The independent inquiry into South Australian Greyhound Racing is in its final stages with a report due by the end of November. GRSA Board and Management completed an extensive submission highlighting the positive impact that our industry has on the wider community. Prizemoney Increases

ADHANA RICO GIVES GRIFFITHS GAWLER CUP GLORY

Adhana Rico for trainer Ashlee Griffiths has taken out the 2023 Gawler Gold Cup final, winning an excellent final just ahead of Stout Monelli in front of a healthy crowd on Sunday 29th October.

Jumping from box one, Adhana Rico found itself second on the first turn but was quickly passed by Stout Monelli for Victorian trainer David Geall, who opened up a break down the back straight.

Adhana Rico was able to close the gap entering the home straight, going neck and neck with Stout Monelli before passing late to win by a quarter of a length in a time of 30.81.

Springvale Max for trainer Gavin Harris finished in third place while Springvale Bray for Michael Giniotis rounded out the first four.

The Group 3 success at Gawler was the latest feature win in an excellent year for Griffiths who is emerging as one of the state's best young trainers with her success including the SA Distance Championship, an Adelaide Cup heat win and the Murray Bridge Straight Track Cup.

Speaking on the dais post-race, Griffiths said she was thrilled to claim Gawler Gold Cup success with Adhana Rico.

"It was so exciting, he did very well to get there. I didn't think he was going to get there and go past him (Stout Monelli) but he made up a lot of ground," Griffiths said.

"It is my first group race that I have won, so yeah it is pretty fantastic."

The Gawler Gold Cup success wasn't the only success on the night for Griffiths with her star short-course greyhound Cash On Delivery taking out the Gawler Sprint Classic.

Jumping from box eight in a high-quality field, Cash On Delivery showcased his early speed and powered to the lead opening up a winning advantage.

Cash On Delivery stopped the clock in a slick 22.53 finishing three lengths ahead of his kennel mate Rockin' Rhino while Go Go Snow for Tamica Dunn finished in third.

The distance feature on the night was the Bothing Stayers Cup final over the 643m distance which was taken out by South Australia's most in-form greyhound in Zipping Neutron.

Zipping Neutron entered the final as a red-hot favourite after clocking 36.92 in his heat which is just one of the few times that 37 seconds has been broken on the Gawler track.

Zipping Neutron showed more of the same in the final, once again breaking the 37 second barrier in a dominant display where it stopped the clock in 36.99 and winning by nine lengths which made it 18 wins out of 20 starts since he arrived in South Australia earlier this year.

The impressive run of recent form has his trainer Tim Aloisi eyeing off Melbourne features including the Bold Trease. "I am very proud of the dog, he hasn't done anything wrong since he has come to SA. You keep waiting for him to slip up but he keeps on delivering," Aloisi said.

"The Gawler Cup Consolation was taken out by Agent Nineteen for local trainer Ben Rawlings who defeated a red-hot field as it stopped the clock in an impressive 30.59 while holding off the fast-finishing He's All Purpose.





GRSA ANNOUNCES PRIZEMONEY INCREASES

South Australian greyhound racing will see a 5% increase in prizemoney across all levels of racing, as well as further investment in the prestigious Anniversary Cup final taking its total prizemoney pool to \$50,000.

Effective from 1 December 2023, the increase is a reflection of the industry's sound fiscal performance over the last twelve months and recognises increased costs associated with participating in the sport.

Greyhound Racing SA [GRSA] Chair Grantley Stevens said the increase in prizemoney would be felt in all parts of the state and at all levels of racing.

"In addition to the significant investments we make in our animal welfare initiatives, club infrastructure and people, we invest in prizemoney because we know that it is critical to the sustainability of our sport," Mr Stevens said.

"When we invest in prizemoney across all grades, we see a real impact on our participants' ability to race dogs at all levels, travel to different regional centres, maintain best practice care and re-invest back into their own facilities.

"We trust that this increase will ease some of the pressures associated with the rising cost of living, while providing further confidence to the industry as to the success and stability of our sport at this challenging time."

The 50th running of the Anniversary Cup was celebrated in 2022 with a significantly increased prize pool. Now, the GRSA board has resolved to increase the total prize pool for the final to \$50.000.

"The annual running of the Anniversary Cup is a time-honoured tradition at Angle Park, and one that brings our greyhound community together for a celebration of our sport.

