2023 MURRAY BRIDGE CUP FINAL

■ MURRAY BRIDGE

On what was a brilliant night at Murray Bridge, it was the Ben Rawlings trained Panorama who proved too fast and too good in the Group 3 Daish Irrigation and Fodder Murray Bridge Cup.

A large crowd was in attendance for the night with the weather holding together and the atmosphere being quite lively.

When it came to the big race it was a competitive betting market, which saw the Tim Aloisi trained Ravers Army start favourite from box one with Fantastic Dixie and Tom Keeping both given good chances. With the crowd buzzing and the dogs ready to go, the boxes opened and it was clearly Panorama who left the best, with the black bitch firing to the front early. Behind her was an even wall of chasers who all had some chasing to do.

Panorama led comfortably to the turn, with Tom Keeping and Fantastic Keary finding their sports just behind her. Around the turn, Tom Keeping started to make quick ground, but had to check off the heels of Panorama which cost him a length or two. It was clearly a two dog race in the straight, with Panorama gripping on to the lead with Tom Keeping desperately trying to reel her in. The line came and it was Panorama who just held on, winning by half a length in 25.49, with Tom Keeping a close second and Fantastic Dixie rushing home late for third.

It was a big night for Ben Rawlings not only winning the Cup, but also taking out the John O'Neill Consolation race with Okeechobee Road winning in barnstorming fashion, much to the delight of punters trackside, and then Bandit Trixie won a grade 6

over the short trip to give Rawlings a treble for the night.

One of the spectacles of the night were the two straight track races which were terrific events, made even better by the swarming crowd along the fence line to cheer the chasers home. The Ashee Griffiths trained Cash On Delivery proved he is one of our most in form straight track dogs at the moment by taking out the 300m race in 16.67, before the Bosco Stamenkovic trained So Be It showed that he is well and truly good enough to match it with the 'big boys', taking out the 350m race in 19.28.

Elizabeth Chegia had two good winners, the first being Fantastic Luna who showed that she is nearing her very best by taking out the special event race over the 530m trip. From box eight she had to do it tough out wide, despite this she was just too good and got up with a big effort, winning in 30.40, but showing plenty. The superstar that is Fantastic Radley showed that he is back to his best, with a return to the staying trip on Sunday. It was one of the more competitive 680m races we have seen at Murray Bridge and the race proved to be a ripper. After landing relatively forward early, Fantastic Radley travelled in third position most of the race, before starting to wind up around the turn. It took him a while but Fantastic Radley just proved to be the superior stayer, outgunning the emerging Kruger Lass to win in a red hot 39.18. Certainly good to have Radley back in town!

An excellent night on track for everyone involved!

GROUP 3 MOUNT GAMBIER CUP HEATS ON SUNDAY 26TH MARCH WITH BIG BONUSES ATTACHED TO FINAL

The \$3,000 Carlin & Gazzard Group 3 Mount Gambier Cup Heats will be run on Sunday, 26th March with the \$36,000 (Group 3) Final on Sunday, 2nd April.

Also on the program will be -

\$4,000 Exchange Printers Mt Gambier Cup Consolation – 512m [Trainers must renominate]

\$2,200 The Produce Store Maiden Feature – 512m

\$2,750 The Formula 400 Open Final – 400m [Heats 26/3/22]

\$3,300 The Tankman 600m Open Feature– 600m [Best 8]

\$3,850 Rock's Tavern Distance Feature – 732m

\$2,200 The Commersh Masters – 305m

• **Nominations for Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Tuesday, 21st March.**

With Panorama for trainer Ben Rawlings taking out the Group 3 Murray Bridge Cup if this greyhound can also win the Mount Gambier Cup Final connections will get a \$5,000 bonus and if Ben Rawlings can win the Mount Gambier Cup with any of his greyhounds he will get a \$5,000 trainer bonus.

LOCAL MATCH RACE SERIES “THE SA EASTAR” IN APRIL

The SA Local Match Race series coined “The SA Eastar” will be held on Thursday night, 6th April [Easter] at Angle Park.

Eligibility for South Australian local greyhounds will be based around the Nationals conditions. They will need to be trained in SA 76 days out of the last 150 prior to the close of nominations.

