Local Cup win has the state buzzing

■ ANGLE PARK

A big crowd at Angle Park has seen the South Australian trained and owned, Buzz Junkie win the 2022 TAB Adelaide Cup.

On what proved to be a brilliant nights racing, a drama filled edition of the Adelaide Cup saw Buzz Junkie use box eight beautifully, to avoid carnage and win by two and a half lengths in 30.72, ahead of Victorians, Zippy Tesla and Photo Man.

The track was a swarm of hype prerace, with punters flocking to the kennel house to get a glimpse of the superstar, Wow She's Fast, who started the race as a \$1.60 favourite. With the dogs loaded into the boxes and ready to go, the anticipation was extreme, but the start of the race did not go the way that most expected or had hoped for. Mallee Magic was easily the first to leave from box one and with that he all of a sudden looked a huge chance, but as his is natural trait, he shifted up to the middle of the track and blocked the run of Wow She's Fast, putting an end to her winning hopes. With some jamming below, it was a domino-like effect that saw Zippy Tesla clip the heels of Mallee Magic, putting an end to his hopes. Whilst this was happening, Buzz Junkie got a dream run down the outside and in the blink of an eye, found himself six lengths ahead of the field coming out of the first turn.

With Buzz Junkie seemingly home and hosed after 150m, there was still some jostling behind with plenty of dogs finding plenty of trouble. Photo Man was a clear second in the back straight with Top Quality and Fernando Mick behind, with the eight dog field now quite spread out.

Turning for home, Buzz Junkie still held a big margin with all interest in the minor placings. Whilst Photo Man looked to have second spot locked in down the back, an incredible surge from the ferocious Zippy Tesla saw him storm into second place, behind the winner in Buzz Junkie.

Whilst Zippy Tesla will go down as one of the best things beaten in a group race this year, a strong and professional Buzz Junkie will take the glory, and rightfully so, with the South Australian trained and owned chaser doing the state proud. Buzz Junkie was sent over for this race from New South Wales and he is owned by Troy Maynard and Nick Lalli, with the boys certainly enjoying the biggest thrill that they have experienced in their relatively short time in the industry. The man behind the win was of course Petar Jovanovic, with the master trainer doing an incredible job with the greyhound, in the short time he has had it. Petar has had some big thrills in his many years in the game, but last night was the biggest and it is so well deserved for a trainer that is not only a terrific man with a dog, but also a fantastic person within the industry, who is always willing to help others. Petar was clearly ecstatic, after capturing a dream he has set out to get his entire life.

"My first Adelaide Cup, I've been wanting to win one all my life," said Jovanovic

"It was unbelievable. Terrific"

"It was a bit late so we couldn't do much last night! We will be celebrating in the next day or so."

"He pulled up fantastic, all good. I've got to thank Micheal and Michelle for giving him to me to train for them, as well as being owned by Nick and Troy."

"He's flying straight back to Sydney, next Tuesday he's booked in. They've got other races in mind, I think they will step him up and try and get ready for the Hume Cup and those types of races but



now he's won the Adelaide Cup, he might get invites to certain races, I'm not sure."

With Buzz Junkie the star of the night, the brilliant performances didn't end there.

Fantastic Radley was dynamite in smashing the 730m track record, taking out the Premiers Cup. Trained by Liz Chegia, Radley was just totally dominant, leading the entire way and holding a significant margin on his three rivals for the whole trip. He clocked some seriously quick splits, of 4.24-15.80-29.04-42.47, which would put him on par with our best 530m sprinters. The win was Fantastic Radley's 32nd of his career, as he took his earnings to \$144,550.

Quite incredibly, the fastest time of the night went to Bobby Axelrod, who took out his grade 6 in dominant fashion. He was able to shoot over from box eight and quickly set up a big break, before roaring away in a slick 30.39. Still not even 2 years old, the win and strength of his run home would have his young trainer, Dillon Robinson, stoked at the future prospects of his white and brindle chaser.

We also witnessed the unveiling of the well hyped Victa Damian, with reports spreading countrywide about what this dog can run. From box eight he put on a brilliant debut performance, winning by four lengths in 30.85. Whilst the time doesn't show much, his track sense, strength and courage he showed in the race, was something you don't see from dogs on debut and despite finding heaps of first turn trouble, he was still good enough to put away the maiden field. He is a dog with a stack of promise and will most likely line up in the Leigh Rogers feature in a few weeks.

