# Mallee Magic wins historic Anniversary Cup

#### ANGLE PARK

On Friday April 29 our industry celebrated 50 years of racing at Angle Park with a very special race meeting featuring the prestigious SA Distance Championship and the 50th Anniversary Cup Final worth \$50,000 to the winning connections.

With inclement weather for the start of our meeting there was a genuine reason for the crowds not to flock in however that was far from the case as there was a line up before the roller door opened and old and young persons alike poured in to celebrate this special night. It wasn't the 10,000 people that were oncourse for out first meeting on 20th April 1972 however early indications are that the numbers surpassed our Group 1 Adelaide Cup meeting which is held every October.

The 50th Anniversary celebrations was a fun night for the whole family who took full advantage of the updated facilities. There were plenty of activities for the kids including face painters, Greyhound As Pets were oncourse providing the patrons an opportunity to get up close and personal with our four legged retired athletes, food trucks did a roaring trade along with live music in the trackside marque.

To celebrate this special milestone of racing at Angle Park a book was released to recognise the past 50 years authored by Ray Fewings called "Chasing A Dream" which was extremely well received by all concerned. Also on the night there was recognition for super star chaser Brett Lee which helped enhance Angle Park's status with his 28.88 track record in the 2001 Group 1 Adelaide Cup with a life size sculpture unveiled.

The 50th Anniversary Cup Final which saw the best sprinters assembled to race for the \$50k first prize and a significant part of the Angle Park history.

The high quality field was one of the most open Cups in history with Interstate raider Auspicious Queen for Paul Abela, Eastar Match Race winner Fantastic Victor for Ossie Chegia and SA Sprint Champion Stout Monelli all sent out the favourites with the start all important. As the boxes flew open, surprise heat winner Threaten again began brilliantly for trainer Ben Rawlings to lead to the winning post with Mallee Magic for Tony Rasmussen also beginning well to challenge followed by Auspicious Queen and Stout Monelli, while the remaining greyhounds jostled for position.

Into the back straight and Threaten was out full of running with Auspicious Queen closing in along the rails and Mallee Magic coming into the race back in third. Howling Hoss for Shelley Trengove, Stout Monelli and Fantastic Victor tried to make ground from off the track. Off the back straight and Threaten was still in the lead, however, looming large on his outside was Mallee Magic while Auspicious Queen persisted for clear running as they broke away from their rivals. On the bend prior to turning for home the SA Derby Winner Mallee Magic raced past Threaten to hit the lead and looked all over a winner as he raced into the front straight. Clearing out from his rivals he dominated the later part of the race to go on and win by 2.50 lengths from Auspicious Queen who ran into a clear second from a gallant Threaten who held on well for third just ahead of Stout Monelli. Mallee Magic ran a sizzling 30.32 for the 530m journey and showed his dominance at the highest level to take the win on an historic night.









# Weblec Star claims memorable SA Distance Championship

The other feature Final on the 50th Anniversary night at Angle Park on April 29 was the SA Distance Championship which was won by Weblec Star for trainer Neville Loechel.

In the SA Distance Championship Final, Heat winners Victa Haydn for Tony Rasmussen and Weblec Star for Neville Loechel were initially equal favourites with former track record holder Lashes Monelli for Tim Aloisi in pre race markets, however, as we neared starting time there was a weight of support for both Lashes Monelli and Victa Haydn seeing them both backed into equal favouritism for the staying feature.

As the start was affected Victa Haydn bounced out really well from his inside draw and pushed hard to withstand the early challenge from New Year Tears for Clint Trengove and Sebon Panther for Tony Nobes to drive up and lead. Weblec Star also had a good start and raced up four wide off the back straight on the first occasion while Lashes Monelli landed in a good spot midfield, however, copped a check seeing her lose a number of lengths in the early part of the race. Into the front straight and Victa Haydn on the rails, Sebon Panther in the middle and Webec Star sweeping up out wide had opened up a decent break on their rivals due to a shuffling up of runners in the second half of the field. Out of the front straight and Victa Haydn used his exceptional sprinting speed to lead clearly form Weblec Star who was battling out second with Sebon Panther and then a gap to New Year Tears and Mr. Ibrox for Shelley Trengove. There was another gap to Lashes Monelli who found herself too far back to make an impact after her early trouble. As the quality field of stayers raced down the back straight Victa Haydn was out full of running by a number of lengths with Weblec Star moving to a clear second and giving strong chase. Sebon Panther was holding onto third as Mr. Ibrox closed in. Turning for home and it looked a race in two with Victa Haydn in control, however, Weblec Star lifted herself for one final dive at the line. To the roars of the crowd Weblec Star powered home over the top of Victa Haydn to win by a head in a slick 42.90 over the 730m journey as they cleared out from their rivals with over 7 lengths back to Sebon Panther who clung on for a determined third just ahead of Mr. Ibrox and New Year Tears.

