CEO'S UPDATE

Hoping for Greener Pastures in 2021

As we close the book on 2020, it's worth reflecting on how fortunate racing has been to find itself in the position we are now in. After a year which kicked off with bushfires and extreme hot weather, and then moved on to the significant challenges posed by the management of Covid restrictions and one of the most serious outbreaks of canine gastroenteritis that this state has experienced. Thankfully, the worst is now largely behind us.

There is much to look forward to in 2021. The renewal of the track and related infrastructure at Angle Park, whilst momentarily disruptive, will restore headquarters to its appropriate standing within the national racing community. The resilience of our wagering audience appears to have continued into this new year and the prospect of higher monthly returns to participants from the Wagering Activity Payment model remain in play. Separately, the wheels are in motion for a national consolidation of tote pools by late 2021, from which the South Australian greyhound industry would benefit, in a relative sense, as much as any other controlling body in the country. The other 'green shoot' from a local perspective is the popularity of the Saturday morning timeslot and the monthly growth that is evident for that meeting.

On a final note, I would like to congratulate connections of this year's GOTY finalists. It could very fairly be said that any of those being considered may have gone in a clear favourite in a different year, which only highlights the extent to which local breeders have focused on quality in recent years and how that is paying off.

In the reasonable hope that the light at the end of the current tunnel is not another train (!), I wish all the very best to our trainers, breeders, owners and punters for a highly successful year.

Lucy kicks off 2021 with back-to-back sprint title

■ ANGLE PARK

The first feature race of 2021 may end up being one of the best races for the year when the big guns of SA Sprinting stepped out in the Listed SA Sprint Championship Final on January 14th at Angle Park.

Most focus was on SA's two star sprinters in Shadow Mist for Lauren Harris who was tipped to improve significantly from box 1 after 4th in his heat after returning from the Group 1 Hobart Thousand series and Coorong Lucy for Cameron Butcher in box 2 who looked to be right back to her best after a blistering heat win the previous week.

The depth of the Final was significant, with three Greyhound of the Year finalists engaged and all runners given some hope of taking out the title.

However it was the queen of SA sprinting who re-established herself at the top of the tree when she lead throughout to claim the \$12,000 first prize and make it back to back victories in this race after taking out the 2020 edition.

The daughter of Worm Burner and Molly Be Nimble did what she does best and exploded from the boxes in a blistering 4.33 to the first turn to lead, however, Shadow Mist began very well and was hard on her heels as they left the front straight. Major Havoc for Tony Rasmussen from box 3 came out well to sit in third while Rushes for Lisa Rasmussen, Major Major for Troy Murray and Jack's Well for Cameron Butcher jostled for positions



in the early stages. Into the back straight and Coorong Lucy raced away and was going strongly with Shadow Mist sticking on well while Major Havoc was being challenged by Major Major along the inside. Jack's Well began to make good ground from worse than midfield. Off the back straight and Lucy wasn't stopping as she kept going into the front straight with a winning break. Shadow Mist gave his all but it looked like she had his measure on this occasion and Major Havoc was

in a strong battle with Major Major for third. As they raced down to the winning post Coorong Lucy was powering home going on to win by 3.50 lengths in a flying 29.52 for the 515m journey. Shadow Mist looks to be close to his best running a gallant second while Major Havoc ran a huge race in third only 2 lengths away and pulling away from Major Major in the run home. Jack's Well lost no admirers charging home from a long way back after having no luck early.

Racing schedule when Angle Park shutdown

At the most recent ICG meeting late last year it was agreed that proposed Schedule B would be adopted when the Angle Park Shutdown was in effect which should be by about mid March.

Greyhound of the Year on Saturday 30th January at Angle Park this year

The date has been set for the Greyhound of the Year function at Angle Park this year on Saturday night, 30th January 2021.

The venue has been moved to Angle Park this year to allow more room under Government guidelines due to COVID restrictions. The GOTY awards night is always a great night and this is anticipated to be extremely exciting with so many fantastic greyhounds vying for the top award. It's a night not to be missed.

2021 Gawler Produce second payment due 29th January

After nominations were finalised for the 2021 Gawler Produce GRSA has guaranteed final stake money of \$22,000 with an estimate for the total series prizemoney around \$40,000. The series is for greyhounds whelped in 2019.

The racing dates for this series will be Heats on Sunday, 20th June 2021, Semi Finals on Sunday, 27th June 2021 and the Final on Sunday, 4th July 2021.

