A MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

NATIONALS COUNTDOWN BEGINS!

In just over a month, GRSA will host the Nationals, for the first time in almost a decade!

The Nationals, of course, will feature incredible racing with the National Sprint and Distance Championships at Angle Park on Saturday night, August 24 and the National Straight Championship earlier in the day at a morning session at Murray Bridge. It will be the richest day of greyhound racing ever presented in SA!

Beyond the racing, GRSA will combine with Greyhound Clubs Australia and Greyhounds Australasia to present a number of business and social functions over the course of the Nationals, making SA very much the centre of international greyhound racing attention from August 22 to 24.

Hopefully, as many participants as possible will take in some of the Nationals experience as we proudly showcase our racing facilities and great aspects of our State.

GRSA is also delighted to have been able to announce a number of small but meaningfully targeted prizemoney initiatives connected to the Nationals.

Further details can be found on page four but a quick summary of the increases and reasoning is as follows:

• The State finals for the National Sprint and Distance finals have been increased by \$10,000 each to \$25,000, recognising the importance of local achievement within the national framework;

• Prizemoney for all races other than the National Straight Championship at the Saturday morning August 24 meeting to be funded at Category 1 level, rewarding those greyhounds with a preference for big stride racing;

• Prizemoney for all races other than the National Sprint and Distance Championships at the Saturday evening August 24 meeting to be increased by \$1500 each, providing a bonus for those competing at the week's pinnacle meeting;

• Category 1 prizemoney will be retained at the Thursday, August 22 Angle Park race meeting, despite the programme focusing on 342m racing and lower grade 530m racing; providing upside for this cohort of greyhounds; and

• Bonus prizemoney will apply at all other race meetings during Nationals week [Monday, August 19 to 25] where-by placegetters will all receive an additional \$100, \$50 or \$25, ensuring Nationals connectivity at the supporting meetings.

Our Nationals are being promoted to the "iconic SA" theme. All at GRSA look forward to joining with you as we collectively and proudly present our racing and our State to the national greyhound community.

GREYHOUND INDUSTRY REFORM INSPECTOR

I am very pleased to confirm that the Greyhound Industry Reform Inspector (GIRI), Sal Perna AM, has commenced his work. The GIRI is in the process of acquainting himself with the SA greyhound industry and his early evaluation is including visits to all tracks.

GRSA has, as previously advised, proactively progressed work on the recommendations that are to be implemented as an outcome of the 2023 Government Inquiry. This initial work will soon be reviewed by the GIRI after which the various reforms will be progressively rolled out.

STRATEGIC PLAN

The SA greyhound racing industry strategic plan will undergo final consultation during the next week. The plan is based on four pillars of focus, each of which are driven by strategic objectives and enabling actions and measurable work plans.

CHAMPION TRAINER, CHAMPION PERSON

The recent passing of training legend Terry Cahalan deeply saddened so many of us in the SA greyhound racing fraternity.

A greyhound trainer of incredible skill, Terry and his brother Laurie began training in their teens from a Wayville backyard. Laurie remains actively involved to this day and is currently enjoying city success with the speedy Toora Terry, a flashy blue and white youngster named in honour of Terry.

Terry cut his training teeth on the coursing fields and the amateur track racing equivalents that prevailed in SA, prior to betting on greyhound racing being legalised in 1971. From the earliest point, he enjoyed an insatiable appetite for knowledge and this led him to training in America when he was 19, at a time when American greyhound racing led the world in terms of glitz, glamour and popularity.

Terry was to return to America, this time with his wife Rhonda and daughters Jenny and Michelle, in the early 80's for another 12 month training stint. On the coursing fields, he treasured his success in the Waterloo Cup while the crowning glory of his track training career was Brookside Bear's brilliant win in the 2002 Adelaide Cup.

Terry was a highly skilled pilot, he was of deep religious faith, was a great giver in the community space, formed and nurtured friendships easily and genuinely and the importance of a loving and supportive family framework drove his values.

The longtail was a constant in a long and vibrant life. Greyhound racing enriched his life but he gave back much more than he took. Few were blessed with finer "dog man's" hands. He will be missed in this industry that is "our way of life".

