This month, the GRSA Board was pleased to announce a \$1 million Industry Performance Reward Payment (IPRP). While the recently announced prizemoney increase, in effect from 1st January 2023, will assist in rebuilding a base level of stake money for participants, it is hoped the IPRP, in addition to the WAP, will assist our participants in managing increased cost of living pressures. As previously reported, GRSA is still expecting wagering performance to re-set throughout 2023 to pre-COVID levels and Chief Operating Officer Gavin Bosch will be visiting clubs in February to provide a further update on this.

Like most businesses, GRSA has not been immune to the challenges around recruitment with many of our departments running rather lean. Our team is committed to venue presentation and safety, however concessions have had to be made while we continue to build our teams back up – particularly our maintenance and race day operations teams. Should you know of anyone who might be interested in joining the greyhound racing industry, we urge you to encourage them to apply. In the meantime, if you see something that has not been attended to, please let us know. After all, “the standard that you walk past, is the standard you accept”.

On that note, if you see something that's not quite right in an industry sense – it could be suspect behaviour, alleged illegal practices or something that reflects poorly on our industry – I remind you to use the GRSA 'Know, Tell, Protect' service. 2023 SA SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL – REVIEW

■ ANGLE PARK

Our first feature of 2023 saw Springvale Roxy for trainer Mike Giniotis continue on her winning way taking out the Listed SA Sprint Championship final at Angle Park on Thursday, 12th January.

After taking out the final of the rich Ashes series during the Festival of Fire last month the daughter of Barcia Bale and Springvale Bryne has now established herself as one of the best sprinters in the State.

Proving to be an almost faultless beginner Springvale Roxy again began well from box 7 to race up to the lead and challenge He's Our Design for Sharyn Gray who held the rails from box 1. Also showing some speed was race favourite Came And Went for Ben Rawlings who slotted into third while Run Like Jess for Adrien Chevalier made ground from his wide draw along with Miss Scallywag for Tony Rasmussen to his inside. One of the strong chances in the race Mallee Magic for Tony Rasmussen began well from box 2 but got tied up with other runners as he tried to get to the outside and found himself back last as they left the front straight. Racing into the back straight and Springvale Roxy accelerated brilliantly to race to a clear lead opening up a nice break from He's Our Design who was being strongly challenged by Came And Went on his outside with Miss Scallywag back in third and Run Like Jess in fourth. Mallee Magic had found his way to the outside and began to make ground but was a mile off the leader. Off the back straight and Springvale Roxy was doing it nicely out in front by 4 lengths from Came And Went who ran to second followed by Miss Scallywag who was running a big race back in third. There was another gap back to fourth where Run Like Jess and Mallee Magic were battling it out. Turning for home and Springvale Roxy was in no danger as she raced down to the finish line a dominant winner by 3.75 lengths in a slick 30.39 ahead of Came And Went and Miss Scallywag who both ran well, while Run Like Jess withheld the challenge of Mallee Magic for fourth.

Springvale Roxy is locally owned and bred by Gavin Harris and trained by Mike Giniotis and now has the impressive record of 58 starts with 24 wins and 22 minor placings and prizemoney of over \$71,000.

SA BRED DOUG PAYNE FEATURE ON JANUARY 26TH

The \$14,275 Doug Payne SA Bred Feature Free For All (Non Penalty) will be run on January 26th.

- Nominations close on Monday, 23rd January 2023 at 9.00am with GRSA.

MISTER HARLEWOOD AT STUD GRADE 6 LOW GRADE FEATURE IN JANUARY

The next low grade series at Angle Park is a Grade 6 series over 530m with \$3,505 Heats on Thursday, 26th January with the \$5,535 Final on Thursday, 2nd February. Winning connections of the Final will also receive a free service to Mister Harlewood donated by Gino Grgurovic valued @ \$1,100 which is very much appreciated.

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 23rd January at 9.00am.

MURRAY BRIDGE SPRINT CLASSIC ON SUNDAY 5TH FEBRUARY WORTH \$10,000

GRSA advise that the \$10,000 Murray Bridge Sprint Classic Final over the 395m will be run on Sunday, 5th February. Heats will be run on Friday, 27th January.

- Nominations for the Heats close on Tuesday, 24th January 2023 at 9.00am with GRSA.

