CEO'S UPDATE

Seizing The Moment

The current positive momentum that is evident within the sport at the moment is the culmination of many aspects. Over time, the South Australian industry has put in the hard yards to get its track strategy right including the addition of one-turn and straight-track racing. The application of six-dog fields under the G-SIX initiative has provided the opportunity to expand into new Sky timeslots which has resulted in the scheduling of racing opportunities around Adelaide on all bar one day of each fortnight. It has also allowed us to secure a foothold in the growing Saturday morning timeslot.

After more than a decade of focusing on the renewal of our four key tracks/venues we are more closely approaching a point wherein the standard of our tracks and facilities aligns comfortably with modern expectations of a professional sport. The Angle Park project (in the coming months) will take us a big step further towards that outcome despite the momentary inconvenience.

Revenue from wagering has weathered the potential storm of the past 12 months and the WAP framework is helping to ensure that gains to the business are being passed on in a timely manner through the vehicle of stakemoney. Separately, our rehoming activity, through GAP, has reached a point of maturity which has resulted in it being one of the most efficient operations in the country, with waiting lists and numbers reduced to a bare minimum.

The next big opportunity for the sport in South Australia is about ensuring that we maximise the racing schedule that we've fought so hard to secure. That requires GRSA providing support for trainers to travel and compete across the various tracks and to help trainers, breeders and owners in their ongoing efforts to build the numbers in this state to a level which will ultimately fill all of our weekly race meetings to capacity – ie 12 races with an optimal mix of six-dog and eight-dog programming. A full schedule is what drives the greatest total return to the people who put on the show – it's that simple. The nice thing about this goal is that we are largely in control of our own destiny.

Air Marshall claims the 2021 Murray Bridge Cup

■ MURRAY BRIDGE

In front of a great crowd, Air Marshall claimed the 2021 Daish Irrigation and Fodder Murray Bridge Cup on Sunday, March 14 for trainer Ray Murray in what was a fantastic night of racing.

Contesting his second Cup Final in a row, the 2020 SA Short Course Greyhound of the Year was well-supported in the markets after his terrific win in his Heat on Friday 5th March and jumped as third favourite behind sprint queen, Coorong Lucy for Cameron Butcher and the up-and-coming Undercut for Tony Rasmussen.

As the lids went up it was the Jeff Galea trained Run Baba Run who set the early pace beginning brilliantly from box 1 with Danyo's Wylie for Lauren Harris and Rushes for Lisa Rasmussen pushing up hard through the middle while Air Marshall was able to move down towards the rail, stalking the early leader. Heading to the bend, Air Marshall began to make his move showing his customary mid-race acceleration as he moved around Run Baba Run to gain the lead while Undercut who had found the rail moved up into third along with the Jeff Britton trained Weblec Ace who was finishing on strongly.

It was a great battle down the home straight as Air Marshall kicked on strongly in the lead while Run Baba Run never gave in and continued to push the leader the whole way to the line but couldn't quite close the gap. Air Marshall stopped the clocked at 25.42 seconds to claim the Cup just half a length ahead of the brave Run Baba Run in second while Undercut ran home well to finish in 3rd place as did Weblec Ace in fourth place.

The son of Banjo Boy and Auntie Chopper, Air Marshall has been fantastic for owner Ray Murray having reached a number of feature finals in 2020 including the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup, Listed Murray Bridge Cup, the SA Straight Track Championship and setting a new track record over the 388m at Angle Park. However, this win is certainly the highlight of what has been a great racing career thus far.

Air Marshall's record now stands at 50 starts for 28 wins, 7 seconds and 7 thirds and career prizemoney of \$51,505.

Jack's Well continues great form for Butcher



Greyhound of the Month for February was Jack's Well for trainer Cameron Butcher. The up and coming sprinting star was undefeated for the month winning all three of his starts, highlighted by his brilliant win in the SA St Leger Final.

The son of Aston Dee Bee and Molly Be Nimble started the month off with a convincing win in his Heat of the prestigious St Leger series having to work hard for victory in a solid 30.18 at headquarters. He then stepped out in the Final and stamped himself as a special chaser winning in brilliant fashion by almost two lengths in a blistering 29.58. He also showed his versatility by stepping up to the 600m and breaking 35 seconds in a flying win to round the month off.

