

NOTES FROM GRSA MANAGEMENT

As reported in a recent Industry Consultative Group meeting, there are several infrastructure projects that GRSA are focusing on – particularly the sand issues at Murray Bridge, the next development stages of IsoLynx and the general race day experience. Through consultation, the new sand composition for testing at the site has been given the green light and GRSA are currently working with Mount Compass Sand to have this installed in the coming weeks. Once we see how this new sand composition performs in the environment and it is deemed to be suitable, the Board is supportive of moving this project forward as a matter of urgency. All the hardware for the IsoLynx system has now been installed and the collection of data has commenced. Participants would have noticed that the km/h speeds are now displayed on SKY and replays now feature additional camera angles – of which both have been well received. GRSA are currently working with our IT partners to have more information published in our form guides, however this development component can take some time.

After having to cancel the '4 nights of Christmas' event due to the unforeseen damage sustained at Angle Park, the team quickly devised a new concept and 'Family Fun in the Sun' was born. These events were run across all our Clubs from the end of January through to February and as the name would suggest, focussed on creating a warm and welcoming environment for young and old – on top of putting on some fantastic racing. What transpired from this was truly something brilliant, as flocks of families attended our racetracks looking for something to do during the school holiday – many experiencing a race meet for the very first time. Whilst there may have been an overzealous security guard or two that were dubious about the children patting our greys – there too were many that got the chance to have a pat as the dogs returned to the kennel house. As always, we thank our trainers for their willingness and encouragement of this – as it really does add to the experience.

Last but certainly not least, we would like to congratulate trainer Lisa Rasmussen on the success of the SA bred and owned, Victa Damien winning the National Derby at Wentworth Park, their first Group 1 race and wish you and the team all the very best in your quest for the Australian Cup.

2023 JOHN GRAY FINAL – REVIEW

ANGLE PARK

The John Gray final of 2023 on January 19 proved to be one of the more even finals in recent history with all eight qualifiers genuine chances of claiming the prestigious feature along with the \$10,000 first prize. However, it was the Paul Rehmann trained Razzle Darryl who was rewarded for his consistency with a terrific win in an exciting contest.

As the start was affected all eight greyhounds came out as one as they charged to the winning post on the first occasion. Accelerating from out wide on the track Show Me Bucks (box 7) for Tony Rasmussen and last years winner It's Smudgy (box 8) for Clint Trengove both took the early lead followed by Howling Hoss for Shelley Trengove, Fifty Eight for Don Turner and the remainder of the field with only a few lengths from first to last as they sorted out their positions. Into the back straight and Show Me Bucks cleared the field to lead with Howling Hoss railing hard into second and It's Smudgy back in third. Razzle Darryl after being in tight racing railed nicely to get to fourth along the inside while race favourite Gondola for Ben Rawlings found herself back last after an average beginning and tight racing on the first turn.

Down the back straight and Show Me Bucks was still in the lead followed by Howling Hoss, Razzle Darryl took the run to the inside of It's Smudgy to move to third and chase out after the leaders while Gondola made a big move around the outside to move to fifth with the remainder of the field too far back to challenge. Off the back straight Show Me Bucks was being challenged by Howling Hoss around the outside and Razzle

Darryl along the inside with It's Smudgy also looking to follow Razzle Darryl through as Gondola closed in. Turning for home and Razzle Darryl hit the lead along the inside and looked to pinch a break from It's Smudgy who ran to second also along the inside while Show Me Bucks and Howling Hoss battled out the minors. Gondola's run looked to end as the top four cleared out in the home straight. Down to the finish line and Razzle Darryl proved too strong in the final stages going on to win by 2.25 lengths from It's Smudgy while Howling Hoss claimed third spot out wide a further length away from Show Me Bucks.

The overall time of 31.32 for the 530m journey was slow in comparison to other times on the night highlighting the tight and competitive contest that the oncourse crowd had just witnessed.

Razzle Darryl is the son of Confident Rankin and Tyla Grace and is Owned by Becc Weinert, he has now won 13 races from his 49 starts including 18 minor placings and prizemoney just over \$33,000.