GRSA administers the event for the Gawler Club, so all payments are to be made to GRSA. If you have already made the one off payment then there is nothing more to do, however, if you only made the first payment the second lot of payments are due on Friday, 29th January 2021 with the third and final payment due on Friday, 2nd April 2021.

The paperwork has been sent out so you should be receiving them in the post.

Saturday morning fortnightly meetings

We introduced the fortnightly Saturday morning meeting at Angle Park with these meetings being Time Graded with alternate conditions as this is the biggest group of greyhounds.

The next meeting will be this Saturday, 23rd January the following meeting will be on Saturday, 6th February which will be a Timed Graded Meeting-"Worst to Best" rating. Greyhounds graded into 3 categories. Maidens, 1-4 wins & 5 or more wins. Specific grades of greyhounds are not considered except for Maidens. Races-N/P with Pathway Prizemoney. Reserves will be determined by Grader. There will be No Guarding. Refer to "Time Based Grading" published conditions.

\$850 Six Fastest Forward (5+ Wins) Heats - 388m [Max 4 Heats - \$1,700 Final Monday 15/2/21. Selected from Worst to Best of this category. Final field will be a 6-dog field plus reserves, comprising of the greyhounds running the fastest times in the Heats, regardless of their finishing position in those Heats]

- Nominations close Tuesday, 2nd February at 9.00am.

Mount Gambier to race twice a week from January

With Victorian trainers now eligible to nominate for Mount Gambier this will allow the resumption of two weekly race meetings per week at Mount Gambier, with both Thursday and Sunday meetings being included in the Sky schedule this month.

The Thursday meetings will be Time Graded events (Maidens, 1-4 wins and 5+ wins) with only 400m plus events programmed and the Sunday meetings will be the normal graded meetings with the new 305m distance included under specific conditions.

With the resumption of two weekly meetings from the beginning of January 2021, GRSA has reverted the prizemoney levels at Mount Gambier back to the current Category 3 levels with a movement back to G-SIX across both meetings where possible.

305m start at Mount Gambier from 24th January

The 305m start will come into effect at Mount Gambier this Sunday, 24th January. The Club has programmed Maiden Heats over 305m sponsored by Razza Racing, open to all Maiden greyhounds of any age. They will then progress to the Final on Sunday, 31st January with the Club appreciative of the sponsorship.

The Club will then revert back to normal conditions that they had for the 277m for the 305m with -

Only two 305m races on Sundays, one for young Maiden greyhounds with the youngest greyhounds gaining entry first based on age. There will also be a Masters 305m with eligible greyhounds being selected on age with the oldest given first preference. Masters conditions is the same as races conducted in the Metro area with greyhounds 3¾ years and above eligible. [Masters can start on 31st January if sufficient nominations]

GRSA and the Mount Gambier GRC strongly recommend trainers nominate for multiple distances to ensure they do not miss out on a run at any meeting.

It is anticipated the 732m start will be available from 11th February.

Any changes to this schedule will be communicated to the industry via the normal channels.

Doug Payne on Thursday January 28th

The \$8,580 Doug Payne SA Bred Feature Free For All will be on Thursday, January 28th. The race is for SA Bred greyhounds only and is Non Penalty.

- Nominations close Monday, 25th January at 9.00am.

Fly For Trix claims December's award

Greyhound of the Month for December was Fly For Trix for trainer Jane McNichol. Fly For Trix had three starts for the month, with two wins and a second, capping of a fine season for the son of Fernando Bale and Weblec Rose.

In a tight month of voting, Fly For Trix got the nod from the judges with the Group 3 Brian Johnstone Final the main highlight. He started the month as a red hot favourite in the Group 3 Feature and he didn't let his supporters down winning in fine style by 1.50 lengths in a flying 29.75. He then went to the straight track at Murray Bridge winning as he liked in 19.07 over the 350m making it 8 wins in a row with a Victorian campaign on the cards. His final run for the month was in the Group 1 Silver Chief Heats in Victoria where he ran a gallant second against very strong company, only beaten 2 lengths when he led for most of the way with a personal time at the Meadows of 29.87.

At the end of the month Fly For Trix record stood at 23 starts for 16 wins and 4 placings and earnings just over \$50,000, with a bright future ahead for connections.



Air Marshall claims award with track record run

The Run of the Month for November was Air Marshall for trainer Ray Murray after his track record performance at Angle Park on Monday, 16th November over the 388m journey.

Blessed with high speed, Air Marshall wasn't first away but he quickly exploded away from his rivals to lead easily over the short course trip. He ran through the first section in 9.84 and a quick time was on the cards. He raced away over the latter stages to win by almost 3 lengths in a flying 21.81, shaving .04 off Victa Louise's time of 21.85 set in April 2018. With the redevelopment of Angle Park early next year it is likely this will be the last track record set at Angle Park before new distances are implemented.