Selection for this series will only be based around winning times at Angle Park. For greyhounds that have run over the 530m at Angle Park on any meeting since 1st November, 2022 their fastest winning time will be recognised and put them on the list for selection.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3, Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. There will be no manual selection from the Grader. The top 4 seeded greyhounds will be rewarded with more prizemoney.

Winners of match races – Match 1 – 1 v 4 \$4,500, Match 2 – 2 v 3 \$4,000, Match 3 – 5 v 8 \$3,500, Match 4 – 6 v 7 \$3,000

There will be \$500 Runner's Up. Overall SA Eastar winner (based on overall times) - \$6,000, second \$2,500, third \$1,500.

“EASTAR” MATCH RACE TRIALLING CONDITIONS - FIRST OPPORTUNITY 23rd MARCH

Trials will be conducted on Thursday, 23rd March and Thursday, 30th March at the Angle Park race meetings over the 530m. There will be up to eight trials conducted each night, with a maximum of two dogs per trial with a total of 8 greyhounds trialling per night. These trials will be run between races at the discretion of the stewards. Trainers must book these trials with Greyhound Racing SA by 11.00am on the day.

Greyhounds will be eligible to trial at the total discretion of the Grader where a trainer may have to provide information in support of trialling. Local eligibility conditions still apply.

Each greyhound will only be allowed to trial once in an effort to improve their position or obtain a spot on the list.

LOW GRADE RACE FOR THURSDAY AT ANGLE PARK

In an effort to ensure we are programming 12 races each Thursday night at Angle Park GRSA have introduced a low grade race for some Thursday nights. These races are for Grade 5 greyhounds over 530m that have a low WPS [Weighted Points Score]. Prizemoney will be slightly less than a normal Grade 5, however, these races will be non-penalty. There will be no guarding, no reserves and only one 8 greyhound race. This should provide encouragement for those trainers who have 500m+ greyhounds but feel they cannot compete on a normal Thursday night due to current form. We are hoping to draw from a different pool of greyhounds and GRSA would encourage trainers to nominate.

\$3,505 Special event Grade 5 [worst to best] – 530m [One 8 dog field will be graded from the Weighted Points Score table of Grade 5 pool of greyhounds worst to best grading. No guarding and no reserves. Trainers cannot nominate for this event specifically. Non Penalty]

The first race is programmed on Thursday, 13th April.

2023 GAWLER PRODUCE – FINAL PAYMENT DUE ON FRIDAY, 31st MARCH

After the second payment was made in January there are still 116 greyhounds eligible for the 2023 Gawler Produce series which is the same as last year and is shaping as another terrific series.

The Final is guaranteed at \$22,000 which has a \$11,000 bonus if a greyhound can win both the Produce Final in June and the Gawler Gold Cup Final in November later this year. The racing dates for this series will be Heats on Friday, 9th June 2023, Semi- Finals on Sunday, 18th June 2023 and the Final on Sunday, 25th June 2023.

595M EASTER CUP HEATS COMING UP ON APRIL 6th

The \$6,015 Heats of the Mixed Easter Cup will be run over 595m for a \$7,750 Final on Thursday, 6th April. Trainers need to nominate for this event with all Grades considered.

EASTER FEATURES AT GAWLER ON EASTER SUNDAY

Easter racing comes to Gawler in April with both the Gawler Future Stars Final and Gawler Easter Sprint programmed on Sunday, 9th April.

The Gawler Future Stars Heats will be conducted for SA Bred greyhounds whelped in 2021 on Friday, 31st March over the 531m with a \$3,500 Final on Easter Sunday, 9th April. Also on Easter Sunday will be the Gawler Easter Sprint for mixed greyhounds over the 531m worth \$5,000. [Trainers must nominate for this feature with all grades considered]. It's going to be a terrific night of racing on the Sunday night over the Easter break.

LOW GRADE FEATURE SERIES AT ANGLE PARK

The next Low Grade Feature Series at Angle Park will be a Open Maiden over the 530m with \$2,650 Heats on Thursday, 13th April and the \$5,535 Final on Thursday, 20th April.

BREEDERS 2023 PRELUDE (2) HEATS ON 24TH APRIL

\$2,200 Heats of Prelude (2) for Breeders 2023 will be run on Monday, 24th April at Angle Park.

