

In the event of a natural disaster (or threat of) Greyhound Racing SA (GRSA) Ltd make all reasonable endeavours to open the nearest safe Kennel House facility for GRSA participants and the greyhounds in their care to be housed at such times refuge is required.

For the purposes of the policy, the definition of a natural disaster is a major adverse event resulting from natural processes; examples include fires and floods but also extend to all other geological processes. An adverse event will not rise to the level of a disaster within the context of the policy if it occurs in an area without a vulnerable participant or greyhound population.

GRSA will at its own discretion deem a Kennel House Facility to be open due to such an event or threat of an event/natural disaster on a case by case basis. The current racing and trialling schedule will take priority so the use of this service may be limited at times. Participants who chose to take up this option should ensure their greyhounds are appropriately supervised at all times whilst using the facilities.

GRSA will use the industry text messaging service to notify participants when the Kennel House facility is available to be accessed.

This service will be offered faithfully in the interests of participant and greyhound welfare but GRSA will not accept any liability for any issues that arise whatsoever from the taking up of this service either whilst in transit or at a GRSA facility. Participants will be required to sign a waiver to that effect.