AGRC Maiden Series in February

The AGRC have sponsored a Maiden Series at Angle Park over the 515m with \$2,255 Heats on Thursday, 11th February with the \$5,000 Final on Thursday, 18th February.

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 15th February at 9.00am.

Launching Pad SA Series begins on 25th February

Again this year the Sandown GRC offered sweepstakes tickets into the rich Launching Pad Series.

There are special conditions on the race, being for greyhounds that have won between 1 and 6 races and have not had more than 30 starts at close of their nominations.

The Heats will be run at Sandown over the 515m on Thursday, 18th March with the Semi-Finals on Thursday, 25th March and the \$150,000 to the winner Final run on Thursday, 1st April. Greyhound Racing SA was able to secure a ticket and will give one greyhound the opportunity to compete in this lucrative series. We will run a Heat and Final series to determine who will make the Launching Pad Heats on 18th March.

Our Heats will be run on Thursday, 25th February over the 515m at Angle Park for greyhounds that have won 1-4 races and no more than 28 starts at close of nominations. The Heats will be worth \$3,280 and will be Non Penalty events. The Final will be run at Angle Park on Thursday, 4th March over the 515m with prizemoney of \$4,715 and will also be Non Penalty.

The winner of the Final will take their spot in the Launching Pad Heats two weeks later, however, if the winner for whatever reason cannot take their spot then the next qualified greyhound will be given that spot.

GRSA has restricted the series to 1-4 wins and 28 starts incase a greyhound wins both the Heat and Final so this will still keep them eligible. If greyhounds win outside the series this may deem them ineligible for the Sandown series. We have also made our Final two weeks before the Launching Pad Heats at Sandown to give the trainer an opportunity to get across the border and trial for the big race.

- Nominations close with GRSA for the SA Heats at 9am on Monday, 22nd February.

Gawler Breeders 2021 Heats in February

The first part of the Breeders 2021 series kicks off with \$1,500 Heats on Sunday, 28th February over the 400m (Short Course).

The \$3,000 Final will be run on Sunday, 7th March 2021. For SA Bred greyhounds paid up for Breeders 2021

- Nominations for the Heats close Wednesday, 24th February at 9.00am.

Murray Bridge Cup and Mount Gambier Cups in March/April with big bonuses

It will be a big couple of months of racing in March and April for the Murray Bridge and Mount Gambier Clubs when they conduct their Cup meetings.

The Murray Bridge Cup Heats will be conducted on Friday, 5th March with the \$15,000 to the winner (listed event) to be run on Sunday night, 14th March.

The Mount Gambier Cup Heats have been scheduled to be on Sunday, 11th April with the \$15,000 to the winner (listed event) Final on Sunday, 18th April.

GRSA will continue with bonuses to link both events, these will include a \$5,000 bonus if the same dog can win both the Murray Bridge Cup and Mount Gambier Cup and a \$5,000 trainer bonus if the same trainer can win both Cups (SA or Interstate or different dogs).

Transition to online nominations

GRSA has been extremely appreciative of ICG panelist, Christine Costa, who has made herself available and spoken to those trainers needing some guidance with the online process over the last few weeks.

She has gone out of her way to assist her fellow participants and now GRSA will be in touch shortly to assist with the processes they require.

The ICG and GRP panel members are happy to assist any trainer who requires some assistance in transitioning; along with GRSA staff, so please do not hesitate to contact any person as the process is reasonably straight forward.

Changes to weighted points score for South Australia

Based on the most recent Grading Review Panel meeting the Grading Department have made changes to the points allocation for the WPS. This is the first part of changes approved by the GRP for implementation and will be effective immediately.

The main changes are –

- The Maiden points for category CTA, CTB, PRI have now been slightly increased and tiered
- All placegetters 7th and 8th are allocated 6th place points to accommodate the mix of G-SIX and 8 – dog Quad racing in SA

GRSA is still working with OzChase for race classification for Time Graded and Pathway events along with the changes approved for the Order of Preference.

THE EASTAR – Match Race Series Local match race series ‘The Eastar’ moved to Gawler for 2021

The local South Australian match race series, nicknamed ‘The Eastar’, will be shifted to Gawler due to the track update of Angle Park, which is expected to be well underway by April 2021.

The series will be held on Easter Sunday night, 4th April at Gawler over the 531m. A big local crowd is expected for the meeting given the timing of the event and the public holiday the following day.

