Settlement of Federal Court proceedings

When the Point of Consumption (POC) tax was introduced by the [then] Labor Government in July 2017, a commitment was given to the codes that they would be compensated for the impact of the introduction of the tax and that they would be no worse off. A compensation payment of \$4,850,000 was ultimately paid to Racing SA, but when that body came to breaking down the compensation amount by code, the payment GRSA was being asked to accept was significantly disproportionate to its market share. It was suggested by the other codes that this had been agreed. GRSA rejected the notion that there had ever been such agreement and was unfortunately left with no alternative in the face of uncompromising positions being adopted by the Thoroughbred and Harness codes but to seek recourse through the Federal Court to resolve the dispute in a manner that was fair to greyhound racing.

The trial of the matter was due to commence on June 19. The parties participated in mediation on May 31, further to which a settlement sum of an additional \$500,000 was agreed, payable by TRSA and HRSA to GRSA. Additionally, those three bodies agreed (as a term of the settlement) that future Government funding for the racing industry, resulting from the imposition of the POC tax, will flow back in proportion to market share as defined within the context of the Racing Inter-Code Deed (to the extent that those monies have not already been directly allocated by Government to a specific code).

On Friday, the Government announced a \$24 million funding package in support of the racing industry with regard to which we are pleased to advise that a 'fair share' of that full sum will flow back to the greyhound code and its participants. This is an important outcome for greyhound racing and one which provides greater certainty for the future of our sport.

Querencia's continues golden run of form

ANGLE PARK

The golden run for local trainer Kirin Corby continued in brilliant fashion when one of her star chasers Querencia saluted in the Group 3 Howard Ashton final on 30th May.

In front of a large crowd the Group 3 feature for SA Bred greyhounds saw Querencia dominate the market on the back of his blistering 29.30 heat win, followed by a scintillating 29.34 win in the semi final.

Drawing awkwardly in box 5 the son of Dyna Double One and Irish Keepsake was slowly away as his main rival Oakvale Beauty for Nathan Wilson exploded from the boxes to lead clearly into the first turn. Emerley Zero for Judi Hurley moved forward into second with Rock It Fernando for Ron Murch hugging the rail in third. Querencia quickly mustered and was charging forward midfield as the field left the front straight. Into the back straight Oakvale Beauty was making every post a winner by stretching out her lead, however, Querencia moved quickly into second giving chase strongly. Rock It Fernando was holding third with the rest of the field struggling to make ground. Off the back straight Querencia moved up ominously to Oakvale Beauty as the pair levelled and shortly after he put his paw to the floor and ran to the lead as they





turned for home. Rock It Fernando was still chasing hard and looking to challenge for second.

Querencia raced away from his rivals and went down to the finish line a big winner by 3 lengths in sizzling 29.49 which was amazing considering he missed the kick. Oakvale Beauty held off the challenge of Rock It Fernando to finish second by ³/₄ length with all placegetters running brilliantly.

Querencia is owned and bred locally by Kirin Corby and joins the likes of Sennachie and Tauwitchere as recent Group winners for Kirin. He has now won



6 races from his 9 starts including 2 minor placings and prizemoney around \$38,000.

The feature race was named in honour of GCA Hall of Fame member, Howard Ashton. Howard was instrumental in the professional running of Greyhound Racing in South Australia for many, many years as an Administrator of the Industry. He started his journey at Angle Park almost 50 years ago and only retired from the industry a few years ago.

South Australia has only 2 other inductees in the GCA Hall of Fame, Brian Johnstone and Doug Payne, who also have races named in their honour.

Government funding announced

On Saturday the State Government announced a \$24m investment into the South Australian racing industry across 4 years, including an upfront \$8 million payment available to the three peak racing bodies.

"We have made it quite clear we are looking at ways to secure the State's economic future by investing in industries that grow the economy and provide substantial benefits to the community," Mr Wingard said.



'Origin-al' path to Adelaide Cup part of exciting cross-state initiatives

Victorian and South Australian-based trainers will have a new direct path to the Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final under exciting new cross-state initiatives being introduced by Greyhound Racing Victoria (GRV) and Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA).