At the end of the month Jack's Well record stood at 27 starts for 14 wins and 10 placings and earnings around \$40,000.

The Run of the Month for February was also won by Jack's Well after his outstanding performance at Angle Park on Thursday, 11th February in the Final of the SA St Leger over the 515m journey. He was the clear favourite for the Final and showed his class winning in brilliant fashion. After a good beginning he landed second and stalked the leader, Rosie Red, until the concluding stages when he pounced and raced away with the feature Final. He ran a flying 29.58 for the 515m journey in winning by 1.5 lengths.

Racing Report

Easter Cup – nominations close on Monday 22nd March

The 600m Easter Cup is programmed to be run at Angle Park over the 600m with \$5,120 Heats on Thursday night, 25th March and the \$6,430 Final on Thursday, 1st April.

This is a mixed event.

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 22nd March at 9.00am.

Low Grade Feature series at Angle Park

The next Low Grade Feature Series at Angle Park will be a Grade 5 over the 515m with \$3,280 Heats on Thursday, 1st April with the \$4,715 Final on Thursday, 8th April.

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 29th March at 9.00am.

Saturday morning meeting

The next meeting will be this Saturday, 20th March with a 10 race program.

The following meeting will be on Saturday, 3rd April which will be a Timed Graded Meeting-“Worst to Best” rating. Greyhounds graded into 3 categories. Maidens, 1-4 wins & 5 or more wins. Specific grades of greyhounds are not considered except for Maidens. Races-N/P with Pathway Prizemoney. Reserves will be determined by Grader. There will be No Guarding. Refer to “Time Based Grading” published conditions.

- Nominations close Tuesday, 30th March at 9.00am.

Gawler Future Stars heats on Sunday, 4th April

The Gawler Future Stars is programmed to be run at Gawler over the 531m for SA Bred greyhounds whelped in 2019 with \$1,505 Heats on Sunday night, 4th April and the \$3,000 Final on Sunday, 11th April.

- Nominations for the Heats close Wednesday, 31st March at 9.00am.

Grading of City A meetings when Angle Park shutdown

It has been determined, when Angle Park is shutdown for redevelopment, that the City A meetings will be shared with Murray Bridge and Gawler. Murray Bridge will conduct back to back Thursday meetings allowing for Heats and Finals of normal and feature races. Gawler will then run back to back Sundays, again allowing for Heats and Finals of normal and feature races. This will mean that we are still conducting one Metropolitan (CITY A) meeting per week.

It has been agreed that any 515m feature races will be run at Gawler over the 531m and any 731m feature races will be run at Murray Bridge over the 680m [the 680m start will be available as the 731m boxes will be removed once redevelopment starts allowing for this start to be used].

It has also been agreed that these meetings should be considered as if the greyhounds have never raced at the venue. This will mean greyhounds will be grades Maiden, Grade 6 and Grade 5 to start with unless new in to the state and regraded higher.

Stakemoney, Grading and Feature races–

With all grades starting from new [no higher than Grade 5 effectively], Management has determined it will be the intent to run a Best 8 each meeting over the 455m, 530m, 680m at Murray Bridge and a 531m and 643m at Gawler for Open class City A grade money.

GRSA intends to run Grade 5 Heats on a regular basis but may have to run Grade 4/5 Heats to ensure there are races for these dogs. The Finals of these races will pay the normal CITY A stakemoney for Finals [Grade 5 or Open depending on grade of Heats].

GRSA will give preference to 455m or higher at both Murray Bridge and Gawler with the intent that no short course races will be conducted. It is assumed all the current Thursday night greyhounds will support these meetings. However, if there was a need to run some short course this would be under standby conditions with reduced prizemoney in line with other meetings.

For Grade 6 events it has been determined that if a greyhound has Grade 6's available they can win at CITY A Gawler and CITY A Murray Bridge. They will however, only be allowed to win over 1 distance for the CITY A class [this is the same as normal APK Thursday]. There will be no retrospectivity with these events.

If a greyhound wins a CITY A Gawler or CITY A Murray Bridge Grade 5 event and have Grade 6's to win at other venues they will NOT lose their Grade 6's. GRSA has put an embargo on this condition while Angle Park is out of action.

