NOTES FROM THE CEO BODELLE FRANCIS

Increase in Government Funding

We were pleased to announce earlier in the month that South Australia's three racing codes – Racing SA, Greyhound Racing SA and Harness Racing SA – will receive an increased return of betting operations tax revenue from 10 to 20 per cent on behalf of the Government of South Australia. This new funding model will commence from 1 July 2023 and will run for four years. As with the current model, the funding will be shared between the codes based on market share. We all know too well that our sport continues to face several challenges and this increase has been greatly welcomed - as has the strong signal of support that has been shown by the state government.

Wagering Activity Payment

GRSA wishes to advise that there will be no Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of May 2023. Total payments for the financial year now amount to \$607,000. Participants should also anticipate that there may be a zero or potentially modest WAP payment for the month of June.

National Police Checks

Since January 2022, police clearances have been a requirement for all participants wanting to join our sport and to date, this has predominantly only effected new registrations. With several licences up for renewal this year, this change to the rule has meant that a large contingent of our community has been required to obtain this clearance. We appreciate that this has caused some inconvenience and has not been a requirement in the past, however as an industry that is subject to much scrutiny, these checks are important and is a process that is widely adopted in both other codes and jurisdictions. In an effort to assist in this transition, Owners will no longer be required to obtain a clearance and a grace period has been granted to any participant that is experiencing difficulties. GRSA are here to assist any participant that requires support and we encourage you to make contact with us if this is the case. We have also put together some further information to assist, please see page 4.

VICTA DAMIAN SHINES AT HOME

Victa Damian has continued to enhance his reputation as a rising star of Australian greyhound racing after taking out the Group 3 Howard Ashton final at Angle Park on May 25.

Defying a competitive field and Adelaide's wet weather, Victa Damian kicked away down the back straight burning off the field to win by nine lengths in 30.21.

He defeated Live It also for the Rasmussen team while the Tim Richards trained Coorong Cam finished in third with an impressive run.

The win capped a special night for the Rasmussen team who had seven of the eight runners in the final including six from the same litter (Fernando Bale x Victa Polly) bred by Ron Schadow.

Schadow was on course for the race last night and Tony Rasmussen said it was a special moment to have him there to watch the litter compete in the final.

"To have Ron here tonight is enormous and it's a special moment for us," Rasmussen said.



DASH OF BLUE CLAIMS SHANE MCQUEEN

A healthy crowd was on course at Angle Park on Thursday June 1 with the headline act on the 12-race program being the final of the Shane McQueen run over the middle distance.

In an even and competitive field drawn from four heats last week, it was Dash Of Blue for trainer Richard Pearce who claimed the race winning in a tight finish from Could Be King and Springvale Max in a time of 34.41.

Jumping from box one, Dash Of Blue was able to get to the front from the inside draw holding out Springvale Max and Could Be King in the first section.

Could Be King checked off heels around the turn allowing Ravers Army to work its way into the race down the back but Dash Of Blue found another kick, getting away to hold off the fast finishing Could Be King with Springvale Max holding on for third.

Speaking after the race, trainer Richard Pearce said he was thrilled Dash Of Blue was able to produce in the final after a strong run behind Could Be King in the heats last week.

"He followed up a good run last week where he finished well," Pearce said.

"He jumped well and he got to the front and I thought he was in a good position when he passed me the first time."

A long-time trainer, Pearce said he was appreciative of the performance of Dash Of Blue and said it was nice to win a race of the caliber of the Shane McQueen.

"It is a special night," he said.

"It has been a while since I have had a good dog. I have had Pancho and a few other good dogs but that was a really good win, he is a handy dog."

1 ONLINE VIA NATIONAL CRIME CHECK

You can complete a National Crime Check online by visiting **nationalcrimecheck.com.au** and clicking on 'Start A New Police Check'

To prove your identity, you need to provide a Selfie Photo as well as four different types of identification documents:

- One document that shows the date you were born or arrived in Australia which is called a Commencement Document.
- One document that proves your identity which is called a Primary Document.
- Two other documents that support your identity which are called Secondary Documents.

See the next page for a list of identification documents that Australia Post require as a guide. Make sure the four documents show your full legal name and date of birth and one of the documents needs to have a photo of you, such as a passport or driver's licence.

