CEO'S UPDATE

What Happens Next?

After months of disruption due to the Covid restrictions which have impacted our business, I'm hopeful that we are beginning to see light at the end of the tunnel. So what lies ahead?

First of all, we have continued to liaise with SAPOL – as recently as twice in the past two weeks – seeking to ease restrictions upon our raceday operations and to allow limited catering. Our most recent submission contemplated GRSA providing basic meals and drinks to trainers and handlers during the course of a race meeting. The response that we have received to this point has been unequivocal – “no food, no drink and no softening of restrictions...for the moment.” In noting that we continue to hear of contrary outcomes for some other organisations [not all of which are ‘apples for apples’] I would observe that SAPOL is utilising a team of people to respond to such requests and, to some extent, the response that we receive is that particular person's subjective interpretation of the guidelines. The process lends itself to some mixed results and our first responsibility is simply to work with it. We're drawing ever closer to normal.

The decision was made this week to restore normal Category 3 level stakemoney at Mt Gambier. That region has been disproportionately impacted by the events of recent months and require special assistance. The Clubs proposed that change and it was readily supported by GRSA. One part of being a healthy industry is that we look after people when they are in particular need. The Mt Gambier region will not know ‘normal’ until the Victorian border restrictions have been lifted.

As for the lifting of broader stakemoney restrictions and reinstating remuneration levels for Management, an announcement on this can be expected in the coming fortnight. On this front, I can only thank everyone in our racing and administration ranks for the patience and pragmatism they have demonstrated in relation to those short-term changes. Given that we appear to have gone a long way towards avoiding any forced shut-down of racing due to Covid-related considerations, the clear opportunity presents to get everyone back on their feet as quickly as possible.

From a racing perspective, our primary objective in the months ahead is to preserve our current schedule and potentially add one [final] meeting to our weekly rotation. Free movement of dogs across the Victorian border will help to quickly grow our race meeting supply and we will take whatever reasonable steps may be necessary to secure that additional meeting opportunity so that we have the foundation from which to build on in the years immediately ahead. In support of that growth objective, and noting that much of the heavy lifting has been done in relation to racing and Club infrastructure, GRSA's focus is about maximising the return to trainers, breeders and owners so that they operate as viably as possible under the South Australian framework.

Despite the inconvenience and the challenges of recent months, we're actually better placed than many to push forward from a strong base as we embark on a broader period of recovery.

Lucy chalks up another feature for Cameron

One feature race win over the years that has eluded Meningie trainer Cameron Butcher has been the Group 3 Howard Ashton, however, on Thursday 1st June his star chaser Coorong Lucy rectified that honour role for him in devastating fashion.

Cameron has won almost every feature race on the local racing calendar including the Group 1 National Sprint Final at Angle Park with the brilliant Worm Burner back in 2016. In some nice synergy Worm Burner is the sire of Coorong Lucy and Howard Ashton was one of the first people Cameron came into contact with when he started his involvement many, many years ago.

The darling of SA greyhound racing was sent out a short-priced favourite on the back of her brilliant 29.46 win in her Semi-Final. In a much stronger field, she repeated the dose again and from box 7 exploded from the lids. She ran her first split in a blistering 4.34 racing to the front. Long Gully Barny for Paula Hearnden also showed his terrific early speed and pushed up from box 1 to land second with Born Lovely for Ben Rawlings beginning better than expected up on his outside. Boombox Charlie for Petar Jovanovic, Toora Ziggy for Laurie Cahalan and Wooden Tiger also for Petar, positioned themselves just off the pace. Into the back straight and Coorong Lucy burnt away in the lead with Long Gully Barny into a clear second while Born Lovely held third and moved to the outside. The pace was hot with no greyhound really able to make any ground on the leaders from the rear. Off the back straight and Coorong Lucy was low flying, out by a few lengths while Long Gully Barny was challenged strongly by Born Lovely who was running a bold race. As heads turned for home Coorong Lucy was out by 3 lengths and going strongly, Born Lovely ran to a clear second and tried hard to bridge the gap while Long Gully Barny came under pressure to hold third from Toora Ziggy, Boombox Charlie and Wooden Tiger which were charging late. Down to the line and Coorong Lucy showed her class by going onto win by 3 lengths in a sizzling 29.57 from a gallant Born Lovely in second. A further 2 lengths away in third



was Wooden Tiger who charged home late and looks like the longer journeys will suite him in the coming weeks, just nosing out Toora Ziggy.