Greyhounds competing must be South Australian, based on the Nationals Championships conditions, which require greyhounds to be domiciled in the state for at least 76 days of the last 150 days prior to the close of nominations.

Selection for this series will be for the fastest greyhounds nominated, based on their best time over the Gawler 531m distance since 1st October 2020 [regardless of their placing]. GRSA will regularly update and publish a leaderboard (top 25), so all trainers and connections are aware of where their greyhound stands up until the close of nominations on Wednesday, 31st March 2021.

There will be two lead up Preludes dates of the Eastar at Gawler. They will be normally graded events over the 531m worth a total of \$3,585 [City A prizemoney] with the winner taking a Prov 1 penalty. They will be programmed for Sunday 28th February and Sunday 21st March with a Maximum of 2 preludes per meeting.

Greyhounds will also have an opportunity to post a time by solo trialling over the Gawler 531m (dates to be determined). Trainers wishing to pursue this option will require approval from the Grading Department, to ensure greyhounds are suitable for the event based on form and times run at other tracks. Greyhounds that sit on the leaderboard (top 25) will also be afforded the opportunity to improve their position by way of solo trialling.

Nominations for the Gawler ‘Eastar’ will close on Wednesday, 31st March 2021 at 9.00am, with the eight (8) fastest greyhounds selected for the local match race series. Reserves will be selected as per a final (based on time) and in the event of a scratching, reserve 9 will have preference over reserve 10.

The head-to-head matches will be decided based on the final leaderboard, with no manual intervention by the Grader, as per the following:

- Match 1 – Seed 1 v Seed 4 [1st \$2,750 - 2nd \$350]
- Match 2 – Seed 2 v Seed 3 [1st \$2,500 - 2nd \$350]
- Match 3 – Seed 5 v Seed 8 [1st \$2,250 - 2nd \$350]
- Match 4 – Seed 6 v Seed 7 [1st \$2,000 - 2nd \$350]

Items from GRP

The items below come from the recent Grading Review Panel meeting with an implementation date advised. There are other items from the meeting that are currently in the process of being changed and an implementation date will then be determined.

Mixed Masters – Grading –

It was recommended to the panel that if a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading. If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters (ie Grade 2/3 & 4) we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event. Effective immediately

Policy Interstate Greyhounds - Summary of change's for the greyhounds career

Interstate greyhounds racing in SA for the first time will be Grade 5 at all tracks and distances, unless they meet the following criteria, which would then see them, being upgraded to Grade 4 at all tracks and distances:

- 5+ metropolitan full stakes wins
- \$75,000 in prizemoney

Interstate greyhounds racing in SA for the first time and meet the following criteria, will be upgraded to Grade 3 at all tracks and distances:

- Group 1 & 2 winners over a similar distance in the past 6 months

The grader has ultimate discretion in applying the above upgrade rule, and may choose to keep a greyhound at Grade 5 level if one or more of the following apply:

- The form of the greyhound is poor enough to warrant it remaining at Grade 5
- The greyhound is a masters greyhound (4yo+)
- The distance the greyhound is nominating for is outside the greyhound's normal distance range

Greyhounds that have left SA to race Interstate to race for 3 months or more, will be subject to the above upgrade rules upon their return. However, any grade that was established at a particular track and distance prior to their departure from SA will be retained in the last 6 months.

This will replace the greyhounds winning a Metro Grade policy for assessment in SA.

This will not affect the Grade 6 policy

This has been in effect from Monday, 4th January 2021.

Comments on nominations marked “only”

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds. The panel previously resolved that “Only” would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put “Only or no start or leave me out” then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

Winning grade 6 races in order

GRSA reminds trainers to win their Grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

Re-grading for all tracks and distances

Re grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.


Approved beanies are part of the GRSA Dress Code Policy and available for sale from GRSA.

Jack's Well claims the last feature race of 2020

The 2020 Kate's A Scandal Xmas Sprint was run at Angle Park on Xmas Eve and the festive crowd were treated to another outstanding performance by the Cameron Butcher trained Jack's Well.

Having only his 19th start in a race, he stepped up to Free For All company for the first time and didn't disappoint, putting away a quality Xmas Sprint field in fine style.

The son of Aston Dee Bee and Molly Be Nimble started a warm favourite after the scratching of Air Marshall [box 1] for Ray Murray earlier in the week. Not noted for his quick beginnings, Jack's Well was beaten out as the boxes flew open from box 3 with reserve Sutton Daisy for Angela Modra making full use of the inside box to charge to the front, quickly followed by Cawbourne Scar [box 4] for Tony Rasmussen and Spring Burner [box 8] for Greg Board. Jack's Well copped a bit of pressure early but made his way to fourth along the inside, with clear galloping room as they left the front straight.

