CEO'S UPDATE

Challenging Times

In addition to the issues that the industry has observed in relation to the liquidity of some UBET pools, we are now facing a double-pronged attack of human and canine coronavirus [the latter presenting as gastroenteritis]. Whilst this obviously complicates what had already become a tricky year, there is currently a silver lining around our circumstances which cannot be ignored – unlike so many other small traders, businesses and sports that are at genuine risk of succumbing to the impact of Covid-19, greyhound racing has an opportunity to continue. This is something that cannot be taken for granted and is an opportunity that we need to try to preserve at all costs.

As is the case with the management of human coronavirus, our response to the threat of the canine gastroenteritis outbreak has needed to evolve as circumstances change. We've continued to consult with groups like the ICG and the Mt Gambier Club in the background to the greatest extent possible, but it's also a time for making [informed] decisions quickly and refining any impact in the run. On the whole, our trainers continue to demonstrate their willingness to put the industry before themselves, through self-reporting and naming of premises, and that's a credit to them.

The ICG meets tomorrow morning to discuss a range of issues, but the management of these viruses and their impact will be front and centre of that agenda. A focus of tomorrow's discussion will be how we clear trainers for racing and recommence GAP services as quickly as possible but with absolute regard for doing so safely. I ask all of industry to continue to work constructively with us to refine the strategies that have been rolled out so that we can work towards a strong recovery for the sport, here in South Australia, as quickly as possible.

In closing, it's not my intention to reiterate any of the practical measures that our people can take to restrict the spread of Covid-19 – they have been widely broadcast. The key with such moments is that we each individually make the commitment to stay true to those measures and to the principles that are being preached, and remain completely diligent about protecting the health of those around us. A healthy industry can lead to a healthy outcome in the longer term.

GREYHOUND RACING TO CONTINUE IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA WITH RESTRICTED ATTENDANCE - COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) UPDATE

In considering the impact of COVID-19 within the greyhound racing industry, Greyhound Racing SA, in consultation with key industry stakeholders have determined that as of today (Tuesday 17/3/2020) only essential staff and licenced trainers, owners and catchers with greyhounds engaged at the race meeting will be permitted entry at race meets until further notice. This is a direct effort to protect the wellbeing of industry participants, staff and the general public from contracting COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS).

Attendance at race meetings and trials will be restricted to that of:

- Licenced trainers, owners and catchers with greyhounds engaged at the race meeting (and their children when alternative arrangements cannot be made)
- Essential staff

During this time there will be no tote (TAB) service or no catering. Licenced trainers and owners are allowed to bring their own food and non-alcoholic drinks.

Greyhound Racing SA appreciate the acceptance of these measures by all participants and fans of greyhound racing in South Australia. GRSA will continue to work with industry to ensure the safety of the industry and general public is upheld.

Furthermore, GRSA encourages participants to follow the personal hygiene advice found on the SA Health Website and to make all efforts to keep public spacing at race meets including in the kennel house, parade area, at the boxes, post-race, in venue, and wherever else possible.

Mount Gambier Thursday Meetings Temporarily Cancelled

As part of GRSA's strategic response to the Canine Gastroenteritis Thursday meetings at Mount Gambier will be temporarily cancelled.

Nominations for greyhounds that are currently domiciled outside SA will not be allowed until otherwise notified (no exemption will be given for veterinary certification – ie negative to coronavirus). An exemption will be available to interstate trainers (by application) on the condition that they agree not to trial or race in their own state while this policy remains in place. In the event that an interstate nomination has already qualified for the next leg of a series (or a final) in South Australia, that trainer's dogs will be allowed to race but examined by the on-course veterinarian prior to kennelling.

Noting the particular impact that this will have in the south-eastern region of SA, Thursday meetings at Mount Gambier will temporarily be cancelled in an effort to concentrate nominations towards the Sunday meeting's which will continue.