MOUNT GAMBIER SUMMER CLASSIC ON SUNDAY 12TH FEBRUARY WORTH \$10,000

GRSA advise that the \$10,000 Mt Gambier Summer Classic Final over the 512m will be run on Sunday, 12th February. Heats will be run on Sunday, 5th February. Special Event for all dogs and bitches whelped on or after 1/1/2021. If insufficient nominations for 2 or more Heats a one-off Final will be run on Sunday 12th February with preference to original nominations.

- Nominations for the Heats close on Tuesday, 31st January 2023 at 9.00am with GRSA.

2023 GAWLER PRODUCE STAKES – NEXT NOMINATIONS CLOSE ON FRIDAY 27TH JANUARY

After nominations were finalised for the 2023 Gawler Produce Stakes there were 124 nominations. We will have guaranteed Final stake money of \$22,000 with an estimate for the total series prizemoney around \$40,000.

The series is for greyhounds whelped in 2021. The racing dates for this series will be Heats on Friday, 9th June 2023, Semi-Finals on Sunday, 18th June and the Final on Sunday, 25th June 2023.

The second lot of payments will be due on the Friday, 27th January 2023 with the third and final payment due on the Friday, 31st March 2023.

NEXT ICG MEETING – FRIDAY 20TH JANUARY

With the Industry Consultative Group panel members finalised the next ICG meeting will be held on Friday, 20th January 2023 with an Agenda sent out to the panel later this week.

NO TRIALS ON AUSTRALIA DAY

There will be NO trials on Thursday, 26th January (Australia Day) due to staffing availability on this public holiday.

GAWLER BREEDERS 2023 HEATS IN FEBRUARY

The first part of the Breeders 2023 series kicks off with \$1,600 Heats on Sunday, 16th February over the 400m (Short Course).

The \$3,300 Final will be run on Sunday, 26th February 2023. For SA Bred greyhounds paid up for Breeders 2023

- Nominations for the Heats close Wednesday, 15th February at 9.00am.

LOCAL MATCH RACE SERIES “THE SA EASTAR” IN APRIL

The SA Local Match Race series coined “The SA Eastar” will be held on Thursday night, 6th April (Easter) at Angle Park.

Eligibility for South Australian local greyhounds will be based around the Nationals conditions. They will need to be trained in SA 76 days out of the last 150 prior to the close of nominations.

Selection for this series will only be based around winning times at Angle Park. For greyhounds that have run over the 530m at Angle Park on any meeting since 1st November, 2022 their fastest winning time will be recognised and put them on the list for selection.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3, Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. There will be no manual selection from the Grader. The top 4 seeded greyhounds will be rewarded with more prizemoney.

Winners of match races – Match 1 – 1 v 4 \$4,500, Match 2 – 2 v 3 \$4,000, Match 3 – 5 v 8 \$3,500, Match 4 – 6 v 7 \$3,000

There will be \$500 Runner's Up. Overall SA Eastar winner (based on overall times) - \$6,000, second \$2,500, third \$1,500.

Greyhound of the Month - Springvale Roxy



Greyhound of the Month for December was Springvale Roxy for trainer Mike Giniotis who had five starts for the month, with four wins and a third, with the highlight being the \$20,000 to the winner Ashes Final on Thursday, 22nd December.

The daughter of Barcia Bale and Springvale Bryne is locally owned and bred by Gavin Harris. She started the month of with two electric wins at Gawler over the 531m running 30.62 and 30.51 respectively. She then stepped out in a Heat of the Ashes where

she was brave in defeat, running third behind Mallee Magic. In the Final she began well and accelerated brilliantly into the back straight to assume the lead and from there the \$20k and Ashes crown was all hers, running a sizzling 30.57 for the 530m journey. She finished off the month with a slick 22.50 win at Gawler over the 400m in grade 5 company.

At the end of the month Springvale Bryne's record stood at 56 starts for 22 wins and 22 placings and earnings just over \$52,000.

Magic December win by Mallee Magic

The Run of the Month for December was the Tony Rasmussen trained sprinter, Mallee Magic for his last to first victory in a Heat of the Ashes at Angle Park on Thursday, 15th December.

