CEO'S UPDATE

So Far.... So Good...

The temporary closure of Angle Park was always going to come with some risk but thankfully, at this point, the stars are mostly aligning for us. The weather has been favourable at a time during the project when that element would have had the most impact in terms of delays and scheduling implications. The conditions that we've discovered under the track have been reasonable, and our Contractors have worked with a sense of urgency that is commensurate with our challenging timeframes.

The anticipated reduction in wagering, due to the loss of the Angle Park 'brand', hasn't really transpired and nominations for all of our weekly timeslots has maintained its momentum. Consequently, we will shortly be able to announce that the Wagering Activity Payment for the month of April will come in just above \$240,000. This is a perfect example of that [equity] stakemoney model rewarding trainers and owners for fielding full meetings across the whole of the weekly schedule.

Our aim now is keep pushing forward so that we can resume racing at Angle Park from the earliest opportunity so that the ground we've gained this year can set the foundation for a strong year in FY22. More [positive] announcements will follow regarding various stakemoney elements in the coming weeks. In noting that a higher base of stakemoney will contribute to a lower WAP, we know the value that trainers, owners and breeders place on having certainty about their wages from the sport.

For all of those who are covering some extra miles during this few months, this amounts to reward for your effort.

Barbados Express our new distance Queen

■ MURRAY BRIDGE

The final of the Bayroad Queen Stayers Cup was run over the 680m at Murray Bridge this year on Thursday May 6.

With Angle Park currently being redeveloped the staying types ventured to the Bridge and over the new distance an even field was assembled with the Ben Rawlings trained Barbados Express showing her class in leading throughout and claiming the \$4,500 first prize.

With a nice crowd on hand and the starting boxes right in front of the patron facility there was much anticipation as the distance offered genuine stayers and middle distance greyhounds a great opportunity to capture a much sought after event.

Heat winners from the week prior, Bedrock Fred for Cherylee Barber and Oakvale Impact for Nathan Wilson were sent out as the favourites in a wide open betting affair. As the start was affected Barbados Express from Box 2 showed great speed to lead to the first turn while New Year Tears for Ryan Tugwell moved to second making full use of his inside draw. Shanlyn Charlott for Vadim Roz quickly moved up to challenge the leaders as they left the front straight with the remainder of the field jostling for positions in behind. Entering the back straight and Barbados Express was moving sweetly in the lead followed by Shanlyn Charlott in second just ahead of New Year Tears on the rails. From back in the field Shadow Burner for Tony Rasmussen was trying to wind up on the outside around Springvale Anna for Bob Fletcher.

Off the back straight and Barbados Express was giving a great display in the lead and moved away from her rivals by a length with Shanlyn Charlott moving to a clear second. New Year Tears was being strongly challenged by Shadow Burner for third place while the remainder of the field tried hard to make ground. Entering the home straight and Barbados Express skipped away from her rivals with a race winning break as she went down to the winning post a 1 length winner in a slick 39.03 which is the fastest time recorded over the 680m in its limited use so far. New Year Tears got motoring late to move to second making ground with every stride while Shadow Burner ran to the line nicely back in third place a further 2.50 lengths back.

Barbados Express is by Fernando Bale out of Sweet Barbados and is owned by Mark Watson, Craig Ahl, Tanner Ahl and Tyson Panagiotou with the owners on hand to be presented with the rug and trophy.

The Stayer's Cup has proven to be a very important addition to the distance racing calendar and it was great to be hosted by Murray Bridge this year. It was the sixteenth running of the Stayer's Cup and was the fourth year it was named the Bayroad Queen in recognition of one of the State's best stayers. Bayroad Queen competed in the early 80's and in 1982 she won the National Distance Final breaking a 13 year dominance of NSW and Victoria. She also won the equivalent of the Association Cup at Harold Park and Sandown Cup at Olympic Park and was named the SA Greyhound of the Year. At the peak of her powers she was considered the best stayer in the country.



Ray Fewings re-appointed to Greyhound Racing SA Board

Industry stalwart, Ray Fewings, has been re-appointed for a second term as a Board Member for Greyhound Racing SA (GRSA), in the role of Company Director – Industry Experience.

Mr Fewings' extensive background in the industry dates back to 1961 as a racecaller and greyhound owner. In the course of his involvement with the sport, Ray has been a greyhound trainer as well as a caller across the three codes on Sky Racing for more than 60 years, while still continuing to train greyhounds in his own right.

Appointments to this particular Board role have previously been resolved by way of an election involving registered participants, but are now undertaken through the Director Selection Panel as a condition of Government current funding.

Ray joined the GRSA Board of Directors in 2017, at a time when the organisation and its stakeholders were facing multiple challenges. Ray has brought invaluable industry experience and context to the Board table, helping to guide GRSA's efforts in relation to participant sustainability – including the introduction of an equity stake money model operating under the framework of Wagering Activity Payments (WAP) – and its management of recent COVID-19 and canine gastroenteritis outbreaks.