2 YOUR LOCAL POLICE STATION

You can also complete a crime check by visiting your local police station, placing an order and manually filling in your form.

Most results typically take several days to be returned - please note online applications are generally processed much quicker.

You will receive a hard copy, which you may need to scan and reproduce in order to post or supply to a requesting party.

Please note, if there is a need to ask a police officer for help and they need to deal with higher priority tasks, you may need to wait to be served.

To prove your identity, for all applications you will need to present identification documents similar to the documents on the following page.

3 ONLINE OR IN-STORE AT AUSPOST

You can complete a Police Check online by visiting your local **Australia Post store** as well as online on their website **auspost.com.au/police-checks**

To prove your identity, for all applications you will need the documents listed on the following page.

If you are applying in-person instore, you will also need to complete an Application for National Police Check form which is available on the above link for downloading.

IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS

Each option on the previous page will require you to provide ID documents. The below table shows the requirements for Australia Post as an example, who require 4 ID documents in total from the list below. All 4 must be hardcopy originals [digital copies not accepted] and must not be expired.

Be sure to check that all of your details across your identity documents match what you've provided in your application. If your maiden name or previous name doesn't match, you'll need to provide change of name documentation.

TYPE OF CLEARANCE - EMPLOYMENT OR VOLUNTEER?

Across all sites, when filling in your application, ensure you are selecting the 'Employment' option as this will get you the required criminal history clearance.

IMPORTANT UPDATE - LICENSING

GRSA wishes to advise Participants of the following:

- Owners renewing licenses will NOT require Police Clearances at the current renewal period [30/6/2023];
 - Trainers, Attendants and Breeders WILL require Police Clearances as previously advised and
 - A grace period will apply to those experiencing difficulties
- If you are requiring assistance in obtaining a Police Clearance, we encourage you to contact Renee Colquhoun [8243 7113 – renee.colquhoun@grsa.com.au] or Des Jonas [8243 7166 – 0478 189 366 – des.jonas@grsa.com.au] at your earliest convenience.

Please note – If you have not renewed your licence by Friday, 23rd June this may prevent any greyhounds being nominated for upcoming meetings from July 1 onwards. Please ensure your trainer and owner's licences are all up to date when nominating.

GRADING REVIEW PANEL MEETING OUTCOMES

The most recent Grading Review Panel meeting was held on Friday, 2nd June. It was an extremely positive meeting with the panel agreeing to some changes to City A Grade 6 conditions to help encourage and retain greyhounds racing at Angle Park on Thursday nights [City A] over the 500m+. There were also be some slight changes to Masters events for greyhounds that have broken the time standard to help them get back into these events a bit sooner. The full minutes are listed below -

Meeting commenced at 10.00am. Shaun Mathieson, Racing Manager, thanked those attending the meeting today. He also thanked those representatives who could not attend, providing feedback on the agenda.

1. Minutes From Previous Meeting

The panel approved the minutes from the previous GRP meeting held on 25/11/22.

2. Business Arising

The Racing Manager provided an update to the panel on those items introduced from the last meeting. The panel discussed a number of those items in detail.

Grade 6 – As a standing item the Grade 6 conditions continue to remain on the agenda for any new discussion.

The RM asked the panel with GRSA running 12 races on every Thursday night was there an option through Grade 6 conditions that could encourage more 500+m events.

The panel discussed options to give another Grade 6 win on a Thursday, removing the condition if you win a Grade 5 event or higher you lose all Grade 6 events at other tracks, the possibility of two Grade 5 events or even Restricted win events like [1-5 win events].

The panel felt it was time to relax some conditions on a Thursday as over time the opportunities to win 500+ Grade 6 events at other tracks have reduced due to the advent of short course distances.

The panel felt the best way to retain and entice some of these greyhounds into our Thursday night program was to give one extra Grade 6 for any greyhound over another distance. This will bring Thursday night into line with ALL of the tracks in SA giving two Grade 6 wins at a City A meeting over different distances. They advised there would be no retrospectivity regarding this condition being implemented and recommended this start as soon as possible.

The panel felt this change should be supported by programming where a Grade 6 595m specific event should be programmed each Thursday where possible to help promote this change along with a Mixed or Open 595m distance. It is unlikely a 731m distance would be run however if there were all Grade 6 greyhounds then this would count as one Grade 6 win for the stayers.

