# Star-Studded Night At Angle Park

## ■ ANGLE PARK

**The best greyhounds in the State gathered at Angle Park on Thursday, April 27th, with the sprinters chasing the \$10,000 first prize for the SA Anniversary Cup Final and the stayers doing the same for the SA Distance Championship Final.**

**In one of the most competitive SA Distance Championship Finals in recent years the Ashlee Griffiths trained Zipping Patch was strongly supported into favouritism and produced a powerful performance to come from midfield with a dazzling finish to claim victory.**

In the charge to the first turn Bedrock Will for Clint Trengove showed great pace to lead clearly from box 8 with Springvale Rex for Gavin Harris sliding across from box 6 into second and Wind Burn Flash for Jason Newman also coming across from her wide draw into third. Zipping Patch began well and pushed up into fourth alongside Dashing Jinx for Clint Trengove while the remainder of the field jostled for positions.

Leaving the front straight and Bedrock Will was going nicely in the lead but was being stalked by Springvale Rex and Wind Burn Flash with a gap back to Zipping Patch however he was starting to make good ground followed by Machismo for Vadim Roz. Off the back straight and Springvale Rex offered a strong challenge to Bedrock Will along the inside and shortly after raced to the lead however Zipping Patch had moved passed Wind Burn Flash into third and was hard on the paws of Springvale Rex as they turned for home. In the charge to the finish line Zipping Patch accelerated along the inside to claim the lead and raced down to the line a strong winner by .75 lengths in a slick time of 42.92 for the 730m journey ahead of Springvale Rex with 2.25 lengths back to Bedrock Will.

The son of Sh Avatar and Zipping Abby is locally owned by Cameron Foreshaw and has been racing in fantastic fashion for the Ashlee Griffiths kennel. He has now won 10 races from 33 starts with 9 placings and prizemoney around \$43,000.

For the 51st running of the SA Anniversary Cup Final a wonderful field was assembled for the prestigious event with Tony Rasmussen claiming back-to-back victories when Victa Alby was able to lead throughout replicating his kennel mate Mallee Magic who did the same thing 12 months prior.

As the start was affected it was an even dispatch with Victa Alby from box 2 beginning ok but receiving some crowding as he pushed towards the lead, both kennel mates Victa Marli for Tony from box 6 and Springvale Maddi for Gavin Harris from box 8 came across from wide draws and challenged hard for the front with Oh Louise for Tim Richards moving nicely into fourth. As they left the front straight Victa Alby withstood the challenge and punched through to lead clearly into the back straight. Victa Marli held second with Oh Louise moving up alongside Springvale Maddi for third as the remainder of the field looked to find their positions.

Into the back straight and Victa Alby opened up a nice break from Victa Marli who was chasing hard, Oh Louise had moved to a clear third while Springvale Maddi was being challenged for fourth by Basil Brush Rose for Renata Maruszczky and Panorama for Ben Rawlings. Off the back straight and into the front straight Victa Alby was burning along in the lead with his lead increasing with every stride. He careered away from his rivals to go on and win by almost 5 lengths in a sizzling 30.23 for the 530m journey. Victa Marli stuck on well for second giving the Rasmussen team the quinella while Oh Louise fought off the challenge from Basil Brush Rose to claim a nice third a further 1.50 lengths away.

Locally owned and bred the son of Fernando Bale and Victa Polly is owned by The Four Girls Syndicate managed by Sue Schadow and has the impressive record of 9 wins from 20 starts with 5 placings and prizemoney around \$46,000.

## ADDITIONAL TUESDAY NIGHT MEETING AT ANGLE PARK

After consultation and support by Sky Racing, GRSA has programmed an extra race meeting on the weekly schedule for the new season, with Tuesday night at Angle Park now on the calendar.

This extra meeting will be shown on Sky 2 and will be for Category 3 prizemoney. It will also be for short course greyhounds (342m) exclusively to not affect 530m+ at Angle Park meetings on Monday (Category 2) and Thursday (Category 1). GRSA may initially have to utilise more 6 dog fields to spread out our numbers across the weekly schedule, however, this will only be determined at the time. These meetings will be graded events and as we haven't run this category with greyhounds taking a grade (Saturday mornings are Non Penalty) it will be like a new venue with most grades being Maiden, Grade 6 and Grade 5 to start with.

