A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

GRANTLEY STEVENS

It was very pleasing to see so many of you take the time to attend the recent Future in Focus – Industry Engagement Forums.

Whether it was Gawler, Murray Bridge, Mt Gambier or Angle Park, the sessions featured strong engagement with very constructive feedback provided that will be helpful as we collectively confront the challenges of the current Government Inquiry and drive increased confidence in this industry we all love.

As outlined at the forums, GRSA is progressing with the implementation of as many of the Government Inquiry recommendations, as quickly as possible. We also outlined our plans to fast track – inclusive of participant input – a strategic plan refresh. The refreshed plan will ensure that we focus on the opportunities embedded in the inquiry reforms whilst also building for the longer term. By way of reminder, if you have not yet provided feedback on the current GRSA strategic plan drafted in 2022, you can do so through the link on the email you hopefully received which remains open until COB Friday 24 May.

It was pleasing to be able to introduce our new CEO Brenton Scott to you at the Industry Engagement Forums. Those that attended, or have met with Brenton at a race meeting, would have seen he has quickly gained a firm grip on the challenges and opportunities we have before us. Together with members of the realigned Executive Leadership Team (ELT) that also presented, we feel we have strong leadership in place at GRSA that will allow for the delivery of positive outcomes.

While feedback from each forum did include some club-specific focuses, there were clearly recurring themes expressed at each gathering. While not exhaustive, the themes and the actions that we need to consider as we progress the strategy refresh were as follows:

- **Welfare** – the need to create an operating environment of self-compliance regarding kennel and care standards.
- **Integrity** – the need for the industry integrity and swabbing system to comprehensively embrace national best practice, the reforms of the Government Inquiry and fairness.
- **Racing** – the need for optimised programming to provide options for greyhounds of all capabilities and a continued commitment to safe racing.
- **Breeding** – the need for a breeding stimulus that aligns with future racing population requirements from quality and quantity perspectives.
- **Lifecycle management** – the need to have in place

an integrated population management process that aligns breeding and importation levels with racing calendar demands and further ensures a managed flow of greyhounds into retirement, including rehoming outcomes.

- **Prizemoney** – the need for a review to consider proportionality balance.
- **Participant demographics** – the need to manage an aging participation population and to create an inviting opportunity for younger participants.
- **Behaviour** - the need for all stakeholders to lead, uphold standards and contribute to collective responsibility of the industry reform journey.
- **Communication** – the need for GRSA and stakeholders to uphold highest possible communication and engagement procedures.

So where to from here?

Immediately following the forums, GRSA split all feedback into one of three categories;

- Items for immediate Board or management consideration.
- Items to be considered as part of the Government Inquiry process.
- Items captured for consideration as part of the Strategic Plan refresh.

How will you learn of the outcomes of the above? This will be achieved in a number of ways.

First, through this important communication channel - Kennel Capers - we will keep all registered participants updated on any Board or management considerations.

Second, the refreshed strategic plan – to which all participants have the opportunity to contribute – will be published in July and can be expected to cover off on the key themes progressed at the Future In Focus sessions.

And third, we plan to ‘hit the road’ regularly. There is clearly a desire from participants to continue quality engagement. Future forums will continue to be a two-way exchange, incorporating updates on the Government Inquiry and progress on strategic plan actions, ensuring we live our values of accountability and transparency.

Thank you again for taking the time to attend and support our industry’s future. I look forward to catching up with you at a race meeting soon. We love our dogs!

LOW GRADE FEATURE CALENDAR RELEASED

Provided in Kennel Capers is the full list of the lower graded feature races at Angle Park for 2024/2025 with Finals worth \$5,810.

CLASSIC AND BREEDERS FUTURITY PAYMENTS – DUE FRIDAY 14TH JUNE 2024

Owners of SA Bred greyhounds are reminded that the next batch of Futurity payments are due on Friday, 14th June 2024.

The payments due are:

Classic 2024 – Final Payment (Pups born July 22 to December 22)

This payment is for greyhounds for which the Second Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Final Payment is \$121 per greyhound.