The panel also supported the removal of the criteria that once you have won a Grade 5 or higher event on a City A meeting that you lose all Grade 6 events at all other tracks. This change could mean that a greyhound becomes a Grade 1 or 2 at City A meetings and then still has Grade 6 events to win. They believed this would help retain some of these greyhounds in the pool of Thursday night City A meetings. They advised there would be no retrospectivity regarding this condition being implemented and recommended this start as soon as possible.

Actions:

The RM to allow one extra Grade 6 over another distance for City A Thursday meetings and remove the condition where once a greyhound has won a Grade 5 or higher event on a City A meeting that you lose all Grade 6 events at all other tracks. No retrospectivity regarding these conditions being implemented and recommended this start as soon as possible

ANGLE PARK – Thursday night extra race –

The RM confirmed some changes discussed at the last meeting to assist Thursday night fields including field sizes, heats from other venues to Angle Park City A finals, Grade 5 selection for low grade greyhounds. The panel believed that for heats from another venue to a City A final the greyhound should take a penalty for the heat but not the final. The RM will advise this in programming the conditions of these events if required.

Actions:

The RM to advise winners of heats take a penalty but not the final when heats at other venues are drawn for a City A final where programmed.

The RM did advise the panel if there are not 12 races each Thursday at Angle Park GRSA will call for short course events at that time. The RM attached a prizemoney breakdown of 342m events for City A meetings if they are to be conducted. It would be an intention for preference to our best short course sprinters. GRSA took into account the Prov 1 prizemoney for short course and the CITY A sprint distance stake money.

The panel were supportive of 500+m racing on Thursday however understood that 12 races needed to be conducted on a Thursday night based on feedback from the RM.

The panel suggested that when nominations closed at 9am for City A meetings and there were insufficient nominations for 12 races they should be extended until 12.30pm. If at 12.30pm there are still not enough for 12 races the grader is to grade the 500m+ events he has and nominations for the 342m races [however many required] called for and close around 2.30pm. This will only be for the best greyhounds nominated and the grader is to take into account the grades of greyhounds that have raced at APM on Monday nights over 342m. All greyhounds on City A Thursday will be Maiden, Grade 6 and Grade 5 to start with and however many races are to be run they will be conducted at the end of the program.

Actions:

The RM to advise and implement the above changes to 342m City A events if they are to be conducted.

MIDDLE DISTANCE NOMINATIONS AND FIELDS –

The RM advised previously the panel discussed middle and staying distance generally about the integrity side of things and suggested that maybe to encourage more stayers that prizemoney should be tiered. The panel at the time suggested that if standard grading of a field of 5 to 8 is drawn then normal budgeted money should be paid. However if 4 runners then this should be \$1k less for City A prizemoney. It was also suggested maybe it should be at the 595m prizemoney however they felt reducing for 4 runners would encourage more nominations.

The RM recommended to continue programming 4 runners as a minimum for stayers over 730m at Angle Park, Mt Gambier and the 680m and Murray Bridge which the panel agreed with no further changes however if there were integrity issues this should be dealt with by the stewards.

TIME BANDS FOR TRACKS AND DISTANCES –

It was suggested from the last GRP meeting that possibly the 342m

time ratings needed to be reviewed as the panel felt greyhounds were running quicker than their ratings. The panel also suggested that Gawler times particularly over the 400m need to be reviewed along with the Murray Bridge Straight track. The RM provided the panel with the Time Rating table and requested they review the times and liaise back to him with any changes in the next few weeks.

Members of the panel believed the conditions should be reviewed. Currently Time Rating is basically calculated with your 4 best runs in the last 6 starts. Some members felt that a more accurate reflection of a greyhounds performance was your last 4 starts or even 3 of your last 4 starts. The reason for this was over 6 starts it takes 1-2 months for a change to your rating to really take effect.

The RM will consider the panels thoughts regarding changing the formula for Time Grading.

Actions:

The RM to follow up with the GRP panel in the next few weeks regarding any possible adjustment to the Time Rating table.