Nominations will close on the Friday before, the same time as Gawler Wednesday. This does avoid Angle Park Monday and Murray Bridge Tuesday which close on the Thursday.

Trials at Angle Park will move from Tuesday night to Wednesday night and be run the same time as the Murray Bridge trials. The implementation date is scheduled for 1st August, 2023

## CLASSIC AND BREEDERS FUTURITY PAYMENTS

Owners of SA Bred greyhounds are reminded that the next batch of Futurity payments are due on Friday, 16th June 2023.

The payments due are:

Classic 2023 – Final Payment (Pups born July 21 to December 21)

This payment is for greyhounds for which the Second Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound.

Breeders 2024 – Second Payment (Pups born January 22 to June 22)

This payment is for greyhounds for which the First Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

Classic 2024 – First Payment (Pups born July 22 to December 22)

This First Payment is due for Classic 2024. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. The First Payment is \$27.50 per pup or a "one-off" Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

To assist all owners of Futurity eligible pups, reminders should be in your letter box over the coming days. It is perhaps a good idea to make the payment as soon as you can, so it does not slip your mind and the closing date passes. If you have sold a pup/s we would ask if you can forward on the information to the new owner. If you have not received a reminder by the end of this month and you think you should have, contact Caralyn Fielden as soon as possible.

## LOW GRADE RACE FOR THURSDAYS AT ANGLE PARK

In an effort to ensure we are programming 12 races each Thursday night at Angle Park GRSA has introduced a low grade race for some Thursday nights. These races are for Grade 5 greyhounds over 530m that have a low WPS (Weighted Points Score).

Prizemoney will be slightly less than a normal Grade 5, however, these races will be non-penalty. There will be no guarding, no reserves and only one 8 greyhound race. This should provide encouragement for those trainers who have 500m+ greyhounds but feel they cannot compete on a normal Thursday night due to current form. We are hoping to draw from a different pool of greyhounds and GRSA would encourage trainers to nominate. \$3,505 Special event Grade 5 (worst to best) – 530m (One 8 dog field will be graded from the Weighted Points Score table of Grade 5 pool of greyhounds worst to best grading. No guarding and no reserves. Trainers cannot nominate for this event specifically. Non Penalty)

The next programmed event is on Thursday, 1st June.

• **Nominations for the Heats close Monday, 29th May with GRSA at 9.00am**

GRSA has also continued with the 1 – 4 win Time Graded Heats on a Saturday morning over 530m into a Thursday night Final, however, with the introduction of the race on Thursday night, in May the 5+ 530m Time Graded events will only be run if insufficient nominations for the meeting (there will be no Heats for this pool of greyhounds).

GRSA will also continue running Heats at Murray Bridge, Angle Park Monday and Gawler into a Thursday night Final where the program allows to draw from a different pool of greyhounds over 500m.

## NEW FLOORING FOR MURRAY BRIDGE

GRSA Maintenance and contractors require a week to install new Regupol flooring in the kennel house at Murray Bridge. The plan for this to occur is in the last part of this month into the first week of June which will cause the least amount of disruption to the

racing and trialling schedule.

Kennels are required to be removed, the floor will need to be grinded back and then prepared for Regupol installation, kennels will need to be reinstalled, this will take about a week to be completed with dates Saturday, 27th May to Sunday, 4th June 2023.

It is anticipated that trials will not be impacted at Murray Bridge during this period bearing in mind the kennel house will not be available.

## VACCINATION RULE FOR RACING IN SA

Trainers are reminded that Rule 25 (Minimum Vaccination Requirements) took effect Monday, 1st May. Vaccination Certificates must be received by GRSA prior to close of nominations for affected greyhounds to be considered eligible.

## 2023 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS IN VICTORIA

**The GCA National Championships are just around the corner. The National Finals this year will be held at The Meadows in Victoria and are to be conducted on Saturday, 26th August.**

Both the National Sprint and National Distance Finals are at Group 1 level.

The State series' for SA will be held at Angle Park on Thursday, 3rd August for the Sprint Heats over 530m with the State Final of the Sprint and one-off Final over 730m of the Distance on the 10th August.

