MESSAGE FROM MATT

Communication

It is evident to me that the quality of the communication between our participants and GRSA staff/Management has probably suffered in some aspects by the challenges of recent times and in response to ongoing change. A big part of greyhound racing moving forward here in South Australia lies in the strength of that relationship and reinforcing the processes which ensure that people are having the opportunity to be heard.

With that in mind, the following items are intended to support that goal:

Raceday Chats

We are currently setting up the system which will support online or raceday office bookings for meetings with specific Managers and senior staff members twice monthly. Over a three month period, this will include three Thursday night sessions (A/P), two Wednesday sessions (A/P) and one Tuesday session (at Gawler) during the early part of a race meeting. We will promote dates and times to the industry based on maximum availability and then allow participants to book in whatever (available) time suits. If there are any teething issues with this process, we will work to resolve them quickly. This will hopefully serve as a convenient and practical opportunity to raise concerns about anything that impacts you as a participant. I urge participants to take advantage of the opportunity for their own benefit and to help us get everyone on the same page.

Raceday Stewards

The following post recently went up on the industry Facebook site in an effort to clarify the importance of participants being able to utilise Stewards as the first point of contact for matters or issues that arise during the running of a meeting:

A couple of bits of recent feedback would indicate, for whatever reason, that participants may sometimes be reluctant to raise raceday-related issues (including safety concerns) with the stewards who are in charge of a given meeting. In the general spirit of trying to foster a better communication flow, we would encourage trainers/participants to view the stewards as their first point of contact for such matters. If they are unable to assist directly at the time, they will raise the matter internally with the relevant Manager and that feedback will guide any relevant actions or response that may be warranted. It will also help to ensure that our Managers have their finger more closely on the pulse of issues as they occur. Our stewards, accordingly, are being encouraged not only to be receptive of feedback, but also to seek it out where appropriate.

Industry Facebook

We have recently had a couple of dealings on the Facebook site which raise the question about what are or are not reasonable expectations of use. To my thinking, that site is a genuinely valuable tool for informing our people and driving constructive discussion around issues of shared importance. However, as with any such site, I would hope that most participants understand that there is always a risk of comments offending other participants or staff or creating other (often unintended) issues. The simple fact is that it's a less than perfect tool for supporting balanced debate on certain issues – particularly true for more sensitive matters – and will, as often as not, facilitate threads that are considerably more harmful and counter-productive than they are useful.

That being the case, a number of posts will be directed to a relevant Manager or member of staff in the first instance with the aim of trying to resolve the query directly. Subject to the outcome of that dealing, any relevant update to the broader industry will be posted back through Facebook at a later point. All such enquiries will be responded to and managed respectfully. Based on previous (site) user behaviour, we would still expect a majority of comments to flow through to the site without the need for this process. Our aim is to ensure that the Facebook site not only remains useful and informative, but also manages to preserve a welcoming and supportive feel.

It's my hope that the opportunity for Raceday Chats (above) will, separately, provide the perfect forum for direct and timely discussion of issues that are of concern to participants and to help build the relationship opportunity.

The next 'live' Q&A session will be scheduled prior to the end of July. Participants may want to express their thoughts on the Facebook site in the interim regarding desired topics for discussion so as to influence which Manager(s) should host that session.

Industry Director Role

The role of the Industry Director, currently held by Dr Chris Doyle is due to lapse on October 31 and is required under the Constitution to be determined by a ballot of licensed persons in the weeks immediately ahead. The commencement of the nomination process will be advised through Kennel Capers and on the website. A nominee must be proposed by a currently licensed participant.

Final produces a dream result for Jones

After a series of heats and then semi-finals, the Final of the 2017 Produce was run at the Gawler track on Sunday 9th July, with all three placegetters coming from the Barossa.

Trainer Jan Jones provided three of the finalists and Lauren Harris two runners, but there are no guarantees in the finals of classic races. As the lids went up, Long Gully Josh from box 7 quickly mustered speed to cross the field and take the lead from High Eden Snow (4) and Stack The Aces (6).