FY24 BREEDERS ACKNOWLEDGED

As part of its ongoing support for SA Registered Breeders – and with the further objective of encouraging quality SA bred outcomes – GRSA last month boosted its breeders' rebate for SA bred litters to a maximum of \$5500 per litter.

This rebate applies to all SA bred litters arising from matings on or after April 1, 2024. Further details can be found on page 5. GRSA is delighted to also confirm that SA Registered Breeders of any litters whelped in the 2024/25 financial year, that were not eligible for the \$5500 rebate, will still be acknowledged for their contribution by way of a one off \$1000 bonus payment.

These payments have been processed this week with the last scheduled for Friday, July 19.

Local participants set for prizemoney increase during Nationals week

As South Australia prepares to host the Nationals for the first time since 2016, local participants are set to reap the benefits with significant prizemoney increases for events during Nationals week.

These prizemoney increases will provide diverse racing opportunities for all of our greyhounds and ensure that all race meetings across Nationals week are supported with strong racing programs.

Key features of the Nationals week prizemoney increases include:

• Saturday August 24 night meeting at Angle Park will not only feature the two Group 1 \$136,750 National Sprint and Distance finals there will also be an extra \$1,500 added to each other event on the program including the Classic 2024 Prelude [1] final enticing some of the very best chasers.

• The meeting at Murray Bridge on Saturday morning of the 24th August will be conducted with City A Metro Prizemoney [Category 1] with a shared meeting across the straight track and one turn track planned.

As well as the Group 3 \$44,875 National Straight Track final, there will be an Open straight track feature over the 350m along with a Grade 5 over 300m.

One turn feature races will include a special event over the 455m along with two finals, a grade 6 455m final and a grade 5 395m final with those heats run on Friday August 16.

• Thursday's Angle Park meeting on August 22 will provide an opportunity for some short-course events with the main focus for sprinting, middle distance and stayers at Angle Park on the Saturday night. The Thursday meeting will provide a mix of events over multiple distances with highlighted events being Open Maiden heats over the 530m, a Maiden/Grade 6 final over 595m from the heats on Thursday August 15, a Grade 5 for Male dogs over 530m along with a restricted Grade 6 [1-2 win] event over 530m.

Over the 342m, we have programmed a Mixed 342m event with some of the quickest bend greyhounds on show along with two finals from heats on the Saturday morning August 17, one Time Graded 1-4 wins (3 heats) and one Time Graded 5+ wins (2 heats) which will provide some of our lower category racers an opportunity to share the spotlight at a City A meeting.

• At all other meetings, there will a Nationals Bonus payment where all winners, seconds and thirds will receive \$100, \$50, \$25 extra respectively.

As well as Nationals week, the SA National Sprint and Distance finals to be decided at Angle Park on Thursday August 8 will also see total prizemoney elevated from \$15,000 to \$25,000.

GRSA's Racing Manger Shaun Mathieson said that the prizemoney increases will look to ensure the strongest possible programs during Nationals week.

"With all eyes on SA during Nationals week, we want to ensure that we have the strongest possible programs right across Nationals week," Mathieson said.

"WIth Gawler out of action due to the Gawler Show, Angle Park and Murray Bridge will be the focus of our meetings and it is hoped that the spread of racing opportunities provides for a great Nationals week for our local participants and industry."

Coursing nominations enjoy boost following prizemoney increase

Coursing nominations at Virginia have enjoyed a significant boost, following the increase to prizemoney which was announced last month.

The July 14 meeting, which was the first since the prizemoney boost was announced, saw more than 60 nominations with plenty of high-quality chasing across the meeting.

GRSA CEO Brenton Scott said he was thrilled to see such great numbers at the coursing meeting.

"In increasing prizemoney, GRSA reaffirmed its commitment to the GOTBA and coursing at Virginia and it was great to see such strong numbers for the recent meeting," Scott said.

Prizemoney for eight-dog coursing events now aligns with prize money for time-graded track events while major increases to the Oaks, Derby and time-honoured Waterloo Cup were announced last month.

Total prizemoney for the Waterloo Cup will rise from \$4000 to \$8000 while the Oaks and Derby will increase from \$2650 to \$5000. Owners and trainers are again reminded that, in order to be eligible to nominate for the Oaks, Derby or Waterloo Cup, a greyhound must have had at least one start at a coursing meeting in 2024.

