COVID-19 Policy

On Friday 4th March 2022, GRSA decided to unwind its COVID vaccine mandate policy. The decision was made following a review of the changing COVID circumstances in South Australia. In particular I note that on Wednesday 2nd March 2022, the South Australian Police Commissioner gave a strong indication at a press briefing that the emergency declaration [the legal instrument that underpins all of the COVID directions that are in place] would likely be unwound during March or April. Clearly the South Australian government was signalling its desire to return to a pre-COVID existence.

When GRSA implemented its vaccine mandate it did so with the health of its staff, participants and patrons front of mind. It was also clear from the government advice at the time that a significant factor in the length of time a person would need to isolate should they come into contact with a COVID positive person was in large part dictated by their vaccine status. The risk of losing a number of race meetings was a very real threat given our small pool of race day staff. While COVID clearly remains within our community; the necessity to isolate is now dictated by the wearing of masks [indoors] – rather than a person's vaccine status.

For the time being and until further notice, it's important that we all remain vigilant and continue to do the following:

- Wear masks indoors
- QR Code check-in
- Social distance
- Observe density limits

I sincerely hope we are nearing the end of the time when there is any need for COVID declarations and restrictions. I know it hasn't been easy for everyone but I am very grateful to all of you for playing a part in keeping GRSA safe and operating.

Springvale Maddi claims the SA St Leger

■ ANGLE PARK

The time honoured SA St Leger was held at Angle Park on February 17th where another outstanding performance was produced in the age restricted classic. Springvale Maddi for Cherylee Barber was able to lead throughout and produce a brilliant performance in taking out the title.

Race favourite She's A Hotshot for Troy Murray was heavily supported prior to the event, backed into a long odds on favourite on the back of her flying all the way heat win and the favourable inside draw. However as the start was affected it was Springvale Maddi who timed it perfectly to race to the front at the winning post on the first occasion. She's A Hotshot did begin well and moved to second being challenged by Springvale Max for Gavin Harris, Little Purpose for Lisa Rasmussen and Maybe Wrong for Shelley Trengove as the racing was tight. As the high quality field of young sprinters left the front straight and into the back Springvale Maddi was in the clear out in the lead while Maybe Wrong moved around the outside into a clear second and gave strong chase. She's A Hotshot was a few lengths back in third but was about to be challenged by Springvale Max and her kennel mate Wizardry Things which began to make good ground.

Off the back straight and Springvale Maddi was rolling in the lead out by 3 lengths from Maybe Wrong which was sticking on well. Springvale Max moved to a clear third along the inside followed through by Wizardry Things relegating She's A Hotshot back to worse than midfield. Into the home straight and Springvale Maddi had shot well clear of her rivals going down to the line to win by over 5 lengths in a dominant display. She stopped the clock in a brisk 30.38, setting the race up early with a sizzling 5.23 and 17.71 first and second splits. Springvale Max flew home late to nose out Maybe Wrong for second, making it a litter quinella with his sister, both being by Barcia Bale and Springvale Bryne. Maybe Wrong ran the race of his life to claim third with Wizardry Things getting home well for fourth.

Springvale Maddi is locally bred by Gavin Harris and owned by Gavin and Cherylee and has now won 14 races from her 30 starts and 11 placings with career prizemoney just over \$41,000.

Please be advised the heats for the Breeders 2022 Prelude[1] over 530m will be conducted this Monday night at Angle Park with nominations closing tomorrow at 9am. The Final will NOW be conducted at Angle Park on Thursday 31st March.

At this stage the trials at Angle Park on Saturday 26th March and Tuesday 29th March can proceed without access to the kennel control area.