Breeders 2025 – Second Payment (Pups born January 23 to June 23)

This payment is for greyhounds for which the First Sustaining Payment was made last December. The Second Sustaining Payment is \$55 per pup or a Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

Classic 2025 – First Payment (Pups born July 23 to December 23)

This First Payment is due for Classic 2025. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. The First Payment is \$27.50 per pup or a “one-off” Final Payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.

To assist all owners of Futurity eligible pups, reminders should now be in your letter box. It is perhaps a good idea to make the payment as soon as you can, so it does not slip your mind and the closing date passes. If you have sold a pup/s we would ask if you can forward on the information to the new owner. If you have not received a reminder by the end of this month and you think you should have, contact Caralyn Fielden as soon as possible.

2024 GAWLER BREEDERS HEATS ON SUNDAY JUNE 30

After the Group 3 Howard Ashton Final, the final race for the Breeders 2024 eligible greyhounds will be the Gawler Breeders Heats over 531m which will be run on Sunday, 30th June with the Final on Friday, 5th July.

Nominations for the Heats close on Wednesday, 26th June with GRSA at 9.00am.

2024 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA THIS YEAR

The GCA National Championships are just around the corner. The National Finals this year will be held locally at Angle Park and are to be conducted on Saturday, 24th August.

Both the National Sprint and National Distance Finals are at Group 1 level worth \$85,000 to the winner.

The State series' for SA will be held at Angle Park on Thursday, 1st August for the Sprint Heats over 530m with the State Final of the Sprint and one-off Final over 730m of the Distance on Thursday, 8th August.

In an effort to support this series ALL States will be conducting their Finals on the same night to be run within a two hour period.

• Nominations will close at the normal time with GRSA which will be at 9am on Monday, 29th July

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA.

For the Sprint series going back is on Wednesday, 15th May 2024.

For the Distance due to it being a one off final going back is on Wednesday, 22nd May 2024.

If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

NATIONAL STRAIGHT TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP AT MURRAY BRIDGE

The National Straight Track Championship this year will be held locally at Murray Bridge on Saturday morning, 24th August with around \$28,000 to the winner – so all the National Finals will be held on the same day.

This year SA will have two SA dogs represent the State in the series with QLD, NSW, VIC and SA challenging for the title.

With the Straight Track series being in SA with the circle and the other States, our Heats will be held at Murray Bridge on Tuesday, 6th August with our Final on Tuesday, 13th August. Prizemoney for the SA Straight track Final will be \$10,000 to the winner aligned with the other three States.

It is important that trainers are aware that these series' for the circle and straight track are run around the same time so please be mindful of this when nominating and the qualifying criteria.

• Nominations close with GRSA at 9am on Friday, 2nd August (this will allow the opportunity if greyhounds get run out over the 530m in the Heats for the Sprint series a chance to nominate for the Straight)

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Sunday, 19th May 2024. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

TUESDAY NIGHT MEETINGS ON THE CALENDAR

Greyhound Racing South Australia [GRSA] announced the introduction of Tuesday night meetings at Angle Park, from the middle of this month. The Tuesday night meetings are designed to meet demand, providing more racing opportunities for lower class greyhounds within SA.

The meetings will be time graded, with 10 races of six dog fields. The meetings will operate in tandem with Saturday morning race meetings which will target greyhounds of the same class with the racing distance at both race meetings restricted to 342m. Excess nominations are currently received for Saturday morning meetings. The Tuesday meetings will provide a further outlet for greyhounds that are nominated for the Saturday mornings and are not provided with a starting opportunity. Greyhounds falling into this category will be granted preference rights if nominated for the subsequent Tuesday night meeting.

With Saturday morning and Tuesday night meetings being restricted to 342m nominations, opportunities for 530m time graded greyhounds will be programmed for other Angle Park dates. Trainers are encouraged to familiarise themselves with the details for the Tuesday night meetings, changes to the Saturday morning meetings and updated trialling times for Angle Park.

ANGLE PARK TO TRIAL ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

Please be advised that with Angle Park racing on Tuesday nights the trials will shift to Wednesday night. The starting times remain the same at 6pm with the booking process and times the same as normal. Please be mindful that Bingo utilise most of the Chasers Restaurant on this night so please be aware of this while oncourse.