"We want to cement its place in the calendar and recognise its importance to South Australian greyhound racing with a major increase to the total prizemoney available in the final.

"I look forward to seeing the state's best sprinters compete in next year's race, with our community gathered to cheer them on."

2024 GAWLER PRODUCE STAKES – NOMINATIONS CLOSE FRIDAY 24TH NOVEMBER

The 2024 Gawler Produce Stakes will be run by GRSA in conjunction with the Gawler Greyhound Racing

Once again we will offer guaranteed Final stakemoney of \$22,000. The estimate for the total series prizemoney is \$40,000, based on this years series. The series is for greyhounds whelped in 2022.

In 2024 we will again be offering additional incentives for trainers to nominate. A bonus will be offered to any greyhound which can win both the Produce Stake and the Gawler Gold Cup.

The jackpot has increased from \$11,000 to \$12,000 as Could Be King missed out on winning the Gawler Gold Cup this year after running eighth in his Heat and not qualifying for the Final.

The SA Bred bonus will also be continued; should the winner of the Final be SA Bred, there will be an SA Bred bonus of \$1,000 to the owner and \$500 to the breeder.

The series will be in June with the Final on Sunday, 23rd June 2024. [Pending alterations]

GRSA administers the event for the Club, so all payments are to be made to GRSA. The fees are, one-off payment option \$121.00 or the sustaining option of \$33 (first), \$55 (second) and \$88 (Final).

Nomination Forms are available, along with the full list of conditions and the payment schedule.

* Nominations for the 2024 Gawler Produce will close on Friday, 24th November with GRSA.

TO MBGRC REGISTERED TRAINER MEMBERS

On behalf of the MBGRC Committee:

The MBGRC Committee wish to advise the MBGRC Registered Trainer Members that you must book your trials, otherwise you may be disappointed when the Murray Bridge Greyhound Racing track staff refuse to trial your greyhounds. Being a dual track facility, the Murray Bridge track staff require prior notification advising names of trainers booked for trials, at what time and on which track.

There are still a few MBGRC Registered Trainers yet to pay this year's [2023/2024] members renewal fee, trainers who are not members of the MBGRC are required to pay \$10 for each trial.

A reminder that Satisfactory Trials at Murray Bridge are on Wednesday nights on a fortnightly basis due to staffing issues. The next fortnightly opportunity will be Wednesday, 22nd November.

GAWLER TRIALS TO MOVE TO ONLINE IN NOVEMBER WITH THURSDAYS INITIALLY

As previously advised GRSA has been working with the Gawler GRC and staff to transition the Gawler trial booking process to online, like Angle Park and Murray Bridge for their Monday and Thursday morning sessions.

After consultation at the most recent ICG meeting this will have to be implemented to accommodate certain trialling requirements.

GRSA will extended the bookings for Gawler for each session from 4 to 6 that one trainer can have in anyone session to assist a number of young greyhounds that trial one after another.

To initiate Gawler online we will start with Thursdays first, which will start in November (date to be confirmed) which can be managed easier and then we will work on the Monday trial session.


Below is examples provided a few years ago so the dates and distances will have changed, however, will give industry a good idea when they log on to the Trial Booker which they can do through the GRSA website.

How do I register an account to book public trials online?


Visit www.trialbooker.com, click on the "register an account" link and fill in the appropriate details.

How do I book a specific trial online?

To book 4 trials, click Book 4:



As soon as you have pressed the Book button, those trials are booked and yours to keep. You then customise the distance, number of dogs, and type for each trial, and confirm them

Field Trials

Existing field trials will appear in each block. To book a dog in an existing field trial simply click the Book 1/2/3 button.



If there are no available field trials of the distance and type you require then feel free to create one yourself. Simply book a slot as-per-normal and select Maiden Field or Performed Field, as shown below.



Note: booking a dog or several dogs in a field trial counts as 1 trial towards your 4 trial maximum.

When do trial bookings commence each week?

Bookings for meetings will commence at 11.30am the working day prior to the trial session (henceforth known as "booking opening time").

Is there a limit to how many trials I can book online?

Yes: 4 (Gawler is 6). If you wish to reserve more than 4 trials a session then you must phone the office as per normal. For example, in the screenshot below, it indicates that you can book 3 more trials using TrialBooker without phoning.

