CEO'S UPDATE

Building The Foundation

In recent days we've commenced a conversation with Member Clubs and the ICG which contemplates the manner in which GRSA can maximise the return to trainers, breeders and owners in a way which also allows our balance sheet to ride out any 'bumps'. Noting that 2020 has set a very low benchmark for any future year, we obviously hope and expect that the bumps in the road ahead might be fewer and further between than has recently been the case.

There are a number of opportunities that GRSA is currently exploring which amount to our opportunity to build changes into our model which will set us up for future growth. One of our primary objectives relates to the weekly schedule and maximising the opportunity that exists for our participant to race across the Gawler-Angle Park-Murray Bridge triangle. G-SIX has already played an important role in helping GRSA to maintain its footprint on Sky Racing and we are continuing to explore new opportunities.

Other matters that are currently 'front of mind' include the potential renewal of racing infrastructure at Angle Park and the potential transition of the on-course experience to transition to a more digital environment supported by the offers and benefits that will form part of Tabcorp's offer to future 'in venue' patrons.

Whether the changes ahead of us are about renewal or growth or cost reduction, all of them are targeted at setting a firm foundation for GRSA as we move towards more prosperous times. One of the keys to that future prosperity rests with the consolidation of national pools. Tabcorp is working towards that goal with the highest priority. It is expected that by this time next year, the various state totes will have consolidated into one national pool. Minor codes in smaller states on the UBET system stand to gain the most from that significant change. GRSA ticks all of those boxes.

The changes of recent years have helped South Australia to continually bat above its weight. As we emerge from one of the most challenging periods that racing [and the broader community has known] it's important for us to embrace the fact that it is only through change that our sport can continue to evolve.

Grading Review Panel main outcomes from meeting

MASTERS EVENTS (GRADE 5 AND MIXED) - For City A, City B and Prov 1 Masters events the greyhounds 4yo and older will be selected on form with the greyhounds between 4 and 3 ¾ still on age. For Masters events conducted at Prov 2 meetings ALL greyhounds will be selected on age.

For the main Masters races which we normally run at the Angle Park Monday and Gawler Friday meetings, these will be on form for 4yo and older and for Gawler Tuesday and Angle Park Wednesday meetings it will be on age. All other conditions still remain like time standards etc.

Effective from nominations closing on Monday, 20th July 2020.

MAIDENS - if there are not 6 or more Maidens nominated, then the race should not be conducted unless specifically needed to make up a program.

Effective from nominations closing on Monday, 20th July 2020.

HEATS TO FINALS - Where there are insufficient nominations to run Heats of an advertised event (less than 10 nominations normal events, middle distance and staying events), the event will be conducted as a one-off Final on the date when the Heats were scheduled. If the event is considered a feature event like the Stayers Cup for example or a memorial race, the one-off Final will be conducted on the date of the original Final and a normal graded event conducted at the Heat meeting.

Effective from nominations closing on Monday, 20th July 2020.

INTERSTATE GREYHOUNDS – Still being considered:

TIME GRADING –

All Time Grading for all clubs in SA to be uniform with groupings [Maiden/1-4 wins/5+ wins].

For Time Grading events when there are two or more races, then the lowest rating time dogs (the fastest dogs for this grouping) are declared the reserves.

If a greyhound is a reserve for a Time Grading event and does not gain a start then they will automatically get a start in the next Time Graded meeting (no matter the track) so long as they are nominated.

Effective from nominations closing on Monday, 20th July 2020.

TIME GRADING AMENDMENTS

Participants should note some minor amendments to the Time Grading table used to calculate a greyhound's Time Rating (to be implemented from 22nd July, 2020).

Part of the Grading Review process is to review and update the Time Grading table to ensure times are aligned to average winning times over the past 24 months of racing.

As a reference point for participants, greyhounds the same or faster than the following times will be given the highest possible rating for their performance:

2020 SA Straight Track Championship at Murray Bridge in late July

The 3 x State Straight Track Championships (Healesville, Capalaba & Murray Bridge) has been cancelled this year due to COVID-19. The Final was to be held at Capalaba in QLD and will now be held in 2021. The 3 States will still run their local series to establish the State's Straight Track Champion.

The \$965 Murray Bridge Heats over the 350m will be run on Wednesday, 29th July and the \$5,000 Final on Wednesday, 5th August.

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Tuesday, 12th May 2020. If unsure of a greyhounds status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

Nominations for the Heats close on Friday, 24th July with GRSA at 9.00am.

