TRANSPONDER TAKES OUT 2023 ADELAIDE CUP

Victorian greyhound Transponder gave trainer Jason Thompson his fifth Adelaide Cup holding off the fast-finishing Big Energy to win a fantastic 2023 edition of the race.

A healthy crowd was on course for the event with four feature races headlined by the 2023 Group 1 TAB Adelaide Cup. The Adelaide Cup field was full of star power headlined by SA Derby and SA vs All-Stars Match Race winner Schillaci, as well as proven Victorian performers in Transponder, Launch Code, Big Energy and Mepunga Smokey.

Also featured in the field were South Australian hopefuls Fiorano for trainer Brenda Oakey and Adhana Rico for Ashlee Griffiths.

It was the Jason Thompson-trained Transponder who prevailed after finding the lead from box one and fending off a challenge from Big Energy winning by half a head in 30.27. Mepunga Smokey for Jeffrey Britton finished in third place while Adhana Rico was fourth.

Also on the Adelaide Cup card, we saw the running of the 2023 SA Country Cup which was taken out by the Dave Peckham trained Federal Fernando, who qualified into the final through the Murray Bridge heats.

Jumping from box two, he powered through to lead early and was never troubled as he accelerated down the back straight holding off the chasing pack and winning by two lengths in 30.73.

The Country Cup success for Federal Fernando was the first time a Murray Bridge representative has taken out the race since the new track was built in 2019.

Zippering Neutron continued his excellent run of feature race success over the 730m journey taking out the 2023 Premier's Cup in a high quality field which included Victorian Moraine Suzie and track record holder Fantastic Radley.

Zippering Neutron was able to lead from start to finish, fending off the early challenge from Fantastic Radley and the late challenge from Moraine Suzie to win his 15th race from 16 starts here in South Australia.

The Ben Rawlings trained Agent Nine Nine claimed the Adelaide Cup Consolation winning a high-quality race in a time of 30.51. After a strong heat run the week prior, Agent Nine Nine was able to lead to the first turn crossing a high quality field to lead around the back.

He extended his margin down the back before Dash Of Blue and Dolly Dutton closed late with strong runs home, but Agent Nine Nine was able to hang on and win in impressive fashion.

2023 GAWLER CUP CARNIVAL KICKS OFF ON MONDAY 23RD OCTOBER

The Gawler Gold Cup carnival will be run over two meetings this year. The Gawler GRC has been in consultation with the Thoroughbreds and Harness Racing in the region and has made a mini carnival again this year with all three codes running their main races for the year around the same time called the "Gawler Carnival of Cups".

Our carnival will kick off on Monday, 23rd October with \$3,000 Heats for the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup over the 531m along with \$1,995 Heats of the Gawler Sprint Classic for open 400m greyhounds and the \$2,760 Heats of the "Bothing" Gawler Stayers Cup for open 643m greyhounds.

The Group 3 Gawler Cup Final will be run on Sunday night, 29th October worth \$36,000 in prizemoney with the winner to receive \$25,000. This night will include the \$8,000 Gawler Sprint Classic Final, the \$8,500 Final of the Bothing Gawler Stayers Cup and there will be a Consolation for the Gawler Gold Cup.

Nominations for the Gawler Cup Heats, Gawler Sprint Classic Heats and Bothing Stayers Cup close with GRSA at 9.00am on Thursday, 19th October

CHANGE OF VENUES TO ACCOMMODATE THE GAWLER CUP HEATS IN OCTOBER

Please note with the Gawler Cup Heats this year being conducted on Monday night, 23rd October our normal schedule will change slightly.

Angle Park will run on Friday, 21st October with a day meeting at City B class while Sunday night, 22nd October will be a Murray Bridge Prov 1 meeting around the One Turn. Please check the October All Tracks calendar for programmed events when released.

LEIGH ROGERS GRADE 6 FEATURE – NOMINATIONS CLOSE ON MONDAY 23RD OCTOBER

The Leigh Rogers Grade 6 feature will be run over the 530m journey with \$3,505 Heats on Thursday, 26th October and the \$14,275 Final on Thursday, 2nd November.

Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday, 23rd October.

