#### FROM THE CEO'S DESK

#### **Murray Bridge**

The Club has opened applications for membership and I would encourage any or all participants who are likely to have a regular involvement with the track to get involved. A resolution will shortly be put to the Members for the Club to be admitted into membership of the Company.

# 20-year wait worth it for Gold Cup winner Tony

#### GAWLER

IT was a big night for Gifford Hill greyhound trainer Tony Rasmussen on Sunday, as his dog Honcho Monelli took out the \$36,000 Gawler Gold Cup.

In a wet race, Honcho Monelli, from box one, raced to the finish line ahead of kennel-mate Shima Breeze, and Pyredos Monelli, which is trained by Ben Rawlings.

Honcho Monelli, the \$2.30 favourite, shot to the front from the start, with Highbury Hustle (box four), and Shima Breeze (box three) trailing just behind.

After the first bend, it was a two-dog race between Honcho Monelli and Shima Breeze. However, Honcho Monelli charged away down the straight to victory.

Speaking to The Bunyip post-race, Rasmussen was delighted to win the Gawler Gold Cup – his second cup of the year.

"It feels really good," he said. "We've tried for the past 20 years to win a Gawler Gold Cup and a Strathalbyn Cup, and we got them both this year."

Moving into the 2019 season, Rasmussen said it's business as usual.

"We've got some young ones coming through, we're buying a few more dogs," he said.

"We're going to see what happens, you just have to play it by ear. You could be up one day, down the next, the wheel goes round and round.

"We're going to carry on training a heap of dogs."

During a brief speech, Rasmussen highlighted the importance of family, and especially his wife, Lisa.

"Me and Lisa have been together now for 35 years, we've been training dogs for 21 years," he said.

"Together, as a team, we've done a real good job."

Honcho Monelli wasn't the Rasmussen family's only win on the night, with heavy favourite Cappuccino taking out race two, and Zinnia Monelli claiming the final race of the night.

Meanwhile, Finniss-based trainer Lauren Harris celebrated a double, with Farmin in race nine and heavily backed Stack the Aces in race six.

Lewiston-based trainer Nicole Newlyn also had a successful night, with outside chance Discounter taking out the first race of the night, before underdog Tan On Black won race 11.











# Shima Breeze claims final Strath Cup

#### STRATHALBYN

After five terrific heats the \$14,350 Daish Irrigation & Fodder Strathalbyn Cup final gave trainer Tony Rasmussen his first win in the event after more than 20 years trying when Shima Breeze scored in the final meeting ever to be run at the Southern Greyhound Raceway on October 21st.

In front of a huge crowd for the final meeting and with warm conditions the daughter of Fernando Bale and Simaguni was heavily supported prior to the event with up to \$18 fixed odds available when markets opened however when the boxes flew open she started at \$5. She began brilliantly from box 6 with kennel mate Shimando beginning just as fast from box 5 giving her a great run across the field with both leading easily to the first turn. Race favourite Spring Bridge for Greg Board began well from box 8 and was able to slot in midfield early while kennel mate and last years winner Spring Bloom began ordinary and found herself back in the pack. Reiko Rocketta for Troy Murray also slotted in well to be just off the pace early. Down the back straight, Shima Breeze ran to the lead and looked all over a winner with Spring Bridge running into second and giving chase while Reiko Rocketta ran to third. As heads turned for home Shima Breeze had a big enough break to hang on and win an emotional victory for connections in a slick 31.07. She won by 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> lengths from Spring Bridge which again had no luck in a feature race finishing second while Reiko Rocketta continued her excellent form finishing third a further 1/2 length away.

Shima Breeze is owned by Tim Aloisi and Matt Lehman and with the \$10,000 first prize, she has amassed prizemoney of almost \$30,000 in 19 starts which include 7 wins and 8 placings.

The other feature on the night was the Strathalbyn Cup consolation which was taken out by Silver Timothy for trainer Lauren Harris and the last ever race conducted at the venue was won by Zoometrical trained by John Sargent.

The Southern Greyhound Raceway at Strathalbyn is now closed in readiness for racing in that region to transition over to the new \$8.5 million dual track facility at Murray

Bridge. Their Cup meeting signalled the end of a 47 year history at that Club but also marks the beginning of a new era of opportunity for southern participants and the broader industry in general.