Why am I limited to 4 trials in one block?

In short: to prevent abuse of the system. To book more phone the office after booking opening time.

Can I cancel a trial booking online? Yes: Press the X button and confirm

entirm.

Will I receive a confirmation to confirm my online trial booking?

Your trials are reserved for you as soon as you press the "Book 4" button (or "Book 4" or whichever it may be). You must then confirm the details of those trials (distance, number of dogs etc.). There will be a summary of your bookings in each session on the Home page.

Can I book trials for other licensees? No—under no circumstances may you book trials for anyone other than yourself using TrialBooker. Dogs must be brought in and paid for by the person whose name they were booked under. If you wish to share a non-field trial with another trainer you must book over the phone.

How can I book a trial if I don't have access to a computer?

You can still book trials by calling the office after booking opening time.

On Sunday, 10th December the \$4,000 Murray Bridge Anniversary Cup will be run over the 530m.

Nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am on Wednesday, 6th December

GOTBA COURSING AWARDS NIGHT – MOVED TO 7TH DECEMBER

GOTBA were going to present their Annual Awards at Angle Park on Thursday, 16th November however this has now been moved to Thursday, 7th December.

To be presented at the dais will be the SA Coursing Trainer of the Year and SA Coursing Greyhound of the Year.

We will also look to run a Free For All event for greyhounds which competed at Virginia during 2023. The race is supported by GOTBA and carries prizemoney of \$5,535.

Nominations for this event close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday, 4th December

CHRISTMAS CUP/BORDER CHALLENGE (MOUNT GAMBIER V WARRNAMBOOL) IN DECEMBER

This year due to programming of feature events the Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club will use the Williams Crane Hire Christmas Cup series to select the representatives for the Border Challenge (Mt Gambier V Warrnambool).

Mount Gambier will run the Christmas Cup series as normal for Open greyhounds over the 512m with Heats worth \$2,500 on Sunday, 10th December and the \$4,500 Final on Sunday, 17th December.

Within the Christmas Cup series and subject to the Border Challenge criteria, the first four past the post in the Christmas Cup Final on December 17 will also be Mount Gambier's first choices to represent the Club in the Warrnambool V Mount Gambier Border Challenge at Warrnambool on Thursday, December 21 worth \$5,800. If any of the first four past the post are not eligible the next placings will be considered and then an invitation from the Club to ensure there are four representatives.

Nominations for the Heats of the Christmas Cup close with GRSA at 9.00am on Tuesday, 5th December

BORDER CHALLENGE CONDITIONS FOR MOUNT GAMBIER:

Trainer must have had starters at 15 Mount Gambier meetings in the past 12 months. Trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous three months. Greyhound must have started at least four times in the past 12 months at Tara Raceway. Warrnambool V Mount Gambier [Warrnambool 450m, Thursday, December 21].

ANGLE PARK TRIALS ON SUNDAY 10TH DECEMBER

Again we have swapped our Saturday with Queensland to the following week to accommodate the Festival Of Fire series. The trials will remain at Angle Park on Sunday, 10th December due to rostering availability even though we will not race on the Saturday morning.

FESTIVAL OF FIRE TO HEAT UP ANGLE PARK IN DECEMBER

GRSA will continue to support local participants in December when the Festival of Fire series of races are conducted. GRSA is thrilled to conduct for the third year, the Festival of Fire series, our newest and most exciting fortnight on the South Australian greyhound racing calendar.

The "Festival Of Fire, series will provide opportunities for the best 48 nominations for the 530m trip, the best 16 nominations over 595m, and the best 8 nominations for a 730m event. There will be heats and final of a restricted event [0-5 wins], running from Saturday morning to Thursday night which will provide a separate opportunity for that category of runner. Again this year there will be a 530m Time Graded event for those greyhounds that rate towards the end of the Time Grading table.

The Festival of Fire is an end of year celebration for the local industry, which provides fantastic opportunities across the entire spectrum of racing classes, across all three distances at Angle Park, the home of SA greyhound racing.

The Festival of Fire series will commence on the racenight of Thursday December 14, continue into the Saturday morning timeslot [December 16] and then culminate in 5 finals and a special stayers event carrying a collective purse in excess of \$100,000 the following Thursday night [December 21].

