CEO'S UPDATE

Industry Representation

It doesn't matter whether you're talking about decisions that are made in greyhound racing, or by your local Council, or at your child's school, all of these bodies rely on stakeholder panels to inform the thinking of their Boards and Committees. The reason for that – it should be fairly obvious – is because it's simply not possible, nor necessarily desirable, to canvass an opinion from everyone. Under our local framework of greyhound racing, those panels include the Clubs themselves, the Industry Consultative Group (ICG) and the Grading Review Panel (GRP).

The Clubs are recognised in our Constitution as the Members of the company and, as such, have legitimate power to vote on matters of special business at general meetings of that group (including the Annual General Meeting). Amongst other things, the Members of Company constitute a majority on the panel which appoints Directors to sit on the Board and oversee the sport. The Constitution also mandates the establishment of an ICG comprising of a mix of individuals who play different roles within the sport such as owners, trainers, breeders and punters.

The Board and relevant Management meet quarterly (at a minimum) with both groups to discuss matters of industry concern. The Constitution contemplates that, whatever skillsets our independent Directors bring to the Board, or to whatever extent the Management and staff of GRSA are experienced in their roles, it's not possible to make effective decisions without an understanding of context at the coalface of the sport.

Individual stakeholders have more than one opportunity to have a voice in the way the sport is run. The most fundamental opportunity lies in being a Member of a Club. Members can openly raise any matters at a general meeting or an annual general meeting and Committees have a responsibility to faithfully represent constituents. For clarity, they are responsible for conveying collective views of their own members rather than those matters which have lacked for general support. All national Clubs also have an opportunity of membership with Greyhound Clubs Australia, with that body playing a similar role in representing the collective position of national Clubs to bodies such as Greyhounds Australasia. Individuals also have the opportunity to become a member of the Greyhound Owners, Trainers and Breeders Association (Virginia) which, in turn, is a member of the national body Greyhound Participants Australia, a body charged with representing on issues affecting participation at a national level.

An opportunity exists currently for industry stakeholders to apply for roles on the Industry Consultative Group. Interested applicants should approach any of our Club Presidents or Secretaries to indicate their availability. Alternatively, please email Sheriden Milam at sheriden.milam@grsa.com.au and she will ensure that the application is passed on to the relevant Club members. Don't miss your chance to be heard.

A 'Victa' victor in the Howard Ashton Final

■ GAWLER

Another major feature race was decided at Gawler greyhounds on Sunday 13th June, with a large holiday weekend crowd in attendance.

This occasion saw the running of the Howard Ashton Final, a paid up race series for SA Bred greyhounds, whelped in the first half of 2019. A prestigious race series with Group 3 status, it was run over the 531m journey, and while usually raced at Angle Park, was one of the feature races transferred to Gawler while that track is having a major update. Four fields contested the Heats, which the following week led into two Semi-finals, and then the \$37,500 Final.

Interestingly only three litters were represented in the Final of eight runners, showing the dominance of those lines in the Series, but also making it a difficult task to separate the runners. A pretty even start however led to some interference on the first turn, and this had an early impact on the field, with further bumping shortly afterwards. When the field finally settled in the back straight, Victa Daryl found himself in front, with Victa Haydn just behind and Victa Grosso not far away.

As they passed the 643m boxes, Victa Daryl was challenged, with Victa Haydn taking the rails run and Victa Grosso an outside run, which saw Victa Haydn going on to win in 31.10 secs. Victa Grosso finished two lengths away in second position, with the unlucky and fast finishing Jack's Well a further length away in third for Cam Butcher of Meningie.

Victa Haydn and Victa Grosso were two of the four Fernando Bale x Victa Victoria litter runners in the race, and were trained by Tony Rasmussen of Murray Bridge, for the My Four Girls Syndicate, managed by Kerry Braun. The litter was bred by Joan Schadow, and the syndicate consists of their daughters.

One of the daughters, Carol Hondow, said after the race that the win was absolutely sensational for Ron and Joan's sake. She added that it is a great present for Ron, who celebrated his birthday on Wednesday. Carol said that their greyhounds have always been a strong family affair, with all the adults and children helping out, over a long period. Carol was highly complimentary of the special job that Tony and Lisa Rasmussen have done with the litter, and have treated them as if they were their own. As a result, the syndicate members have helped out Tony and Lisa in return, wherever they can.

With the litter just two years old, and with each only having a limited number of starts, this litter of "Victas" has shown enough at this stage to suggest that the syndicate will have a great chance of success and enjoyment with them.



Jack's Well finds his best form at Gawler

The Gawler Club has hosted additional races while Angle Park is undergoing a major upgrade and of those was the SA Anniversary Cup, which attracted an excellent field on Sunday May 16.

Heats were run the week prior, with the best performing runners making it through to the Final. With such a speedy field engaged, it was no surprise that four greyhounds were in line across the track as they turned out of the straight the first time.

Zippling Sultan from box 4 charged to the front, with Jack's Well [5] following closely behind. The two dogs then got right away from the rest of the field, and had the race between them. Zippling Sultan held a lead of about two lengths as they raced down the back, but Jack's Well was slowly narrowing the gap. Entering the home straight, Zippling Sultan still lead by a length, but Jack's Well kept trying, and in a tight finish, got up on the line to win by a head. Zippling Sultan was second for Ken Gill of Lewiston, and Spring Vinnie [8] ran into third position for Greg Board of Murray Bridge.