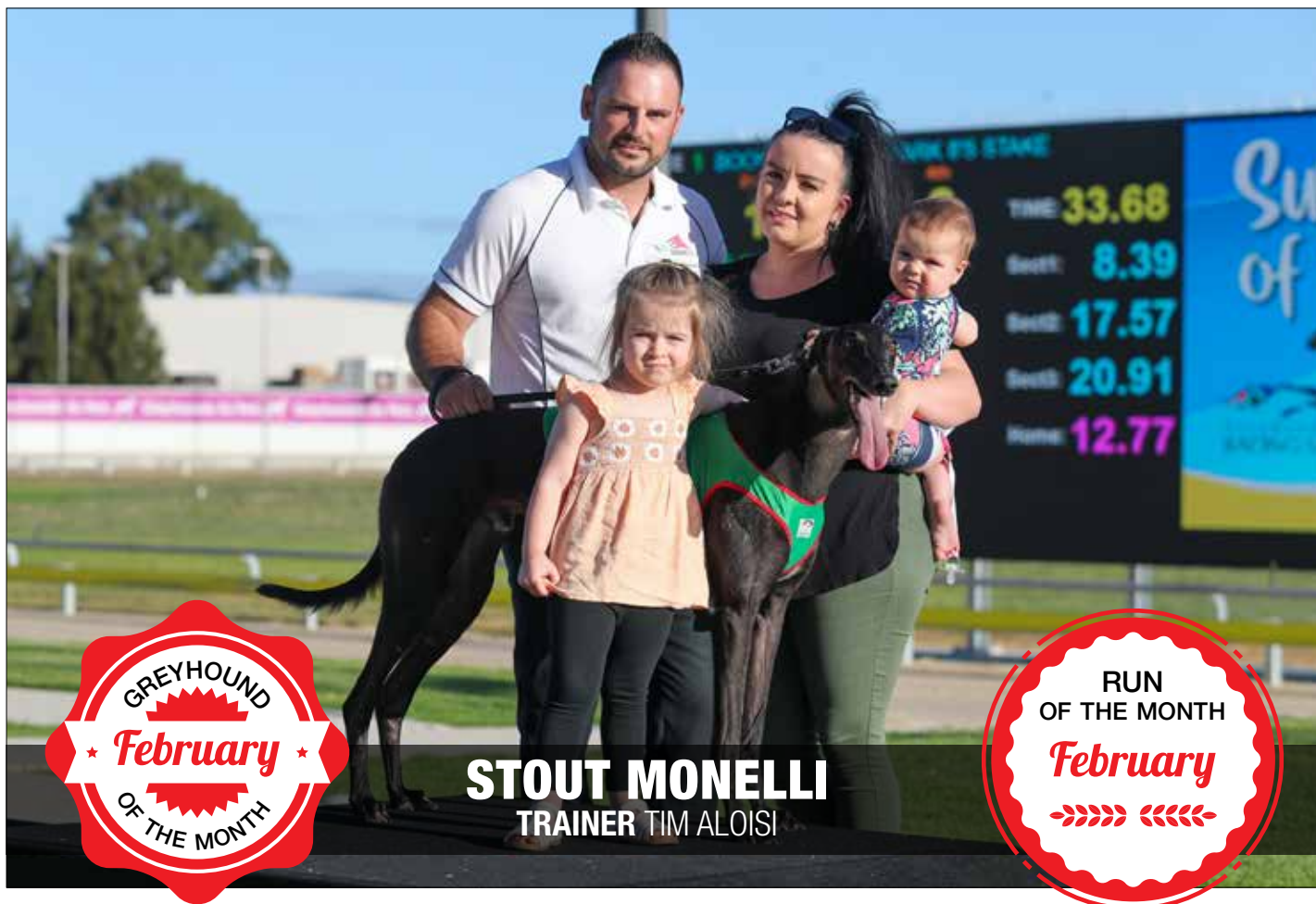

THREE IN A ROW FOR STOUT MONELLI



Greyhound of the Month for February was Stout Monelli for trainer Tim Aloisi making it a three peat of awards for the son of Barcia Bale and Corona Monelli, after he collected the December award last year and the January award this year, with his track record performance over the 595m at Angle Park the highlight of this month.

He had three starts for the month with two wins and a third placing, setting the month alight, kicking off with his track record performance. He stepped up to the 595m with much anticipation and he

didn't disappoint leading all the way for a 6.75 length win in 33.68. He then backed that up with another strong win over 595m in winning by 5.25 lengths before a good third in open company rounding the month off.

At the end of the month Stout Monelli's record stood at 50 starts for 27 wins and 15 placings and earnings just under \$235,000.

The Run of the Month for January was also won by Stout Monelli for trainer

Tim Aloisi after he smashed the track record over the 595m at Angle Park on Thursday, 10th February.