Weblec Star is by Mepunga Balzer out of Weblec Belle and is owned by the Weblang Syndicate managed by Angela Langton.

#### **Classic and Breeders Futurity payments**

## Owners of SA Bred greyhounds are reminded that the next batch of Futurity payments are due on Friday, 17th June 2022.

The payments due are:

**Classic 2022** – Final Payment (Pups born July 20 to December 20) This payment is for greyhounds for which the Second Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound. Breeders 2023 - Second Payment (Pups born January 21 to June 21)

This payment is for greyhounds for which the First Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

Classic 2023 – First Payment (Pups born July 21 to December 21)

This First Payment is due for Classic 2023. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. The First Payment is \$27.50 per pup or a "one-off" Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

To assist all owners of Futurity eligible pups, reminders will be sent out over the coming days. It is perhaps a good idea to make the payment as soon as you can, so it does not slip your mind and the closing date passes. If you have sold a pup/s we would ask if you can forward on the information to the new owner. If you have not received a reminder by the end of this month and you think you should have, contact Caralyn Fielden as soon as possible.

#### Low grade feature series at Angle Park

The next Low Grade Feature Series at Angle Park will be an SA Owned Grade 6 series over the 530m with \$3,260 Heats on Thursday, 16th June with the \$5,150 Final on Thursday, 23rd June.

• Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 20th June at 9.00am.

### Saturday to Thursday night finals at Angle Park

GRSA looked at the opportunity to increase the number of races conducted on a Thursday night at Angle Park which may positively assist the field sizes by not having to split as many races. Without affecting the greyhounds which are nominated regularly for Thursday night we are looking at drawing from a different pool of greyhounds.

Once a fortnight we will run the morning Saturday meeting at Angle Park where we would run between one to four 530m events on the 10 race card. These greyhounds are Time Graded greyhounds [1-4 wins and 5 + wins] and would normally not compete on a Thursday night. We have decided to program Heats on the Saturday for these greyhounds [maximum 2 Heats] into a Final on the Thursday night [5 days later]. The Heats would be at the normal Time Graded prizemoney, however, the Final on the Thursday will be budgeted Grade 6 or Grade 5 money. The Heats and Finals will be 6 dog fields and non penalty. The Final will be conducted as Race 1 on the Thursday night.

The next of these will be for Saturday, 28th May for 5 + wins with the Final on Thursday, 2nd June.

# Cup win highlights a big month for Mallee Magic

Greyhound of the Month for April was Mallee Magic for trainer Tony Rasmussen who claimed enough votes for the monthly award due to his brilliant month of racing, highlighted by victory in the 50th Anniversary Cup Final at Angle Park. He just edged out SA Distance Champion Weblec Star, Group 3 Mt Gambier Cup winner Departure Gate and Eastar Match Race winner Fantastic Victor in a great month of highlights for SA greyhounds.

Mallee Magic returned to the race track in early April after a 6 week break and returned in fine form running 30.65 over the 530m at Angle Park on a Monday night. He then stepped up to the 595m in a heat of the Easter Cup dominating his Heat with a strong win in 34.25 and started one of the favourites for the Final. Without much luck he ran 5th and then dropped back to the 530m to challenge the best sprinters in the state for the Heats of the 50th Anniversary Cup. Mallee Magic was brilliant in winning his Heat running a sizzling 30.22 and winning by over 4 lengths in a high quality field. With \$50,000 on offer for the winner Mallee Magic quickly raced up on the pace to



challenge for the prize, Mallee Magic proved too strong over the concluding stages to go on and win in 30.32. Mallee Magic had five starts for the month with four wins returning to his very best form which did see him claim the SA Derby back in September last year. At the end of the month Mallee Magic's record stood at 28 starts for 14 wins and 5 placings and earnings around \$117,000.