The series is for all greyhounds eligible for Breeders 2023 with the \$4,500 Final to be run on Monday, 1st May.

SA ANNIVERSARY CUP IN APRIL

The \$5,535 Heats of the SA Anniversary Cup will be run over 530m on Thursday, 20th April. The \$14,275 Final will be run on Thursday, 27th April.

• **Nominations for the Heats close on Monday, 17th April at 9.00am with GRSA**

SA DISTANCE CHAMPIONSHIP IN APRIL

The \$6,790 Heats of the SA Distance Championship will be run over 730m on Thursday, 20th April. The \$15,250 Final will be run on Thursday, 27th April.

• **Nominations for the Heats close on Monday, 17th April at 9.00am with GRSA**

GOTBA COURSING TO START IN APRIL

GOTBA at Virginia will hold their first Coursing meeting for 2023 on Sunday, 23rd April.

The club will be looking to have trials near the end of this month which should give plenty of time for those trainers looking to go Coursing this year.

• **Nominations close with GRSA at 9am on Wednesday, 19th April.**

Further dates will be released shortly.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED “ONLY”

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that “Only” would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. (Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race)

If trainers put “Only or no start or leave me out” then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

Greyhound of the Month - Victa Damian

Greyhound of the Month for February was Victa Damian for trainer Lisa Rasmussen making it back to back awards to start the year off. He again only had two starts for the month but made a huge impression on the National scene.

The locally owned and bred son of Fernando Bale and Victa Polly started the month off in the Heats of the Group 1 Australian Cup at the Meadows where he won in brilliant fashion, running 29.70 over the 525m journey.

He then stepped out in the Group 1 Final as one of the favourites,

however, after missing the kick it looked like his race was over, but using his brilliant mid race speed he raced around the field to run an outstanding third.

Victa Damian's next event will be the Heats of the Group 1 Golden Easter Egg at Wentworth Park later this month.

At the end of the month Victa Damian's record stood at 13 starts for 9 wins and 2 placings and earnings just below \$170,000.

Run of the Month - Queen Of Scotch

The Run of the Month for February was the Tony Rasmussen trained sprinter, Queen Of Scotch for her brilliant win in the SA St Leger Final at Angle Park on Thursday, 16th February.

In a quality field of young sprinters she started the race favourite and didn't disappoint when she was able to grab the early lead and prove too hard to catch, even though she liked to use plenty of the race track. She ran splits of 5.16 and 17.60 to race away with the win in a sizzling 30.33 by 2.25 lengths.

2023 SA LAUNCHING PAD FINAL – REVIEW

■ ANGLE PARK

After three terrific heats were conducted on March 2nd, the final of the SA Launching Pad series at Angle Park on March 9th, was a fitting finale with one of the most open finals we have seen in recent years. However, it was Live It for trainer Tony Rasmussen booking his spot in the 2023 Launching Pad series for SA at Sandown at the end of the month with a last gasp win.

Most of the greyhounds came out as one when the start was effected however Ragin' Riot from the outside box for Robyn Mackellar quickly mustered momentum to race to the lead prior to the winning post on the first occasion. She was followed by Agent Nine Nine for Ben Rawlings, Live it for Tony Rasmussen and Victa Kerle also for Tony as they made a line of three just in behind the speed. Race favourite Could Be King for Ben Rawlings found himself back last from the middle box with plenty to do as they left the front straight. Into the back straight and Ragin' Riot cleared out in the lead followed by Live It who moved into second around the outside, both Victa Kerle and Agent Nine Nine were battling out for third while Zipping Hyland for Nicole Price started to make good ground from back in the field. Down the back straight and it was Ragin' Riot still in the lead followed by Live It, Victa Kerle had moved to a clear third from Agent Nine Nine while Zipping Hyland continued to make ground. Could Be King was still back last as he looked to move to the outside with his race all but done. Off the back straight the front division began to close up with Ragin' Riot just in front turning

for home with Live It on her outside challenging strongly, Victa Kerle was pushing in between both leaders as Agent Nine Nine was looking for room on the inside and running up behind them was Zipping Hyland pulling to the outside. With only 2 lengths between the top five the drive to the line was going to be crucial. As they got to the finish line it was Live It who poked his nose in front to claim the prize with a blanket covering the minors. Zipping Hyland snared second down the outside only a head away with a neck back to Victa Kerle, Agent Nine Nine and Ragin' Riot who all dead heated for third in an exhilarating finish.