Down the back straight and Long Gully Josh opened up a break of 3 lengths over Dream A Little (1), which had found a run while sticking to the rails. As they turned into the home straight, the fast finishing Dream A Little stormed home down the outside to narrowly win on the line by just $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, in a great time of 30.84 secs on a heavy track. Long Gully Josh ran a game race to finish second for Paula Hearnden of Angaston, while the fancied High Eden Frost (5) was only a whisker away in third place for Jan Jones.

The winner is trained by Jan Jones at Eden Valley and is raced in partnership with husband Tony. All three of their runners are from the same Banjo Boy and Zardae litter, which they had purchased through a long-time friend in Victoria, but they had reared them from an early age. Jan said that she had nominated for the series about six times over the years, but this was the first time that she had runners in the Final. Jan and Tony have been in greyhounds for



some twenty years and after racing at the Gawler track, they had quickly become aware that the race is something special. To now win it was a big thrill, as Jan said it is always "anybody's race".

Jan said that although Dream A Little was not as fancied as her other runners, because of the form that Dream A Little had shown in the St Leger, Jan had a sneaky feeling she

could go well. Jan and Tony both enjoy their involvement in the industry and Tony likes the interaction with every one of their greyhounds. With a bonus on offer to the winner of both the Produce and the Gawler Gold Cup, Jan is hoping that the team can contest the upcoming event in November, but in the meantime all three greyhounds will have a short, well-earned break.

A winning month for the Rawlings Kennel

It was a big month of feature race wins for Ben Rawlings and his team winning both the Shane McQueen and the AGRC/GRSA Auction Final.

Rawlings continued his golden run of feature race wins when Allen Oregon was able to lead all the way in the prestigious Shane McQueen Feature Final at Angle Park on the 8th June.

In front of a huge crowd at the venue, a hot field lined up for the main 600m feature for the year, with the race full of depth and quality. Allen Oregon was sent out one of the favourites alongside Zipping Zeus for Tony Rasmussen and Purpose Driven for Cameron Butcher. Allen Oregon had opened up a race winning break off the back straight and careered away from his rivals to win by 4 lengths in a handy 35.13. Zipping Zeus had no luck during the run and was an eye catching effort to get home hard for second just ahead of Purpose Driven who battled on solidly for third.

Allen Oregon has now won 19 races with 18 placings from 65 starts with career prizemoney just over \$103,000. Over the 600m his record stands at 4 wins from his 5 starts.

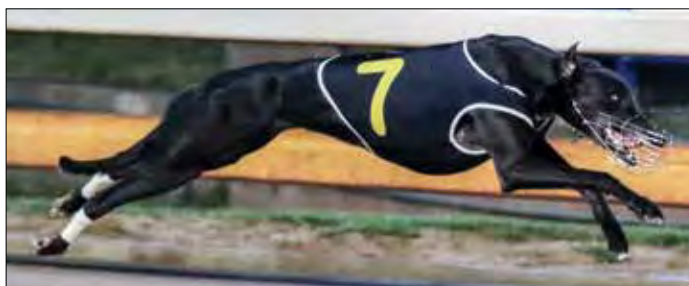
The AGRC/GRSA Auction Final was the following Thursday night with Rawlings sending out Kung Fu Mary against an even field.

Locally bred by Tina Cattermole, Kung Fu Mary was at double figure odds with many believing whilst she had plenty of speed she may not be able to sustain her efforts over the 515m journey. With a sizzling start she ran to the front on the first turn and went on to record a stirring victory by 1 length in a solid 30.37 for the 515m journey. The beaten brigade all made ground late but couldn't reel her in. Springvale Hope ran a nice second for Gavin Harris while Fast Fyfe for Kerry Stagg claimed third in a fast drive to the line. There were plenty of hard luck stories out of the race with less than 10 lengths separating all 8 greyhounds however Kung Fu Mary made her own luck at the start of the race.

The Auction final was for greyhounds that were purchased

through the 2015 Greyhound Auction held at Angle Park and is a culmination of almost 2 years preparation for these greyhounds by their owners and trainers in making the feature final.