This race was introduced in recognition of one of the icons of South Australian greyhound racing, John Gray and was the 28th running of this event. John was a great supporter of South Australian greyhound racing, and his family continues a hands-on association with the industry today. This race has been graciously supported over a long period by Vaun Gray and the Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club.

LAUNCHING PAD SA SERIES BEGINS ON 2nd MARCH

Again this year the Sandown GRC offered sweepstake tickets into the rich Launching Pad Series.

There are special conditions on the race, being for greyhounds that have won between 1 and 6 races and have not had more than 30 starts at close of their nominations.

The Heats will be run at Sandown over the 515m on Thursday, 23rd March with the Semi-Finals on Thursday, 30th March and the \$150,000 to the winner Final run on Thursday, 6th April. GRSA was able to secure a ticket and will give one greyhound the opportunity to compete in this lucrative series. We will run a Heat and Final series to determine who will make the Launching Pad Heats on 23rd March.

Our Heats will be run on Thursday, 2nd March over the 530m at Angle Park for greyhounds that have won 1-4 races and no more than 28 starts at time of nominations. The Heats will be worth \$3,855 and will be Non Penalty events. The Final will be run at Angle Park on Thursday, 9th March over the 530m with prizemoney of \$5,535 and will also be Non Penalty.

The winner of the Final will take their spot in the Launching Pad Heats two weeks later, however, if the winner for whatever reason cannot take their spot then the next qualified greyhound will be given that spot.

GRSA has restricted the series to 1-4 wins and 28 starts incase a greyhound wins both the Heat and Final so this will still keep them eligible. If greyhounds win outside the series this may deem them ineligible for the Sandown series. We have also made our Final two weeks before the Launching Pad Heats at Sandown to give the trainer an opportunity to get across the border and trial for the big race.

• Nominations close with GRSA for the SA Heats at 9am on Monday, 27th February.

MURRAY BRIDGE STRAIGHT TRACK HEATS FOR MURRAY BRIDGE CUP FINAL NIGHT

The Murray Bridge GRC and GRSA will conducted Straight Track Heats on Tuesday, 7th March with two \$3,000 Finals conducted as races 1 and 2 on Sunday, 12th March to align with the Group 3 Murray Bridge Cup around the one turn track. We have ran these races in the past year however instead of having Heats on Final night we will run the two Straight Track Finals.

The \$1,265 Heats on Tuesday will be over the 300m and 350m and be a Special Event, Non Penalty for the best greyhound nominated over each distance.

• Nominations for Straight Track Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Thursday, 2nd March.

MURRAY BRIDGE AND MOUNT GAMBIER CUPS IN MARCH/ APRIL AT GROUP 3 LEVEL WITH BIG BONUSES

It will be a big couple of months of racing in March and April for the Murray Bridge and Mount Gambier Clubs when they conduct their Cup meetings.

These events are at Group 3 level and offer \$25,000 to the winner.

The \$3,000 Murray Bridge Cup Heats will be conducted on Sunday, 5th March with the \$36,000 (Group 3) Final to be run on Sunday night, 12th March. Also on the Final nights program will be

\$4,000 Murray Bridge Cup Consolation – 455m (Trainers must renominate)

\$5,000 Special Event Feature (N/P)- 680m

\$4,000 Special Event Feature (N/P)-530m

\$3,000 Special Event Feature (N/P)-395m

We will also run two Straight Track Finals on the night which will be over the 300m and 350m worth \$3,000 each (Heats run on Tuesday, 7th March).

• Nominations for Cup Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Wednesday, 1st March.

The \$3,000 Mount Gambier Cup Heats will be run on Sunday, 26th March with the \$36,000 (Group 3) Final on Sunday, 2nd April.

 Nominations for Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Tuesday, 21st March.

GRSA will link bonuses to both of these events, which will include a \$5,000 bonus if the same dog can win both the Murray Bridge Cup and Mount Gambier Cup and a \$5,000 trainer bonus if the same trainer can win both Cups (SA or Interstate or different dogs).

BREEDERS 2023 PRELUDE (1) HEATS ON MONDAY 13TH MARCH

The Series is for all greyhounds eligible for Breeders 2023 with the \$4,500 Final to be run on Monday, 20th March.