MURRAY BRIDGE EMPTY OUT AREA

The Murray Bridge GRC request that if trainers wish to use the emptying out facilities at Murray Bridge they are required to pick up after their dogs, showing consideration for other users.

The appointment will be for a 2 year term which could be extended if agreed upon, with the Panel meeting 2 to 3 times a year, however, there will be general correspondence during this time which will take place via email.

RACING AND TRIALLING FREQUENCY REMINDER

GRSA adopted a new local rule in regard to frequency of racing and trialling which was implemented on Wednesday, 1st February, 2023.

Rule 69A Racing and trialling frequency

[1] In this rule:

Race has the same meaning given to this term in R9 of the GAR.

Trial means a satisfactory trial, or a qualifying trial as defined in R9 of the GAR.

[2] A greyhound will only be permitted to start in [a] No more than a combined total of 2 race and trial starts in any 7-day period; and,

[b] No more than a combined total of 7 race and trial starts in any 28-day period.

[3] This sub-rule commences on a date to be fixed by Stewards' Notice.

The intent of this rule is to monitor and regulate the frequency of races and official trials of greyhounds, to ensure adequate rest time is given between events. The rule is similar to one in effect in Western Australia. We have automated the Ozchase Racing system to be able to monitor this rule. The rule is self-explanatory.

A greyhound must not start more than 2 times [races or trials combined] in any 7-day period. Further, a greyhound must not start more than 7-times [races or trials combined] in any 28-day period.

Any attempt to nominate a greyhound outside these parameters will be flagged by the OzChase system. If a greyhound gains a start from reserve deeming it ineligible under this rule for its next engagement or it competes in another state prior to racing back in SA then the greyhound will come out.

**Racing Administration staff will scratch these greyhounds acting under this rule without notification [the responsibility rests with the trainer to ensure they do not contravene this rule].

**For clarity if a greyhound races on Sunday, Wednesday then Sunday it will be eligible. The first day counts as day 1 and therefore resets on the Saturday.

VACCINATION RULE FOR RACING IN SA – REMINDER

Trainers are reminded that Rule 25 [Minimum Vaccination Requirements] took effect Monday, 1st May, 2023. Vaccination Certificates must be received by GRSA prior to close of nominations for affected greyhounds to be considered eligible for nominating. It is also imperative that once the greyhound has been vaccinated the paperwork is lodged by yourself as soon as possible. Trainers are also reminded that they must not have their greyhound vaccinated within 5 days of racing. Should this occur, the greyhound will be scratched from its engagement or if paperwork lodged after an engagement and discovered the greyhound raced inside the 5 days then the matter will be referred to the stewards.

DAYLIGHT SAVING – MURRAY BRIDGE TRIALS

A reminder to ALL participants that daylight savings has ended, so please be sure to check kennel times and start times of events to ensure nothing is missed.

As it is non daylight savings the Murray Bridge trials will revert to a 4:00pm start.

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month.

These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner & \$150 to the Breeder.

The SA Bred Bonus scheme is continuing to go over budget with the number of SA Bred winners increasing. For the month of July there were 203 winners, August 197, September 196, October 226, November 209, December 218, January 218, February 194, March 179 and April 197. This means that we are currently 37 winners over budget for this financial year.

PROJECTS AND INFRASTRUCTURE

GREYHOUND EDUCATION CIRCUIT (GEC) MURRAY BRIDGE

You may be aware that GRSA are constructing a Greyhound Education Circuit (GEC) at Murray Bridge.

Greyhound Education Circuits are important for building confidence in greyhound pups prior to track racing and will offer a safe training and education facility for greyhounds of all ages. This Circuit will be the first of its kind in South Australia, and only the second to be built trackside in Australia.

Construction at Murray Bridge is due to commence in the coming weeks and is anticipated to take approximately two to three months. During this period, we are committed to minimising any impact on participants and racing. However, there may be some effect on parking access to the slipping track and let-out yards. We will make every effort to ensure noise is kept to a minimum on race days. Further information will be provided closer to the completion date regarding specific operations of the facility.