Feature races like the Howard Ashton, SA Distance Championship, Anniversary Cup etc will be finalised when the official date is advised for the shutdown of Angle Park.

The Eastar – Match Race Series at Gawler – nominations close Wednesday, 31st March

The local South Australian match race series, nicknamed 'The Eastar', has been shifted to Gawler due to the track update of Angle Park.

The series will be held on Easter Sunday night, 4th April over the 531m. A big local crowd is expected for the meeting given the timing of the event and the public holiday the following day.

Greyhounds competing must be South Australian, based on the Nationals Championships conditions, which require greyhounds to be domiciled in the State for at least 76 days of the last 150 days prior to the close of nominations. Selection for this series will be for the fastest greyhounds nominated, based on their best time over the Gawler 531m distance since 1st October 2020 (regardless of their placing). GRSA will regularly update and publish a leaderboard (top 25), so all trainers and connections are aware of where their greyhound stands up until the close of nominations on Wednesday, 31st March 2021.

The head-to-head matches will be decided based on the final leaderboard, with no manual intervention by the Grader, as per the following:

- Match 1 – Seed 1 v Seed 4 [1st \$2,750 - 2nd \$350]
- Match 2 – Seed 2 v Seed 3 [1st \$2,500 - 2nd \$350]
- Match 3 – Seed 5 v Seed 8 [1st \$2,250 - 2nd \$350]
- Match 4 – Seed 6 v Seed 7 [1st \$2,000 - 2nd \$350]

The prizemoney for the overall Eastar placegetters (based on individual times in the match races) will be:

- 1st \$4,500 – 2nd \$1,300 – 3rd \$650

The overall winner of the Gawler Eastar will be guaranteed a spot in the State of Origin Match race series [SA V Vic] to be held at the newly developed Angle Park track in September, as long as it is nominated and eligible to represent SA. As an added incentive the winner of the State of Origin Match Race Series guarantees itself a spot in the Group 1 Adelaide Cup in October and if successful will be guaranteed a spot in the Group 1 TOPGUN at the Meadows in November.

Trialling conditions


Trials will be conducted at race meetings with up to 8 trials on Wednesday, 24th March and up to 8 trials on Sunday night, 28th March at Gawler over the 531m. [The race meeting will be a maximum of 11 races to accommodate this and GRSA may vary the mix of 8 dog and G-Six racing with one less race available].

There will be a maximum of two dogs per trial and a total of 8 greyhound's trialling per meeting. These trials will be run between races at the discretion of the Stewards. Trainers must book these trials with Greyhound Racing SA by 4.00pm the day before for Wednesday and 4.00pm on the Friday before the Sunday. All greyhounds will be eligible to trial, whether on the current list to improve their position or not, at the absolute discretion of the Grader.

Local eligibility conditions still apply. Each greyhound will only be allowed to trial once in an effort to improve their position or obtain a spot on the list.

Syndication update

Sean Donnelly has been hard at work with interested new owners, participants and Clubs in his role of Syndication Co-ordinator.

At Angle Park Thursday, 18th March the two Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club "We Love Our Dogs" syndicate greyhounds, Weblec Blade and Weblec Rebel will compete under the training guidance of Vadim Roz with over 20 excited new or returning owners into our industry.

Sean's primary role is to grow syndication in South Australia and with the number of new people in the first syndicate signs are looking positive. He is still seeking support from industry in regard to available trainers and sourcing of greyhounds so please do not hesitate in reaching out to him if you can assist. He is also available in providing administrative support for Clubs and trainers and for any person interested in getting involved in syndicates in SA.

Easter Arrangements – Things to know

With the Easter long weekend coming up there are a couple of important things to remember.