The RM provided a verbal update to the panel regarding the 305m Maiden events at Mt Gambier being selected on form for Prov 1 meetings and he advised shortly there will be more information video's to be released through social media by GRSA. SA Country Cup - The panel were supportive of the SA Country Cup remaining in its current format however felt the Prov 1 condition for Gawler and Grade 5 at Angle Park City A for the final could be reconsidered which the RM will do prior to conditions being released.

Gawler Feature Race Concept – The RM advised the group he was still working through the details for a possible new race series at Gawler with February the preferred date. Initial thoughts were for this to be some form of Match Race series over the 643m with participants having some input into each match up that may suit the lower ranked greyhounds. There would be prizemoney encouragement for taking on the high rated dogs etc. The RM advised there is nothing budgeted for this series and is still very much in the development stage. The RM advised that this type of race might suit handicap boxes if that was something that GRSA looked to implement.

The RM provided a verbal update to the panel on the North V South Challenge programmed for July with updated conditions. The panel felt that trainer bonuses would help encourage support for both clubs. The RM will consider this suggestion.

He also advised the group about a new series to be run in June and aligning with the Gawler Produce for Mixed Masters 3/4/5 greyhounds named after outgoing chairman Mike Wittholz.

The panel were supportive of these events and changes.

Nomination Numbers Online – The RM advised he has not been able to change the preferences online to make the numbers correct. He did advise that we are putting more feature events in Ozchase for trainers to see so they can nominate directly into these events.

Last Start Placegetter on the Order - The panel previously discussed that a last start placegetter for a Prov 2 meeting should be on the Order. The RM advised he has not actioned this mainly because of the pool of greyhounds and that this would be a fundamental change to the automated program which would need considerable testing. At this time he suggested not changing as most of these greyhounds were getting in the fields regardless. The panel were comfortable with this response.

3. Agenda Items

ADDITIONAL TUESDAY NIGHT MEETING AT ANGLE PARK

The RM confirmed with the panel that we will be running at extra meeting per week at Angle Park on Tuesday nights. This extra meeting will be shown on Sky 2 and will be for Category 3 prizemoney. It will also be for short course greyhounds [342m] exclusively to not affect 530m+ at Angle Park meetings on Monday [Category 2] and Thursday [Category 1]. These meetings will be graded events and as we haven't run this category with greyhounds taking a grade [Saturday mornings are Non Penalty] it

will be like a new venue with most grades being Maiden, Grade 6 and Grade 5 to start with.

Nominations will close on the Friday before, the same time as Gawler Wednesday. This does avoid Angle Park Monday and Murray Bridge Tuesday which close on the Thursday.

Trials at Angle Park will move from Tuesday night to Wednesday night and be run the same time as the Murray Bridge trials. The implementation date is scheduled for 1st August, 2023.

The panel were wary of the support for other meetings with the Murray Bridge Straight track on this day a concern. With nominations and participation at an even balance an extra meeting could result in short fields.

The panel believed the Tuesday night meeting should be G-SIX for all races and it should be announced to give some certainty for trainers. The RM will consider this feedback.

GRADING REVIEW PANEL MEMBERS

The RM advised since March of 2021 there has been no change to the Grading Review Panel with all members continuing in their roles which has been very much appreciated by Management. He advised the current panel members of a slight adjustment to each member to ensure the whole panel does not expire at the same time based on the 2021 list with each member a two year term-

Petar and Daniel were happy to continue with Mike deciding to step away as he is no longer a representative of the Gawler Club and Sharyn would be fine to continue however if there is another strong applicant, she would also be happy to step aside. All other members were happy to continue. The RM advised once all members confirmed he will then look to advertise for those positions available.

TIME GRADING SUGGESTIONS

The RM requested some feedback from the panel regarding a few suggestions for Time Grading.

- He sought feedback from the panel about having a cut of for Time Grading. For example Mt Gambier currently has a restriction of 5.50 for 5+ win 400m events. The panel were comfortable with the current process and felt some of this should be addressed by programming and encouraging more nominations.

- The RM suggested that reserves for Time Graded events selected to gain a start should be based on rating. As it currently stands reserves for all time graded events are randomly selected meaning a greyhound that has a faster rating than the other reserve may gain a start ahead of this greyhound. It is the RM's understanding than in NSW they can select the reserve for specific events without it being a final. The panel were supportive of this change and would like the RM to obtain details and look to implement for these events where possible.