All registered persons attending trials must familiarize themselves with this policy and also with the accompanying 'Staying Safe Around The Lure' safety sheet which is available at the racetracks and online with the policy.

The main points detailed in the policy that participants should be aware of are:

- All registered persons attending trials must make themselves known to GRSA officials before commencing, so their attendance can be acknowledged.
- All trial activities must be done under supervision of Stewards or officials.
- Never use openings or passages not designed as a thoroughfare (e.g. lure chutes) to pass through.
- Never stand or walk in the path of the lure.

STAYING SAFE AROUND THE LURE

This Toolbox Safety Talk is about staying safe around the lure. Always stay vigilant and follow directions to prevent accidents and injuries.

Some important points:

1. Understand the Lure

The lure is a mechanical device that travels along the path of the inner racetrack rail, controlled by a lure driver. The lure can travel very fast and is relatively quiet. The lure can start, stop and change its speed at any time and without warning.

2. The Trial

Before the use of a lure at a trial, you must listen to, or read, this safety briefing and note the warning signs on the racetrack. Only use the gates to move between areas. Never use the lure chute on the catching pen gate as a thoroughfare. Where chains are in place to stop movement, do not move them without direction.

3. Wear Proper Clothing

You must always wear a visible vest or clothing when you are near the track. Clothing must be suitable for physical work.

4. Stay Clear of Moving Parts

You must never walk onto the racetrack (sand) surface unless under direction and supervision of a GRSA official. You must never approach the lure, or approach or stand in the path of travel of the lure, which is within 1.5-metres of the inner rail.

5. Communication is Key

If you ever see something that you think is a hazard, while the lure is moving, yell out –

STOP LURE. STOP LURE. STOP LURE.

6. Be Aware of Surroundings

Stay alert to your surroundings. Avoid distractions like mobile phones or personal conversations that might divert your attention from the lure.

Remember, your safety and the safety of those around you are of utmost importance. By following these guidelines and respecting the rules and directions around the lure, we can create a safer and more productive environment for everyone.

CHAPEL ROAD TRAINER: KIAH HURLEY

Greyhound of the Month for April was Chapel Road for trainer Kiah Hurley, who had two starts for the month and was undefeated winning both events, with the highlight being victory in the Group 3 Mount Gambier Cup Final in the middle of the month.

The son of Bernardo and Sunset Seniorita started the month off in the Heats of the Mount Gambier Cup. After a torrid run outside the leader, he strode to the lead turning for home to run away with a stirring victory by 3 lengths in 30.10. As he lined up for the Group 3 Final, and as the start was affected, Chapel Road began well from box 1 to push through and lead on the first turn. He ran terrific sectionals out in the lead and whilst the hot field of chasers tried to bridge the gap, Chapel Road dominated from the front to go on and win by 2 lengths in a blistering 29.56 for the 512m journey. At the end of the month Chapel Road's record stood at 41 starts for 9 wins and 20 placings and earnings around \$78,000.



RIOT ROOSTER TRAINER: BEN RAWLINGS

The Run of the Month for April was the Ben Rawlings trained Riot Rooster, for his win in Heat 3 of the SA Anniversary Cup over the 530m at Angle Park on Thursday, 18th April.

The son of Superior Panama and Ring In took on the best local and Interstate sprinters as he looked to qualify for the \$50,000 feature. He began fairly from box 2, however, as the leader rolled away from the rails, he railed strongly, and the "Rooster" quickly assumed control from there and raced away for a brilliant win.

He won by 2.5 lengths in a sizzling 30.24 to be the fastest qualify for the Final and establish himself as a real star of SA chasing.



BUDDY MONELLI TAKES OUT ANNIVERSARY CUP

With an elevated \$50,000 prize pool, we saw plenty of high quality greyhounds step out for the 2024 Anniversary Cup which was taken out by the Lyn Smith trained Buddy Monelli.

In the care of Nicole Price while in South Australia, the Victorian chaser made the most of a box one draw producing a brilliant run to take out the race in 30.18 Kai Bale for Tim Aloisi was second while Fantastic Spike for Liz Chegia was third.

The other feature on the night was the SA Distance Championship which was taken out by the Gavin Harris trained Lena Jinx.