Coorong Lucy is owned locally by Cameron and Yvonne Butcher and was bred by Cameron being by Worm Burner and Molly Be Nimble. In fact, Worm Burner sired the first three placegetters in Thursday's feature which is an outstanding effort in itself.

Coorong Lucy only turned two in March and now has the impressive record of 25 wins from just 34 starts including 6

minor placings and prizemoney just over \$102,000. Who knows where the darling of SA sprinting heads but most locals hope we see her strutting her stuff locally for many more months to come.

Thursday night's feature race was named in honour of GCA Hall of Fame member, Howard Ashton. Howard was instrumental in the professional running of Greyhound Racing in South Australia for many, many years as an Administrator of the Industry. He started his journey at Angle Park almost 50 years ago and only retired from the industry a few years ago.

The Truck keeps on rolling at Angle Park

Sir Truculent continued on his winning way at Angle Park, in capturing the prestigious Shane McQueen Feature Final over the 600m distance.

The son of Worm Burner and Establish is locally owned, bred and trained by Wally Harkins with his star greyhound giving him some of his biggest highlights in racing over the last 12 months. He has now won 12 of his last 16 starts, 10 of them over the 731m including the Stayer's Cup and the last two over the middle distance at headquarters, pocketing the Heat and Final of the Shane McQueen along with the \$7,995 first prize tonight.

It wasn't easy for Sir Truculent, he had to combat a high quality field, he drew the outside box and entering the back straight he was back near last and wide with his main rivals Two Times Twice for Ben Rawlings and Holy Reign for Robyn Mackellar high balling in the lead. However, there would be no doubt of his strength as he began to gather in the lead division down the back straight. Two Times Twice was going well in the lead with Holy Reign being challenged by the Damien Bates trained Ask Me Know for second as they left the back straight. Sir Truculent was still 6 or 7 lengths of the lead and wide but was beginning to motor home. Turning for home Two Times Twice was still going well and looked as if he shook off his rivals until the big black dog came thundering home, two to his one in the shadows of the post, with Sir Truculent going onto win by almost 2 lengths. His time of 34.93 was also slick highlighting what an amazing performance this was. Two Times Twice finished second with Ask Me Now back in third but take nothing away from Sir



Truculent, he gave his rivals a start and a beating.

Sir Truculent has now won 19 races with 19 placings from 48 starts with career prizemoney just under \$80,000.

This was the 17th running of the event, named in the memory of former GRSA CEO, Shane McQueen who tragically passed away in May 2003. Shane worked with the Office of Gaming in Western Australia and then as the Operations Manager with Greyhounds WA before moving his family across the border and joining Greyhound Racing SA as the CEO back in 1998.

Updated boxing procedures

Following COVID-19, all greyhound States nationally amended their boxing procedure to 4 waves of 2 dogs.

GRSA has reviewed the procedure and will now be boxing in 3 waves:

1 – 4 – 7

2 – 5 – 8

3 – 6

For G-SIX it will be in 2 waves. This was implemented at all tracks from Tuesday.

We are continuing to work with Government on a plan to returning to a regular boxing procedure.

2020 Gawler Produce heats

All eyes will focus on Gawler Friday, 19th June when some of the best young and performed chasers will do battle in the \$2,000 Heats of the 2020 Gawler Produce. The likes of Spring Vinnie, Shadow Burner, Wooden Tiger, Oakvale Style, Born Lovely, Worth A Shout, Long Gully Barney and Air Marshall will all contest the series.

With 4 Heats the first four placegetters will qualify for the \$2,700 Semi-Finals on Friday, 26th June with the \$22,000 Final and \$2,700 Consolation on Sunday, 5th July.