Kung Fu Mary is the daughter of Nolen and Hilltop Snow purchased by Neil Rawlings for \$4,000 at the sales. She is now in the ownership of the Portlana Syndicate managed by Trevor Thiele and has the record of 9 wins and 5 placings from 20 starts and prizemoney just below \$25,000.

The Auction was reintroduced in 2014 and with the continued support of the Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club, owners and breeders there will be another Auction at Angle Park on Sunday 29th October.

Owners and trainers are reminded that the Oaks & Derby at Angle Park are fast approaching. A reminder to trainers about the eligibility and conditions of both these series which has our races listed as one of the few AGRA Age Restricted Classics for the season.

The whelping date of both the Oaks and Derby is for greyhounds whelped 27 months prior to the heats so to be eligible for both series your greyhound will have to be whelped on or after 1st June 2015. The other requirement is that Maidens are ineligible so your greyhound has to have won a race. The series are two week series with Open Heats and a Final. The Dates are:

Coffex Coffee Oaks (Group 3):

\$4,590 Heats x 8 – Thursday 7th September

\$35,000 Final – Thursday 14th September

- Nominations close Monday 4th September at 9.00am.

BGC Industrial Cleaning Supplies SA Derby (Group 3):

\$4,590 Heats x 8 – Thursday 14th September

\$35,000 Final – Thursday 21st September

- Nominations close Monday 11th September at 9.00am.

2017 National Championships in Queensland

The AGRA National Championships are just around the corner. The National Finals this year will be held at Albion Park in Queensland to be conducted on Friday 25th August. Both the National Sprint and National Distance Finals will carry prizemoney of \$75,000 to the winner.

The State series' for SA will be held at Angle Park on Thursday 3rd August

for the Heats with the State Finals on the 10th August.

The most important date for local trainers to remember is the national closing date for entries. Acceptances for the National Championships will close with GRSA on Thursday 20th July at 12 noon. Nominations this year must be lodged via fax or handed into GRSA due to Stat Dec requirements for Queensland.

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the National Acceptance Closing date to be eligible to represent SA. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

On Fire claims another round of monthly awards



Greyhound of the Month for June was the Cameron Butcher trained On Fire who made it back to back monthly awards.

The son of Bekim Bale and Alana Blues was undefeated in June winning all 5 of his starts at headquarters in Free For All company. He was unstoppable winning over the 515m on each occasion with winning times ranging from 29.63 to 29.78 making it

10 straight wins in a row.

At the end of the month, On Fire's record stands at 39 starts with 24 wins and 11 placings with earnings over \$94,000.

The Run of the Month for June was again awarded to the Cameron Butcher trained On Fire who sizzled around the Angle Park loam on Thursday 29th June over the 515m recording a blistering 29.67 win in winning by 3 lengths after finding plenty of trouble in the small field.

On Fire could have been selected from any of his winning performances in June.



New winning post for Angle Park in August – Angle Park shutdown

The New Winning Post will be installed in August however for this to occur Angle Park will be out of action for almost two weeks.

To best fit in with the schedule this will be done immediately after the State Finals of the Nationals giving sufficient time prior to the Oaks and Derby series in early September. 2017 AGRC/GRSA Greyhound Auction on 29th October

The Greyhound Auction will again be held in October 2017 to be conducted on Sunday 29th October.

Nomination Forms for the Auction will be sent out shortly to Breeders/Owners and will be available from GRSA. The closing date is 4pm on Friday 18th August 2017. The conditions have changed from last year due to breeding numbers and processes.

The main changes are –

- Extension of dates for eligible pups – increased to 1st October 16 to 30th June 17
- This will be a Reserve Auction with the vendor to pay commission on Reserve price if passed in to be eligible for the Race Series.