The organisation has subsequently established a solid foundation of growth for the coming years. The race meeting schedule around Adelaide now covers all seven days of the week, and stake money reductions in 2019 and 2020 have been remedied by way of more than \$3 million worth of additional payments in the current year, comprising of monthly WAP distributions and a discretionary payment to industry of \$1 million in February of this year.

Chairman of the Board, Grantley Stevens communicated his support of Ray's re-appointment. "Ray has been an outstanding contributor to the business over the past 3 years. His understanding and experience as an industry participant are invaluable and I am delighted that Ray has been given the opportunity to continue with us into the future."



"It is very pleasing to be able to continue my role as a Director for Greyhound Racing SA. I feel as a business and industry we have made great progress and am looking forward to what the next 3 years will bring" Mr Fewings commented.

Introduction of Category 2 stake money at Mount Gambier

Greyhound Racing SA (GRSA) is pleased to announce that the weekly Sunday race meeting at the Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club will be elevated to Category 2 stake money from 1st July 2021. The value of that stake money increase will approach \$300,000 annually in additional returns to local participants.

The Board and Management of GRSA have long held the view that the strongest model for greyhound racing in South Australia is one that is based on an equitable approach to supporting regional Clubs, and this change is motivated by that goal.

"The additional prize money will be a

great boost for racing in the Mount Gambier Region which means we will hopefully see a further influx of Victorian trainers to our race meetings," Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club President, Noel Perry, explained.

COVID-19 hit the Club particularly hard in 2020 with its supply of racing nominations severely reduced due to the Victorian border closure. That came on top of the impact that the Club had already suffered due a severe canine gastroenteritis outbreak in the first half of last year.

"We're really pleased to see our regional Clubs thriving, and the performance of the Mount Gambier Club in recent

times is a testament to the resilience of the Committee and the local trainers supported by the venue," GRSA CEO, Matt Corby noted.

"We are also working toward introducing other positive changes for South Australian stake money strategy from the start of the next financial year which means that these are very exciting times." Continued Mr Corby.

Since the introduction of greyhound racing being broadcast from Mount Gambier on Sky Racing just prior to 2012, the Club has quadrupled its annual racing schedule from 26 to 104 meetings annually.

Third time lucky for Coleman and Camilleri in Cup win

For the Lara training team of Deb Coleman and Rob Camilleri it was a case of third time lucky in the Group Listed Commercial Hotel Mount Gambier Cup [512 metres] after Zippling Zarbo was successful at Tara Raceway on Sunday April 18.

Two years ago their odds-on favourite in the cup, Slingshot Hammer, was a desperately close second. Then, last year's winner, Sunset Milo, was transferred from their Lara kennels just prior to the cup to Adelaide owner Tim Aloisi in order to overcome border restrictions.

After an impressive heat win, Zippling Zarbo lined up from box one as a \$1.90 favourite. And she led all the way to defeat a determined Renewed, trained at Two Wells by Bec Romyn, by a length in 29.56 seconds.

A further length back in third spot was Fabriola Zad who turned in a big run for Portland trainer Nifty Lenehan who was looking to emulate his father Brian, the cup-winning trainer in 1993 of Immortal Flash.

Bred and raced by the Hallinan family of Clergate in NSW, Zippling Zarbo was handled with aplomb by 24-year-old Ricky Coleman who did his mother and step-father proud.

And he was full of praise for the three-year-old red fawn daughter of El Grand Senor and Zippling Abby.

"She's been with us since pre-training and has always tried her heart out," he said. "Winning the cup was certainly a big thrill and we're now looking to race here in Mount Gambier on a more regular basis."

Gemtree Maximus claims the Breeder's Prelude (2) at Gawler

It was a great win by Gemtree Maximus for trainer Paul Rehmann in the Breeder's Prelude (2) Final at Gawler on Sunday 2nd May claiming the 531m feature in 30.80 seconds from box 8.

The son of Worm Burner and Lochinvar Akira's record now stands at an impressive 9 wins and 2 placings from his 14 career starts. Crazy Diva for Des Hockley and Victa Reid for Lisa Rasmussen ran well to finish in second and third places respectively.



Gary's Miracle produces a month to remember

Greyhound of the Month for April was Gary's Miracle for trainer Michael Stewart. The daughter of Magic Sprite and Jenneke had a super month of racing, winning three and placing in three of her six starts with the highlight being the Easter Cup Final over the 600m.

She started the month off with a brilliant win in the Final of the Easter Cup when she was able to lead throughout and gave nothing else a chance in winning by 2.5 lengths in a sizzling 34.94 over the 600m. Two placings followed before another brilliant win at Murray Bridge, this time over the 455m running a slick 25.27. A placing at the Bridge before another win, this time over the 530m when she ran sizzling time in winning by 3.5 lengths in 29.69. She has proven to be one of the most versatile and consistent chasers in the State.

At the end of the month Gary's Miracle record stood at 60 starts for 13 wins and 19 placings and earnings just over \$33,000.