In an effort to support this series ALL States will be conducting their Finals on the same night to be run within a two hour period.

• **Nominations will close at the normal time with GRSA which will be at 9am on Monday, 31st July**

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Wednesday, 17th May 2023. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

## NATIONAL STRAIGHT TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP AT HEALESVILLE

**The National Straight Track Championship this year will be held at Healesville on Saturday morning, 26th August – so all the National Finals will be held on the same day.**

This year SA will have two SA dogs represent the State in the series with QLD, NSW, VIC and SA challenging for the title.

So the Straight Track series aligns with the circle and the other States, our Heats will be held at Murray Bridge on Tuesday, 1st August with our Final on Tuesday, 8th August. Prizemoney for the SA Straight track Final will be \$10,000 to the winner aligned with the other three States.

It is important that trainers are aware that these series' for the circle and straight track are run at the same time so please be mindful of this when nominating and the qualifying criteria.

• **Nominations close with GRSA at 9am on Thursday, 27th July**

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Saturday, 13th May 2023. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

## COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED "ONLY"

**A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.**

The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race] If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader

will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

## WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

## RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

## CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

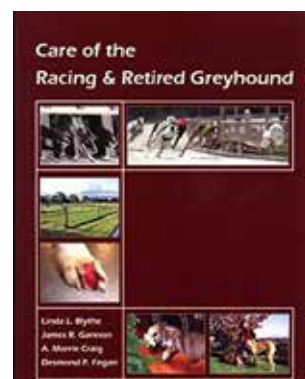

## Greyhound of the month - Victa Alby

**Greyhound of the Month for April was Victa Alby for trainer Tony Rasmussen who had three starts for the month with two wins and the highlight being the prestigious Anniversary Cup win at Angle Park on Thursday, 27th April.**

The son of Fernando Bale and Victa Polly started the month off by qualifying for the Group 3 Launching Pad Final at Sandown where he ran a luckless seventh against some of the best young sprinters in the land.

He returned to SA with a brilliant win in the Heats of the

Anniversary Cup where he ran a slick 30.53 for the 530m when he led throughout.

Starting favourite in the Final he began well and used his inside draw to advantage when he pushed hard on the first turn to lead and from there he was never headed.

He ran a sizzling 30.23 in winning by almost 5 lengths against our top local sprinters.

At the end of the month Victa Alby's record stood at 20 starts for 9 wins and 5 placings and earnings just over \$46,000.

## Run of the month - Ravers Army

**The Run of the Month for April was the Tim Aloisi trained Ravers Army for his flying effort at Angle Park on Monday, 24th April over the 530m journey.**

One of the most versatile chasers in the State, Ravers Army showed his pure speed at headquarters when he was able to lead throughout in mixed 4/5 company and record a blistering 30.14 in winning by over 5 lengths, one of the fastest times recorded at the redeveloped Angle Park.

## 2023 NORTH VS SOUTH CHALLENGE

Below are details of how the 2023 North V South Challenge will work for a 531m Final worth \$8,000 and a 400m Final worth \$4,000, to be run at Gawler on Sunday 30th July and then on rotation with Murray Bridge over the coming years.

This year's series will start with one Heat for Gawler greyhounds and one Heat for Murray Bridge greyhounds at Gawler on Sunday, 16th July, with the 531m Heats worth \$2,125 each and the 400m Heats worth \$1,855 for round 1. Round 2 will be at Murray Bridge with the same greyhounds competing in one Heat for the Gawler greyhounds and one Heat for Murray Bridge greyhounds on Sunday, 23rd July, with the 530m Heats worth \$2,125 and the 395m Heats worth \$1,855. Each Heat will consist of a maximum of 8 dogs with the Finals run at Gawler on Sunday, 30th July as an 8 dog Final plus reserves. **Greyhounds will receive points through both rounds 1 and 2 to establish the 4 from each Club who will progress through to the Final.**