Conditions below -

Auction Date: 29th October 2017

Whelping Dates: 1st October 2016 to 30th June 2017

Entry Fee: \$50 per pup (non-refundable)

Commission: 11%

Minimum Upset Price: \$500

Fees to Enter Race Series: Nil

Race Series Dates: June 2019 (Greyhounds 23-32 mths old)

Race Series Stakes: 1st- \$16,000, 2nd-\$5,000, 3rd- \$2,500, Unpl- \$500 (if more than 50 pups)

Breeder/Nominator Bonuses: 1st- \$3,500, 2nd-\$2,500, 3rd- \$1,500 (if more than 50 pups)

Special Conditions:

- Greyhounds purchased through the auction that are not SA Bred will be allowed the same grading exemptions in regards to Grade 6 and Juvenile races as locally bred greyhounds
- The main race series Heats and Final are scheduled for June 2019. One month before (May) there will be a Wednesday 388m series with Heats and Final for pups sold at the auction. There will also be a Wednesday heats 515m and Final Thursday night 515m held in July the month after the main race series

MYOZCHASE INTRODUCTION

GRSA has now gone Live with MyOzChase which will provide an easy way for participants in the Greyhound Racing Industry to perform transactions online that previously had to be completed manually and via paper-based Forms.

The portal available on the GRSA website will also improve communications between participants and Greyhound Racing Controlling Bodies. The MyOzChase website is not only designed for use on PC's and laptops, but is also compatible with most versions of Android and iOS mobile devices, tablets and iPads, thus supporting industry interaction on-the-go.

GRSA has contacted participants in regard to their log in details etc.

MyOzChase will initially be offering the following functionality to users who register, obtain a log-in and complete a once-off identity verification prior to transacting online with their Controlling Body:

- Online updates of personal details
- View all their associated greyhounds (as an Owner, Trainer, Custodian, etc.)
- Submit Notifications of Retirement for greyhounds
- Submit Trainership and/or Kennel changes for greyhounds (replacing the current Kennel Notification or Notice of Training / Removal Form) *Please note should you wish to transfer a previous Victorian trained greyhound into your kennel you will need to do this via the Online Nomination portal.
- Link through to the Online Nominations website (for Trainers only)

Further enhancements will be made to some of the current screens as we strive to provide improved functionality to industry participants. In particular, filtering and sorting will be added to the My Greyhounds screen to allow users to break down the list of greyhounds on display.

Just a reminder that your My Greyhound list shows any greyhound to which you currently have an association with (as an Owner, Trainer or Custodian according to the data available in OzChase), so you may need to retire, change Trainership or change kennels on some of them.

The functionality to be available on MyOzChase will increase over time to offer some or all of the following:

- Submit transfers of un-named greyhounds
- Submit and pay for transfers of named greyhounds
- Submit and pay for naming applications

- Submit and pay for ownership transfers
- Submit and pay for new licences
- Submit and pay for licence renewals
- Submit (and pay, if applicable in your State) for new Ownership Group or Syndicate applications
- Submit whelping notices
- Submit nomination of a Dam to be registered for breeding purposes
- Submit request for breeding exemptions for a Dam
- Submit request for breeding leases
- Submit and pay for litter registrations
- Submit and pay for duplicate Greyhound ID Card, Pink Card or Person Licence Cards
- Submit and pay for non-FSI breeding services
- Pay a fine or late fee
- Update greyhound vaccination details
- Upload a new photo as an update to personal details
- Access to various reports, such as view prize money split, view nominated greyhounds in account, etc.
- Deliver tailored, State-specific content to participants via their preferred method of communication (including the ability to opt in or opt out of future communications)
- Integrate Online Nominations and related functions into the MyOzChase website.

Additional information will become available on MyOzChase in the future to allow the general public, who register to use the website, to:

- Search for a greyhound in the system and be able to view a summarised list of greyhound data
- View race performances for a selected greyhound
- View the Trainer database (only those who have agreed to have their details published) to seek the services of a Trainer for a greyhound.

Current OzChase Online Nominations Users

Participants who currently use OzChase Online Noms can use their Online Noms password for MyOzChase and do not need to create another log in.

Online Noms and MyOzChase are both connected to the underlying OzChase system, hence their passwords will always be the same.