Into the back straight and Cawbourne Scar railed hard to claim the lead from Sutton Daisy while Jack's Well moved swiftly into second around the outside as Sutton Daisy dropped back and was challenged by Helen's Teddy for Bec Romyn, who made very quick ground



along the rails after a slow beginning.

Off the back straight and Jack's Well had raced clear from Cawbourne Scar while Sutton Daisy was under pressure to hold her position from Helen's Teddy around the outside and Spring Burner railing hard along the inside. Rounding the home turn and Jack's Well slipped into another gear and raced away by 5 or 6 lengths with Cawbourne Scar desperately trying to hold down second from a strong challenge from Helen's Teddy. As they hit

the line Jack's Well had increased his lead, racing away from his rivals in a powerful performance to win by 7.75 lengths in a blistering 29.61, setting a new race record which included a sizzling run home of 12.56. Helen's Teddy got home strongly into second while Cawbourne Scar held on well for third.

The Xmas Sprint is one race that had eluded master trainer Cameron Butcher on the SA feature race calendar until now.

WAP updates for participants

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) advises participants that the Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of November 2020 amounted to \$275,000 and the WAP for December 2020 was \$292,000.

Total WAP payments for the six months to the end of December now amount to \$1,276,000. GRSA are delighted at this outcome. When the WAP model was introduced it was forecast that the total WAP payments over the course of the year would amount to \$600,000. Given that we are only half way through the year and the WAP paid is more than double that original forecast it is evidence of the benefits of the model.

The table below is provided for the benefit of those participants wishing to better understand the computation of the WAP.

Change to remittance advice

Following feedback from participants we have added some additional data into the WAP remittance advice. Unfortunately, we are limited to using the existing fields on the remittance advice. We are also restricted to a maximum of 22 characters per field, which will necessarily require the shortening of long dog names. Nevertheless, we are hopeful that participants get value from the new data and are open to hearing comments about how we might improve it further.

Distribution between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

Participants to remain behind boxes

There have been an increasing number of occasions where participants have been viewing race starts from in front of the boxes, particularly at the Angle Park 388m and Gawler 400m distances.

Participants are reminded that they are to stay behind the boxes until the field is released. Please approach Stewards if you require further explanation.

Veterinary clearance prior to trial

Veterinary clearance is required prior to trialling for Satisfactory Trials relating to unraced for more than 6 months, returning from retirement or whelping, or when requested by Stewards.

The purpose of the Veterinary clearance is to ensure the greyhound is fit to trial and therefore needs to be viewed by Stewards prior to trialling. Should Veterinary clearance not be provided to Stewards the Satisfactory Trial will not proceed.

Veterinary Certificate for late scratching

On occasions when a late scratching for illness or injury is not examined by on track Veterinary staff, Stewards will invariably request a Veterinary Certificate to be provided within 48 hours.

Trainers are reminded that the certificate is required to state that the greyhound was unfit to race on the particular day it was scratched and the reason that it was unfit [the particular injury or illness]. Stewards do not require a Veterinary Certificate stating the greyhound is fit to resume racing.

Reminder - Hot Weather Policy review

The GRSA Hot Weather Policy was reviewed in March at an Industry Consultative Group Meeting. Some important changes have been made:

- 1) Early kennelling will be implemented if the temperature is expected to reach or exceed 35 degrees at kennelling time. Participants will be advised via text message.
- 2) Trainers will no longer be required to provide a Veterinary Certificate confirming that a greyhound suffers from heat stress to have a greyhound included on the Heat Stress Register.
- 3) Early kennelling will not be provided for day meetings. It will apply to twilight and night meetings only.

Please consult Stewards if you require clarification.

Social media

I remind everyone to be mindful when posting comments on social media that are unwelcome. Even in the face of a post that you take an issue with, please do not engage with it. As greyhound industry participants, you are under a brighter spotlight in the public arena than the general public are.

Where I can substantiate a complaint that posts to social media breach the rules of racing, I may commence action. This will include the option to suspend registration where I think this action is needed (for example repeat offenders).

In addition, I encourage anyone who thinks they are the victim of online comments that are unwelcomed to contact me. This year, the federal government is likely to introduce new laws that compel social media platforms and ISPs to identify and disclose the true identity of troll accounts and take action against them. If the platform or ISP does not comply, they face being banned from operating in Australia. Posting harmful content, even if on an account that is anonymous, is illegal under federal criminal law and is punishable by imprisonment of up to 3-years. It does not matter that the poster is not in South Australia.

