CEO'S UPDATE

The Road Ahead

It goes without saying that we've travelled something of a broken path in recent times and, whilst the greatest threat appears to be behind us, the reality is that 'normal' cannot be restored overnight. A bit like the Government of the day, I would ask you to remain patient and disciplined to ensure that we preserve our racing opportunity.

There is growing discussion about the merits of a catering offer on raceday. Our opportunity in that space is heavily limited and I'll try to explain why that is the case. Our patron facilities are sporting venues. The current Government direction, as it relates to such venues, is that they are able to provide take-away meals [no alcohol] only. Additionally, the direction specifically precludes the sale of snacks and beverages from an external canteen [or similar]. We are only able to accommodate trainers inside the patron facility at our venues – with all of the relevant social distancing measures – by virtue of the fact that we are not catering. The minute we change that, it essentially requires us to evict trainers from the building. Even if we were deemed to be a café or a restaurant, which we are not, all but 10 trainers would need to be evicted. To any extent that this approach isn't being adopted by other sporting organisations, it would be unwise for us to treat that as compelling precedence. Additionally, our commitment to the Police Commissioner some weeks' back was that we would manage racing with only essential individuals at the venue, and that hasn't changed.

Additionally, we have written to the Office of Recreation, Sport and Racing regarding the value that we would place on its support of cross-border movement of greyhounds. As is probably evident from the many public statements that the Premier has made in relation to this restriction, GRSA was advised that this remains a matter for individual dealings between participants and border police. Whilst that outcome is obviously problematic, and continues to prevent Mt Gambier from having the benefit of Victorian participation, it's also consistent with the type of compromise which many businesses are being forced to cope with at the current time. On a more positive note, the Chief and Deputy Chief Medical Officers [at a federal level] are continuing to observe that the border restrictions have no genuine basis in medical risk within the context of the broader strategy to suppress Covid-19.

As we start to rebound from both these restrictions and the recent gastroenteritis outbreak, it's our intention to return to the racing model which was serving us well prior to the onset of fire, heat, viruses and the various challenges confronting UBET. Our grading of meetings will start to revert, as a norm, to G-SIX fields with G-EIGHT Quaddie legs, and this will be the case at all venues [albeit that a flexible approach will still need to apply to Mt Gambier until things have settled there]. Further information will be released on that approach in the days ahead. Separately, having regard for what is logically a diminishing risk of racing being forced into temporary closure by Covid-19 restrictions, we can start to turn our attention towards a timeframe for reversing out the reductions that have been applied to participants and staff/Management of GRSA as soon as possible.

Thank you for your patience and professionalism up to this point of the most trying of years.

A big night for Ben at Angle Park

It was definitely one of the more remarkable training performances at headquarters on Thursday 23rd April when Ben Rawlings trained 6 winners, including 2 feature finals and also 2 second placings just to top it off.

Zippering Galon won the 2020 SA Distance Championship in race 6 and It's A Riot claimed the SA Anniversary Cup 2 races later in what was certainly a memorable night for all connections.

Zippering Galon was highly fancied to win the 2020 SA Distance Championship along with the Wally Harkin's trained Sir Truculent but it was Wooden Tiger who set a fast pace early for trainer Petar Jovanovic. As they went past the finishing post on the first lap the two race favourites were sitting well back in the field as Cripps Dusty went about catching the leader. Down the back straight Zippering Galon made his move, weaving through the field and caught the leaders turning into home.

Zippering Galon ran on strongly to the finish line to claim the win ahead of Sir Truculent who had also motored home from well back and My Boy Bean in third place for Clint Trengove.

The next feature on the night was the SA Anniversary Cup where It's A Riot claimed a memorable all-the-way win.

In a very strong field that included EASTAR series winner Alfieri and kennel mate Two

Times Twice, It's A Riot jumped brilliantly to find the lead just ahead of Chief's Sidekick.