# Kinrock Star shines bright in Run on the Month

#### Ihe Run of the Month for April was the Troy Murray trained Kinrock Star who produced one of the most amazing finishing bursts seen at Angle Park in recent memory in a Heat of the 50th Anniversary Cup over the 530m journey

After the son of Kinloch Brae and Red Rocks walked out of the boxes and was 4 lengths behind the second last greyhound at the winning post on the first occasion, his winning chances looked gone. However, Kinrock Star railed nicely around the bend and started to make ground quickly into the back straight. He was still a fair way off the lead and his chances of winning looked to be gone when recent SA Match Race champion, Fantastic Victor, ran to the front and sailed away from his rivals. Kinrock Star was still making good ground off the back straight as he weaved through the traffic to come to the outside. Turning for home he was wide but charging into second place but still 2 lengths of the flying Fantastic Victor. Kinrock Star showed an amazing burst of speed to close off the race in fine style and claim victory by an ever increasing half a length in a brilliant 30.39. His splits of 5.56, 17.86 and a blistering run



home of 12.53 showed how fast he came home, but also how slow out the blocks he was. Many good judges aligned this performance to that of 2019 Group 1 Adelaide Cup winner Hooked On Scotch who came off a hot speed to win when all looked lost. Who knows where Kinrock Star will get to in the next 6 months.

### Mount Gambier satisfactory and normal trials – timing for bookings

Trainers are reminded of their requirements when booking Satisfactory Trials and normal trials at Mount Gambier. Mount Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays which need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

For normal trial bookings they need to be made by 4pm the day before for both Wednesday and Saturday. No trial bookings will be accepted after this time, effective immediately.

GRSA is working with the Club in regard to an online trial booker system which would help the management of these normal trials.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.

## 2022 Group 3 Howard Ashton

The major race for Breeders 2022 is the Group 3 Howard Ashton. Trainers are reminded that the \$3,700 heats will be run on Thursday, 12th May.

These will be followed by the \$4,500 semi-finals on May 19th and the \$37,500 final on May 26th.

The race is for greyhounds that are eligible for Breeders 2022. Greyhounds didn't have to have compete in the preludes to run in the Group 3 Howard Ashton.

The GCA National Championships are just around the corner. The National Finals this year will be held at Wentworth Park in NSW and are to be conducted on Saturday, 29th August.

Both the National Sprint and National Distance Finals will carry prizemoney of \$75,000 to the winner.

The State series' for SA will be held at Angle Park on Thursday, 4th August for the Sprint Heats over 530m with the State Final of the Sprint and one-off Final over 730m of the Distance on the 11th August. In an effort to support this series ALL States will be conducting their Finals on the same night to be run within a two hour period.

• Nominations will close at the normal time with GRSA which will be at 9am on Monday, 1st August

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Wednesday, 18th May 2022. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

## National Straight Track Championships also in NSW

The National Straight Track Championship this year will be held at Richmond on Saturday morning, 29th August –with the winner receiving \$25,000 so all the National Finals will be held on the same day.

This year SA will have two SA dogs represent the State in the series with QLD, NSW, VIC and SA challenging for the title.

So the Straight Track series aligns with the circle and the other States, our Heats will be held at Murray Bridge on Tuesday, 2nd August with our Final on Tuesday, 9th August. Prizemoney for the SA Straight track Final will be elevated to \$10,000 to the winner and align with the other three States.

It is important that trainers are aware that these series' for the circle and straight track are run at the same time so please be mindful of this when nominating and the qualifying criteria.

• Nominations close with GRSA at 9am on Thursday, 28th July

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Saturday, 14th May 2022. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

### Trial days for Gawler and Murray Bridge

After consultation in the most recent ICG meeting GRSA have made some changes to the trialling days at both Gawler and Murray Bridge to make it easier for participants. Gawler will continue to trial on the Monday morning, however, will now also trial every Thursday morning. There will be no rotation due to racing.

Murray Bridge will trial on Monday morning, however, will not trial on Thursday morning for the Straight Track. These will now be moved to the Wednesday night with the One Turn trial session. During non daylight saving Straight track trials will start at 4.30pm with the One Turn at 5.30pm. During Daylight saving the Straight track will start at 5.30pm with the One Turn 6.30pm.