In addition, there is also a \$500 bonus available for any greyhound who has competed at any of two Virginia coursing meetings during the season if they are able to win the Derby, Oaks or Waterloo Cup.

There are only two meetings left to ensure nomination eligibility for the Derby, Oaks and Waterloo Cup or to qualify for the bonuses and GOTBA chairman Neil Mann hopes that numbers will stay strong heading into the feature meetings.

"There are terrific incentives available to consider coursing over the next two meetings, and we hope that we see numbers continue to be strong in the second half of the season," Mann said.

The next coursing meetings are Sunday, August 11 and Sunday, September 8 before the Oaks, Derby and Waterloo Cup meeting on the weekend of September 21 and 22.

New Prizemoney (Commenced July 2024)

4 dog coursing events – first \$350, runner up \$110 (Up from first \$265, runner up \$90)

8 dog coursing events – first \$525, runner up \$160 (up from first \$380, runner up \$120)

Waterloo Cup – first \$6,000, runner up \$1,600, thirds \$200

Oaks - first \$3,700, runner up \$1,000, thirds \$150

Derby – first \$3,700, runner up \$1,000, thirds \$150

Entry conditions for Derby, Oaks and Waterloo Cup: Must have had 1 start at any Coursing venue during 2024 to be eligible for the Waterloo Cup, Oaks or Derby.

Bonus – If the winner of the Derby, Oaks or Waterloo Cup is a greyhound that has raced at two Virginia Coursing meetings during the 2024 season, a \$500 bonus will apply.

2024 GAWLER CLASSIC HEATS ON WEDNESDAY JULY 24

The first part of the series for the Classic 2024 eligible greyhounds will be the Gawler Classic Heats over 400m which will be run on Wednesday, 24th July with the \$3,300 Final on Wednesday, 31st July.

Nominations for the Heats close on Friday, 19th July with GRSA at 9.00am.

2024 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA IN AUGUST

The GCA National Championships are just around the corner. The National Finals this year will be held locally at Angle Park and are to be conducted on Saturday, 24th August.

Both the National Sprint and National Distance Finals are at Group 1 level worth \$85,000 to the winner.

The State series' for SA will be held at Angle Park on Thursday, 1st August for the Sprint Heats over 530m with the State Final of the Sprint and one-off Final over 730m of the Distance on Thursday, 8th August.

In an effort to support this series ALL States will be conducting their Finals on the same night to be run within a two hour period.

• Nominations will close at the normal time with GRSA which will be at 9am on Monday, 29th July

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA.

For the Sprint series going back is on Wednesday, 15th May 2024.

For the Distance due to South Australia running as a one off Final going back is on Wednesday, 22nd May 2024.

If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

NATIONAL STRAIGHT TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP AT MURRAY BRIDGE

The National Straight Track Championship this year will be held locally at Murray Bridge on Saturday morning, 24th August with around \$28,000 to the winner – so all the National Finals will be held on the same day.

This year SA will have two SA dogs represent the State in the series with QLD, NSW, VIC and SA challenging for the title.

With the Straight Track series being in SA with the circle and the other States, our Heats will be held at Murray Bridge on Tuesday, 6th August with our Final on Tuesday, 13th August. Prizemoney for the SA Straight track Final will be \$10,000 to the winner aligned with the other three States.

It is important that trainers are aware that these series' for the circle and straight track are run around the same time so please be mindful of this when nominating and the qualifying criteria.

• Nominations close with GRSA at 9am on Friday, 2nd August (this will allow the opportunity if greyhounds get run out over the 530m in the Heats for the Sprint series a chance to nominate for the Straight)

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Sunday, 19th May 2024. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

UPDATE FOR NATIONAL STRAIGHT TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

The Racing Managers on Thursday, 27th June 2024 from the States that have a qualifying series for the National Straight Track Championship (NSW, QLD, VIC and SA) met to discuss the published rules for the eligibility of the series. The first part refers to 76 days out of 150 days being domiciled in that State where the series is taking place, however, if a greyhound does not qualify under that domiciliary condition, it would revert to where the greyhound was first named. This would mean that greyhounds named in WA, Tasmania and Northern Territory (whist none bred in NT for a number of years) would not be eligible for a series if they do not reach the 76 day clause in a State that holds a series.