Other notable races on the night were the Country Cup, taken out by Enthusiastic for Nicole Price and the Adelaide Cup Consolation went to Hill Top Jack for David Geall.

So that was it for another Adelaide Cup night, well done to all involved and I am sure Petar, Nick and Troy will be celebrating their deserved victory for many days to come!

2022 TAB GROUP 1 ADELAIDE CUP REVIEW

The 2022 Group 1 TAB Adelaide Cup was taken out by Buzz Junkie for local trainer Petar Jovanovic.

In an upset victory, odds of 100/1 were on offer as the pre post market was dominated by Victorian trained star, Wow She's Fast. Buzz Junkie is owned locally by Troy Maynard and Nick Lalli with Nick recently recovering from injuries sustained at a recent trial session at Angle Park. Buzz Junkie has subsequently returned to NSW to be trained.

This years Adelaide Cup which was run in inclement weather at times and had 1,348 attending which included 867 for General Admission, 266 in Chasers Restaurant, 100 in the Pepperjack Bar and 115 in the Garden Bar. Last year under Covid restrictions we had 1,700 people attending which included 320 in Chasers Restaurant [maximum], 80 in the track side Garden Bar [maximum] and 300 children. In 2000 there were 1,000 [due to Covid limits], 1,300 patrons in 2019, with 1,500 in 2018 and 1,200 in 2017.

Our total TAB tote turnover on the meeting was \$221,951 compared to \$193,324 last year with \$214,391 in 2020, in 2019 it was \$252,563, \$355,866 in 2018 and \$231,013 in 2017. The First 4 Jackpot on the Cup performed very well reaching \$134,384 with a \$30,000 start. In 2021 the Cup had a First 4 jackpot of \$20,000 with the pool reaching \$87,828, compared to \$111,465 in 2020 and \$100,932 in 2019 all with a \$20k start, in 2018 it was \$54,176 and \$52,596 in 2017 with a \$10,000 jackpot.

Being mindful that so much money is now wagered through many other corporate bookmakers on the night which is calculated separately.

With Curly Seal bookmaking this year and only fielding downstairs his figures were \$14,890 compared to \$19,065 last year and \$20,686 in 2020, it was \$23,168 in 2019 and \$17,890 in 2018 and \$8,956 in 2017.

The Adelaide Cup Consolation was won by Hill Top Jack for Victorian trainer David Geall, while the Premier's Cup was won by Fantastic Radley in track record time for Elizabeth Chegia. Another feature on the night was the SA Country Cup which was won by Enthusiastic for Nicole Price representing the Gawler Greyhound Racing Club.

2022 GAWLER GOLD CUP FINAL THIS SUNDAY

After six Heats we have an outstanding field assembled for the Final on Sunday night, 23rd October at our Northern track. Heat winners were Propelled 30.57, Silver Stone 30.86, Kelsey Bale 30.38, Charlee's Misty 30.68, Came And Went 30.37 and Spring Phoebe 30.59. The \$36,000 2022 Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup Final over 531m will be race 8 and due to start at 7.51pm. Gawler Cup box draw listed below -

Also featured on the night will be the \$8,000 Gawler Sprint Classic Final, after three Heats the winners were Karmen Kristy 22.44, Taylor Toves 22.44 and Mepunga Knight 22.58. This will be race 3 on the program due to start at 6.17pm. We also have the \$4,000 Gawler Cup Consolation for this greyhounds that didn't quite make the Group 3 Final which will be race 6 on the program due to start at 7.09pm. We also have two Heats of the Bothing Gawler Stayer's Cup over the 643m which will be races 4 and 5 on the night due to start at 6.32pm and 6.54pm respectively. These are two exciting races which feature the likes of Victa Grosso, Springvale Rex and Mr. Ibrox from Heat 1 and Radek Bale, Howling Hoss and Spring Agatha in Heat 2. The Gawler GRC and GRSA named the Stayers Cup in honour of Bothing last year to recognise one of our great stayers over the last 20 years.

Bothing was nicely bred being by Carlisle Jack out of Which Wire, owned by Andrew Lee, Brett Smith and Alexander Calabria and trained by Bosco Stamenkovic. In the year of 2006 there was no better stayer in the country after he won the National Distance Championship at Launceston in Tasmania over the 720m where he established a new track record of 42.49 and won by almost 5 lengths. He also currently holds the Gawler 643m track record which he set 15 years ago running an amazing 36.81 and won by almost 18 lengths, with few greyhounds getting close to this mark over the last decade and a half. He won the State Final of the National Distance, he was named SA Staying Greyhound of the Year and showed he could sprint as well, winning a Heat of the SA St Leger before finishing third in the Final. His best time over the 515m at Angle Park was 29.30 while he ran 43.06 over the 731m, he also won at Wentworth Park in 42.72 over the 720m. His career ended with 17 wins and 7 placings from only 30 lifetime starts with earnings around \$82,000 in prizemoney.