Jack's Well is trained at Meningie by Cameron Butcher, and is raced in partnership with his wife, Yvonne. The Butchers are well known for their ability to produce good dogs on the track, and have established a sensational breeding line. Jack's Well is from a litter from their racing dam Molly Be Nimble, which was bred in partnership with fellow Meningie trainer, Tim Richards. The litter of eight was shared between them, with all dogs making it to the track.

Jack's Well has been an outstanding performer, with 21 wins and 11 placings from just 37 starts. At one stage earlier this year, "Buster" recorded 11 wins from 12 starts. The previous litter from Molly Be Nimble produced Coorong Lucy who was the 2020 SA Sprinting Greyhound of the Year. Yvonne explained that the name of the brindle dog came from an old well that was located on their property, and she had thought that someday it would be a good name for one of their dogs.

It is a bit of a drive from Meningie to race at most tracks, so you have to like what you are doing. Cameron and Yvonne both like the thrill of "getting that good dog", but they enjoy the dogs themselves, considering them to be part of the family, and putting a smile on their face. There would have been a bit extra to smile about on the way home this time.

Jack's Well claims second monthly award

Greyhound of the Month for May was Jack's Well for trainer Cameron Butcher. The son of Aston Dee Bee and Molly Be Nimble had an excellent month of racing, winning three and placing in one of his five starts, with the highlight being the SA Anniversary Cup Final at Gawler.

He started the month off with an unplaced run in the Breeders Prelude [2] Final before a placing in the Heats of the SA Anniversary Cup. He then struck a purple patch of form winning the Anniversary Cup in fine style at Gawler, before two more wins at Gawler against mixed 4/5 opposition, and then a Heat win of the Group 3 Howard Ashton.

At the end of the month Jack's Well's record stood at 39 starts for 23 wins and 11 placings and earnings just under \$70,000.



Craggy Island sets new track record to claim ROTM award

The Run of the Month for May was Craggy Island for trainer Ray Fewings, after his track record performance at Murray Bridge on Monday, 24th May in a mixed 3/4 event over the 395m.

He started from box 6 and quickly ran to the front opening up a nice break on his rivals. He raced away in the front straight to win by almost 8 lengths in a blistering 21.76, setting a new mark by almost .2 of a second.

Gawler Produce Series to kick off on Friday 2nd July

The Gawler Produce series will kick off with the Heats on Friday, 2nd July.

With the changes to feature races due to the Angle Park redevelopment the Gawler Produce series has been pushed back a few weeks to allow greyhounds to compete in the Howard Ashton and Shane McQueen and then be ready for the Produce.

GRSA has also tried to fit in with the City A programming where possible.

50th Anniversary at Gawler in July

In celebration of the 50th Anniversary of the Gawler Greyhound Racing Club there will be a Feature Open Event run on Sunday, 18th July worth a total of \$10,000.

The race will be run over the 531m and will be run on the Gawler Produce Final night.

Champion Puppy moved to August and conducted at Gawler

The Champion Puppy series for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st July 2019 will be conducted in August.

This series is normally conducted in July, however, with changes to feature events it has been moved to August with the Heats on Sunday, 1st August and the Final on Sunday, 8th August. GRSA has committed to running this series in this timeslot and with Angle Park not being ready at this time the series will be run at Gawler and will coincide with the City A meetings.

The Heats will be worth \$5,595 with the Final now worth \$14,275.

- Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Wednesday, 28th July

National Straight Track Championships in Queensland this year

The National Straight Track Championship this year will be held at Capalaba on Sunday, 15th August –with the winner receiving \$25,000.

This year SA will have two SA dogs represent the State in the series with QLD, NSW, VIC and SA challenging for the title.

Our local Heats are listed on Wednesday, 28th July with the Final on Wednesday, 4th August. This will allow 11 days until the National Final to organise travel and trialling arrangements. SA eligibility conditions refer to 76 days out of the last 150 days prior to our nominations closing for the Heats.

GRSA have been advised that Capalaba trial every Friday and Monday, with Monday the ideal day to trial in preparation for a Sunday meeting [National Final].

Capalaba also advise they can accommodate trials on Sunday and Wednesday race meetings. The Club has a Wednesday meeting on 11th August just prior to the NSTC.

The Capalaba Club are more than happy to accommodate the needs of visiting trainers and already have had a number of trainers offer their place for Interstate visitors.

2021 National Championships in Victoria

The GCA National Championships are just around the corner. The National Finals this year will be held at the Meadows in Victoria and are to be conducted on Saturday, 28th August.

Both the National Sprint and National Distance Finals will carry prizemoney of \$75,000 to the winner.

The State series' for SA will be held at Murray Bridge on Thursday, 5th August for the Sprint Heats over 455m with the State Final of the Sprint and one-off Final over 680m of the Distance on the 12th August.

These events have to be run on the same night at the one venue to meet National requirements.

In an effort to support this series ALL States will be conducting their Finals on the same night to be run within a two hour period.

- Nominations this year will close at the normal time with GRSA which will be at 9am on Monday, 2nd August

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Wednesday, 19th May 2021. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

Million Dollar Chase moved to September 25th

Please note that greyhounds can now participate in both the Million Dollar Chase and the Group 1 Adelaide Cup with the dates of both races not crossing over in 2021 due to the Million Dollar Chase final to be run on September 25th this year.

Nominations close 12.30pm Thursday, Qualifying for the following Monday on the One Turn and the Wednesday week on the Straight.

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

Gawler morning trials

With the Gawler trial sessions currently on Mondays and Thursdays starting at 7am, staff are finding that at times that they are waiting for trainers to arrive and trial.