- There will be NO trials at Gawler on Good Friday [2nd April] – these trials will be conducted on Thursday, 1st April instead.
- There will be trials at Mount Gambier on Saturday morning [3rd April].
- There will be trials at Angle Park on Sunday morning [4th April].
- There will be NO trials at Gawler or Murray Bridge on Monday, 5th April due to track preparation.
- Scratchings for the Angle Park meeting on Saturday, 3rd April will be taken up to 3pm on Thursday, 1st April.
- Nominations for the Angle Park meeting on Monday, 5th April will close at 9am on Wednesday, 31st March along with Gawler Sunday, 4th April.
- Nominations for the Gawler meeting on Wednesday, 7th April will close at 9am on Thursday, 1st April along with both the Angle Park Tuesday, 6th April.
- Nominations for the Angle Park and Mount Gambier meetings on Thursday, 8th April and Murray Bridge Friday, 9th April will close at 9am on Tuesday, 6th April.
- Nominations for the Mount Gambier and Gawler meeting on Sunday, 11th April will close at 9am on Wednesday, 7th April.

2021 Gawler Produce – final payment due on Thursday, 1st April

After the second payment was made in January there are still 104 greyhounds eligible for the 2021 Gawler Produce series which is terrific for the Club and is shaping as another exciting series.

The Final is guaranteed at \$22,000 which has a \$9,000 bonus if a greyhound can win both the Produce Final in July and the Gawler Gold Cup Final later this year.

The racing dates for this series will be Heats on Sunday, 20th June 2021, Semi-Finals on Sunday, 27th June 2021 and the Final on Sunday, 4th July 2021.

2021 Mount Gambier Cup series in April

The Mount Gambier Cup carnival will be run over two weeks this year, highlighted by the 2021 Commercial Hotel Mount Gambier Cup Final on Sunday, April 18. The Cup is a listed event and will carry \$14,275 in total prizemoney with \$10,000 to the winner.

On Sunday, 11th April the Club will conduct the Commercial Hotel Mount Gambier Cup Heats with eight terrific Heats anticipated. At this meeting the Club will also be running Heats of The Produce Store Feature Maiden over 512m and Heats of the Formula 400 Open over 400m.

On Sunday, 18th April the Club will not only feature the \$14,275 Commercial Hotel Mount Gambier Cup Final it will also feature a \$3,000 Exchange Printers Consolation of the Cup, which trainers will need to renominate for, the \$2,000 The Produce Store Maiden Final, the \$2,000 Formula 400 Final and the \$2,500 The Tankman 600 Open Feature over 600m.

It looks to be a superb two weeks of racing in the South East of the State.

- Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Wednesday, 7th April

Air Marshall and Ray Murray in line for Murray Bridge Cup / Mount Gambier Cup bonuses

GRSA has bonuses linked to both the Murray Bridge Cup which was won by Air Marshall and trained by Ray Murray and the Mount Gambier Cup Final programmed on Sunday, 14th April.

They include a \$5,000 bonus if Air Marshall can win both the Murray Bridge Cup and Mount Gambier Cup and a \$5,000 trainer bonus if Ray Murray can win both Cups as a trainer (can be different greyhounds).

Mount Gambier racing twice a week

With two meetings a week at Mount Gambier on a Thursday and Sunday, the Thursday meetings are Time Graded events [Maidens, 1-4 wins and 5+ wins] with only 400m plus events programmed and the Sunday meetings are normal graded meetings with the new 305m distance included under specific conditions.

305m start at Mount Gambier

With the 305m start available at Mount Gambier there will only be two 305m races programmed on Sundays. One will be for young Maiden greyhounds with the youngest greyhounds gaining entry first based on age, the other will be a Masters, with eligible greyhounds being selected on age with the oldest given first preference.

Masters conditions is the same as races conducted in the Metro area with greyhounds 3¾ years and above eligible.

GRSA and the Mount Gambier GRC strongly recommend trainers nominate for multiple distances to ensure they do not miss out on a run at any meeting.

Online scratchings now available

GRSA will now make scratchings out of drawn race meetings available for trainers through the Ozchase system, effective immediately. This will provide flexibility for trainers during their busy schedules. Trainers can still phone scratching's through as normal.

Once a scratching has been lodged, GRSA will consider this greyhound as requiring to be removed and will be published as soon as possible or the next working day.


Any Late Scratching's cannot be made via online and will have to be phoned through to the Stewards.

Please see below for the process of making a scratching via OzChase -

To request that a greyhound is scratched from a race, a trainer can select the 'Scratch Greyhound' action.