The \$8,500 Final of the Bothing Gawler Stayers Cup will be an 8 dog field and will be run on Sunday, 31st October along with the \$4,000 Gawler Anniversary Cup over the 531m rounding out the outstanding three meetings of racing.

Mallee Magic returns with a magic month

Greyhound of the Month for September was Mallee Magic for trainer Tony Rasmussen who returned to racing in terrific fashion.

After having a month off the scene, the son of Worm Burner and Bells Are Ringin only had two starts for the month, winning one of those but against the highest of quality. He returned mid month and was rated the highest SA greyhound in the SA V Allstars Match Race series where he took on superstar, Wow She's Fast. Whilst beaten in track record time his performance was full of merit to finish 4th overall. He then stepped out in a Heat of the Group 1 Adelaide Cup where he showed he was right back to his very best, he led throughout and won convincingly in the fastest of all Heats running 30.12 and showed he would be hard to beat in the Final.

At the end of the month Mallee Magic's record stood at 40 starts for 19 wins and 8 placings and earnings around \$142,000.



Victa Grosso claims award with another record

Another track record and another run of the month for Victa Grosso for trainer Tony Rasmussen.

After claiming the Mount Gambier track record, he then ventured to Gawler over the 531m on Sunday, 2nd September. He started a dominate favourite and justified that quote leading throughout and winning by over 11 lengths. He ran a time of 30.22 which bettered the previous mark by .01 which had only been equalled in the last 15 years. A fantastic performance.

GAWLER CLUB TO RECOGNISE BOB TAPLIN ON SUNDAY 30TH OCTOBER

After the recent passing of Gawler Club Treasurer, Bob Taplin, the Club and Committee will name a race in his memory at their meeting on Sunday, 30th October.

This will be a one-off event called the Bob Taplin Memorial where some of Bob's family will be in attendance. The race will be a 531m event with an extra \$200 added, however, will be determined by what nominations we have for each grade.

Nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am on Wednesday, 26th October.

BORDER CHALLENGE (MOUNT GAMBIER V WARRNAMBOOL) HEATS

Mount Gambier will run a Heat Sunday, 23rd October over the 512m journey worth \$2,125. It is race 4 on the program due to start at 12.37pm. The first four greyhounds will represent the Club in the \$5,800 Challenge Final Sunday, 30th October. The Warrnambool Heat will be run on Thursday, 20th October again with the first four qualifying for the Final at Mount Gambier. The reserves for this series will come from the Mount Gambier Heat to be consistent with what occurred the last time this series was conducted in 2019.

LEIGH ROGERS GRADE 6 FEATURE

The Leigh Rogers Grade 6 feature will be run over the 530m journey with \$3,260 Heats on Thursday, 27th October and the \$14,275 Final on Thursday, 3rd November.

Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday, 24th October.

BRIAN JOHNSTONE HEATS

Following the second Classic 2022 Prelude Final which will be conducted on Thursday, 20th October at Angle Park, attention will swing to the rich Brian Johnstone Series. The Group 3 series is the main event of the Classic 2022 Futurity.

The \$3,700 Heats for the Brian Johnstone will be run on Thursday, 10th November at Angle Park, followed by the \$4,500 Semi-Finals on Thursday, 17th November and the \$37,500 Final on Thursday, 24th November.

Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday, 7th November.

SATURDAY TO THURSDAY NIGHT FINALS AT ANGLE PARK

Once a fortnight GRSA run Heats on the Saturday morning meeting at Angle Park, where there will be either (1-4 wins or 5+ wins) over the 530m and will be Non Penalty events, run at 8 dog fields.

The Final will be conducted as Race 1 on the Thursday night.

Trainers should be mindful that if you have a greyhound in a Heat and it qualifies for the Final that the greyhound will be ineligible to compete in the Final if it is engaged to race the day prior [Wednesday].

The next lot of Heats will be on Saturday, 29th October for 5+ wins with the Final on Thursday, 3rd November.

- Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9am on Wednesday, 26th October.