Conditions -

- Greyhounds must be SA trained.
- Greyhounds must be in South Australia as of midnight 1st November 2023 to be eligible (greyhounds that have not had their first training amendment lodged that are in SA at this time will be eligible). For those greyhounds that have left the state prior to this date however are considered SA based on the Nationals criteria of 76 days out of 150 days prior to close of nominations for each event will be eligible.
- All races will be Non Penalty

JUNE'S GRADING REVIEW PANEL MEETING OUTCOMES – MAIN POINTS

- GRSA will allow one extra Grade 6 over another distance for City A Thursday meetings bringing this into line with all tracks in SA. No retrospectivity regarding this change. Implemented• GRSA has removed the condition where once a greyhound has won a Grade 5 or higher event on a City A meeting that the greyhound will lose all Grade 6 events at all other tracks. This means a greyhound could be a Grade 4 or Grade 3 over 530m on a Thursday City A meeting and will still be able to win Grade 6 events at other tracks. No retrospectivity regarding this change. Implemented
- GRSA will now allow a greyhound after winning a Grade 5 Masters event in faster time than the time standard to get back into Masters with 2 runs in a Grade 5 at the track and distance, it doesn't matter if they are placed or unplaced just so long as there are two starts out of Masters. This has been changed from being just unplaced to get back. Implemented

VACCINATION RULE FOR RACING IN SA

Trainers are reminded that Rule 25 [Minimum Vaccination Requirements] took effect Monday, 1st May. Vaccination Certificates must be received by GRSA prior to close of nominations for affected greyhounds to be considered eligible.

ONLINE NOMINATIONS TO BE UPDATED WITH VACCINATION DETAILS OF GREYHOUNDS

OzChase will update the currency of the Greyhound's vaccination and will be displayed within Online Nominations shortly. Each Greyhound on the Currently Trained list of a trainer will include a new column displaying the latest vaccination date recorded.

It will be colour coded according to the condition outlined below:

GRSA will advise an implementation date which will assist trainers manage R25 and the Vaccination requirements.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month.

These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner & \$150 to the Breeder.

At the ICG meeting in January the SA Bred Bonus scheme was tabled for discussion where when we have 200 or more SA bred winners we go over budget and there is no monthly payment for the Owner of Breeder separate to the \$225. It was discussed that this was happening more regularly with more racing and more SA Bred greyhounds winning events. It was suggested increasing the base amount from \$225 and removing monthly payments, therefore, reducing monthly administration of the scheme. The Board advised changes to be implemented from 1 July 2023, however, kept the base amount at \$225 due to the increased numbers and racing opportunities. Due to this change the SA bred winners will no longer be listed in Kennel Capers each month.

For the month of July there were 203 winners, August there were 197, September there were 196 and October 226 (we are 22 winners over budget)

CURRENT MASTERS TIMES AND POLICY

- For greyhounds 3¾ years and older. 4yo and older will get preference. City A, City B and Prov 1 meetings are done by form for 4yo and older and then greyhounds will only get in from under 4yo to 3¾ yo in age from oldest to youngest. Prov 2 meetings are all done on age from oldest to youngest regardless of w for all ages.
- Dates are exact so going back 4yo and 3¾ from the date of race. le date of race run on 20/11/22 4yo would be 20/11/18 whelping.
- Time restrictions if a greyhound wins a Grade 5 Masters race in a faster time than published and it will have to have 2 runs (placed or unplaced) in normal company at that class of meeting before being eligible at that class of meeting.

- •The Grader will look to grade a Grade 5 Masters event on every program over a distance if enough dogs are nominated regardless if it is advertised in the All Tracks calendar.
- All races Non Penalty.

If a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading.

If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs, only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters (ie Grade 2/3 & 4) we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event.

305m Masters Policy for Mt Gambier – With Mt Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events, however, factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance.

There will still be a Time Standard applied based on the published table being 17.75. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week.

The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.



We remind all participants that while GRSA integrity and welfare teams are authorised to make unannounced inspections of licenced premises, they will always identify themselves on site.

We strictly adhere to regulations and do not use hidden cameras. Therefore, should you see unidentified people, cameras or drones on your property, and you believe them to be trespassing, we remind you to immediately contact SAPOL on 131 444.

We would also advise you to contact the GRSA Welfare team on 0438 703 038. GRSA cannot make a police complaint on your behalf, nor can we prosecute outside of the rules of racing.