Jack's Well fantastic run at Angle Park rewarded

The Run of the Month for April was Jack's Well for trainer Cameron Butcher after his fantastic performance at Angle Park on Thursday, 8th April in a Mixed 1/2/3 event over the 515m journey where he ran a blistering 29.42.

He began well from box 8 to land third early before powering away from his rivals. His first split was 4.48 before opening up down the back straight in a flying 16.84, he raced down to the finish line in 29.42 in winning by an ever extending 9.25 lengths.

Satisfactory and Qualifying trials at Gawler on Wednesday night each week. Nominations close 12.30pm Wednesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Tuesday) Qualifying for the following Friday.

Satisfactory and Qualifying trials at Murray Bridge for both tracks are now on Friday mornings once a week – effective immediately.

During the Angle Park shutdown we will move this away from the monthly Tuesday night during this period, which was difficult to staff and didn't provide enough opportunity for trainers to clear or qualify greyhounds whilst Angle Park is out of action.

These Satisfactory and Qualifying trials will be conducted between 8.50am and 9.15am fitting in the middle of the One Turn track finishing and the Straight track starting, however, please fit in with staff on the day. Nominations close 12.30pm Thursday, Qualifying for the following Monday on the One Turn and the Wednesday week on the Straight.

Gawler morning trials

With the Gawler trial sessions currently on Mondays and Thursdays starting at 7am, staff are finding that at times that they are waiting for trainers to arrive and trial.

This means there are extended periods where there is no activity. Staff have been advised that if there is an extended period where no one has arrived to trial for them to cease the session. GRSA currently do not take bookings for Gawler but may have to in the future if trainers do not arrive in a timely manner for these sessions.

Saturday morning meetings once a fortnight at Gawler

The next meeting will be on Saturday, 15th May at Gawler which is a Timed Graded Meeting - "Worst to Best" rating. With Maiden and 1-4 win races having first preference.

The first of 10 races will be at 7.57am with the last at 10.34am

The next meeting will be on Saturday, 29th May at Gawler which will be a Timed Graded Meeting - "Worst to Best" rating. Maiden and 5+ win races will have first preference. Greyhounds will be graded into 3 categories, Maidens, 1-4 wins and 5 or more wins. Specific grades of greyhounds are not considered except for Maidens. Races–N/P with Pathway Prizemoney. Reserves will be determined by Grader. There will be No Guarding. Refer to "Time Based Grading" published conditions.

- Nominations close Tuesday, 25th May at 9.00am.

Murray Bridge Straight track Cup heats on Wednesday 19th May

The \$965 Heats of the Murray Bridge Straight Track Cup will be held over the 350m on Wednesday, 19th May with the \$7,145 Final on Wednesday, 26th May.

- Nominations for the Heats close Friday, 14th May at 9.00am.

SA Distance Championship Heats at Murray Bridge on Thursday 20th May

The \$5,120 Heats of the SA Distance Championship will be held at Murray Bridge over the 680m on Thursday, 20th May with the \$11,460 Final on Thursday, 27th May also at Murray Bridge.

- Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 17th May at 9.00am.

****Please note due to the movement of Feature races, the new 680m distance has been added and we will be attempting to program these features on the CITY A meetings. The Heats of the SA Distance Championship at Murray Bridge coincide with the Heats of the Group 1 Sandown Cup, this is normally avoided and when we are back racing at Angle Park will continue to be separated.**

2021 Group 3 Howard Ashton heats on 30th May

The major race for Breeders 2021 is the Group 3 Howard Ashton which will be run at Gawler over the 531m journey this year.

Trainers are reminded that the \$2,000 Heats will be run on Sunday, 30th May. These will be followed by the \$4,000 Semi-Finals on 6th June and the \$37,500 Final on 13th June.

The race is for greyhounds that are eligible for Breeders 2021. Greyhounds didn't have to have compete in the Preludes to run in the Group 3 Howard Ashton.

Gawler Produce Series to kick off on Friday 2nd July

With the changes to feature races due to the Angle Park redevelopment the Gawler Produce series has been pushed back a few weeks to allow greyhounds to compete in the Howard Ashton and Shane McQueen and then be ready for the Produce. GRSA has also tried to fit in with the City A programming where possible.

Champion Puppy moved to August and conducted at Angle Park

The Champion Puppy series for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st July, 2019 will be conducted in August.

This series is normally conducted in July, however, with changes to feature events it has been moved to August (dates TBC) and run at Angle Park [TBC].