The industry-first initiatives include the winner of GRSA's State of Origin series, to be held at Angle Park on 26 September, being guaranteed a berth in the \$75,000 to-the-winner Adelaide Cup Final on 11 October. The State of Origin series is run along similar lines to Sandown's Speed Star, with four Vic-trained greyhounds clashing with four locals under match race conditions.

The format sees the GRSA grader select the best four nominated greyhounds from each State and rank them from 1 to 4, with 1 being the highest rank. The head-to-head match races will pit the two number 1 sprinters from each State against each other, followed by 2 vs 2, 3 vs 3 and 4 vs 4, with the overall winning greyhound earning \$7500. The State of Origin series was introduced in 2018 and is sure to create even greater interest among Victorian trainers in its second year with the inclusion of the massive carrot of bypassing the Adelaide Cup heats.

A guaranteed Adelaide Cup spot isn't the only benefit awaiting the State of Origin winner. In addition to gaining direct entry into the Adelaide Cup Final, the State of Origin victor will also secure a position in the Group 3 Sandown Shootout, the four-sprinter feature to be run on 14 November.

Another innovation will see the winner of the Adelaide Cup

receive automatic entry, should connections accept, into the invitation-only Group 1 Topgun at The Meadows, which will be run this year on 9 November. With positions in the Adelaide Cup and Shootout on offer, State of Origin places will be keenly sought after and the winner of Sandown's Speed Star series, to be held on 15 September, will be rewarded with one of the four Victorian spots in the Origin series.

GRV CEO Alan Clayton said the cross-state initiatives would generate broader interest in greyhound racing. "GRV and GRSA are delighted to introduce such unique opportunities to participants and their greyhounds and these new initiatives will add another dimension to our sport," Mr Clayton said.

"Victoria and South Australia have a great history of friendly rivalry across a number of sports, and if we can bring some of that parochialism into the greyhound racing world it has the potential to captivate interest from general sports fans."

GRSA Racing Manager, Shaun Mathieson said the alignment between the two state industry bodies demonstrates their close working relationship. "GRSA and GRV are consistently focussed on providing real benefit to its participants, as well as increasing interest in greyhound racing." Mr Mathieson.

"This linking of interstate feature races is an industry first and we believe that the linking of these feature races will bring an increased quality in fields, resulting in a better racing product. GRSA is a proud innovator, consistently pushing to bring positive outcomes to the industry."

More Rum Bateman provides memorable victory for Murnane

In front of a huge June crowd at Angle Park on June 6th More Rum Bateman for trainer Kevin Murnane landed the prestigious Shane McQueen Feature when the son of My Bro Fabio and Miss Tupelo came from the clouds to score an upset victory.

More Rum Bateman had been in consistent form over the staying trip and put the writing on the wall with an eye catching second in the heats over the 600m, however, due to the high quality of the field he was sent out at double figure odds by the bookies and paid an amazing \$46.00 on the TAB for his victory.

As the start was affected More Rum Bateman (box 5) was fairly away with Love Made Me [2] for Troy Murray, Staunch As [3] for Derek Anderson, Master Chaos [6] for Irene Rehmann, Come Home [7] for Lisa Rasmussen and Jack Get Back (8) for Ken Trowbridge all pushing hard for the lead. Into the front straight Love Made Me was crossed by Staunch As who was first challenged by Master Chaos but then the pair were crossed by Come Home who charged to the front down the front straight. Meanwhile More Rum Bateman was getting balanced up and starting to go through his gears as they left the front straight. Into the back straight and Come Home had a length



advantage over Master Chaos who was looming ominously while Jack Get Back and Staunch As battled out for third. Off the back straight and More Rum Bateman still had plenty of work to do from midfield as both Come Home and Master Chaos looked to have the race amongst themselves. Turning for home and Master Chaos levelled up with Come Home however More Rum Bateman had gone past Jack Get Back into third and set his sights on the leaders. Down the final straight and More Rum Bateman sprouted wings to claim the leaders and go on and win by almost 1 length in a flying 35.05 for the 600m with a brilliant finishing burst. Master Chaos continued his good form into second and Come Home also ran well for third.