This means there are extended periods where there is no activity. Staff have been advised that if there is an extended period where no one has arrived to trial for them to cease the session. GRSA currently do not take bookings for Gawler but may have to in the future if trainers do not arrive in a timely manner for these sessions.

Grading of City A meetings when Angle Park shutdown

When Angle Park is redeveloped in mid-April the below outcomes have been listed below -

- When Angle Park is shut down for redevelopment that the City A meetings will be shared with Murray Bridge and Gawler. Murray Bridge will conduct back to back Thursday meetings allowing for Heats and Finals of normal and feature races. Gawler will then run back to back Sundays again allowing for Heats and Finals of normal and feature races. This will mean that there is one Metropolitan [CITY A] meeting per week.
- Feature 515m races will be run at Gawler over the 531m and any 731m feature races will be run at Murray Bridge over the 680m.
- There will be a 680m City A prizemoney at Murray Bridge each Thursday every week whether City A or Prov 1 to support these stayers during this period.
- These meetings will be considered as if the greyhounds have never raced at the venue. This will mean greyhounds will be grades Maiden, Grade 6 and Grade 5 to start with unless new into the State and regraded higher.
- With all grades starting from new (no higher than Grade 5 effectively) there will not be as higher prizemoney races per meeting initially with no high grade races being conducted. There will be a Best 8 each meeting over the 455m, 530m, 680m at Murray Bridge and a 531m and 643m at Gawler for this high grade money. [GRSA will just make up these races]. Trainers need to write "No Best 8" on the nomination if they do not want to be in this event. If there are insufficient nominations for a Best 8 the Grader will make up normally graded events based on current policy.
- The Racing Department intends to run Grade 5 Heats on a regular basis but may have to run Mixed 4/5 Heats to ensure there are races for these dogs. The Finals of these races will pay the normal stakemoney for Finals [Grade 5 or Open depending on grade of Heats].
- The Grader will give preference to 455m or higher at both Murray Bridge City A and Gawler City A meetings with the intent that no short course races will be conducted. However, if there was a need to run some short course this would be under "standby" conditions.
- When a greyhound wins a Grade 5 or above over any distance at the Gawler City A and Murray Bridge City A meetings they will NOT lose any Grade 6's at other venues. The normal rule has been suspended.
- If a greyhound has already won a Grade 6 [City A] it should be eligible for Murray Bridge City A and Gawler City A Grade 6 if they have more Grade's to win as these are considered different tracks. They will still only be able to win one City A at each of these meetings if they do not win more races than allowed.
- There will be NO retrospectivity for Grading.

“Beat The Grader” during redevelopment

Our normal race schedule generally doesn't allow for any “Beat the Grader” scenario's, however, with the changes to both Murray Bridge Prov 1 and Gawler Prov 1 this is likely to happen which is an added benefit to owners and trainers.

It will be available for the Murray Bridge Monday Prov 1 to Murray Bridge Thursday Prov 1 and then the Murray Bridge Thursday Prov 1 to Murray Bridge Monday Prov 1.

For Gawler the Friday Prov 1 to Sunday Prov 1 could happen, however, there is only a few days between meetings.

Please contact the Grader for clarification around the “Beat The Grader” policy.

Prov 1 prizemoney for Mount Gambier from July 1

It is confirmed that the increase to Provincial 1 will be from Mount Gambier's Sunday meeting on 1st July, 2021 and will be the same breakdown as Gawler and Murray Bridge.

This meeting will be considered a Provincial 1 meeting for Grading and the grades that the greyhounds currently have for Provincial 2 will carry over to Provincial 1. This was the same process when Gawler split into Provincial 1 and Provincial 2 meetings a number of years ago. Thursday meetings will remain Time Grading under the current format as it has proven to be quite successful over the years, however, the impact of these changes will be monitored by GRSA.

Border Challenge (Mt Gambier v Warrnambool) Series postponed to August

After consultation with the Mt Gambier GRC and Warrnambool GRC the Border Challenge series between the two Clubs has been postponed.

The Mt Gambier series was to be run on the 20th and 27th June, however, due to ongoing SA and VIC border restrictions both Clubs felt it should be postponed to ensure the series viability. The Clubs are looking at reprogramming sometime in August.

The Conditions for the series are:

Maximum of 2 Heats. If 1 Heat first 4 through, if 2 Heats first two through to \$5,800 Final over 512m at Mt Gambier.

Trainer must have had starters at 15 Mount Gambier meetings in the past 12 months.

Trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 3 months.

Greyhound must have started at least four times in the past 12 months at Tara Raceway.

Classic and Breeders Futurity payments – due tomorrow (Friday 18th June)

Owners of SA Bred greyhounds are reminded that the next batch of Futurity payments are due on Friday, 18th June 2021. The payments due are:

Classic 2021 – Final Payment [Pups born July 19 to December 19]

This payment is for greyhounds for which the combined First and Second Sustaining Payment was made. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound.

Breeders 2022 – Second Payment [Pups born January 20 to June 20]

This payment is for greyhounds for which the First Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

Classic 2022 – First Payment [Pups born July 20 to December 20]

This First Payment is due for Classic 2022. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. The First Payment is \$27.50 per pup or a “one-off” Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

Murray Bridge detour to track – note from government

Essential bridge maintenance works will be undertaken on the Old Murray Bridge (Bridge Street, Murray Bridge) from Tuesday, 15 June, with completion expected in late July, weather permitting.

