CEO'S UPDATE

Greyhound RACING SA

Government Funding

Further to the recent announcement of the \$24 million Government funding package over five years, there was an article in The Advertiser this week which alluded to the conditions that would be placed on that funding. Whilst talks are still continuing on this front, the Racing Minister had [prior to the funding announcement] consistently foreshadowed with our Board his intention for reasonable steps to be taken to review the governance models across the three codes. All but one of our five Board Members are appointed as independent Directors through an open public process, and considerable effort has been devoted towards ensuring that the GRSA model is both sustainable and accountable.

Straight Track Racing

The commencement of straight track racing from July 24 at Murray Bridge should be welcome news for many across the industry. The works to install drop-on boxes for the 300m start have been completed and trialling is underway. The appeal of a national straight track series final at Healesville in August, in which SA will field three runners, should only add to the popularity of the new track in its first few weeks. The Murray Bridge dual track project is a vital component of a vibrant and sustainable long-term model for greyhound racing in this State. To any extent that trainers support racing at this venue, they are making an important investment towards the future of our sport.

Stakemoney Increase

In conjunction with the new racing opportunities at Murray Bridge, the recent announcement of a \$1 million increase in annual stakemoney and returns to industry is a highly positive step towards greater viability for our trainers, breeders and owners, noting the significant investment – both financial and personal – to pursue their racing dream. The scale of the increase amounts to reward for patience and reflects the positive direction in which SA greyhound racing is currently headed.

G-SIX Racing

GRSA is in discussion with Tabcorp about extending the trial of G-SIX racing in whatever form that might take. A further update will be made available as those talks progress.

Major stakemoney uplift announced

The Board of GRSA has announced an increase to participant returns in excess of \$1 million annually from 2019-20 in a move which signals the current strength of the sport in South Australia and draws on the momentum of the recent announcement of State Government funding support for the three codes of racing.

The following changes have been implemented from the start of July:

- A stakemoney increase of 15% for all standard grade racing beyond a distance of 400m
- A stakemoney increase of 10% for all standard grade racing up to and including a distance of 400m
- A stakemoney increase of 15% for all Time-Graded and Pathway races
- Elevation of Thursday night stakemoney for Grade 6 and Juvenile events (39% above current levels) for closer alignment with higher grades
- A doubling of the breeder component of monthly payments under the SA Bred Scheme
- Removal of trial fees at all South Australian TAB greyhound tracks (Angle Park, Gawler, Murray Bridge and Mount Gambier) for Club Members

Whereas more recent stakemoney increases have placed a focus on targeted matters such as travel costs and unplaced payments, the emphasis on this occasion has been about growing base stakemoney levels across all regions and for all standards of racing.

GRSA Chairman Grantley Stevens indicated that "this is a significant moment for the industry and one which amounts to reward for patience. The sport in South Australia has had to roll up its sleeves in recent years to lay the foundations of a sustainable model, and now we can see the benefits starting to flow back to our breeders, trainers and owners – the people who put the show on and make the sacrifices to follow their dream."

Mr Stevens added "these stakemoney changes, and the recent \$8.6 million investment in the new dual track facility at Murray Bridge, are all about supporting viable opportunities for the next generation of racing enthusiasts."

Exciting cross-state initiatives

Victorian and South Australian-based trainers will have a new direct path to the Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final under exciting new cross-state initiatives being introduced by Greyhound Racing Victoria (GRV) and Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA).

The industry-first initiatives include the winner of GRSA's State of Origin series, to be held at Angle Park on 26 September, being guaranteed a berth in the \$75,000 to-the-winner Adelaide Cup Final on 11 October. The State of Origin series is run along similar lines to Sandown's Speed Star, with four Vic-trained greyhounds clashing with four locals under match race conditions.

The format sees the GRSA grader select the best four nominated greyhounds from each state and rank them from 1 to 4, with 1 being the highest rank. The head-to-head match races will pit the two number 1 sprinters from each state against each other, followed by 2 vs 2, 3 vs 3 and 4 vs 4, with the overall winning greyhound earning \$7500. The State of Origin series was introduced in 2018 and is sure to create even greater interest among Victorian trainers in its second year with the inclusion of the massive carrot of bypassing the Adelaide Cup heats.

A guaranteed Adelaide Cup spot isn't the only benefit awaiting the State of Origin winner. In addition to gaining direct entry into the Adelaide Cup Final, the State of Origin victor will also secure a position in the Group 3 Sandown Shootout, the four-sprinter feature to be run on 14 November.