Mount Gambier Cup Series moved to late May/early June 2020

With the recent response to the Canine Gastroenteritis that GRSA released earlier affecting participation in the South East, GRSA, after consultation with the Mount Gambier Club and various stakeholders have decided to move the Listed Mount Gambier Cup series to late May/earlier June.

The Cup series was meant to kick off on Sunday, 29th March, however, with these restrictions in place it was considered appropriate to make the move.

The Heats will now be conducted on Sunday, 31st May with the Final on Sunday, 7th June 2020. All associated features with the series including the Produce Store Maiden Heats and feature events on Cup day will move with the Cup. GRSA thanks the support for all concerned regarding this change.

Murray Bridge Cup / Mount Gambier Cup bonuses

GRSA will continue a couple of bonuses to link both the Murray Bridge Cup which was won by Hot Sophie and trained by Tony Rasmussen and the Mt Gambier Cup Final now programmed to run on Sunday, 7th June. They will include a \$5,000 bonus if Hot Sophie can win both the Murray Bridge Cup and Mount Gambier Cup and a \$5,000 trainer bonus if Tony Rasmussen can win both Cups as trainer (can be different greyhounds).

Murray Bridge trial changes in March

In March due to the Speedway being conducted on Sundays at Murray Bridge there will be some date changes.

These dates will be Friday, 27th March for Murray Bridge and Sunday night for Gawler on 29th March. With this being the case the trial days will be swapped with Gawler trialling on Friday, 27th and Murray Bridge trialling on Thursday, 26th March.

GRSA also advise that from March there will no longer be officiating staff available to clear greyhounds for Satisfactory trials and Qualifying Qualy trials on the fortnightly Tuesday nights at Murray Bridge. GRSA will send an official to Murray Bridge on a monthly basis on a Friday morning trial session, which has both tracks trialling. This presents an opportunity to also include the Straight Track for Qualifying and Satisfactory Trials. The trial session for April will be Friday, 24th April.

ICG meeting – Friday March 20

The next Industry Consultative Group meeting will be held at GRSA on Friday, 20th March.

An Agenda will be sent out to the panel shortly for discussion at the meeting.

600m Easter Cup heats coming up on April 2

The \$4,560 Heats of the Mixed 3/4/5 Easter Cup will be run over 600m for a \$7,750 Final on Thursday, 9th April.

- Nominations for the Heats close on Monday, 30th March at 9.00am with GRSA.

Easter features at Gawler on Easter Monday

Easter racing comes to Gawler in April with both the Gawler Future Stars Final and Gawler Easter Sprint programmed on Monday, 13th April.

The Gawler Future Stars Heats will be conducted for SA Bred greyhounds whelped in 2018 on Friday, 3rd April over the 531m with a \$4,500 Final on Easter Monday. Also on Easter Monday will be the Gawler Easter Sprint for Grade 4 and Grade 5 greyhounds over the 531m worth \$3,500. It's going to be a terrific night of racing on the Monday night over the Easter break.

Coorong Lucy wins after another great month



Greyhound of the Month for February was Coorong Lucy for trainer Cameron Butcher who made it back to back awards for the start of the year after she had an unblemished record for the month winning all four of her starts.

The daughter of Worm Burner and Molly Be Nimble started the month off with an easy win in a Juvenile at headquarters running a slick 29.74 in winning by over 5 lengths. She then stepped out in the prestigious St Leger series where she was the overwhelming favourite. She won her Heat in easy fashion by over 4 lengths in 29.82 and then produced an outstanding run in the Final to score a blistering win by just over 1 length in 29.87. Her last run for the month was a slashing win in Open company where she sizzled around the Angle Park loam in 29.50 in winning by over 8 lengths.

At the end of the month Coorong Lucy's record stood at 29 starts for 21 wins and 6 placings and earnings around \$71,495.

Coorong Lucy also claimed the Run of the Month for February for Cameron Butcher for her exceptional win at Angle Park over the 515m on Thursday, 20th February in the SA St Leger Final.

