NOTES FROM THE CHAIRMAN GRANTLEY STEVENS

Dear valued participants,
While the greyhound industry never sleeps, I hope you all got a moment to spend precious time with family and friends over the Christmas and New Year period. As we always say in sport, 2024 is going to be a big year for greyhound racing in South Australia. It has kicked off very positively with our "Fun in the Sun" events attracting strong crowds at Murray Bridge and Mt Gambier with big nights planned at Angle Park and Gawler.
As you are aware, we have entered a period where the entirety of our industry is being closely scrutinized by government. While the Premier has been very clear in his remarks that he does not want to see our industry shut down, we do need demonstrate change across several areas to strengthen greyhound racing in South Australia for the future.
Together with the Board and Senior Management team we have undertaken significant dialogue with our clubs and participants since the handing down of the Inquiry's 89 recommendations. While there is strong support for the vast majority of requirements, there are some that we do require clarification, or more detail from government. We will be communicating the particulars of this to government by the end of the month and subsequently working through this with them. As soon as we have a final position on all recommendations, we will share it with you.
A key person that will drive the execution of this reform will be our next CEO. The Board are currently in the final stages of working through a strong list of candidates to fill this key role. I look forward to informing you of the successful candidate shortly and thank Ben Kavenagh who has temporarily stepped off the board to fill the interim role ensuring a smooth transition during this important time for us.
Some of you may have also been wondering why no date has been set for the 2023 Greyhound of the Year award. We are currently experiencing an unprecedented situation where one of our candidates is yet to have an interstate, 2023-related inquiry, resolved. We are advised that this matter should be dealt with soon, at which point, we can then release all eligible candidates for the prestigious award and announce a date. 2023 was a year where we had several outstanding performances across our industry. I look forward to acknowledging and celebrating these with you all soon.

2023 KATE'S A SCANDAL XMAS SPRINT

Adhana Rico for trainer Ashlee Griffiths has taken out the 2023 Kate's A Scandal Xmas Sprint in a brilliant 30.32.

Getting away well from box one, Adhana Rico held the rail and was able to enjoy clear running out in front and record a comfortable win by four lengths.

Victa Marli for Ron Schadow finished in second place while Agent Nine Nine for Ben Rawlings rounded out the podium.

The race is named for Kate's A Scandal who was the winner of 15 consecutive races culminating in 1981 with the National Sprint Championship at Olympic Park in Victoria.



2024 SA SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP

Fiorano has taken out the 2024 Listed SA Sprint Championship returning to his best with a brilliant performance from box three.

The Listed event produced a high-quality field with Adhana Rico entering the Final as a red-hot favourite. However, he was upstaged by his kennel mate in Fiorano, who returned to his best out of the boxes with a 5.19 first split which saw Fiorano able to pinch a winning break.

Adhana Rico began to close around the home turn but Fiorano was able to hold off and win by a quarter of a length in 30.41 with Adhana Rico in second and the fast-finishing Could Be King rattling home into third position.

It marks a first feature race victory for Fiorano since crossing to the Ashlee Griffiths kennel in early December.



2024 JOHN GRAY FINAL

Dashing Deb for trainer Gavin Harris has taken out the 2024 John Gray Grade 5 series Final after a thrilling final at Angle Park.

A high quality field was assembled for the Final after four Heats were run the prior week with in-form chasers such as Riot Rooster, Unholy Reign and Fantastic Ada also making the final off the back of recent feature race success.

However, it was the outsider of the field in Dashing Deb who claimed the race, swooping home later to nail Unholy Reign in the final strides in winning in 30.75.

Unholy Reign for Robyn Mackellar finished second while Riot Rooster for Ben Rawlings finished in third place.

The John Gray success continued a recent run of good form for Gavin's kennel after Lena Jinx broke the track record over the 730m trip in November, Springvale Rex claimed the distance feature in the Festival of Fire and impressive youngster Springvale Rita clocked 30.28 in winning at Angle Park recently.

ST LEGER HEATS ON THURSDAY 1st FEBRUARY

A reminder to trainers that the St Leger Heats for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st July, 2021 are to be run on Thursday, 1st February with the Final on Thursday, 8th February.

Prizemoney for the St Leger series is – Heats - \$5,810 and the Final - \$14,275.

• Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Monday, 29th January

MAIDEN/GRADE 6 LOW GRADE FEATURE IN FEBRUARY

The low grade series in February at Angle Park is a Maiden/Grade 6 series over 595m with \$4,050 Heats on Thursday, 15th February with the \$5,810 Final on Thursday, 22nd February.

• Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 12th February at 9.00am.

GAWLER BREEDERS 2024 HEATS IN FEBRUARY

The first part of the Breeders 2024 series kicks off with \$1,600 Heats on Sunday, 18th February over the 400m [Short Course].

The \$3,300 Final will be run on Sunday, 25th February 2024. For SA Bred greyhounds paid up for Breeders 2024

• Nominations for the Heats close Wednesday, 14th February at 9.00am.

LAUNCHING PAD SA SERIES BEGINS ON 22nd FEBRUARY

Again, this year the Sandown GRC will offer a sweepstake ticket into the rich Launching Pad Series.

There are special conditions on the race, being for greyhounds that have won between 1 and 6 races and have not had more than 30 starts at close of their nominations.

The Heats will be run at Sandown over the 515m on Thursday, 14th March with the Semi-Finals on Thursday, 21st March and the \$150,000 to the winner Final run on Thursday, 28th March. GRSA will secure a ticket and will give one greyhound

the opportunity to compete in this lucrative series. We will run a Heat and Final series to determine who will make the Launching Pad Heats on 14th March.

Our Heats will be run on Thursday, 22nd February over the 530m at Angle Park for greyhounds that have won 1-4 races and no more than 28 starts at time of nominations. The Heats will be worth \$4,050 and will be Non Penalty events. The Final will be run at Angle Park on Thursday, 29th February over the 530m with prizemoney of \$5,810 and will also be Non Penalty.

The winner of the Final will take their spot in the Launching Pad Heats two weeks later, however, if the winner cannot take their spot (would need to be confirmed by GRSA as a satisfactory reason) then the next qualified greyhound will be given that spot.

GRSA has restricted the series to 1-4 wins and 28 starts incase a greyhound wins both the Heat and Final so this will still keep them eligible. If greyhounds win outside the series this may deem them ineligible for the Sandown series. We have also made our Final two weeks before the Launching Pad Heats at Sandown to give the trainer an opportunity to get across the border and trial for the big race.

BREEDERS 2024 PRELUDE (1) SERIES IN MARCH

The Breeders 2024 Prelude (1) series kicks off with \$3,700 Heats on Thursday, 7th March over the 530m.

The \$4,500 Final will be run on Thursday, 14th March. For SA Bred greyhounds paid up for Breeders 2024

SA OWNED GRADE 5 LOW GRADE FEATURE IN MARCH

The low grade series in March at Angle Park is a SA Owned Grade 5 series over 530m with Heats on Thursday, 14th March with the \$5,810 Final on Thursday, 21st March.

GROUP 3 MURRAY BRIDGE CUP ONE WEEK LATER IN MARCH

The Murray Bridge Cup series has been moved back one week in March 2024. The series was due to be run on Sunday, 3rd and 10th March, however, the Speedway across the road has

one of their main meetings for the year now scheduled on 10th March, the same night as the Cup Final was due to be run. It is preferred that the greyhounds do not race at the same time as the speedway, especially in competition with the Clubs only Group 3 feature event of the year.

After consultation with the Murray Bridge GRC and Gawler GRC it was agreed to make the below changes –

- Gawler will now race on Sunday night, 10th March [Public Holiday Eve]
- Murray Bridge will now race on Monday night, 11th March for the Heats [Public Holiday]
- Angle Park will now race on Friday, 8th March

Due to the movements above GRSA will also change

- Gawler to race on Friday, 15th March
- Murray Bridge to race on Sunday night, 17th March for the Group 3 Final

This will mean that the Heats of the Group 3 Murray Bridge Cup will be on Monday night, 11th March and the \$36,000 Group 3 Murray Bridge Cup Final will be run on Sunday, 17th March

MURRAY BRIDGE STRAIGHT TRACK HEATS FOR MURRAY BRIDGE CUP FINAL NIGHT

The Murray Bridge GRC and GRSA will conducted Straight Track Heats on Tuesday, 12th March with two \$3,000 Finals conducted as races 1 and 2 on Sunday, 17th March to align with the Group 3 Murray Bridge Cup around the one turn track.