When Strathalbyn opened in 1971, it became only the second registered track to race in South Australia after Whyalla, the latter having opened earlier that year after the Government had passed legislation to legalise gambling on greyhound racing. In that first instance, racing was conducted over two distances – 585 yards (535 metres) and 825 yards (754 metres). Despite being one of the oldest Clubs in the state, the Strathalbyn track was only promoted to the status of being a Sky venue for broadcast into hotels, agencies and homes from 2010.

The industry owes a debt of gratitude to the Strathalbyn Club for the role that it has played in keeping racing in that region strong and enabling the opportunity for future growth as a result of the Murray Bridge venture.

# **GOTBA Coursing Awards**

GOTBA will present their Annual Awards at Angle Park tonight (Thursday, 15th November). To be presented at the dais will be the SA Coursing Trainer of the Year.

Also featuring on the night will be a Free For All event for greyhounds which competed at Virginia during 2018. The race is supported by GOTBA and carries prizemoney of \$4,820. It will be race 8 on the program due to start at 9.07pm and has drawn together a high quality field. There will be a rug and trophy presentation after the event for this race.

# 2019 Gawler Produce nominations close Friday 16th

The 2019 Gawler Produce Stakes will be run by GRSA in conjunction with the Gawler Greyhound Racing Club. Once again, we will offer guaranteed Final Stakemoney, which will be \$22,000. The estimate for the total series prizemoney is \$40,000, based on this year's series. The series is for greyhounds whelped in 2017 regardless of where they were whelped.

In 2019 we will again be offering additional incentives for trainers to nominate. A bonus will be offered to any greyhound which can win both the Produce Stake and the Gawler Gold Cup. The jackpot will increase from \$6,000 to \$7,000 as Panhandle Slim did not take part in the Gawler Gold Cup.

The SA Bred bonus will also be continued; should the winner of the Final be SA Bred, there will be a bonus of \$1,000 to the owner and \$500 to the breeder.

#### The dates for this series will be:

Heats on Friday, 21st June 2019, Semi Finals on Friday, 28th June 2019 and the Final on Sunday, 7th July 2019 with a \$2,700 consolation event.

GRSA administers the event for the Club, so all payments are to be made to GRSA. The fees are, one-off payment option \$121.00 or the sustaining option at \$33 (first), \$55 (second) and \$88 (Final).

Nomination Forms are available, along with the full list of conditions and the payment schedule. Forms have been posted to those with eligible greyhounds.

The final part of this series will be the Gawler Classic 2018 to be run on 9th and 16th December 2018.

# Honcho Monelli takes out top award for October

Greyhound of the Month award for October went to the Tony Rasmussen trained Honcho Monelli who took out his third monthly award for the year and now looks the favourite for Greyhound of the Year honours.

Honcho Monelli started the month of in brilliant fashion winning a heat of the Group 1 Adelaide Cup in a slick 29.74 before starting one of the favourites in the final. He missed the kick in the Group 1 final but flashed home out wide to run a slashing third in the high quality feature. Towards the end of the month Honcho Monelli ventured to Gawler for the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup heats where he was sensational in running 30.63 for the 531m journey in winning by 6 lengths and would start as one of the shortest priced favourites for the final in recent history.

At the end of the month Honcho Monelli's record stood at 102 starts with 30 wins and 43 placings and earnings around \$168,000.



# Spring Bridge wins ROTM with Strath heat win

The Run of the Month for October was the Greg Board trained Spring Bridge for his sensational performance at Strathalbyn on Tuesday 16th October in a heat of the Strathalbyn Cup.

Starting a short priced favourite he began well from box 2 to surprisingly push through and lead on the first turn. From there it was just a matter of what kind of time the son of My Bro Fabio and Tina Lee ran. He blistered away from his rivals to win by almost 13 lengths running a sizzling 30.88 for the 536m journey which was only .17 outside of Right Time's track record set in 2013.

Spring Bridge has recently been sent to the kennels of star trainer Seona Thompson in Victoria winning on debut last Thursday night at Sandown in a prelude of the rich Melbourne Cup series and we wish the connections every success.

It will still be available during normal office hours to be used (greyhounds racing on that day excluded). Please ask the Racing Admin staff if you wish to use the mat.