It's A Riot pushed ahead to lead by 3 lengths down the back straight as Two Times Twice and Chief's Sidekick tried to make up the ground. However, It's A Riot

did not take his foot off the pedal and pushed on leading all the way to post an impressive 29.77 win. Rawlings also claimed the quinella as Two Times Twice ran on well in second place but couldn't quite close the gap on his kennelmate. Chief's Sidekick also battled on well for third for Damien Bates.

Shane McQueen heats this month

The main 600m feature at Angle Park comes up on Thursday, 28th May with the running of the \$5,120 Heats of the Shane McQueen.

This series has always been well supported by the industry with three or four Heats normally run. The Final will be held on Thursday, 4th June and will be worth \$11,435.

- Nominations for the Heats close on Monday, 25th May with GRSA at 9.00am.

2020 Gawler Breeders heats on 5th June over 531m

After the Group 3 Howard Ashton Final later this month the Heats for the Gawler Breeders over the 531m will be run on Friday, 5th June and the Final on Friday, 12th June for those greyhounds that are eligible for Breeders 2020.

2020 Gawler Produce Stake next month

A reminder to all trainers with greyhounds paid up for the Gawler Produce Stake that the Heats will be run on Friday, 19th June. The Semis are listed for Friday, 26th June and the Final will be held on Sunday, 5th July.

The prizemoney breakdowns will be announced after the number of Heats are known, however, the Final is guaranteed at \$22,000 and consolation at \$2,700.

Nominations for the Heats close on Tuesday, 16th June with GRSA at 9.00am.

The winner of the Final is also eligible for a \$8,000 bonus if it can win the 2020 Gawler Gold Cup later this year. If the winner of the Gawler Produce is SA Bred there is also a \$1,000 SA Bred Bonus.

Racing and feature race dates released for 2020/2021

The racing dates for season 2020/2021 have been released based on the schedule that we are currently racing on. These dates may be subject to some slight change, however, generally should remain as listed.

We have also just released the Angle Park, Murray Bridge and Gawler feature dates together with the list of lower graded feature races with the Finals worth \$4,715 for the 2020/2021 season which is included in Kennel Capers. This information is also available on the GRSA website at www.grsa.com.au. These dates may be subject to change along with some alterations to prizemoney.

2020 Mount Gambier Cup to be run this year

GRSA has re-considered the running of the 2020 Mount Gambier Cup which was postponed/cancelled from March this year.

In reviewing budgets, feature races and making some changes we believe we can support the running of the Mount Gambier Cup. The event will only be scheduled when borders are opened up by Government and the GRSA Board approves nominations from Interstate. GRSA would prefer this event be run before June 30 this year, however, some of these restrictions may not be removed. That being the case, we are supportive of the event being run before the end of the calendar year with an expectation of sooner rather than later. In doing this, the event will have to be conducted at reduced stakes for the Heats and reduced stakes [\$10,000 to the winner] for the Final which falls in line with other reductions to feature events across the State during this time

Changes to nomination closing times

Based on items discussed and approved at the most recent Industry Consultative Group, GRSA has changed some of the days of closing of nominations to aid participants who trial the night before they nominate. This will hopefully increase our numbers for race meetings resulting in less extension of nominations. Moving the nominations closer to the race date may have implications for the sa.thedogs form analyst releasing as quick as normal.

It's A Riot is April's Greyhound of the Month

Greyhound of the Month for April was It's A Riot for trainer Ben Rawlings who had 5 starts for the month with 3 wins and 2 placings, with the highlight being his super win in the SA Anniversary Cup Final.

The son of Barcia Bale and It's A Bird started the month off with a solid placing at headquarters before taking on the Easter Match Race Series. He ran a brilliant 29.58 in his match, however, missed the lead time by only .04 of a second in an outstanding performance. He then took on the Anniversary Cup series and won his Heat in fine style in a slick 29.73. He was one of the favourites for the Final and made full use of box 3, jumping well and leading throughout in one of the strongest Finals seen in recent years. He ran 29.77 in the feature and stamped himself as one of the best sprinters in the State. He rounded the month off with a very easy win at headquarters by almost 5 lengths.