The \$1,330 Heats on Tuesday will be over the 300m and 350m and be a Special Event, Non Penalty for the best greyhound nominated over each distance.

MURRAY BRIDGE AND MOUNT GAMBIER CUPS IN MARCH/ APRIL AT GROUP 3 LEVEL WITH BIG BONUSES

It will be a big couple of months of racing in March and April for the Murray Bridge and Mount Gambier Clubs when they conduct their Cup meetings.

These events are at Group 3 level and offer \$25,000 to the winner.

The \$3,000 Murray Bridge Cup Heats will be conducted on Monday, 11th March with the \$36,000 [Group 3] Final to be run on Sunday night, 17th March. Also on the Final nights program

will be -

\$4,000 Murray Bridge Cup Consolation – 455m [Trainers must renominate]

\$5,000 Special Event Feature [N/P]– 680m

\$4,000 Special Event Feature [N/P]– 530m

\$3,000 Special Event Feature [N/P]– 395m

We will also run two Straight Track Finals on the night which will be over the 300m and 350m worth \$3,000 each [Heats run on Tuesday, 12th March].

The \$3,000 Mount Gambier Cup Heats will be run on Sunday, 7th April with the \$36,000 [Group 3] Final on Sunday, 14th April.

GRSA will link bonuses to both of these events, which will include a \$5,000 bonus if the same dog can win both the Murray Bridge Cup and Mount Gambier Cup and a \$5,000 trainer bonus if the same trainer can win both Cups [SA or Interstate or different dogs].

LOCAL MATCH RACE SERIES “THE SA EASTAR” IN LATE MARCH

The SA Local Match Race series coined “The SA Eastar” will be held on Thursday night, 28th March [Easter] at Angle Park.

Eligibility for South Australian local greyhounds will be based around the Nationals conditions. They will need to be trained in SA 76 days out of the last 150 prior to the close of nominations.

Selection for this series will only be based around winning times at Angle Park. For greyhounds that have run over the 530m at Angle Park on any meeting since 1st November, 2023 their fastest winning time will be recognised and put them on the list for selection.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3, Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. There will be no manual selection from the Grader. The top 4 seeded greyhounds will be rewarded with more prizemoney.

Winners of match races – Match 1 – 1 v 4 \$4,500, Match 2 – 2 v 3 \$4,000, Match 3 – 5 v 8 \$3,500, Match 4 – 6 v 7 \$3,000 There will be \$500 Runner's Up. Overall SA Eastar winner [based on overall times] - \$6,000, second \$2,500, third \$1,500.

Those greyhounds that have won at Angle Park since 1st November, 2023 are [Top 15 – subject to eligibility] GRSA will separate equal times to a third decimal point if required closer to the event– [updated 23/1/24]

“EASTAR” MATCH RACE TRIALLING

GRSA will allow trialling opportunities in a lead up to this series to be conducted on a race night with dates to be advised. These trials will be run between races at the discretion of the stewards. Trainers must book these trials with Greyhound Racing SA by 11.00am on the day.

Greyhounds will be eligible to trial at the total discretion of the Grader where a trainer may have to provide information in support of trialling. Local eligibility conditions still apply.

Each greyhound will only be allowed to trial once in an effort to improve their position or obtain a spot on the list.

595M EASTER CUP HEATS COMING UP ON 21ST MARCH

The \$6,315 Heats of the Mixed Easter Cup will be run over 595m for a \$7,750 Final on Thursday, 28th March. Trainers need to nominate for this event with all Grades considered.

EASTER FEATURES AT GAWLER ON EASTER SUNDAY

Easter racing comes to Gawler in late March with both the Gawler Future Stars Final and Gawler Easter Sprint programmed on Sunday, 31st March.

The Gawler Future Stars Heats will be conducted for SA Bred greyhounds whelped in 2022 on Friday, 24th March over the 531m with a \$3,500 Final on Easter Sunday, 31st March. Also on Easter Sunday will be the Gawler Easter Sprint for mixed greyhounds over the 531m worth \$5,000. [Trainers must nominate for this feature with all grades considered]. It's going to be a terrific night of racing on the Sunday night over the Easter break.