If you are a victim and the troll account holder is unidentified, or even an unregistered person with GRSA, please still contact me. It may be a matter we can refer to the police or the office of the eSafety Commissioner.

On a practical front, ignore and block trolls who make comments that are unwelcome. They want you to react, and for reasons only known to them, think that the time taken to make the posts is worth their precious time. Don't. Don't comment. Don't waste one second of your life on it. Just let them punch away at the keyboard to an audience of no one.

COVID-19

By now everyone will be used to the idea of the COVID-SAafe check in at all facilities. Simply download the mySA GOV app on your mobile, open the app, and follow the check-in procedure.

We do provide paper sign-in sheets for those who cannot use the QR code system. With these sign-in sheets, I keep them for 28 days and then shred them via a secure shredding service. GRSA does not keep copies [scanned or otherwise] of these sheets. Should a cluster be associated with a GRSA facility, we are obliged to assist SA Health by supplying to them [in the 28-day period]. Similarly, GRSA does not have access to any data relied on by the mySA GOV SA app. If you have a mobile, can I please encourage you to use the QR codes. After the first time, it is a very easy process.

If you have any suggestions for a better way to check in, especially during kennelling [location of the QR codes] please let me know. I am limited in where I can put the QR codes

outside, as the wind plays havoc with them. But if you think checking in would be better at a different location, please let me know.

Masks, as you know, are optional and GRSA follow government advice to recommend masks in areas where social distancing cannot be achieved.

I have placed GRSA's COVID-19 response in one Stewards' Notice, on the GRSA web page under Racing-COVID-19 Response. It includes the procedure for facilities, cross border procedure and some links to various sites. In addition, where I issue a specific Stewards' Notice on a COVID-19 restriction, you can find that again on the GRSA web page, under Integrity-Rules and Policies-Stewards' Notices. This specific notice will advise of current restrictions where we need to follow a specific SAPOL Direction. This usually relates to cross-border movement.

Thanks again to everyone for your efforts with the COVID-19 response. Let's hope this year sees that this gets relegated to the history books.

Local rule amendments

Rule 114 of the Local Regulatory Rules was recently amended. The first amendment formally recognises the renaming of GAP to "Greyhounds as Pets".

The second amendment inserts a new sub-rule [1A] that provides "where a greyhound has been retired in accordance with GAR 106[3](a), a registered person shall be guilty of a Serious Offence if the person sells or otherwise transfers ownership or custody of a greyhound to a third party into circumstances where they are aware, or ought to be aware, that the greyhound will be, or is likely to be euthanised or exist under conditions that are to its detriment." Local Rule 114[1A] reinforces the well-established and supported practice that registered persons actively participate in the process of retiring their greyhounds to third parties.

Projects Update

Murray Bridge Track Works

Throughout December and early January, the team at Murray Bridge have undertaken a significant civil works project to modify the cambers and camber transitions on the home bend of the circle track.

This project has not been without its challenges, as over 350 tonnes of new sand material was added to the track and needed to be blended with the existing racetrack surface.

It has now been over three weeks since the initial works took place, and the team is extremely comfortable that the sand surface has now had time to fully bed down. The surface is looking very much like it did prior to the works.

Huge credit must go to the whole team down at Murray Bridge, but in particular to Joe Hodge, who spent many hours on the tractor harrowing, rolling and watering the surface to get the track ready for both races meetings and trials.

GRSA believes the changes will prove very successful and will monitor injury rates over the coming months to see whether the change in camber has had an impact on injury performance.



Management will also engage with the new MBGRC Committee and local participants on how the changes have impacted the

racing line of greyhounds exiting the home bend on the track.

Mount Gambier 305m Start

The project to install a new short-course 305m racing start at Mount Gambier is nearing completion, with the majority of works and the commencement of trialling occurring prior to Christmas.

Whilst there are still a few small elements remaining to be completed, the new start has been used for trialling over the past 3 weeks and will be available for racing from Sunday, 24th January race meeting.

The final element of this project will be the refurbishment of some old Victorian boxes, which will then be placed on the 277m/732m concrete slab, for use solely as a 732m staying distance.

For clarity, once these boxes are again placed on that slab, it will not be possible to run both the old 277m start and the new 305m start concurrently. The 277m distance has effectively been decommissioned.

It is hoped that the staying start will be up and running by the end of February.



Slipping Track Timing Systems

New timing systems are being installed on the slipping tracks at both Angle Park and Murray Bridge and will be fully operational by next week.