She began very well to be up vying for the early lead before being checked losing a number of lengths. She balanced up and gave chase, charging home to score by 1.25 lengths going away from her rivals. Coorong Lucy's overall time was a slick 29.87 with splits of 4.49 and 17.32 with a run home in a blistering 12.55.

“Easter” Match Race series in April

The “Easter” Match Race series will be held on Thursday night, 9th April (Easter) at headquarters.

This event is for South Australian local greyhounds with selection for the series based around winning times for greyhounds that have run over the 515m at any Angle Park meeting since 1st December, 2019 along with those that have trialled (see trialling conditions below) to set a time.

It will be an exciting night with innovative coverage from inside the boxes and around the track for each match race. There will be specific greyhound rugs for each greyhound adding to the promotion around the Easter theme. Prizemoney for each match will be between \$4,500 and \$3,000 with GRSA adding \$500 for each greyhound which places second in their match. The overall winner will collect \$6,000. Listed below is the current list of greyhounds (subject to domiciliary eligibility) that have won and broken 29.90 seconds at Angle Park since 1st December, 2019. GRSA will separate equal times to a third decimal point if required closer to the event.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3,

Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. There will be no manual selection from the Grader.

The overall winner of the local Match Race series will be guaranteed a spot in the State of Origin Match race series [SA V Vic] in September so long as it is nominated and eligible to represent SA.

Prizemoney for the match races –

Winners receive - Match 1 – 1 v 4 \$4,500, Match 2 – 2 v 3 \$4,000, Match 3 – 5 v 8 \$3,500, Match 4 – 6 v 7 \$3,000.

Runner Ups receive - \$500.

Overall SA Easter winner (based on overall times) - \$6,000, second \$2,500, third \$1,500.

- Nominations close Monday, 6th April with GRSA at 9.00am.

Trialling conditions

Trials will be conducted Thursday, 19th March, Thursday, 26th March and Thursday, 2nd April at the Angle Park race meetings over the 515m.

There will be up to eight trials conducted each night, with a maximum of two dogs per trial and a total of 8 greyhounds trialling per night. These trials will be run between races at the discretion of the Stewards. Trainers must book these trials with Greyhound Racing SA by 11.00am on the day.

All greyhounds will be eligible to trial. Whether on the current list of greyhounds that have broken 29.90 seconds in winning since 1st December, 2019 at Angle Park to improve their position or haven't won over the 515m from 1st December, 2019 or any other reason at the absolute discretion of the Grader. Local eligibility conditions still apply. Each greyhound will only be allowed to trial once in an effort to improve their position or obtain a spot on the list.

Murray Bridge Straight Track Cup confirmed in May 2020

GRSA advise that the inaugural Murray Bridge Straight Track Cup Final will be run on Wednesday, 27th May 2020 worth \$7500/\$2140/\$1070.

The Heats will be conducted on Wednesday, 20th May 2020.

2020 Gawler Produce – final payment due on Friday, 3rd April

After the second payment was made in January there are still 96 greyhounds eligible for the 2020 Gawler Produce series which is terrific for the Club and is shaping as another exciting series.

The final is guaranteed at \$22,000 which has a \$8,000 bonus if a greyhound can win both the Produce Final in July and the Gawler Gold Cup Final in November later this year.

The racing dates for this series will be Heats on Friday, 19th June 2020, Semi-Finals on Friday, 26th June 2020 and the Final on Sunday, 5th July 2020.

Hobart Bushfire Appeal Night a huge success

Canine gastroenteritis update

REMINDER TO TRAINERS & BREEDERS

YOU MUST REPORT!!! If any greyhounds in your kennels (racing greyhounds, brood bitches, puppies or retired greyhounds) are displaying the following symptoms - vomiting, diarrhoea, elevated temperature, lethargy, and/or loss of appetite – **YOU MUST CONTACT GRSA STEWARDS IMMEDIATELY** on [08] 8243-7100 or after hours on 0487 189 366 [Des Jonas – Chief Steward]

ACTIVE CASES (CONFIRMED & HIGHLY SUSPECTED)

Nine [9] active cases of Canine Gastroenteritis that are now either confirmed or highly suspected (multiple ill greyhounds in same kennel) in South Australia, all of whom have entered a period of quarantine.