This is effective immediately and any changes to this will be advised to industry via text message and social media.

Trainers, whom have a greyhound that is required to complete a Satisfactory Trial, are required to contact the offices of GRSA and provide the relevant details. By contacting the office, you will be advised of any further requirements that are needed for the Satisfactory Trial.

# Qualifying and satisfactory trials for Murray Bridge

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night at approximately 5.15pm (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials).

Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

# Satisfactory and qualifying trial times for Angle Park

After sufficient racing has been completed on the redeveloped Angle Park track, times have now been allocated for the new distances for Satisfactory trails and Qualifying trials. Effective immediately.

# Comments on nominations marked "only"

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

### Winning grade 6 races in order

## GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

# Re-grading for all tracks and distances

## Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

# Breeders Support Program – important update from July 1

At the most recent ICG meeting our local breeding numbers were discussed. After considering how many litters are currently being bred, the panel decided to make an alteration to how many Breeder Rebates will be available each financial year.

For any Breeder Rebate application lodged (at Litter Registration time) from July 1 2022 to June 30 2023, GRSA will only rebate two Litters fully and if there is a third litter, this will be at a half price rebate. If a Breeder has a fourth litter there will be no claim available. It will be up to the Breeder to determine which 2½ Litters they would like the Breeders Support Claim for in the 12 month period. Please contact Racing Manager, Shaun Mathieson at GRSA for further information.

Below are the current Breeders Support Conditions -

Details regarding the Breeders Support Program for litters registered in SA. It is crucial that GRSA receives receipts for actual and verifiable expenses relating to litters whelped for items below or else no support payment can be provided: Claims will be a Maximum of \$2,000 with FSI and Pup payment in addition.

The Local Rules 2022 have been in force from 31 January. The local rules do not have a comparison table, but have the old rules listed next to the rule number and rule short title. For example – "L30 [LR114]" means the new local rule is L130, but the old Local Regulatory Rule was LR114. Either rule number is valid and, until it comes time to reprint our forms, we will continue to use forms with the old numbers to lessen the impact on the environment.

# Adobe PDF electronic signature trial

We will soon be trialling forms that can be signed electronically. This will, we hope, make lodging forms easier than printing, signing and lodging or scanning/emailing.

For the trial, if you receive an email that is from Adobe, please do not direct it to the bin. It could be your new form. Simply follow the instructions and send back. The system will be mobile device friendly.

# **GRSA events – COVID-19**

# Litters and vaccinations

## Please note local rule 38 (old LR30) will be amended shortly to reflect current vaccination protocols.

The rule will read -

38 (LR30) Litters to be registered

[1] Unless the Authority in special circumstances otherwise decides, no greyhound whelped in South Australia shall be eligible to be registered for any purpose under these Rules unless the litter in which it was produced was registered with the Authority.

(2) Any notice of whelping must include all greyhounds whelped (alive or deceased).

[3] The application for the registration of a litter shall be-

(a) lodged with the Authority within four (4) months of the whelping date;

(b) accompanied by a certificate of C3 vaccination, issued by a veterinary Surgeon that indicates that such vaccinations were performed on each greyhound in the litter between the age of six [6] and eight [8] weeks;

(c) accompanied by a certificate of C5 vaccination, issued by a veterinary Surgeon that indicates that such vaccinations were performed on each greyhound in the litter between the age of ten (10) and sixteen (16) weeks; and,

(d) in the approved form.

Please see your friendly greyhound vet for expert advice on vaccinations.

## **Dress Code**

Stewards remind participants to comply with the GRSA Dress Code printed below. All elements of the code must be adhered to, but your attention is directed to the highlighted text below:

Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) is committed to upholding the Rules of greyhound racing.

GRSA has a dress code policy for all persons parading greyhounds. The dress code is to be complied with at all GRSA TAB race meetings.

Dress Code is as follows:

- Black pants, black dress jeans or black dress chinos.
- Black enclosed shoes (all black).
- Black or navy jumper
- Collared white shirt
- White polo shirt
- GRSA polo shirt
- GRSA black shorts black socks and shoes must be worn with shorts
- Approved head wear GRSA baseball caps or GRSA beanie.

Trousers, etc., must not be faded or torn and must have regular cuffs (no elastic cuffs).