Grading of City A meetings when Angle Park shutdown

When Angle Park is redeveloped in mid April the below outcomes have been listed below -

- When Angle Park is shutdown for redevelopment that the City A meetings will be shared with Murray Bridge and Gawler. Murray Bridge will conduct back to back Thursday meetings allowing for Heats and Finals of normal and feature races. Gawler will then run back to back Sundays again allowing for Heats and Finals of normal and feature races. This will mean that there is one Metropolitan [CITY A] meeting per week.
- Feature 515m races will be run at Gawler over the 531m and any 731m feature races will be run at Murray Bridge over the 680m.
- There will be a 680m City A prizemoney at Murray Bridge each Thursday every week whether City A or Prov 1 to support these stayers during this period.
- These meetings will be considered as if the greyhounds have never raced at the venue. This will mean greyhounds will be grades Maiden, Grade 6 and Grade 5 to start with unless new into the State and regraded higher.
- With all grades starting from new (no higher than Grade 5 effectively) there will not be as higher prizemoney races per meeting initially with no high grade races being conducted. There will be a Best 8 each meeting over the 455m, 530m, 680m at Murray Bridge and a 531m and 643m at Gawler for this high grade money. [GRSA will just make up these races]. Trainers need to write "No Best 8" on the nomination if they do not want to be in this event. If there are insufficient nominations for a Best 8 the Grader will make up normally graded events based on current policy.
- The Racing Department intends to run Grade 5 Heats on a regular basis but may have to run Mixed 4/5 Heats to ensure there are races for these dogs. The Finals of these races will pay the normal stakemoney for Finals [Grade 5 or Open depending on grade of Heats].
- The Grader will give preference to 455m or higher at both Murray Bridge City A and Gawler City A meetings with the intent that no short course races will be conducted. However, if there was a need to run some short course this would be under "standby" conditions.
- When a greyhound wins a Grade 5 or above over any distance at the Gawler City A and Murray Bridge City A meetings they will NOT lose any Grade 6's at other venues. The normal rule has been suspended.
- If a greyhound has already won a Grade 6 [City A] it should be eligible for Murray Bridge City A and Gawler City A Grade 6 if they have more Grade's to win as these are considered different tracks. They will still only be able to win one City A at each of these meetings if they do not win more races than allowed.
- There will be NO retrospectivity for Grading.



BEANIES AVAILABLE

Approved beanies are part of the GRSA Dress Code Policy and available for sale from GRSA. These beanies are GRSA specific and are the only ones approved, at a cost of \$10 and are available to purchase from the GRSA office's.

“Beat The Grader” during redevelopment

Our normal race schedule generally doesn't allow for any “Beat the Grader” scenario's, however, with the changes to both Murray Bridge Prov 1 and Gawler Prov 1 this is likely to happen which is an added benefit to owners and trainers.

It will be available for the Murray Bridge Monday Prov 1 to Murray Bridge Thursday Prov 1 and then the Murray Bridge Thursday Prov 1 to Murray Bridge Monday Prov 1.

For Gawler the Friday Prov 1 to Sunday Prov 1 could happen, however, there is only a few days between meetings.

Please contact the Grader for clarification around the “Beat The Grader” policy.

National Straight Track Championships in Queensland this year

The National Straight Track Championship this year will be held at Capalaba on Sunday, 15th August –with the winner receiving \$25,000.

This year SA will have 2 dogs represent the State in the series with QLD, NSW, VIC and SA challenging for the title.

Our local Heats are listed on Wednesday, 28th July with the Final on Tuesday, 3rd August. This will allow 12 days until the National Final to organise travel and trialling arrangements.

GRSA have been advised that Capalaba trial every Friday and Monday with Monday the ideal day to trial in preparation for a Sunday meeting [National Final].

Capalaba also advise they can accommodate trials on Sunday and Wednesday race meetings. The Club has a Wednesday meeting on 11 August just prior to the NSTC.

The Capalaba Club are more than happy to accommodate the needs of visiting trainers and already have had a number of trainers offer their place for Interstate visitors.

GRSA fax machines

Greyhound Racing SA has two fax machines in operation at present, however, they will be gradually phased out. The Graders Fax Machine [8243 1964] which is used for nominations is still in use, however, we are gradually transitioning trainers to the easy Online format.

The administration Fax Machine [8268 2870] which does not receive many outgoing faxes and GRSA will cease the operation of this Fax line in the coming weeks. Please use other means of contacting GRSA moving forward.

Upcoming GOTBA racing dates

Border Challenge (Mount Gambier v Warrnambool) heats on Sunday 20th June

There will be a maximum of 2 Heats run over 512m at Mount Gambier. If there is 1 Heat the first 4, or if there are 2 Heats the first 2 greyhounds will go through to the \$5,800 Final on Sunday, 27th June.

Special Conditions apply –

Trainer must have had starters at 15 Mount Gambier meetings in the past 12 months.

Trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous three months.

Greyhound must have started at least four times in the past 12 months at Tara Raceway.

- Nominations for the Heats close Wednesday, 16th June at 9.00am.

Category 2 prizemoney for Mount Gambier

It is anticipated that the increase to Category 2 prizemoney will be for the Club's Sunday meeting from 1st July, 2021 and will be the same breakdown as Gawler and Murray Bridge.

This meeting will be considered a Provincial 1 meeting for Grading and the grades that the greyhounds currently have for Provincial 2 will carry over to Provincial 1. This was the same process when Gawler split into Provincial 1 and Provincial 2 meetings a number of years ago. It would also be anticipated that the Thursday meeting will remain Time Grading under the current format as it has proven to be quite successful over the years.