ANGLE PARK AND TOWNSVILLE TO SWAP IN DECEMBER

Greyhound Racing SA have liaised with Racing Queensland in regard to swapping a Saturday morning meeting in December. The Angle Park meeting set down for Saturday, 10th December will now be run on Saturday, 17th December with the Townsville meeting swapping from the 17th to the 10th December.

This will allow GRSA the opportunity to align and showcase some feature races during the Christmas period.

SA Oaks and Derby Finals kicked off a big Spring

Yahiro Bale trained by Daniel Gibbons produced a last to first victory in an amazing run to take out the Group 3 Coffex Coffee SA Oaks Final in September.

Sent out a warm favourite the daughter of Feral Franky and Dyna Zesty was well supported after her brilliant win in the Heats seven days prior, however, a slow beginning was not what the punters or connections wanted.

As the start was affected Yahiro Bale found herself back last with kennel mate McKeon Bale, as Miss Scallywag for Tony Rasmussen flew the lids to challenge for the early lead, with Melissa Keeping for Matthew Lanigan driving hard to her inside. It was tightly bunched leaving the winning post on the first occasion with Melissa Keeping spearing through to lead Miss Scallywag with a blanket over the remaining 6 runners as they jostled for position. Yahiro Bale had made ground quickly to be poking in between runners looking for a gap to appear.

Into the back straight and Melissa Keeping railed hard to lead clearly from Ava Blazer for Jeff Britton, however, railing even harder to her inside was Yahiro Bale who amazingly moved to second as the Group 3 field entered the back straight. Miss Scallywag was pushed back to fourth and looked to hold her position as the remainder of the Oaks field looked to make ground.

Off the back straight and Yahiro Bale moved up powerfully to challenge Melissa Keeping for the lead as they broke away from Ava Blazer who was holding third just ahead of Miss Scallywag. In a twinkling of an eye Yahiro Bale was now in the lead and racing away from her rivals in a brilliant display of chasing. She gave her opposition a start and a beating as she sped away from her rivals to win by 3 lengths in a slick 30.52. Melissa Keeping just couldn't hold off the late finish of Ava Blazer who grabbed second on the line relegating her to third, while Miss Scallywag was also claimed by the late finishing burst of Zippering Daria for Ed Burrett who claimed fourth.

The SA Derby Final followed and as always showcased some of the best young male chasers in the land with a wonderful field lining up for the Group 3 feature however it was the race favourite, Deadly Class who won the \$25,000 first prize and wrote his name into the prestigious honour roll.

Trained by Anthony Azzopardi the son of Barcia Bale and Elevated had suffered two close seconds at Angle Park in the previous fortnight, however, deservingly broke through for a sensational win when the pressure was on. He began very well from box 2 to move quickly towards the lead however was burnt off by kennel mate Salad Dodger who showed blistering acceleration to assume control out of the front straight. Local hope Rushes Raw for Kim Johnstone and the highly promising Hector Fawley for Lisa Cockerell both began ok but found some trouble on the first turn putting them out of play. Multi Matt for Jeff Britton moved to third out wide on the track while WA visitor Columbus Monelli for Morgan Turner railed hard to move to fourth after being towards the tail of the field.

As they entered the back straight Salad Dodger led but looming large in his rear-view mirror was Deadly Class with clean air to make ground. Multi Matt was third and Columbus Monelli was fourth as they raced down the back straight. Off the back straight Salad Dodger was starting to shorten stride as Deadly Class first looked to go to his inside then swung wide as they turned for home. Making ground quickly was Multi Matt along the rails while Columbus Monelli would have the final crack in the home straight. Mid way down the home straight and they claimed Salad Dodger with Deadly Class finding the front and then withstanding a late finishing burst from Columbus Monelli to go on and win by a nose from the WA sprinter with Salad Dodger claiming third just ahead of Multi Matt.