Industry Consultative Group meeting on Friday 7th August

The next ICG meeting will be held on Friday, 7th August. An Agenda is currently being produced and will be available for the panel members prior to the meeting.

Sir Truculent claims the monthly award double



Greyhound of the Month for June was local staying star Sir Truculent for trainer Wally Harkins who was undefeated for the month, winning all of his four starts and dominating the Thursday night schedule.

The son of Worm Burner and Establish, which was also bred by Wally, started the month off in fine style winning the prestigious Shane McQueen Middle Distance Feature over the 600m where he came from the tail of the field to score. He then stepped back up to his pet distance of the 731m, continuing on his winning way, winning his next three starts. He ran 42.95 in winning by 3.75 lengths, then 42.88 in winning by 13.25 lengths and then 43.00 in winning by 3 lengths, easily accounting for his opposition.

At the end of the month Sir Truculent's record stood at 51 starts for 22 wins and 19 placings and earnings around \$87,000. With Sir Truculent heading over the border we wish him the best of

luck and let's hope he can bring back to SA some of their money.

The Run of the Month for June was again the Wally Harkins trained Sir Truculent for his brilliant win at Angle Park in the Shane McQueen Final on Thursday, 4th June.

Sir Truculent, back in trip and in a super strong Final looked like his winning chances were gone at the winning post on the first occasion when he was back 7th and struggling to make ground. Down the back straight he was getting warm and had many lengths to make up, however, turning for home his big motor kicked in and he raced to the lead for a stirring win. He went on to win by 1.75 lengths but his time of 34.93 was amazing, to do what he did and still break 35.00 seconds for the 600m showed what a brilliant performance it was.

2020 SA Distance and Sprint Championship finals in August

The National Championships have been cancelled this year due to COVID-19. They were to be held at Wentworth Park in NSW and will now be held in 2021. SA and other States will still run their local series to establish the State's best sprinter and stayer.

The \$5,120 SA Heats of the Sprint will be run on Thursday, 6th August and the \$8,580 Final on Thursday, 13th August.

The Distance will be conducted as a one off Best 8 on Thursday, 13th August worth \$9,330. GRSA will provide a lead up race depending on numbers for the stayers as required.

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not

less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Wednesday, 20th May 2020. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

Sky Racing will also support this series with ALL States conducting their Finals on the same night to be run within a 2 hour period. It makes for a great promotional concept.

Nominations for the Heats of the Sprint close on Monday, 3rd August with GRSA at 9.00am.

[Whilst the nominations for the Distance will close on 10th August the domiciliary conditions will be the same as the Sprint]

Kings and Queens Feature heats in August

Again this year GRSA will conduct the Kings and Queens Feature series with Heats on Thursday, 27th August and a \$6,430 Final on Thursday, 3rd September in continued support of any greyhound affected by the change to the GCA Age Restricted Classics change a few years ago.

The eligibility for this series is for dogs and bitches whelped between 1st March 2018 and 31st May 2018.

Performed Maidens are eligible [raced or quality trialed].

It will be dependent upon nominations, however, we would like to run a dogs Heat and a bitches Heat separately with greyhounds qualifying into the Final. If there are not sufficient nominations for either sex then these Heats may be mixed into a couple of mixed Heats. Special conditions apply, however, these races will be non-penalty.

- Nominations close Monday, 24th August at 9.00am with GRSA.

Gawler Classic 2020 (Short Course) in late August

The Heats of the 2020 Gawler Classic (Short Course – 400m) will be run on Friday, 28th August.

These Heats are for SA Bred greyhounds which have been paid up for Classic 2020. The \$3,000 Final will be run on Friday, 4th September.

- Nominations for the Heats close at 9am on Tuesday, 25th August.

Oaks and Derby eligibility in 2020

The Group 3 SA Oaks and SA Derby to be run in September this year will be for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st June, 2018 [27 months] which has stayed the same as the last few years.

The Heats of the Oaks will be run on the same night as the Derby again this year with Heats on Thursday, 10th September and the Group 3 Finals on Thursday, 17th September.

\$25,750 Final – Thursday, 17th September

Boxing procedures to revert back to normal in August

Following COVID-19, all greyhound States nationally amended their boxing procedure to 4 waves of 2 dogs.

GRSA recently reviewed the boxing procedure and currently have 3 waves of boxing:

1 – 4 – 7

2 – 5 – 8

3 – 6

For our G-SIX it is in 2 waves of boxing.

We are continuing to work with Government and if all goes to plan GRSA will return to our regular boxing procedure from 1st August.