### Conditions

- To be eligible for either Murray Bridge or Gawler trainers will be classified on their Post Code as to which Club they can represent (see table below. Please contact GRSA if your postal address is not recognised below).
- The greyhound must be SA trained.
- A South Australian-trained greyhound is defined as one that is in SA for a period of not less than 3 out of the 6 months immediately before the time of nomination.
- The 530m/531m event is open to all greyhounds.
- The 395m/400m event is open to all greyhounds.
- The winner of each event takes a penalty including the Final however if they won round 1 they will only take one penalty. If a greyhound has won round 1 and round 2 they will only take 1 penalty for the Club they are representing.
- The greyhounds must not have any offences precluding them from competing at Murray Bridge or Gawler or they will be ineligible for the rounds.
- Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.
- The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track over any distance it is attempting to represent. (Gawler Prov 1 or Prov 2 and Murray Bridge One Turn Prov 1). This only relates to the track they are representing.
- The same greyhounds will compete in both Rounds 1 and 2.
- There will be No Reserves for Round 1 and Round 2
- In Round 1 both Heats for each distance must have 5 or more nominations to be conducted separately. If one Heat has 5 or more nominations and the other Heat has 4 nominations, then this will be conducted as one race for round 1 with all greyhounds progressing to round 2 and then the final. In Round 1 if there are 3 or fewer nominations for a distance then this event will be combined, made up to a maximum of 8 runners and conducted as the final on Sunday 16th July (531m event worth \$4k, 400m event worth \$2k)
- Points will be allocated for each round (1st 12 points, 2nd 9, 3rd 7, 4th 5, 5th 4, 6th 3, 7th 3, 8th 3)
- If greyhounds have the same amount of points the greyhound with the best finish in either round 1 or 2 will progress, however, if the placings are the same then this will be by ballot.
- The two reserves for the Final will be determined by points initially (as above) to select which reserve from either Club is the first or second reserve, however, if identical then by a ballot. The sixth greyhounds if required will be by points or then by ballot if required. Should a greyhound be withdrawn before the final fields, the next placed greyhound from that Club's Heat will be selected.
- Once a greyhound has been selected or qualified for a Heat, it is not eligible to compete for the other Club in this series.

- GRSA reserves the right to alter any conditions as necessary.

## RISK AND COMPLIANCE

### DISQUALIFIED, SUSPENDED, WARNED OFF PERSONS & DEFAULTERS – WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR YOU?

**The Greyhounds Australasia Rules (GAR) define a warned off person the same as a disqualified person. A disqualified person is a person who is disqualified by the Controlling Body or Stewards or pursuant to the Rules of any approved controlling authority or thoroughbred, harness, or greyhound racing club.**

Greyhound racing means everything and anyone who participates, at any level, at any time, with any activity associated with greyhounds or racing and includes, but is not limited to –

- (a) the keeping of greyhounds which are in the care or custody of registered or other persons;
- (b) the registration or breeding of greyhounds;
- (c) any matter or thing connected to greyhound racing.

Rule 156(x) of the GAR states that any person shall be guilty of an offence if they, as a registered person or person associated with greyhound racing, associates with a disqualified person for the purposes of greyhound racing.

What this means is, as a registered person, if you associate with a person who is disqualified or warned off, for the purposes of greyhound racing, you commit a breach of the rules. It does not mean you cannot have any contact – the rules of greyhound racing are not there to control who you see outside racing, but you cannot – categorically – associate for the purposes of greyhound racing. This can include assistance with training, consultation, advice, assessments, examinations, or anything else that relates to your activity with greyhounds. Please be mindful of this.

The GAR define a suspension as the withdrawal for any period of any registration, licence, right or privilege granted pursuant to the Rules. A person who is suspended cannot perform tasks that would normally be allowed under their registration or respective licence. A suspension can be imposed as a penalty after an Inquiry; or, as a condition subject to an Inquiry, pursuant to Rule 169[5][c] of the GAR.

The GAR define a defaulter as a person declared by the Controlling Body or a person authorised by a Controlling Body to be a defaulter, or who otherwise becomes a defaulter by operation of a rule of greyhound racing, who is in default in relation to the payment of money payable to Greyhounds Australasia, a Controlling Body, or a Club, including any prize money directed to be returned to the relevant Controlling Body or Club. It is an offence pursuant to Rule 156[u] to be a defaulter and the privileges afforded to a registered person are stopped.