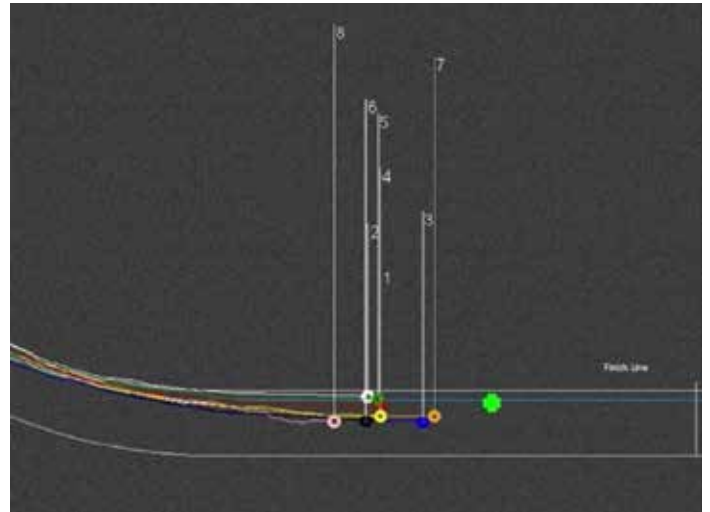

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

COMPLIANCE AND WELFARE

Disqualified, suspended, warned off persons and defaulters – what does it mean for you?

The Greyhounds Australasia Rules (GAR) define a warned off person the same as a disqualified person. A disqualified person is a person who is disqualified by the Controlling Body or Stewards or pursuant to the Rules of any approved controlling authority or thoroughbred, harness, or greyhound racing club.

Greyhound racing means everything and anyone who participates, at any level, at any time, with any activity associated with greyhounds or racing and includes, but is not limited to –

- [a] the keeping of greyhounds which are in the care or custody of registered or other persons;
- [b] the registration or breeding of greyhounds;
- [c] any matter or thing connected to greyhound racing.

Rule 156(x) of the GAR states that any person shall be guilty of an offence if they, as a registered person or person associated with greyhound racing, associates with a disqualified person for the purposes of greyhound racing.

What this means is, as a registered person, if you associate with a person who is disqualified or warned off, for the purposes of greyhound racing, you commit a breach of the rules. It does not mean you cannot have any contact – the rules of greyhound racing are not there to control who you see outside racing, but you cannot – categorically – associate for the purposes of greyhound racing. This can include assistance with training, consultation, advice, assessments, examinations, or anything else that relates to your activity with greyhounds. Please be mindful of this.

The GAR define a suspension as the withdrawal for any period of any registration, licence, right or privilege granted pursuant to the Rules. A person who is suspended cannot perform tasks that would normally be allowed under their registration or respective licence. A suspension can be imposed as a penalty after an Inquiry; or, as a condition subject to an Inquiry, pursuant to Rule 169[5][c] of the GAR.

The GAR define a defaulter as a person declared by the Controlling Body or a person authorised by a Controlling Body to be a defaulter, or who otherwise becomes a defaulter by operation of a rule of greyhound racing, who is in default in relation to the payment of money payable to Greyhounds Australasia, a Controlling Body, or a Club, including any prize money directed to be returned to the relevant Controlling Body or Club. It is an offence pursuant to Rule 156[u] to be a defaulter and the privileges afforded to a registered person are stopped.

The overall effect of these types of penalties is considered by Rule 178 of the GAR –

178 Effect of disqualification, suspension, warning off or being declared a defaulter

- [1] A penalty imposed pursuant to the Rules will apply throughout the jurisdiction of the body imposing the penalty.
- [2] A person who is disqualified, warned off, suspended or declared to be a defaulter must not, during the period of the penalty:
 - [a] nominate a greyhound for any Event;
 - [b] permit a greyhound that the person owns or trains to compete in any Event;
 - [c] act as an attendant at a meeting;
 - [d] train a greyhound;
 - [e] participate in any activity connected with the breeding of greyhounds;
 - [f] act as an official at a meeting;
 - [g] be engaged as an employee or agent by any other person associated with the training of greyhounds; or
 - [h] be a member, officeholder, employee or volunteer of a Club registered pursuant to the Local Rules of a Controlling Body.
- [3] Unless a Controlling Body orders otherwise, a person who is disqualified, warned-off or declared a defaulter is not:
 - [a] permitted to transact or engage in any business affecting the registration or licensing of persons or greyhounds with a Controlling Body;
 - [b] to enter any enclosure or other part of a racecourse or any property occupied or used in connection with a racecourse whether acting as agent or in any other capacity;
 - [c] to enter the premises of a Club;
 - [d] to have or hold any of the rights or privileges conferred by any licence or registration pursuant to the Rules;
 - [e] eligible to otherwise participate in or associate with greyhound racing, and any greyhound which has been nominated by the person or in the person's name, or which the person wholly or partly owns which is proved to the satisfaction of a Controlling Body to be under the person's care, custody or in training with the person, is prohibited from competing in any Event; and
 - [f] to enter or go to or remain on, at any time, any place where greyhounds are bred, whelped, handled, reared, broken in, kept or housed, educated, pre-trained, trained or raced.