LOW GRADE FEATURE SERIES AT ANGLE PARK IN MARCH

The March Low Grade Feature Series at Angle Park will be a Maiden/Grade 6 over the 595m with \$3,855 Heats on Thursday, 16th March with the \$5,35 Final on Thursday, 23rd March.

• Nominations for the Heats close Friday, 10th March at 9.00am.

RACING AND TRIALLING FREQUENCY – STARTED 1ST FEBRUARY

GRSA has adopted a new local rule in regard to frequency of racing and trialling which was implemented on Wednesday, 1st February 2023. Some greyhounds will not be eligible for the 7 in 28 period as this includes events in January. The local rule is below

69A Racing and trialling frequency

[1] In this rule:

Race has the same meaning given to this term in R9 of the GAR.

Trial means a satisfactory trial, or a qualifying trial as defined in R9 of the GAR.

- [2] A greyhound will only be permitted to start in
- [a] No more than a combined total of 2 race and trial starts in any 7-day period; and,
- (b) No more than a combined total of 7 race and trial starts in any 28-day period.
- [3] This sub-rule commences on a date to be fixed by Stewards' Notice.

The intent of this rule is to monitor and regulate the frequency of races and official trials of greyhounds, to ensure adequate rest time is given between events. The rule is similar to one in effect in Western Australia. We have automated the Ozchase Racing system to be able to monitor this rule. The rule is self-explanatory. A greyhound must not start more than 2 times (races or trials combined) in any 7-day period. Further, a greyhound must not start more than 7-times (races or trials combined) in any 28-day period.

Any attempt to nominate a greyhound outside these parameters will be flagged by the OzChase system. If a greyhound gains a start from reserve deeming it ineligible under this rule for its next engagement or it competes in another state prior to racing back in SA then the greyhound will come out.

- **Racing Administration staff will scratch these greyhounds acting under this rule without notification. [the responsibility rests with the trainer to ensure they do not contravene this rule]
- **For clarity if a greyhound races on Sunday, Wednesday then Sunday it will be eligible. The first day counts as day 1 and therefore resets on the Saturday.

LOCAL MATCH RACE SERIES "THE SA EASTAR" IN APRIL

The SA Local Match Race series coined "The SA Eastar" will be held on Thursday night, 6th April (Easter) at Angle Park.

Eligibility for South Australian local greyhounds will be based around the Nationals conditions. They will need to be trained in SA 76 days out of the last 150 prior to the close of nominations.

Selection for this series will only be based around winning times at Angle Park. For greyhounds that have run over the 530m at Angle Park on any meeting since 1st November, 2022 their fastest winning time will be recognised and put them on the list for selection.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3, Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. There will be no manual selection from the Grader. The top 4 seeded greyhounds will be rewarded with more prizemoney.

Winners of match races – Match 1 – 1 v 4 \$4,500, Match 2 – 2 v 3 \$4,000, Match 3 – 5 v 8 \$3,500, Match 4 – 6 v 7 \$3,000

There will be \$500 Runner's Up. Overall SA Eastar winner (based on overall times) - \$6,000, second \$2,500, third \$1,500.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED "ONLY"

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

Greyhound of the Month - Victa Damian



Greyhound of the Month for January was Victa Damian for trainer Lisa Rasmussen who only had two starts for the month but what performances they were, winning both and claiming the Group 1 National Derby at Wentworth Park.

The locally owned and bred son of Fernando Bale and Victa Polly started the month off in the Heats of the Group 1 National Derby where he created a huge impression winning his way through to the Final, in brilliant fashion, running 29.44 over the 520m journey demolishing his rivals by almost 8 lengths. He then stepped out in the Final as the favourite and didn't let anyone down, landing

second early and then powering home for his maiden Group 1 win by 4.25 lengths. He ran a time of 29.47 which was .03 quicker than Million Dollar Chase winner She's A Pearl who won the Group 1 Paws Of Thunder on the same night. Victa Damian's next event will be the Heats of the Group 1 Australian Cup at the Meadows on Saturday night, 18th February, followed by the Golden Easter Egg at Wentworth Park in early April.

At the end of the month Victa Damian's record stood at 11 starts for 8 wins and 1 placing and earnings just over \$110,000.

Run of the Month - Springvale Roxy

The Run of the Month for January was the Mike Giniotis trained sprinter, Springvale Roxy for her wonderful win in the Listed SA Sprint Championship Final at Angle Park on Thursday, 12th January.