# Super bonus for SA Bred from 1st January 2018

The super-bonus scheme is premised upon 100% dividend to breeders for SA Bred greyhounds. The following updates have been approved for implementation from 1st January 2018. The super bonus will only be paid out to breeders residing in South Australia.

The following is a summary of the bonus by race:

Adelaide Cup [515m] - G1 \$12,500, Adelaide Cup [515m] – 2ND \$5,000, Adelaide Cup [515m] – 3RD \$2,500, Adelaide Cup finalist \$1,000, BGC SA Derby [515m] – G3 \$3,500, BGC SA Derby [515m] – 2ND \$1,500, BGC SA Derby [515m] – 3RD \$750, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks[515m] – G3 \$3,500, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks[515m] – 2ND \$1,500, Coffex Coffee SA Oaks[515m] – 3RD \$750, Gawler Gold Cup [531m] - G3 \$5,000, Mount Gambier Cup [512m] - Listed \$2,500, Murray Bridge Cup [455m] - Listed \$2,500, Group 1 victory [interstate] \$10,000, Group 2 victory [interstate] \$5,000, Group 3 victory [interstate] \$2,500

### Naming applications

When lodging a Naming Application participants are advised to allow at least two weeks for the name to be approved from Greyhounds Australasia and then for GRSA to process the application and issue a greyhound card and weight card.

Therefore, should you wish to nominate the greyhound GRSA suggests that you lodge the Naming Application three weeks prior to nominating, this will give GA, GRSA and yourself enough time to name the greyhound, issue documentation and then for the trainer to have the greyhound "checked off" on a trial night. This time frame could be further extended if GA requires more name choices.

# Checking off of greyhounds at trials on Tuesdays & Wednesdays

Stewards have advised that the checking off of greyhounds to clear them to race will ONLY be conducted at trials on Tuesday nights and Wednesday nights.



# Handling greyhounds at the trials while lure in motion

# A reminder to participants that when on course for any trial sessions that the lure could be in motion at anytime.

Please be mindful of your surroundings and also with your greyhounds ensuring you have full control at all times.

### **Completion of paperwork**

#### Participants are reminded of their obligation to ensure that when lodging paperwork that it is fully completed and payment is made at the time of lodgement.

GRSA is here to assist should you be unsure of how to complete any paperwork however it is not our responsibility to arrange for its completion, nor is it our responsibility to ensure that it is lodged. Therefore, please ensure when lodging any paperwork eg, Transfer of Ownerships, Litter Registrations etc that they are fully completed and paid for (if payment required) and lodged within a timely manner.



### Notification of training amendment and clearance of greyhounds

# Trainers are reminded of their obligation to notify GRSA within 3 working days of a greyhound coming into or leaving their kennel (Rule 105(4)(i)).

This is a requirement for all greyhounds regardless of where bred. We have had a number of trainers recently put in training amendments late the night prior to nominations closing at 9am the following day. This practice can lead to your nomination not being accepted or being unable to nominate online should any issues arise the following morning.

Trainers are also leaving it to the night before nominations close to have greyhounds "checked off". This practice can also lead to your nomination not being accepted or being unable to nominate online should any issues arise.

It is therefore in the trainer's best interest to have lodged with GRSA the training amendment and clearance of the greyhound a number of days prior to wishing to nominate the greyhound. It is not GRSA's responsibility to ensure that the paperwork is processed within ½ hour, which is the amount of time available to have it processed before nominations close at 9am.



As Greyhound Racing SA (GRSA) is set to open the new Murray Bridge greyhound racing track in the next few weeks, participants will need to become familiar with the new facility. The following information seeks to provide participants with everything they need to know in regards to racing and trialling at the Murray Bridge Greyhound Racing Club.







### Getting to the track

The address of the new facility is 2 Kennett Road, Murray Bridge East. Participants travelling from the Adelaide direction can choose two different routes to get to the track.

The first is via the Murray Bridge town centre. Simply take the first Murray Bridge exit off the Princes Highway, then travel approximately 7km down Adelaide Road, through the town centre, cross the Murray River, then take a right turn into Kennett Road.