GROUP 3 BRIAN JOHNSTONE HEATS IN NOVEMBER

Following the second Classic 2023 Prelude Final, attention will swing to the rich Brian Johnstone Series. The Group 3 series is the main event of the Classic 2023 Futurity.

The \$3,700 Heats for the Brian Johnstone will be run on Thursday, 9th November at Angle Park, followed by the \$4,500 Semi Finals on Thursday, 16th November and the \$37,500 Final on Thursday, 23rd November.

Nominations for the Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday, 6th November

GOTBA COURSING AWARDS NIGHT – THURSDAY 16TH NOVEMBER

GOTBA will present their Annual Awards at Angle Park on Thursday, 16th November. To be presented at the dais will be the SA Coursing Trainer of the Year and SA Coursing Greyhound of the Year.

Also featuring on the night will be a Free For All event for greyhounds which competed at Virginia during 2023. The race is supported by GOTBA and carries prizemoney of \$5,535.

Nominations for this event close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday, 13th November

GAWLER TRIALS TO MOVE TO ONLINE IN NOVEMBER WITH THURSDAYS INITIALLY

As previously advised GRSA has been working with the Gawler GRC and staff to transition the Gawler trial booking process to online, like Angle Park and Murray Bridge for their Monday and Thursday morning sessions.

After consultation at the most recent ICG meeting this will have to be implemented to accommodate certain trialling requirements.

GRSA will extend the bookings for Gawler for each session from 4 to 6 that one trainer can have in anyone session to assist a number of young greyhounds that trial one after another.

To initiate Gawler online we will start with Thursdays first, which will start in November [date to be confirmed] which can be managed easier and then we will work on the Monday trial session.

GRSA online trial booking system FAQs

Below are details regarding the Trial Booker process.

Below are examples provided a few years ago so the dates and distances will have changed, however, will give industry a good idea when they log on to the Trial Booker which they can do through the GRSA website.

How do I register an account to book public trials online?

Visit www.trialbooker.com, click on the "register an account" link and fill in the appropriate details.

How do I book a specific trial online?

To book 4 trials, click Book 4:



As soon as you have pressed the Book button, those trials are booked and yours to keep. You then customise the distance, number of dogs, and type for each trial, and confirm them

Field Trials

Existing field trials will appear in each block. To book a dog in an existing field trial simply click the Book 1/2/3 button.



If there are no available field trials of the distance and type you require then feel free to create one yourself. Simply book a slot as-per-normal and select Maiden Field or Performed Field, as shown below.



Note: booking a dog or several dogs in a field trial counts as 1 trial towards your 4 trial maximum.

When do trial bookings commence each week?

Bookings for meetings will commence at 11.30am the working day prior to the trial session (henceforth known as "booking opening time").

Is there a limit to how many trials I can book online?

Yes: 4 (Gawler is 6). If you wish to reserve more than 4 trials a session then you must phone the office as per normal. For example, in the screenshot below, it indicates that you can book 3 more trials using TrialBooker without phoning.



Why am I limited to 4 trials in one block?

In short: to prevent abuse of the system. To book more phone the office after booking opening time.

Can I cancel a trial booking online? Yes: Press the X button and confirm.



Will I receive a confirmation to confirm my online trial booking?

Your trials are reserved for you as soon as you press the "Book 4" button (or "Book 4" or whichever it may be). You must then confirm the details of those trials (distance, number of dogs etc.). There will be a summary of your bookings in each session on the Home page.

Can I book trials for other licensees? No—under no circumstances may you book trials for anyone other than yourself using TrialBooker. Dogs must be brought in and paid for by the person whose name they were booked under. If you wish to share a non-field trial with another trainer you must book over the phone.

How can I book a trial if I don't have access to a computer?

You can still book trials by calling the office after booking opening time.

OzChase will update the currency of the Greyhound's vaccination and will be displayed within Online Nominations shortly. Each Greyhound on the Currently Trained list of a trainer will include a new column displaying the latest vaccination date recorded.

It will be colour coded according to the condition outlined below:

Please be advised Satisfactory Trials at Murray Bridge on Wednesday nights will be conducted on a fortnightly basis due to staffing issues. The next fortnightly opportunity will be Wednesday, 30th August.