To ensure the works can be undertaken safely and efficiently, the bridge will be closed intermittently throughout the works period, for a maximum of 10 days in total. To minimise disruption, work will not be undertaken on weekends.

On days when work is being undertaken, the bridge will be closed from 9.30am to 3.30pm, outside of peak traffic times. The bridge will remain open outside of these times. During the bridge closure times, a detour will be in place for vehicles via the Swanport Bridge. Road users are asked to follow electronic notice boards and directional signage when detours are in place. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take care when workers are on site.

WAP Update for participants - May 2021

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) advises participants that the Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of May 2021 was \$291,000.

Total WAP payments for the eleven months to the end of May now amount to \$2,644,000 compared to the initial total estimate of \$600,000 for the full year. The table below is provided for the benefit of those participants wishing to better understand the computation of the WAP.

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney.

If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

Base stakemoney to increase by 9% across Category 1, Category 2 and Category 3 from 1 July 2021

The consistent feedback received from participants in relation to the Wagering Activity Payments (WAP) model and stakemoney more generally has been a strong preference for higher base prizemoney (weekly) payments in exchange for lower monthly WAPs.

Accordingly, from 1 July 2021 base stakemoney will increase by 9% across all three racing categories. Importantly, the WAP model will remain in place and participants will be guaranteed to receive 50% of net wagering revenue.

Participants should note that the increase in base stakes is coupled with an expectation that wagering revenue will reduce in the coming financial year. The combination of these two factors will most likely result in some months of the year where WAPs are very low or potentially zero. GRSA is forecasting total WAP payments for the year being \$500,000 (and accordingly an average monthly payment of approximately \$40,000). These lower payments are not a sign that the system is faltering. Participants will continue to receive 50% of net wagering revenue, but in a time where net wagering revenue is expected to taper.

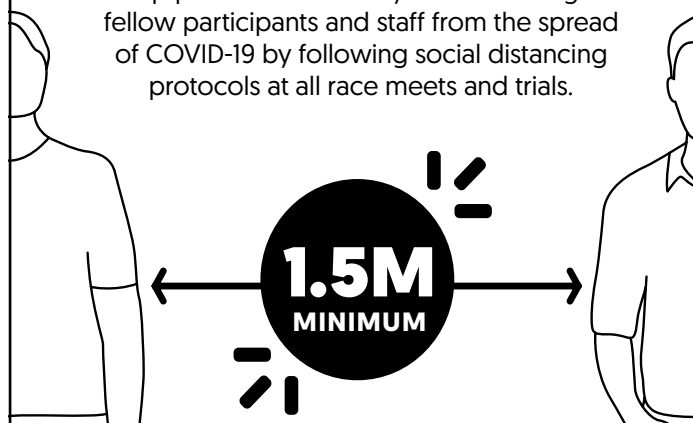

Compliance and Welfare

COVID-19

We recently went through the police operation Trace to enforce QR code check-in compliance in SA.

I am pleased to report we were not criticised for our response. I have placed extra QR code signs at the venues to make it easier to check-in, as well as 'how to' posters on downloading and using the mySA GOV app. I thank everyone for doing your part during the pandemic by checking in. Remember, you need to check in when you attend a GRSA facility for racing (including trials) and social gatherings at the licenced premises. GRSA also has QR check in for its offices at Angle Park (including GAPSA).

The vaccine

Not long ago, I received my first vaccine for COVID-19 from the Wayville hub.

I was very impressed with the operation there and the whole process saw me in and out in about 35 minutes. You need to have your Medicare card and fill out a short health questionnaire as you line up to register. After you register with reception (a bit like an airline check in), you sit in your coloured area and finish filling out the questionnaire. Once you finish, you get called into a cubicle and receive the vaccine. After that, you must wait 15 minutes before you leave. Parking is free (but make sure you validate your ticket before you leave the venue).

As for the vaccine, I received the Astra Zeneca. I usually do not react well to vaccines, so I was expecting to be whacked by it. It did not disappoint. I didn't feel the needle, so it started well. But it went south from there. That night, I was light headed, with a dull headache, aches and pains and chills. Overnight was ordinary and I woke up feeling pretty sorry for myself. This lasted just on 48-hours before it suddenly left me, as predicted by the nurse that administered the vaccine.

I am due my booster in August (up to 12-weeks from first dose). Others who received the Astra Zeneca felt little to no side effects, so what I write here is a no holes bars account of the side effects at their best.

I hope this gives you some insight when you consider your options on getting the vaccine. I do not regret getting it, despite the side-effects.

Cross-border travel

If you plan to cross the border, please refer to the Steward's Notice on the website on the subject (see the interstate travel COVID-19 banner on the homepage, or under Integrity – Rules and Policies – Stewards' Notices). This Notice gives you all the information and links you need to apply for the correct permits.

Always remember that the border can close within a matter of hours after an outbreak. Thanks to our vigilant participants both here and interstate (especially Victoria), we get some advance notice, but it is by no means a long time and sometimes it's still too late to change plans without a lot of inconvenience. We do our best to try to keep everyone up to date on the most recent developments, but please understand some if it is a best guess approach until police confirm the situation.

Retirement to breeding

Do not forget, if you transition your greyhound from racing to breeding, as well as the Pink Card, you need to still 'retire' your dog per rule 106 of the Greyhounds Australasia Rules.

This can be done via the Form 106R and must be lodged no later than 10 working days after your greyhound stops racing and begins its breeding purposes.