The Managers considered Rule 10 in the conditions which could allow for the host state (SA this year) to make a determination regarding eligibility outside of the 76 days clause. As the Nationals move between the 4 States each year it was best to get all Managers from those Jurisdictions to discuss and agree to a consistent position of eligibility for these greyhounds. After several things were discussed, it was agreed that these greyhounds would not be eligible if they do not meet the 76 days clause as any greyhound is required to do for the States that conducted the Straight Track series. The 76 days out of 150 days has been a standing condition for a number of years and with the conditions having been published and trainers having made a choice about their greyhound regarding the domiciliary clause, all Jurisdictions believed it would not be reasonable to introduce a further clause.

HEATS CLASSIC 2024 PRELUDE (1) AT ANGLE PARK

The \$3,700 Heats of Classic 2024 Prelude [1] will be run on Thursday, 15th August with the \$4,500 Final on Saturday, 24th August over the 530m to coincide with the Group 1 Nationals meeting. For SA Bred greyhounds whelped July 22 to December 22 and paid up for Classic 2024.

* Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 12th August with GRSA at 9.00am.

NEXT LOW GRADE SERIES AT ANGLE PARK

The next low grade series will be in late August at Angle Park for Maidens over the 530m with \$2,785 Heats on Thursday, 22nd August with the \$5,810 Final on Thursday, 29th August.

• Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 19th August at 9.00am.

HEATS CADILLAC RACING WINTER CLASSIC AT MOUNT GAMBIER

The \$2,400 Heats of Cadillac Racing Winter Classic will be run on Sunday, 18th August with the \$6,500 Final on Sunday, 25th August over the 512m. For dogs and bitches whelped on or after 1st July 2022. Non Penalty.

* Nominations for the Heats close Tuesday, 13th August with GRSA at 9.00am.

KINGS AND QUEENS FEATURE HEATS IN AUGUST

Again, this year GRSA will conduct the Kings and Queens Feature series with \$5,810 Heats on Thursday, 29th August and a \$7,500 Final on Thursday, 5th September in continued support of any greyhound affected by the change to the GCA Age Restricted Classics change quite a number of years ago. The eligibility for this series is for dogs and bitches whelped between 1st March 2022 and 31st May 2022. Performed Maidens are eligible (raced or qualy trialled). Depending upon nominations we would like to run a dogs Heat and a bitches Heat separately with greyhounds qualifying into the Final. If there are not sufficient nominations for either sex, then these Heats may be mixed into a couple of mixed Heats. Special conditions apply; however, these races will be non-penalty.

• Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 26th August at 9.00am with GRSA.

OAKS AND DERBY ELIGIBILITY IN 2024

The Group 3 SA Oaks and SA Derby to be run in September this year will be for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st June, 2022 (27 months). The Heats of the Oaks will be run on the same night as the Derby again this year, with Heats on Thursday, 12th September and the Group 3 Finals on Thursday, 19th September.

• Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 9th September at 9.00am.

PREFERENTIAL BOX DRAWS TO START AT MURRAY BRIDGE STRAIGHT TRACK IN AUGUST

GRSA will conduct Preferential Box Draws (PBD) for selected events at the Murray Bridge Straight track starting from August 1, 2024 (Maidens and Feature Cup and Championship series will be excluded). PBD events are being regularly programmed Interstate under each state's conditions. PBD events will be specifically advertised, and trainers must advise if they want to compete in these events along with the racing trait of the respective greyhound at the time of nominating in the comments box. If trainers do not provide this information when nominating, they will not be considered for these advertised PBD events.