Some items from GRP

The items below come from the previous Grading Review Panel meetings.

Grade 6 in higher grade middle distance & stayers events

– On occasions a Grade 6 dog will race in a 4/5, Open or FFA Middle Distance or Staying Event. If it wins this race they will lose their Grade 6 at the venue for the other distances. GRSA created

a new mixed 4/5/6 which is available for Middle distance and Staying events. Middle and Staying Distance are classed as the 530m, 680m at Murray Bridge, 643m at Gawler and 600m and 731m (old Angle Park). Trainers need to be clear on their nomination if they are a Grade 6 greyhound that they do not want to be in a mixed Middle or Staying event.

Comments on nominations marked "only"

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds. The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

Winning Grade 6 races in order

GRSA reminds trainers to win their Grade 6 events in order at a specific venue. For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

Re-grading for all tracks and distances

Re grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

Classic and Breeders Futurity payments

Owners of SA Bred greyhounds are reminded that the next batch of Futurity payments are due on Friday, 18th June 2021.

The payments due are:

Classic 2021 – Final Payment [Pups born July 19 to December 19]

This payment is for greyhounds for which the combined First and Second Sustaining Payment was made. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound.

Breeders 2022 – Second Payment [Pups born January 20 to June 20]

This payment is for greyhounds for which the First Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

Classic 2022 – First Payment [Pups born July 20 to December 20]

This First Payment is due for Classic 2022. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. The First Payment is \$27.50 per pup or a "one-off" Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

To assist all owners of Futurity eligible pups, reminders will be sent out over the coming days. It is perhaps a good idea to make the payment as soon as you can, so it does not slip your mind and the closing date passes. If you have sold a pup/s we would ask if you can forward on the information to the new owner. If you have not received a reminder by the end of this month and you think you should have, contact Caralyn Fielden as soon as possible.

Online scratchings now available

GRSA have now made scratchings out of drawn race meetings available for trainers through the OzChase system. This will provide flexibility for the trainers during their busy schedules. Trainers can still phone scratchings through as normal.

Once a scratching has been lodged, GRSA will consider this greyhound as requiring to be removed and will be published as soon as received on the next work day.

Any Late Scratching's cannot be made via online and will have to be phoned through to the stewards.

Please see below for the process of making a scratching via OzChase -

To request that a greyhound is scratched from a race, a trainer can select the 'Scratch Greyhound' action.

A greyhound can be selected from the dropdown on the screen. Once selected, the details related to this greyhound (ear brands, certificate number and microchips) will be displayed.

The meeting list presented to the trainer for selection will show those meetings where the selected greyhound has been allocated as a runner or reserve. If the greyhound has multiple starts at the meeting, then all races for this greyhound will be listed against the appropriate meeting entry.

WAP Update for participants - March 2021

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) advises participants that the Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of March 2021 was \$330,000.

Total WAP payments for the nine months to the end of March now amount to \$2,162,000 compared to the initial total estimate of \$600,000 for the full year. While GRSA are delighted by the additional payments being received by participants, the model will be amended in the next financial year to incorporate an increase in base stakemoney and modest monthly WAPs. This is consistent with feedback from consultation with industry in December 2020. GRSA is modelling those changes currently and it's anticipated that an announcement in that regard will be made in late May.

At the end of the current financial year, a calculation will be made which identifies any shortfall in the payments to trainers, breeders and owners below the committed level of 50% returns from net wagering revenue. That payment will be distributed in line with total WAP distributions over the 12 months and specifically excludes the \$1 million discretionary payment in February.

The table below is provided for the benefit of those participants wishing to better understand the computation of the WAP.

As noted previously, the results are much better than GRSA's budget estimates and the expectation is that future levels above the base will be more modest.

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney.

If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

Licensing time is coming

GRSA licences expire on 30th June. License renewal will be for a period of 2 years for Trainers, Breeders, Attendants and Owner/Attendants.

Please note that the cost will remain the same as previously, which was for a single year term. Owners' licenses will be valid a period of 3 years. Keep an eye out for licence renewals as they are being distributed now. Whilst GRSA aims to process applications in a timely manner, participants are encouraged to ensure all paperwork is correctly completed and lodged with payment as early as possible. Participants who have failed to pay outstanding fines and do not address the matter, may be unable to renew their licences until they become financial. If GRSA has contacted you in writing regarding monies owing, please contact Lauren O'Malley without delay.

Swab sample routine

Participants are advised that GRSA Stewards will be presenting a more robust sampling routine during the new season 2021/2022.

Stewards and Animal Welfare staff will increase the number of Out of Competition Samples being taken. As well as the regular urine samples, blood, saliva and hair sampling will also feature throughout the season.