Remote trainers fee to assist Mount Gambier meeting

With continuing border restrictions affecting participation in the South East due to COVID-19, GRSA have decided to support the Mount Gambier meeting knowing the importance to be racing on a weekly basis during this time.

For those Trainers that live more than 150 kilometres from Mount Gambier and travel to this meeting they will receive an additional \$75 payment to their normal Trainers Fee. The fee will be capped at one payment per registered premises and will continue until the borders are open.

Winning grade 6 races in order

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

Re-grading for all tracks and distances

Re grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re grade per meeting.

Scratching deadlines and trials booking closing to remain at 3pm

Whilst the Greyhound Racing SA Offices have gone back to closing at 4.30pm the scratching deadlines and trial bookings closing will remain at 3pm to assist the management of these processes.

GRADING REVIEW PANEL MINUTES

The Grading Review Panel met on Monday 22nd June (via Zoom and Social Distancing) to discuss grading in South Australia from an Agenda provided.

Following is a summary and recommendations of items discussed:

The panel approved the minutes from the previous GRP meeting held on 28/11/19. The panel reviewed recommendations and implementations from the previous GRP meeting with their recommendations below.

Business Arising

The Racing Manager provided a general verbal update to the panel on those items introduced from the last meeting. The panel were comfortable that no further updates were required as some items exist in the Agenda.

Agenda Items

Masters/Veterans Races – The main reason for today's meeting was regarding Masters races and the way they are selected. The current selection criteria is that all Masters events are selected by age regardless of their form (oldies in first). This had not been advertised over the years to industry and it was suggested some greyhounds had poor form getting an automatic start when some dogs that were 4yo and older were being left out and whether this was reasonable. This has only really come to light due to the changes the GRP made in regard to Masters events with more races being conducted than ever before as our pool of older greyhounds increases. Last month the panel discussed the way these races were graded and after receiving feedback via email and phone from the panel regarding this topic was split regarding age or form.

After a robust discussion the panel agreed that for City A, City B and Prov 1 Masters events the greyhounds 4yo and older will be selected on form with the greyhounds between 4 and 3 ¾ still on age. For Masters events conducted at Prov 2 meetings ALL greyhounds will be selected on age.

The panel felt this provided the opportunity for the out of form Masters dogs at the lesser categories and the older dogs with form getting a start at our better class meetings.

The panel also discussed greyhounds continuing to race in the class which are significantly out of form for a sustained period and that the stewards should consider the performance of these greyhounds more closely.

Actions: The RM to advertise that for City A, City B and Prov 1 Masters events the greyhounds 4yo and older will be selected on form with the greyhounds between 4 and 3 ¾ still on age. For Masters events conducted at Prov 2 meetings ALL greyhounds will be selected on age. Effective from nominations closing on Monday 20th July 2020

Non-Advertised Maiden Events (Thursday Apk) –

Recently there have been a couple of occasions that Maiden races on a Thursday night have been reduced to 3 runners due to ineligibly, injury etc so it was suggested to the panel to have a policy where there are insufficient nominations (less than 6) to run a full field Maiden event on a Thursday night, the Grader can (where appropriate) construct a Mixed Maiden/Grade 6 event, using inexperienced (1 win or 2

with a Maiden Heat & Final) and/or poorer quality Grade 6 greyhounds to make a field. GRSA currently includes other dogs in Maiden events for middle distance races and also at Mt Gambier for advertised events to assist with greyhounds gaining a start. After much discussion the panel felt having this policy for Maiden events in the Metro area was not warranted and believed that Maidens should race in their own event unless specified in the All Tracks calendar. The panel advised that they recommend if there were not 6 or more Maidens then the race should not be conducted unless specifically needed to make up a program.

Actions: The RM to advertise if there are not 6 or more Maidens nominated then the race should not be conducted unless specifically needed to make up a program. Effective from nominations closing on Monday 20th July 2020

Running of Heats and Finals – Current circumstances see GRSA running a one-off heat into a final (due to lack of noms), and often the final can be impacted by withdrawals and end up being a 3-4 dog race, which was not acceptable to the panel. With GRSA running G-SIX races now, it was suggested that we no longer run one-off heats into a final. It was suggested to the panel that as policy where there are insufficient nominations to run heats of an advertised event (less than 10 nominations normal events, middle distance and staying events), the event will be conducted as a one-off final on the date when the heats were scheduled. If the event is considered a feature event like the Stayers Cup for example or a Memorial race, the one-off final will be conducted on the date of the original final, with nominations remaining open and closing as per the normal nomination closing time of the revised meeting. The greyhounds will race in a normal event. In this scenario, no preference will be given to greyhounds that nominated for the original heats. The panel agreed for this to occur as a matter of policy.