Conditions -

• PBD racing to be introduced for advertised race events at the Murray Bridge Straight track as from August 1, 2024

• Three racing traits - R = Rail, M = Middle, W = Wide

• The Trainer nominates the racing trait of the greyhound relating to box rise and 50m after the start

- This is reviewed by Stewards/Grading teams
- Box draws via OzChase which can now accommodate an automated process where greyhounds can be grouped by trait and then automatically box drawn
- Grading of each race event will be done under normal grading and programming guidelines
- There will be No Reserves for these events

Tuesday 6th August - PBD Grade 6 Heats - 300m

Tuesday 13th August – PDB Grade 6 Final – 300m, PBD Grade 5 300m

Wednesday 21st August - PBD Grade 6 - 350m

Wednesday 28th August – PBD Mixed – 350m

TUESDAY NIGHT MEETINGS ON THE CALENDAR

Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) announced the introduction of Tuesday night meetings at Angle Park, which started a few months ago. The Tuesday night meetings are designed to meet demand, providing more racing opportunities for lower class greyhounds within SA. The meetings are time graded, with 10 races of six dog fields. The meetings operate in tandem with Saturday morning race meetings which will target greyhounds of the same class with the racing distance at both race meetings restricted to 342m. The Tuesday meetings will provide a further outlet for greyhounds that are nominated for the Saturday mornings and are not provided with a starting opportunity. Greyhounds falling into this category will be granted preference rights if nominated for the subsequent Tuesday night meeting.

With Saturday morning and Tuesday night meetings being restricted to 342m nominations, opportunities for 530m time graded greyhounds will be programmed for other Angle Park dates. Trainers are encouraged to familiarise themselves with the details for the Tuesday night meetings, changes to the Saturday morning meetings and updated trialling times for Angle Park.

Tuesday night meetings

Weekly Tuesday night meetings at Angle Park (commenced May 14, 2024) have been time graded, Provincial 2 class, restricted to 10 races of six dog fields with reserves over 342m only. Groupings will be 'Worst to Best' with maidens, 1-4 wins and 5+ wins. Grading procedures for Tuesday nights will grant preference rights to any greyhound nominated at the immediately prior Saturday morning meeting but not provided with a separate starting opportunity at the Tuesday night meeting when fields were drawn, provided the said greyhound is re-nominated for the Tuesday night meeting. Greyhounds in this category include those listed as a reserve and not placed in another starting field at the time of box draw for the Saturday morning meeting and greyhounds that were nominated but were not graded to start in a field or listed as a reserve. Any greyhounds placed in a starting field at the time of box draw for a Saturday morning meeting will be considered last if nominated for the immediately following Tuesday night meeting. This will ensure the greatest number of greyhounds are provided with the opportunity to compete at either the Saturday morning or Tuesday night meeting.

The meetings will be graded with reserves where nominations permit. Nominations will close for the Tuesday night on the Friday before at 9am with GRSA . The meeting will start at approximately 6pm SA time.

Saturday morning meetings

The fortnightly Saturday morning meetings, as from May 11, will remain a time graded meeting but will be restricted to 10 races of six dog fields with reserves over the 342m only.

Reserves at Saturday morning meetings will, where possible, be graded to a 'cascading' format. For example, if there are four races of one pool of greyhounds then the reserves of the first race will also be included in the second race as starters, the reserves for the second race will also be included in the third race as starters and so on.

RACING AND TRIALLING FREQUENCY REMINDER

GRSA adopted a new local rule regarding frequency of racing and trialling which was implemented on Wednesday, 1st February, 2023.

[1] In this rule:

Race has the same meaning given to this term in R9 of the GAR.

Trial means a satisfactory trial, or a qualifying trial as defined in R9 of the GAR.

[2] A greyhound will only be permitted to start in [a] No more than a combined total of 2 race and trial starts in any 7-day period; and,

(b) No more than a combined total of 7 race and trial starts in any 28-day period.

[3] This sub-rule commences on a date to be fixed by Stewards' Notice.

The intent of this rule is to monitor and regulate the frequency of races and official trials of greyhounds, to ensure adequate rest time is given between events. The rule is similar to one in effect in Western Australia. We have automated the Ozchase Racing system to be able to monitor this rule. The rule is self-explanatory.

A greyhound must not start more than 2 times (races or trials combined) in any 7-day period. Further, a greyhound must not start more than 7-times (races or trials combined) in any 28-day period.

Any attempt to nominate a greyhound outside these parameters will be flagged by the OzChase system. If a greyhound gains a start from reserve deeming it ineligible under this rule for its next engagement or it competes in another state prior to racing back in SA, then the greyhound will come out.

**Racing Administration staff will scratch these greyhounds acting under this rule without notification (the responsibility rests with the trainer to ensure they do not contravene this rule).