At the end of the month It's A Riot's record stood at 27 starts for 11 wins and 8 placings and earnings around \$55,000.



Alfieri sizzles around Angle Park to monthly award

The Run of the Month for April was the Bill Wudarczyk trained Alfieri, for his sizzling win at Angle Park in a Heat of the SA Anniversary Cup over the 515m on Thursday, 16th April.

Starting the even money favourite he exploded out of box 7 to challenge for the early lead in a slick 4.45. Into the back and the son of Fernando Bale and Rhonda Rocks raced away from his rivals recording a flying 16.77 second split. He was in no danger down the home straight going on to win by almost 7 lengths in a breath taking 29.39.



Administration time changes

As part of the changes previously advised by GRSA during the COVID-19 pandemic, GRSA have altered their Administration Business hours.

Normal Business hours would be 8.30am to 4.30pm, however, from Monday, 4th May these have varied to 8.30am to 3.30pm during this period. This change is part of GRSA's strategy to reduce costs where it can; in order to help alleviate the downturn in business income.

This will have an effect on scratching closing times and trials being booked. Both will now close at 3pm when they would have normally closed at 4pm.

Access to the Office and Telephone calls will only be available up until 3.30pm from Monday to Friday.

This will also have some implications on race books with the change in nomination times and early closing of the office there will only be a one page per race book provided which will also save on costs during this period. All information is still available on the GRSA website.

Due to the reduction in office hours participants need to be mindful when lodging paperwork that the processing time may take longer.

We appreciate your patience and understanding during these challenging times.

Scratchings for those meetings that closed 4pm the day before will now be 3pm

As advised above trainers please note that scratching's for ALL meetings that would have closed at 4pm the day before will now close at 3pm the day before.

Classic and Breeders Futurity payments

Owners of SA Bred greyhounds are reminded that the next batch of Futurity payments are due on Friday, 19th June 2020.

The payments due are:

Classic 2020 – Final Payment (Pups born July 18 to December 18)

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound.

Breeders 2021 – Second Payment (Pups born January 19 to June 19)

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

With regard to the First Payment for Classic 2021 (Pups born July 19 to December 19) GRSA has decided to delay these payments due to the current environment affected by COVID-19. This series will now only consist of two sustaining payments, First payment of \$82.50 or Final Payment of \$121 due Friday, 19th December with the Final Payment due in June 2021 for owners who paid the First Payment in December.

The payments for Classic 2020 and Breeders 2021 are unable to be delayed due to races programmed in August for Classic 2020 and

having the First Payments already made for Breeders 2021.

To assist all owners of Futurity eligible pups, reminders will be sent out over the coming days. It is perhaps a good idea to make the payment as soon as you can, so it doesn't slip your mind and the closing date passes. If you have sold a pup/s we would ask if you can either forward on the information or let Caralyn Fielden know at GRSA and she can follow it up. If you haven't received a reminder by the end of this month and you think you should have, contact us as soon as possible.

Non-essential persons oncourse at race meetings

GRSA reminds participants with children, that due to the COVID-19 restrictions non essential persons and the public are not allowed oncourse which includes children.

Unfortunately during school holidays this can be difficult for some of our participants to manage, however, they need to make other arrangements for them.

GRSA appreciates the significant changes in place for the industry during this time and appreciates the efforts that are being made and continue to be made to abide social distancing and restrictions.

Murray Bridge trials

GRSA advises that as from March there has no longer been an officiating staff member to clear greyhounds for Satisfactory trials and Qualifying Qualy trials on the fortnightly Tuesday nights at Murray Bridge.

However, there is an official once a month on a Friday morning trial session, which has both tracks trialling. This presents an opportunity to include the Straight Track for Qualifying and Satisfactory Trials. The next trial session will be Friday, 19th June.

Winning grade 6 races in order

GRSA reminds trainers to win their Grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

Re-grading for all tracks and distances

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

GAR46 – Preparation for racing

Participants are reminded of GAR46[2].