No cargo pants, tracksuit pants or leggings permitted.

Jumpers must be plain and not contain branding, stripes or contrasting colours.

Any person failing to comply with the dress code will not be permitted to parade greyhounds, and may be guilty of an offence in accordance with GAR 86 (z) which reads:

#### **R86 Offences**

A person (including an official) shall be guilty of an offence if the person-

 (z) being an owner, trainer or registered person in charge of a greyhound fails to comply with the dress standards of a Controlling Body or club;

HANDLERS ARE TO REPORT UNCLEAN PARADE VESTS WHICH WILL BE TAKEN OUT OF CIRCULATION IMMEDIATELY UNTIL CLEANED.

GRSA reserves the right to alter this policy at any time.

#### GREYHOUND RACING SOUTH AUSTRALIA GRADING REVIEW PANEL MEETING

# Held at the offices of GRSA at 55 Cardigan St, Angle Park onFriday 8th April, 2022

Meeting commenced at 10.38am. Shaun Mathieson, Racing Manager, thanked those attending in person and via Zoom.

#### 1. Minutes From Previous Meeting

The panel approved the minutes from the previous GRP meeting held on 16/08/21.

#### 2. Business Arising

The Racing Manager provided an update to the panel on those items introduced from the last meeting. The panel discussed a number of those items in detail.

Grade 6 Non SA Bred Maximum Of 12 Lifetime Wins – This remains a standing item on the Agenda. From the last meeting the RM provided the panel some statistical information regarding the movement of Grade 6's to Grade 5's to see if greyhounds are not moving quickly enough through the classes to assist with higher grades. The RM advised greyhounds have a grade at each track and distance however establishing if they are a grade 6 or grade 5 is quite hard as at one track they are a grade 6 and then another track over another distance a grade 5.

The RM provided the panel with a table of greyhounds over the last 3 months to establish those greyhounds graded into events that were Maiden, Grade 6, Grade 5 and Open.

The RM advised the pools of greyhounds are pretty consistent however changing total wins or interstate grade 6 wins doesn't necessarily mean the percentages will change above. The panel believed there needed to be more in depth detail regarding the pool of Grade 6

greyhounds to aid any decision. The panel discussed restricting the lifetime wins and also discussed a change to interstate greyhounds however still felt that while Grade 6 rules could be varied at this time there was no need to change as there were plenty of positives under the current conditions but will continue to review. The RM suggested that some participants still did not understand the Grade 6 policy and advised one of the items that continue to be miss understood is about winning in order at a specific venue. The policy was listed below.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

The RM advised that we have not been able to manage a policy book as yet and have not had some kennel house meetings about Grading. Circumstances have not allowed for this to occur however it is still on the RM's agenda later this year.

The RM advised that he is trying to manage the programming so that there is a meeting for Prov 2 normal graded at Angel Park and not just Time Graded however the opportunity hasn't presented itself recently.

**Mixing Of Races** –In recent times we have noticed that Victoria have moved away from Aged Prizemoney for grading. The panel were advised that the RM will still look at ways to mix our races however the panel were comfortable that race wins is the main format of mixing.

**Performance Trials** – The panel discussed the possibility of performance trials in SA for unraced greyhounds. The RM advised that GRSA are currently investigating the ISO Lynx cameras and set up which could assist with this. He also advised there would need to be extensive resourcing at every trial session for these to occur. Some members were strongly for this to occur to provide information on these first starters. Some panel members were against this. If we did trial they could be half field trials to assist. The RM was requested by the panel to check with the other States and see how they manage performance trials.

Actions: The RM to liaise with other states regarding Performance Trials and how they are managed. How will Iso-Lynx assist this.

The RM advised that two items that we consistently advertise in our publications are comments on nominations and re-grading opportunities however we continue to get some queries. The panel felt to continue to advertise items below -

#### COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED "ONLY"

The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

#### **RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES**

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful

nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

#### 3. Agenda Items

#### ISOLYNX – Digital Transformation and Broadcast Enhancement (IsoLynx - greyhound tracking data)

The RM advised that this item was presented to the Industry Consultative Group last month for their reference, which could also provide data to assist grading with ratings etc.