Stepping up to the 595m for the first time he quickly asserted his dominance on his rivals running to the front early and from there he was never going to be caught. He ran splits of 8.39 and 20.90, stopping the clock at 33.68 in winning by almost 7 lengths. He broke the previous best time by .32 meaning he would have beaten that greyhound by over 4 lengths.



BEANIES AVAILABLE

Approved beanies are part of the GRSA Dress Code Policy and available for sale from GRSA. These beanies are GRSA specific and are the only ones approved, at a cost of \$10 and are available to purchase from the GRSA office's.

LOCAL MATCH RACE SERIES “THE SA EASTAR” IN APRIL

The SA local Match Race series coined “The SA Eastar” will be held on Thursday night, 14th April (Easter) at Angle Park.

Eligibility for South Australian local greyhounds will be based around the Nationals conditions. They will need to be trained in SA 76 days out of the last 150 prior to the close of nominations.

Selection for this series will only be based around winning times at Angle Park. For greyhounds that have run over the 530m at Angle Park at any meeting since 1st November, 2021, their fastest winning time will be recognised and put them on the list for selection.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3, Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. There will be no manual selection from the Grader. The top 4 seeded greyhounds will be rewarded with more prizemoney.

The overall winner of the local Match Race series will be offered a spot in the State of Origin Match race series [SA V Vic] in September so long as it is nominated and eligible to represent SA subject to changes.

Winners of match races – Match 1 – 1 v 4 \$4,500, Match 2 – 2 v 3 \$4,000, Match 3 – 5 v 8 \$3,500, Match 4 – 6 v 7 \$3,000

There will be no unplaced money. Overall SA Eastar winner [based on overall times] - \$6,000, second \$2,500, third \$1,500, Runner Up's \$500.

“EASTAR” MATCH RACE TRIALLING CONDITIONS NOW RELEASED - FIRST OPPORTUNITY 24th MARCH

Trials will be conducted on Thursday, 24th March, Thursday, 31st March and Thursday, 7th April at the Angle Park race meetings over the 530m.

There will be up to eight trials conducted each night, with a maximum of two dogs per trial with a total of eight greyhounds trialling per night. These trials will be run between races at the discretion of the Stewards. Trainers must book these trials with Greyhound Racing SA by 11.00am on the day.

Greyhounds will be eligible to trial at the total discretion of the Grader where a trainer may have to provide information in support of trialling. Local eligibility conditions still apply.

Each greyhound will only be allowed to trial once in an effort to improve their position or obtain a spot on the list.

ANGLE PARK'S 50 YEAR ANNIVERSARY AND \$50K TO THE WINNER ON FRIDAY 29TH APRIL

After consultation with Greyhound Racing Victoria, Greyhound Racing SA is very appreciative that they have swapped their Friday night meeting on April 29th with Angle Park's Thursday night meeting on April 28th.

This will mean that Angle Park can celebrate our 50th Anniversary with a big night planned on a Friday night along with increased prizemoney of \$50,000 to the winner for the Anniversary Cup Final on the night.

The night itself will be very much like an Adelaide Cup atmosphere with plenty of entertainment for families as we celebrate 50 years at Angle Park. The feature Anniversary Cup Final, offering \$50k to the winner will be sure to provide a high quality line up of sprinters, locally and interstate, with Heats for this event on Thursday, 22nd April. Coinciding with the Anniversary Cup Final is the SA Distance Championship Final worth \$10k to the winner with Heats also run on Thursday, 22nd April.

Other changes will be the Gawler Friday meeting on 29th April will now be run on Thursday, 28th April in the twilight timeslot.

The MBGRC has 10 vouchers from PurePro Dog for the sponsorship of one race per month with a large bag to the winning trainer and small bag to the second placed trainer.

These will be Maiden Class with 5 races on the circle track meetings and 5 races at straight track meetings. These will also be highlighted in the All Tracks calendar.

2022 GAWLER PRODUCE – FINAL PAYMENT DUE ON FRIDAY, 1ST APRIL

After the second payment was made in January there are still 116 greyhounds eligible for the 2022 Gawler Produce series which is terrific for the Club and is shaping as another exciting series.