Alternatively, participants can avoid the Murray Bridge town centre by staying on the Princess Highway for an additional 9km, turning left onto Old Princess Highway and then traveling approximately 6km back to the west before turning left into Kennett Road. This route would also be for participants travelling from the south-east.



### **Travel times**

Participants should be aware of the following travel times (times and distances sourced from Google Maps, travel times may vary depending on the day and time of travel):

- Angle Park to Murray Bridge GRC 1 hour 17 minutes (89km)
  - Gawler to Murray Bridge GRC 1 hour 15 minutes (92km)
- Two Wells to Murray Bridge GRC 1 hour 45 minutes (120km)
- Port Augusta to Murray Bridge GRC
   4 hours 9 minutes [367km]
  - Barmera to Murray Bridge GRC 2 hour 12 minutes (207km)
  - Keith to Murray Bridge GRC 1 hour 36 minutes (152km)
- Mount Gambier to Murray Bridge GRC
   3 hour 47 minutes (361km)

### **Racing Information**

Racing at the new Murray Bridge facility will commence on the 1-turn track in December, with straight racing set to commence a couple of months later in February. The main reasoning for this staggered start is to allow for staff and participants to become familiar with the new facility and the logistics of race meetings and trial sessions. The delayed start to straight track racing will also allow for the completion of certain infrastructure including fencing, lure system and specialist broadcast and AV equipment.

### **1-Turn Track Details**

Participants visiting Murray Bridge will note the sheer size of the new 1-turn track in comparison to the existing tracks in SA. The 640-metre circumference of the circuit is substantially bigger than Angle Park (457m), Gawler (492m), Strathalbyn (443m) and Port Augusta (520m). The term '1-Turn' track (sometimes called horseshoe track) refers to the majority of racing occurring around the home bend.

The following table gives a rough indication of expected race times and splits at the new track:




### **Operational Areas**

Participants will need to quickly become familiar with the new venue for both race meetings and trial days. To assist in this process, the following map highlights the key areas that trainers should be aware of when bringing their greyhounds to the track.

The internals of the buildings should be very familiar to most participants, as their designs are based on facilities at the Gawler track. Participants enter the kennel house directly into the control area and it has a long hallway with 12 race kennel bays to the left. The wash bays are located on the verandah of the kennel house. The patron building is loosely based on the Gawler equivalent and will feel very familiar to participants. Whilst it is not a double storey building, it is still elevated above the race tracks and has great views of the tracks and surrounds.

The empty out area that will be used for the first few months will become a public access area in the long term, however the maintenance team will need to establish a decent cover of grass to the right of the trainer's carpark before the empty out area can be relocated.



### **Trialling Schedule**

Until the construction phase of the project has been completed, GRSA is unable to confirm the commencement of trialling Murray Bridge. Based on the current schedule, it is hoped that trialling will commence the week beginning Monday 26th November, 2018.

#### In the lead up to the first meeting on Wednesday 19th December, GRSA anticipates the following trialling schedule before race meetings commence:

# **Release of Stewards reports**

Stewards endeavour to ensure Stewards reports are uploaded to GRSA's website at the conclusion of each race meeting. Occasionally this may not be possible due to unfinished business arising from the race meeting.

Stewards advise reports will be posted when completed which is unlikely to extend beyond the following day.

# Hot weather

#### Now we have had our first taste of warm weather, all participants are reminded about the GRSA Hot Weather Policy, which is published within this edition.

GRSA will invest much time over the next few months monitoring weather conditions, attempting to move meetings to more suitable timeslots and keeping the industry updated.

The main points to remember from the Hot Weather Policy are:

- GRSA works off the Bureau of Meteorology temperature forecasts
- Trainers may scratch all runners engaged without penalty when the temperature is forecast to be 38°C at official scratching time
- When the temperature is forecast to be 32°C or above, the kennel house will be opened 30 minutes earlier than advertised, unless the meeting has been moved to the morning
- Barking muzzles are not permitted to be used at SA race tracks when the forecast temperature is to be 32°C or above

# **Receipt of 106 notifications**

Participants lodging official paperwork for 106 notifications of retirement or euthanasia are able to request that a copy is made for their own records when that paperwork is lodged via GRSA reception.

Forms submitted electronically will receive a receipt back that they have been lodged. At this time, GRSA is unable to provide this receipt service for forms lodged with officials at race meetings, trials or kennel inspections.