[2] If the handler of a greyhound engaged to compete in an Event fails to appear at the kennels within 5 minutes of the appointed time to retrieve the greyhound, the Stewards may order the withdrawal of the greyhound and the handler shall be guilty of an offence.

From time to time Kennel staff have been known to chase up Trainers who have not presented at the Kennel House to retrieve their greyhound pre-race. Kennel Staff have been instructed to cease this practice as Stewards believe an inconsistent approach can appear to favour some over others. Please ensure you are aware of your obligations at each track as Stewards will be enforcing this rule.

Participants are able to purchase their very own red vests for \$20 however GRSA will always have some available. These vests look very smart and come up particularly well on Sky Racing promoting SA Racing so with that in mind the long parade coats have been phased out of action with participants required to have a black or navy jumper available to be worn under the vests.

Audit of greyhounds owned/trained/in care of South Australian licensed persons

The Animal Welfare department (with the assistance of other GRSA staff) will shortly be conducting a routine audit of greyhounds, including inactive data, to ensure that GRSA is continuing to track all greyhounds, throughout their lifecycle, to the highest standard.

GRSA staff will be contacting all South Australian licensed people with greyhounds in their ownership/care (according to OzChase) to confirm their location.

In conjunction with this process, licensed persons may be required to complete forms declaring the current status of greyhounds or, in rarer instances, require them to lodge a statutory declaration.

Please note, if you are contacted about a greyhound with regard to which you have previously declared information, this may be due to incomplete evidence having been provided previously. GRSA cannot alter the status of a greyhound in the system without certain specific information or evidentiary documents being provided. We appreciate your cooperation during this project.

Management of Canine Gastroenteritis outbreak

South Australia has received no new notifications of canine gastroenteritis in local kennels in the past three weeks.

Furthermore, advice from interstate greyhound authorities suggests that they now longer see the canine gastroenteritis outbreak as a significant issue for the code going forward.

As such, GRSA will make the following changes to temporary requirements and procedural amendments from 1st June, 2020:

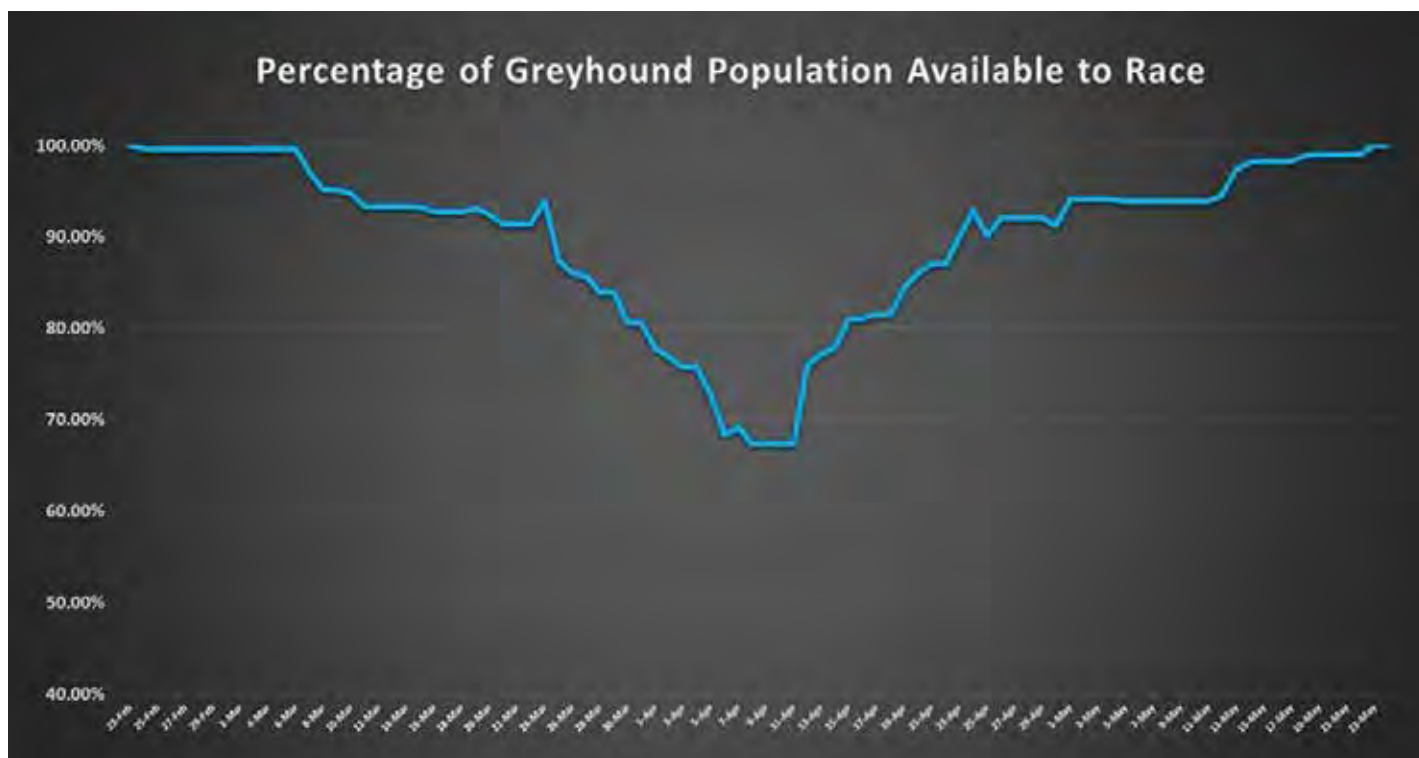
- It will no longer be a requirement to mandatorily report canine gastroenteritis in your kennels
- Trainers are to manage quarantine periods on an individual basis (mandatory 18 day standown will no longer be applied)
- No longer a requirement to isolate newly arrived greyhounds from interstate for a period of 10 days (however caution is still recommended)
- Arm trials to resume as normal, with the requirement for trainers to bring their own lure material removed (although this option is still available)
- The use of multiple decoy lures at race meetings to cease
- The use of bio-security footbeds to cease

- Additional resourcing to undertake cleaning and disinfecting to cease
- The prohibition on interstate greyhounds racing in SA for a period of 10 days since their last interstate start to be removed

Note that sample testing of potentially infected dogs at race meetings will continue as required.

GRSA will still be available to provide support for participants if they do happen to get canine gastroenteritis in their kennels going forward, including testing to confirm the virus. If any of your greyhounds have symptoms (vomiting, diarrhoea, elevated temperature, lethargy, and/or loss of appetite), you can contact the GRSA Animal Welfare team on [08] 8243 7100 for any assistance.

Management would like to thank all SA participants for the way they have helped to contain and manage the outbreak in this state. This strain of virus was particularly nasty and had a significant impact on greyhound numbers throughout April and May. At one stage over one-third of greyhounds were unavailable to race (refer graph), highlighting the need to make changes to the racing schedule in response.



Angle Park Vet clinic relocation well underway

The project to relocate the Angle Park Vet Clinic is well underway and GRSA is hopeful that operations could begin as early as August.

The new location will provide direct access for clinic customers from the front car park and allow for a significant visual presence for the clinic from Cardigan Street (refer artwork below). It will also improve logistics around the venue as Vet Clinic customers will no longer need to enter the venue, which

has been a challenge at times during events and race meetings.

The requirements of the new clinic are very similar to the existing clinic, with a reception area, office/storage space, consultation rooms, surgery, x-ray room and a recovery room. The biggest issue with the layout of the existing clinic is probably the size of the reception area, so the new clinic having a far greater sized reception area.



Murray Bridge Slipping Track

The other major project underway is the new slipping track at Murray Bridge. Works are progressing on schedule and GRSA is hoping participants can commence using the track towards the end of July.

The track is approximately 300 metres long and 4 metres wide, with a sand surface similar to the current Angle Park slipping track. It will have a road to the northern side of the track, which will run its entire length, with vehicle turnarounds and access gates at both ends. An automated irrigation system will keep the surface damp.