A greyhound can be selected from the dropdown on the screen. Once selected, the details related to this greyhound (ear brands, certificate number and microchips) will be displayed.

The meeting list presented to the trainer for selection will show those meetings where the selected greyhound has been allocated as a runner or reserve. If the greyhound has multiple starts at the meeting, then all races for this greyhound will be listed against the appropriate meeting entry.

Current super bonus for SA Bred

The super bonus scheme is premised upon a 100% dividend to breeders for SA Bred greyhounds. The following is a summary of the bonus by race:

RACE SUPER-BONUS

Adelaide Cup [515m] - G1 \$12,500, Adelaide Cup second - \$5,000, Adelaide Cup third - \$2,500, Adelaide Cup finalist \$1,000, BGC SA Derby [515m] - G3 \$3,500, BGC SA Derby second - \$1,500, BGC SA Derby third - \$750, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks [515m] - G3 \$3,500, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks second - \$1,500, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks third - \$750, Gawler Gold Cup [531m] - G3 \$5,000, Mount Gambier Cup [512m] - listed \$2,500, Murray Bridge Cup [455m] - listed \$2,500, Group 1 victory (interstate) \$10,000, Group 2 victory (interstate) \$5,000, Group 3 victory (interstate) \$2,500.

The super-bonuses for interstate events will only be applied for series/events that are open entry. Events that are restricted by age or gender are ineligible for the bonus. Events that are exclusively open to SA Bred runners or incorporate other restrictions, such as 'sweepstake' events, puppy/auction Classics and Maiden series are not eligible for the super-bonus.

Changes to Weighted Points Score for South Australia

Greyhound Racing SA advise changes to the Weighted Point Score Table for SA Grading.

Based on the previous Grading Review Panel meeting the Grading Department have made changes to the points allocation for the WPS. This is the first part of changes approved by the GRP for implementation and will be effective immediately.

The main changes are –

- The Maiden points for category CTA, CTB, PRI have now been slightly increased and tiered
- All placegetters 7th and 8th are allocated 6th place points to accommodate the mix of G-Six and 8 – dog Quad racing in SA

GRSA is still working with OzChase for race classification for Time Graded and Pathway events along with the changes approved for the Order of Preference.

*In the event that the 1st payment of the SA Bred Scheme is claimed as a component of the rebate, those pups will automatically be registered in the scheme with only the 2nd and 3rd payments still required.

The limit of the support as it relates to the [50%] contribution to the stud/sire fee component is equivalent to the full support value of \$2,000. The limit of the support as it relates to 'other' expenses is \$1,000. Excluded expenses include veterinary [pre-conception], rearing, breaking in or pre-training costs.

Participants are able to purchase their very own red vests for \$20 however GRSA will always have some available. These vests look very smart and come up particularly well on Sky Racing promoting SA Racing so with that in mind the long parade coats have been phased out of action with participants required to have a black or navy jumper available to be worn under the vests.

Some items from GRP

The items below come from the previous Grading Review Panel meeting with an implementation date advised.

There are other items from the meeting that are currently in the process of being changed and an implementation date will then be determined.

Mixed Masters – Grading –

It was recommended to the panel that if a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading. If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters (ie Grade 2/3 and 4) we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event. Effective immediately

Policy Interstate Greyhounds - Summary of change's for the greyhounds career

Interstate greyhounds racing in SA for the first time will be Grade 5 at all tracks and distances, unless they meet the following criteria, which would then see them being upgraded to Grade 4 at all tracks and distances:

- 5+ metropolitan full stakes wins
- \$75,000 in prizemoney

Interstate greyhounds racing in SA for the first time and meet the following criteria, will be upgraded to Grade 3 at all tracks and distances:

- Group 1 & 2 winners over a similar distance in the past 6 months

The grader has ultimate discretion in applying the above upgrade rule and may choose to keep a greyhound at Grade 5 level if one or more of the following apply:

- The form of the greyhound is poor enough to warrant it remaining at Grade 5
- The greyhound is a masters greyhound (4yo+)
- The distance the greyhound is nominating for is outside the greyhound's normal distance range

Greyhounds that have left SA to race interstate to race for 3 months or more, will be subject to the above upgrade rules upon their return. However, any grade that was established at a particular track and distance prior to their departure from SA will be retained in the last 6 months.

