

New event headlines 2024 Festival of

Now in its fourth year, the Festival of Fire is back and bigger than ever in 2024, with a new event added to the two-week year-end celebration of South Australian greyhound racing.

This year's series will see The Ember added to the Festival of Fire program and will offer our short course specialists a terrific opportunity to take part in the newest and most exciting fortnight on the South Australian racing calendar.

Run over the 342m distance, the Ember will see our best 16 nominations take part heading towards a \$10,000 final as part of the Festival of Fire finals nights on Thursday, December 19th.

The Festival of Fire is a year end celebration for the local industry, which provides fantastic opportunities across the entire spectrum of racing classes, now across all four distances at Angle Park, the home of SA greyhound racing.

Once again, the 'Festival of Fire' series will provide opportunities for the best 48 nominations for the 530m trip, the best 16 nominations over 595m and the best 8 nominations for a 730m event.

There will also be heats and final of a restricted event (0-5 wins) running from Saturday morning to Thursday night which will provide a separate opportunity for that category of runner. There will also be a 530m Time Graded event for those greyhounds that rate towards the end of the Time Grading table.

The Festival of Fire series will commence on the race night of Thursday December 12, continue into the Saturday morning timeslot (December 14) and then culminate in 6 finals and a special stayers event carrying a collective purse in excess of \$110,000 the following Thursday night (December 19).

Conditions –

- Greyhounds must be SA trained.
- Greyhounds must be in South Australia as of midnight 1st November 2024 to be eligible (greyhounds that have not had their first training amendment lodged that are in SA at this time will be eligible). For those greyhounds that have left the state prior to this date however are considered SA based on the Nationals criteria of 76 days out of 150 days prior to close of nominations for each event will be eligible but still must be SA trained for the series.
- All races will be Non Penalty

THE ASHES (530M) – Best 16 Nominated – Selected by the GRSA Grader – No Reserves –

Maidens Ineligible – Maximum of Two Heats – Guarding applies for Heats

Heats Thursday 12th December (Open City A Prizemoney) – Final Thursday 19th December (1st \$20,000, 2nd 5,800, 3rd 2,900)

THE INFERNO (530M) – For those greyhounds not selected for The Ashes and not selected for The Flame. Best 32 Nominated on Time Rating with Reserves – Maidens are Ineligible – Maximum of Four Heats - Selection of Heats will be Guarded and Separated under normal Heat and Final rules. If same Time Rating most race wins go in and then most prizemoney go in and then by Graders Discretion).

Heats Thursday 12th December (Grade 5 City A Prizemoney) – Final Thursday 19th December (1st \$12,500, 2nd 3,650, 3rd 1,825)

THE FLAME (530M) – Lowest Ranked 32 Nominated on Time Rating – With Reserves -Maidens are Ineligible – Maximum Four Heats Guarding Applies. Selection of Heats will be Guarded and Separated under normal Heat and Final rules. If same Time Rating greyhounds with the least race wins go in then the least amount of prizemoney go in and then by Graders Discretion. Greyhounds must have had atleast one race start over 455m or further in the last 3 months prior to close of nominations to be eligible.

Heats Thursday 12th December (Grade 6 City A Prizemoney) – Final Thursday 19th December (1st \$10,000, 2nd 2,900, 3rd 1,450)

*Reserves may be the same for Inferno and Flame, preference if a scratching will be given to Inferno series. The Grader reserves the right to formulate the Reserves as required with the view to providing opportunities for all greyhounds where possible.

Remaining events determined by nominations received for other events.

*If All Heats Are Taken Then GRSA Will Allow Any 730m Greyhound Nominated For This Night To Solo Trial In Preparation For The Blaze On Thursday 19th December however GRSA will also program a Stayers event at Angle Park on Saturday.

SATURDAY 14TH DECEMBER

THE SPARK (530M) – Best 64 Nominated (0-5 Wins Only) – Selected by the GRSA Grader With Reserves – Maidens are Eligible – Maximum of Eight Heats – Guarding of Heats apply (Greyhounds are not Eligible if have a race start on Thursday 12th December).

Heats Saturday 14th December (Open City B Prizemoney) – Final Thursday 19th December (1st \$10,000, 2nd 2,900, 3rd 1,450)

(NEW EVENT) THE EMBER (342M) – Best 16 Nominated – Selected by the GRSA Grader – With Reserves – Maidens Ineligible – Maximum of Two Heats – Guarding applies for Heats (Greyhounds are not eligible if have a race start on Thursday 12th December).

Heats Saturday 14th December (Open City B Prizemoney) – Final Thursday 19th December (1st \$7,000, 2nd 2,000, 3rd 1,000)

Remaining events determined by nominations received for other events if required.

