FROM THE CEO'S DESK

The Busiest of Times

Strathalbyn Swansong

In what is turning into one of the busiest periods we have known as an industry, the curtain is about to come down on racing at Strathalbyn in readiness for the imminent shift to Murray Bridge. After 47 years of operation, the final edition of the Strathalbyn Cup will be run and won this Sunday, October 21.

Strathalbyn was the second Club in South Australia to commence racing operations after the Government had passed legislation to permit wagering on greyhound racing. At that time – the year was 1971 – the Club raced over just the two distances – 585 yards (535 metres) and 825 yards (754 metres). Despite having been quick out of the boxes to commence racing, the Strathalbyn track was only promoted to the status of being a Sky venue for broadcast into hotels, agencies and homes from 2010.

The SGR has a proud history of volunteer support. The longest-serving member of the Committee, Les Newton, played a role in the construction of the track – helping to dig out the holes for the lure rail posts by hand. More recently, long time track curator Neil Wright had his outstanding contribution in that field acknowledged when he received the 2014 Volunteer of the Year award which he jointly won with Yvonne King who was recognised for her countless hours in the canteen and managing the trials. Many others have contributed to the Club's success over time with Alan McCulloch receiving recognition in the form of the Volunteer of the Year award and Lauren Harris taking out the Industry's Young Person award in 2006.

The Club has been tremendously supportive of the move to the new facility at Kennetts Road in Murray Bridge which will become only the second venue in the country (other than Geelong in Victoria) to boast two TAB tracks. The industry owes a debt of gratitude to the Strathalbyn Club for the role that it has played in keeping racing in that region strong and enabling the current opportunity for future growth as a result of the Murray Bridge venture. We would love to see as many Industry participants as possible come along to support the Club as it celebrates this final special occasion.

Murray Bridge

The cessation of racing at Strathalbyn signals the beginning of the shift to Murray Bridge. We remain optimistic about TAB racing being conducted at that venue - all things being equal - this side of the new year. In the interim, Scott Wuchatsch and Shaun Mathieson will continue to notify the industry about the progress of the project and achievements of important milestones. Prior to racing at the venue, we will need some help from industry in the form of support for trials and then some non-TAB racing to ensure that everything is functioning soundly before we take the step to the big stage. I would like to thank Scott and his team for all of their efforts in managing this complex project. He has seen this initiative through from start to finish and has delivered on budget and close to time projections without any expansion of GRSA internal staff or resourcing. No other State would have delivered this project with fewer resources or at the cost that will be achieved.

Now, more than ever, our administration and participants should feel bonded by the shared purpose of helping to get Murray Bridge up and running in the most positive manner possible. The new facility will send a message to the South Australian community and the national industry about the health of greyhound racing in this state. I hope that racing at the venue meets and exceeds any of the expectations that participants may have had of this venture. In the interim I would continue to urge everyone to have understanding about the complexity of this project and the effort that is going into getting all of the various elements right.

Adelaide Cup

This year's Adelaide Cup was a great success with attendance growing on recent figures and wagering outcomes up across the board. It goes without saying that a local victory would have been the cherry on the cake, but racing doesn't always go to script. In the background, GRSA will continue to bring rigour to the decision that was made to schedule the Million Dollar Chase in the timeslot that it has occupied in 2018 and will be seeking to ensure that the interests of our local industry are considered and respected, in relation to such decisions, at the national level.

Congratulations to our seven local finalists and their respective connections. Here's hoping that we can keep the Cup inside our borders when the event comes around again in 2019.

On a closely related note, the State of Origin concept series which was conceived by our Racing Manager, Shaun Mathieson, received some really positive feedback and even this far out, we are committed to maintaining this event as a promotional element of the Cup series going forward. It is becoming increasingly clear that match-racing – as a product – has a role to play within the broader framework of 'full field' racing.

It would be remiss of us not to acknowledge the imminent departure of our Chief Operating Officer, Sarah Webster, who has plans to return to England with her young family. On behalf of the Board, Management and staff, we would like to thank Sarah for her considerable efforts and successes wearing multiple hats for the business and wish her and husband Grant, all the very best for the next leg of their journey. Her contribution to the current health of the business and our ability to secure financing for Murray Bridge, would be hard to overstate.