Actions: The RM to advertise that as policy where there are insufficient nominations to run heats of an advertised event (less than 10 nominations normal events, middle distance and staying events), the event will be conducted as a one-off final on the date when the heats were scheduled. If the event is considered a feature event like the Stayers Cup for example or a Memorial race, the one-off final will be conducted on the date of the original final. Effective from nominations closing on Monday 20th July 2020

Upgrading of Interstate Greyhounds – The panel were provided with an option to completely simplify the rules around grading greyhounds that are either racing in SA for the first time, or are returning to racing in SA after an extended period interstate (more than 3 months since its last run). The panel were advised if we move away from the Metro grade at the Interstate track and proposed the change below which provides for simple rules and still gives incentive for SA participants to get greyhounds from interstate.

Summary of proposed change's provided to the GRP for the last 12 months:

Interstate greyhounds racing in SA for the first time will be Grade 5 at all tracks and distances, unless they meet the following criteria, which would then see them being upgraded to Grade 4 at all tracks and distances:

- 5+ metropolitan full stakes wins
- \$50,000 in prizemoney

Interstate greyhounds racing in SA for the first time and meet the following criteria, will be upgraded to Grade 3 at all tracks and distances:

- Group 1 & 2 winners over a similar distance in the past 6 months

The grader has ultimate discretion in applying the above upgrade rule, and may choose to keep a greyhound at Grade 5 level if one or more of the following apply:

- The form of the greyhound is poor enough to warrant it remaining at Grade 5
- The greyhound is a masters greyhound (4yo+)
- The distance the greyhound is nominating for is outside the greyhound's normal distance range

Greyhounds that have left SA to race interstate to race for 3 months or more, will be subject to the above upgrade rules upon their return. However any grade that was established at a particular track and distance prior to their departure from SA will be retained in the last 6 months.

Notwithstanding the above rules, the Grader may choose to upgrade a greyhound based on their discretion in relation to the meeting and nominations received.

The panel discussed this topic at length, they considered other options like aged prizemoney etc however they believed the above represented a fair option for dogs to come to SA.

They believed it may also reduce the need for some greyhounds to be purchased to get grading exemptions when this may actually not be required. However were happy to continue with the SA ownership proof of purchase if necessary.

Actions: Whilst there was an agreed position by the panel regarding a change in policy, management believed that further information was required before a change in policy was affected. The RM to provide panel members further relevant information ASAP.

Semi Final Numbers – The panel were advised of the current policy of heats to semi finals

The guidelines are –

3-5 Heats – 2 Semis
6-7 Heats – 3 Semis
8 Heats – 4 Semis

Whilst the panel would prefer an even number of Semi Finals they agreed that above was the best and fairest outcome for dogs to progress from heats to semi finals.

Frequency of Time Graded Meetings - Currently GRSA runs 1 meeting at Angle Park and 1 meeting at Gawler for Time Grading events (this can slightly be increased depending on 5 Tuesdays or Wednesdays in the month. The panel were asked should this be increased to Murray Bridge. The panel were supportive of more Time Graded meetings so long as it could fit in across the weekly schedule. The panel suggested that Time Grading for Gawler Tuesday should only occur when there is an Angle Park Wednesday so greyhounds can go to the next meeting.

Separately the panel was asked that Mt Gambier requested

a variance when they resume Time Grading meetings. They would like to revert back to a grouping policy but have Maidens / 1-3 wins / 4 - 6 wins / 7+ wins. The panel were supportive of them moving back to a grouping system but felt 4 groups could not be sustained. They recommended that all Time Graded meetings across the state be uniform for groupings. They suggested the Racing Manager manage this depending on the pool of nominations for this region.

The panel discussed the Reserves aspect of Time Grading with them being currently being selected at random when there are two or more races for that grouping. They believed this could be unfair to the slower dogs in the race and also dogs that were reserve for one meeting could be randomly drawn as reserve for the next meeting. The panel agreed that for Time Grading events when there are two or more races then the lowest rating time dogs (the fastest dogs for this grouping) are declared the reserves. Also if a greyhound is reserve for a Time Grading event and does not gain a start then they will automatically get a start in the next Time Graded meeting (no matter the track) so long as they are nominated.

Actions: The RM to manage the racing schedule for Time Grading and that all Time Grading for all clubs be uniform with groupings.