A terrific field was assembled for the time honoured event where Springvale Roxy started one of the favourites. She began brilliantly from box 7 to grab the early lead and from there she was in no danger. She ran splits of 5.24 and 17.64 to race away with the win in a blistering 30.39 by almost 4 lengths.



2023 DOUG PAYNE SA BRED FEATURE – REVIEW

ANGLE PARK

The 2023 SA Bred Doug Payne Feature was run on Thursday, January 26th at Angle Park as part of the "Family Fun in the Sun" promotion in beautiful warm conditions with a large crowd in attendance. It was the Gavin Harris owned and trained sprinter, Springvale Max who showed his class to win in fine style and go past the \$100,000 in prizemoney.

Gavin previously won this race in 2017 with star sprinter Zinfandel Zara who had her blossoming race career shortened due to injury and no doubt this is a race that he targets with his SA bred sprinters.

The son of Barcia Bale and Springvale Bryne was sent out on the third line of betting behind Springvale Roxy for Mike Giniotis and the heavily supported Yarramundi Paul for Vadim Roz who was backed into challenge for favouritism. As the start was affected there was good speed from He's Our Design for Sharyn Gray who made full use of box 1 to grab the early lead', however, was quickly challenged by Victa Kurt from box 8 for Lisa Rasmussen who moved up stylishly. Back in third was Springvale Max who began well and was able to get ahead of both Springvale Roxy and Yarramundi Paul. Out of the front straight and He's Our Design was in the lead with Victa Kurt on his outside and tucked away on the inside in a great spot was Springvale Max. There was a small gap back to Springvale Roxy and Yarramundi Paul who looked to make ground. Down the back straight and the run appeared for Springvale Max along the inside as he grabbed the

lead from He's Our Design with Victa Kurt also making ground out wide with still a gap back to the rest. On the turn for home and Springvale Max had burst away from his opposition opening a race winning break. Victa Kurt ran to a clear second while He's Our Design began to struggle and was heavily challenged by Springvale Roxy and Yarramundi Paul for the minor prize. Down to the finish line and Springvale Max was doing it well in the lead and went on to win by 3.75 lengths in a slick 30.47 for the 530m journey. Victa Kurt ran a bold race for second with a further 1 length back to Yarramundi Paul who flashed home to grab third.

Springvale Max has now won just over \$102,000 in prizemoney with a terrific record of 26 wins from 62 starts including 16 placings.

Doug Payne is one of only three South Australian's inducted into the GCA Hall of Fame and is recognized as an icon of SA greyhound racing. He was a true ambassador for the industry winning the first three Adelaide Cups in 1972, 73 and 74 in addition to winning 14 training premierships.

It is always good to have some of Doug's family on course again this year with his daughter Carolyn, presenting the rug and trophy to the winning connections.

Distribution between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants who receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party (eg owners) then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

[^] **Prizemoney** includes payments to winners, places und unplaced of all South Australian races. Following feedback from participants in December 2020, additional money for feature races is averaged over the year.

From GRSA's perspective, the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you **DO NOT** need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically, however;
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners of your own accord, then you **DO** need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dogs(s). The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of \$71.43, calculated as:

$$$1,000 \div $700,000 \times $50,000 = $71.43$$

Participants should note that:

- WAP is **not payable** for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000].
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

This month, I would like to visit a couple of the rules as a refresher.

Treatment Record Books

Please remember to have – and use – treatment record books for all your racing greyhound. Rule 151 of the Greyhounds Australasia Rules states -