The winner of the Final is also eligible for a \$8,000 bonus if it can win the 2020 Gawler Gold Cup later this year. If the winner of the Gawler Produce is SA Bred, there is also a \$1,000 SA Bred Bonus paid to the owner and \$500 bonus paid to the breeder.

Group racing national calendar released

Greyhound Clubs Australia has released the 2020/2021 Group Racing Calendar. South Australia will continue with our Group racing for the coming season. We have advised of the prizemoney levels, however, they may revert back to normal levels as we come out of COVID-19 restrictions.

The calendar of events for National Group racing is available on the GRSA website.

Classic and Breeders Futurity payments – due Friday 19th June

Owners of SA Bred greyhounds are reminded that the next batch of Futurity payments are due Friday, 19th June 2020.

The payments due are:

Classic 2020 – Final Payment [Pups born July 18 to December 18]

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound.

Breeders 2021 – Second Payment [Pups born January 19 to June 19]

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

With regard to the First Payment for Classic 2021 [Pups born July 19 to December 19] GRSA has decided to delay these payments due to the current environment affected by COVID-19. This series will now only consist of two sustaining payments, First payment of \$82.50 [\$27.50 + \$55] or Final Payment of \$121 due Friday, 19th December with the Final Payment due in June 2021 for owners who pay the First Payment in December.

The payments for Classic 2020 and Breeders 2021 are unable to be delayed due to races programmed in August for Classic 2020 and having the First Payments already made for Breeders 2021.

Grading Review Panel meeting on Monday 22nd June

Due to some Grading matters requiring some discussion the Grading Review Panel has been brought together and will meet on Monday, 22nd June.

Industry Consultative Group meeting on Friday 7th August

The next ICG meeting will be held on Friday, 7th August. An Agenda is currently being produced and will be available for the panel members prior to the meeting.

2020 SA Champion Puppy heats in July

Owners and trainers of up and coming youngsters should note that the Champion Puppy series isn't far away.

The 2020 SA Champion Puppy Series is for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st July 2018 and is conducted as Heats to a Final series.

The \$4,715 Heats will be run on Thursday, 16th July and the Final on Thursday, 23rd July. Prizemoney for the 2020 Final will be \$8,580.

Nominations for the Heats close on Monday, 13th July with GRSA at 9.00am.

Coorong Lucy makes it a treble of awards

Greyhound of the Month for May is again SA's sprinting star, Coorong Lucy, giving her three GOTM nominations in the first five months of the year. She had a super month of racing winning all 3 of her starts highlighted by a devastating performance in the Group 3 Howard Ashton Final in late May.

The daughter of Worm Burner and Molly Be Nimble started the month off in the Heats of the Howard Ashton at headquarters on a Wednesday where she was professional in leading throughout in a slick 29.79. She then returned to the bright lights of Thursday night in the Semi-Finals at Angle Park and made a statement

to the rest of her challengers running a blistering 29.46 where she shanghaied out of the boxes. She started a short priced favourite in the Group 3 Final and again showed amazing early speed to lead

throughout running a brilliant 29.57 for the 515m journey.

At the end of the month Coorong Lucy's record stood at 34 starts for 25 wins and 6 placings and earnings just over \$100,000.

Sir Truculent wins award with another dominating display

The Run of the Month for May was the Wally Harkins trained Sir Truculent, for his super win at Angle Park in a Free For All over the 731m on Thursday, 14th May.

Sir Truculent has been dominating the staying ranks recently, however, on this night he was even more dominating than normal. He began midfield, raced up to the lead early in the event and then from there it was all about times and margins. He ran a flying 42.74 in winning by almost 11 lengths confirming he is currently the best stayer in the State.

2020 SA Straight Track Championship at Murray Bridge in late July

The 3 x State Straight Track Championships (Healesville, Capalaba & Murray Bridge) have been cancelled this year due to COVID-19. They were to be held at Capalaba in QLD and will now be held in 2021. The 3 States will still run their local series to establish the State's Straight Track Champion.

The \$965 Murray Bridge Heats over the 350m will be run on Wednesday, 29th July and the \$5,000 Final on Wednesday, 5th August.