From box three, the track record holder made light work of the small field, winning by five lengths in 42.66.

Distribution between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants who receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party (e.g. owners) then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective, the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you **DO NOT** need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically, however;
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners of your own accord, then you **DO** need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

Example to help participants understand the WAP they receive

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dog(s). The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

Assumptions:

In this example, assume the owner/trainer received **\$1,000** in prizemoney for any/all races for the month.

In this the total prizemoney (paid to all participant) is **\$700,000**.

In this example, the total WAP is **\$50,000**.

In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of **\$71.43**, calculated as:

$$\$1,000 \div \$700,000 \times \$50,000 = \$71.43$$

Participants should note that:

- WAP is **not payable** for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000];
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

Please call GAP SA on 8243 7124 on the booking day as early as possible to book your dogs in for assessment. You will also need to bring the greyhound's identification card with you on the day.

Greyhounds should not be raced or trialled within the 10 days prior to assessment.

Please remember to book in your greyhound's vet work AFTER you submit the GAP placement form.

Payment of placement fees

The \$60 placement fee is due at the time the placement form is submitted, payment can be made by either completing the card details on the form or by paying in cash. The placement form will only be processed, and the greyhound placed in GAP, once payment has been received.

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

We continue to look to increase these further in order to offer a wider variety of times to meet participants varying requirements.

The following graph depicts the number of assessments that have been occurring on a monthly basis.

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kennelling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

RACING REPORT

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

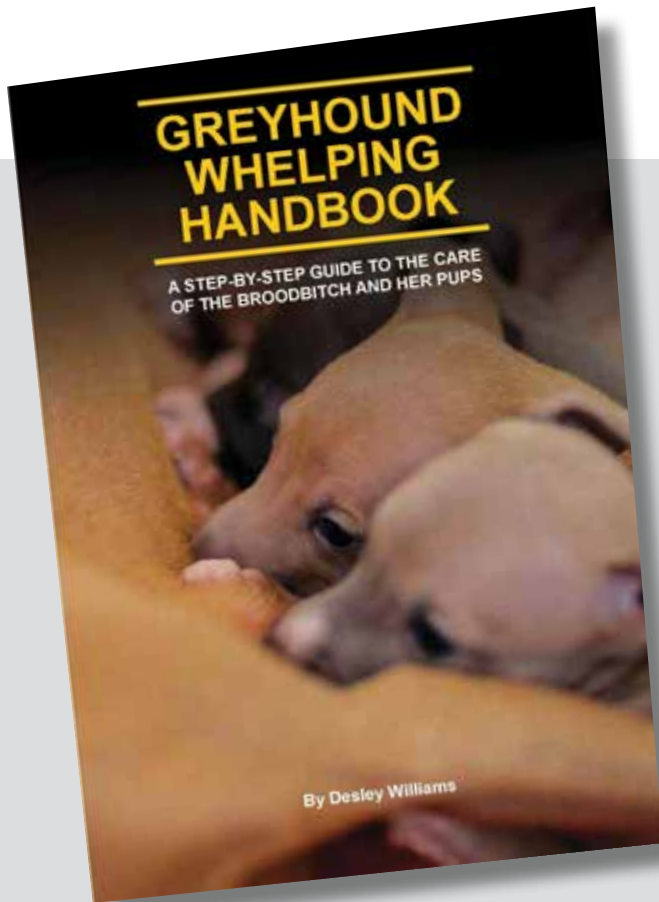

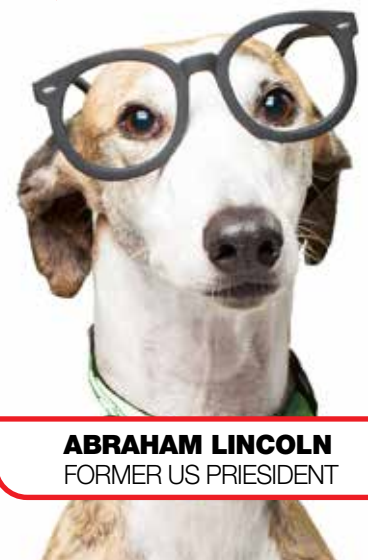
