussen took out another feature final at Gawler when his greyhound Willow managed to win from box one. The week before Willow was successful in his heat when he ran a quick time of 31.25 from box five which naturally made him race favourite for the final when he drew box one. He hunted the rail very well into the first turn and managed to hold the lead heading into the back. He careered away to win by seven lengths and ran a time of 31.37 on a wet track to take out the final. He has now had the two career starts for two wins.

Trainer Tony Rasmussen was very impressed with the win. Tony stated "his trial on the Monday before the heats was really good. I think he is going to be a very handy dog overall". He also said that he was "very proud about how he mustered up along the rail in the final". Willow is owned by popular greyhound personalities Cameron and Yvonne Butcher. Tony stated "I've always had a long standing good relationship with Cameron and Yvonne". When asked about future plans with Willow, Tony stated "I'm going to give him a week off and take him back to Gawler. Then I'll eventually take him to Angle Park".



Trainer Vadim Roz also had a very big night on the night. He scored a treble of winners. His first winner came in race one in the form of a dead heat when his greyhound Yarramundi Bee ran first along with Cooper Kyran who finished on level terms. Bodhi's Bro Kai was Vadim's second winner of the night and there was no dead heat to speak of here because he won by a length and a half. Bodhi's Bro Kai has now won five in a row. His third and final winner was in race eleven when Luxury Rocks greeted the judge first and ran a time of 23.08. Scoring doubles on the night were trainers Tim Richards, Tony Rasmussen and Nicole Price.

GAP kennelling fee payment process change

Please note that as of 1st August 2021 the GAP kennelling payment process has changed for a trial period of three months.

The changes are as follows:

Instead of making a weekly payment of \$33 per dog, the new kennelling fee will be a flat amount of \$50 per dog, irrespective of the time period the greyhound will spend at the GAP kennels.

Participants who would like their greyhounds placed in the GAP kennels will be requested to pay the \$50 at the time when the placement form is filled in and the \$60 placement fee is paid.

This means that for greyhounds that are to be kennelled with GAP an upfront payment of \$110 will be requested. After that, participants will not need to make any additional payments for their dogs in the GAP kennels. Noting that prior to foster care dogs spend an average of 4 weeks in kennels, this change is expected to generate a saving of \$82 per dog for participants.

Please remember to book in your greyhound's vet work AFTER you submit the GAP placement form.

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

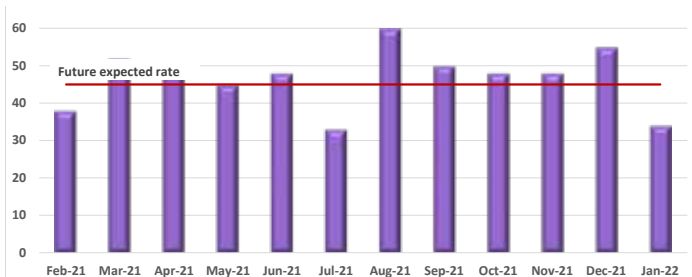

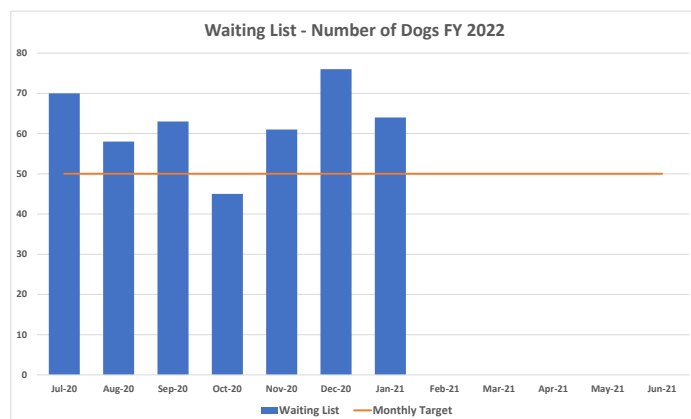
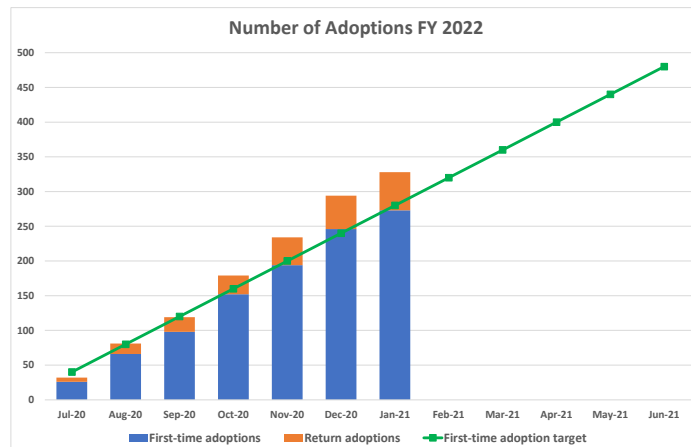
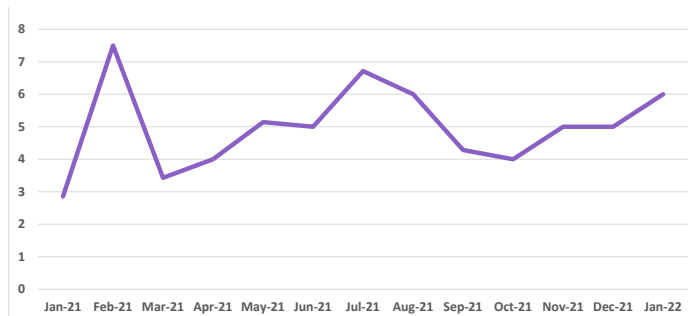
Latest updates from GAP

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday (drawn Thursday) meetings. Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Friday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the Sunday meeting (drawn the following week).

Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Thursday.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Friday (drawn Tuesday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

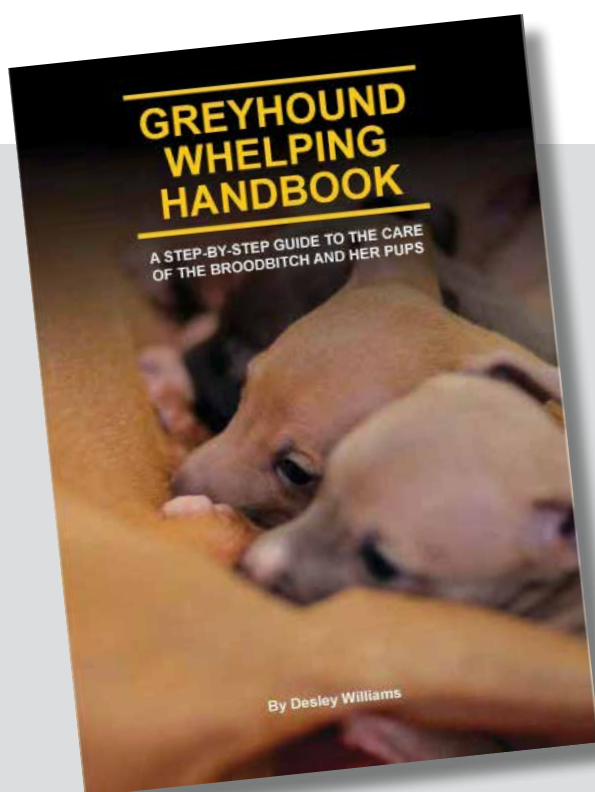