PREFERENTIAL BOX DRAWS

The RM gave a verbal update regarding Preferential Box Draws. Whilst this has been discussed previously by the Grading Review Panel recently there was a National meeting about implementation with NZ already using a PBD system and WA trialling over the 275m at Cannington. Victoria was to trial at Traralgon however this has been postponed. QLD have now advised a trial and the RM advised that it was likely some trial would take place in SA in the next 12 months however no conditions have been confirmed as yet.

4. Submissions

Alan McCulloch [edited]

1. Greyhounds winning a grade 5 masters event in faster time than the time standard are required to drop back to a normal

grade 5 event and cannot compete in a masters grade five until they have had 2 unplaced runs. I would like to see the policy changed to allow them to have two runs back in a grade 5 but not necessarily unplaced before being eligible to nominate for a masters again. Masters greyhounds have a limited racing career and they don't need to be excluded from an age event that is in keeping with their age. The panel were supportive of this change to take effect asap.

Actions:

The RM to make the above change to Masters events asap.

2. Could the panel discuss the possibility of increasing the age of Master's events to 4 years and over as we seem to have more greyhounds available for those events. This would reduce the age range which at present is anything up to a year and a half. The panel were comfortable with the current age structure of Masters events.

3. The first place I go to for information is the GRSA web site. Yet if one goes to the Grading section on the web site many decisions made by this panel are not written into the Grading rules and policies. The RM advised that a policy book and updating the information on the website is a priority for the Grading Department.

Regarding 4 dog staying events on the program ahead of other events which was confirmed and addressed earlier in the meeting.

Lachlan Mill [edited]

Time grading on the Straight track where normal graded events have had a prizemoney increase. The RM advised the panel that there is a balance between Time Graded and normal graded events programmed at the Straight track. The most important thing is to ensure there is always a meeting programmed each week on the straight track that can accommodate our racing population.

ADDITIONAL TUESDAY NIGHT MEETING AT ANGLE PARK

After consultation and support by Sky Racing, GRSA has programmed an extra race meeting on the weekly schedule for the new season, with Tuesday night at Angle Park now on the calendar. This extra meeting will be shown on Sky 2 and will be for Category 3 prizemoney. It will also be for short course greyhounds (342m) exclusively to not affect 530m+ at Angle Park meetings on Monday (Category 2) and Thursday (Category 1). GRSA may initially have to utilise more 6 dog fields to spread out our numbers across the weekly schedule, however, this will only be determined at the time. These meetings will be graded events and as we haven't run this category with greyhounds taking a grade (Saturday mornings are Non Penalty) it will be like a new venue with most grades being Maiden, Grade 6 and Grade 5 to start with.

Nominations will close on the Friday before, the same time as Gawler Wednesday. This does avoid Angle Park Monday and Murray Bridge Tuesday which close on the Thursday.

Trials at Angle Park will move from Tuesday night to Wednesday night and be run the same time as the Murray Bridge trials. The implementation date is scheduled for 1st August, 2023.

LOW GRADE RACE FOR THURSDAYS AT ANGLE PARK

In an effort to ensure we are programming 12 races each Thursday night at Angle Park, GRSA has introduced a low grade race for some Thursday nights. These races are for Grade 5 greyhounds over 530m that have a low WPS (Weighted Points Score). Prizemoney will be slightly less than a normal Grade 5, however, these races will be non-penalty. There will be no guarding, no

reserves and only one 8 greyhound race. This should provide encouragement for those trainers who have 500m+ greyhounds but feel they cannot compete on a normal Thursday night due to current form. We are hoping to draw from a different pool of greyhounds and GRSA would encourage trainers to nominate. \$3,505 Special event Grade 5 (worst to best) – 530m (One 8 dog field will be graded from the Weighted Points Score table of Grade 5 pool of greyhounds worst to best grading. 2023 MOUNT GAMBIER ANNIVERSARY CUP WORTH \$8,000 ON 23rd JULY

One of the main feature meetings for the Mount Gambier GRC is programmed on Sunday, 23rd July where the \$8,000 (increase in prizemoney) Exchange Printers Anniversary Cup Final for Open greyhounds will be run over the 512m along with the \$2,500 John Reid Memorial Maiden Final over 305m and the \$5,000 Eric Lewis Memorial Feature Open over the 732m along with other events. Heats for both the Anniversary Cup and John Reid Maiden will be run on Sunday, 16th July with both weeks likely to have some terrific racing.