Another innovation will see the winner of the Adelaide Cup receive automatic entry, should connections accept, into the invitation-only Group 1 Topgun at The Meadows, which will be run this year on 9 November. With positions in the Adelaide Cup and Shootout on offer, State of Origin places will be keenly sought after and the winner of Sandown's Speed Star series, to be held on 15 September, will be rewarded with one of the four Victorian spots in the Origin series.

GRV CEO Alan Clayton said the cross-state initiatives would generate broader interest in greyhound racing. "GRV and GRSA are delighted to introduce such unique opportunities to participants and their greyhounds and these new initiatives will add another dimension to our sport," Mr Clayton said.

"Victoria and South Australia have a great history of friendly rivalry across a number of sports, and if we can bring some of that parochialism into the greyhound racing world it has the potential to captivate interest from general sports fans."

GRSA Racing Manager, Shaun Mathieson said the alignment between the two state industry bodies demonstrates their close working relationship. "GRSA and GRV are consistently focussed on providing real benefit to its participants, as well as increasing interest in greyhound racing." Mr Mathieson.

"This linking of interstate feature races is an industry first and we believe that the linking of these feature races will bring an increased quality in fields, resulting in a better racing product. GRSA is a proud innovator, consistently pushing to bring positive outcomes to the industry."

GRSA Chairman Grantley Stevens reappointed

Greyhound Racing SA (GRSA) is pleased to announce that its current Chairman, Grantley Stevens has been reappointed for a further three-year term. After being appointed to the Board in the role of Director – experience in finance in 2013, Mr Stevens has since gone on to be elected to the role of Chairman from March 2018. In the past year, under Mr Stevens' stewardship, racing has commenced at the new \$8.6 million Murray Bridge dual track facility, and the company has continued to build on the positive momentum of recent years.

"I am looking forward to an exciting period ahead for greyhound racing in South Australia. The sport in this state drives vital benefits back to the community and makes a critical contribution to the social fabric of the communities in which greyhound racing is conducted," Mr Stevens said,

The Board of GRSA comprises four independent Directors, recruited through an open public process undertaken through an independent recruitment consultant, and an industry elected Director.

Great day sends off Port Augusta in style











The running of the final Port Augusta Cup was held on Saturday 29th June closing a long chapter of greyhound racing in the town.

With a history that leads back to 1970, it was certainly a bittersweet day for the Club and the Industry as they celebrated the final race meeting and despite the weather there was a great crowd at Chinnery Park watching.

It was Blastoise who etched himself into the history books as he took out the final Port Augusta Cup for trainer Shelley Trengove in a great race ahead of the fast-starting Hot Chevy for trainer Adam Manton in second and Aston Ricardo for Leanne Fagan in third place. In what was a fitting finale, the final ever race run at the Port Augusta Greyhound Club, the Broadbridge Family Stakes, was won by trainer Don Turner with Will Eye Am.





Inaugural National Straight Track Championship

Australia's first ever National Straight Track Championship for greyhounds will take place over late July and early August in Victoria, Queensland and South Australia, with the Healesville Greyhound Association hosting the Grand Final on 18 August 2019.

Sponsored by SEN, the Championship will showcase Australia's best straight track racers with \$35,500 in total prizemoney; which includes \$5,000 to the winner of each State Final as well as an inaugural GRV Grand Final bonus of \$14,500 to be distributed throughout first, second and third places.

Queensland's Capalaba Greyhound Racing Club, the Murray Bridge Greyhound Racing Club in South Australia and Victoria's Healesville Greyhound Association will each host state heats and finals with the top three placings from the QLD and SA Finals joining Victoria's 1st and 2nd place getters to race for the National title.

The Grand Final winner will also receive entry into heats for the Group 3 Healesville Cup, which now carries \$67,000 in total prizemoney.

Greyhound Racing Victoria's (GRV)'s CEO Alan Clayton said Victoria is proud to host the first National Straight Track Championship.

"This will be an exciting part of Victoria's safe racing program that is expanding the importance of straight track racing in the state," Mr Clayton said.

"The National Straight Track Championship combined with the Healesville Cup delivers a strong straight track schedule in Victoria."

"GRV is very pleased to work with Healesville Greyhound Association to develop the inaugural Championship and that Australia's two other straight tracks, Capalaba and Murray Bridge, have embraced this great new event on the national greyhound racing calendar."