In a hot line up of sprinters he began well from box 2, however, as he looked to get to the outside he found some traffic finding his way back to last on the inside as they entered the back straight. He started to make good ground getting to the outside off the back straight and whilst he was still second last he was launching a big run. As the leaders jammed up Mallee Magic sprouted wings into the home straight, storming home to claim a .75 length victory in an amazing performance. They ran 30.86 for the 530m journey which was only solid, however, the performance of Mallee Magic to come from last was just brilliant.



PRIZEMONEY INCREASED FROM 1ST JANUARY 2023

Greyhound racing in South Australia will benefit from a return to pre-COVID prizemoney levels following an overall stake money increase of 7.5%, equally distributed across all TAB grades and races. Effective from 1 January 2023, the increase will total \$750,000 over a twelve-month period, rebuilding a foundation of base level prizemoney across the industry.

While the increase in base stake money levels will likely result in a reduction in monthly Wagering Activity Payments (WAP), it will provide more certainty to participants surrounding industry returns.

The prizemoney increase will be felt across all grades of greyhound racing in South Australia and will extend from Angle Park to regional tracks at Mount Gambier, Gawler and Murray Bridge. Races held at Murray Bridge's straight track will enjoy an additional funding boost, taking the total prizemoney increase at the track to 20%.

SA NAMINGS \$55 FROM 1ST JANUARY 2023

As previously advertised GRSA advise that SA Naming's will be \$55 including GST effective 1st January 2023. As there is a cost for naming's from Greyhounds Australasia to GRSA it was approved that a fee should be reintroduced with all States charging for namings.

ICG ACTION ITEMS FROM LAST MEETING EFFECTIVE 1ST JANUARY 2023

From the last ICG meeting, below are action items that take effect from 1st January 2023 –

- The Group agreed for the reintroduction of the naming fee of \$55 including GST for SA namings.
- The Group agreed to remove SA Bred Scheme payment of \$27.50 from Part B of the Breeders Support Program (which generally is not required anyway).

SATURDAY TO THURSDAY NIGHT FINALS AT ANGLE PARK

Once a fortnight GRSA run Heats on the Saturday morning meeting at Angle Park, where there will be either (1-4 wins or 5+ wins) over the 530m and will be Non Penalty events, run as 8 dog fields. The Final will be conducted as Race 1 on the Thursday night.

Trainers should be mindful that if you have a greyhound in a Heat and it qualifies for the Final that the greyhound will be ineligible to compete in the Final if it is engaged to race the day prior [Wednesday].

The next lot of Heats will be run in January on Saturday, 21st for 5+ wins with the 8 dog Final on Thursday, 26th January.

This will be followed by Heats on Saturday, 4th February for 1-4 wins with the 8 dog Final on Thursday, 9th February.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED “ONLY”

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that “Only” would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put “Only or no start or leave me out” then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

WAP PAYMENT UPDATE FOR JANUARY 2023

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) advises participants that the Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of December 2022 amounted to \$30,000. Total payments for the financial year now amount to \$456,000.

GRSA notes that the Chief Operating Officer, Mr. Gavin Bosch is planning to visit each club during February to provide an update on prizemoney and wagering trends. The WAP for December is the lowest recorded this year and is a sign that a re-calibration of lower wagering revenue appears to have arrived. Separately, base stakes have increased by 7.5% from 1st January 2023 which will result in lower WAP's going forward.

Distribution between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants who receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party (eg owners) then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective, the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you **DO NOT** need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically, however;
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners of your own accord, then you **DO** need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

Example to help participants understand the WAP they receive:

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dogs[s]. The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

Assumptions:

In this example, assume the owner/trainer received \$1,000 in prizemoney for any/all races for the month.

In this the total prizemoney (paid to all participant) is \$700,000.

In this example, the total WAP is \$50,000.

In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of \$71.43, calculated as:

$$\$1,000 \div \$700,000 \times \$50,000 = \$71.43$$

Participants should note that:

- WAP is **not payable** for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000].
- Trainers’ fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

NEW RULE – RACING & TRIALLING FREQUENCY – OPERATIONAL ON WEDNESDAY 1ST FEBRUARY 2023

Please note that from Wednesday 1st February 2023, the following local rule [inserted on 3rd November 2022] will become operational. A Stewards' Notice setting the date will be published shortly. The local rule reads -

69A Racing and trialling frequency

(1) In this rule:

Race has the same meaning given to this term in R9 of the GAR. **Trial** means a satisfactory trial, or a qualifying trial as defined in R9 of the GAR.