The Final is guaranteed at \$22,000 which has a \$10,000 bonus if a greyhound can win both the Produce Final in June and the Gawler Gold Cup Final in November later this year. The racing dates for this series will be Heats on Friday, 10th June 2022, Semi-Finals on Sunday, 19th June 2022 and the Final on Sunday, 26th July 2022

595M EASTER CUP HEATS COMING UP ON APRIL 14

The \$5,595 Heats of the Mixed Easter Cup will be run over 595m for a \$7,750 Final on Thursday, 21st April. Trainers need to nominate for this event with all Grades considered.

EASTER FEATURES AT GAWLER ON EASTER SUNDAY

Easter racing comes to Gawler in April with both the Gawler Future Stars Final and Gawler Easter Sprint programmed on Sunday, 17th April.

The Gawler Future Stars Heats will be conducted for SA Bred greyhounds whelped in 2020 on Friday, 8th April over the 531m with a \$3,500 Final on Easter Sunday. Also on Easter Sunday will be the Gawler Easter Sprint for mixed greyhounds over the 531m worth \$5,000. [Trainers must nominate for this feature] It's going to be a terrific night of racing on the Sunday night over the Easter break.

BREEDERS 2022 PRELUDE (2) HEATS ON 18TH APRIL

\$2,200 Heats of Prelude (2) for Breeders 2022 will be run on Monday, 18th April at Angle Park.

The series is for all greyhounds eligible for Breeders 2022 with the \$4,500 Final to be run on Monday, 25th April.

- Nominations close Wednesday, 13th April with GRSA at 9.00am

SA DISTANCE CHAMPIONSHIP IN APRIL

The \$6,320 Heats of the SA Distance Championship will be run over 730m on Thursday, 21st April. The \$15,250 Final will be run on Friday, 29th April to coincide with the 50th Anniversary celebrations .

- Nominations for the Heats close on Tuesday, 19th April at 9.00am with GRSA

GOTBA COURSING TO START IN APRIL

GOTBA at Virginia will hold their first Coursing meeting for 2022 on Sunday, 24th April.

The club will be looking to have trials near the end of this month so should give plenty of time for those trainers looking to go Coursing this year.

- Nominations close with GRSA at 9am on Wednesday, 20th April.

Further dates will be released shortly.

SATISFACTORY AND QUALIFYING TRIAL TIMES FOR ANGLE PARK

After sufficient racing has been completed on the redeveloped Angle Park track, times have now been allocated for the new distances for Satisfactory trails and Qualifying trials. Effective immediately.

342m – 20.50, 530m – 31.70, 595m – 35.70, 730m – 45.00

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED “ONLY”

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that “Only” would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put “Only or no start or leave me out” then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their Grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.



COVID-19 UPDATE

Since last edition, the SA government continues to roll back restrictions within the community, to help reduce the spread of COVID-19.

Vaccination rates in the community are remarkably high. At its last meeting, the Board of GRSA resolved to remove GRSA's vaccination mandate for all venues. This was, in part, due to the major efforts by South Australians to take steps to reduce the spread of the virus. GRSA will always strongly encourage everyone to be vaccinated, but it will not require proof of vaccination. In essence, it is your choice. GRSA continues its COVID-19 response plan, with the main part of that now being masks. Please remember, masks need to be worn within all shared, indoor places. This includes our administration areas, GAP, clubhouses, and kennel houses. You do not need to wear a mask outdoors [unless you wish to do so]. GRSA will also follow the police directions issued under the major emergency declaration, as required by law.

WHAT IS IT LIKE TO HAVE COVID-19?

COVID-19 is not a mild disease. It is true some people suffer mild symptoms, but that is not always the case. Symptoms include a sore throat, nasal congestion, headaches, joint and muscle pain, fever [38-39 degrees], confusion, coughs, and irritability. These can last for 3-7 days and be quite debilitating. If you have any of the rather unpleasantly named 'co-morbidities', your ability to manage the disease at home is reduced. Please do not take your symptoms for granted. A downhill slide can creep up on you. Also, if you have symptoms and test negative with a home Rapid Antigen Test [RAT], please seek a PCR. The RAT kits carry a fair degree of error, and if you feel like you have a flu, the RAT may have returned a false negative result. Being forewarned is forewarned so you do not get taken by surprise.

GENERAL HEALTH

On the topic of health generally, the community is reacting to the sudden passing of cricket greats Rod Marsh and Shane Warne.