THE BLAZE (730M) – Open Event– Selected by the GRSA Grader – With Reserves – Maidens Ineligible

Thursday 19th December – Best 8 (1st \$10,000, 2nd 2,900, 3rd 1,450, Unplaced \$400)

Finals – The Ashes, The Inferno, The Bonfire, The Flame ,The Spark and The Ember.

Remaining events determined by nominations received for other events.

NEW SA LOCAL RULE – L47A

From October 3, 2024, GRSA introduced a new local rule 47A: fairness in greyhound racing. From July 2, 2024, GRSA released a proposed local rule for wider industry consultation. That proposed local rule followed NSW local rule 166A: lay betting, with added provisions to prescribe other unlawful conduct relating to racing. GRSA appreciated the input from various industry members and, consequently, will review the proposed, added provisions. The new local rule 47A, from October 3, 2024, only relates to lay betting (and not the proposed added provisions from the consultation version). This local rule 47A follows the NSW local rule and is consistent with the Ashton Review recommendation 18: "GRSA introduce a local rule prohibiting participants from lay betting on any greyhounds racing at South Australian tracks". Local rule 47A is:

Local Rule 47A Fairness in Greyhound Racing

- [1] The objectives of this rule are to maintain the integrity and fairness of greyhound racing, to prevent corruption, and to protect the welfare of the greyhounds. Any conduct contrary to these objectives will not be tolerated.
- (2) This rule is read in conjunction with, and expanding, R166 of the Greyhounds Australasia Rules.
- (3) A person, being a trainer, will be guilty of an offence if the person:
- (a) places a bet on a greyhound, other than a greyhound trained by that person, in a race in which they have a starter;
- (b) places any type bet on a greyhound, other than a greyhound trained by that persons, in a race to finish ahead of a greyhound they train in the race;
- (c) has a bet placed on their behalf on a greyhound in a race to finish ahead of their own greyhound; or(d) receives any benefit in any way connected with the laying of their greyhound by another person.



SAFE CHASE LURE INSTALLED AT GAWLER IN EARLY DECEMBER

GRSA will be upgrading the lure system at the Gawler venue to the Safe Chase lure which is already successfully in use at Angle Park and the Murray Bridge Straight Track. This upgrade is set for the first two weeks of December, enhancing safety, performance, and reliability for everyone involved.

To facilitate the installation, significant testing and prepare for return to racing, Gawler will pause both racing and trialling for a period. Please note the following changes:

FISCHER MOTORS MURRAY BRIDGE SUMMER DERBY AND OAKS IN DECEMBER

Both the Summer Oaks and Summer Derby to be run in December are again proudly sponsored by Fischer Motors. Along with the sponsorship the Club has kept both races at \$7,500 each and added a \$1000 bonus for the trainer of each Final if they are a member of the MBGRC.

PREFERENTIAL BOX DRAWS AT MURRAY BRIDGE STRAIGHT TRACK

GRSA are conducting Preferential Box Draws for selected events at the Murray Bridge Straight track meetings [Maidens, Feature Cup and Championship series are excluded]. These type of events are being regularly programmed Interstate under each state's conditions. Events will be specifically advertised, and trainers must advise if they want to compete in these events along with the racing trait of the respective greyhound at the time of nominating in the comments box. If trainers do not provide this information when nominating, they will not be considered for these advertised PBD events.

Conditions -

- PBD racing introduced for advertised race events at the Murray Bridge Straight track from August 1, 2024
- Three racing traits R = Rail, M = Middle, W = Wide
- The Trainer nominates the racing trait of the greyhound relating to box rise and 50m after the start

- This is reviewed by Stewards/Grading teams
- Box draws via OzChase which can now accommodate an automated process where greyhounds can be grouped by trait and then automatically box drawn
- Grading of each race event will be done under normal grading and programming guidelines
- There will be NO Reserves for these events

CURRENT MASTERS TIMES AND POLICY

- For greyhounds 3¾ years and older. 4yo and older will get preference. City A, City B and Prov 1 meetings are done by form for 4yo and older and then greyhounds will only get in from under 4yo to 3¾ yo in age from oldest to youngest. Prov 2 meetings are all done on age from oldest to youngest regardless of form for all ages.
- Dates are exact so going back 4yo and 3¾ from the date of race. le date of race run on 20/11/22 4yo would be 20/11/18 whelping.
- Time restrictions if a greyhound wins a Grade 5 Masters race in a faster time than published and it will have to have 2 runs (placed or unplaced) in normal company (if in a Mixed Masters and wins and runs faster than the time standard then will NOT count) at that class of meeting before being eligible at that class of meeting.
- The Grader will look to grade a Grade 5 Masters event on every program over a distance if enough dogs are nominated regardless if it is advertised in the All Tracks calendar.
- All races Non Penalty.