Also note your obligations to report certain adverse outcomes to GRSA, pursuant to Rule 168 of the GAR –

Division 8: Obligations of registered persons to report certain offences and circumstances

168 Obligations of registered persons to report certain offences and circumstances

A registered person must notify the Controlling Body or Controlling Bodies by whom they are registered, within seven days of:

- [a] being found guilty of an offence punishable by fine or

imprisonment, other than a fine for a traffic offence;

(b) having their registration with any Controlling Body or approved controlling authority (including those that relate to harness racing and thoroughbred racing, either in Australia or abroad) suspended, disqualified or cancelled;

(c) becoming a defaulter in the jurisdiction of any Controlling Body;

(d) being warned off or fined in excess of \$250 in connection with greyhound, harness or thoroughbred racing, other than by a Controlling Body with whom they are registered;

(e) being the subject of any action under legislation directed at the prevention of cruelty to animals.

These types of adverse outcomes will also be considered during any licence application, review, or renewal process, under the fit and proper person test outlined in Part 4 of the Local Rules.

The meeting commenced at 10.10am.

1 APOLOGIES

2 NOTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

The Minutes from the ICG Meeting held on Friday 17 June, 2022 were noted as a true and correct record.

3 BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETING**3.1 Updates from Minutes**

The Chairman noted the recent increase to the Track Injury Rebate Scheme which now brings SA into line with other jurisdictions and has been well received.

Panel members suggested the Puppy Auction would not be going ahead and this would be confirmed following an upcoming Committee Meeting. They noted the reasonable request from the Board to ensure rearers were available to purchasers, however he believes this would create limitations. They highlighted other issues which would leave too greater onus on Club to undertake. They suggested the Club may delay the auction another year and assess environment at that time. The Group highlighted issues with lack of rearers generally across industry and increased costs associated with rearing.

3.2 Sustainable Breeding Levels

The RM noted the minutes arising from last meeting, and was mindful facilities were reducing and would be difficult to place restrictions on the premise therefore management moved away from this idea, preferring to have breeders apply for breeding support rather than automatically be given. Management considered all payments provided under breeder support. The CEO noted this item has been put on Greyhounds Australasia CEO's agenda to monitor. Members of the panel suggested there were breeders that were breeding dogs and having large numbers going straight to GAP. They suggested implementing different tiers of breeding licences, which would involve criteria and a requirement to have a proven breeding record. They suggested this may increase quality of breeding and assist to manage numbers. The CEO took the panels comments on board. Members suggested restricting future breeding based on performance of previous litters. The Group suggested not approving third litter until first two litters have been proven. The RM suggested this would be subjective, group clarified and this would be for those that were registered and raced. Members suggested a bitch would be required to be in SA three months prior to mating to qualify for Breeders Support Program. The Group suggested GRSA would have to cover insemination costs, vaccination, microchipping and ear branding, and also contribute to cesarean costs up to an agreed amount. Members suggested removing pup support payment from section C. The RM questioned whether naming fee should be charged to breeders. The Group agreed that a reintroduction of the naming fee of \$55 +GST was fair and

reasonable. The Group agreed to remove SA Bred Scheme payment of \$27.50 from Part B. It was agreed a 1 January 2023 implementation date was reasonable.

3.3 Limited Monthly Starts

The CEO noted discussion at GA level, referencing WA local rule. She advised Management reviewed the current SA greyhound population and noted no greyhounds would be affected by rule. She further advised there was appetite to implement nationally. The RM noted there would be very limited impact should a local rule be implemented, however a change would provide positive public perception. The Group provided their support to recommending the Board consider implementation of a local rule to limit monthly starts the same as WA has adopted. Members raised concern with coursing and where this sits with limited starts. Discussion around the manual process of coursing and potential to exclude from policy. The Chairman requested the Racing Manager investigate options to incorporate coursing within OzChase. The COS noted the limited number of dogs involved in coursing and separate coursing rules which would make this difficult.

3.4 Digital Transformation and Broadcast Enhancement (Isolynx)

The Chairman noted progression of project with times being displayed on Sky Racing the previous night. Members requested over the 342m start, the 730m split is recorded and available in racebooks. Members from the Board suggested this information and any other valuable data can be made available. The panel noted infographics provided by Sandown. The Chairman requested any ideas and requested information be fed through to the Marketing Manager to be considered.