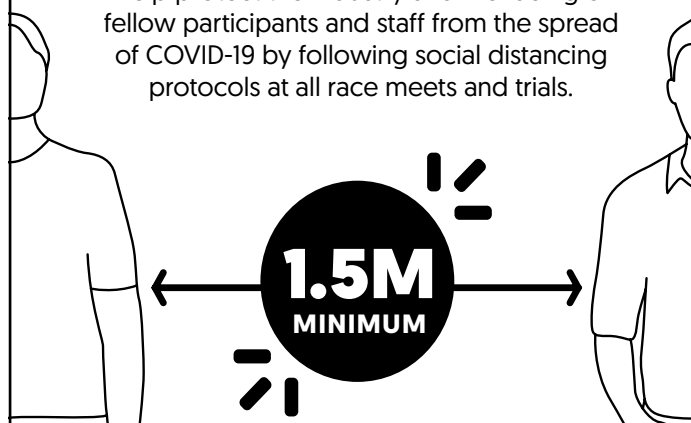

Kennel inspections

With annual licence renewals coming up, we are revising our yearly kennel inspections and following up on any that need review.

Now is a good time to review your kennel processes to make sure they are as good as they can be. Kennels need to be clean and tidy, with good supplies of water and warmth, with winter approaching. Make sure your medication records are up to date. If you have any additions or departures from your kennels, make sure you notify us on the correct forms and by the due date. Our animal welfare officers are not there to make your life miserable. They are there to make sure that the greyhounds are in the best state of health and happiness they can be, so we can pass that on to the industry and the community.

Bedding

As part of the review of the animal welfare policy, I am reviewing the way we define bedding.

In my time here, I have formed the view that a 'one size fits all' approach will not work for some greyhounds. The bottom line is that all greyhounds need a comfortable bed to sleep on and one that provides protection from cold, hard surfaces and they must be safe for the greyhound. The issue, then, is, what are acceptable materials and set ups that work? Like people, different beds suit different sleepers. I would be interested to hear your views on what a decent bed setup might work for greyhounds that, say, chew? If you would like to share your ideas, please send me an email or call. There are no right or wrong answers, but I would, ideally, like to get some opinions on it before I try to write a 'definition' of a bed.

Thinking of making changes to your kennels?

Some changes to your kennels may need Council approval.

Covid-19 update

You will know that the COVID-19 vaccination program is underway.

Some of you will be in phase groups where you are eligible to receive the 1st and 2nd vaccinations now, with two brands available. GRSA has no plans to make vaccinations mandatory for staff or participants at this time. The reason I say 'at this time' is that, as the last year has shown, predicting the future on the COVID-19 pandemic is almost impossible. However, please consider the vaccine and speak to your health professional for advice to make an informed decision. Also, do not forget the flu vaccination (you cannot COVID-19 and the flu vaccination at the same time). Although influenza A is off our radar for the second year in a row, it is still a potential danger to at least some members of our cohort.

As always, thank you all for doing your part at our facilities – checking-in and social distancing. If you have not already done so, consider using the mySA-GOV app to check in. From what I have been advised, I can assure you your data is safe.

Cross border travel

The police directions for cross-border travel have been re-written to now settle on levels of restrictions for cross border travel as a way to control border movement during an outbreak.

Level 6 is the highest and this a hard border closure. If you want to travel across the state border – for racing, work or pleasure – I encourage you to look at our webpage and read the Stewards' Notice on cross border travel. I have settled on this Notice as the roadmap for you to navigate the various websites to obtain the correct borders passes.

Projects Update

Angle Park project on track

The Angle Park track redevelopment project continues to proceed well, with contractors making good progress in the favourable weather conditions in recent weeks.

Visually the track is starting to take shape, the majority of the base has been placed and the pouring of the inner gutter has commenced which shows the final inside racing line.

Starting slabs for the four new racing distances have all been pegged out, with the obviously 342m and 530m distances creating the most interest. Those that have viewed the new starts onsite are excited to see racing out of the revised locations.

The rosebush/fence barrier separating the concrete tiers from the grassed area has been removed, with plans for greater access for patrons to the grassed area at the conclusion of the development.

The project remains on schedule to have Angle Park returning to racing in August, with the civil contractor in particular working with great urgency to meet GRSA's tight timeframes.

Away from the track, works have commenced on addressing drainage concerns in the kennel house washdown area, with sections of concrete removed from the floor in preparation for new drains and flooring.

In the judges tower, the bottom level of the building has been gutted and a new stairway to access that level is currently in fabrication and soon to be installed. The reconfiguration of the judges tower will result in the Sky Racing camera vision been positioned right on the finishing line, a welcome change.

The maintenance team is working hard to rejuvenate a number of different areas around the venue, so that when participants do return, they should notice vast difference to the presentation of the kennels area, off street frontage and the race tracks surrounds.

Hopefully by the next edition of Kennel Capers we can provide some greater clarity about the likely return to trialling and racing.

The wet weather in the morning had fortunately cleared by race 1 giving punters the opportunity to enjoy the highlight of the South Eastern racing calendar.