The systems, which will need to be operated by participants using the track, will provide a sectional time, overall time and run home time for greyhounds running up the length of the slipping track.

Instructions on use of the timing systems will be displayed at each of the timing consoles, which will be located at the far end of the Angle Park track and the lake end of the Murray Bridge track.

GRSA will produce an instructional video on how to use the systems which will be placed on the GRSA Facebook group. Maintenance staff will also be available to provide training.

It may take some time getting used to the new timing systems and if any participant needs assistance they are asked to contact GRSA admin.



Gawler 326m Education Boxes

The new Gawler 326m puppy/educational boxes will be available for use from the trial session on Friday next week.

The boxes will allow for up to 4 greyhounds to trial at once and will have full timing, including a first sectional and run home time.

Given that there is no booking of trials at Gawler, participants are advised to let GRSA staff know at the session that they wish to trial out of the boxes when they arrive on site.

Angle Park Redevelopment Project

Works are continuing behind the scenes on the planning for the upgrade to the Angle Park race track.

Whilst the Christmas and New Year period has resulted in some delays to the timing of these preliminaries, GRSA is still confident of the project commencing at some point in March 2021.

It is expected that the commencement date and the timing of the project will be confirmed towards the end of January, after which management will advise the industry and make the necessary changes to the racing calendar.



Brett's big boilovert in Sims Memorial

Compton trainer Tracie Price boasts a fair record in recent times in the long-running Sims Feature Maiden over 512 metres with Benara Cosmic successful in 2014 and Rocketline again last year.

The series is now known as the Sims Family Memorial, run in memory of Col and Val Sims and their son Ian.

And it's probably fair to say that Price and his wife Karen would not have gone into the final on Sunday 17th January at Tara Raceway with Compton Pete and Compton Brett with much confidence.

After all, Compton Pete had won his roughhouse heat the previous week in 30.69 seconds, certainly considerably slower than Apache Jakit and Noir Star's 30.15 seconds and 30.19 seconds when running the quinella in the other heat.

Compton Brett, on the other hand, had scraped into the final after running 7½

lengths fourth in the faster of the two heats. In fact, after eight starts he had yet to run a place, Price saying bad box manners had been holding him back.

He wasn't kidding. The big black dog once again made a mess of the start from box eight in the final. But after finding an early spot on the rails, Compton Brett was able to rail through down the back straight and take the lead. A boilovert was looming. Meanwhile, out wide, Compton Pete was

keeping out of trouble and making ground.

And in the run home, the Price-trained pair fought out the finish, Compton Brett, a \$34 chance and probably the longest-priced winner of a Sims Feature Maiden, winning by 2¼ lengths in 30.43 seconds.

These days it is a pretty big business out at the Compton kennels; predominantly a family operation and perhaps not all that different to the successful Sims family operation all those years ago.


If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!


Latest updates from GAP

Greyhounds As Pets

Classic win for Oakvale Style at Gawler

The feature event at Gawler's Sunday 3rd January race meeting was the running of the 2020 Gawler Classic Final.

The event is part of a paid up Series of races for SA Bred greyhounds whelped in the second half of 2018, and attracted a full field of eight runners. Run over 531m distance, Zinfandel Tori from box 3 was fast away, to lead the favourite runner, Fly For Trix [7] out of the straight the first time around. On the turn however, Fly For Trix was checked in running, which allowed Zinfandel Tori to open up a four length break on the field. Down the back straight, Oakvale Style [6] was starting to run on well, and Fly For Trix had been able to regain his momentum, so an interesting finish was on the cards. However, Oakvale Style proved to be too strong in the finish, going on to win by six lengths in a good time of 30.94 secs. Second was Fly For Trix for Jane McNicholl of Williamstown, and Zinfandel Tori finished third for Vadim Roz of Lewiston.

Oakvale Style is trained by Nathan Wilson, and is raced in partnership with his wife Kerri. Nathan and Kerri breed all their own stock, and have had an exciting and rewarding time in the industry. It all began when Nathan and Kerri, along with his sister Mel and her husband Ken, started going to the greyhounds at Angle Park, about ten years ago. Enjoying the racing as spectators, they decided to become owners, the result being that they soon bred a litter, which started a breeding line

that among others, produced Oakvale Destiny, the mother of Oakvale Style. Oakvale Destiny won the prestigious Sapphire Crown race in 2014, which is run in Victoria, and she has also won in other states, winning a total of nearly \$280 000 in the process.

Based in Pinnaroo, Nathan is a cereal farmer there, in addition to his interesting greyhound hobby. With a racing team of ten racing dogs, there is plenty of work and travel involved to make it a success. While the current racing team should

have long careers ahead of them, Nathan is looking to breed from a couple of his females, something in which Kerri takes the lead role.