Time Grading update

GRSA has been working at achieving some of the outcomes from the recent Grading Review Panel meeting held on 28th April 2017. Some items like cascading reserves need to be implemented by OzChase however some do not.

We will be able to include greyhounds with 0 – 2 starts so every greyhound nominated will be eligible for consideration. The table below details the rating for 0-2 start greyhounds -

“A greyhound with 0 starts will be given a rating of 10 as a starting point. At its second start it will have the average of 10 and its first start. At its third start, it will be the average of the 2 lowest ratings, including the base rating of 10. ie if had 12, 12 from 2 starts, it will be $10 + 12 / 2 = 11$ ”

For “Best to Worst” Time Grading we will be able to include higher graded greyhounds into mixed events if there are insufficient nominations for a single race. The conditions of this are listed below -

“A Grade 4 can be mixed with a Grade 5 however a Grade 3 will not unless there is also a Grade 4 greyhound selected for that time graded race”

GRSA has also started to program some category Time Grading meetings. These meetings are for greyhounds that are Maidens, 1 – 4 wins and 5 plus wins all time graded “lowest to highest”. Please refer to the All Tracks calendars for details.

Qualifying trials to move to Wednesday's at Strathalbyn

After consultation with the Strathalbyn GRC the monthly qualifying trial session will move to Wednesday nights.

The Club will still run on the rotation with Friday and Wednesday depending on when the race meeting is programmed. All qualifying trials will need to be booked through GRSA as per normal by 12.30pm on the day of the Qualy trials.

All bookings for normal trials will now also be taken by the Club. As they do on Wednesday nights they will now also take the bookings for Friday nights. You can book trials via text MSG / or call Yvonne King at the Club on 0407 334 349 between 9am & 11am on the day of the trials.

GRSA thanks the support of Yvonne and the Strathalbyn GRC in regard to these changes with qualy trials and bookings.

- Juvenile, Juvenile/Maidens and Maidens (that have not won on the circle will all be graded as 4 dog events). This will protect the more inexperienced greyhounds.
- Maidens (that have won 1 or more races on the circle), Novice, 1 stake, open etc will be graded as 8 dog events

This is all still dependent upon nominations received. The Club will run 16 dog events for the Waterloo Cup, Oaks and Derby as per normal, depending upon nominations.

From the Stewards

Licensing time

GRSA thanks participants for being patient with the licensing process and full mailout of new licence cards means all registered persons should be in receipt of their cards.

Participants will notice this year lanyards are attached to their cards allowing the option of them being worn. Please note GRSA Officials will shortly undertake random inspections on race day to ensure all persons handling greyhounds are correctly registered.

Reminder about race day issues

Stewards remind all participants they are the first point of contact for all race day related matters including safety concerns.

Please see them directly for any queries. If they are unable to assist you directly on race day, they will pass on your message to the relevant GRSA manager (maintenance, integrity, racing, etc) who will contact you as soon as practicable.

Third party retirement information

A new document has been created by the GRSA Animal Welfare staff to help new owners to understand the needs of retired greyhounds rehomed to a third party.

The handout includes information like how to get their greyhound a green collar via GAP, how to change the ownership details linked to the microchip and basic information regarding greyhound care. The document can be found on the GRSA website under Industry/Forms and handouts will be distributed during kennel inspections.

Endorsements to be removed for marring or failing to pursue

Stewards remind trainers and owners the onus lies with them in relation to making an application for a marring or failing to pursue offence to be cancelled after ten (10) races.

The relevant Rule is below:

R70 Cancellation of marring or failing to pursue endorsement or recording

- (1) Where the Controlling Body Register, Certificate of Registration or Weight Card of a greyhound contains one endorsement for having offended pursuant to Rule 69 for marring another greyhound or Rule 69A or 69B for failing to pursue the lure with due commitment, and that greyhound competes in not less than ten (10) Events, excluding a course,

without again having the Controlling Body Register, its Certificate of Registration or Weight Card, or endorsed for a similar offence, the Controlling Body may, upon application by the owner or trainer, cancel the endorsement. Only 1 application may be made pursuant to this Rule in respect of any greyhound.