GRSA expects that all participants undertaking quarantine will not attend trial sessions or race meetings whilst they are in quarantine.

QUARANTINE PERIOD – (14 DAYS MINIMUM FROM LAST CASE)

GRSA will not impose a mandatory period of quarantine on any trainer that are suspected, or have been confirmed to have greyhounds that have contracted the Canine Gastroenteritis virus. It will instead recommend affected trainers self-quarantine their kennel for a minimum period of 14 days from the time of the last greyhound in their kennel showing signs of the virus. Management are currently talking with industry Vets to understand the correct protocols in regards to the return to racing and may make further adjustments to the quarantine period advice.

Whilst the onus will be on the trainer to manage this period, the GRSA Racing Department, in conjunction with Stewards, may refuse nominations from trainers that (a) its felt that haven't served a long enough period of quarantine to ensure their greyhounds are free of the virus, or (b) are suspected of being impacted by the virus but have failed to self-report. In the case of (b), Stewards will conduct their own enquiries (which may include testing) to be confident that greyhounds are fit, health and not contagious when being nominated to race.

SA TRAINERS COMPETING INTERSTATE

If a South Australian trainer chooses to race or trial a greyhound interstate (e.g. Fantastic Reef in the Launching Pad), they will need to isolate that greyhound on their property once it returns to SA. The greyhound will also be subject to a mandatory period of 10 days of no racing or trialling in SA from the date of its interstate engagement/trial. Stewards will work with individual trainers in this regards, but recommends contact is made with GRSA prior to a trainer taking a greyhound interstate to race or trial.

Farewell from Lisa

Earlier this month I resigned from my role as Integrity Manager with my last day being in early April.

It is an exciting time for me after being a racing administrator for the last 13 years. Regulation is not the most popular role but it is so important to ensure everyone has a 'fair go' in any sport.

I am very proud to have been part of some significant change for the betterment of our industry including:

- A significant reduction in euthanasia;
- Local Rules ensuring every greyhound is given the opportunity to be rehomed;
- The success of the Track Injury Surgery Rebate Scheme;
- Improved rigour around ensuring the registration of fit and proper persons;
- Delivering education for all trainers and ongoing education for all of industry;
- The rewrite of the National Rulebook.

I'd like to thank all the Integrity department staff who work tirelessly to improve our industry – they definitely punch above their weight with little recognition of how knowledgeable and dedicated they are. I sincerely wish the industry all the best for the future.

Inquiries, Appeals and Other Disciplinary Notifications

Mr. Dean Decrea – Notice of Warning Off effective 18/02/20 – the GRSA Board considered its history of dealings with unregistered person Mr. Decrea, culminating in his recent posting of highly defamatory online comments against two senior GRSA Managers. Having considered his poor record, the Board issued a warning office effective 18/02/20. Mr. Decrea did not appeal the decision.

GRSA participants are reminded that as a condition of licensing, they are not permitted to have any association with warned off individuals.

All reports from Stewards inquiries and appeal decisions can be found at www.grsa.com.au under the Integrity banner.

What happens if I am disqualified?

This question is often asked after someone has received a penalty resulting in disqualification. The ramifications of being disqualified are far-reaching with impacts on both the person disqualified and those they reside or associate with.

The process that results in disqualification generally involves a formal inquiry process with GRSA Stewards. However, it is important to note that the GRSA Board also has the power to disqualify people without the need for a Stewards inquiry.

After Stewards hand down their penalty, the subject of the disqualification receives a letter from the GRSA integrity department outlining the outcome of the hearing with information about the effects of being disqualified.