TO MBGRC REGISTERED TRAINER MEMBERS

On behalf of the MBGRC Committee:

The MBGRC Committee wish to advise the MBGRC Registered Trainer Members that you must book your trials, otherwise you may be disappointed when the Murray Bridge Greyhound Racing track staff refuse to trial your greyhounds. Being a dual track facility, the Murray Bridge track staff require prior notification advising names of trainers booked for trials, at what time and on which track.

There are still a few MBGRC Registered Trainers yet to pay this year's [2023/2024] members renewal fee, trainers who are not members of the MBGRC are required to pay \$10 for each trial.

NEW SPONSOR FOR MURRAY BRIDGE SUMMER DERBY AND OAKS IN DECEMBER

VACCINATION RULE FOR RACING IN SA

Trainers are reminded that Rule 25 (Minimum Vaccination Requirements) took effect Monday, 1st May. Vaccination Certificates must be received by GRSA prior to close of nominations for affected greyhounds to be considered eligible.

CURRENT MASTERS TIMES AND POLICY

- For greyhounds 3¾ years and older. 4yo and older will get preference. City A, City B and Prov 1 meetings are done by form for 4yo and older and then greyhounds will only get in from under 4yo to 3¾ yo in age from oldest to youngest. Prov 2 meetings are all done on age from oldest to youngest regardless of form for all ages.
- Dates are exact so going back 4yo and 3¾ from the date of race. ie date of race run on 20/11/22 – 4yo would be 20/11/18 whelping.
- Time restrictions if a greyhound wins a Grade 5 Masters race in a faster time than published and it will have to have 2 runs [placed or unplaced] in normal company at that class of meeting before being eligible at that class of meeting.
- The Grader will look to grade a Grade 5 Masters event on every program over a distance if enough dogs are nominated regardless if it is advertised in the All Tracks calendar.

- All races Non Penalty.

If a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading.

If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs, only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters [ie Grade 2/3 & 4] we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event.

305m Masters Policy for Mt Gambier – With Mt Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events, however, factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance.

There will still be a Time Standard applied based on the published table being 17.75. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week.

The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month. These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner & \$150 to the Breeder.

At the ICG meeting in January the SA Bred Bonus scheme was tabled for discussion where when we have 200 or more SA bred winners we go over budget and there is no Monthly payment for the Owner of Breeder separate to the \$225. It was discussed that this was happening more regularly with more racing and more SA Bred greyhounds winning events. It was suggested increasing the base amount from \$225 and removing monthly payments, therefore reducing monthly administration of the scheme. The Board advised changes to be implemented from 1 July 2023, however, kept the base amount at \$225 due to the increased numbers and racing opportunities. Due to this change the SA bred winners will no longer be listed in Kennel Capers each month.

For the month of July there were 203 winners, August there were 197 and September there were 196.

DUAL LURE CONTINUES AT ANGLE PARK ON TUESDAY NIGHTS

As advised a dual lure is being trialled at Angle Park on Tuesday nights until sufficient trialling has taken place to determine the positives and negatives of the dual lure at our venues.

To manage this process trainers will need to book trials as normal. GRSA will allocate timeslots 7.15pm to 7.40pm and 7.40pm to 8.05pm each Tuesday meaning we will be trialling up to 20 trials each Tuesday night. Having two blocks of time will assist trial staff to manage the changing of the lure etc.

When booking online please book as normal in these slots and it will be assumed that you want to trial on the dual lure. If a trainer does not want to trial on the dual lure then please book in different time slots.

When ringing up to book a trial please advise staff if you want to book a dual lure trial, bearing in mind there is only 20 trials and once gone there will not be anymore until the following week.

GAP PRESENTATION STANDARDS

Participants are reminded that greyhounds which arrive to GAP unwashed or in poor condition will lead to a non-compliance being issued.

Presenting greyhounds to GAP in poor condition is a breach of the welfare policy and the animal welfare obligations of their inspection.

Participants issued a non-compliance may also be issued a small fine.

TRACK INJURY REBATES

To make processing of Track Injury Rebates [TIRs] more efficient, please ensure the following is submitted with the form; TIRs application form, vet history from relevant clinic, and PAID invoice from veterinary clinic. Please also make sure that the application form is filled out correctly and includes the on-track vet [OTV] or steward signature on application form, vet signature who provided medical care relating to the injury, and responsible person's signature and details.