The panel agreed that for Time Grading events when there are two or more races then the lowest rating time dogs (the fastest dogs for this grouping) are declared the reserves. Also if a greyhound is reserve for a Time Grading event and does not gain a start then they will automatically get a start in the next Time Graded meeting (no matter the track) so long as they are nominated. Effective from nominations closing on Monday 20th July 2020

Frequency of Straight Track Racing – The panel were advised that the Murray Bridge Straight Track currently runs once a fortnight (except for Cup series) on a Wednesday. If this can be accommodated could we increase the number of meetings on the Straight track. The panel were supportive of this but believed this would only be likely if a proposed Saturday morning meeting time slot opened up. The panel were split as to whether a Friday/weekend timeslot or a mid-week time slot for the Straight Track would be best but were open to any new opportunities.

Grading Review Panel Members – The Racing Manager spoke to the current members of the GRP advising we still require a Semi Professional and Breeder to fill some gaps. Due to the short notice of today's meeting he advised he will look to the current structure in place and see how best to fill these gaps.

Online Nominations - The Grader advised the panel of the reluctance with trainers to transition to Online Nominations. With his role now flexible allowing for work offside he is still getting faxes and even scanned emails to our Admin address which represents risk of them being missed. The panel believed that by end the end of the year ALL trainers should be nominating online and the panel advised that along with GRSA they would be open to assist those trainers needing it.

Current Grading of Race Meetings (G-Six – 8 Dog Fields)

– The panel were advised of the current criteria that the Grading Department use in formatting race meetings.

- Mt Gambier – based on Mt Gambier only racing once a week on Thursdays and the restrictions around non Victorian nominations allowed at present the Grading Department will grade as many races as possible with G-SIX or 8 dog fields allowed attempting to give every greyhound a start.

However when restrictions are lifted and Sunday racing dates are included allowing for Victorian participation and two meetings per week the Grading Department will grade as many races as possible –

- o Races 5-8 will be 8-dog where possible
- o G-SIX all other races
- o Reserves required where possible
- o Feature races excluded from G-SIX. Could include normal heats if one is in the Quad.
- o 732m will require a minimum of 4 runners, Middle distance and high grade events as determined by the Grader based on nominations
- **Murray Bridge One Turn and Straight Track** – the Grading Department will grade as many races as possible
 - o Reserves required where possible
 - o 530m and high grade events as determined by the Grader based on nominations
- Angle Park Thursday night - the Grading Department will grade as many races as possible. Maidens will be considered if sufficient nominations allow.
 - o Reserves required where possible
 - o 731m will require a minimum of 4 runners, Middle distance, high grade and Maiden events as determined by the Grader based on nominations
- Angle Park City B & Prov2 and Gawler Prov1 & Prov2 meetings - the Grading Department will grade as many races as possible.
 - o Races 5-8 will be 8-dog where possible
 - o G-SIX all other races
 - o Reserves required where possible
 - o Feature races excluded from G-SIX. Could include normal heats if one is in the Quad.
 - o 731m will require a minimum of 4 runners, Middle distance and high grade events as determined by the Grader based on nominations

(In regard to G-SIX the grader will always look at Maidens and Grade 6 events in the first instance along with short course events)

(8 dog fields will generally be higher graded events, over 500+ or further where possible)

(Structure of races & meetings will be determined based on nominations and preferences)

The panel were advised that these basic criteria will always be subject to change based on any number of situations however it is our organisational objective to run as many races as possible, a minimum of 6 dog fields and reserves in all races.

This was noted by the panel.

Grade 6 in Higher Grade Middle Distance & Stayers

Events – The panel were advised that on occasions a Grade 6 dog will race in a 4/5, Open or FFA Middle Distance or Staying Event. If it wins this race they will lose their Grade 6 at the venue for the other distances. Management suggested GRSA change these events to Special Events (with a penalty) at Box Draw to ensure this doesn't occur until a mixed 4/5/6 can be added into Ozchase.

The panel were supportive of this change.

The panel also spoke of the need for a low grade 600m or 731m distance on a Monday night allowing for progressing to Thursday night at Angle Park. Maybe some programming restrictions to give a chance to those stepping up in class. The RM to manage this in programming.