(2) A greyhound will only be permitted to start in -

(a) No more than a combined total of 2 race and trial starts in any 7-day period; and,

(b) No more than a combined total of 7 race and trial starts in any 28-day period.

(3) This sub-rule commences on a date to be fixed by Stewards' Notice.

The intent of this rule is to monitor and regulate the frequency of races and official trials of greyhounds, to ensure adequate rest time is given between events. The rule is similar to one in effect in Western Australia. GRSA have now automated our computer systems to be able to monitor this rule. The rule is self-explanatory. A greyhound must not start more than 2 times [races or trials combined] in any 7-day period. Further, a greyhound must not start more than 7-times [races or trials combined] in any 28-day period. Any attempt to nominate a greyhound outside these parameters will be flagged by the OzChase system and you will not be able to nominate that greyhound.

Minimum Vaccination Requirements for Greyhounds

A new rule of racing pertaining to vaccination requirements for greyhounds, **R25 Minimum Vaccination Requirements**, came into effect when the new rules were released on 1st May 2022. Most jurisdictions, including GRSA, chose to delay the introduction of this rule and have targeted 1st May 2023 as the introduction date.

What this will mean is that all greyhounds must have vaccinations up to date, including annual boosters, to permit them to race from 1st May 2023.

R25 Minimum Vaccination Requirements outlines the requirements at different stages of a greyhound's life, as specified in sub-rule 25[3]:

Additionally, sub-rule 25[6] outlines that a greyhound must not compete in any event within seven days of the date it was administered a vaccine.

25 Minimum vaccination requirements

(1) An owner, trainer or person responsible for a greyhound must provide evidence of the current vaccination status of a greyhound upon request of the Controlling Body, officer of a Controlling Body, or any other employee, agent or official with authority of the Controlling Body.

(2) Unless a Controlling Body determines based on a certificate issued by a veterinarian that vaccination would prejudice the greyhound's health, an owner, trainer or person responsible for a greyhound must ensure that a greyhound meets the minimum vaccination requirements and has up to date vaccination status.

[3] The minimum vaccination requirements are:

- (a) C3 Vaccination between six and eight weeks of age and prior to registration of a litter;
- (b) C5 Vaccination between 10 and 16 weeks of age and prior to registration of a litter;
- (c) C5 Vaccination at between 12 and 16 months of age and prior to naming; and
- (d) once in every further 12-month period a C5 Vaccination unless a veterinarian certifies the greyhound is protected to a C5 level.*

[4] Where the minimum vaccination requirements are not met the Controlling Body or its Stewards may:

- (a) refuse the registration of any litter;
- (b) refuse the naming of any greyhound;
- (c) prohibit a greyhound from nominating for any Event;*
- (d) order a greyhound be scratched from any Event;
- (e) prohibit a breeding female from being serviced or being registered as a breeding female.

(5) A Controlling Body may determine minimum vaccination requirements be increased providing that it is in the best interests of animal welfare and greyhound racing, such as in response to the outbreak of a reportable disease.

[6] Unless a Controlling Body determines otherwise, a greyhound must not compete in any Event within seven days of the date it was administered a vaccine.

Evidence of the administration of a Vaccination by Veterinary Surgeon can be lodged with GRSA by email to admin@grsa.com.au. For further information, please contact the Racing Department or Stewards.

GRSA staff not to handle greyhounds

Please be advised that it is an expectation of Management that no employee shall handle a greyhound on behalf of a registered participant during a race meeting or trial session including for activities such as boxing and catching. Employees who are also registered participants are expected to refrain from handling greyhounds when engaged as an employee. Exceptions are when the handling of a greyhound is required in an emergency or to restrain it.

Lightning Safety Protocol

GRSA have released a Lightning Safety Protocol which provides instruction and guidance to Stewards, staff, and participants when lightning and thunder presents. This policy applies to all race meetings and trial sessions.

1. IMPLEMENTATION OF PROTOCOL

At a race meeting:

- it shall be the responsibility of the Steward-In-Charge to monitor the prevailing weather for signs of approaching storms and implement the GRSA Lightning Safety Protocol.
- The Steward in charge may delegate another Steward to perform or assist in this function.