The overall effect of these types of penalties is considered by Rule 178 of the GAR -

178 Effect of disqualification, suspension, warning off or being declared a defaulter

[1] A penalty imposed pursuant to the Rules will apply throughout the jurisdiction of the body imposing the penalty.

[2] A person who is disqualified, warned off, suspended or declared to be a defaulter must not, during the period of the penalty:

- [a] nominate a greyhound for any Event;
- [b] permit a greyhound that the person owns or trains to compete in any Event;
- [c] act as an attendant at a meeting;
- [d] train a greyhound;
- [e] participate in any activity connected with the breeding of greyhounds;
- [f] act as an official at a meeting;
- [g] be engaged as an employee or agent by any other person associated with the training of greyhounds; or
- [h] be a member, officeholder, employee or volunteer of a Club registered pursuant to the Local Rules of a Controlling Body.

[3] Unless a Controlling Body orders otherwise, a person who is disqualified, warned-off or declared a defaulter is not:

- [a] permitted to transact or engage in any business affecting the registration or licensing of persons or greyhounds with a Controlling Body;
- [b] to enter any enclosure or other part of a racecourse or any property occupied or used in connection with a racecourse whether acting as agent or in any other capacity;
- [c] to enter the premises of a Club;
- [d] to have or hold any of the rights or privileges conferred by any licence or registration pursuant to the Rules;
- [e] eligible to otherwise participate in or associate with greyhound racing, and any greyhound which has been nominated by the person or in the person's name, or which the person wholly or partly owns which is proved to the satisfaction of a Controlling Body to be under the person's care, custody or in training with the person, is prohibited from competing in any Event; and
- [f] to enter or go to or remain on, at any time, any place where greyhounds are bred, whelped, handled, reared, broken in, kept or housed, educated, pre-trained, trained or

raced.

Also note your obligations to report certain adverse outcomes to GRSA, pursuant to Rule 168 of the GAR -

Division 8: Obligations of registered persons to report certain offences and circumstances

168 Obligations of registered persons to report certain offences and circumstances

A registered person must notify the Controlling Body or Controlling Bodies by whom they are registered, within seven days of:

- [a] being found guilty of an offence punishable by fine or imprisonment, other than a fine for a traffic offence;
- [b] having their registration with any Controlling Body or approved controlling authority (including those that relate to harness racing and thoroughbred racing, either in Australia or abroad) suspended, disqualified or cancelled;
- [c] becoming a defaulter in the jurisdiction of any Controlling Body;
- [d] being warned off or fined in excess of \$250 in connection with greyhound, harness or thoroughbred racing, other than by a Controlling Body with whom they are registered;
- [e] being the subject of any action under legislation directed at the prevention of cruelty to animals.

These types of adverse outcomes will also be considered during any licence application, review, or renewal process, under the fit and proper person test outlined in Part 4 of the Local Rules.

Up to date GAR and Local Rules are available on the website.

## COVID-19 AND OTHER WINTER NASTIES

I cannot let a month go by without returning to my old focus of COVID-19, but more specifically, the winter cold and flu season.

The old COVID-19 preventative measures are still useful for the usual colds and flu we see every season. Please consider –

- Social distancing (1.5m)
- Wash hands regularly

### License Renewal Time Is Approaching Some GRSA licenses will expire on July 1st.

All license classes will be renewed for a period of two years with fees remaining unchanged. Keep an eye out for license renewal documentation which will be emailed to those participants with registered email addresses (as recorded in Ozchase) and posted to those without. Whilst GRSA aims to process applications in a timely manner, participants are encouraged to ensure all applications are correctly completed and lodged with payment as early as possible. Persons wishing to nominate greyhounds for race meetings from 1st July must submit applications prior to Friday 23rd June to ensure the application is processed in time. Note that Owner licenses must also be renewed to ensure nominations are accepted. Participants who have failed to pay outstanding fines and do not address the matter, may be unable to renew their licenses. There will also be several show cause notices issued to currently licensed participants who have been inactive for some time, or have indicated, by way of public social media comment or other means, that they do not wish to participate under the current relevant conditions, policies, and rules. Licensees requiring a new Police Clearance or photo will be advised with the renewal notice. Online services provide a quicker and generally cheaper product for Police Clearances.