Participants can begin to register with GRSA to receive key fobs which allow access to the facility outside of normal business hours (the key fobs will open the main entrance gates). If you do wish to have access to the slipping track, please contact GRSA reception on [08] 8243-7100 to register. Once we have received the key fob supply, they can then be distributed to participants that have registered.

GAP SA is looking for small dogs to help with their green collar and first point assessments.

During assessments, greyhounds will be muzzled, on a leash and handled by an experienced assessor and handlers. All dogs will be walked around together in a secure testing area for approximately 5-10 mins to assess the greyhound's reaction to the small dog. If the greyhound is reacting well we will allow them to approach and sniff the small dog.

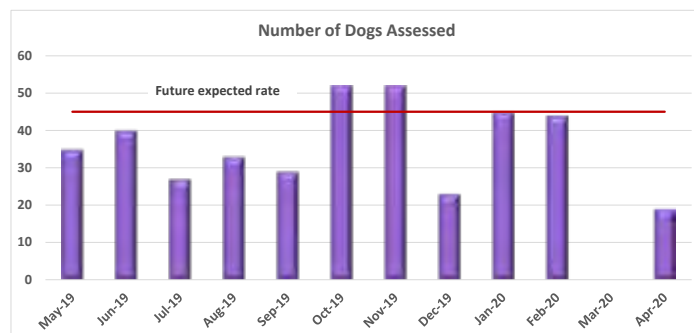

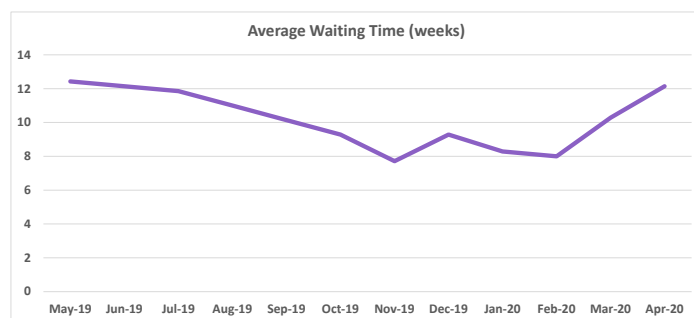
Latest updates from GAP

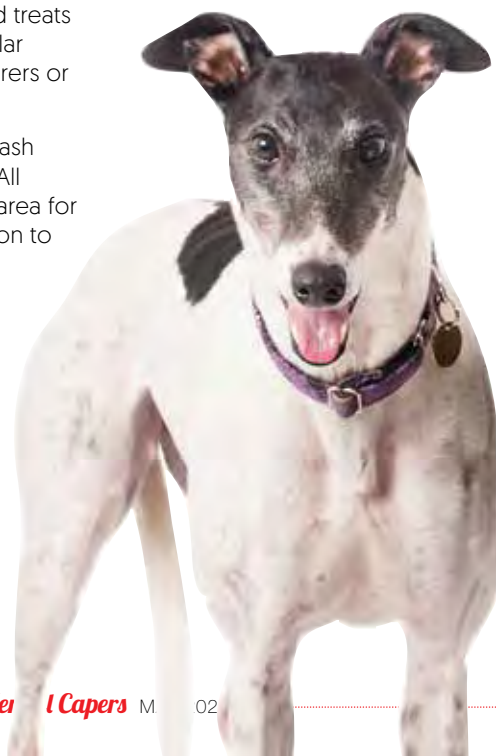


We have also been working on reducing the time between assessment and entry into the program. The following graph shows the average monthly waiting times in weeks.

Leading trainer's 50 local winners come up in record time

ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

Under the new schedule Angle Park Qualifying Trials will be run weekly on Wednesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting (12 days later due to nominations). With 388m racing now available on Monday nights trainers can qualify for all distances.

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Wednesday of the meeting.

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Tuesday and Friday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the race meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA by midday on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Gawler Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before.
3. For Murray Bridge Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA by 4.30pm the day before. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.