Murray Bridge Straight Track Cup

I attended Murray Bridge for the Straight Track cup on 26 May and it was a thoroughly enjoyable day, with my mobile office commanding a much better view than my usual abode at Angle Park.

I can also thoroughly recommend the ham and cheese toasties and chips, offered by the ever-helpful McQueens staff at the clubhouse. I hope to travel to other venues as a matter of routine, so please say hello if you are around.

Projects Update

Angle Park redevelopment

It's been a few weeks since the last update on the Angle Park redevelopment project, and I am happy to report that works have been progressing well despite some significant rain days in Adelaide in the past month.

The majority of the track concreting work has been completed, including the inner and outer plinths, three of the four starting slabs, as well as the track base in readiness for the final sand layer.

All trenching works on the infield and along the home straight have been completed, and the electrical and plumbing contractors have installed cabling and irrigation piping into the underground conduits.

Foundations have been poured for the realigned light poles along the home straight, with new light poles set to arrive on site late this week, which will be installed shortly after.

Next week the track will really start to take shape, as the

fencing contractor commences work on the outer track fence. The enclosing of the track should really start to return the site to how it was prior to the commencement of works.

The refurbished starting shelters and starting boxes will then begin to be placed on the starting slabs and the lure rail contractors will return to finish off the rail, prior to the sand surface being laid on the track.

Projects not associated directly with the race track development are also on track to be completed towards the end of July. This includes the wash bay works, kennel house flooring, judges tower reconfiguration, installation of the video board and general frontage works.

Despite the delays associated with the poorer weather in the past month, the project remains on schedule to recommence racing in August. Timeframes are starting to get tight, but management is optimistic that these dates can be met.



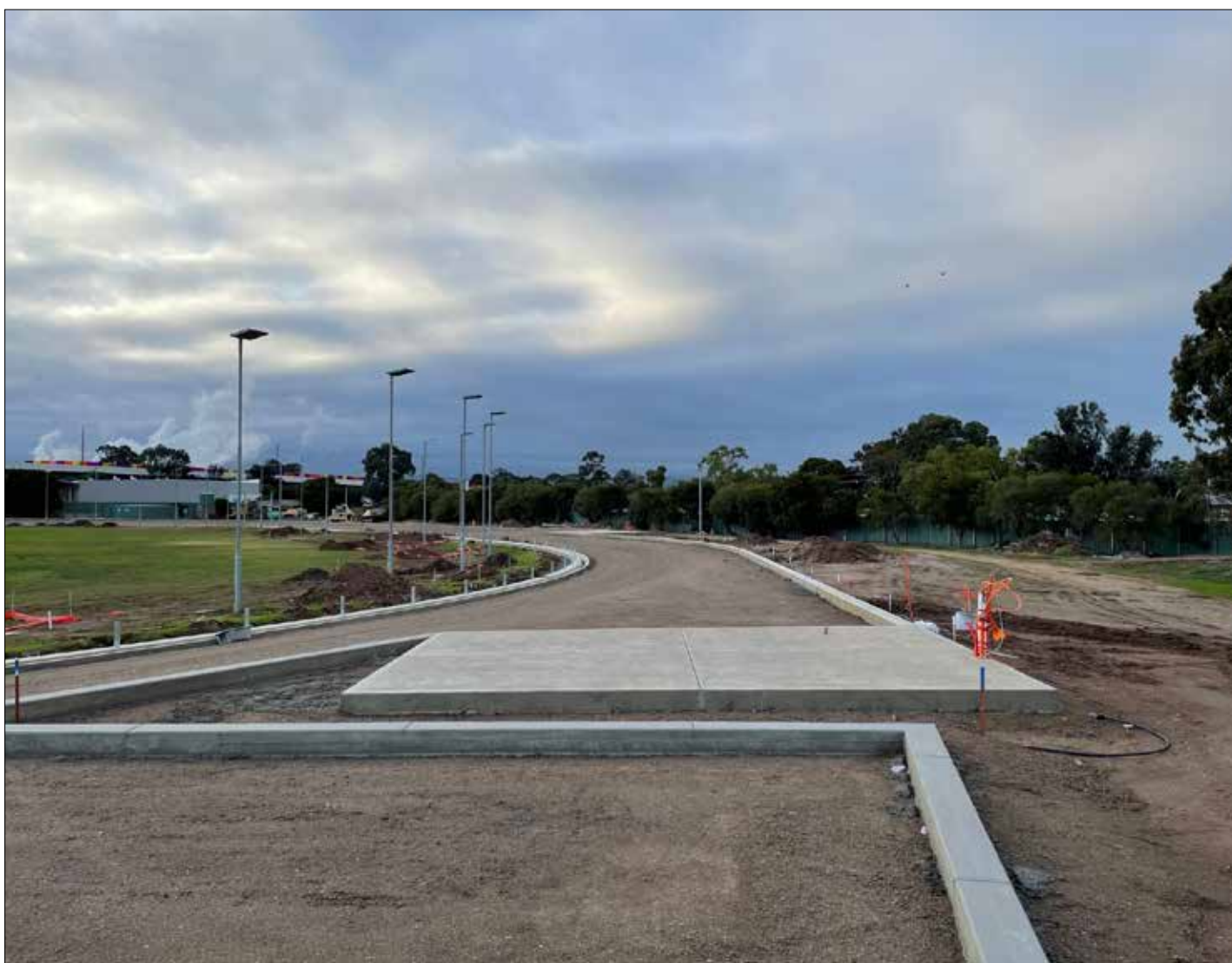

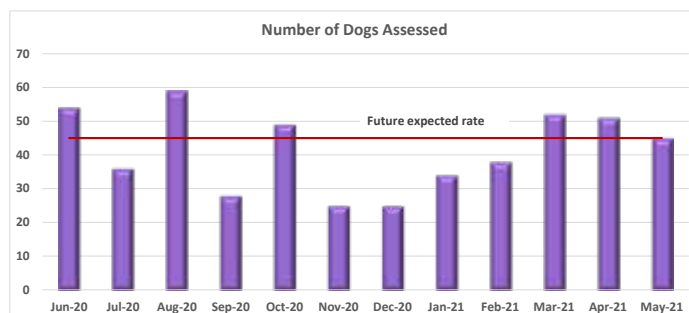
If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialed after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