Two larger than life characters, their passing reminds us that whatever you have by way of success and material possessions in life, you cannot buy time. Our racing community, over the last year or so, has also suffered from losing good people too soon. Remember your life is what you make it and all that time you spend engaged in activities or problems you do not really need to is time you never get back. So, keep yourself mentally and physically active and healthy; don't sweat the small stuff; and, enjoy time with people or doing things you love. Take some time

out to relax at the Clubhouses at Murray Bridge, Gawler or Mount Gambier; Chasers, or McQueens. Get some fresh air at the grandstand areas. Your mind and body will thank you for it.

NEW RULES

Please remember the new local rules are in force and are available on the GRSA web site.

It is important that you understand the key provisions.

GREYHOUND CARE - GET TO KNOW YOUR VET

It is important to have at least one vet you can go to for advice.

We are fortunate in South Australia to have many good vets and a number who possess a specific skill set to manage greyhounds. Please have and stick to a care plan and keep your vet in the loop with respect to the ongoing health of your greyhounds. If you need any assistance, please contact the animal welfare team.

ELECTIONS

No matter who you support, the last few years have seen significant challenges thrown up to our governments, some not seen in recent, living memory. I urge you all to research the various party policies, including about greyhound racing, and make an informed decision about where your vote should be directed. PRESENTATION FOR SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Recently there have been occasions whereby Trainers have booked greyhounds for Satisfactory Trials and have subsequently decided not to undertake the trial and therefore have not presented the greyhound.

Trainers are advised that Stewards will in future treat this circumstance in the same manner as non-presentation at a race meeting. The rule is as follows:

R31 Presentation of greyhound for racing and kennelling time

[1] The handler of a greyhound drawn for an Event shall present the correct greyhound to the Stewards at or before the time specified in sub-rule 2.

[2] Unless otherwise specified, a greyhound drawn for an Event shall be in the hands of the Stewards not later than 45 minutes before the advertised starting time of the first Event of the meeting or qualifying trial.

[3] The Stewards may alter the kennelling time referred to in sub-rule [2] if deemed necessary.

[4] A greyhound not presented pursuant to sub-rule [2] shall not be allowed to compete in the Event for which it has been drawn and shall be prohibited from competing in any Event for a period of not less than 28 days commencing on the date on which the failure to comply with sub-rule [2] occurred, provided however that the Stewards or Controlling Body may revoke or vary such order of prohibition.

Trainers wishing to cancel a Satisfactory Trial must contact the Racing Department or Stewards to avoid penalty.

PROJECTS UPDATE

SCOTT WUCHATSCH STRATEGIC PROJECTS MANAGER



Race/Trial Data Transformation Project

GRSA has commenced works on a project to install a ground breaking greyhound tracking system at all South Australian tracks, the IsoLynx Real Time Location System (RTLs).

The IsoLynx system uses a series of fixed receiving points around a race track to record the real-time location of every greyhound during a race, by referencing a small electronic tag placed in each race rug.

The data acquired from the greyhound tags can then be used to determine things such as the path each greyhound takes during a race, acceleration, speed and total distance covered. Future possibilities could include the heart rate of each greyhound and its core body temperature.

This technology is now commonplace in professional sports such as AFL, NRL and American Football, with a noticeable increase in the racing codes in recent years (most commonly used to provide sectional data in thoroughbred racing).

Participants may have already noticed the technology in use at greyhound meetings on the Sky Racing broadcast, with live speed data presented for Victorian metropolitan racing and at Richmond and Grafton in NSW.

The system also allows for a number of exciting initiatives, such as:

- robotic camera tracking of all races and trials
- Driverless lure driving utilising the SafeChase lure
- Varied broadcast camera angles such as drone footage



GRSA sees a great number of possibilities in using the IsoLynx system, particularly for trainers in assessing the performances of their greyhounds.

By way of example, the following data could be provided to trainers and punters after each race, giving greater detail on the nature of each individual greyhound performance.

This data can then be used to determine a greyhound's fitness and possible injuries that may have been picked up during a race or trial. On that basis, the data will be invaluable for Stewards and Veterinarians at a race meeting.

The other significant opportunity is to drive wagering by providing more data for punters and more accurate predictive models such as speed maps.