### Reminder lodgement of paperwork before Christmas

Given a few public holidays in late December and early January, all participants are reminded to submit any licence or pink card applications before 19th December to ensure they are processed in a timely manner.

#### **Inquiries and notifications**

**Mr. Robert Barclay** – Stewards inquiry 31/10/18 – GAR 84B[1] – Was in possession of a syringe on course without the permission of Stewards. Mr. Barclay pleaded guilty and was disqualified for six [6] months; with three [3] months suspended for 24 months on the basis that he does not reoffend under this Rule. Mr. Barclay has appealed the severity of the penalty and was not granted a stay of proceedings.

**Mr. Simon Gesler** – Stewards inquiry 22/10/18 – GAR 86(ag) – Failed to comply with The South Australian Greyhound Industry Animal Welfare Policy. Mr. Gesler was found guilty of the charge and was disqualified for six [6] months; wholly suspended for a period of 24 months on the basis that he does not reoffend under the Rule.

**Mr. Brian Weis** – Stewards inquiry 24/10/18 – GAR 83[2] – Failed to present the greyhound GINGER ROAD free of any prohibited substance (SALBUTAMOL) for an event at Mount Gambier on 24 June 2018. Mr. Weis pleaded not guilty and was disqualified for a period of six [6] months. GINGER ROAD was disqualified from the event.

# Lodgement of breeding documents

With the removal of fees for breeding documentation I remind participants of the due date for lodgement of documentation under the Rules of Greyhound Racing. It is imperative that these documents are still lodged on time so GRSA can plan for the future regarding greyhound population.

Notice of Service (within 14 days)

Whelping Notice (within 14 days)

Litter Registration (within 4 months)

To ensure documents are received by the due dates the following fines have been reviewed and have been increased and will be imposed should documentation be lodged late.

Due date to 4 weeks overdue - \$50

5 weeks to 8 weeks overdue - \$100

9 to 12 weeks overdue - \$150

13 to 16 weeks overdue - \$200

17 plus weeks overdue - \$250

# The Golden Rules

Since the introduction of cobalt and arsenic thresholds, all participants should be reminded – in their own best interests – that there are a number of Golden Rules that can help them to avoid making any such breaches (for prohibited substances generally) and which should be adhered to as principles of best practice:

- Always consult your vet to seek guidance in relation to any of the products that you are using, any associated risks and other relevant context
- Review the range of any feeds or supplements that you typically purchase and, wherever it is reasonable to do so, replace products containing substances that could contribute to a threshold breach under the rules (eg. cobalt) with alternative products
- Observe the instructions on any products that you use and adhere strictly to those directions (having regard for prescribed amounts, frequency of administration/ application, methodology for administering/applying)
- Ensure a greyhound is never administered any treatment on race day other than as relates to its feeding and drinking requirements (GAR83[A][1] treats this as a specific offence]
- Refrain from the use of injectable treatments (eg. Vitamin B12) to any extent that is practical, including ensuring a greyhound is not administered any injectables the day before an event

Our registered participants have the responsibility to ensure that greyhounds are presented to the track free of any prohibited substances. This information is offered as advice in good faith and should not be relied on as a defence in the event of a breach occurring.

**Hot Weather Policy**

Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) is committed to animal welfare. Like all animals, greyhounds can be affected by hot weather. The main form of cooling for canines is through panting. In an attempt to limit the effect of heat on greyhounds, GRSA has implemented this policy to ensure greyhounds are properly cared for during hot weather.

#### CANCELLATION OF MEETINGS:

GRSA will always attempt to move race meetings to a more suitable timeslot.

#### TABMEETINGS – Forecast 40°C or above

Morning meetings on days for which the predicted temperature is forecast to be 40°C or above at 8.00am will continue as scheduled but may still be called off, delayed, cancelled or abandoned at the discretion of the Stewards and in consultation with the on-course Veterinarian.

Day and Twilight meetings will be abandoned if the predicted temperature is forecast to be 40°C or above at 8:00am on the morning of the scheduled event. Day and Twilight meetings are race meetings scheduled to start after 11.00am (Day) and before 5:00pm (Twilight).