**For clarity if a greyhound races on Sunday, Wednesday then Sunday it will be eligible. The first day counts as day 1 and therefore resets on the Saturday.

CURRENT MASTERS TIMES AND POLICY

• For greyhounds 3³/₄ years and older. 4yo and older will get preference. City A, City B and Prov 1 meetings are done by form for 4yo and older and then greyhounds will only get in from under 4yo to 3³/₄ yo in age from oldest to youngest. Prov 2 meetings are all done on age from oldest to youngest regardless of form for all ages.

• Dates are exact so going back 4yo and $3\frac{3}{4}$ from the date of race. le date of race run on 20/11/22 - 4yo would be 20/11/18 whelping.

• Time restrictions if a greyhound wins a Grade 5 Masters race in a faster time than published and it will have to have 2 runs (placed or unplaced) in normal company at that class of meeting before being eligible at that class of meeting.

• The Grader will look to grade a Grade 5 Masters event on every program over a distance if enough dogs are nominated regardless if it is advertised in the All Tracks calendar.

If a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading. If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters [ie Grade 2/3 & 4] we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event.

305m Masters Policy for Mt Gambier - With Mt Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events, however, factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance. There will still be a Time Standard applied based on the published table being 17.75. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week. The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.

GRADING UPDATE REMINDERS

• GRSA allow one extra Grade 6 over another distance for City A Thursday meetings bringing this into line with all tracks in SA.

• GRSA removed the condition where once a greyhound has won a Grade 5 or higher event on a City A meeting that the greyhound will lose all Grade 6 events at all other tracks. This means a greyhound could be a Grade 4 or Grade 3 over 530m on a Thursday City A meeting and will still be able to win Grade 6 events at other tracks. • GRSA allow a greyhound after winning a Grade 5 Masters event in faster time than the a placing in their last two starts using WPS, First starters then other Maidens using WPS.

VACCINATION RULE FOR RACING IN SA – REMINDER

Trainers are reminded that Rule 25 (Minimum Vaccination Requirements) took effect Monday, 1st May, 2023. Vaccination Certificates must be received by GRSA prior to close of nominations for affected greyhounds to be considered eligible for nominating. It is also imperative that once the greyhound has been vaccinated the paperwork is lodged by yourself as soon as possible. Trainers are also reminded that they must not have their greyhound vaccinated within 5 days of racing. Should this occur, the greyhound will be scratched from its engagement or if paperwork lodged after an engagement and discovered the greyhound raced inside the 5 days then the matter will be referred to the stewards.

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month.

These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner & \$150 to the Breeder.

The SA Bred Bonus scheme is continuing to go over budget with the number of SA Bred winners increasing. For the month of July there were 203 winners, August 197, September 196, October 226, November 209, December 218, January 218, February 194, March 179, April 197, May 203 and June 190. This means that we are over budget for this financial year by 30 winners (\$6,750).

A reminder that the emptying of Greyhounds along the fence line or around trees can only occur if you are going to pick up waste. The Council have highlighted that there is an issue occurring again. There are bins provided for waste. The Gawler Track is on public land and as such trainers would incur the same penalties as anyone else who chooses not to pick up after their animals.

Council may impose fines for those that offend.

NEW LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT ARRANGEMENTS

With the recent departure of our General Manager, Integrity and Welfare, Ms Kelly Rourke, there are some interim changes to our management. The Chief Executive Officer, Mr Brenton Scott, will oversee greyhound welfare and GAP; and I will oversee integrity that includes Stewards (that also cover licensing). Mr Des Jonas is still the Chief Steward.

GREYHOUND REFORMS

I had the pleasure of meeting the Greyhound Industry Reform Inspector (GIRI) and his team recently. As you may be aware, the GIRI is tasked with overseeing reforms in the greyhound racing industry, guided by the report of the Independent Inquiry into the Governance of the Greyhound Racing Industry in South Australia (GI). The leadership and management team are working extremely hard to work on the reforms, and we have made good progress so far. But there is a long way to go. It is vital that everyone strive for best practice in their sport, especially with greyhound care. Working together, everyone can showcase their four-legged athletes and build community support: the social licence that is often spoken about. Like a driver's licence, a social licence is earned and not possessed as of right. It is extremely important that you go about your days training and racing greyhounds, like you are on a world stage.