Real Simple wins the 2018 Adelaide Cup



The Thompson kennel from Victoria made it four Group 1 Adelaide Cup victories in the past 10 years when Real Simple for Seona Thompson was able to lead throughout in 29.69 to win SA's premier race.

Bogie Bullet for Ben Rawlings was brave in defeat running second, only going down by 1 length, with Honcho Monelli for Tony Rasmussen motoring home out wide into third a further 3.25 lengths away. The son of Collision and Unbelief, Real Simple joined his kennel mates in Aqua Cheetah in 2016, El Galo in 2009 and Whippy's Image in 2008 making the Thompson kennel the most successful kennel in recent times of the Group 1 feature.

As part of SA's Breeders Super Bonus Scheme Kirin Corby who bred Fabwik, received \$1,000 for making the Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final along with Irene Rehmann who qualified Master Chaos.

There were over 1,500 patron's oncourse for the meeting which was up on last year's 1,200 and 950 in 2016. Chaser's Restaurant was totally booked out over a week before the Cup with around 500 people enjoying the Chaser's Buffett. There were over 180 children oncourse compared to 100 children last year who enjoyed the "Super Hero" theme night, face painters and family areas provided on the night. The Cash Grab was a big hit again, which saw plenty of patron involvement where 2 partons won between \$1,600 and \$2,000 each.

Our total UBET tote turnover on the meeting was \$355,866 compared to \$231,013 last year and \$241,235 in 2016. The Jackpot provided by UBET performed well for the Cup having a First 4 Jackpot of \$10,000 with the pool reaching \$54,176 compared to \$52,596 last year and \$51,512 in 2016 with the same jackpot.

With Curly Seal bookmaking this year his figures were \$17,890 compared to \$8,956 last year and \$10,012 in 2016.

The Adelaide Cup Consolation was won by Smart Knocka for Tracie Price while the Premier's Cup was won by Jeebus Bird for Tony Rasmussen. Also a feature on the night was the SA Country Cup which was won by Reiko Rocketta for Troy Murray representing the Gawler GRC.









Inaugural State of Origin Match Race Series won by Nations

The inaugural 2018 UBET State of Origin Match Race series (SA V Victoria) was run on September 27th at Angle Park with the South Australian greyhounds dominating the night, clean sweeping the series and winning all 4 Match Races to claim bragging rights over our Victorian counter parts.

The overall winner of the series was the Tony Rasmussen trained Nations who continued his excellent form with a brilliant all the way win against the highly rated Victorian Bernardo for trainer William Mcmahon. He ran a blistering 29.55 for the 515m journey.

The series turned out to be a tight affair with only .02 separating the top 3 overall times. Spring Bridge came second by a whisker running 29.56 for Greg Board when he used local knowledge to lead all the way for SA and defeat Saint David for Victorian trainer Peter Byrne. Coming in third was Nations kennel mate Honcho Monelli who ran a brilliant race in also leading throughout and running 29.57 in defeating the heavily supported Degani for William Mcmahon. Cairnlea Jet made it a clean sweep for SA when the Petar Jovanovic trained speedster had to come from behind and charge past Dr. Mino for Judith Mcmahon in the home straight, running a flying 29.67.

GRSA introduced this exciting new feature "State of Origin" Match Racing as a lead up to the Group 1 UBET Adelaide Cup series.

GRSA thanks the support of UBET and Sky Racing for their support of this series however would especially like to thank the local trainers and the Victorian trainers who travelled so far to ensure this series was successful.

Murray Bridge racing dates – first meeting on December 19

The racing dates for SA greyhounds for the remainder of the 2018/2019 season including Murray Bridge have been released. Whilst all dates are subsequent to change it is anticipated that the first Murray Bridge meeting will be run on Wednesday, 19th December 2018 meaning that our local schedule will change. All meetings at Murray Bridge initially will be on the One Turn track with the Straight track anticipated to have its first meeting on Wednesday, 13th February 2019.