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Tuesday, 12th May 2020. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

Nominations for the Heats close on Friday, 24th July with GRSA at 9.00am.

2020 SA Distance and Sprint Championship finals in August

The National Championships have been cancelled this year due to COVID-19. They were to be held at Wentworth Park in NSW and will now be held in 2021. SA and other States will still run their local series to establish the State's best sprinter and stayer.

The \$5,120 SA Heats of the Sprint will be run on Thursday, 6th August and the \$8,580 Final on Thursday, 13th August.

The Distance will be conducted as a one off Best 8 on Thursday, 13th August worth \$9,330. GRSA will provide a lead up race depending on numbers for the stayers as required.

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Wednesday, 20th May 2020. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

Sky Racing will also support this series with ALL States conducting their Finals on the same night to be run within a 2 hour period. It makes for a great promotional concept.

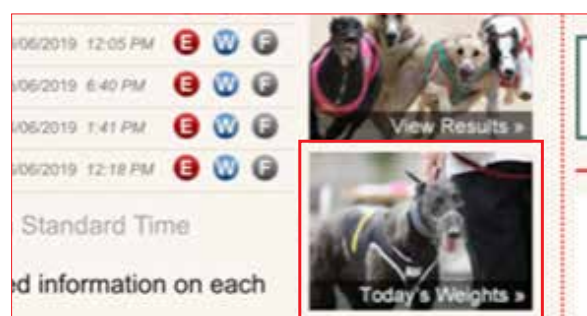
Nominations for the Heats of the Sprint close on Monday, 3rd August with GRSA at 9.00am.

Mount Gambier stakemoney increase

Due to the Victorian Border closure, the opportunity for Mt Gambier to have a viable racing option has been dramatically compromised.

Further to discussions at the recent Members of Company meeting, GRSA and the Clubs expressed support for Mt Gambier returning to normal category 3 levels immediately. GRSA and the Clubs both believe that Mt Gambier needed additional support to remain viable in this difficult time.

Discussions are occurring in the background about stakemoney levels and staff remuneration returning to normal levels in the weeks ahead.

Remote trainers fee to assist Mount Gambier meeting

With continuing border restrictions affecting participation in the South East due to COVID-19, GRSA has decided to support the Mt Gambier Thursday meeting knowing the importance to be racing on a weekly basis during this time.

For those trainers that live more than 150 kilometres from Mt Gambier and travel to this meeting they will receive an additional \$75 payment to their normal Trainers Fee. The fee will be capped at one payment per registered premises and will continue until the borders are open. This has taken effect from the Clubs meeting held on Thursday, 18th June 2020.

2020 Mount Gambier Cup to be run this year

GRSA has re-considered the running of the 2020 Mt Gambier Cup which was postponed/cancelled from March this year.

In reviewing budgets and feature races and making some changes we believe we can support the running of the Mt Gambier Cup so it will be re-scheduled. The event will only be scheduled when borders are opened up by Government and the GRSA Board approve nominations from Interstate. We are supportive of the event being run before the end of the calendar year with an expectation of sooner rather than later. In doing this, the event will have to be conducted at reduced stakes for Final [\$10,000 to the winner] which falls in line with other reductions to feature events across the State during this time.

Interstate greyhounds transferring to South Australian trainers – isolation removed

Restrictions regarding isolation periods for greyhounds and greyhounds that have started inside 10 days in another State have now been removed.

GRSA would still request trainers monitor the condition of any greyhound that comes into their kennel from another State, however, there is no longer any restrictions in place.

Non essential persons oncourse at race meetings

GRSA reminds participants with children that due to the COVID-19 restrictions non essential persons and the public are not allowed oncourse which includes children.

Unfortunately during school holidays this can be difficult for some of our participants to manage, however, they need to make other arrangements for them. GRSA appreciates the significant changes in place for the industry during this time and appreciates the efforts that are being made and continue to be made to abide due to social distancing and restrictions.

Winning Grade 6 races in order

GRSA reminds trainers to win their Grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins, trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

Re-grading for all tracks and distances

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

Murray Bridge Sundays to finish around 8pm

GRSA advise that we have liaised with Sky Racing regarding the finishing times of Murray Bridge on Sundays recently.