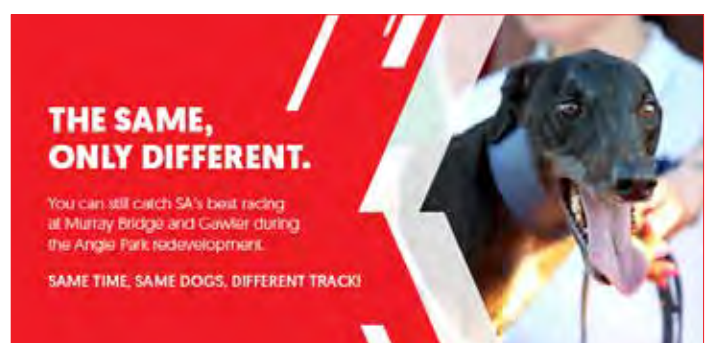

It was also great to see Allinga Road recording a new first split record over the 455m distance on April 30th in 7.81 during race 7 of the evening.

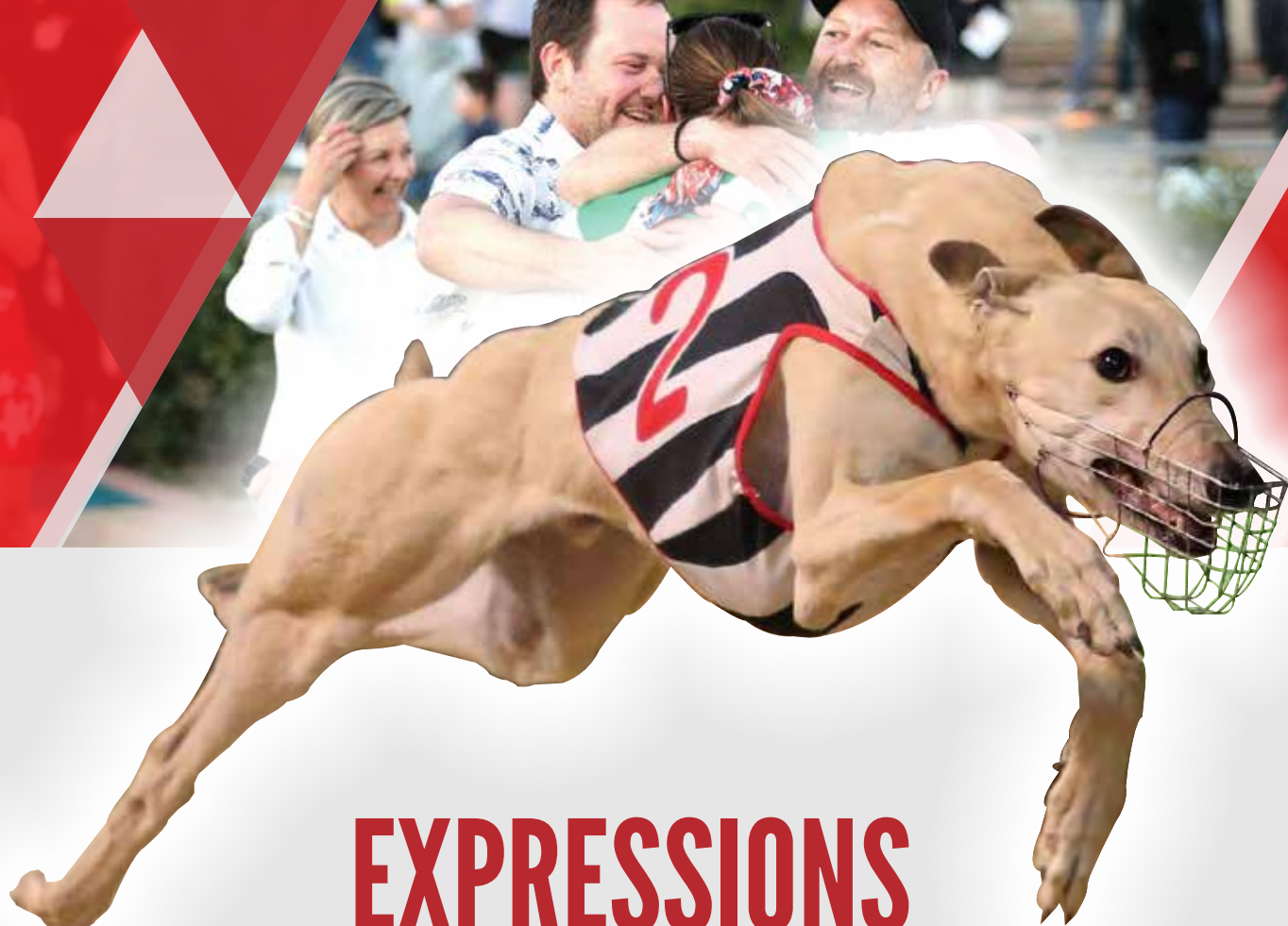


Troy Murray with Agent Hamish after his track record win over the 530m distance at Murray Bridge.