He advised in the next few months, GRSA will install infrastructure at all SA tracks as part of the digital transformation and broadcast enhancement project (IsoLynx real-time location system). He advised that the IsoLynx system records greyhounds around the track, using a small tags in race rugs to capture live in-race data including speed, acceleration and distance travelled. This technology is already in place in Victoria and NSW, with speed data appearing on the Sky Racing broadcast at some tracks. In addition to the substantial data that the system provides, robotic cameras will provide a unique broadcast for each race and even trials could be broadcast. The RM advised that this technology would open a world of possibilities from an analysis perspective for our industry. The panel were supportive of this implementation which could cost around \$1million for all 4 tracks. The RM advised that SA could be a leader in this space and it would be imperative that whatever data is available that it is the same for each state for uniformity.

#### ANGLE PARK – Thursday night extra race

The RM advised that GRSA recently looked at the opportunity to increase the number of races conducted on a Thursday night at Angle Park. Without affecting the greyhounds which are nominated regularly for Thursday night we looked at drawing from a different pool of greyhounds. He advised that we have now implemented the Saturday morning to Thursday night heats to finals. Once a fortnight we run Time Graded heats [1-4 wins or 5 + wins] over 530m on the Saturday (maximum 2 heats] into a final on the Thursday night [5 days later].

The heats are normal Time Graded prizemoney however the final on the Thursday is budgeted Grade 6 or Grade 5 City A prizemoney. The heats and finals will be 6 dog fields and Non Penalty. The Final will be conducted as Race 1 on the Thursday night. The RM asked for suggestions from the panel for other options to increase Thursday nights program.

Members suggested Gawler or Murray Bridge Heats to an Angle Park final or restricted wins Grade 5 heats. The RM appreciated the feedback and will look to see how the programming of these events could fit into the monthly calendar.

#### GRADE 7 FOR SA -

The RM advised that it has been suggested by some members of industry that we should introduce a Grade 7 grade, much like Victoria where the Grade 7 comes after Maiden and before Grade 6 which would be more for 1 to 2 win greyhounds. The panel believed that at this stage it wouldn't be wise to introduce another grade in-between Maiden and Grade 6 when there are some concerns about the length of time it takes for the progression of greyhounds through the grades.

#### MIDDLE DISTANCE NOMINATIONS AND FIELDS

The RM advised that GRSA has a policy in support of Middle Distance races and Staying events where we will run with 5 nominations for the Middle Distance and 4 nominations for the Staying Event. He advised that we will support these races however if some nomination and racing behaviour was questioned then we may consider reviewing. He provided two examples for feedback.

a) When there are 5 greyhounds over 595m and all trained by the same trainer and with all other nominations at the meeting accommodated should this be the 12th race. The panel advised they could be all different owners and we need to be running as many races as possible. They felt it was up to the stewards and integrity if there were concerns about this race.

b) What would happen when a greyhound accepts for a 730m event that had only run over 400m recently. The panel felt there should be a flag to the grader if possible so he is aware as grading is now about numbers in accessing getting a start. They felt the grader could query this however it was still up to the trainer to ensure they are nominating genuinely. If this was not the case then they were comfortable that the stewards would deal with the trainer.

Actions: The RM to provide this feedback to the integrity department and stewards along with following this guideline with grading.

#### TIME RATING FOR MASTERS AT ANGLE PARK AND 305M AT MT GAMBIER

The RM advised since Angle Park has been redeveloped with the new distances of 342m, 530, 595m and 730m we have not allocated any times for Masters Events. There has been sufficient racing at the venue for a Time Standard to be applied. The below Time ratings for Masters events was discussed and approved for implementation at a date advised to industry. Time Band [5] is –

342m - 19.72 - 19.81 (recommended 19.75) 530m - 30.66 - 30.80 (recommended 30.80) 595m - Unlikely 730m - Unlikely

Actions: The RM to advise Masters time band as 19.75 for 342m and 30.80 for 530m for Angle Park programming with a date to be announced to industry for implementation.

#### Time Rating for Mt Gambier 305m for Masters-

The RM advised previously we have released the Masters conditions for the 277m however with the 305m distance now available this condition should be changed to accommodate the 305m along with a new Time Standard. The panel agreed to the same conditions and changed the time standard to 17.75. They advised the RM to release and set an implementation date. The new conditions are -

305m Masters Policy for Mt Gambier – With Mt Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events however factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week. The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.