On the dais Kevin Murnane was gracious in winning the McQueen final, a race he had been chasing for a number of years and paid tribute to the McQueen family which were in attendance. One of his biggest wins of his training career he also acknowledged the support of his owners and partner and the performance of More Rum Bateman.

More Rum Bateman has now won 7 races with 16 placings from 46 starts with career prizemoney around \$20,000.

The race is named in honour of ex GRSA CEO Shane McQueen who was a terrific greyhound administrator in WA and SA until his untimely passing in 2003.

Futurity payments due this month

Owners of SA Bred greyhounds are reminded that the next batch of Futurity payments are due on Friday, 28th June 2019.

There will be three series' for which payments will need to be made.

The payments due are:

Classic 2019 - Final Payment - Pups Born July 17 to Dec 17

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound.

Breeders 2020 – Second Payment - Pups Born Jan 18 to June 18

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

Classic 2020 - First Payment - Pups Born July 18 to Dec 18

The First Payment is due for Classic 2020. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. The First Payment is \$27.50 per pup or a "one-off" Final payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

To assist all owners of Futurity eligible pups, reminders have been sent out earlier this week. It is perhaps a good idea to make the payment as soon as you can, so it doesn't slip your mind and the closing date passes. If you have sold a pup/s we would ask if you can either forward on the information or let Caralyn Fielden know at GRSA and she can follow it up. If you haven't received a reminder by the end of this week and you think you should have, contact us asap.

Gawler Produce Stake heats this month (not G-SIX)

A reminder to all trainers with greyhounds paid up for the Gawler Produce Stake that the heats will be run on Friday, 21st June. The semis are listed for Friday, 28th June and the final will be held on Sunday, 7th July.

The prizemoney breakdowns will be announced after the number of heats are known, however the final is guaranteed at \$22,000 and consolation at \$2,700.

Nominations for the heats close on Monday, 17th June with GRSA at 9.00am.

The winner of the final is also eligible for a \$7,000 bonus if it can win the 2019 Gawler Gold Cup later this year. If the winner of the Gawler Produce is SA Bred there is also a \$1,000 SA Bred Bonus.

Querencia claims dual awards after breakout month



Greyhound of the Month award for May went to Querencia for trainer Kirin Corby which unanimously received all seven first preference votes from the judging panel on the back of him being undefeated throughout May, highlighted by his brilliant Group 3 Howard Ashton victory late in the month.

The son of Dyna Double One and Irish Keepsake has always been considered one of the most exciting young chasers in the land and proved his talent racing through the Howard Ashton series without tasting defeat. He won his heat by over 13 lengths at Angle Park running 29.30, with that time considered one of the 15 fastest of all time. He then won his semi-final by 8.5 lengths in a blistering 29.34 before being a red hot favourite for the final. He missed the kick and had to work hard to challenge for the lead but by midrace the Group 3 feature was in his keeping going on to win by 3 lengths in an amazing 29.49, considering he missed the start.

At the end of the month Querencia's record stood at 9 starts for 6 wins and 2 placings and earnings around \$37,000 and is now considered the most exciting young chaser in the land.

The Run of the Month for May not surprisingly was Querencia for trainer Kirin Corby as he had produced 3 outstanding wins during the month, however, it was his win in the heat of the Howard Ashton at Angle Park on Thursday, 16th May that ticked the boxes for the judges.

He was able to lead throughout running splits of 4.43 and 16.59 on his way to a flying 29.30 for the 515m journey. He won by over 13 lengths and showed his endless amount of natural speed and talent.



4 dog events for GOTBA Coursing meetings

GRSA has approved that 4 – dog races will continue for upcoming GOTBA meetings. Normally the club would move to 8 – dog events, however, in support of the Club they can run 4 – dog events.