Nathan is keen to support the industry as well, and has recently decided to help out as Vice President of the Murray Bridge Club, which is an hour away from Pinnaroo, and is his "local" track. Nathan and Kerri like working with greyhounds because of their special nature, and enjoy the people involved that they have met, both locally and interstate.

GRSA is looking for South Australian trainers that we can partner with new syndicates and owners to help get new participants involved and grow the sport we love.

With a real determination to make syndication a success for the future of the code here in our state, GRSA recently created the role of Syndicate Coordinator to work as a conduit between the public and participants to help facilitate new and successful syndicates.

- Syndicates will choose their desired trainer from a list of those public trainers wishing to register.
- No contact details will be revealed to the syndicate until a meeting between the parties has occurred to ensure a correct fit for both trainer and syndicate.
- The process is designed to be as easy as possible for all parties, with the GRSA Syndication Coordinator assisting in the setting up and managing of the syndicates, as well as providing templates and contracts for the syndicate and trainers
- GRSA will ensure that syndicates are aware of the Syndicate Manager being the main point of contact with the trainer.
- Syndicates will also be fully aware of their obligations to the greyhound(s) in regards to post-racing and its entry into GAP SA or the home of a syndicate member.

Essential criteria for trainers:

- Registered as a public trainer
- Excellent communication skills and commitment to engage with syndicate members
- A willingness to help make syndication an enjoyable experience
- An excellent animal welfare record
- A positive attitude
- Any basic experience with Facebook and social media

to help communicate with the syndicate is an advantage.

In return, the GRSA Syndicate Coordinator will facilitate that trainers are only having to deal with the Syndicate Manager and will help present available options of greyhounds for purchase with the final decision that of the syndicate with hopefully input from the trainer.

We are in the early stages of this process and GRSA hopes we can all work together to ensure this is a success for all involved.

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday or Tuesday (drawn Thursday) meetings. Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday.

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Friday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Thursday.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held on a monthly basis at a Wednesday night session for one turn track only. Qualifying will be for the following Friday (drawn Tuesday). The next session will be Wednesday, February 24th. Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday prior.

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

Summer here we come!

As summer fast approaches the landscape will continue to dry out, growth from winter and spring rains will create an abundance of fuel for bushfires that may affect you and your dogs.

If you live in, travel through or visit bushfire risk areas it is critical that you recognise the need to have a plan and be prepared.

The risk is real and you should be prepared for the worst at all times. The consequences can be both devastating and terrifying, so why risk it?

Here are some points to be seriously considered when getting your property ready for summer and help greatly reduce the risk of being adversely affected by a bushfire:

- Clean out your gutters on sheds and buildings keeping them free from debris such as leaves and bark. Removing branches of trees that are overhanging any of your buildings is advised.
- Create a defensible space around your home by reducing vegetation
- Rake up leaves and removed excess rubbish and debris from around buildings and other structures
- Move flammable objects away from house
- Ensure you have a well-stocked emergency kit
- Place wire 'ember' mesh over wall vents
- Ensure your dogs and cats are identified and registered in case you become separated.

- Ensure your pets' vaccinations are up to date in case they need to be placed in kennels.
- Be sure you can adequately restrain or confine your pets as it may become frightened and distressed.
- Have an appropriate container, vehicle or equipment to transport your animal.

If you are planning to leave early in the event of a bushfire, consider what items you may need to include in your emergency kit for your pets, suggestions include:

- Plastic containers for water and food
- Small amounts of pet food
- Suitable bedding
- Pet medication
- Animal documentation such as identification and vaccination certificates
- Update your 5 Min Bushfire Plan – don't have one... make your own 5 Minute Plan today by visiting the CFS website and take all precautions necessary. Follow this link for more details:

Remember to also think of others in the community and alert them to potential hazards and check on them in the event a bushfire occurs.

Important points to remember on "High Risk Fire Days"

- If you have to leave your home during the day you will need to decide whether to take your animals to a safer place.
- Keep in mind that, if there is a fire, you may not be able to return to your home for some time.
- If you are home, keep your pets inside (where possible).
- Check you have the necessary pet items in your emergency kit if you plan to leave early.
- Have somewhere pre-arranged to accept your animals (if large number are being moved).
- When leaving your home keep all dogs on a lead and confine other animals in cages or suitable carrying devices.
- Cover cages with a woollen blanket to minimise distress and secure all pets in a car or vehicle that provides adequate protection for transportation.