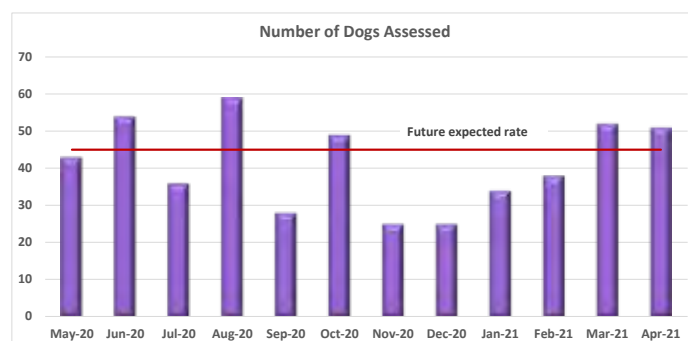
If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

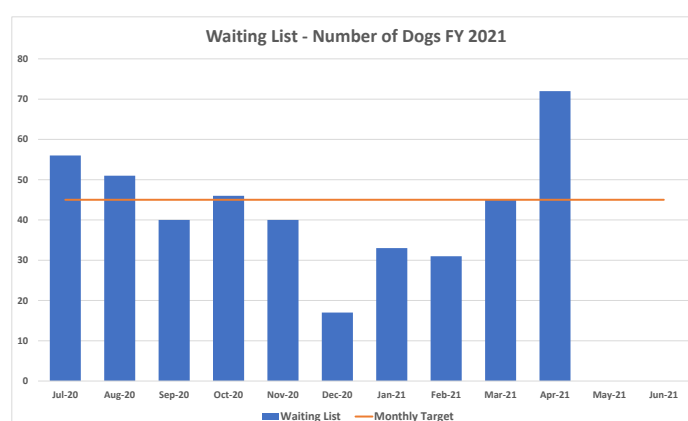
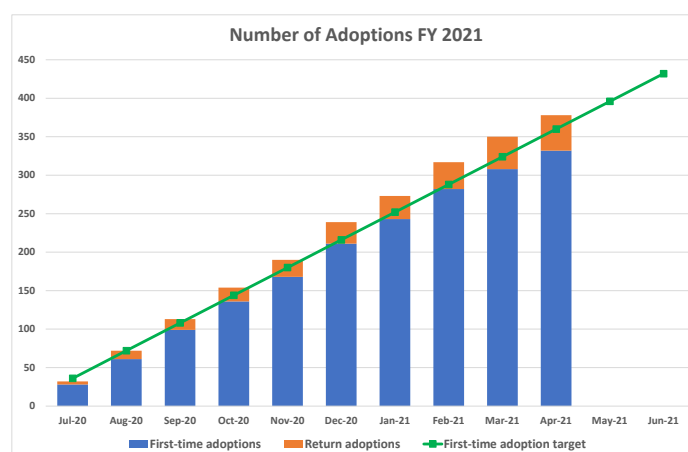
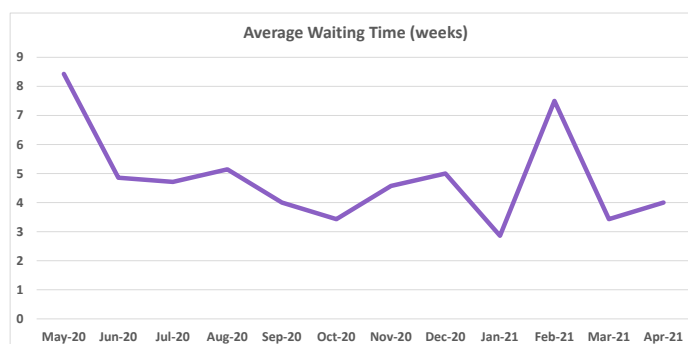
Latest updates from GAP

There was a great crowd in attendance on Sunday 9th May to witness some competitive racing. Two Heats of the Gawler Anniversary Cup were run, with the winners, Air Marshall and Zipping Sultan, plus the placegetters competing in the \$10,700 Final to be decided on Sunday 16th May

Local greyhound syndicate experiences that winning feeling

Greyhound racing has lots of thrills and excitement, especially if you own a share in your own racing dog. People from all walks of life participate in greyhound racing with syndication an easy and affordable way to get started.

And that's the way it was at Tara Raceway yesterday when Cawbourne Shiny, a July 2019 son of Ritza Lenny and Cawbourne Clover opened his winning account in the Williams Crane Hire Maiden Stake [305 metres] for the nine-members of the Rise N Shine Syndicate.

Satisfactory and Qualifying trials at Murray Bridge for both tracks are now on Friday mornings once a week – effective immediately. Nominations close 12.30pm Thursday (for online nominations 11.59pm Tuesday) Qualifying for the following Friday.

Satisfactory and Qualifying trials at Murray Bridge conducted each month on a Tuesday night (see Kennel Capers for date). Nominations close 12.30pm Tuesday qualifying for the following Monday.

Trainers are advised that Satisfactory Trials on these days **ONLY** will be approved.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kennelling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Tuesday, Wednesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these days fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
4. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
5. Trials will be 455m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
6. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
7. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
8. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
9. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races there will be NO trials.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.