South Australia's Murray Bridge Club is about to start racing on their new straight track, the first of its kind as a one turn track which incorporates a straight track.

"Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) is enthusiastic to explore more interstate partnership opportunities like this that create a more vibrant racing calendar," GRSA CEO Matt Corby said.

"Straight track racing offers real benefits in terms of safe racing, more opportunities for our greyhounds and appeal to the wagering audience."

In November 2018, Racing Queensland converted Capalaba to a TAB venue and elevated the Capalaba Cup to Group 3 level prize money.

"The National Straight Track Championship strengthens the presence of straight track racing in the national calendar as a safe and exciting form of racing," Brenton Scott, Greyhound Strategy and Development Manager for Racing Queensland said.

"Queensland looks forward to participating in the inaugural event, and the opportunity to host in the years to come."

Like the National Sprint and Distance Championships, the National Straight Track Championship will annually rotate between different states with Capalaba to host the 2020 Grand Final followed by Murray Bridge in 2021.

Trengove continues great run of form

Lewiston trainer Clint Trengove secured one of the biggest wins of his training career when Stitch 'Em Cilla took out the AGRC/GRSA Auction Final at Angle Park.

In a terrific training performance he qualified three greyhounds for the feature Final, all with the "Stitch 'Em" prefix.

As the start was affected Stitch 'Em Cilla which started the punters elect began well from box 8 to challenge for the early lead but pushing up on her inside in the run to the first turn were her kennel mates Stitch 'Em Frank (box 2) and Stitch 'Em Walks (box 4) which both showed excellent early speed. Out wide on the track, the reserve Demolisher for Derek Anderson was also charging forward towards the leaders. Into the back straight and Stitch 'Em Cilla ran to the front passing Stitch 'Em Frank while Demolisher made good ground out wide on the track while the rest of the field struggled to make ground. Off the back straight and Stitch 'Em Cilla was going strongly with Demolisher making good ground while Stitch 'Em Frank was coming under pressure to hold onto third spot. As heads turned for home Stitch 'Em Cilla was doing it well going on to win by 2 lengths in a solid 30.10 for the 515m journey. Demolisher was brave in defeat running second while Amara Lucy for trainer Cherylee Barber flashed home into third spot.

Stitch 'Em Cilla is owned by Clint and is locally bred by Rob Harnas being out of Dyna Double One and Power Merc.

Murray Bridge Straight Track trials and racing

Nominations for the very first meeting on Wednesday, 24th July will close at 9am tomorrow and we will race for three Wednesdays in a row on the Straight Track with the Heats of the National Straight Track Championship on Wednesday, 31st July and \$7,145 Final on Wednesday, 7th August.

We will still be trialling leading up to the first meeting with an additional session added this Sunday.

With the two starting distances in operation and the upcoming first meeting on the Murray Bridge straight track, industry is reminded that straight track trials are scheduled as normal this Friday 19 July. Straight track trials will be conducted from both distances between 9am – 11am. Ideally, 350m trials to go first. No bookings required for straight track. Normal trial bookings for circle track.

GRSA has also scheduled an additional trialling session (straight track only) prior to the race meeting this Sunday 21 July. The trial session will be held from 2.30pm – 3.30pm sharp as kennelling for the race meeting will begin at 3.45pm. Querencia makes it two Run of the Month's in a row

The Run of the Month for June was Querencia for trainer Kirin Corby for the second month in a row after he produced another blistering performance at Angle Park on Monday, 10th June in a Grade 6 event.

Starting as a long odds on favourite he didn't disappoint with a sizzling 9.25 length win after leading throughout. His time was exceptional running the 515m journey in 29.29 with splits of 4.41 and 16.64.

Super-bonus for SA Bred greyhounds

The super-bonus scheme is premised upon 100% dividend to breeders for SA Bred greyhounds. The super bonus will only be paid out to breeders residing in South Australia.

Naming applications

When lodging a Naming Application participants are advised to allow at least two weeks for the name to be approved from Greyhounds Australasia and then for GRSA to process the application and issue a greyhound card and weight card.

Therefore, should you wish to nominate the greyhound GRSA suggests that you lodge the Naming Application three weeks prior to nominating, this will give GA, GRSA and yourself enough time to name the greyhound and issue documentation. This time frame could be further extended if GA requires more name choices.

Council dog registrations

Dogs and Cats Online (DACO), the central database for all dog registrations in South Australia, has generated a mail out of renewals across the State.