As sectional data can be taken at any point of a race, performances at different tracks and distances can be better analysed and aligned, allowing for more accurate pre-race predictions.

Management is in the process of

working with the IsoLynx supplier Brook Group and local contractors to establish the infrastructure requirements at each specific venue.

It is expected that the system could be operational as early as May, however this will be dependent upon the availability of equipment and contractors.

It should be noted that the race/trial data transformation is already occurring throughout greyhound jurisdictions around the country, most notably in Victoria and NSW, but with more sure to follow.

The GRSA Board and management have recognised the possibilities of this technology and the need for the local industry to constantly evolve, particularly in the critical areas of product enhancement and wagering growth.

Installation of the IsoLynx system at all SA tracks will provide the local industry with a competitive advantage over other states, something that hopefully translates to more revenue and ultimately greater returns to participants.

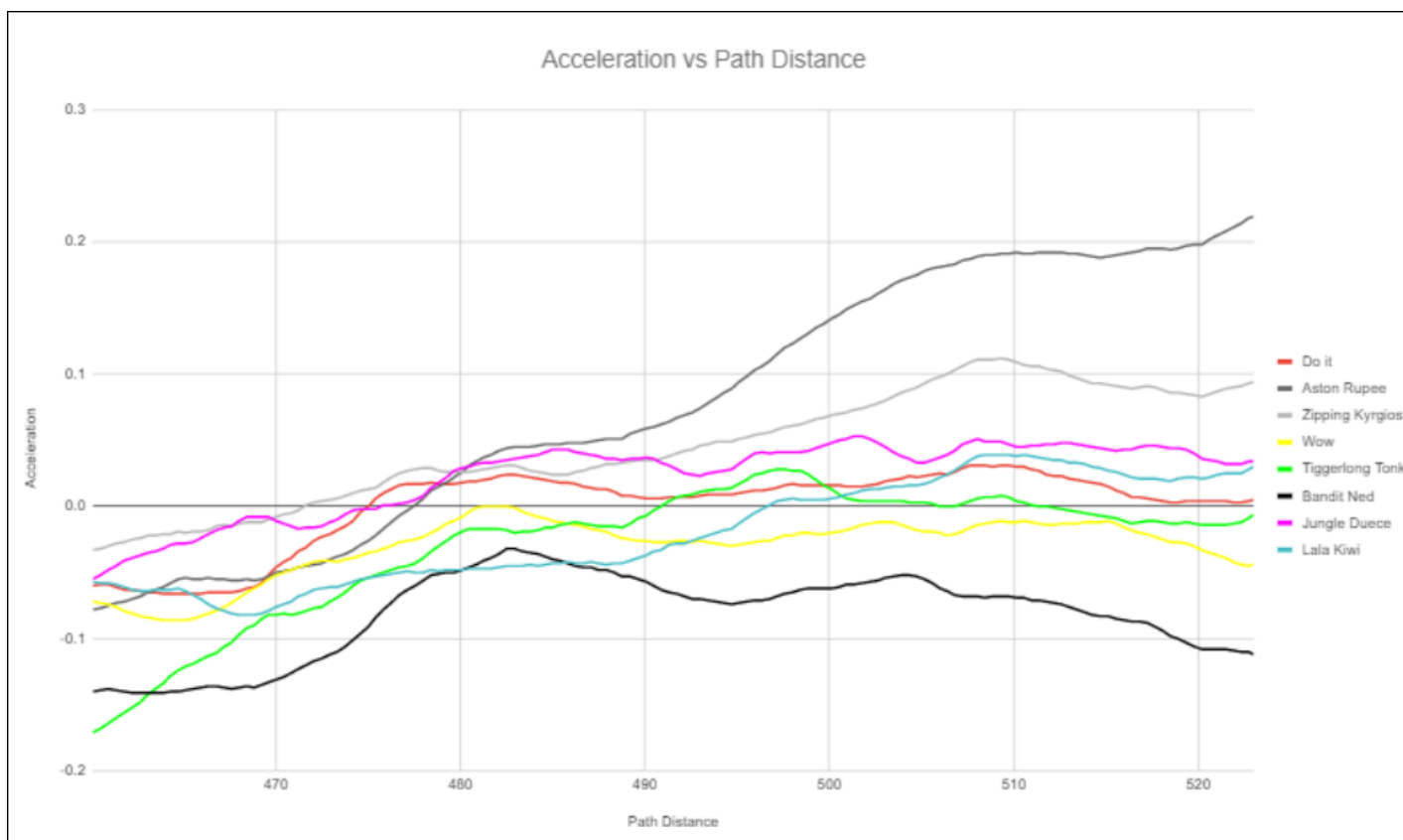

WAP payment update for February 2022

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) wishes to advise participants that the Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of February 2022 will amount to \$240,000, taking total payments for the year past \$1.3 million.