This will replace the greyhounds winning a Metro Grade policy for assessment in SA.

This will not affect the Grade 6 policy

This has been in effect from Monday, 4th January 2021.

Comments on nominations marked “only”

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that “Only” would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. (Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race)

If trainers put “Only or no start or leave me out” then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

Winning grade 6 races in order

GRSA reminds trainers to win their Grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

Re-grading for all tracks and distances

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

Beanies available from Grsa

Approved beanies are part of the GRSA Dress Code Policy and available for sale from GRSA.

These beanies are GRSA specific and are the only ones approved. They cost \$10 and are available the GRSA racing office.

Bookings of trials through Online Trial Booker

Trainers are reminded for those that book trials for Angle Park and Murray Bridge that staff are directed to accommodate these bookings.

For trainers who wish to trial without making a booking, which is fine however they will only be fitted in if there is space or will be at the end of the bookings.

Murray Bridge Slipping Track

For trainers who wish to use the Murray Bridge slipping track key fobs are available from the GRSA reception and Darren at the Murray Bridge Club.

Local Rule LR37(A)(SA)

Participants are reminded of Local Rule LR37(A)(SA). Stewards will be ordering breathalyzer analysis testing at upcoming race meetings.

Intoxication of Persons

LR37(A)(SA)

[1] Stewards at any meeting may order any person to submit to a breathalyzer analysis test.

[2] Any person who exceeds the Alcohol Level of .05% on a breath analyser shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a penalty pursuant to GAR 95.

[3] Any person in the opinion of the Stewards affected by alcohol is not permitted to enter the kennel area or track for any reason or to handle any greyhound. Where an order given pursuant to this Rule is not complied with the Steward in charge of the meeting shall order the greyhound to be withdrawn from the Event.

[4] Any person required under this Rule to submit to a breath analysis must not refuse or fail to comply with all reasonable directions of a Steward and, in particular, must not refuse or fail to exhale into the apparatus by which the breath analysis is conducted in accordance with the directions of the Stewards.

Reporting on greyhound status

Location of unnamed greyhounds

I remind everyone of their obligations under GAR 105 [4] (i) that within three [3] working days you must notify GRSA of a greyhound coming onto or leaving your care/custody. This includes unnamed greyhounds. Location changes of unnamed greyhound forms are available on the website or at the office. This year the Animal Welfare team will be conducting audits of all greyhounds on participants properties to ensure greyhounds are where they are supposed to be. Please contact the Animal Welfare team if you require assistance.

Retirement for breeding purposes

Please note that greyhounds with a pink card are not automatically retired in OzChase. This is to ensure participants can organise a pink card while still racing. If you have a pink card for your bitch and she will not race again, complete the Notification of retired greyhound form within ten [10] working days if you haven't already. Please contact the Animal Welfare team if you are unsure if your greyhound is retired or you require assistance.

Retirement from breeding

Once you have decided that your greyhound will no longer be breeding, ensure that you complete the Notification of retired greyhound form within ten [10] working days. This will ensure the greyhound does not remain in your ownership if you have retired her. Please contact the Animal Welfare team if you are unsure if your greyhound is retired or you require assistance.

Track Injury Rebate Scheme

I remind everyone that the Track Injury Rebate Scheme operates for injuries covered by the policy, at covered events, subject to the scheme maximums.

The process starts with you lodging the form with supporting documents to the Animal Welfare team. You can lodge the forms in person or email to the animal welfare team.

ANNOUNCEMENT ON ANGLE PARK REDEVELOPMENT IMMINENT

An announcement regarding the commencement of the Angle Park redevelopment project is imminent, with management planning for the shutdown of South Australia's home of greyhound racing within weeks.

The project, which will see Angle Park undergo complete track rebuild and a minor redesign, will also result in all racing at the venue being suspended for a period of approximately 4 months.

With a large portion of infrastructure from the original construction in 1971 remaining in use, significant degradation of key parts of the lure system, rail fencing and concrete plinths has become increasingly evident.

Additionally, the foundations of the track including sub-base, base, concrete gutters and plinths and drainage, are all in need of replacement and modernisation.