The Clubs next meeting will be run on Sunday, 23rd June at Virginia. As part of their programming the Club will run Masters events if sufficient eligible greyhounds are nominated.

Cinderella's Cleaning Champion Puppy heats in July (Not G-SIX)

Owners and trainers of up and coming youngsters should note that the Champion Puppy series isn't far away.

The Cinderella's Commercial Cleaning Group Champion Puppy Series is for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st July 2017 and is conducted as heats to a final series.

The \$4,820 heats will be run on Thursday, 11th July and the final on Thursday, 18th July. Prizemoney for the 2019 Final will be \$10,710.

Nominations for the heats close on Monday, 8th July with GRSA at 9.00am.

2019 Gawler Breeders heats on July 16 (NO G-SIX)

After the Group 3 Howard Ashton Final last month the Gawler Breeders will be run on Tuesday, 16th July for the heats and the final on Friday, 26th July for those greyhounds that are eligible for Breeders 2019.

2018 National Championships in Western Australia

The GCA National Championships are just around the corner.

The National finals this year will be held at Cannington in Western Australia and are to be conducted on Saturday, 24th August.

Both the National Sprint and National Distance finals will carry prizemoney of \$75,000 to the winner.

The State series' for SA will be held at Angle Park on Thursday, 1st August for the heats with the State finals on the 8th August.

In an effort to support this series ALL states will be conducting their finals on the same night to be run within a 2 hour period. It makes for a great promotional concept.

• Nominations this year will close at the normal time with GRSA which will be at 9am on Monday, 29th July

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Wednesday, 15th May 2019. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

Murray Bridge Showgrounds demolition underway

GRSA advises that demolition works on the track and facilities at the old Murray Bridge Showgrounds site are well underway. This work involves the removal of the clubhouse and judges tower, as well as the starting boxes, track fencing, lure rail, catching pen and lure motor shed.

Participants will no longer be able to use the Showgrounds site to free gallop their greyhounds.

GRSA will discuss with the Club and maintenance staff the possibility of using the new straight track for free galloping outside of the normal racing and trialling schedule. There is also a long term objective to have a dedicated slipping track on the Murray Bridge site.

The exit from the Showgrounds site was a requirement of the Murray Bridge Council, as part of the purchase agreement for the parcel of land where GRSA have built the new greyhound racing facility.

Black shorts available from GRSA

After approval from the ICG, black shorts are now part of the GRSA Dress Code Policy and available for sale from GRSA. These shorts have the GRSA logo embroidered on the back and are the only shorts approved. They cost \$45 and are available in mens and ladies sizes with orders taken if we do not have your size. Black shorts are to be worn with black socks and black shoes. These shorts can be worn at the discretion of the participant at any time.

Red wet weather jackets

GRSA has purchased new red Jackets for Winter as a replacement for the blue Drizeabone jackets which are now no longer available.

These red jackets are at the tracks and are available for purchase at Angle Park for a cost of \$50. GRSA will take orders as required.

After consideration, participants are able to wear the red jackets at their discretion.

GRSA trialling schedule updated

- Murray Bridge from 6pm Tuesday and 8am Friday. STAT and Qualys once a month to be run at 6.50pm 7.15pm the same as Angle Park. Dates will be Tuesday 9/7/19, 13/8/19 and 10/9/19.
- Gawler from 7am Monday and 7am Thursday. Thursday is STAT and Qualys every week
- Angle Park from 6pm Wednesday and 7am Saturday. STAT and Qualys every Wednesday for the corresponding Monday APM meeting [12 days later due to nominations]
- Please note when trialling at Angle Park a ticket is required. To get a ticket trainers must advise staff by paying or for payment to go onto their account. Staff have been advised that greyhounds cannot trial without a ticket being presented.



What is G-SIX Racing?

G-SIX racing is an exciting, innovative trial of 6-dog racing at selected South Australian tracks

How is G-SIX racing different to the current format?

The format of G-SIX racing only differs in that the standard field size reduces from 8 to 6 dogs.

How does the box draw work?