LOW GRADE FEATURE SERIES AT ANGLE PARK IN APRIL

The Low Grade Feature Series at Angle Park in April will be an Open Maiden over the 530m with Heats on Thursday, 11th April and the \$5,810 Final on Thursday, 18th April.

BREEDERS 2024 PRELUDE (2) HEATS ON 4th APRIL

\$3,700 Heats of Prelude (2) for Breeders 2024 will be run on Thursday, 4th April at Angle Park.

The series is for all greyhounds eligible for Breeders 2024 with the \$4,500 Final to be run on Thursday, 11th April.

SA ANNIVERSARY CUP IN APRIL WORTH \$50,000

The \$5,810 Heats of the SA Anniversary Cup will be run over 530m on Thursday, 18th April. The \$50,000 Final will be run on Thursday, 25th April.

SA DISTANCE CHAMPIONSHIP IN APRIL

The \$7,140 Heats of the SA Distance Championship will be run over 730m on Thursday, 18th April. The \$15,250 Final will be run on Thursday, 25th April.

JUNE'S GRADING REVIEW PANEL MEETING OUTCOMES – MAIN POINTS

- GRSA will allow one extra Grade 6 over another distance for City A Thursday meetings bringing this into line with all tracks in SA. No retrospectivity regarding this change. Implemented
- GRSA has removed the condition where once a greyhound has won a Grade 5 or higher event on a City A meeting that the greyhound will lose

all Grade 6 events at all other tracks. This means a greyhound could be a Grade 4 or Grade 3 over 530m on a Thursday City A meeting and will still be able to win Grade 6 events at other tracks. No retrospectivity regarding this change. Implemented

- GRSA will now allow a greyhound after winning a Grade 5 Masters event in faster time than the time standard to get back into Masters with 2 runs in a Grade 5 at the track and distance, it doesn't matter if they are placed or unplaced just so long as there are two starts out of Masters. This has been changed from being just unplaced to get back. Implemented

STAYING EVENTS TO MOVE TO 5 RUNNERS AS A MINIMUM FROM JANUARY 2024

For a number of years GRSA has supported our staying ranks by running these events with a minimum of 4 runners. GRSA has tried to encourage this pool to grow at the expense of other events on a program, even with such small numbers. However, from meetings drawn in January 2024 any staying event programmed will need to be a minimum of 5 runners to be considered in the program. This will affect the Angle Park 730m, Murray Bridge 680m and Mt Gambier 732m.

GRSA will continue to review processes in relation to the field size and scheduling.

2024 GAWLER PRODUCE STAKES – SECOND PAYMENT DUE FRIDAY 9TH FEBRUARY

GRSA advises that the second payment for the 2024 Gawler Produce series will be due on Friday, 9th February. Please contact GRSA for further information if required.

BREEDING SUPPORT CLAIM RESTRICTION REMOVED

In July of 2022 after consultation with the ICG, GRSA introduced a restriction on the number of Breeders Support Claims that could be applied for in a 12 month period to assist with sustainable breeding. At the most recent ICG meeting, held this week, and after reviewing current and forecast breeding numbers it was agreed to remove this restriction effective immediately in support of our current breeders. There is no retrospectivity regarding claims that were not processed due to the policy at the time. Please contact Racing Manager, Shaun Mathieson for further information if required.

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month.

These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner & \$150 to the Breeder.

At the ICG meeting in January 2023 the SA Bred Bonus scheme was tabled for discussion where when we have 200 or more SA bred winners we go over budget and there is no monthly payment for the Owner of Breeder separate to the \$225. It was discussed that this was happening more regularly with more racing and more SA Bred greyhounds winning events. It was suggested increasing the base amount from \$225 and removing monthly payments, therefore, reducing monthly administration of the scheme. The Board advised changes to be implemented from 1 July 2023, however, kept the base amount at \$225 due to the increased numbers and racing opportunities. Due to this change the SA bred winners will no longer be listed in Kennel Capers each month.

For the month of July there were 203 winners, August there were 197, September there were 196, October 226, November 209 and December 218 [we are 49 winners over budget]

Greyhound of the Month for December was Where's Poppy for trainer Kirin Corby, who had three starts for the month with two wins and a second, her highlight being the \$28,700 The Ashes Final on Festival of Fire night.