With COVID-19 restrictions in place Sky advised that where possible the meeting will finish around 8pm. This will aid participants returning home locally or travelling.

Scratching deadlines and trials booking closing to remain at 3pm

Whilst the Greyhound Racing SA Offices have gone back to closing at 4.30pm.

The scratching deadlines and trial bookings closing will remain at 3pm to assist the management of these processes.

Murray Bridge trials

Satisfactory trials and Qualifying trials are held on a monthly basis on a Friday morning trial session, which has both tracks trialling.

The next trial session will be Friday, 17th July.

Licensing notice

GRSA advises that all licenses expiring on 30th June, 2020 will be automatically extended until 30th June, 2021.

Current purple licence cards will still be valid throughout season 2020 – 2021.

Catcher Licence feedback

Stewards have for some time now been considering our policy around licensing young catchers.

Current policy has a special licence available for “15-16-year-old catcher” which restricts the minimum age to 15 years. Enquiries Interstate reveal all other States allow 14-year-old catchers to some degree. Stewards are seeking input from participants on their thoughts on the subject.

Projects Update

Angle Park Vet Clinic

GRSA is hopeful that by the time the next edition of Kennel Capers is released, that Greg and Daniella will be operating out of their brand-new vet clinic.

These works are nearing completion, with only a few trades remaining to provide the finishing touches on the fit out.

This project has run extremely smoothly, managed brilliantly on the ground by GRSA Maintenance Manager Terry Winder. Management is extremely pleased that the project has run on time and on budget.



GAP Kennel Room and Off-Lead Area

The other project occurring at Angle Park is the improvement of GAP facilities for the housing and daily management of greyhounds onsite.

These works include a 10 bay kennel room under the grandstand, but also an off lead area out the front of the staff car park.

These improvements are important to continue to evolve the capabilities of the GAP network and to provide facilities that genuinely assist in the logistical aspects of greyhound adoption.



Murray Bridge Slipping Track

The last of GRSA's major projects in progress is the slipping track at Murray Bridge.

Works remain on track for completion in the next 3–4 weeks, with the project also running to budget.

GRSA will shortly be in a position to distribute key fobs to participants who have registered their interest, which will allow them access to the site after hours to utilise the training facilities.

New Kennels at Gawler

Participants who have raced at Gawler over the last week will have seen the new stainless steel kennels that were recently delivered and installed.

Gawler is the last SA track to receive the upgraded kennels, which have replaced the old and deteriorating steel versions which have been a maintenance issue for some time.

GRSA has received considerable interest in the old kennel units, which are being offered to participants for free. An announcement regarding allocations and pick up instructions will be communicated shortly.



Remote/Battery Lure Technology

Given the success of the remote/battery lure at the Murray Bridge straight track over the past 18 months, GRSA is committed to transitioning that to that technology at other venues.

In the coming weeks and months GRSA intends to communicate a plan to roll out the new lure at both the Murray Bridge circle track and at Gawler.

The ultimate aim will be the removal of cable driven systems at all tracks in SA, with the remote/battery lure becoming the new norm.

Angle Park Lure Rail

Contractors have again attended Angle Park to undertake repairs and reinforcement to the 49-year-old lure rail.

GRSA hopes these works will mitigate the risk of lure rail failure in the short term, which last occurred a few weeks back resulting in the abandonment of a trial session.

These works are considered temporary measures until such time a decision is made on the upgrade of racing infrastructure at the venue.

McQueen's Upgrades

Management has made a decision to undertake some minor improvements to McQueens Tavern during the hospitality shut down due to Covid-19.

The works will include the removal of the salad bar [result of Covid-19 concerns], purchase of some new furniture and the replacement of the old flooring.

The specific timing of these upgrades has not yet been confirmed, however it is hoped that they can occur over the next couple of weeks before a return to full operations.

Virginia Roadworks

Participants should note that the road next to the Virginia track will be graded over the coming days, with the facility being unavailable for use during these works.

Communication will be sent to participants the day prior to the works taking place, unfortunately this is the earliest notice we will be able to give.