Night meetings on days for which the predicted temperature is forecast to be 40° C or above at 8:00am will continue as scheduled but may still be called off, delayed, cancelled or abandoned at the discretion of the Stewards and in consultation with the on-course Veterinarian.

If a Day or Twilight meeting proceeds in accordance with this policy, but the actual temperature reaches 40° C or above, a decision about the cancellation or abandonment of the meeting will be made at the discretion of the Stewards and in consultation with the on-course Veterinarian.

#### NON-TAB MEETINGS – Forecast 40°C or above

Where the predicted temperature is forecast to be  $40^{\circ}$  C or above at 5:00pm on the Friday preceding the affected event, it will automatically be cancelled at that time. On the basis of an extreme hot weather forecast, a decision may be made prior to that time to cancel at the absolute discretion of Stewards.

#### COURSING MEETINGS – Forecast 30°C or above

In noting that Coursing involves multiple runs on the same day, when the predicted temperature is forecast to be 30°C or above at 5:00pm on the Friday preceding the affected event, it will automatically be cancelled at that time. On the basis of an extreme hot weather forecast, a decision may be made prior to that time to cancel at the absolute discretion of the Stewards.

#### SCRATCHING WITHOUT PENALTY

Trainers who have greyhounds engaged for racing on projected hot weather days – especially if they do not have air-conditioned transport facilities – may apply to scratch their runners **without penalty**. The following conditions apply:

- The predicted temperature is forecast for the venue's regional centre must be 38°C or above at the official scratching time
- Applications to scratch greyhounds under this policy must be made prior to the official scratching time. If a greyhound is withdrawn after that time the normal ten (10) day penalty will apply.
- Trainers cannot scratch their greyhounds selectively all runners for that trainer must be withdrawn
- The temperature will be sourced from Bureau of Meteorology <u>www.bom.gov.au</u> and will link venues to regional centres in accordance with the following:

NOTE: GRSA will maintain and monitor records of greyhounds which are scratched due to hot weather.

#### Selected greyhounds nominated by the one trainer to be scratched from meeting:

GRSA will maintain a Heat Stress Register which records greyhounds which are particularly vulnerable to heat stress. To be included in the register, a veterinary certificate confirming that the greyhound suffers from heat stress when racing or trialing in hot weather must be provided by the greyhound's trainer. That documentation must be received by GRSA in advance of the close of nominations for a given meeting for it to be eligible for selective scratching from that or any subsequent meetings due to hot weather.

Any greyhound on the register which is nominated for a meeting in relation to which the predicted temperature is forecast to be 38 °C degrees or higher for the corresponding regional centre as at the official scratching time will automatically be scratched from the meeting by GRSA. Under such circumstances, no penalty will be applied to the greyhound as a result of that scratching.

This policy will be applied regardless of whether the meeting in question is a Day, Twilight or Night meeting. It will also be considered a breach of this policy for a greyhound listed on the register to trial when the forecasted temperature is 38°C degrees or higher for the corresponding regional centre on that day other than for morning trial sessions.

#### COMMUNICATION OF CANCELLATION OF RACE MEETING OR TRIAL SESSION

GRSA will make every endeavor to announce any rescheduling of a race meeting by 8:00am that morning via the industry text service and any other vehicles that it deems appropriate. Radio TAB will be advised of any relevant information.

Trials may be cancelled at any time up until 4 hours prior to the scheduled commencement of the trial session. As with race meetings, the cancellation of a trial session will be notified by industry text and any other appropriate vehicles.

#### **RACING OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES – HOT WEATHER**

- In hot weather conditions when the predicted temperature is forecast to be 32°C or above, GRSA will ensure the kennel house is opened 30 minutes earlier at all venues, unless the meeting has been shifted in to a morning timeslot
- 2) Greyhounds to spend minimum time outside kennels
- 3) Previews are to be conducted in a shaded area
- 4) Greyhounds to parade directly to starting boxes
- 5) Greyhounds to remain in kennel house for at least 30 minutes after their event

- 6) Club to provide adequate drinking facilities for greyhounds
- 7) Club to provide adequate cooling foot-baths
- 8) Club to provide bottled water to participants when temperature is 32°C or above.
- 9) Ice vests can be used during parading and after the event but must be removed prior to placing greyhounds into their allotted kennel
- 10) GRSA Racing Department (where possible) to program distance events during the coolest part of the meeting (Day meetings early races, Night Meetings later races)
- 11) In hot weather conditions when the predicted temperature is forecast to be 32° C or above, barking muzzles will not to be permitted to be used at any time at SA race tracks

GRSA reserves the right to alter this policy at any time.