The result is a pleasant surprise given the zero result in the previous two months; but it is too early to predict whether the uplift in February revenue will be repeated in the months ahead.

Payments will be made to participants this coming Friday, 18th March.

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dogs(s). The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

Participants should note that:

- WAP is not payable for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000];
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

Came And Went with a great win to his name

One of South Australia's top sprinters lined up in race six at Gawler Greyhounds on Sunday 15th February.

The Troy Murray trained Came And Went gained a start from box one in that particular race over 531 meters. He was the short priced favourite at a price of \$1.07 which was based off his recent form. Heading into the race Came And Went was a winner at Angle Park over 530 meters where he ran a time of 30.05 which is the second fastest time recorded over that distance at Angle Park. A few weeks prior to that he ran 22.42 over the shorter distance of 400 meters at Gawler which is absolutely flying. He looked set to run a very quick time from box one and he did exactly that. He would lead all of the way to run a time of 30.43. It's very rare to see a greyhound run that quick around the Gawler track. Trainer Troy Murray and his team have done a great job to get this greyhound back to career best form.

Other impressive performances on the night included the creatively named On The Tequila's win who is trained by Lewiston trainer Robyn Mackellar. It was On The Tequila's Ninth start and



her third career win. She ran a personal best time of 30.91 which was a massive improvement on her previous personal best of 31.65. She wasn't the best away at the jump but she showed great strength to dominate the concluding stages of the race. She is definitely a youngster to keep an eye on.

Another highlight was Blaze Maker winning over the shorter distance of 400 meters in race seven for Riverland trainer Don Gordon. Her recent form had been consistent enough to suggest she was good enough to win this race and that's exactly what she did. She led all of the way from box six and ran a time of 22.65 which was a new personal best for her.

GAP kennelling fee payment process change

Please note that as of 1st August 2021 the GAP kennelling payment process has changed for a trial period of three months.

The changes are as follows:

Instead of making a weekly payment of \$33 per dog, the new kennelling fee will be a flat amount of \$50 per dog, irrespective of the time period the greyhound will spend at the GAP kennels.

Participants who would like their greyhounds placed in the GAP kennels will be requested to pay the \$50 at the time when the placement form is filled in and the \$60 placement fee is paid.

This means that for greyhounds that are to be kennelled with GAP an upfront payment of \$110 will be requested. After that, participants will not need to make any additional payments for their dogs in the GAP kennels. Noting that prior to foster care dogs spend an average of 4 weeks in kennels, this change is expected to generate a saving of \$82 per dog for participants.