3.5 AGRC Syndicate Dog – Weblec Rebel

The Group noted the update. Members noted the potential interest from the syndicate to invest in additional dogs.

3.6 Prizemoney Submission

The Group noted the update.

3.7 Inquiry Delays

The IM noted the update provided in Kennel Capers regarding the IHP. He advised that enquiries are back on track and backlog cleared. Members requested notices are published for those that have been finalised. The IM advised that he has requested these from the panel. Members suggested that people were not being deterred enough by penalties and others were being disheartened by the lack penalties. The IM committed to raising with IHP and IWC. The Chairman noted the panels comments.

4 AGENDA ITEMS**4.1 Marketing Presentation**

The MM provided "marketing in focus" document to the group. Members noted Tara Tipsters and amount of charitable donations being made to local charities and groups and potential for positive media coverage. Members commended the increased marketing presence. Members advised the positive impact of the recent trainer videos, showing the human side of trainers. The Group showed their appreciation to the CEO, Board and Management on their professional handling of the recent live baiting crisis.

4.2 ICG Panel Members

Members advised that the Members of Company were happy to continue with the current group and applications that have been received for vacant positions on the ICG which they were

working through.

5. OTHER BUSINESS

5.1 Jason Newman Submission – Mt Gambier Population

Jason provided background to the issues, noting ageing, dwindling and unreliable population. He highlighted the very real possibility of needing to be able to field 70-80 dogs from local population base. He suggested there was need to strategically plan for the future. He suggested potentially engaging consultant to review and facilitate a working group to collect data. The Chairman appreciated comments and questioned if the Committee had considered what is required to bring Tara Raceway up to a training facility. Members suggested it was reasonably set up but would require mentoring to be able to utilise. Members of the Board suggested mapping out where opportunities lay, and form group to build strategic plan and identify resources required to fulfill plan. He offered his services to facilitate the formation of such a plan.

5.2 Christine Costa Submission – Trials and Statistical Overview

The panel noted her concerns with straight track trials. The RM confirmed looking to have the ability to book trials online for all tracks and all sessions on all days. Discussion around ability to notify cancellation of trials. Management to enforce bookings and procedures around trials including arrival time.

The Group questioned the resumption of trials. Derek Kordick advised necessary measures required to be implemented to satisfy SafeWork SA and internal investigations. Members questioned whether compensation can be paid to Peter Franklin who attended from interstate at the time trials were cancelled at Mt Gambier. Management committed to looking into this.

5.3 Lisa Rasmussen Submission – Finish on Lure

LM questioned whether finish on lure could be once again considered by the Board. She noted benefits of finish on lure including rewarding the dog. The Chairman noted his initial discussion with vets and intent to obtain further information to aid in decision. Some Members advised their objection to finish on lure highlighting injury rate, equipment issues and general safety matters. The COS advised Stewards were supportive of finish on lure due to staff safety. Some members noted the need for education of lure drivers in regard to finish on lure to which the COS agreed. The Chairman appreciated the discussion and noted this would form part of decision for the Board.

Members suggested bull rings should be disallowed at private properties and only be allowed at GRSA tracks where they are monitored. The Chairman questioned if there was any support from trainers to retain bull rings. Members suggested it was a fairly large restriction to put on trainers should they not be able to access private bull rings. The Group suggested bull rings be required to be registered and any attendance at them by trainers to be registered.

5.4 Late Gear Changes

Members requested any gear changes like blinkers are advised and recorded in form guide.

5.5 Satisfactory Trials

The Group requested that satisfactory trials be available on website. The Marketing Manager committed to addressing this.