# Do you have a small dog?

Do you or someone you know have a small dog that could benefit from some socialisation and company during the day?

GAP SA is looking for small dogs to help with their green collar and first point assessments.

Your dog will be well looked after with plenty of pats and treats throughout the day. They will assist with either green collar assessments for dogs that have been living with foster carers or for greyhounds entering the program.

During assessments, greyhounds will be muzzled, on a leash and handled by an experienced assessor and handlers. All dogs will be walked around together in a secure testing area for approximately 5-10 mins to assess the greyhound's reaction to the small dog. If the greyhound is reacting well we will allow them to approach and sniff the small dog.

We are looking for dogs that are generally social and happy meeting other dogs and ones that walk well on a lead. Sessions are rostered at least a month in advance and are generally around two to four hours in length.

# A gem of a win for patient trainer

#### MOUNT GAMBIER

Mumbannar trainer Monty Wilson still remembers the day at the end of last year when Toolong breeder Phil Lenehan called him to see if he would be interested in taking a well-bred giveaway greyhound called Gold Gem.

However, there was just one catch – and isn't there always one when it comes to a giveaway? The daughter of US 50race winner Kiowa Producer and Gold Chalice, who won 10 Victorian provincial races, had recently copped a suspension at Shepparton for unsatisfactory box manners.

"As I only train giveaway greyhounds I told Phil I'd have a go with her, figuring that her box manners surely weren't so bad that she couldn't be sorted out," Wilson said.

Well, it depends what sort of timeframe you put on wayward greyhounds. Gold Gem last raced at Shepparton on November 27, 2017 and it would be another eight months before she resumed for Wilson at Tara Raceway on July 19.

On that occasion she ran third over 400 metres, well beaten, but according to her trainer it felt like a win to him and his wife Jen just to get the brindle bitch back on the racetrack.

"She was a really strange dog and to be honest, it took a long time just to get her confidence let alone trying her again in the starting boxes," Wilson said.

And, it has to be said, the re-introduction to the fundamental process of entering the starting boxes from the back and coming out the front didn't go all that well, at least initially.

"The first three times we tried her in the boxes was a disaster. In fact, as a last resort, Gold Gem was then booked in for box re-education at a Victorian breaking-in establishment.

"However, before she left we decided to give her one more try out of the boxes and it was at her fourth trip to the track that the penny finally dropped.

"Because of her suspension at Shepparton at the end of last year she was still required to run a satisfactory trial before she could race again so a couple of weeks later she passed with flying colours at Tara Raceway."

For all that, it took Gold Gem 11 runs to finally open her winning account, with Wilson declaring it a "gem of a win".

She virtually led all the way from box two in last Sunday's Laser Electrical Maiden Stake (512 metres) at Tara Raceway, eventually running out a 4½ length winner

over Oriental Tiger.

"She was my twelfth win for the year and one of the most satisfying," the beaming trainer declared.

In the third event on the program. a Mixed 3 & 4 Grade race over 400m, Rosco Fields [1] flew the start, but was quickly tackled by Steel [5], who went to the front. Around the back turn, Crackenback [3] started making up ground along the rails, with Stir Crazy [8], which had been last out of the boxes, continuing its strong run out wide to move to third. As they entered the straight, the three had the race between them, but it was Stir Crazy down the outside that got the judge's nod, winning by 3⁄4 length in a fast time of 22.98 secs. Second placing went to Steel, trained by Ray Murray of Reeve's Plains, with Crackenback trained by Mike Wittholz, placed third.

Mike, who is the Chairman of the Gawler Club, also trained the winner Stir Crazy, which is owned by the Top Vintage syndicate. The syndicate comprises other Gawler Club Committee members Bob Taplin and Bob May, in conjunction with Ashley Harvie and Duane Jones. The win took Stir Crazy's tally to 10 wins and 14 placings from 41 race starts, with only one of those starts exceeding the 400m journey. Stir Crazy has shown his

best race form from the outside boxes, as it allows him to get settled after his customary slow starts, and run around the outside of the field with a strong finish. With his run on style, it is a possibility that "Sam" could possibly run extra distance, something that Mike is considering. Leanne Fagan scored the only training double on the day when Aston Ricardo and Aston Hinkley both recorded all the way wins. Along with husband Paul, Leanne and family run a large training and rearing property at Calomba, and are instrumental in providing temporary accommodation for greyhounds in the adoption program.