Submissions –

Wendy Sebastyan Submission

1. More restricted win races in place of grade 6. The RM to manage this in programming
2. Review the grade 5 dogs. As it stands, dogs that have never won a race at a track or have been downgraded, are being mixed because of the number of wins. SA bred dogs that have won all of their grade 6 races become disadvantaged also. The panel understood that mixed occurs based on race wins and believed this was the fairest outcome for everyone. They supported the Grader attempting to run races of just one grade wherever possible.
3. I would like to suggest provincial placing in last 3 starts to be included and placed higher than last start reserve. The panel considered this but were of the opinion that a Reserve that did not gain a start the week before should be remain in its current position on the Order. With the introduction of the WPS and the publishing of these fields most people are satisfied with the fairness on how dogs are selected.

Kim Johnstone Submission

A general point regarding Grade 6 conditions and how many races greyhounds can win. Trying to protect young dog with low wins. The panel felt this was similar to Wendy's submission and felt the RM could program more restricted win Grade 6 events.

Separately the panel felt the Grade 6 policy and how many races a dog can win should be reviewed again at a later date with the pool of Grade 6 significantly higher than any other grade.

Dress code

Stewards have to some degree relaxed the dress code during Covid 19 restrictions however wish to advise participants to review their choice of attire in an effort to conform to the code.

Mrs. Treloar pleaded guilty and was suspended for a period of ten [10] weeks; with six [6] weeks suspended for twelve [12] months on the basis she does not re-offend under this rule, to commence midnight 22/06/20. Mrs. Treloar was also fined the sum of \$200. DULKANINNA was disqualified from the event.

Mr. Nathan Wilson – Integrity Hearings Panel 22/06/20

GAR83[2] – Failed to present LOSE YOUR BLUES free of any prohibited substance [PROCAINE, PENTOBARBITONE & 4-HYDROXY XYLAZINE] for an event at Angle Park on 26th August, 2019.

GAR83[2] – Failed to present OAKVALE BEATY free of any prohibited substance [PROCAINE] for an event at Angle Park on 19th September, 2020.

GAR84 – Possession of a prohibited substance [TESTOPROP] during a kennel inspection on 30th September, 2020.

Mr. Wilson pleaded guilty to all charges and was suspended for a period of four [4] weeks wholly suspended for twelve [12] months on the basis he does not re-offend under these rules. LOSE YOUR BLUES and OAKVALE BEATY were disqualified from their respective events.

GAR83[2] – Failed to present IKE THE VIKING free of any prohibited substance [PROCAINE] for an event at Gawler on 3RD November, 2019.

Mr. Mann pleaded guilty to both charges and was suspended for a period of ten [10] weeks; with six [6] weeks suspended for twelve [12] months on the basis he does not re-offend under this rule, to commence midnight 1st July, 2020. Mr. Mann was also fined the sum of \$500. IKE THE VIKING and MISAFFECTION were disqualified from their respective events.

Mr. Brian Clarke – Integrity Hearings Panel 22/06/20

GAR8[o] – In that in the opinion of Stewards, improperly, fraudulently, negligently or dishonestly falsified the transfer of DESTINI PESO from a Victorian owner to himself in order to disguise the transaction as having occurred during a period of his disqualification. Mr. Clarke pleaded guilty and was disqualified for a period of four [4] months, to commence midnight 22nd June, 2020.

Mr. Ken Gill – Integrity Hearings Panel 22/06/20

GAR86[f] – Engaged in unseemly, improper, insulting or offensive language, conduct or behaviour towards the Chief Steward at Angle Park on 26th September, 2020.

GAR86[o] – In the opinion of Stewards behaved in an improper manner in the kennel house at Angle Park on 26th September, 2020 with witnesses reporting offensive language and a manner of behaviour inconsistent with that expected of GRSA participants. Mr. Gill pleaded guilty

to both charges and was fined \$250 wholly suspended for twelve [12] months on the basis he does not re-offend under this rule.

Mr. Damien Bates – Notice of positive sample –

greyhound ASK ME NOW was found to have prohibited substances KETOPROFEN and MELOXICAM in a urine sample following an event at Angle Park on 30th April, 2020. Inquiry to be scheduled at a date to be fixed.

Murray Bridge Slipping Track opening soon

The Murray Bridge slipping track is set to open to participants from late next week (hopefully Friday 24/7).

A few minor items need to be completed before giving the green light for greyhounds to be slipped up the track, namely:

- signage
- CCTV cameras
- water taps
- gate padding

The maintenance team is also keen to apply more irrigation to the surface in a bid to settle and compact the sand, which has only recently been laid.

This project has been very well-managed onsite by MBGRC maintenance manager Darren Pearce, but more importantly has run on time and on budget.

To access the slipping track, participants will need to acquire a key fob from GRSA reception, which will open the main gate of the facility. Key fobs (and use of the track) will be free of charge (replacement fobs will cost \$20).