Consultation regarding the rebuild and redesign of the track has progressed over the past 18 months, with the Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club (AGRC) playing an elevated role in that process.

Whilst the project is primarily about the renewal of ageing infrastructure, it provides a clear opportunity to subtly redesign the track based on modern design principals.

The redevelopment will result in minimal visual change, but will result in a safer track for racing, by implementing established design improvements identified by recent research into this area.

The only way to address the current issues at Angle Park track is to revamp all of the different track elements at the one time.

This project will ultimately deliver a world-class metropolitan track, the equal of any other in the country in terms of safety, fairness and presentation.

The most notable change for participants will be the re-positioning of the four existing starts at Angle Park, as summarised below:

- 388m > 342m
- 515m > 530m
- 600m > 595m
- 731m > 730m

Accordingly, the most famous and longstanding national track record of 28.88 sec over the 515m, held by legendary sprinter Brett Lee [dating back to the 2001 Adelaide Cup] will almost certainly remain unsurpassed.

GRSA also intends to undertake a number of unrelated minor projects during the Angle Park shut down, including:

- Upgrading of the kennel house flooring
- Relocation of the wash bays to outside the kennel house
- Reconfiguration of the judges tower to ensure an optimal race vision camera position
- Installation of a new video board [replacing existing semaphore board]

All race meetings during the affected period will be transferred to Gawler and Murray Bridge, including the current Thursday night Category 1 stakemoney meeting at Angle Park.


A revised weekly schedule of Sky Racing follows on from this update, as does drawings of the new track and revised starting positions.

Jack's Well continues St Leger dominance

The time honoured SA St Leger was conducted on February 11th where more history was made on the Angle Park loam with trainer Cameron Butcher continuing his dominance of this race after Jack's Well was able to score a game victory giving the Meningie maestro his sixth St Leger victory in the last 8 years.

Both Jack's Well [box 4] and Fly For Trix [box 6] for Jane McNicholl were sent out equal favourites for the 43rd running of the SA St Leger based on their strong Heat victories and exceptional overall records. As the start was affected Rosie Red [box 1] for Bosco Stamenkovic flew the lids leading easily to the first turn. Jack's Well and Fly For Trix both began fairly however got caught up in tightening to the first turn with Victa Grosso [reserve 9 from box 3] for Tony Rasmussen on the inside and Canya Go Wild [box 7] for Paul Bodsworth on the outside. As they left the front straight Rosie Red had pinched a nice break with Jack's Well quickly moving to second while Victa Grosso ran to third. Oakvale Style [box 2] for Nathan Wilson ran to fourth while Fly For Trix jostled with Outstanding News [box 5] for Tony Rasmussen and found it hard to make ground. Racing off the back straight



and an upset was looming with Rosie Red still out in the clear lead and giving the backers of her at \$14 a bold sight however Jack's Well was starting to close the gap and looming ominously. Victa Grosso was a further 4 lengths away in third and was well clear of the remainder of the field. As heads had turned for home and it was down to two greyhounds, Rosie Red in the lead and Jack's Well closing late, ironically they are both brother and sister out of the same Aston Dee Bee and Molly Be Nimble litter and both owned by Cameron and Yvonne Butcher so this finale may have played out

many months ago on the training track. As they raced down to the finish Rosie Red could not hold of the powerful finish of her brother, as Jack's Well swept to the lead and another feature race win in his keeping. His winning time was sensational, running 29.58 for the 515m journey with splits of 4.50 and 16.83 when many other greyhounds on the night struggled to break 30 seconds. He won by 1.50 lengths from Rosie Red who was gallant in defeat at only her 8th lifetime start. Victa Grosso ran well for third, a further 5.50 lengths away with the luckless Fly For Trix back in fourth.

WAP Update for participants - February 2021

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) advises participants that the Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of February 2021 was \$291,000.

Total WAP payments for the eight months to the end of February now amount to \$1,827,000. When the WAP model was introduced it was forecast that the total WAP payments over the course of the year would amount to \$600,000. It is highly likely that WAP payments for the full year will easily exceed \$2 million. It is noteworthy that the interrelationship between the WAP model and base stakes will be the subject of review as part of the budgeting and forecasting process for the coming financial year. While GRSA are delighted by the additional payments being received by participants, it is highly likely that the model will be modified to derive higher base stakes and lower WAPs in the coming financial year.