Division 4 – Requirements in relation to treatment records

- 151 Treatment records to be kept
- [1] The person in charge of a greyhound must keep and retain written records detailing all vaccinations, antiparasitics and treatments administered to the greyhound:
- (a) from the time the greyhound enters their care until the greyhound leaves their care; and
- (b) for a minimum of two years.
- [2] If requested by a Controlling Body, a Steward, or an authorised person, the record/s of treatment referred to in subrule [1] of this rule must be produced for inspection.
- [3] Each record of treatment kept in accordance with this rule must be made by midnight on the day on which the treatment was given, and, as a minimum requirement, include the following information:
- (a) the name of the greyhound;
- (b) the date and time of administration of the treatment;
- (c) the name of the treatment (brand name or active constituent);
- (d) the route of administration;
- (e) the amount given; and
- (f) the name and signature of the person or persons administering and/or authorising the treatment. For the purpose of subrule (3), "day" means the 24-hour period from 12.00am to 11.59pm on any calendar day.
- [4] An offence is committed if any person in charge of a greyhound at the relevant time fails to comply with any of subrules [1] to [3] of this rule.
- [5] A person who commits an offence under subrule (4) of this rule may be penalised.
- [6] For the purposes of this rule "treatment" includes:
- [a] all Controlled Drugs (Schedule 8);
- (b) all Prescription Animal Remedies and Prescription Only Medicines (Schedule 4);
- (c) any injectable substance not already specified in this rule, notwithstanding the route of administration;
- (d) all Pharmacist Only (Schedule 3) and Pharmacy Only (Schedule 2) medicines; and
- (e) all veterinary and other medicines containing other scheduled or unscheduled prohibited substances.

You can keep records manually (handwritten) or electronically, as long as the entries substantially conform with the above rule.

GRSA produce a Treatment Record Books that can be obtained from the Angle Park office or via download on our webpage.

Services of Notices

Rule 11 of the Greyhounds Australasia Rules provides, with respect to notices -

11 Giving notice

- [1] A notice or other document required or authorised to be given to or served on any person pursuant to the Rules may be given or served by:
- [a] having it personally delivered to the person to whom it is addressed;
- (b) posting it by prepaid registered post addressed to the last known place of residence or business of the person;
- (c) leaving it with a person at the last known place of residence or business of the person to whom it is addressed;
- (d) sending it by email to an email address provided by a person to a Controlling Body;
- (e) transmitting it by other electronic device (including by digital communication or facsimile) to a known address of a person.

Please consider confirming and updating, where necessary, your email address with us. Email is a fast and reliable way to send notices to you.

Our venues and liquor licensing

GRSA's member clubs, as you know, operate at several venues around the State. These venues trade under a liquor licence, the same as any other pub or club in South Australia. The requirements placed upon us, under the various liquor licensing laws and associated policies and procedures, place certain restrictions on various activities and conduct, such as where you can consume alcohol and how. Please remember that our friendly hospitality staff need to enforce these rules. Your cooperation with them is appreciated during our events.

New staff

At the moment, GRSA is putting on more staff, especially in the Stewards and Animal Welfare Departments. Some of these are to replace departed staff and others are new positions. Please say hello when you see any new faces and welcome them to the industry.

Minimum Vaccination Requirements for Greyhounds

A new rule of racing pertaining to vaccination requirements for greyhounds, **R25 Minimum Vaccination Requirements**, came into effect when the new rules were released on 1st May 2022. Most jurisdictions, including GRSA, chose to delay the introduction of this rule and have targeted 1st May 2023 as the introduction date.

What this will mean is that all greyhounds must have vaccinations up to date, including annual boosters, to permit them to race from 1st May 2023.

R25 Minimum Vaccination Requirements outlines the requirements at different stages of a greyhound's life, as specified in subrule 25[3]:

Additionally, sub-rule 25(6) outlines that a greyhound must not compete in any event within seven days of the date it was administered a vaccine.

25 Minimum vaccination requirements

- [1] An owner, trainer or person responsible for a greyhound must provide evidence of the current vaccination status of a greyhound upon request of the Controlling Body, officer of a Controlling Body, or any other employee, agent or official with authority of the Controlling Body.
- [2] Unless a Controlling Body determines based on a certificate issued by a veterinarian that vaccination would prejudice the greyhound's health, an owner, trainer or person responsible for a greyhound must ensure that a greyhound meets the minimum vaccination requirements and has up to date vaccination status.

(3) The minimum vaccination requirements are:

- [a] C3 Vaccination between six and eight weeks of age and prior to registration of a litter;
- (b) C5 Vaccination between 10 and 16 weeks of age and prior to registration of a litter;
- (c) C5 Vaccination at between 12 and 16 months of age and prior to naming; and
- (d) once in every further 12-month period a C5 Vaccination unless a veterinarian certifies the greyhound is protected to a C5 level.