AFTER marrying into the greyhound industry in the late 1960s, Judi Hurley and her family, including grandchildren, have built an empire at their stabling establishment in Two Wells that the family hope will last for generations.

Judi, the matriarch of the whole-family operation along with her sister-in-law Kathy, and while the industry is demanding, it's a very easy thing to fall in love with.

"It's something that you can get into and that you really get satisfaction out of," Judi said.

"When you breed your own pups, to getting them onto the track, it's really a two-year process, so that sort of level of commitment."

"But when they race, it justifies everything you've done - all the late nights, the dramas, racing off to the vets - I think it's really a lifestyle more than a job."

After getting a hold of a promising dog named Eudora Eudora, the Hurleys began breeding 'Emery' dogs, who have become ubiquitous across South Australia, led by Emery Dryad with 27 wins and almost \$40,000 in prize money.

"This business is a little bit like malaria," Judi joked.

"It bites you, and then it keeps coming back. You think you've gotten out of it, but then you come back."

"The majority of them are what we call bread and butter dogs - they're good enough to pay for that kind of keep - but they're definitely not money making machines, more like money costing machines."

Judi reflected on how the industry has changed over the past 50 years, pointing out that in the early days women weren't even allowed to take a dog to the starting boxes.

"It changed in the '70s and '80s when they became more aware, and now I think there are probably almost as equal number of females involved compared to males," she said.

"It's certainly still changing, especially with female involvement... I was the first female appointed to a racing board here in South Australia, and I've always felt supported."



Greyhounds are Hurley women's best friend

Penrice's Kerri Hurley loves her greyhounds.

It could be said it's in her blood, being one of six Hurley women across three generations involved in greyhound racing right now.

Kerri's mother, Judi, became involved with the industry in the late 1960s, when she met and married professional greyhound trainer, Peter Hurley.

Peter sadly passed away from cancer in 2015, but Judi still owns 20 dogs at her Mopps property, and wouldn't have it any other way.

"I'm 74 now. What am I going to do? Kait, my play hound, have one? None of those things appeal to me!" she laughed.

Judi and sister-in-law Kathy Hurley have dedicated much of their lives to the sport, and are well respected matriarchs in the industry.

Kerri grew up with the dogs, and while she spent some time away from the sport, her father's illness brought her back to the family's expansive Two Wells greyhound racing property, Emery Park, in 2013.

"When dad got sick he shut the business down and just focused on their own dogs, so I took over the training," said Kerri.

"It was a big enterprise and a lot of hard work."

"I'd never trained a dog, dad was there to give me support and to help me out and

when I got winners, it was a pretty good feeling."

While Emery Park has since been sold, Hurley greyhounds are still a force to be reckoned with. Judi has already had 40 winners this year, and her loved hound, Moby, is a top breeder in the state.

"It's a good thing that not only her daughter, but her grandchildren and great-grandchildren have continued into the sport."

Kathy's adult granddaughters, Kiah, Jayde and Jannyn, are the next generation of Hurley women to become greyhound trainers, contributing significantly to the industry.

"They're definitely holding their own," said Kerri.

"If they ever left the industry they'd leave a big hole."

Kerri's children, who were each given a greyhound by their grandmother for their birthdays, are involved too.

"My children, Sarah Emery and Madison Emery, who is now retired, Dillon Emery has a young pup that is yet to begin his racing career, and my youngest son, Ryan, is a Shippie dog who is currently racing and has been doing quite well," said Kerri.

In a serendipitous twist of fate, Kerri recently began working for Ja Irvine of Levrier Wines, only to discover that Ja also has a close affinity with greyhounds, evident in the name of her winery: Levrier is the French word for greyhound.

"As soon as Kerri came to work, the story

came out that her mum was a greyhound trainer - so it was sort of like, it had to be!" said Ja.

Levrier Wines is a sponsor of the greyhound adoption programme GAP, and Ja has two adopted greyhounds, Daphne and Georgia, who come to work with her every day.

"It's been over 25 years now since I've had greyhounds because they're just such beautiful breeds," said Ja, who first came across the dogs when she found one on the side of the road, injured and abandoned.