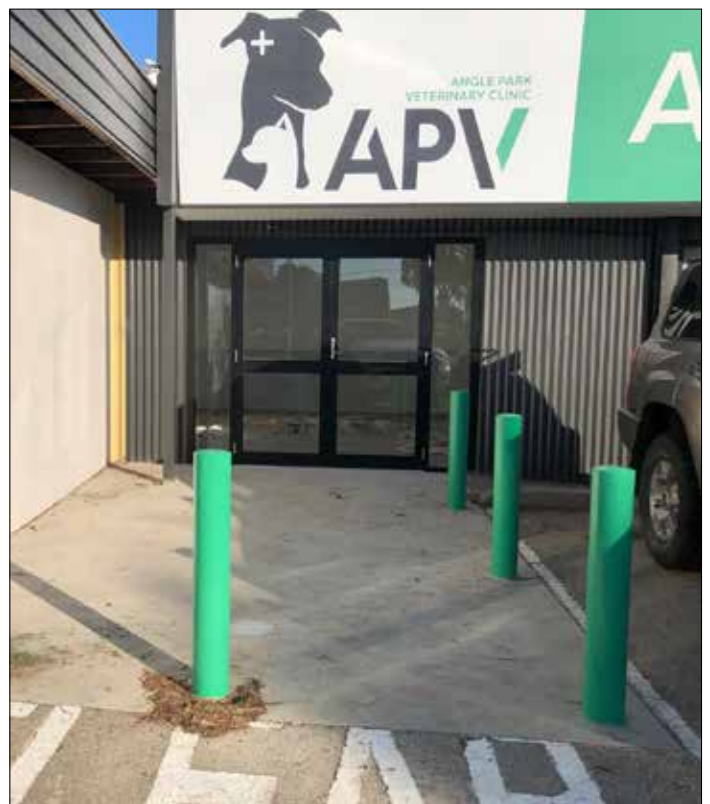


Angle Park Vet Clinic

Progress on the Angle Park Vet Clinic relocation has been excellent, despite the fact the numerous trades onsite needed to be managed through with this difficult COVID-19 period.

What was once an old, rundown storage area is now a modern and bright vet clinic, a dramatic transformation that is sure to impress regular customers of the clinic.

Works are expected to be completed in the next fortnight, after which Greg and Daniela will make the transition from the existing clinic to the new premises.



Murray Bridge Straight Track Catching Pen

As previously advised the team down at MBGRC have recently undertaken some works to the Murray Bridge straight track catching pen.

Unfortunately there has been a couple of serious injuries occur at recent meetings on the Murray Bridge straight track, that have been sustained once greyhounds had gone past the finishing line.

As is the case with all significant injuries, an internal review has taken place into each individual injury to establish the potential cause and if any action is necessary.

Whilst the result of this review could not identify the specific cause of these injuries, it has identified some potential improvements in infrastructure, preparation and process that can be implemented ASAP.

These changes include:

- The addition of significant amount of 'heavy' sand to the catching pen, resulting in the last 30m to incline at a gradient of 1%
- More regular harrowing of the track past the finish line, including the catching pen
- Defining the optimum level of elasticity in the bungy cord attached to the decoy lure, to ensure the decoy material lands further into the catching pen

The Club conducted its first straight track meeting since the works recently, with the changes receiving positive feedback from participants.



GRSA would like to reinforce the view/recommendation that greyhounds should at the very least trial on the straight track prior to racing there for the first time.

The reasons for this relate to the obvious differences compared to the other tracks in SA, namely the straight uphill run, shortened lure run up, remote/battery lure, straight lure arm and the method of lure exit from the track.

Your dog will be well looked after with plenty of pats and treats throughout the day. They will assist with either green collar assessments for dogs that have been living with foster carers or for greyhounds entering the program.

During assessments, greyhounds will be muzzled, on a leash and handled by an experienced assessor and handlers. All dogs will be walked around together in a secure testing area for approximately 5-10 mins to assess the greyhound's reaction to the small dog. If the greyhound is reacting well we will allow them to approach and sniff the small dog.