TRIALS

Please remember the new trial policy is now operational. Please be guided by Stewards and GRSA officials at trials and practice safety at all times. Recently there was an enquiry about GRSA officials assisting at trails to handle greyhounds. At present, it is GRSA's position that GRSA officials cannot handle greyhounds at trials (e.g. catching). There are a number of reasons for this, including rule restrictions, our integrity framework and resourcing (work health and safety). This was in place at least from January 2023. Please refer to the trial policy for guidance on when you require a catcher.

WORKS AT RACETRACKS

There are a number of works being conducted at our racetracks. Please be mindful of your safety and follow the directions of any signs or fencing in place for your safety.

Please note in your diaries the Nationals, August, 22-24. I urge you to look at the program and try to get along to a few of the events.



WELFARE AND GAP HAYLEY ALEXANDER

GREEN COLLAR / MUZZLE EXEMPTION ASSESSMENTS FOR TRAINERS

GAP Manager Hayley Alexander and GAP Supervisor Jemma Nicholson are Certified DCMB Approved Green Collar Assessors who have the ability to Muzzle-Exempt Greyhounds within the GAP Program.

This assessment can be conducted during GAP First Point Assessments however if Hayley and Jemma are not present this will not occur.

Passing a Green Collar means the greyhound can go straight into an adoptive home through the 'Supported Adoption' rehoming pathway, rather than having to enter Foster Care or the Prison Program.

Recent statistics have shown Muzzle-Exempt greyhounds are more desirable to families and therefore often move into homes quicker than those who are not.

If you have a greyhound currently waiting on the GAP Waitlist that you would like to have Green Collar Assessed please call GAP on 8243 7124 and book a free of charge appointment time.

Green Collar Assessment Sessions will also be scheduled and become available to trainers depending on demand.

Please note that privately rehomed greyhounds will be required to pay \$100 for the Green Collar Assessment and must be in the new home for 3 months prior to assessment

CASH ON DELIVERY TRAINER: CAMERON FORSHAW

Greyhound of the Month for June was Cash On Delivery for trainer Cameron Forshaw, who had three starts for the month for two wins and a second with the highlight being victory in the \$75,000 to the winner Thunderbolt Final at Grafton in New South Wales.

The son of Zambora Brockie and Shilo was on the back of a huge winning streak when the team took Cash On Delivery to Grafton for the qualifying Final of the Thunderbolt over the 350m.

Chasing his 13th win in a row he won impressively qualifying for the Feature Heats the week later.

Against the best short course sprinters available, Cash On Delivery had no luck in the Heats, however, was still good enough to run second and make the feature Thunderbolt Final. Starting one of the favourites he surprisingly missed the start from box 3, however, on this occasion he got the luck and pushed through to lead rounding the home turn.

From there Cash On Delivery was in no danger going on to win by 2.25 lengths in 20.09 and in doing so provided one of the biggest wins for his trainer and connections.

At the end of the month Cash On Delivery's record stood at 54 starts for 35 wins and 14 placings and earnings around \$135,000.



ZINFANDEL TRACE TRAINER: GAVIN HARRIS

The Run of the Month for June was the Gavin Harris trained Zinfandel Trace, for her win in the prestigious Gawler Produce Final over the 531m at Gawler on Sunday, 23rd June.

The daughter of Barcia Bale and Zinfandel Zara began well from box 3 to take up a forward position just off the speed and down the back straight she began to make her move, however, off the back straight she received a check and went back to fourth, all looked over but she balanced up and came again.

Turning for home and Zinfandel Trace accelerated brilliantly to pass her opposition down the outside to go on and win by .75 length in 30.84, a brilliant performance.

Kind reminder from GAP: Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

We continue to look to increase these further in order to offer a wider variety of times to meet participants varying requirements. The following graph depicts the number of assessments that have been occurring on a monthly basis.

Payment of placement fees

The \$60 placement fee is due at the time the placement form is submitted, payment can be made by either completing the card details on the form or by paying in cash. The placement form will only be processed, and the greyhound placed in GAP, once payment has been received



TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during nondaylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start

2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track

3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

- 1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
- For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- 6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
 Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
- 10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

RACING REPORT

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.