"They can be a little bit naughty, so getting the right person to look after them once they've finished racing is really important."

"The greyhound adoption programme helps get the families and the greyhounds a nice home together."

"They're extremely loyal."

The Hurley women are proud to be representing a sport that has achieved a five per cent increase in female participation over the past five years.

"I definitely do think a woman's touch does help because I think we just have a bit more empathy," said Judi.

"I believe that our involvement has been a tremendous joy to all of us and has only strengthened our love of the breed. It is also essential to have female involvement in all facets of the industry."

Lavish Pedro takes out first Straight Track Cup

Lavish Pedro made a fast impression for his new trainer Richard Stasiak winning the Heat and then first ever Straight Track Cup Final both in track record times!

In fact, we saw multiple track records broken during in the Straight Cup Heats and Final!

The 350m record was broken in consecutive races in the Straight Track Championship Heats with Sweet on Me trained by Ben Rawlings setting the bar at 18.78s before Lavish Pedro trained by Richard Stasiak set it to 18.76s.

When the Finals of the straight track rolled around the next week on Wednesday 27th May, the track record was again broken, and then broken 2 races later in the Final! Danyo's Sarah, trained by Lauren Harris set the new record at 18.75s before Lavish Pedro ran the hands off the clock in the Final setting a blistering 18.66 seconds.

Owned and trained by Richard, Lavish Pedro has now had 51 career starts for 18 wins and 14 placings.

Also of note is the 300m track record was broken by Suspense in his maiden race in 16.27, trained by Kirin Corby on 20th May.

Do you or someone you know have a small dog that could benefit from some socialisation and company during the day?

GAP SA is looking for small dogs to help with their green collar and first point assessments.

Your dog will be well looked after with plenty of pats and treats throughout the day. They will assist with either green collar assessments for dogs that have been living with foster carers or for greyhounds entering the program.

During assessments, greyhounds will be muzzled, on a leash and handled by an experienced assessor and handlers. All dogs will be walked around together in a secure testing area for approximately 5-10 mins to assess the greyhound's reaction to the small dog. If the greyhound is reacting well we will allow them to approach and sniff the small dog.

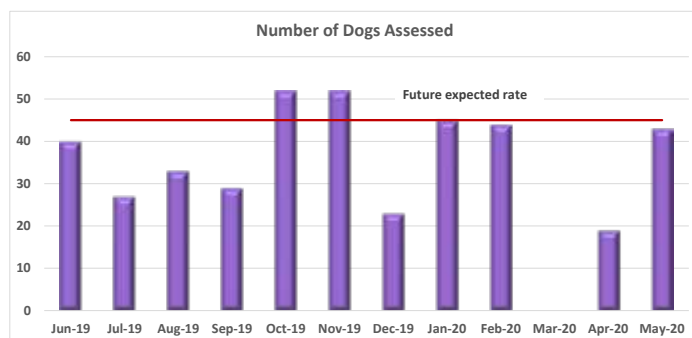

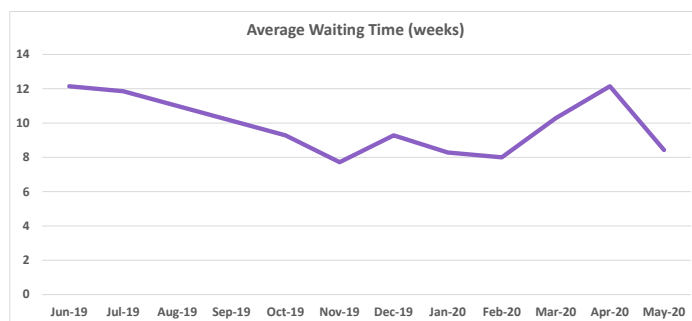
Latest updates from GAP

ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

Under the new schedule Angle Park Qualifying Trials will be run weekly on Wednesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting (12 days later due to nominations). With 388m racing now available on Monday nights trainers can qualify for all distances.

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Wednesday of the meeting.

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Tuesday and Friday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the race meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA by midday on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Gawler Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before.
3. For Murray Bridge Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial.