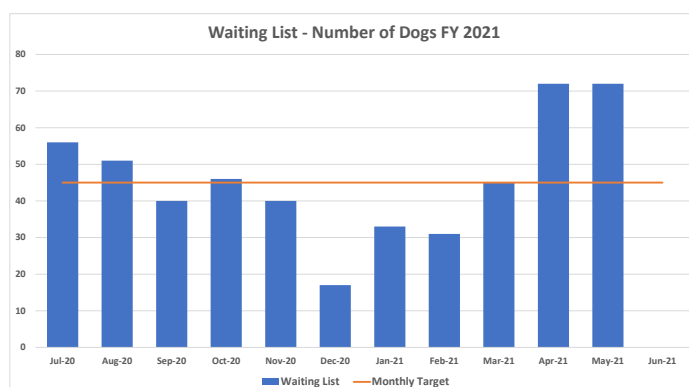
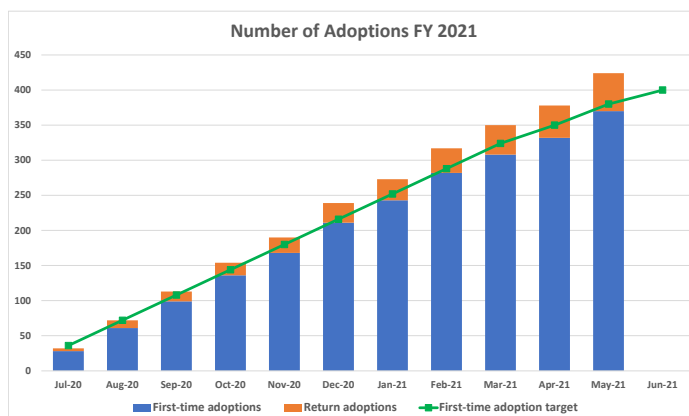
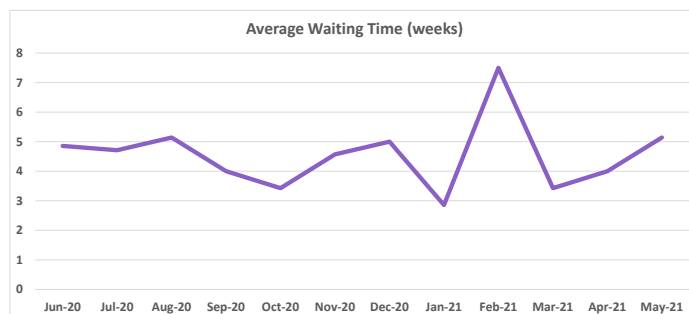
Latest updates from GAP

First local win for visiting trainer

■ MOUNT GAMBIER

Kiah Hurley of Lewiston has been training greyhounds for 10 years but on Sunday, 13th June it was the first time she had found her way down to Tara Raceway.

A second placing with Iron Eyes Punk behind the tearaway Rock It Barcia in the Klaassens Contractors Stake (512 m) had her in the money mid-meeting but her main chance always looked to be Sarcasmic in the last race.

Raced by Victorian owner Jeff Galea of Brookfield, Sarcasmic went into the Gordon Refrigeration Mixed Stake (400 m) from box one having won his past three starts at Gawler over 400 metres.

And the black dog never looked in any danger of defeat, leading all the way to defeat Rough In Vegas by 4¾ lengths in a quick 22.84 seconds for Hurley, a great-niece of long-time greyhound industry stalwart, Judi Hurley.

The win was the 14th overall for Sarcasmic, who was also bred by his owner. It also continued the good run for Hurley who has now won five races since March with the son of Fernando Bale and Little Pookie, who raced on 170 occasions for 16 wins and 50 minor placings.

The litter also includes the Galea owned and trained Scatterbox, a winner of 12 races and \$71,000 in stakemoney, and his kennelmate Run Baba Run [22, \$120,000].

Scatterbox was a 2020 Group 1 Australian Cup finalist and a finalist in the Group 2 Cranbourne Cup while Run Baba Run reached the final of the 2020 Group 1 National Futurity at Wentworth Park. He was also runner-up in the 2021 Group Listed Murray Bridge Cup.

2 NOTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

3 BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

3.1 Trialling Schedule when APK shutdown

The Chairman suggested shutdown date of 9 April was looking promising. It was noted participants were supportive of proposed schedule.

3.2 Local Rules

The Group noted the update.

3.3 On-Course Strategy – Transformation Pack Extract

The Chairman provided an update, noting the future savings that this initiative will be capable of driving.

3.4 Syndication Coordinator

The RM provided a brief update including the PDS process. He noted the additional 30 people that were associated with syndicate members attending Angle Park the previous night. He advised Sean Donnelley's intent was to work with other clubs and get more syndicates off the ground with more relationship building with owners, trainers etc. It was noted that communication has been very good.