(4) Where the minimum vaccination requirements are not met the Controlling Body or its Stewards may:

- (a) refuse the registration of any litter;
- (b) refuse the naming of any greyhound;

(c) prohibit a greyhound from nominating for any Event;

- (d) order a greyhound be scratched from any Event;
- [e] prohibit a breeding female from being serviced or being registered as a breeding female.
- [5] A Controlling Body may determine minimum vaccination requirements be increased providing that it is in the best interests of animal welfare and greyhound racing, such as in response to the outbreak of a reportable disease.
- [6] Unless a Controlling Body determines otherwise, a greyhound must not compete in any Event within seven days of the date it was administered a vaccine.

Evidence of the administration of a Vaccination by Veterinary Surgeon can be lodged with GRSA by email to admin@grsa. com.au For further information, please contact the Racing Department or Stewards.

GRSA staff not to handle greyhounds

Please be advised that it is an expectation of Management that no employee shall handle a greyhound on behalf of a registered participant during a race meeting or trial session including for activities such as boxing and catching. Employees who are also registered participants are expected to refrain from handling greyhounds when engaged as an employee. Exceptions are when the handling of a greyhound is required in an emergency or to restrain it.

Lightning Safety Protocol

GRSA have released a Lightning Safety Protocol which provides instruction and guidance to Stewards, staff, and participants when lightning and thunder presents. This policy applies to all race meetings and trial sessions.

1. IMPLEMENTATION OF PROTOCOL

At a race meeting:

- it shall be the responsibility of the Steward-In-Charge to monitor the prevailing weather for signs of approaching storms and implement the GRSA Lightning Safety Protocol.
- The Steward in charge may delegate another Steward to perform or assist in this function.

At a trial session:

 it shall be the responsibility of an appointed GRSA official to monitor storm activity and implement the GRSA Lightning Protocol.

2. THE "30/30 RULE"

The "30/30 rule" relates to the time lapse between observing the flash of lightning and hearing the clap of thunder.

The rule is used as a measure of the imminence of a storm and therefore as a factor in considering whether outdoor activities should be suspended.

The rule is based on the time taken for sound to travel. Depending on the prevailing temperature and humidity sound travels at approximately 340 metres per second.

Therefore, in assessing the proximity of a storm, every three [3] seconds of delay between the observation of a lightning flash and the hearing of the associated thunder equates to a distance of approximately one [1] kilometre.

Accordingly, a thirty (30) seconds flash to thunder delay equates to the lightning activity being approximately ten (10) kilometres away.

In summary:

- **30 seconds:** Count the number of seconds between observing lightning and hearing thunder. If this time period is thirty seconds or less, the lightning is sufficiently close to represent a hazard.
- **30 minutes:** After observing the final lightning flash or hearing the final thunder, remain under cover for thirty minutes to ensure the hazard has passed.

It is important to understand that blue sky and the absence of rain are not adequate reasons to ignore the "30/30 rule". Many victims are struck before the storm actually arrives because they wait too long to seek shelter.

Note: The "30/30 rule" is not an absolute rule. A storm may move very quickly, or not generate any lightning or thunder until it is very close, or topographical or wind conditions may prevent sound from traveling to your position. These conditions are especially common in mountain areas. It is important that staff observe weather conditions and be alert to the possibility of the above occurring.

3. APPLICATION/IMPLEMENTATION

If through the application of the "30/30 rule" or from the observations of the responsible Steward or appointed GRSA official as described in the Protocol, it is considered that lightning activity is occurring within ten [10] kilometres of a race track the following measures shall be taken:

a) Suspension of Activity

If the flash to thunder delay is thirty (30) seconds or less,

- (i) all activity shall be suspended, and
- (ii) an announcement made requesting all persons and greyhounds in attendance to seek shelter indoors.

b) Resumption of Activity

As trailing storm clouds may still carry a lingering charge, activity at the race track shall not resume until a period of thirty [30] minutes has elapsed after the last flash of lightning was observed.




Latest updates from GAP




We have also been working on reducing the time between assessment and entry into the program. The following graph shows the average monthly waiting times in weeks.

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:30pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

- 1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
- 3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

- For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
- For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
- 3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
 - Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
- 10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.