If a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading. If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters [ie Grade 2/3 & 4] we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event.

305m Masters Policy for Mt Gambier – With Mt Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events, however, factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance. There will still be a Time Standard applied based on the published table

being 17.75. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week. The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.

3-5 Heats - 2 Semis

6-7 Heats – 3 Semis

8 Heats - 4 Semis

MAIDEN SELECTION CRITERIA

As determined through the Grading Review Panel the entry criteria for Maidens into an event will be Order of Preference, Maidens with a placing in their last two starts using WPS, first starters then other Maidens using WPS.

GRADING UPDATE REMINDERS

- GRSA allow one extra Grade 6 over another distance for City A Thursday meetings bringing this into line with all tracks in SA.
- GRSA removed the condition where once a greyhound has won a Grade 5 or higher event on a City A meeting that the greyhound will lose all Grade 6 events at all other tracks. This means a greyhound could be a Grade 4 or Grade 3 over 530m on a Thursday City A meeting and will still be able to win Grade 6 events at other tracks.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED "ONLY"

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds. The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race] If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue. For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds. A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting. VACCINATION RULE FOR RACING IN SA – REMINDER

Trainers are reminded that Rule 25 (Minimum Vaccination Requirements) took effect Monday, 1st May, 2023. Vaccination Certificates must be received by GRSA prior to close of nominations for affected greyhounds to be considered eligible for nominating. It is also imperative that once the greyhound has been vaccinated the paperwork is lodged by yourself as soon as possible. Trainers are also reminded that they must not have their greyhound vaccinated within 5 days of racing. Should this occur, the greyhound will be scratched from its engagement or if paperwork lodged

after an engagement and discovered the greyhound raced inside the 5 days then the matter will be referred to the stewards.

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month.

These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner and \$150 to the Breeder.

The SA Bred Bonus scheme is continuing to go over budget with the number of SA Bred winners increasing. This meant that last financial year we went over budget by \$6,750 (30 winners). So far, this financial year in July 2024 there were 224, August 212, September 178 and October 228 meaning we are 42 winners over budget [\$9,450].

Pet Detective wins Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup

TRAINER Ben Rawlings has had one of the best nights of his training career with Pet Detective winning the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup on Sunday 27th October.

After winning four of the five heats, Rawlings held a strong hand in the final with his up and comer Pet Detective winning the race while kennel mates Fear The Dragon and Lone Rooster rounded out the top three.

Pet Detective was arguably the least fancied of the Rawlings runners, with the May 2022 whelping only stepping up to open company for the first time during the series.

Jumping from box seven, Pet Detective crossed to land second down the back and was able to fend off the challengers with a strong run home, winning in 30.96

The Group 3 success was a third feature in recent weeks for Pet Detective, who won the Kings & Queens final at Angle Park in early September before winning the SA Country Cup on Adelaide Cup night in October.

The continual improvement gives Rawlings high hopes for Pet Detective heading into the future.

"He's just turned a corner and he just doesn't give up this dog now," Rawlings said after the race.

"To serve it up to them and go past and run away like he did. It was a fair run, he's improved a lot."

It was a special night for Rawlings qualifying four runners through to the finals with all hands on deck to help box and catch greyhounds including partner Ashleigh, father and new Angle Vale Football Coach Neil and mum Tanya.

"Normally, it would just be me and one person catching so to have everyone involved and to have them all after the race made it all that better," Rawlings said.

"I have a lot of support, and everyone wanted to be involved and that means a lot."



This year's Gawler Gold Cup was sponsored by Peter Kittle Toyota who were on board for the first time as naming rights partner. Managing Director Brendan Eime, joined Member for Light Tony Piccolo in the presentation.

"At Peter Kittle, we are all about being engaged in the local community and supporting the local events and we are excited to be apart of the Gawler Gold Cup this year," Eime said post-race.

With a healthy crowd on course and perfect weather, locals were treated to a terrific card of racing with several other features on the program.

In race two on the card, Cash On Delivery made it back back wins in the Gawler Sprint Classic with an excellent win over the 400m journey.

From box seven, Cash On Delivery speared the boxed with a sensational 8.52 first split to find the lead and proved too hard to chase down in winning in 22.45. It was career win number 44 at start number 67 and continues his reign as one of the state's best short course greyhounds.