These include:

- Training facility – registered persons are not to train, keep or race any greyhounds at any property deemed by the Board as being or having been the training property of a person that has had their registration cancelled through disqualification or other means.
- Transfer of greyhounds – disqualified persons cannot transfer greyhound ownership to anyone residing with them or any relative, including a spouse or domestic partner, whether or not they reside with the disqualified person.
- Access to a racecourse – disqualified persons are not permitted to enter any part of a racecourse, including lands within the property used in connection with greyhound racing during any event. Events include race meetings, all trials and training activity.
- Greyhound training facilities – disqualified persons are not permitted to enter, go onto or remain on any place where greyhounds are trained, kept or raced.
- Breeding – disqualified persons must obtain permission from the GRSA Board before engaging in any greyhound breeding activities, which includes the transfer of breeding units of semen. There are also limitations on who you can transfer units to, even with GRSA Board approval.
- Nominations – disqualified persons are unable to nominate a greyhound to compete in any event.
- Disqualified persons cannot act as an attendant or official at a meeting; train a greyhound; be employed by any person involved in the training of greyhounds; and cannot be a member of a committee of a club involved in greyhound racing.
- Living arrangements – a registered person cannot remain registered if they are living with a disqualified person.

This is not an exhaustive list and there are many other activities that are impacted by disqualification. Rather it is an overview of some of the more common impacts of being disqualified.

Over the next few months work will continue to create a brand-new facility, which will ultimately allow direct access for Vet Clinic clients from the existing car park at the front of McQueen's Tavern.

The relocation will ensure that GRSA and Vet Clinic operations will no longer cross paths and hopefully allow for a more seamless movement of people and greyhounds around the venue.



Canine Gastroenteritis – Bio Security Measures

The recent canine gastroenteritis outbreak has been a challenge for all involved, particularly maintenance and cleaning staff, who without little notice were required to make significant changes in regards to the operation of the department.

Credit must go to all the members of the maintenance team who quickly rallied to make changes to lures, cleaning processes and the logistics of running trial sessions and race meetings.

The expedience with which these changes were implemented was first rate, with GRSA most certainly leading the way nationally in this regard. Hopefully the quick implementation of these initiatives have gone some way to protecting the local industry against disruptions as a result of the gastroenteritis outbreak.



Murray Bridge Slipping Track

Delays have been experienced with construction of the Murray Bridge slipping track, with limited works taking place over recent weeks.

The impediments to the progression of the project have now been resolved and we expect over the coming weeks for more activity on site in relation to the new training facility.

Soon the entrance gates to the entire facility will be automated, which will allow trainers in the future to access the slipping track after hours [same as Angle Park].

Whilst the precise completion date of the project is not yet known, it is expected that the slipping track will be up and running towards the end of this financial year.

Participants will see little projects continuing at all venues across the state and the team will try to keep disruptions to a minimum during this time.

April assessment dates will be communicated at a later stage. Once transport between kennel locations is possible, GAP will schedule extra assessments to catch up with the backlog.

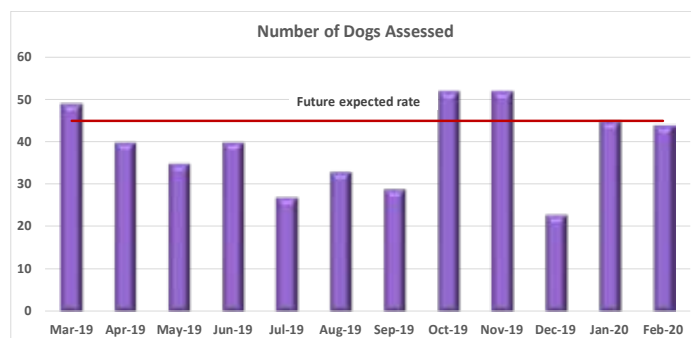

Do you have a small dog?