G-SIX racing will adopt a standard approach to drawing six dog fields with vacancies in the 3 and 6 boxes. The runners will still wear the rug colours which traditionally correlate to their box draw - ie 1, 2, 4, 5, 7 and 8. The reserves will carry the standard rug colours of 9 and 10.

Why G-Six?

It is important for racing and sport generally to explore innovative ways to present itself. As the controlling body, we need to look for new approaches to appeal to and engage with our wagering audience.

When does G-SIX start?

G-SIX will commence May 2 for a 3-month trial period.

Where will G-SIX run?

Angle Park, Gawler and Mount Gambier. The dual tracks at the new Murray Bridge venue will continue with the traditional 8 dog format.

What are the advantages of G-SIX?

- More races run at more race meetings
- Cleaner racing with less interference
- Stakemoney increases to SA trainers and owners, worth more than \$1,000,000 annually
- The introduction of a new Thursday timeslot at Mount Gambier to enable consistent weekly scheduling at both Murray Bridge and Mount Gambier

How does G-SIX affect the current racing schedule?

The racing schedule will expand to accommodate two weekly meetings at each of its TAB venues. The introduction of G-SIX will signal the introduction of a consistent Thursday afternoon timeslot at Mount Gambier and enable racing at Murray Bridge each Wednesday. The commencement of G-SIX racing will coincide with the introduction of straighttrack racing at Murray Bridge.

How will G-SIX racing affect the 3rd place dividend for wagering?

No 3rd place dividend will apply to G-SIX racing as is the normal practice for 6-dog fields. It follows that place dividends for 1st and 2nd will be relatively inflated as a result.

Will all races at the selected venues run in G-SIX format?

Yes, with the exception of a handful of specified feature events held during the 3-month trial including:


Whilst GRSA aims to process applications in a timely manner, participants are encouraged to ensure all paperwork is correctly completed and lodged with payment as early as possible.

The Golden Rules

Since the introduction of cobalt and arsenic thresholds, all participants should be reminded – in their own best interests – that there are a number of Golden Rules that can help them to avoid making any such breaches (for prohibited substances generally) and which should be adhered to as principles of best practice:

- Always consult your vet to seek guidance in relation to any of the products that you are using, any associated risks and other relevant context
- Review the range of any feeds or supplements that you typically purchase and, wherever it is reasonable to do so, replace products containing substances that could contribute to a threshold breach under the rules (eg. cobalt) with alternative products
- Observe the instructions on any products that you use and adhere strictly to those directions (having regard for prescribed amounts, frequency of administration/ application, methodology for administering/applying)
- Ensure a greyhound is never administered any treatment on race day other than as relates to its feeding and drinking requirements [GAR83[A][1] treats this as a specific offence]
- Refrain from the use of injectable treatments (eg. Vitamin B12) to any extent that is practical, including ensuring a greyhound is not administered any injectables the day before an event

Our registered participants have the responsibility to ensure that greyhounds are presented to the track free of any prohibited substances. This information is offered as advice in good faith and should not be relied on as a defence in the event of a breach occurring.


Projects Update

Strategic Projects Manager Scott Wuchatsch



There are a number of reasonably significant projects in progress at tracks across the state, as GRSA's focus on best practice facilities and infrastructure continues. The following provides an update on the status of these projects.

Murray Bridge 300m Start



As previously advised to the industry, the commencement of straight track racing at Murray Bridge has been further delayed following a decision by the GRSA Board and management to replace the current 300m chute start with a moveable box system (dropped on by crane).

This action has been taken in direct response to industry feedback, after concerns were raised with the alignment of the outside track fence and the possibility of crowding at the point where the chute meets the track proper.

Planning is well progressed to install this alternate system,

however, the delay to the commencement of straight track racing remains subject to contractor timeframes. GRSA hopes to have a likely timeframe of works in the coming days.

The works will not only involve the installation of the crane system, but also the realignment of the track fence, a concrete outer plinth and gutter, changes to the irrigation system and possible grassing of the chute (refer plan below).