However, we will offer whatever assistance we can within our remit as the governing body for greyhound racing in South Australia.

Furthermore, should you come across online vision or images that you believe to be of a licensed premise, we ask that you forward it to GRSA rather than commenting on it or responding to it on your own platforms.

As a representative of our industry, your actions and words matter and it's important that you are seen to be taking the appropriate steps, rather than sharing views online.

This is particularly critical now, while GRSA continues to engage with the South Australian Government's independent inquiry into greyhound racing.

FIRST POINT ASSESSMENTS

There is now an updated placement form that participants will receive upon a greyhound passing a First Point Assessment [FPA]; this placement form means that no retirement form will be required **ONLY** if they are retiring a dog through GAP. The placement form only requires one signature from either the responsible person of the care and custody of the greyhound, the owner or the ownership/syndicate group manager. Once the form has been returned and the placement fee paid, this will be processed alongside the retirement of the dog. Participants will still also need to return the papers and/or cards for the relevant greyhound. All other types of retirement will still be required to complete and return the 106R 'Notification of Retirement Form', this new process is for dogs going through the GAP SA program only.

WELFARE NEWS

Claudia Harward has now transitioned into a new role as 'Welfare and Rehoming Support Officer', alongside her usual duties with GAP, she will now assist with admin for the Welfare Team.

Reminder that participants should contact welfare on the mobile 0438 703 038 if they need to report anything and it is the best contact to reach the welfare team on n case of questions or in an emergency.

Also, a reminder that with the warmer season coming up, that participants should have their bush fire plans ready to go, and also a plan in case of snake bites or extreme weather. The welfare team will continue to have a strong focus on cooling conditions being compliant before we reach the extreme hot weather.

Any participant lodging a retirement or GAP placement form, are kindly reminded that if they do not receive a confirmation, or receipt of payment – we kindly ask that you follow up with the relevant department, and not leave it weeks/months before following up that it has been received.

Participants are assuming that paperwork is being received on our end but are in fact sending it to the wrong emails or via post and it's not coming through for processing.

TRACK INJURY REBATES

To make processing of Track Injury Rebates (TIRs) more efficient, please ensure the following is submitted with the form; TIRs application form, vet history from relevant clinic, and PAID invoice from veterinary clinic. Please also make sure that the application form is filled out correctly and includes the on-track vet (OTV) or steward signature on the application form, vet signature who provided medical care relating to the injury, and responsible person's signature and details. The application and policy can be found on the GRSA website at Track Injury Rebate (greyhoundracingsa.com.au)



Greyhound of the Month for October was Adhana Rico for trainer Ashlee Griffiths, who capped of a brilliant month of racing with the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup win in late October.

The son of Fernando Bale and Bella Rico had three starts for the month with one win and one placing but all of his performances were at the highest level. After winning a Heat of the Adelaide Cup in late September he produced a wonderful performance in the Group 1 Final to finish 4th, only 2 lengths from star chaser Transponder on SA 's night of nights. He then went off to Gawler for the Group 3 series at the northern venue and didn't have a lot of luck in his Heat running a close second and qualifying for the Final. He drew perfectly in box 1 for the Group 3 feature and showed determination to rail hard on the first turn and move to second. In a stirring battle he was able to run down star Victorian, Stout Monelli, in the shadows of the post to claim an emotional win for connections.

At the end of the month Adhana Rico's record stood at 55 starts for 14 wins and 21 placings and earnings around \$115,000.



The Run of the Month for October was the Tim Aloisi trained Zipping Neutron for his brilliant win at Gawler on Sunday, 23rd October over the 643m journey in a Heat of the Bothing Gawler Stayers Cup. A red hot favourite for the series Zipping Neutron began well from box 4 and raced near the lead during the early stages before he powered to the front mid race to open up an unassailable lead. He raced away from his rivals to win by over 5 lengths, however, the time recorded was breathtaking. He ran 36.92 which was only .11 outside superstar Bothing's track record set in 2006 which the series is named after. By all reports he is the only greyhound to break the magical 37 seconds barrier since the track record was set 17 years ago.

Please call GAP SA on 8243 7124 on the booking day as early as possible to book your dogs in for assessment. You will also need to bring the greyhound's identification card with you on the day.

Greyhounds should not be raced or trialled within the 10 days prior to assessment.