- (2) Where the Controlling Body cancels an endorsement, that one cancelled endorsement shall not be treated as a prior offence for the purpose of determining the length of the period of suspension to be imposed on a subsequent offence or application of Rule 69B.

Inquiries and notifications

Mr. Brodie Jessup – Racing Appeal Tribunal 16/06/17 – GAR 83(2) - Failed to present the greyhound ASA FLYING SPUR free of any prohibited substances DEXMETHYLVENLAFAXINE for an event at Angle Park on 15 December 2016. Mr. Jessup's appeal was heard in part before being adjourned and withdrawn by the appellant. Penalty of three (3) months disqualification stands beginning 27/06/17.

Mr. Tracie Price – Racing Appeal Tribunal 16/06/17 – GAR 83(2) – Failed to present the greyhound FLYING FLUTTER free of any prohibited substance PHENOBARBITONE for an event at Mount Gambier on 01/01/17 and 22/01/17. Mr. Price pleaded guilty to both charges and was suspended for a period of two (2) months and fined \$5,000. Suspension commenced midnight 21/05/17. Mr. Price's appeal was dismissed and penalty stands.

Mr. Wayne Verrall – Racing Appeal Tribunal 16/06/17 – GAR 86(ah) – Associating with a currently disqualified person. Mr. Verrall pleaded not guilty and was disqualified for a period of three (3) months to commence midnight 21/05/17. Mr. Verrall's appeal was dismissed and the penalty of three (3) months disqualification stands as Mr. Verrall failed to make payment of outstanding fines of \$800.

The Golden Rules

– Avoidance of Prohibited Substance Breaches

In noting that we have seen recent Cobalt and Arsenic threshold breaches, it serves as a timely opportunity for GRSA to remind participants – in their own best interests – that there are a number of Golden Rules that can help them to avoid making any such breaches (for prohibited substances generally) and which should be adhered to as principles of best practice:

- Always consult your vet to seek guidance in relation to any of the products that you are using, any associated risks, and other relevant context
- Review the range of any feeds or supplements that you typically purchase and, wherever it is reasonable to do so, replace products containing substances that could contribute to a threshold breach under the rules (eg. cobalt) with alternative products
- Observe the instructions on any products that you use and adhere strictly to those directions (having regard for prescribed amounts, frequency of administration/application, methodology for administering/applying)
- Refrain from the use of injectable treatments (eg. Vitamin B12) to any extent that is practical
- Refrain from any treatment of a greyhound on raceday other than as relates to its feeding and drinking requirements (GAR83(a)(1) treats this as a specific offence)

Our registered participants have the ultimate responsibility to ensure that greyhounds are presented free of prohibited substances. This information is offered as advice in good faith only and should not be relied upon as a defence in the event of a breach being recorded.

These Golden Rules will appear in the Integrity section of future Kennel Capers editions on an ongoing basis as a reminder for participants of this responsibility.

New winning post to be installed at Angle Park

Participants have now been advised of the shutdown of Angle Park in mid-August to allow construction of the new finishing post.

Whilst a two week period of construction may seem excessive, the project is quite complex, as the area around the winning post contains all the electrical connections for the track lights and lure system.

Elements of the project will include:

- Removal of temporary post
- Removal of large concrete slab supporting the temporary post
- Remove and replace electrical switchboard servicing track lights and lure system
- Pouring of new concrete slab (and allow adequate curing time)
- Installation of winning post frame
- Installation of signage
- Reinstallation of mirror box, lighting, electrical connections and timing system