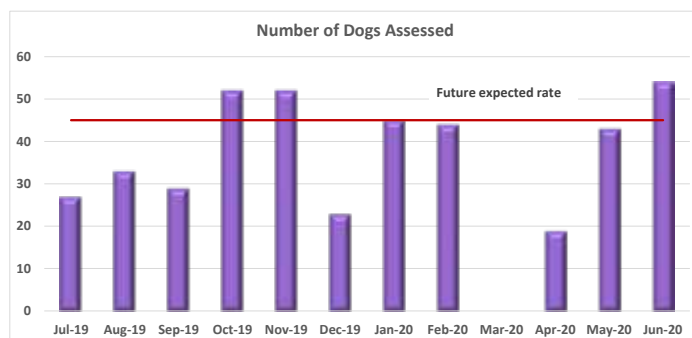
We are looking for dogs that are generally social and happy meeting other dogs and ones that walk well on a lead. Sessions are rostered at least a month in advance and are generally around two to four hours in length.

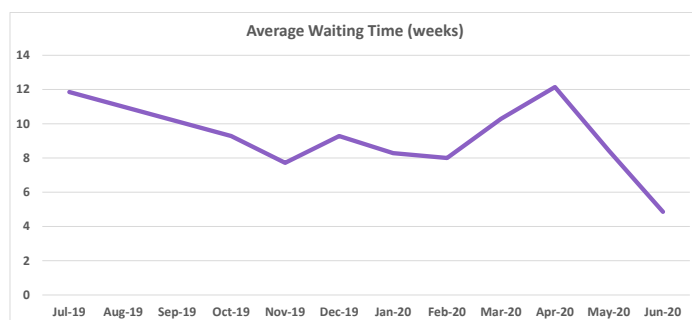
Latest updates from GAP

Just how far Saint Maddie – unraced at the time – has progressed since joining Dean Fennell's Glencoe kennels back in mid-April was highlighted by her effort in the JB Irrigation Mixed Stake (512 m) at Tara Raceway on Thursday 13th July.

The rank outsider at \$31 in the top class five-dog field, Saint Maddie sat in second spot behind Rock It Fernando for the majority of the journey before grabbing a half-head victory in a best of day 29.82 seconds.

The run was certainly a far cry from a couple of early wins when the black bitch struggled to break 24 seconds over the 400 metres journey although recent efforts against similar company had been full of merit.

The June 2018 whelping is owned by Koroit breeder Peter Byrne who transferred her to Fennell after the border closure prevented Victorian participants from racing at Tara Raceway.

By Peter Rocket, Saint Maddie is out of Miss Lava, a litter sister to top performers Annie Lava, Back On Lava and John John Lava, and herself a winner over 515 metres and 595 metres at Sandown Park and also over 600 metres at Tara Raceway.

This start was the last at Tara Raceway for

Saint Maddie – for the time being at least – with Fennell reporting that Byrne is to give her a chance in Melbourne with Lara trainer Brendan Pursell.

She leaves Glencoe with a record of five wins and seven minor placings from 13 starts.

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday (drawn Thursday) or Wednesday (drawn Friday) meetings.

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the Tuesday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations for both of these qualifying trials close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Wednesday.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held on a monthly basis at a Friday morning session, which has both tracks trialling. The next session will be Friday, 14th August. Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Thursday prior.

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Tuesday and Friday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the race meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be

selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA by midday on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Gawler Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before.
3. For Murray Bridge Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

Elite field for Greyhound racing's Group Two \$67,000 Energis Ballarat Cup (GRV Website)

Four dogs who contested greyhound racing's richest and most prestigious race, the TAB Melbourne Cup, will converge again for this Saturday's Group Two \$67,000 Energis Ballarat Cup.

And the recently-crowned Melbourne Cup winner Aston Dee Bee will go head to head with 2016 winner Ando's Mac. The Mymiong-based Ando's Mac is sure to have strong local backing from the Ballarat crowd, with trainer Anthony Azzopardi keen to follow on from the success he had in the 2016 Ballarat Cup with Zambora Brockie.

Ando's Mac is the only local representative in the 2017 Energis Ballarat Cup, after taking out the first heat thanks to an unimpeded run from box eight. Ando's Mac has an impressive record at his home track, and is now attempting to claim his second Victorian Country Cup after saluting at Warragul earlier this year. Aston Dee Bee is one of three dogs in the field to come from Seona Thompson's kennels, joining Big Flood and Bewildering. Victorian greyhound racing ambassador and AFL games record holder Brent Harvey will be in attendance, while there will be a Sports club challenge, a live musical act, a punters club and dining packages available for a family friendly night out. Ballarat has long been considered traditional heartland of Victorian greyhound racing, with a recent report identifying that the industry generated \$9.59 million in direct expenditure for the region in 2015-16 while 767 local residents are actively involved in greyhound racing as a participant, employee or volunteer.