At a trial session:

- it shall be the responsibility of an appointed GRSA official to monitor storm activity and implement the GRSA Lightning Protocol.

2. THE "30/30 RULE"

The "30/30 rule" relates to the time lapse between observing the flash of lightning and hearing the clap of thunder.

The rule is used as a measure of the imminence of a storm and therefore as a factor in considering whether outdoor activities should be suspended.

The rule is based on the time taken for sound to travel. Depending on the prevailing temperature and humidity sound travels at approximately 340 metres per second.

Therefore, in assessing the proximity of a storm, every three [3] seconds of delay between the observation of a lightning flash and the hearing of the associated thunder equates to a distance of approximately one [1] kilometre.

Accordingly, a thirty [30] seconds flash to thunder delay equates to the lightning activity being approximately ten [10] kilometres away.

In summary:

- **30 seconds:** Count the number of seconds between observing lightning and hearing thunder. If this time period is thirty seconds or less, the lightning is sufficiently close to represent a hazard.
- **30 minutes:** After observing the final lightning flash or hearing the final thunder, remain under cover for thirty minutes to ensure the hazard has passed.

It is important to understand that blue sky and the absence of rain are not adequate reasons to ignore the "30/30 rule". Many victims are struck before the storm actually arrives because they wait too long to seek shelter.

Note: The "30/30 rule" is not an absolute rule. A storm may move very quickly, or not generate any lightning or thunder until it is very close, or topographical or wind conditions may prevent sound from traveling to your position. These conditions are especially common in mountain areas. It is important that staff observe weather conditions and be alert to the possibility of the above occurring.

3. APPLICATION/IMPLEMENTATION

If through the application of the "30/30 rule" or from the observations of the responsible Steward or appointed GRSA official as described in the Protocol, it is considered that lightning activity is occurring within ten [10] kilometres of a race track the following measures shall be taken:

a) Suspension of Activity

If the flash to thunder delay is thirty [30] seconds or less,

- (i) all activity shall be suspended, and
- (ii) an announcement made requesting all persons and greyhounds in attendance to seek shelter indoors.

b) Resumption of Activity

As trailing storm clouds may still carry a lingering charge, activity at the race track shall not resume until a period of thirty [30] minutes has elapsed after the last flash of lightning was observed.

Murray Bridge Sand Issues

GRSA Management are aware of ongoing issues with the sand at Murray Bridge.

Namely the sand is very sticky when too wet and very hard when too dry. It has been determined that the root cause of both issues is the high clay content of the sand. That clay content has been increasing over time as the river water used to wet the track contains fine clay particles.

Replacing all of the sand comes at a considerable cost and as such it has been prudent to formulate a plan for the large project. The plan (which has been considered by the Murray Bridge Greyhound Racing Club Committee and will soon be discussed at the Industry Consultative Group) includes the following elements:

- Scientific testing of existing sand at all tracks [which will determine clay content and particle/grain size – both are characteristics which impact the "stickiness" when wet];
- Agreeing the "best" sand composition for replacement. [Note: Burrumbeet sand from Victoria is being strongly considered – and will also be scientifically tested];
- Testing new sand on a small section of the straight track and if successful implementing on both tracks; and
- In stage 2 – considering water filtration options to remove the fine clay particles from the track water.

Testing is set to commence shortly and will take approximately 6 weeks to be completed. An update on the progress will be provided in the next edition.

Bobby Axelrod Stock's Continue To Rise

Bobby Axelrod continued his rise to stardom with another feature race win on Friday, 6th January taking out the Gawler Classic race over the 531m trip.

It wasn't a perfect performance from the White and Brindle chaser, but his class helped him get out of trouble and despite leaving the boxes quite poorly, he was still able to reel off a flying 30.55. The win was his 16th career win, which is incredibly impressive considering he has only 28 starts so far. It was off the back of a red hot 30.49 heat win the week prior, that saw Bobby Axelrod start an odds on favourite in the race, with the market confidence being shared by his trainer, Dillon Robinson, who gave the chaser a great hope going into the race.