## Distribution between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants who receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party (e.g. owners) then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective, the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you **DO NOT** need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically, however;
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners of your own accord, then you **DO** need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

Example to help participants understand the WAP they receive

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dog(s). The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

In this example, assume the owner/trainer received **\$1,000** in prizemoney for any/all races for the month.

In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of **\$71.43**, calculated as:

$$\text{\$1,000} \div \text{\$700,000} \times \text{\$50,000} = \text{\$71.43}$$

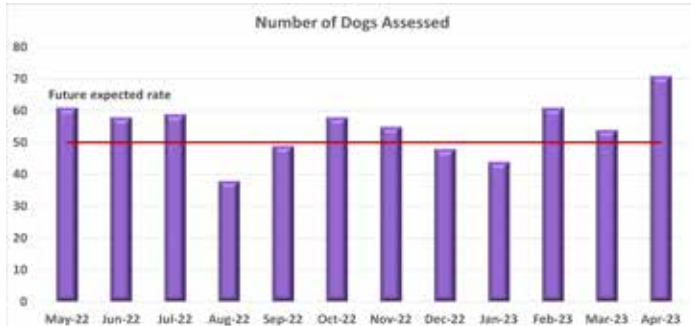
Participants should note that:

- WAP is **not payable** for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000];
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

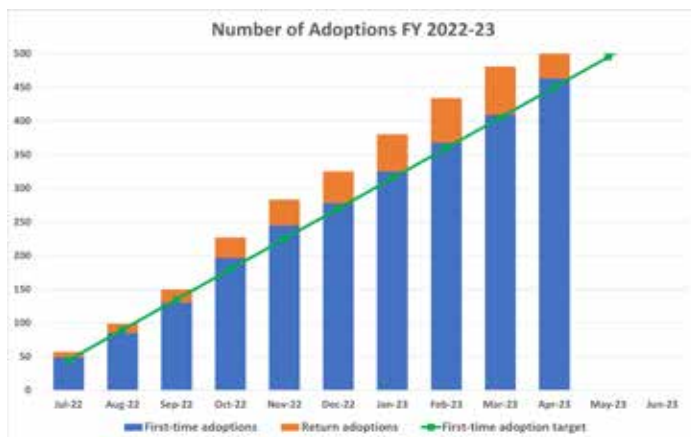
## Latest updates from GAP

### Kind reminder from GAP:

**Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.**

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialed after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

# TRIALS

## QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:30pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

## ANGLE PARK

### SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

### BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

## POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

### Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

### Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

### Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

### Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

## MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

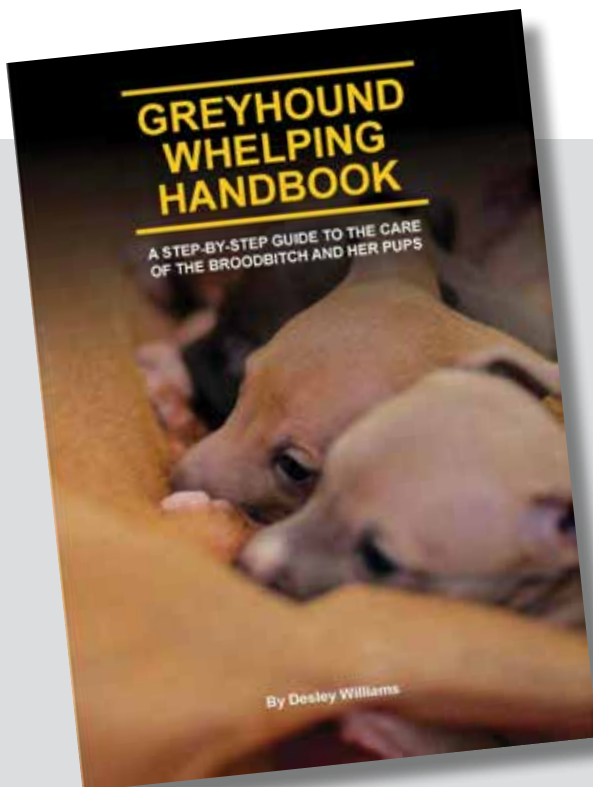