Now is a really important time to ensure greyhounds that have left or entered your kennel are updated as it is the responsibility of the trainer or breeder of greyhounds to transfer sold, retired or greyhounds that have transferred kennels to be removed from their council 'list'.

In the first instance, any questions or issues with dog registration should be referred directly back to your local council. Several councils have contacted GRSA looking for assistance with participants who have had difficulty registering greyhounds this year and we will assist if we can, but ultimately council needs to manage their registrations.

It is a requirement of holding a trainer and/or breeder licence with GRSA that you comply with legislative requirements of dog registration and this forms part of a registered kennel address being approved by GRSA to house greyhounds.

GRSA also monitors the prices set by council of individual greyhound and dog permit rates. Prior to registration time, we approached the LGA to lobby for a uniform approach to feesetting. Now we are working with individual councils with higher than average greyhound registration rates to seek financial relief for our participants in those areas.

Communication with disqualified persons or defaulters

All participants are reminded that they could be found in breach of the Rules if they are associating with disqualified persons or persons that are declared a defaulter with GRSA.

This includes commenting and engaging with disqualified persons or defaulters for the purposes of greyhound racing on Facebook and/or greyhound forums i.e. Greyhound Data. These persons have lost their privileges of being associated with our Industry.

In terms of the national Rules, the definitions are below:

"disqualification" in relation to a person or greyhound means disqualified by a Controlling Body or Stewards or pursuant to the Rules of any approved controlling authority or thoroughbred, harness or greyhound racing club.

"defaulter" means a person, declared by the Controlling Body or an authorised person to be a defaulter, who is in default in respect to the payment of any money payable to the Controlling Body or a club, including any prize monies directed to be returned to the relevant Controlling Body or club.

GRSA collates a list of persons disqualified, suspended, warned off, subject to inquiry and who are declared a defaulter. In the first instance, if participants are unsure of the status of a person, they are encouraged to contact the Integrity department to seek clarification of that persons status to ensure they do not find themselves inadvertently breaching a Rule.

Police matters affecting registration

GRSA reminds all participants it is a part of your licencing conditions that if you become convicted of an offence punishable by fine or imprisonment whilst registered, you must notify GRSA within forty-eight (48) hours of such a charge.

Details of the offence must be provided in writing to the Integrity Manager and will be handled confidentially. Whilst the nature of the offence may not have any effect on the conditions of your licence, it important for GRSA to be advised rather than to find out through another avenue. Any questions on this can be referred to Lisa Michalanney.

Notification of samples returned from the racing laboratory

The Integrity department offers a service to trainers who wish to receive notification when their samples have been cleared with Racing Analytical Services Limited (RASL).

This service is only available to SA registered trainers and is sent via e-mail. Trainers please note that out of competition testing is not advised in the service.

Selling of greyhounds to unlicensed persons

GRSA has been alert to a number of transfers recently where greyhounds have been sold to persons who are not currently registered as an Owner.

Sellers should understand there is a risk selling to unregistered persons as you may run into a hurdle if GRSA determines not approve an Owner registration. Sellers are welcome to contact the office prior to sale to confirm the bonafides of a potential buyer.

DACO BRN on ads

All registered greyhound breeders are reminded that The Dog and Cat Management Act 1995 requires all South Australian breeders who sell greyhound they have bred, must be registered with the Dog and Cat Management Board.

These breeders advertising dogs they have bred for sale must display their DCMB Breeders Registration Number in all advertisements, including any advertising through GRSA publications.

Local Rules for Integrity Hearings Panel

Local Rules have been prepared and approved by the GRSA Board to allow for the newly formed Integrity Hearings Panel to hear and adjudicate on matters deemed serious offences. These Rules became effective 1 June 2019 and can be found updated in the online Rulebook.



Do you or someone you know have a small dog that could benefit from some socialisation and company during the day?




Latest updates from GAP

Living up to the hype

MOUNT GAMBIER

Even ordinary weather conditions at Tara Raceway on Sunday 14th failed to deter patrons from leaving the comfort of the cosy wood-heated clubrooms and venturing outside to catch a glimpse of the greyhound everyone had been talking about – Galactic Zeus.

Already, his sister Galactic Athena had won this year's Fairthorne Forestry Mount Gambier Cup and his brother Galactic Titan only a few nights' earlier had won his way through to the Champion Puppy Final at Angle Park.