GRSA is obviously very keen to see the commencement of straight track racing in SA and as such is working feverishly to ensure racing can commence as soon as possible.

Investigating Angle Park Track Upgrade

Management is currently in the process of investigating options for the refurbishment and/or redesign of the Angle Park track.

Participants would be aware of the many challenges that exist with the current infrastructure, these include but are not limited to:

- Inadequate track drainage (results in surface water)
- No proper base under track

- Concrete plinths uneven and lifting in places
- Aging lure system (several failures in recent years)
- Track fencing and advertising signage dilapidation

As part of these investigations, GRSA will need to consider modern track design elements. Some of these, such as transition turns, have been incorporated in all track rebuilds over the past 20 years. One of the more recent track design changes has been the raising of cambers, largely based on the work of the University of Technology Sydney (UTS) in identifying best practice track design.

GRSA will look to include both these elements (transition turns and increased camber) into the refurbishment. The advice being provided to the industry by UTS is that these changes have a significant impact in reducing racing injuries.

The Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club (AGRC) is working with management (as part of a project team) to identify what will be the best option for the industry, one that retains certain elements of the current track, yet incorporates modern design standards.

Once the initial design has been finalised, it will be made available to industry participants for comment and feedback.

Mount Gambier Kennel House refurbishment

Planning is well underway for the complete refurbishment of the Mount Gambier kennel house, currently scheduled to occur in August/September this year (subject to final approval by the GRSA Board on 27th June).

The project will involve the following elements:


- Removing the old
 concrete/brick kennels
- New internal cladding of the entire building
- Epoxy floor coating
- Revised configuration to incorporate a small Stewards room
- New kennel security cages
- New stainless steel kennel cages
- Replacement of some old
 air-conditioning units

The refurbishment will bring the kennel house building up to a more modern standard, in line with the existing kennel houses around the State. GRSA is applying a long term focus to the quality of finishes on the refurbishment, which hopefully will limit future expenditure on the building. This focus on quality will hopefully be apparent to local participants upon completion of the project.

One of the key elements of this project

is the requirement is the requirement to continue to race throughout the works. GRSA is confident that the planning for a temporary kennel building will be more than adequate for the 6 week construction period.

The following plan is the design the team is working towards.

History of Port Augusta Greyhound Club

In the early 1970's greyhound racing was booming in the north of the State. Whyalla and Port Pirie raced TAB meetings on

alternate Wednesdays. Port Augusta had 45 trainers, 100 members and 200 greyhounds regularly supplying greyhounds for both tracks.

Leading northern trainer Harold "Socky" Grantham had his own trial track adjacent to the Port Augusta Racing Club just outside Port Augusta. With so much interest in greyhound racing a Committee lead by astute trainers Ray MacDonald [our first President] and Wally Rosmann was formed with the intention of applying for a licence to race at Port Augusta.

Club supporters faced quite a bit of opposition to greyhound racing at Port Augusta – not from the township itself – but from other Associations within the greyhound industry who felt there were already too many tracks.

The Port Augusta Greyhound track was built around the picturesque Chinnery Park oval when the foundations were laid in 1972. "Relay for Life" supporting Cancer, schools and sporting clubs such as football, cricket, athletics and soccer also use the oval.

Like most country Clubs improvements have only been possible because of voluntary labor. The facilities were built and solely funded by the Port Augusta Greyhound Club. The covering of the Bookmaker's ring where Patrons are well catered for, Verandah in front of the parade ring at kennel-house and over greyhound starting boxes have been welcome additions along the way.

The surface is beautifully grassed with the track and surroundings always kept in an impeccable condition. The turns are banked leading to good size straights offering all greyhounds an even opportunity. A Bramich lure is installed with 80 kennels in the spacious air-conditioned kennel-house.

On 17 July, 1975, the Port Augusta Greyhound Club received approval for registration as a trial track which paved the way for trophy meetings to be held. In order to obtain a licence the Club amalgamated with the Port Pirie Greyhound Club [known as Spencer Gulf Greyhound Racing Club] and held its first registered race meeting on 10th June 1978. A huge crowd was in attendance and the first race at Chinnery Park was won by "Quiet Ben" owned/trained locally by the late Barb and Vin Collins. The first Port Augusta Cup was won by "African Trilogy" owned/trained by the late Darcy and Maureen Miller from Gladstone.