# TRIALS ANGLE PARK

#### **QUALIFYING TRIALS – NOW WEEKLY**

Angle Park Qualifying Trials are run weekly on Tuesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting and the Wednesday APD meeting. Trainers must be specific on their nominations about which day they are trialling for and what distance. (ie Wed 388m, Mon 515, Mon 600m etc)

#### Tuesday Angle Park Qualifying dates are:

**November 20th** (for APM Monday meeting on 26th November – no APD Friday meeting on 28th November due to Time Grading meeting)

**November 27th** (for APM Monday meeting on 3rd December – for APD Wednesday meeting on 5th December)

**December 4th** (for APM Monday meeting on 10th December – for APD Wednesday meeting on 12th December)

December 11th (for APM Monday meeting on 17th December)

December 18th (for APM Monday meeting on 24th December)

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Tuesday of the meeting.

#### NOMINATING ONLINE FOR QUALIFYING TRIALS

For Angle Park, Gawler and Strathalbyn qualifying trials the nominations must be lodged with GRSA by 12.30pm on the day of the meeting. To nominate online however you can only do this up until 11.59pm the day before. Due to a system security policy you cannot nominate on the day for these trials online. Please contact our staff if you have any issues with these nominations prior to them closing.

#### SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

#### **BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS**

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number.

#### POLICY FOR TRIALS IN PLACE

Remember trials will only be taken from -

- \* 11.30am Monday for Angle Park Tuesday nights
- \* 11.30am Tuesday for Gawler Wednesday nights

\* 11.30am Thursday for Angle Park Saturday morning (day earlier due to being morning trials)

\* For Public Holidays it will be the working day before ie if Monday is a Public Holiday then bookings taken on the Friday

\*trial days that are not booked in with GRSA remain the same process (ie Gawler Thursday)\*

#### POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK AND GAWLER BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

#### RACE MEETING TRIAL POLICY

Angle Park Monday & Wednesday along with Gawler Tuesday, Friday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the Race Meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than 8 greyhounds nominated.

- 1. Reserves at the Meeting that do not obtain starts.
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located in an area affected by track closures.
- 3. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged.
- 4. Satisfactory trials.
- 5. Other greyhounds.

#### PROCEDURE/CRITERIA

- For Monday nights trainer to contact GRSA between 10.00am and 11.00am on the Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching line.
- 2. For Angle Park Wednesday, Gawler Tuesday & Friday trainer to contact GRSA between 4.00pm and 4.30pm on the day before.
- 3. For Gawler Sunday trainer to contact GRSA between 8.00am and 9.00am on the scratching line to nominate.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds Trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards allot the Box for the Greyhound.
- 6. Trials will be 515m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension or not cleared to race are not eligible to be nominated (these trials are conducted as if they are at a race meeting so all greyhounds need to be eligible at nomination time).
- 8. Greyhound registration certificate or cards must be produced at kennelling time.

9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilize the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave OR trainers with no other greyhounds will be free to leave following their trial.

If there are 12 races at Angle Park or Gawler there will be NO trials.

The Vet Clinic at these meetings cannot be used to accommodate any greyhounds to allow for extra trialling greyhounds. This policy has been introduced so that participants book in under the policy. The Vet Clinic needs to be available for the Vet and Stewards at race meetings

#### **EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY-**

- Thursday nights are kept available for the option for Interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead up to our Group races and also local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead up to a feature race upon request and they will take one of the eight kennels available for trialling ahead of the policy and sit separately to the 4 dog trials. Feature races are considered to be – Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals & any Group race Interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event and nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy.
- If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between this will be conducted as a solo trial and sit separately to the 2 four dog trials.

It is extremely important that trainers book in to trial at these race meetings. If unable to book in at these times then please contact GRSA where permission may be given to accept a booking outside of these times.