Do you or someone you know have a small dog that could benefit from some socialisation and company during the day?

GAP SA is looking for small dogs to help with their green collar and first point assessments.

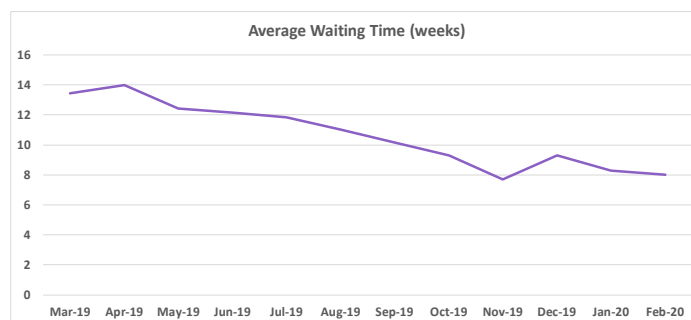
Your dog will be well looked after with plenty of pats and treats throughout the day. They will assist with either green collar assessments for dogs that have been living with foster carers or for greyhounds entering the program.

During assessments, greyhounds will be muzzled, on a leash and handled by an experienced assessor and handlers. All dogs will be walked around together in a secure testing area for approximately 5-10 mins to assess the greyhound's reaction to the small dog. If the greyhound is reacting well we will allow them to approach and sniff the small dog.

We are looking for dogs that are generally social and happy meeting other dogs and ones that walk well on a lead. Sessions are rostered at least a month in advance and are generally around two to four hours in length.

A promising future

Sunday night racing returned to Gawler over the March long weekend, and a great holiday crowd enjoyed a good night of racing.

The feature event on the program was the Gawler Breeders Final, which is part of a paid up series for greyhounds whelped in the first six months of 2018. This race is one of several special races available to this group of greyhounds and is contested over the 400m journey. Heats had been conducted the previous week, which means the Final brought together a very good field.

The public fancy for the event was Maddison Kaye, which drew box 1 in the race and was able to jump away best, to lead as expected. However Dusty Divot [7] challenged for the lead, but after a short tussle, Maddison Kaye was able to maintain her position, although Dusty Divot was in hot pursuit. Maddison Kaye, by running a very smart 22.51 secs, made it a difficult task for the others, and went to the line with 3 lengths in hand. Long Gully Barny ran on well into second placing for Paula Hearnden of Angaston and Dusty Divot was third for Matt Payne of Middleton.

The successful trainer was Des Hockley of Lewiston, who trains the fawn female for Debbie Stuppos of Whyalla. The training duties had previously been undertaken by Debbie's brother, Graham Brown, but the

travelling down from Wyhalla to trial and race was onerous, and consumed a lot of time that could be better spent on their pups. So the decision was made to transfer the training to Des, who has now achieved consecutive wins at Gawler in excellent times, from just three starts. Des and Graham have known each other for many years, so it was not a hard decision to make.

Debbie said that they had wanted to give Maddison Kaye every chance, with the greyhound having a great record of eight wins and three placings from just 13 starts, with 12 of those starts being at Gawler. Debbie wasn't surprised at the two wins,

but was ecstatic about the quick times. She confided that Maddison Kaye wasn't ideally suited to box 1, as she takes a little time to settle in the field before she takes off, but it worked out well on the night.

The name Maddison Kaye comes from the name of the granddaughter of a good family friend who looked after their brood female for some time, which added a nice touch to their story. Debbie said the challenge was now to see how Maddison Kaye handles the 500m racing, but she hasn't done a lot wrong to this point, so the future looks promising.

ANGLE PARK

ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

Under the new schedule Angle Park Qualifying Trials will be run weekly on Wednesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting (12 days later due to nominations). With 388m racing now available on Monday nights trainers can qualify for all distances.

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Wednesday of the meeting.

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Tuesday and Friday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the race meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA by midday on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Gawler Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before.
3. For Murray Bridge Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.