Racing was originally contested over 503m and 682m. In 1982 the popular 447m was introduced and in 2016 the 682m was replaced with 591m.

The amalgamation between the two Clubs was unsuccessful

and on 30th June 1979 each Club went its separate way and conducted their affairs as a separate entity.

Valuable records and history were lost when fire destroyed the kennel-house, Stewards' room and Secretary's office in 1993 and again when vandalised a couple of years later.

We survived rationalisation in 1998 and to provide a service during the summer months we were requested by Greyhound Racing SA to look at possibility of installing lighting. This we did at considerable expense to ourselves and with the support of the Port Augusta City Council. Our first night meeting conducted under lights on 20 January, 2000 saw a huge crowd in attendance. In an endeavour to assist the trainers who travelled long distances we changed to twilight meetings. This was well received and excellent support and patronage has continued over the years from both trainers and local patrons alike creating a wonderful atmosphere during the summer months.

With the closure of the Whyalla Club in 2008, Greyhound Racing SA agreed to allow that Club to have additional meetings scheduled at the Port Augusta track to stimulate growth and maintain the greyhound population in both Whyalla and Port Augusta.

With countrytrack closures imminent in 2011 we were once again successful in submitting our case to continue greyhound racing in the north of the State with on-going support from the Port Augusta City Council and our very supportive Patron Dan van Holst Pellekaan MP. Sadly, now with the changing landscape and as a non-TAB track it has been a struggle to attract enough greyhounds to hold meetings and the difficult decision was made by the Committee earlier this year to cease racing.

The Club has been well served by many wonderful people which has allowed us to stay viable over the past 41 plus years. We are very proud of what we have achieved due to a very strong Committee and an amazing band of hardworking, dedicated Volunteers ably supported by the loyal Ladies Supporters Club.

All this would not have been possible without the great assistance received over many years from Greyhound Racing SA, Port Augusta City Council, Patron Dan Van Holst Pellekaan MP, and our many valued Sponsors.

Last, but by no means least we extend our sincere thanks to the loyal Owners/Trainers from nearby Whyalla, Port Pirie and surrounding areas and to those who have travelled from as far away as Broken Hill, Gawler area, Strathalbyn and Adelaide. Your support over many years has been invaluable.

We have all met some incredible people along the way and lifelong friendships have been formed. Thanks everyone for your support over this incredible journey.

Do you have a small dog?




Latest updates from GAP

Noosa Parade boosts Iron Dog prospects

MOUNT GAMBIER

With a 600 metre third placing (and four points) in the first round of the Winning Post Supplies Iron Dog, Ecklin South greyhound Noosa Parade, in order to stay in contention, was always going to have to find plenty in the 732 metre second round at Tara Raceway.

And the 4½-year-old 108 start veteran certainly kept the hopes alive for the Warrnambool-based Geoff Lewis managed Noosa Syndicate and his 25-year-old trainer Peter Fulton when running down the odds-on favourite Cryer's Plugger in the second heat.

Having only his second start over the staying journey, Noosa Parade gave the front-running favourite a fair start early but down the back started to get busy before finishing the stronger in the run home for a two length win in 43.76 seconds.

The son of Collision and Miss Black Fern has been based at Ecklin South for his entire racing career, Fulton describing the black dog as a real trier.

"He's been a terrific dog for us, although to be honest, he would probably now be better placed to see out his racing career in an area such as Mount Gambier. In the meantime, though, we'll continue to race him but we're open to all offers."

Noosa Parade's win took him to 10 points and with two 512 metre heats on Sunday 16th June to wrap up the three-distance series he's right in the mix, now only one point behind the joint leaders Dyna Quota, Black Spring and Cryer's Plugger.