Live It ran a handy time of 30.74 for the 530m journey and is locally bred by Lisa Rasmussen and locally owned by Lisa and Brett Gaspari. He now has a handy record of 15 starts with 5 wins and 5 placings with career prizemoney around \$13,000.

Live It will now compete in the rich Launching Pad heats run at Sandown which will be run over the 515m Thursday, 23rd March with the Semi-Finals on Thursday, 30th March and the \$150,000 to the winner Final run on Thursday, 6th April. We wish him and connections the very best of luck on the National stage.

Greyhound Racing SA Limited [GRSA] advises that the Wagering Activity Payment [WAP] for the month of February 2023 will amount to \$67,000. Total payments for the financial year now amount to \$587,000.

Distribution between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants who receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party (eg owners) then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective, the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you **DO NOT** need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically, however;
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners of your own accord, then you **DO** need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of **\$71.43**, calculated as:

$$\$1,000 \div \$700,000 \times \$50,000 = \$71.43$$

Participants should note that:

- WAP is **not payable** for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000].
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

UPDATES TO LOCAL RULES

There are some important amendments to the Local Rules, coming into effect in the next few weeks.

This month, the Board resolved to strengthen the rules around penalties. As you may know, GRSA regulates the Rules of Racing through Stewards and the Integrity Hearings Panel (IHP). To determine penalties after a finding of guilt for a breach of the rules, GRSA relies on any mandatory penalties prescribed by the rules as well as looking to similar, previous decisions both in SA and interstate. Further, GRSA also could look to penalty guidelines published interstate.

Per the Board resolution on 2nd March 2023, GRSA will introduce its own penalty guidelines for certain breaches of rules. It is, by operation of the amendment of the local rules, GRSA's expectation that Stewards and the IHP will follow the ranges of penalties set by the guidelines, unless special circumstances are present. You should note, in some circumstances, the penalty range to be followed is higher than that previously settled upon by Stewards or the IHP. This means, where circumstances require the penalty guideline be followed, the penalty will not be like those that were previously determined - the penalties will be higher.

To allow for circumstances where a guideline penalty might produce an unfair outcome, there are two responsibilities for GRSA. The first is that Stewards or the IHP must not require a person to pay a fine if they are satisfied that the means of the person, so far as they are known to them, are such that the person would be unable to comply with the order; or compliance with the order would unduly prejudice the welfare of dependants of the person, (and in such a case the Controlling Body may, if it thinks fit, order the payment of a lesser amount).

It must be noted, however, that under another amendment, a person who experiences a material or significant change in the person's financial affairs which may adversely affect the capacity of the person to pay their debts when they fall due; or, ceases to meet any condition stipulated in the registration (or licence) condition, must notify GRSA within 14-day of that change. This will be considered by GRSA, when considering any submission from a person that to pay a fine will cause hardship.

Further, and of significance, is the Board resolution that, unless otherwise approved by GRSA, no registered person may train, keep (unless retired as a pet) or race any greyhounds at any property or premises which are deemed by GRSA as being, or as having been, the property to train greyhounds of a person who has had their registration ceased as a result of having been disqualified, warned off, suspended or declared to be a defaulter for a breach or potential breach of the Greyhounds Australasia Rules or Local Rules (of any Controlling Body).

The effect of this insertion is to prevent a person subject to a suspension (or other order preventing their participation in racing) from transferring their greyhounds into the possession of another person on the same property.

These changes will come into effect soon and will be published on the GRSA website. A Stewards' Notice will set the date and terms of the operation of the amendments.