3.5 Sheepskin Lures for Education

The panel noted recent occurrences with throat infections from trial lures.

Action: Management to ensure Clubs are disinfecting lures adequately and look at restoring canine coronavirus measures regarding changing lures at trials.

The SPM advised a prototype is available now, concerns with liability as design comes with risks. He advised he was happy to provide if participants accepted these risks. Sheepskin alone is also available. He committed to making available for purchase as soon as possible.

3.6 Science of Hair-Testing and Related Context

The group noted the update. The panel suggested the threat of having hair testing available would be a deterrent. The Chairman of stewards noted no hair testing available at the moment due to Covid. It was agreed to announce the [sporadic] use of hair testing will occur in future.

Action: The COS to publish notice in Kennel Capers regarding future use of hair testing.

3.7 Scratchings and Nominations

The RM provided an update noting scratchings are now available online which provided greater flexibility to participants. He advised care needed to be taken to ensure the correct dog is being scratched and that the onus was on the operator. Members provided feedback on the layout of online nominations form, not mobile friendly. Members suggested utilising the nominate dogs function at the top of the page.

Action: The RM to provide some clear instructions on best way to use online nomination form, as well as consulting OzChase to determine if form can be amended.

Panel Members noted issues with Mt Gambier Sunday nominations closing 9am on Wednesday with satisfactory trials being held on Wednesday morning. It was suggested it would be helpful for nominations to close at 12pm. The COS suggested moving trial day.

Action: Management to explore trialling strategy at Mt Gambier.

3.8 Angle Park Short Course Discussion

Discussion around camber, slight adjustments needed. The SPM addressing this in redevelopment.

3.9 Preferred Box Draws

The CEO noted Jane McNicholls support for preferential draws, referenced the SPM research, noted issues and complexities with practical implementation. National approach would be beneficial. Panel Members suggested those dogs that cause harm to others, chronic railers would benefit from preferential draws. Those dogs that are known to have erratic racing manners, target them. Members suggested trialling, one race per meeting, would assist with wagering. Some Members did not support. Members advised the reasons why they did not support the Preferred Box Draws were, 1. Inside Box Draw (1-4) are significantly greater winning races compared to outside box draws, under current racing conditions. 2. Where are greyhounds deemed to be inside or outside runners, based on box rise or first turn trajectory path, they can contradict each other and that further investigation be conducted under a randomised model. The CEO suggested a very soft trial would be required, he supported the overarching principle and suggested management build a model to potentially trial at Mt Gambier where pools are smaller. It was suggested a small percentage of dogs that have extreme racing habits be identified for the trial. Suggested trainer would nominate as particular runner, which Stewards would review. The COS suggested Stewards would already have view of this group of dogs. Reduced interference would limit injuries. The SPM questioned whether a random element of box draws would remain.

Action: Management to build model of preferential box draws.

The group were in favour of trainers picking draws as per Murray Bridge Cup final.

3.10 Participant Facilities – Animal Welfare Policy

Management to run advertisement via kennel capers and industry FB page for any contractors that wish to advertise in this space.

3.11 Industry Culture and Bullying

The group noted the update.

3.12 Vet Checks – Mt Gambier

The group noted the update. Members noted the Mt Gambier Club is happy with Craig and Lewis. Panel Members noted quality of vets in SA and benefit of these.

4 AGENDA ITEMS

4.1 Wagering Activity Payments

Members questioned why WAP payments were not included in general prizemoney payments. The FM noted yesterday's announcement and intent to do this. Noted budgeting predictions did not eventuate, better result than expected. The Chairman noted the Board and Management are mindful of this and budget process would address concerns. Members questioned, indexed to prizemoney, consider spread similar to SA bred payments, noting wagering. The FM noted this data is not known. The FM managements intent is fair distribution of money, not Management's recommendation to change current method, belief fairest way is to distribute based on winnings. FM more than happy to consider alternate systems. The SPM referenced Tasmanian system where all races are paid same amount, change to this to then pay WAP same

amount, requires aspirational system. The FM suggested deferring discussion until next IGC meeting following Board decisions around stake money payments. Averaging listed races to be introduced. Frequency of WAP payments, for less fluctuations, pay less frequently, better off payments sooner than later. Year end reconciliation, balance at end of year how to distribute; opinion was to base on full 12 months. Top up money allocated to it is considered feature race and excluded from WAP. Members raised the issue of WAP not being paid on "GRSA deemed Top Up" races which can be heats, finals, Classics, Preludes which result in winners getting paid less than normal grade 6 races which are paid WAP. Members presented a highlighted list of Top Up races that should be considered for allocation of future WAP payments. The FM suggested a standard approach would be best, all Finals and Adelaide Cup heats would be excluded, FM suggested for consistency and fairness, continuing approach for the remainder of the year and amend from July 1, 2021

Action: All races over \$5,000/Adelaide Cup Heats, Finals – RM to propose model of which races would be excluded from WAP payments

Ray Fewings left meeting at 11.16am

4.2 Grading of CITY A meetings when Angle Park shutdown

The RM clarified grading and prize money structure during Angle Park shutdown. Strong intent to 455m plus during these meetings to accommodate Thursday night dogs but will include shortcourse as required under standby conditions, prize money has been adjusted to reflect this. The RM questioned the group due to lag between end of preludes and when Howard Ashton final is potentially run, what is preferred time/venue to hold Howard Ashton final. Groups opinion was to hold Howard Ashton final at Gawler push back two weeks, prepare at track where final is being held.