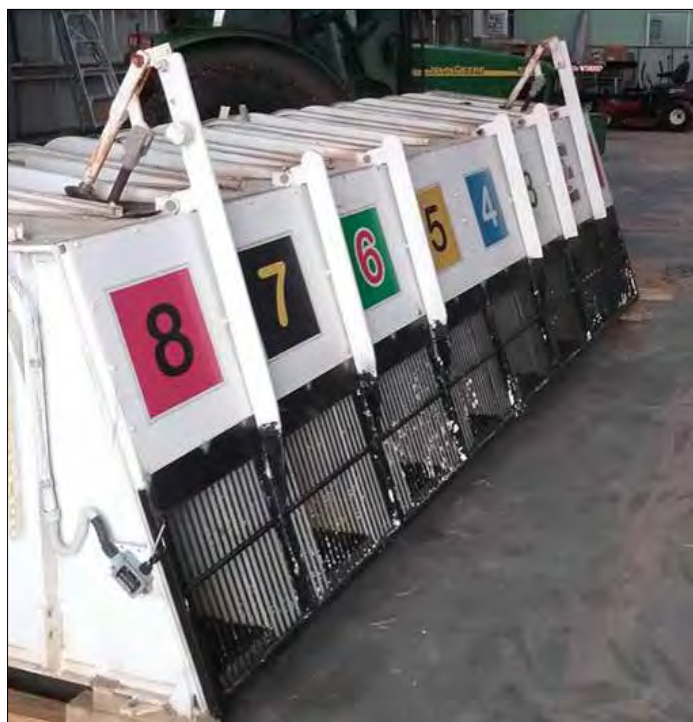
The construction type and design of the new post needed to represent a relatively 'new for old' solution, as the project will be funded from insurance after the old winning post was destroyed by a storm last year.

Mt Gambier 732m start

Staying races at Mt Gambier will hopefully return next month, with the Club currently refurbishing a set of boxes sourced from Victoria. The start is also very popular for trialling over the 277m distance.

Some changes to the starting area need to be made to accommodate the the wider boxes including fencing realignment, pouring of a new concrete pad, new grass matting and addressing some current drainage issues.

The Club is hopeful of programming a staying race at the end of August, however this will obviously be dependent on the installation of the boxes.



Murray Bridge project update

GRSA expects to provide a more detailed update on the Murray Bridge project in the next edition of Kennel Capers.

Mobilong Prison Project

It has been a frustrating couple of months up at Mobilong Prison as the finishing touches are made to the new kennel facility inside the prison.

The majority of works have been completed, however the Department of Correctional Services (DCS) is managing some additional works, including installation of some off-lead areas, a laundry room and equipment installation (benches, freezers, fridges, cabinets etc.)

Unfortunately this is a slow process and GAP is hopeful that greyhounds can start entering the 18 kennel facility within the next few weeks.

Gawler Satellite Semaphore Board

Another small but exciting project aimed at assisting trainers when racing and trialling at Gawler, is the installation of a satellite semaphore board.

This will basically be a small display board at the rear of the existing semaphore board which will face the 400m start, which will show race and trial times in real time.

Once again, equipment has been ordered from suppliers and installation is expected to occur in the coming weeks.



Timing Systems - Emerley Park and Virginia

GRSA is overseeing the installation of new timing systems at Emerley Park and Virginia.

The Emerley Park installation will include timing systems on both the circle track and straight track, which GRSA hopes will increase utility of the venue for training and trialling purposes.

At Virginia, the old timing system will be replaced by a simple yet modern equivalent.

Equipment for both tracks has been ordered and expected to arrive in the coming weeks. The maintenance team will manage the installation which is expected next month, hopefully in time for the Waterloo Cup meeting at Virginia.

Angle Park Track Preparation

The GRSA maintenance team continues to seek the most safe and consistent racing surface possible for all meetings at Angle Park.

Harrowing of the Angle Park track occurred in early May and early June, which has resulted in a slower surface, but a much improved injury rate.

Managing water retention in the surface has been a challenge for the team, however it is felt recent changes to preparation techniques has addressed this issue.

SA Lure to Change Colour

The new blue, yellow and white lure will be rolled out to all SA tracks in trials and then race meets, following trialling at Angle Park over the past few months.

Lure material has been sourced and distributed to all SA Clubs in preparation for the rollout, which will see SA join other states in transitioning to the blue, yellow and white colour.