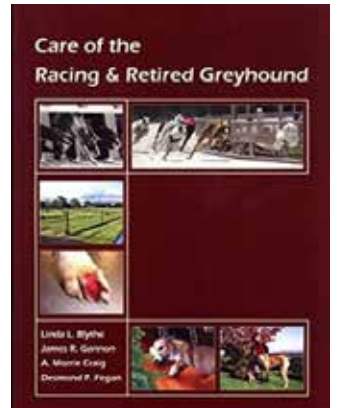

Minimum Vaccination Requirements for Greyhounds

A new rule of racing pertaining to vaccination requirements for greyhounds, **R25 Minimum Vaccination Requirements**, came into effect when the new rules were released on 1st May 2022. Most jurisdictions, including GRSA, chose to delay the introduction of this rule and have targeted 1st May 2023 as the introduction date.

What this will mean is that all greyhounds must have vaccinations up to date, including annual boosters, to permit them to race from 1st May 2023.

R25 Minimum Vaccination Requirements outlines the requirements at different stages of a greyhound's life, as specified in sub-rule 25(3):

Additionally, sub-rule 25(6) outlines that a greyhound must not compete in any event within seven days of the date it was administered a vaccine.

25 Minimum vaccination requirements

[1] An owner, trainer or person responsible for a greyhound must provide evidence of the current vaccination status of a greyhound upon request of the Controlling Body, officer of a Controlling Body, or any other employee, agent or official with authority of the Controlling Body.

[2] Unless a Controlling Body determines based on a certificate issued by a veterinarian that vaccination would prejudice the greyhound's health, an owner, trainer or person responsible for a greyhound must ensure that a greyhound meets the minimum vaccination requirements and has up to date vaccination status.

[3] The minimum vaccination requirements are:

[a] C3 Vaccination between six and eight weeks of age and prior to registration of a litter;

[b] C5 Vaccination between 10 and 16 weeks of age and prior to registration of a litter;

[c] C5 Vaccination at between 12 and 16 months of age and prior to naming; and

[d] once in every further 12-month period a C5 Vaccination unless a veterinarian certifies the greyhound is protected to a C5 level.

[4] Where the minimum vaccination requirements are not met the Controlling Body or its Stewards may:

[a] refuse the registration of any litter;

[b] refuse the naming of any greyhound;

[c] prohibit a greyhound from nominating for any Event;

[d] order a greyhound be scratched from any Event;

[e] prohibit a breeding female from being serviced or being registered as a breeding female.

[5] A Controlling Body may determine minimum vaccination requirements be increased providing that it is in the best interests of animal welfare and greyhound racing, such as in response to the outbreak of a reportable disease.

[6] Unless a Controlling Body determines otherwise, a greyhound must not compete in any Event within seven days of the date it was administered a vaccine.

Evidence of the administration of a Vaccination by Veterinary Surgeon can be lodged with GRSA by email to admin@grsa.com.au For further information, please contact the Racing Department or Stewards.

GRSA staff not to handle greyhounds

Please be advised that it is an expectation of Management that no employee shall handle a greyhound on behalf of a registered participant during a race meeting or trial session including for activities such as boxing and catching. Employees who are also registered participants are expected to refrain from handling greyhounds when engaged as an employee. Exceptions are when the handling of a greyhound is required in an emergency or to restrain it.

Lightning Safety Protocol

GRSA have released a Lightning Safety Protocol which provides instruction and guidance to Stewards, staff, and participants when lightning and thunder presents. This policy applies to all race meetings and trial sessions.

1. IMPLEMENTATION OF PROTOCOL

At a race meeting:

- it shall be the responsibility of the Steward-In-Charge to monitor the prevailing weather for signs of approaching storms and implement the GRSA Lightning Safety Protocol.
- The Steward in charge may delegate another Steward to perform or assist in this function.

At a trial session:

- it shall be the responsibility of an appointed GRSA official to monitor storm activity and implement the GRSA Lightning Protocol.

2. THE “30/30 RULE”

The “30/30 rule” relates to the time lapse between observing the flash of lightning and hearing the clap of thunder.

The rule is used as a measure of the imminence of a storm and therefore as a factor in considering whether outdoor activities should be suspended.

The rule is based on the time taken for sound to travel. Depending on the prevailing temperature and humidity sound travels at approximately 340 metres per second.

Therefore, in assessing the proximity of a storm, every three [3] seconds of delay between the observation of a lightning flash and the hearing of the associated thunder equates to a distance of approximately one [1] kilometre.