Actions: The RM to advise Masters time band as 17.75 for 305m for Mt Gambier programming with a date to be announced to industry for implementation.

#### **BOOKING SATISFACTORY TRIALS ONLINE**

The RM advised recently GRSA released advice to industry regarding nominating online for Satisfactory Trials which has been causing some confusion in regard to process. Then panel were comfortable with this released to industry.

#### NOMINATIONS FOR SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Recently we have had several trainers nominating online using the Qualifying Trial meeting for Satisfactory Trials. The online Qualifying Trial meetings are for trainers to nominate their greyhound which they wish to improve on the Order of Choice for the upcoming meeting only. Trainers, whom have a greyhound that is required to complete a Satisfactory Trial, are required to contact the offices of GRSA and provide the relevant details. By contacting the office, you will be advised of any further requirements that are needed for the Satisfactory Trial. [Contact the Club for Mt Gambier]

#### TIME GRADING -

The panel had a general discussion regarding Time Grading and also reviewed a submission from Kurt Donsberg and a couple of general queries for the Panel to consider.

General Queries -

• Can a last start winner at Angle Park City A be considered last for Time Grading? Whilst the panel had some reservations about a last start City A Angle Park winner being nominated they did feel that the ratings could be compromised if they agreed to pull greyhounds out of sequence. They were comfortable that if their rating warranted a start in a race then they should be considered.

• Time Rating First Starters – rating of 10 is this acceptable or should this be varied? When Time Ratings were introduced 10 was considered reasonable however based on the ratings of Maidens over a long period of time the panel felt this should be varied and reduced to 8 as a starting point.

#### Actions:

The RM to change Maidens in Time Rating from 10 to 8 in Ozchase. This to be advised to industry once the change has been made.

Submission from Kurt Donsberg and the RM responses at the time-

• Time graded criteria - 1) consensus is there should be a lower limit. Too many dogs racing that aren't genuine time

graded. It would seem these are 530m dogs which we only have 1 event so if nominated they could get in. We do have the rule that if their rating is slower than half the slowest dog they can get in. If we ran all short course Time Grading then would not be an issue due to numbers.

The panel understood and appreciated Kurts point but believed no change was necessary.

• -2) genuine TG dogs missing out via reserves. If races were treated as finals only two dogs per category would miss a run, whereas currently it can be up to 8. Reserves are always an issue. We want reserves but don't want to compromise the ratings. Cascading reserves have been considered but every event would have to be drawn as a final which creates some issues. You would get significant change in the events for 1 scratching. If they are a reserve for a full Time Graded meeting and they miss out they will not be reserve next Full Time Graded meeting so long as they nominate and they are in the group to get a start. [Mt Gambier does sit separately from this pool]

Again the panel understood and appreciated Kurts point about reserves but at this time the way it is being graded is the best outcome for then industry.

#### NO RACE AT COURSING -

The RM advised that last year there was a situation at a Coursing meeting where there was a lure breakdown for the final round of an event. At the time it was decided to not run the event and it was advised both greyhounds were the winners. With this being the case the RM advised that both greyhounds took a penalty and both split the prizemoney. The panel considered this and felt that Coursing should be considered differently as there are a couple of rounds of racing. They believed the prizemoney should be split in this case however neither greyhound should take a penalty due to the no race aspect. They believed the grades should be varied from last year and have this policy going forward. The RM to advise industry.

Actions: The RM to ensure that when a lure breakdown occurs resulting in a No Race at Coursing that no grades are applied and the prizemoney split.

#### 4. Submissions

The panel discussed submissions from Lachlan Mill -

• It would be great to get some videos on the Website or Facebook regarding the process of grading and the reasons why we might be delayed in releasing the fields. The RM advised it would be his intention to implement some clips on social media to assist participants in understanding grading and the grading process better.

• Could GRSA please start scheduling as many 530m races at APK as possible. Currently 342m racing is placed outside of the quaddie in the g-six slot, and the 530m racing inside the quaddie. This needs to be swapped the other way round. 1. It will mean more 530m races = more turnover and a better look for our sport, 2. It rewards people for running their dogs over the 530m trip as it is easier to win races with less dogs.