Research provided by SA veterinarian Jane McNicholl into the vision of greyhounds, provided five main recommendations in regards to lures:

- Lures should consist of violet/blue or green/yellow colours (avoiding orange/red colours)
- a contrast of colours (light and dark) on the lure is recommended
- since dogs see actual movement, the use of flapping tails is recommended
- as dogs have very good hearing, a noise emitted by the lure should be considered
- a standard specified design should be considered for all tracks

IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE:

- From Monday 17th July, 2017
– all SA trial sessions to use new lure
- From Monday 31st July, 2017
– all SA race meetings to use new lure

ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS – NOW WEEKLY

Angle Park Qualifying Trials are run weekly on Tuesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting and the Wednesday APD meeting. Trainers must be specific on their nominations about which day they are trialling for and what distance. (ie Wed 388m, Mon 515, Mon 600m etc)

Tuesday Angle Park Qualifying dates are:

July 25th (for APM meeting on 31st July – for APD Wednesday on 2nd August)

August 1st (for APM meeting on 7th August – for APD Wednesday on 9th August)

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Tuesday of the meeting.

NOMINATING ONLINE FOR QUALIFYING TRIALS

For Angle Park, Gawler and Strathalbyn qualifying trials the nominations must be lodged with GRSA by 12.30pm on the day of the meeting. To nominate online however you can only do this up until 11.59pm the day before. Due to a system security policy you cannot nominate on the day for these trials online. Please contact our staff if you have any issues with these nominations prior to them closing.

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number.

POLICY FOR TRIALS IN PLACE

Remember trials will only be taken from –

- * 12.30pm Monday for Angle Park Tuesday nights
- * 12.30pm Tuesday for Gawler Wednesday nights
- * 12.30pm Thursday for Angle Park Saturday morning (day earlier due to being morning trials)

* For Public Holidays it will be the working day before ie if Monday is a Public Holiday then bookings taken on the Friday

trial days that are not booked in with GRSA remain the same process (ie Gawler Thursday)

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK AND GAWLER BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

RACE MEETING TRIAL POLICY

Angle Park Monday & Wednesday along with Gawler Tuesday, Friday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the Race Meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than 8 greyhounds nominated.

1. Reserves at the Meeting that do not obtain starts.
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located in an area affected by track closures.
3. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged.
4. Satisfactory trials.
5. Other greyhounds.

PROCEDURE/CRITERIA

1. For Monday nights trainer to contact GRSA between 10.00am and 11.00am on the Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching line.
2. For Angle Park Wednesday, Gawler Tuesday & Friday trainer to contact GRSA between 4.00pm and 4.30pm on the day before.
3. For Gawler Sunday trainer to contact GRSA between 8.00am and 9.00am on the scratching line to nominate.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds Trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards allot the Box for the Greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension or not cleared to race are not eligible to be nominated (these trials are conducted as if they are at a race meeting so all greyhounds need to be eligible at nomination time).
8. Greyhound registration certificate or cards must be produced at kennelling time.

9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilize the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave OR trainers with no other greyhounds will be free to leave following their trial.

If there are 12 races at Angle Park or Gawler there will be NO trials.

The Vet Clinic at these meetings cannot be used to accommodate any greyhounds to allow for extra trialling greyhounds. This policy has been introduced so that participants book in under the policy. The Vet Clinic needs to be available for the Vet and Stewards at race meetings

EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY–

- Thursday nights are kept available for the option for Interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead up to our Group races and also local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead up to a feature race upon request and they will take one of the eight kennels available for trialling ahead of the policy and sit separately to the 4 dog trials. Feature races are considered to be – Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals & any Group race Interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event and nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy.
- If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between this will be conducted as a solo trial and sit separately to the 2 four dog trials.

It is extremely important that trainers book in to trial at these race meetings. If unable to book in at these times then please contact GRSA where permission may be given to accept a booking outside of these times. .

MOUNT GAMBIER

The Mt Gambier GRC committee advises that satisfactory trials can be run in the summer months under the criteria below.

1. On race days when there are less than 12 races.
2. On race days with 12 races when the temperature is 30 degrees or less trial can be run before the first race but greyhounds must leave the track straight after the trial to head back to their home kennel.