Action: The RM to propose schedule for Howard Ashton preludes and finals to be held at Gawler at suitable timings.

4.3 Local Rule – Breeding Restrictions

Discussion around age limits for breeding. Consensus of group was that an exemption is required for those dogs over 8 years with vet clearance. Local rules increase maximum number of litters allowed from 3 to 5.

Action: For the Board to revisit the Local Rule in relation to breeding restrictions in relation to age of broodbitch and number of litters having regard for feedback from this meeting.

4.4 Greyhound Property "Nanny"

Members noted previous experience and success with this. CEO suggested advertisement in Kennel Capers to attract interest from potential previous trainer who would be available to act as property "nanny".

Action: For Kennel Capers to be utilised to attract expressions of interest from previous/retired trainers to be engaged as property 'nannies' to give trainers the opportunity to take leave.

4.5 Stake money and Strategy Options

Once the Board resolve draft strategy to be published to group for discussion.

4.6 Future On-Course Model

Discussed earlier in the meeting.

4.7 Wide Lure Arm – Concept Development

Members suggested new lure at Murray Bridge was not loud enough, whistler. The SPM advised option to install alternate louder option. The SPM committed to arranging Steriline unit to be made available at Angle Park following redevelopment.

4.8 Timing of Pink Card Applications

CEO questioned if there was any improvements to process. JH suggested promotion in Kennel Capers around spring (regularly), can

apply while still racing. Members noted issue with Form B (breeding plan) required to receive pink card

Action: For Kennel Capers to be utilised to send the message to trainers/breeders that they can apply for a Pink Card for a future broodbitch even while she continues to race (to avoid late applications on the cusp of going into season).

5. OTHER BUSINESS

5.1 Christine Costa

Discussion around track ratings and providing more information to punters. The COS noted there has been previous discussion held around this, however opinion is very subjective. Members noted effect on wagering and noted inconsistencies with track maintenance staff which is being addressed with SPM. Members suggested communication of track ratings could be done via Facebook or Twitter to alert punters to condition. The CEO suggested that GPS technology would be the best solution to this issue, although not in immediate future, working towards this. Scott reference IPS technology at a cost of \$120,000 per track, provisions made at Angle Park should this be introduced in future.

5.2 Greyhound Galloping

Members referenced study papers and information available to assist trainers. Suggested information can be provided by links via website and Kennel Capers. Members noted education sessions proposed by John Katakasi.

CEO with Marketing Manager to look in to Jane McNicholl and John Katakasi providing education sessions for participants. Educational videos, Jane McNicholl, Petar Jovanovic and others (max. 3 minutes) available regularly.

Action: For the future GRSA website to include instructional content from bigger jurisdictions (eg GRV) as well as local content provided by SA veterinarians and/or animal behaviourists.

5.3 Private Advertising of Greyhound Puppies

Members noted her concerns with greyhound puppies being available via Gumtree by ex-trainer. The CEO noted future paper to Board regarding compulsory desexing of all greyhounds.

5.4 RSPCA Publication

Members noted publication produced RSPCA which contained images of greyhounds and noted her concern with how the images were used.

5.5 Barking Muzzles

The Chairman to raise with GA at next Board meeting. CEO noted industry will be consulted and have an opportunity to provide feedback.

5.6 Straight Track Racing

Members requested straight track racing occurring once a week. CEO took on notice and suggested this would be a discussion held post Angle Park redevelopment.

5.7 Coursing

The RM noted would not be held when Saturday morning meeting scheduled. RM suggested they would commence in May on alternate week to Saturday morning during the Angle Park redevelopment.

Trainers are advised that Satisfactory Trials on these days **ONLY** will be approved.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kennelling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Tuesday, Wednesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these days fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
4. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
5. Trials will be 455m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
6. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
7. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
8. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
9. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races there will be NO trials.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

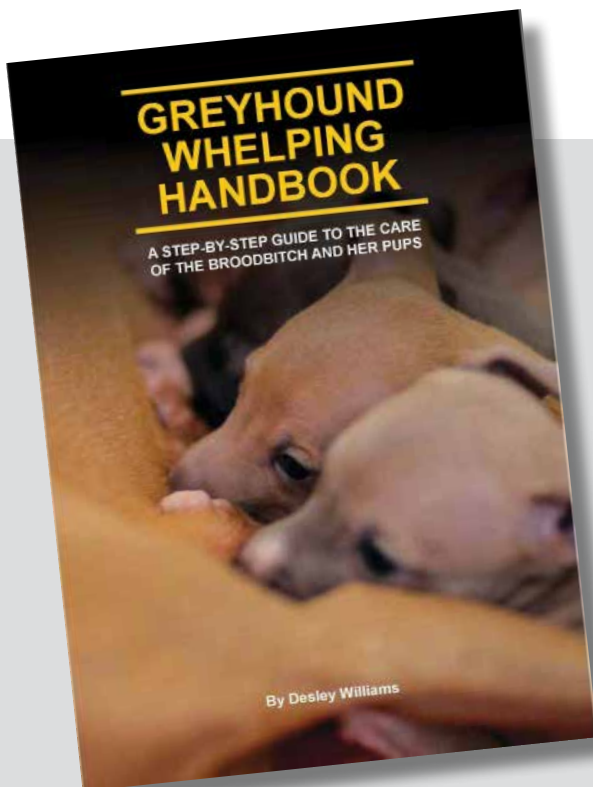