RISK AND COMPLIANCE

INDEPENDENT INQUIRY INTO THE GOVERNANCE OF THE GREYHOUND RACING INDUSTRY IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA

As you may be aware, the Independent Inquiry into the Governance of the Greyhound Racing Industry in South Australia (Inquiry) is continuing and GRSA continues to assist that Inquiry where requested. Submissions to the Inquiry closed on 29th September and GRSA forwarded a comprehensive submission on behalf of the Controlling Body and wider Industry. This will be considered together with other submissions that no doubt will cover the spectrum of opinions on the industry. To those who participated in the process so far – thank you. Your efforts and opinions will be valuable to the Inquiry. I will keep you updated on the progress of the Inquiry in coming weeks.

TRIALS

We are close to widening the scope of trials. There will be some changes to the process. When you arrive at trials, you will need to supply your name to Stewards to log your attendance at the venue.

This is only for the purposes of safety management. We do not need details of greyhounds and you continue to book or otherwise arrange your trial as you normally do. After you are logged in, you will receive your safety talk that is reproduced below.

Please always follow the directions of staff. Because the new system may require some changeover of equipment, please be patient.

Finally, do not proceed onto the track until directed to do so and never stand in front of, or approach, the direct path of the lure. The safety talk will include –

UNDERSTAND THE LURE

The lure is a mechanical device that travels along the path of the inner racetrack rail, controlled by a lure driver. The lure can travel very fast. The lure can start, stop, and change its speed at any time and without warning.

BEFORE THE TRIAL

Before participating at a trial, you must listen to, or read, any safety briefing and note warning signs on the racetrack. Only use the designated gates to move between areas. Never use the lure chute on a catching pen gate as a thoroughfare or jump any fences or inner rails. Where chains are in place to stop movement, do not move them without direction.

STAY CLEAR OF MOVING PARTS

You must not walk onto the racetrack surface unless under the direction and supervision of a GRSA official. You must never approach the lure, or approach or stand in the path of travel of the lure (which is within two [2] metres of the inner rail) at any time.

COMMUNICATION IS KEY

If you ever see something that you think is a hazard, while the lure is moving, yell out –

STOP LURE. STOP LURE. STOP LURE.

BE AWARE OF SURROUNDINGS

Stay alert to your surroundings. Avoid distractions like mobile phones or personal conversations that might divert your attention from the lure.

Remember, your safety and the safety of those around you are of utmost importance. By following these guidelines and respecting the rules and directions around the lure, we can create a safer and more productive environment for everyone.

Let's all work together to stay safe!

DUAL LURE

Remember that GRSA now has a dual lure that you can try at Angle Park trials. This is simply a try out for you and is not part of any imminent plan to introduce it to events. It would be good to receive your feedback in coming weeks or months (positive and negative) as we can then report to our Board about the try out and the appetite for it.

We hope to review our Animal Welfare Policy in coming months. You can refer to the policy on our web page. If you have any comments or suggestions for improvement, please let me know. I will keep you updated on this project into 2024.

For integrity and welfare matters, you may be pleased to contact the General Manager of Integrity and Welfare, Ms Kelly Rourke. For stewarding matters, please refer to the Chief Steward, Mr Des Jonas.

WAP ANNOUNCEMENT

Greyhound Racing SA advises that no Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) will be made for September 2023.

As participants are aware, the WAP calculation is based on the net wagering revenue generated each period. Wagering revenue for September 2023 was 12.5% lower in comparison to the same month from the previous financial year. This result is very much a continuance of the trend seen throughout calendar year 2023 with wagering revenue returning to pre-covid levels. In addition, the reduction is an indication of the negative impact that high inflation and interest rates continue to have on the disposable incomes of the wagering public.

As listed in the calculation below total payments to participants exceeded the 50% WAP benchmark return and thus no payment will be made for September 2023.

Payment of placement fees

The \$60 placement fee is due at the time the placement form is submitted, payment can be made by either completing the card details on the form or by paying in cash. The placement form will only be processed, and the greyhound placed in GAP, once payment has been received.

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

We continue to look to increase these further in order to offer a wider variety of times to meet participants varying requirements.

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.