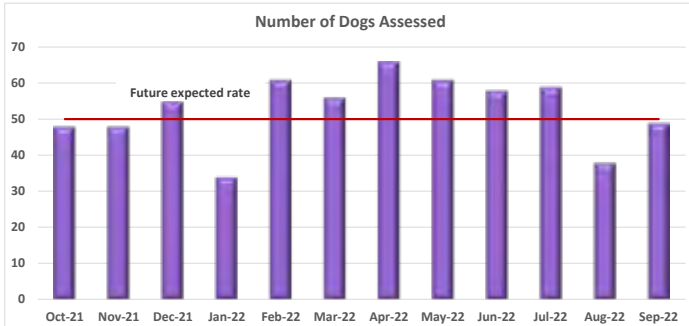

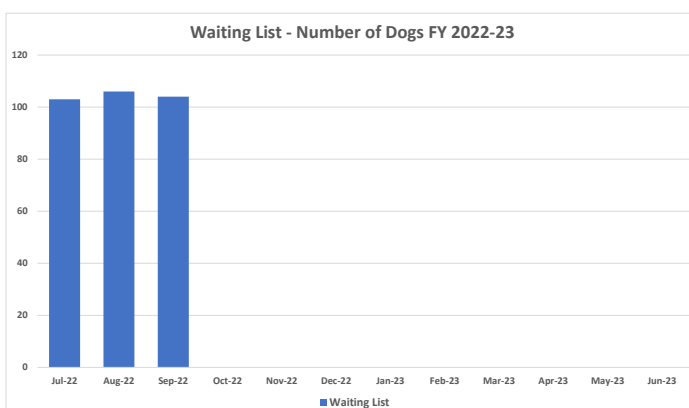
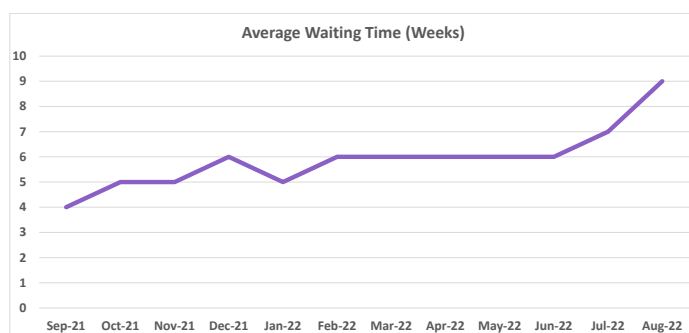
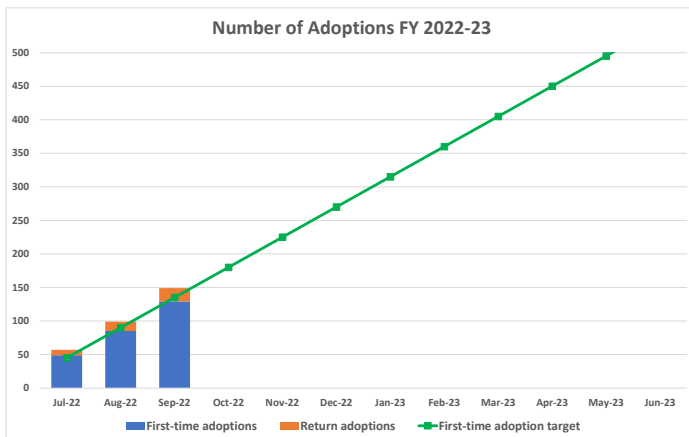
Latest updates from GAP

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialed after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night at approximately 5.15pm (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

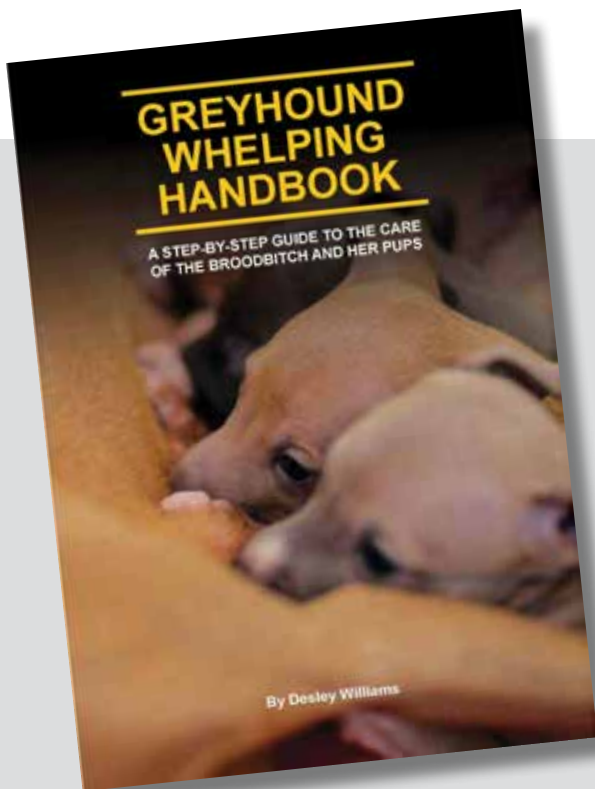