Accordingly, a thirty [30] seconds flash to thunder delay equates to the lightning activity being approximately ten [10] kilometres away.

In summary:

- **30 seconds:** Count the number of seconds between observing lightning and hearing thunder. If this time period is thirty seconds or less, the lightning is sufficiently close to represent a hazard.
- **30 minutes:** After observing the final lightning flash or hearing the final thunder, remain under cover for thirty minutes to ensure the hazard has passed.

It is important to understand that blue sky and the absence of rain are not adequate reasons to ignore the “30/30 rule”. Many victims are struck before the storm actually arrives because they wait too long to seek shelter.

Note: The “30/30 rule” is not an absolute rule. A storm may move very quickly, or not generate any lightning or thunder until it is very close, or topographical or wind conditions may prevent sound from traveling to your position. These conditions are especially common in mountain areas. It is important that staff observe weather conditions and be alert to the possibility of the above occurring.

3. APPLICATION/IMPLEMENTATION

If through the application of the “30/30 rule” or from the observations of the responsible Steward or appointed GRSA official as described in the Protocol, it is considered that lightning activity is occurring within ten [10] kilometres of a race track the following measures shall be taken:

a) Suspension of Activity

If the flash to thunder delay is thirty [30] seconds or less,

- (i) all activity shall be suspended, and
- (ii) an announcement made requesting all persons and greyhounds in attendance to seek shelter indoors.

b) Resumption of Activity

As trailing storm clouds may still carry a lingering charge, activity at the race track shall not resume until a period of thirty [30] minutes has elapsed after the last flash of lightning was observed.

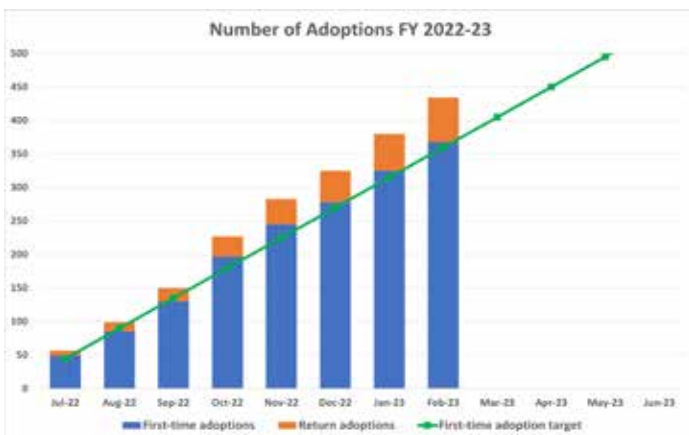
Latest updates from GAP

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:30pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kennelling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

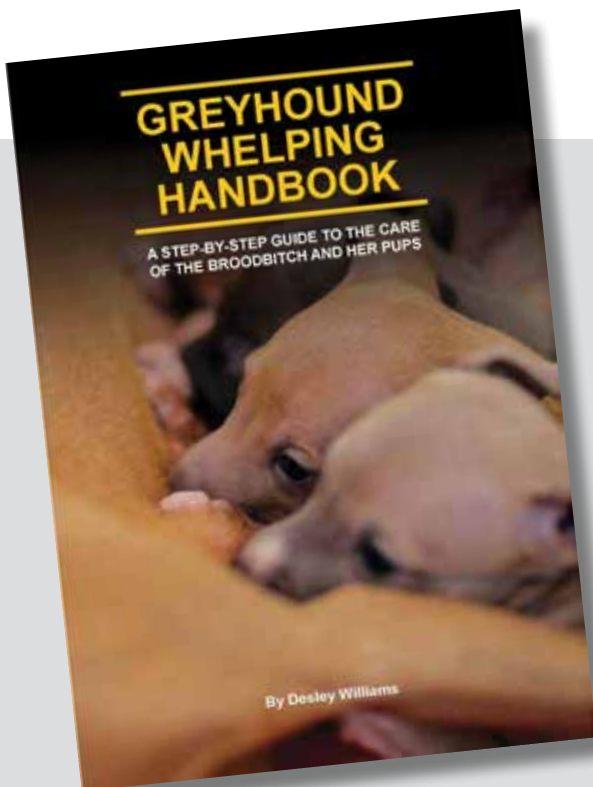