RACING AND TRIALLING FREQUENCY – STARTED 1ST FEBRUARY

GRSA has adopted a new local rule in regard to frequency of racing and trialling which took effect on Wednesday 1st February 2023. The update local rule is below -

69A Racing and trialling frequency

(1) In this rule:

Race has the same meaning given to this term in R9 of the GAR.

Trial means a satisfactory trial, or a qualifying trial as defined in R9 of the GAR.

(2) A greyhound will only be permitted to start in –

(a) No more than a combined total of 2 race and trial starts in any 7-day period; and,

(b) No more than a combined total of 7 race and trial starts in any 28-day period.

(3) This sub-rule commences on a date to be fixed by Stewards' Notice.

The intent of this rule is to monitor and regulate the frequency of races and official trials of greyhounds, to ensure adequate rest time is given between events. The rule is similar to one in effect in Western Australia. We have automated the Ozchase Racing system to be able to monitor this rule. The rule is self-explanatory. A greyhound must not start more than 2 times (races or trials combined) in any 7-day period. Further, a greyhound must not start more than 7-times (races or trials combined) in any 28-day period.

Any attempt to nominate a greyhound outside these parameters will be flagged by the OzChase system. If a greyhound gains a start from reserve deeming it ineligible under this rule for its next engagement or it competes in another state prior to racing back in SA then the greyhound will come out.

**Racing Administration staff will scratch these greyhounds acting under this rule without notification. (the responsibility rests with the trainer to ensure they do not contravene this rule)

**For clarity if a greyhound races on Sunday, Wednesday then Sunday it will be eligible. The first day counts as day 1 and therefore resets on the Saturday.

2023 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS IN VICTORIA

The GCA National Championships are just around the corner. The National Finals this year will be held at The Meadows in Victoria and are to be conducted on Saturday, 26th August.

Both the National Sprint and National Distance Finals are at Group 1 level.

The State series' for SA will be held at Angle Park on Thursday, 3rd August for the Sprint Heats over 530m with the State Final of the Sprint and one-off Final over 730m of the Distance on the 10th August.

In an effort to support this series ALL States will be conducting their Finals on the same night to be run within a two hour period.

• **Nominations will close at the normal time with GRSA which will be at 9am on Monday, 31st July**

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Wednesday, 17th May 2023. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

NATIONAL STRAIGHT TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP AT HEALESVILLE

The National Straight Track Championship this year will be held at Healesville on Saturday morning, 26th August – so all the National Finals will be held on the same day.

This year SA will have two SA dogs represent the State in the series with QLD, NSW, VIC and SA challenging for the title.

So the Straight Track series aligns with the circle and the other States, our Heats will be held at Murray Bridge on Tuesday, 1st August with our Final on Tuesday, 8th August. Prizemoney for the SA Straight track Final will be \$10,000 to the winner aligned with the other three States.

It is important that trainers are aware that these series' for the circle and straight track are run at the same time so please be mindful of this when nominating and the qualifying criteria.

• **Nominations close with GRSA at 9am on Thursday, 27th July**

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Saturday, 13th May 2023. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED "ONLY"

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. (Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race) If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

2023 NORTH VS SOUTH CHALLENGE

Below are details of how the 2023 North V South Challenge will work for a 531m Final worth \$8,000 and a 400m Final worth \$4,000, to be run at Gawler on Sunday 30th July and then on rotation with Murray Bridge over the coming years.