Black Silencer for Tim Aloisi claimed the Bothing Stayers Cup over the long-distance trip of 643m leading most the way from a box one draw in winning in 37.28.

A relative newcomer to South Australia, Black Silencer franked recent good form at Angle Park with a strong showing in the final which is named for Gawler 643m track record holder Bothing, whose record has stood for close to 20 years.





Greyhound of the Month for October was Pet Detective for trainer Ben Rawlings, he was undefeated throughout the month winning all four of his events, with the highlight being a super win in the Group 3 Peter Kittle Toyota Gawler Gold Cup Final on Sunday, 27th October.

The locally bred son of Fernando Bale and Tangelo Fire started the month off with a slick 30.51 win at headquarters over the 530m in Mixed 4/5 company before returning to headquarters for the SA Country Cup Final where he represented Gawler in fine style winning a very strong edition of the series in a handy 30.70.

Next on the agenda was the Gawler Cup series where he ran a strong race to win his Heat in 31.01 before stepping out in the Final. After drawing box 7 in the Final many thought his chances would be reduced, however, showing his customary early pace, he was able to offset the wide draw and race handy on the speed before drawing away for a resounding victory.

He ran 30.96 in winning by just over 2 lengths and established himself as one of our top local sprinters.

At the end of the month Pet Detective's record stood at 29 starts for 16 wins and 9 placings and earnings just over \$65,000.



The Run of the Month for October was the Robyn Mackellar trained Euler Bale for the third month in a row, this time breaking the track record at Gawler on Sunday, 13th October.

The son of Dyna Villa and Dyna Winter ran a blistering 22.07 and lowering the previous mark by around 1½ lengths when he was able to lead throughout over the 400m journey.

Nose Print Technology set to be implemented

Greyhound Racing SA is collaborating with Greyhound Welfare & Integrity Commission (GWIC) and IsciLabs on world-leading nose print technology as the new form of secondary identification at race meetings.

With the phasing out of ear branding for all greyhounds from November 1 2024, the nose print recognition technology will become the new identification method on race nights while current methods of marking and microchipping will also continue.

The technology uses artificial intelligence to capture and identify the unique ridge impressions in the nose of the greyhound and is 99.97% accurate, or the same as a human fingerprint.

As well as continue to provide a strong and robust level of racing integrity, the technology will also provide 'real time' check-in proof of life scan capabilities and also allows for post rehoming check in as well.

GRSA will continue to provide information to participants as more information on this technology and the rollout in the near future.

STAYING SAFE AROUND THE LURE

This Toolbox Safety Talk is about staying safe around the lure. Always stay vigilant and follow directions to prevent accidents and injuries.

Some important points:

1. Understand the Lure

The lure is a mechanical device that travels along the path of the inner racetrack rail, controlled by a lure driver. The lure can travel very fast and is relatively quiet. The lure can start, stop and change its speed at any time and without warning.

2. The Trial

Before the use of a lure at a trial, you must listen to, or read, this safety briefing and note the warning signs on the racetrack. Only use the gates to move between areas. Never use the lure chute on the catching pen gate as a thoroughfare. Where chains are in place to stop movement, do not move them without direction.

3. Wear Proper Clothing

You must always wear a visible vest or clothing when you are near the track. Clothing must be suitable for physical work.

4. Stay Clear of Moving Parts

You must never walk onto the racetrack (sand) surface unless under direction and supervision of a GRSA official. You must never approach the lure, or approach or stand in the path of travel of the lure, which is within 1.5-metres of the inner rail.

5. Communication is Key

If you ever see something that you think is a hazard, while the lure is moving, yell out –

STOP LURE. STOP LURE. STOP LURE.

6. Be Aware of Surroundings

Stay alert to your surroundings. Avoid distractions like mobile phones or personal conversations that might divert your attention from the lure.

Remember, your safety and the safety of those around you are of utmost importance. By following these guidelines and respecting the rules and directions around the lure, we can create a safer and more productive environment for everyone.

Thank you for your attention, and let's all work together to stay safe!

Please remember to book in your greyhound's vet work AFTER you submit the GAP placement form.

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

We continue to look to increase these further in order to offer a wider variety of times to meet participants varying requirements. The following graph depicts the number of assessments that have been occurring on a monthly basis.

Payment of placement fees

The \$60 placement fee is due at the time the placement form is submitted, payment can be made by either completing the card details on the form or by paying in cash. The placement form will only be processed, and the greyhound placed in GAP, once payment has been received





QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

- 1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
- 3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

- For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
- For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- 6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- 9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave.
 - Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
- 10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.

Thinking of making changes to your kennels?

Some changes to your kennels may need Council approval.