But Galactic Zeus was better than both of these, or so the word went. Reportedly, there had even been a couple of 400 metre track records run on trial mornings – a few setbacks along the way holding up his race debut until last Sunday.

He's another one of the Paddy Whacker x Galactic Rumball litter bred and raced by Robert Chuck of Moorak and trained at Worrolong by Steve Bartholomew.

And the smart punters were quick to snap up the \$1.45 on offer about Galactic Zeus, who at 38 kilograms towered above his opposition as the field made its way to the 400 metre boxes for the Klaassens Contractors Maiden Stake.

Lektra Phyliss, having her first start for another local trainer in Noel Perry, quickly took up the running from box eight but Galactic Zeus had her measure by the first split, clocking 10.95 seconds before finishing the race off in fine style with a 5½ length win over the early leader.

Overall, the brindle dog ran 22.91 seconds – the quickest at Tara Raceway this year – his run home time of 11.96 seconds posing the question as to whether any greyhound had ever finished off a 400 metre race in quicker time.

Long-time track watchers at Tara Raceway on Sunday could not remember a quicker run-home time. And spare a thought

for Lektra Phyliss, whose time of 23.30 seconds would win most maiden 400 metre races.

From a maiden point of view, Galactic Zeus' winning time was second only to Wise Stella who ran splits of 10.74 seconds and 12.15 seconds when clocking an overall time of 22.89 seconds almost 12 months ago to the day.

By another way of a comparison, the Tara Raceway 400 metre track record, run on Friday, February 19, 2016, is held by Cryer's Ricky at 22.78 seconds – with splits of 10.67 seconds and 12.11 seconds.

A repeat performance from Jones

GAWLER

Eden Valley trainer Jan Jones, claimed her second Gawler Produce Final in three years, when her runner Star Anise was able to comfortably win the event on Sunday night. First run in 1975, the Produce is a "paid up" Series conducted over three weeks, and this year's was restricted to greyhounds whelped in 2017.

Star Anise drew the coveted box 1 in the 531m event and used it to full advantage to lead from Stitch 'Em Cilla (7) and Oakvale Beauty (2), as they ran out of the straight the first time. Star Anise then showed her rivals a clean pair of heels to open up a big break. Star Anise was never challenged and maintained a handy break to the wire, winning by six lengths and recording her personal best time of 30.70 secs. Stitch 'Em Cilla ran second for Clint Trengrove of Lewiston and Oakvale Beauty was in third place for Nathan Wilson of Pinnaroo.

Star Anise is trained at Eden Valley by Jan Jones and raced in partnership with her husband Tony. Known as "Tilly" in the kennel, she was obtained from a breeding deal with long time Victorian racing friends, Merv and Kay King. Jan and Tony were very keen to take the pups, as they were bred from a front running, city winning female in Melbourne. They secured a pair of pups at three months of age and then reared them through to the education stage, before also taking on the training duties. Unfortunately the other pup was unsuccessful and is now a pet on their property, but Star Anise showed a lot of ability, with a results record now of nine wins and six placings from 19 starts. She has a great record at Gawler, with three wins and a placing from five starts there and a career perfect score from four starts out of box 1.

Jan said that she has learnt in racing that things don't always pan out as you think, and that with such a good field, it was very important in this race for Star Anise to lead. Jan and Tony enjoyed the win, which sees their record in this great event go to two wins, also taking out the 2017 series with Dream A Little. As a result of the win, they were getting plenty of encouragement to breed from Tilly after retirement, so it will be interesting to see if they take up the challenge.

TRIALS ANGLE PARK

ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

Under the new schedule Angle Park Qualifying Trials will be run weekly on Wednesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting (12 days later due to nominations). With 388m racing now available on Monday nights trainers can qualify for all distances.

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Wednesday of the meeting.

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK AND GAWLER BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Tuesday and Friday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the race meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start

2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track

3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA by midday on Monday to nominate. Should the

Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.

- 2. For Gawler Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before.
- 3. For Murray Bridge Wednesday, the trainer is to contact

GRSA by 4.30pm the day before. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.

- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
 Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be

permitted to leave with Stewards permission.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER

The Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club will conduct satisfactory trials under the criteria below:

- 1. On race days only when there are less than 12 races scheduled
- 2. These trials must be booked with GRSA by 4.30pm the day before a mid-week meeting and 4pm on the Friday prior if a Sunday meeting.

GRSA reserves the right to alter or amend this policy at any time.