"Going by the times, it seemed certain that he was going to win it, but then again from being from the wider box, he did well to stay out of the carnage and just ran around them. Once he crossed them and got on the arm it was all good!" exclaimed Robinson

Whilst Bobby Axelrod showed some early promise when he started his career, it wasn't until Adelaide Cup night in 2022, where showed how good he is. On a night where some star studded chasers like Wow She's Fast, Mallee Magic, Propelled and Hill Top Jack went around, Bobby Axelrod went quicker than all of them, when he won a grade 6 in a flying 30.39, which was the best of the night. It was on this night that Dillon knew how good Bobby was and since then, he has continued to develop his racing craft.

"He showed potential early on in the breaking process."

"I thought by the time he ran at Angle Park [Adelaide Cup night], that he was going to get there, it was just a matter of how long he was going to stay up winning and placing."

Life at home is quite easy for Bobby Axelrod, with the laid back dog enjoying his time in the small kennel and the surrounding suburbs.

"He has his unique personality, he's a pretty quiet, good kennel dog. We live in the suburbs."

"He mostly goes for a free gallop at Virginia, up and back just once a week then he races in between."

The success shown from the November 20' whelping has attracted interest from potential buyers but Dillon and connections have decided to not sell.

"I had one person offer some money for him, but we thought we would keep him for ourselves and enjoy the fun."

The next step for Bobby Axelrod is a trip to Victoria this week, where he will stay to continue his racing career.

"We're going to send him down to Victoria with Jess Hopkins, because she is training the two siblings, Lektra Teddy and Rosie's No Angel."

"Not at this stage [picked out a race], we will just send him over there and see how he goes, we will take it one step at a time."

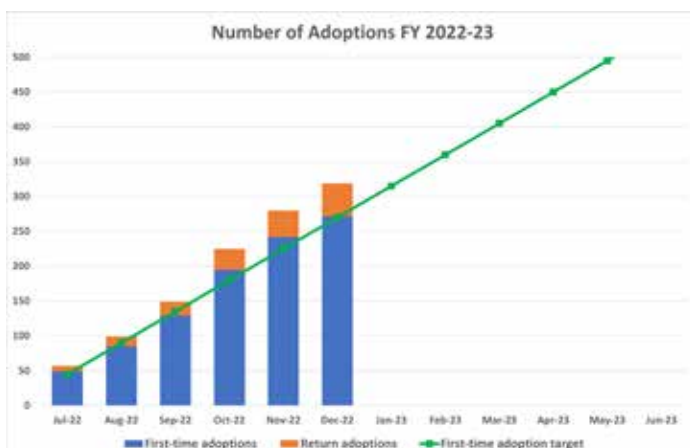
Latest updates from GAP

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:30pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kennelling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

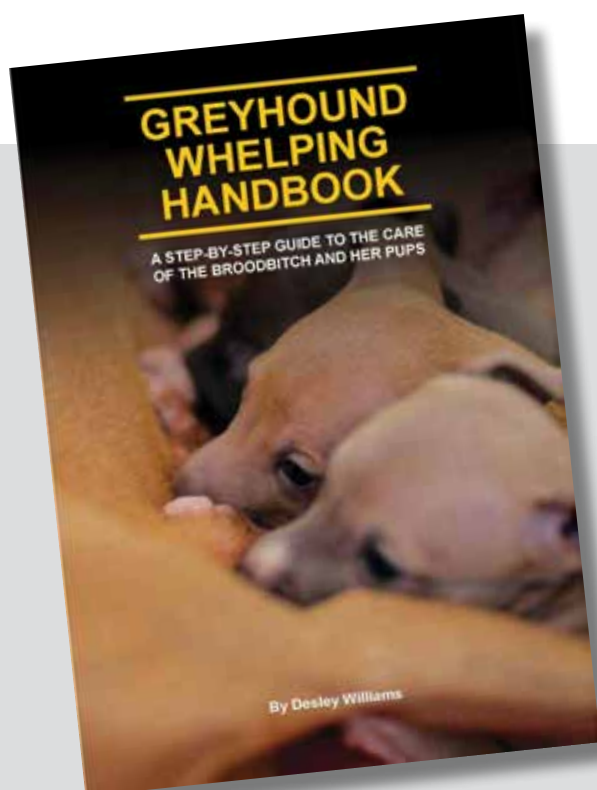