This year's series will start with one Heat for Gawler greyhounds and one Heat for Murray Bridge greyhounds at Gawler on Sunday, 16th July, with the 531m Heats worth \$2,125 each and the 400m Heats worth \$1,855 for round 1. Round 2 will be at Murray Bridge with the same greyhounds competing in one Heat for the Gawler greyhounds and one Heat for Murray Bridge greyhounds on Sunday, 23rd July, with the 530m Heats worth \$2,125 and the 395m Heats worth \$1,855. Each Heat will consist of a maximum of 8 dogs with the Finals run at Gawler on Sunday, 30th July as an 8 dog Final plus reserves. **Greyhounds will receive points through both rounds 1 and 2 to establish the 4 from each Club who will progress through to the Final.**

Conditions

- To be eligible for either Murray Bridge or Gawler trainers will be classified on their Post Code as to which Club they can represent [see table below. Please contact GRSA if your postal address is not recognised below].
- The greyhound must be SA trained.
- A South Australian-trained greyhound is defined as one that is in SA for a period of not less than 3 out of the 6 months immediately before the time of nomination.
- The 530m/531m event is open to all greyhounds.
- The 395m/400m event is open to all greyhounds.
- The winner of each event takes a penalty including the Final however if they won round 1 they will only take one penalty. If a greyhound has won round 1 and round 2 they will only take 1 penalty for the Club they are representing.
- The greyhounds must not have any offences precluding them from competing at Murray Bridge or Gawler or they will be ineligible for the rounds.
- Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.
- The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track over any distance it is attempting to represent. [Gawler Prov 1 or Prov 2 and Murray Bridge One Turn Prov 1]. This only relates to the track they are representing.
- The same greyhounds will compete in both Rounds 1 and 2.
- There will be No Reserves for Round 1 and Round 2
- In Round 1 both Heats for each distance must have 5 or more nominations to be conducted separately. If one Heat has 5 or more nominations and the other Heat has 4 nominations, then this will be conducted as one race for round 1 with all greyhounds progressing to round 2 and then the final. In Round 1 if there are 3 or fewer nominations for a distance then this event will be combined, made up to a maximum of 8 runners and conducted as the final on Sunday 16th July [531m event worth \$4k, 400m event worth \$2k]
- Points will be allocated for each round [1st 12 points, 2nd 9, 3rd 7, 4th 5, 5th 4, 6th 3, 7th 3, 8th 3]
- If greyhounds have the same amount of points the greyhound with the best finish in either round 1 or 2 will progress, however, if the placings are the same then this will be by ballot.
- The two reserves for the Final will be determined by points initially [as above] to select which reserve from either Club is the first or second reserve, however, if identical then by a ballot. The sixth greyhounds if required will be by points or then by ballot if required. Should a greyhound be withdrawn before the final fields, the next placed greyhound from that Club's Heat will be selected.
- Once a greyhound has been selected or qualified for a Heat, it is not eligible to compete for the other Club in this series.
- GRSA reserves the right to alter any conditions as necessary.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE GREYHOUNDS AUSTRALASIA RULES

GRSA recently received advice from Greyhounds Australasia (GA) about some proposed amendments to the Greyhounds Australasia Rules.

As you know, GA maintains the GAR with the Controlling Bodies following them under the federated arrangements.

The following is proposed –

GAR 138 (e) Meaning of an Exempted Substance

Draft amendment GAR 138(e):

138 Meaning of exempted substance

An exempted substance includes the following substances:

...

[e] cyclosporin, tacrolimus, oclacitinib or lokivetmab when administered to a greyhound as an immunomodifier and where it has been prescribed by a veterinarian for the sole purpose of treating or preventing a chronic condition in a greyhound including superficial chronic keratitis [pannus] or allergic/atopic dermatitis.

GAR 139 (1)(n) Permanently Banned Substances, and certain offences in relation to them.

Draft amendment GAR 139(1)(n)

139 Permanently banned prohibited substances, and certain offences in relation to them

1. The following prohibited substances, or any metabolite, isomer or artefact of any of them are deemed to be permanently banned prohibited substances:

...

[n] hypoxia inducible factor [HIF]-1 stabilisers, including but not limited to cobalt and FG-4592, and hypoxia inducible factor [HIF] activators including but not limited to argon and xenon.

GAR 140 (h) Prohibited Substances subject to a threshold. Draft amendment GAR 140(h)

140 Prohibited Substances subject to a threshold

In addition to the exempted substances, a substance is not a prohibited substance for certain offences identified in these Rules if detected at or below the following thresholds in a sample of the specified sample type:

...

(h) prednisolone at or below a mass concentration of 50 nanograms per millilitre in a sample of urine taken from a greyhound.

GAR 146 (6)(g) Therapeutic substances and screening limits – Ketoprofen

Draft amendment GAR 146 (6)(g):

146 Therapeutic substances and screening limits

...