The RM advised the mix between G Six and the 8 dog Quaddie is dependent upon how many nominations for each distance and grade. The intent is always to get as many races as possible and give as many greyhounds a start as possible when looking at the race programming. We will run heats with one of the those races in the quaddie with the others outside which means we can run 8 dog fields and have an 8 dog final. On occasions the RM advised we will place some feature events outside the quaddie to free up a few more 8 dog fields depending on nominations. He advised GRSA supports 6 dog racing and generally Maidens and the lower grades will be 8 dogs however this can vary.

#### Late Items –

Some panel members brought up about split kennelling and the possibility of 13 races. The RM advised at this time split kennelling was not an option due to managing the time frames and trainers and that 12 races are our maximum capacity at any venue.

Some members requested that Maidens for Feature races (ie Brian Johnstone and Howard Ashton) need to do a qualifying trial before being eligible for these series. The RM advised that at this time there is no requirement for trialling however with the discussion around Performance Trials this may be added to that topic for the next agenda. The panel were comfortable with that.

### **Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners**

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP.
   Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

#### Participants should note that:

- WAP is not payable for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000];
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

We hope that everyone had an enjoyable night. Here is to the next 50 years!










# **National Adoption Day**

# 50 years on and trainer is still going strong

#### MOUNT GAMBIER

Warrnambool trainer Colin Kelly was quick to recall his first winner.

"It was back in 1969 at Warrnambool's old Botanic Park track with a dog called Royal Nilo who I had picked up from legendary local greyhound man Stan Lake," he said.

Kelly, accompanied by wife Lyn – a Warrnambool Greyhound Racing Club committee member – was reminiscing at Tara Raceway on Sunday, 15th May after kennel newcomer Felonious Gru opened his winning account in the Bartholomew Pick 6 Maiden Stake (305 metres).

And while in a reminiscing mood, he also didn't have any trouble recalling his best greyhound – and why would he? The dog in question was Lady Lilly who won the 1983 Warrnambool Cup and Melbourne Cup as well as the 1984 Ballarat Cup. By Tempix out of Lady Grotto, Lady Lilly was trained by Kelly, a Warrnambool postman at the time, for Gary Hughson and his sister Maree.

As far as the Melbourne Cup was concerned, Lady Lilly looked likely to miss out on advancing to the next round after finishing fourth in her Heat.

"She moved into a Semi-Final when another runner was withdrawn. And she made the most of the opportunity when recording the fastest time of the four Semi-Finals," Kelly said.

Lady Lilly then defeated Swift Glade and Winifred Bale in the Final of the \$35,000 to the winner event at Sandown Park.

Kelly took over the training of Felonious Gru several weeks ago after the son of SH Avatar and Shades Of Lippy had copped a couple of failing to pursue convictions.

"I was hoping the finish-on-lure might help to turn him around," he said. "So when he trialled here recently over 400 metres in 23.17 seconds I thought he would be worth trying in a race at Tara Raceway."

Raced by the Espresso Racing Syndicate, the red fawn dog gained a run as a reserve. He also lined up in a blinkered muzzle, Kelly leaving no stone unturned in a bid to avoid any further convictions.

And Felonious Gru never put a foot wrong, railing through on Cadillac Bullet approaching the home turn before running away to a 2½ length win in 18.00 seconds.

# GAP kennelling fee payment process change

Please note that as of 1st August 2021 the GAP kennelling payment process has changed for a trial period of three months.

The changes are as follows:

Instead of making a weekly payment of \$33 per dog, the new kennelling fee will be a flat amount of \$50 per dog, irrespective of the time period the greyhound will spend at the GAP kennels.

Participants who would like their greyhounds placed in the GAP kennels will be requested to pay the \$50 at the time when the placement form is filled in and the \$60 placement fee is paid.

This means that for greyhounds that are to be kennelled with GAP an upfront payment of \$110 will be requested. After that, participants will not need to make any additional payments for their dogs in the GAP kennels. Noting that prior to foster care dogs spend an average of 4 weeks in kennels, this change is expected to generate a saving of \$82 per dog for participants.






## As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.



#### QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night at approximately 5.15pm (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

# **ANGLE PARK**

#### SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

#### BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

#### POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

#### **Policy Background**

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

#### **Race Meeting Trial Policy**

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4)

greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start

2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track

3. Satisfactory trials

#### Procedure/criteria

- 1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
- 2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
- 3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
   Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
- 10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race

meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

#### Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

#### MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.