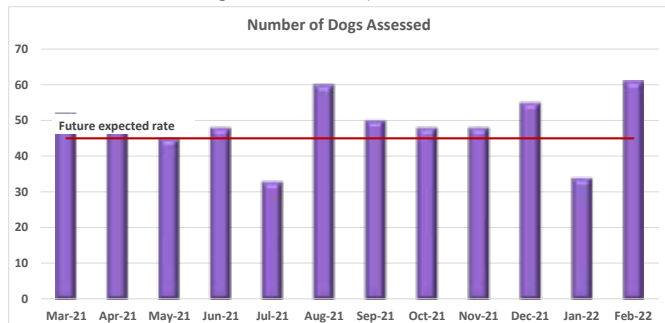

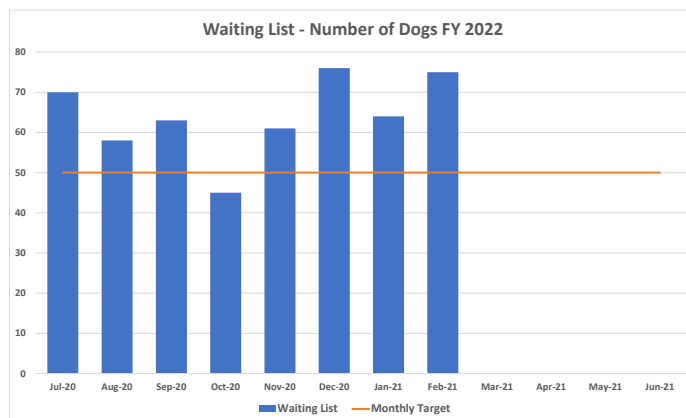
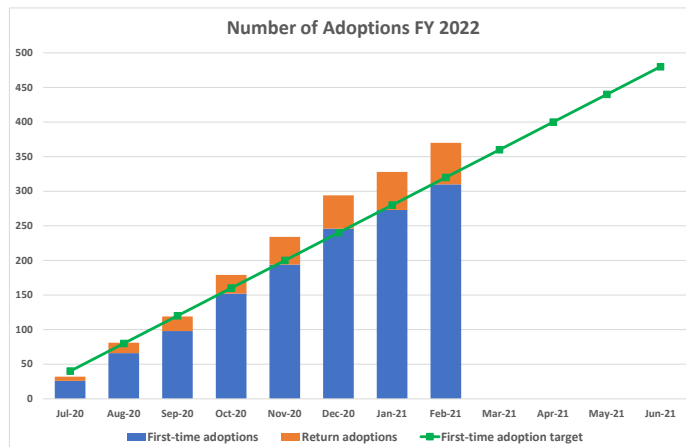
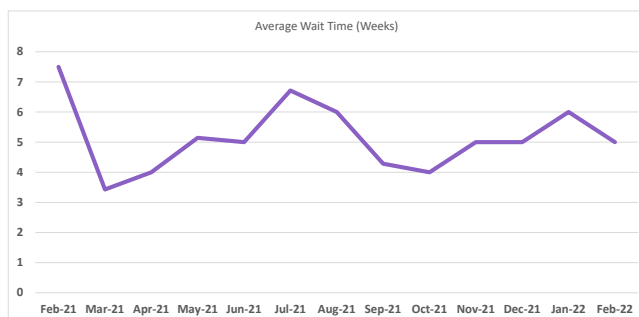
Latest updates from GAP

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday (drawn Thursday) meetings. Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Friday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the Sunday meeting (drawn the following week).

Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Thursday.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Friday (drawn Tuesday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.



Voluntary payment for GAP SA on prizemoney forms

Owners can direct prizemoney to GAP on the Prizemoney Reimbursement forms. GRSA has made this change on the forms where Owners can direct a percentage of prizemoney to GAP.

These forms are available on the website and from GRSA.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

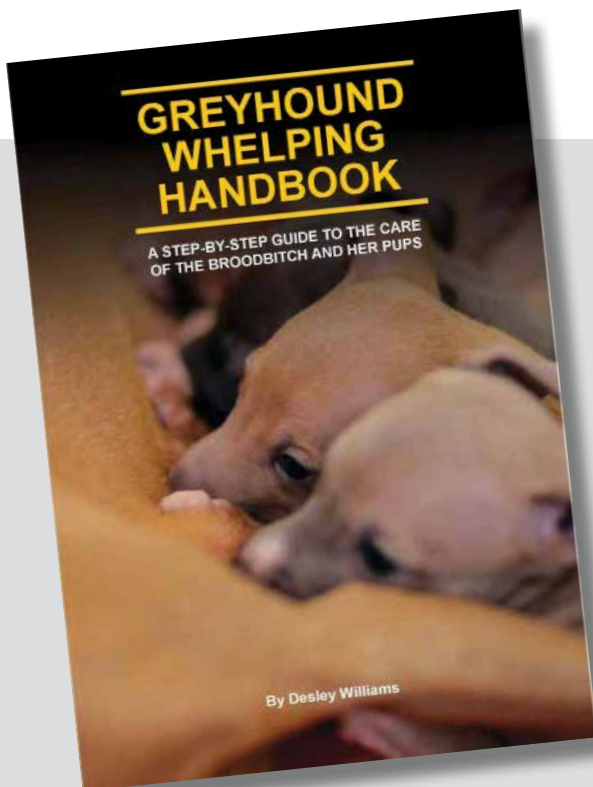