(6) The following screening limits apply:

(g) ketoprofen at a mass concentration of 5 nanograms per millilitre in a sample of plasma or 10 nanograms per millilitre in a sample of urine.

GAR 147 (6)(d) Residue substances and residue limits – Procaine

Draft amendment GAR 147 (6)(d):

147 Residue substances and residue limits

...

(6) The following residue limits apply:

(d) procaine at a mass concentration of 5 nanograms per millilitre in a sample of plasma or 200 nanograms per millilitre in a sample of urine.

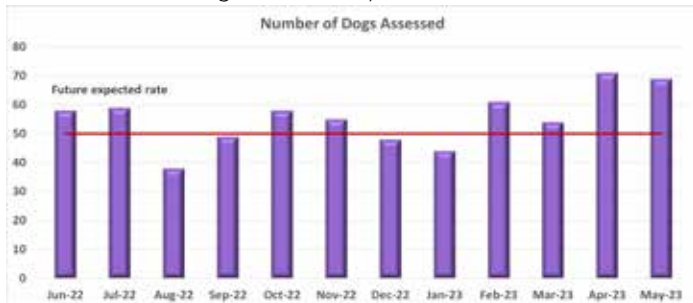

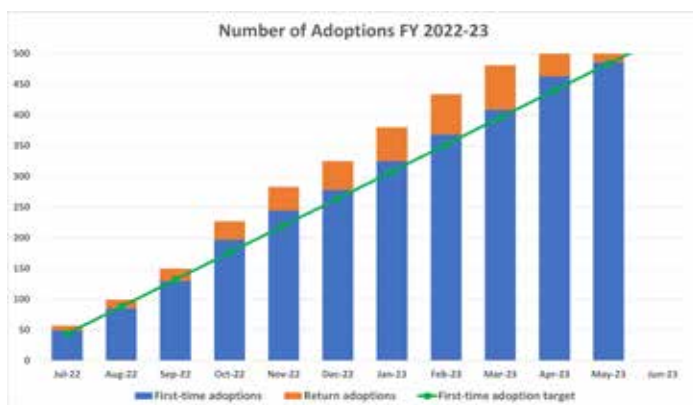
Latest updates from GAP

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialed after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

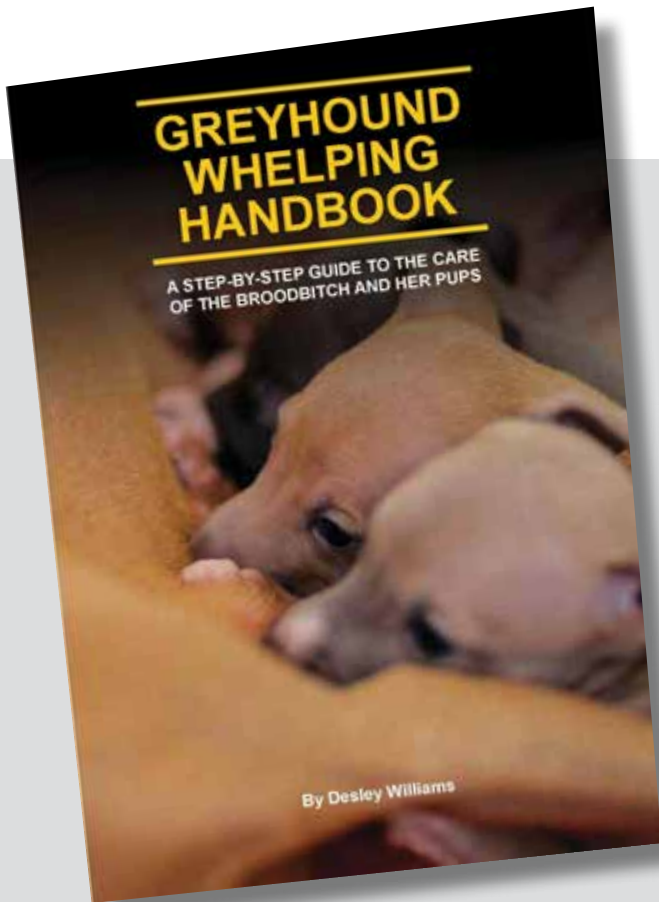