The table below is provided for the benefit of those participants wishing to better understand the computation of the WAP.

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney.

If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.



Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.


If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialed after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!




Latest updates from GAP

A quinella in Gawler Breeder's for Des

GAWLER

Sunday, 7th March at Gawler featured the running of the 2021 Gawler Breeder's, run over the 400m trip. This is the first race for the Breeders 2021 series for paid up greyhounds whelped in the January to June 2019 period.

After two Heats run the previous week, it was Midnight Sebon who showed the best early pace to go to the front, but was quickly challenged by Far More Crazy (1) which railed through to lead. Far More Crazy opened up a three length break over the rest of the field, and was not challenged further, going on to win by that margin in a good time of 22.86 secs. Second was Crazy Diva [3] which had run on well from mid-field, and Hukanui Lady [7] finished third for Lisa Rasmussen of Murray Bridge.

That result gave trainer Des Hockley the quinella, as he trains both Far More Crazy and Crazy Diva. The two greyhounds are littermates from their Fabregas x Just Crazy mating, and are both owned by the Bazinga Syndicate, managed by Des's partner, Renata Maruszczky.

Des had purchased Just Crazy as a pup from Mike and Karen Wittholz, and after a successful racing career, Mike and Karen bred two litters from her, with some good performers among them. Des and Renata then had Just Crazy's third litter, retaining six themselves. Des said that there was usually only about a length between the

two greyhounds in their performance, with Far More Crazy scoring six wins and nine placings from 16 starts, and Crazy Diva with ten wins and three placings from 17 starts, they have proven to be very consistent.

The next races in the Series will be run at Angle Park and will be run over the longer 515m distance, which Des hopes they will perform well over. Des won the same Series last year with Maddison Kaye, so he is hoping for a repeat performance. Involved with greyhounds since his early


days in Broken Hill, Des is located at Lewiston and gets plenty of support to manage his team from Renata and his new "apprentice", Brenda Oakey.

One of the good performers from the previous Just Crazy litter, All Out Crazy, kept it in the family, by winning the final race in a very quick time, running 22.69 secs. The Mike Wittholz trained All Out Crazy won by a length over Cheque Money and Canya Bandido was third.

Richards takes involvement to new heights

Meningie trainer Tim Richards' involvement in greyhound racing goes back something like six years. Prior to that his sporting interest had been football, one highlight being the 2005 grand final in the River Murray Football League when he coached Jervois to a record-breaking premiership win over Tailem Bend.

These days it's records of a different kind. Almighty Stripe's 22.68 seconds for 400 metres at Tara Raceway last October the fastest recorded at the track. And Justice For All's time of 29.59 seconds when winning the Summer Classic (512 m) was also a race record.

Richards won his first race at Tara Raceway just over three years ago with Allen Paul which he had purchased from NSW breeder Paul Wheeler for \$500. At the time he had said he hoped to become further involved through breeding his own stock.

And this is where his involvement with Worm Burner's owners Cameron and Yvonne Butcher, also based at Meningie, came into play.

"I've enjoyed success with a couple of their bitches that I've bred with – Spicy Peppa, a winner of 25 races, has produced Almighty Stripe, Contrail, Jervois Boy, Jervois Bruit and Meek And Mild from a mating to Fabregas," Richards said.

"Then there's Molly Be Nimble's litter by Aston Dee Bee which we shared and includes Jack's Well (14 wins and \$40,000 in stakemoney) and Justice For All. She was recently mated for a third occasion, this time with Barcia Bale.

"I have to say, Cameron and Yvonne have been really helpful

and very good to me. I certainly appreciate that they have given me an opportunity to become involved in their line which is highlighted by Little Looper, the dam of Worm Burner."

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday or Tuesday (drawn Thursday) meetings. Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday.

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Friday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Thursday.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held on a monthly basis at a Wednesday night session for one turn track only. Qualifying will be for the following Friday (drawn Tuesday). The next session will be Wednesday, 28th April. Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday prior.

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kennelling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.