The Nicole Stanley trained Dyna Quota, winner of this year's SA Distance Championship (731m) at Angle Park, was the stand-out stayer of the Iron Dog and she needed a win in the second round in order to be about the place prior to the running of her 512 metre heat.

The clash of Dyna Quota and Cap Abbott's Black Spring, in what was the first 732 metre race run at Tara Raceway since the end of July last year, didn't disappoint.

In the end, the daughter of Dyna Double One x Jayney Bale had 1¼ lengths to spare over Black Spring in 43.50 seconds – the second-fastest ever run at the track and only three-quarters of a length outside Nellie Noodles' eight-year-old track record. And Abbott can lay claim to having the third-fastest greyhound to have gone around over the distance at Tara Raceway with Black Spring running 43.59 seconds.

Dyna Quota is raced by Glen Burns, Scott Brandon and Danny Fraser of the Cheap Buy Syndicate – well-named in view of the fact that they picked up the black bitch for \$1000 last November.

The return of distance racing at Tara Raceway certainly added to the meeting. Let's hope we won't have to wait another 11 months before seeing the stayers go around again on a Sunday afternoon.



Gary's first winner came in race 1. a Maiden over the 400m journey, which saw Firecracker Miss [7] overtake early leader Break Out [5] mid race to win by nearly four lengths. Bangor Mist [8] was second for Ray Burgess of Napperby, with Mr Mouchos [4] third for David Hall of Paskeville.

The next race, also a 400m Maiden, saw Yeah Nah Gary [2] go straight to the front and after an early tussle, was able to shake off She's Mini Winny [9], going on to win with the convincing margin of just over six lengths. She's Mini Winny maintained second spot for Leanne Fagan of Calomba, with Puma Country [8] third for Bob Isaacson of Lewiston.

Firecracker Miss and Yeah Nah Gary are trained at Owen by Gary Pidgeon, and raced in partnership with his wife Michaela. These two winners are the first two to race from a litter of eight that were bred by Gary. Their mother is his own La Nina Lady, which traces its line back to the second greyhound that Gary ever raced, named Universal Lady, which was a very successful greyhound, winning 32 races from 87 starts.

Gary wasn't expecting a win with either dog today, as they were both coming back from a short break after injury, and

needed a few runs .He had however noticed that there had been a general improvement as they mature and gained experience. Yeah Nah Gary had copped a big bump at his first start and has taken time to find his feet, but Gary said he was pleased with the big improvement he had shown today.

Gary started training at a youthful age in 1981, but gave it away for a while, before resuming about twenty years ago. He has about twenty greyhounds in work, and is ably assisted by his wife Michaela, who trained her first winner in her own name, a month ago. Gary supports the new greyhound racing format known as G-Six racing, which has a field of only six runners, particularly for young greyhounds which is currently being trialled in SA.

At the track for the first time were Gary's friends Owen Parker and Valerie Black, who both hail from Owen as well. They certainly picked a good day to do that, witnessing Gary's double, and Gary is introducing them to the sport through a racing syndicate. Gary had a great record for the day with his two winners from as many starters, but he did recall that his best effort was three from three. It would be great to be able to do that every week!

TRIALS ANGLE PARK

ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

Under the new schedule Angle Park Qualifying Trials will be run weekly on Wednesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting (12 days later due to nominations). With 388m racing now available on Monday nights trainers can qualify for all distances.

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Wednesday of the meeting.

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK AND GAWLER BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Tuesday and Friday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the race meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start

2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track

3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA by midday on Monday to nominate. Should the

Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.

- 2. For Gawler Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before.
- 3. For Murray Bridge Wednesday, the trainer is to contact

GRSA by 4.30pm the day before. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.

- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- 6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
 Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be

permitted to leave with Stewards permission.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound gualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER

The Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club will conduct satisfactory trials under the criteria below:

- 1. On race days only when there are less than 12 races scheduled
- 2. These trials must be booked with GRSA by 4.30pm the day before a mid-week meeting and 4pm on the Friday prior if a Sunday meeting.

GRSA reserves the right to alter or amend this policy at any time.