Please remember to book in your greyhound's vet work AFTER you submit the GAP placement form.

Payment of placement fees

The \$60 placement fee is due at the time the placement form is submitted, payment can be made by either completing the card details on the form or by paying in cash. The placement form will only be processed, and the greyhound placed in GAP, once payment has been received

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

We continue to look to increase these further in order to offer a wider variety of times to meet participants varying requirements. The following graph depicts the number of assessments that have been occurring on a monthly basis.

VET CLINICS

To clarify for GAP Works (sterilization, dental work, vaccinations & health checks) that are required once a greyhound has been placed into the GAP program, the preference for participants are that they use and book with Angle Park, Adelaide Plains or Gambier Vets in the first instance.

If other clinics would like to be used for participants i.e. Blake's Crossing, Blue Lake, or Limestone Vet clinics, these clinics are still able to be booked into for GAP works,

HOWEVER, participants must contact GAP and seek prior authorization **BEFORE** booking at these clinics. For foster care, emergency care or other situations, any clinic can be utilized in order to meet the welfare and best interests of any greyhound within our industry.

Please note for any GAP works prior notice of 24-48 hours is required to be given to GAP before the vet appointment takes place, this allows us to send through the relevant paperwork in time to ensure that the costs are covered by GAP.

GAP UPDATES

GREEN COLLAR ASSESSMENTS AT FIRST POINTS

As of November 2021, GAP Supervisor Jemma Nicholson was certified as a Greyhound Green Collar Assessor by the Dog and Cat Management Board of South Australia. In conjunction with this, former manager Katalin Orosz and Jemma Nicholson worked with the DCMB to change Greyhound Legislation to remove the mandatory foster care period for greyhounds prior to adoption. Because of this, greyhounds in South Australia are able to be Green Collar Assessed prior to rehoming and therefore can undergo their Muzzle Exemption Testing at the time of their First Point Assessment.

The components of the assessment include:

1. Small Dog Interaction Assessment

Must be able to interact appropriately unmuzzled

2. Physical Handling Assessment

Must be ok with ears, paws, tail being touched as well as a 'hug' test and eye contact stare test

3. Food Handling Assessment

Must be ok with assessor holding food bowl and touching greyhound whilst eating

Please note: the food bowl is not taken away from the greyhound to minimise risk of resource guarding behaviours*

When greyhounds pass their Muzzle Exemption Assessment during First Points, they are then advertised for 'Supported Adoption' rather than foster care and will go into an adoptive home to eliminate double handling. Supported Adoption is essentially the same as 'fosterto-adopt' except the greyhound has already passed their Green Collar Assessment and is not required to wear their muzzle out in public or return to GAP for this assessment. GAP SA will support families in transitioning their greyhounds into their homes as well as providing the essentials that they need for this period.

These greyhounds still require some assistance transitioning show that they can be great with young children and other into the home with regards to learning the environment due to not being fostered prior but are not required to wear a muzzle due to being comfortable and wellmannered around other dogs. As they come straight from the racing environment, they may not have had as much exposure as those who have been fostered but this is a beautiful journey and also makes relationship bonding that little bit more special!

It is important to note that greyhounds who have passed their Green Collar Assessment at the First Point are still required to wear a muzzle out in public and are not Muzzle Exempt until they receive their Green Collar and Certificate from GAP SA which is only given to the **Registered Owner***

PET PREP PROGRAM

Jayne Jarman and Bec McAuley-Fry are now offering socialisation and training sessions to assist trainers with greyhounds that are struggling to be rehomed. This includes greyhounds with higher prey-drive, poor lead manners and/or anxiety and confidence issues. Jayne and Bec will introduce greyhounds to a home environment, socialise them with a variety of other breeds and cats (if suitable) and also be taken on excursions for new environment exposure.

They have worked with several greyhounds already and so far and results have proven very successful with confidence building, socialisation and mannerism improvement.

When GAP advertise greyhounds for foster or adoption, it helps to have personality traits and quirks mentioned to help promote the dog's character and make them more appealing to families. You can provide this information to the GAP Assessors during first points but this is another benefit of the Socialisation Sessions as Jayne and Bec will provide GAP with information and details on each greyhound they work with to add to their online profiles as well as cute photos which are always a winner!

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

- 1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
- 3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

- For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
- For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
 - Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
- At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

RACING REPORT

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.