The daughter of Sennachie and Fabwick started the month off with a win in open company over the 530m journey in 30.37 and then backed that up the following week with a solid second in Heat of the Ashes. She stepped out in our feature race for December as one of the favourites which resulted in a two dog war over the concluding stages with Where's Poppy holding off the flying Adhana Rico in the run to the finish line winning by .5 length in 30.53.

At the end of the month Where's Poppy's record stood at 20 starts for 13 wins and 7 placings and earnings around \$75,000.



The Run of the Month for December was the Ashlee Griffiths trained Adhana Rico, for his brilliant performance at Angle Park on Thursday 28th December over the 530m journey in the Kate's A Scandal Xmas Sprint.

He started a short priced favourite in the \$10,000 to the winner feature where he was able to grab the early lead and from there was never headed, running a slick 30.32 in winning by 3.5 lengths, in another dominant display of speed and strength.

Please also make sure that the application form is filled out correctly and includes the on-track vet (OTV) signature for race-meetings or steward signature for trials on the application form, vet signature who provided medical care relating to the injury, and responsible person's signature and details.
- Please be aware that the track injury recovery rebate is not guaranteed upon submission of the application, must meet certain requirements for approval. All eligibility and approval is reviewed in line with the policy.

Greyhounds should not be raced or trialled within the 10 days prior to assessment.

Please remember to book in your greyhound's vet work AFTER you submit the GAP placement form.

Payment of placement fees

The \$60 placement fee is due at the time the placement form is submitted, payment can be made by either completing the card details on the form or by paying in cash. The placement form will only be processed, and the greyhound placed in GAP, once payment has been received.

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

We continue to look to increase these further in order to offer a wider variety of times to meet participants varying requirements.

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

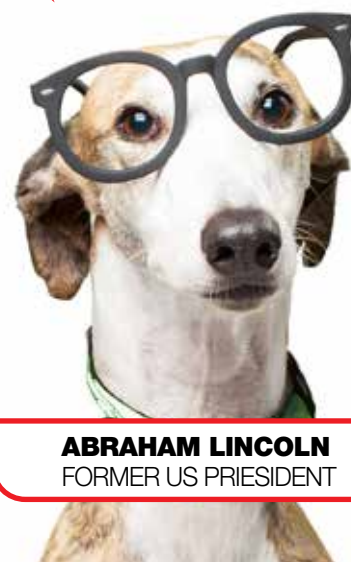

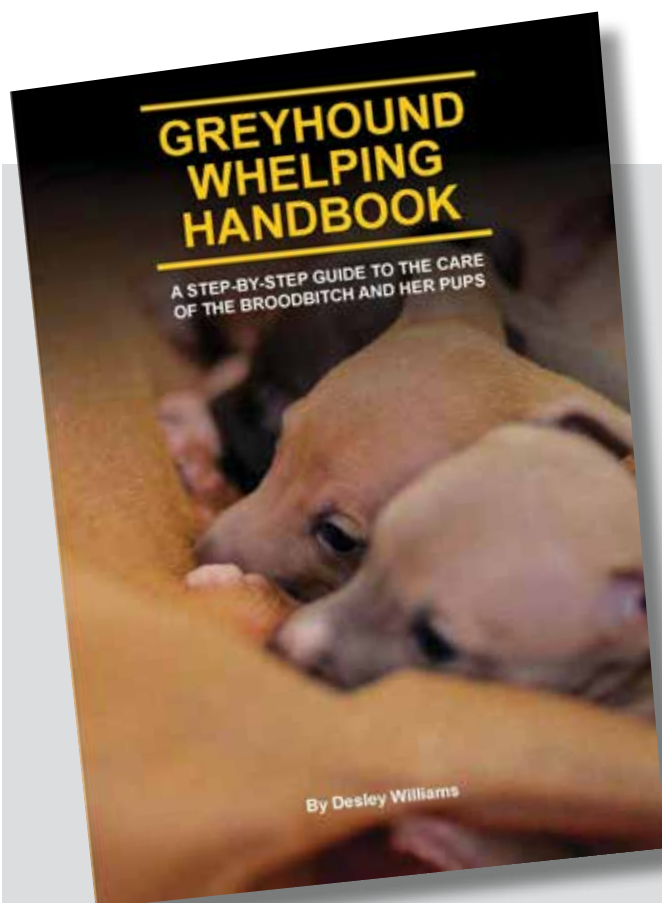