It is GRSA's intention once Strathalbyn has conducted their last meeting on Sunday, 21st October that all maintenance equipment and other items are transferred to Murray Bridge to assist with the preparation of the new venue.

GRSA will look to trial at Murray Bridge for about one month and conduct at least one Picnic meeting (Non-TAB) to ensure everything at the venue is working prior to our first meeting on the 19th December.

GRSA appreciates the feedback from participants regarding trialling under the new schedule and would welcome any more feedback before this is reviewed and a trial schedule is released.

2018 Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup Final on November 4th

The Gawler Gold Cup carnival will be run over three meetings. The carnival will kick off on Sunday, 28th October with Heats of the Gawler Sprint Classic for open 400m greyhounds.



Stewards afterhours race day contact number

Following the notice regarding adherence to kennelling times in the previous issue of Kennel Capers,

Stewards have received a number of enquiries as to who to contact afterhours in the event of vehicle breakdown or other cause of late arrival. Please be advised that the person to contact is Chief Steward Des Jonas on 0487 189 366.

Injury re-examination

Stewards wish to draw attention to GAR73(3). Under this sub-rule trainers may apply for a reduction of injury time imposed by an on-course Veterinarian during the course of a race meeting.

The rule reads:

R73 Greyhound suffering injury

(3) Where a greyhound is prohibited pursuant to Rules 37[2] and 73[1] from competing in any Event, the trainer may, subsequent to the day that an order is made, make only 1 application to the Stewards for the greyhound to be examined by an officiating veterinary surgeon or authorised person, to determine whether at the time of the examination the greyhound is free of injury and if the greyhound is found not to be suffering an injury the restriction imposed shall be revoked.

The greyhound must be examined by the same veterinarian who initially put a penalty on the greyhound.

Stewards also advise trainers to be aware that any greyhound presenting under the above rule may be subject to the taking of a sample based on the following rule:

R83 Greyhound to be free of prohibited substances

(2) The owner, trainer or person in charge of a greyhound -

[c] presented for any test or examination for the purpose of a period of incapacitation or prohibition being varied or revoked

shall present the greyhound free of any prohibited substance.

Please feel free to contact Stewards for further information.

Veterinary Certificate of Euthanasia

It is a requirement under the Rules that when a greyhound is euthanised, a veterinary certificate of euthanasia is required to be lodged with the GRSA 106 Notification of Euthanased Greyhound form.

It is the responsibility of the person lodging this form to ensure this certificate is collected from the treating veterinary practice. GRSA will also be reminding all clinics with regular greyhound clients of the same requirement.

Reminder – free carpet squares for bedding

In an effort to help trainers who find it difficult getting adequate bedding for kennels, the Animal Welfare team have been lucky enough to secure some carpet off-cuts from Discount City Carpets and Carpet Call.

The carpet will be cut to approximately 1000 x 600 and we can help arrange collection from Angle Park or Mount Gambier. If you are interested in this, please phone the Animal Welfare team or catch-up with them on kennel inspections.

Toenails

Recently several participants have raised concerns about their dogs sustaining injuries potentially from other greyhounds' toenails during races. Just a friendly reminder to please keep your greyhound's toenails well maintained for not only their health and wellbeing but for that of others.

A factsheet prepared by GRSA will shortly be distributed on kennel inspections about toenail clipping and health.

Inquiries and notifications

Miss. Tracey Amos – Stewards inquiry 10/10/18 – GAR 86[0] – Negligent in engaging in a breeding program prior to her registration as a breeder being approved. Miss. Amos pleaded guilty and was fined \$400. GAR 127[6] – Did have an inactive breeding female inseminated. Miss. Amos pleaded guilty and was fined \$300; wholly suspended for 12 months on the basis that she does not reoffend under this Rule.

Mrs. Kathy Johnstone – Outcome of Stewards rehearing 20/08/18 – Following an inquiry into a frozen semen breeding unit inseminated into two separate breeding females, Stewards considered new evidence including an explanation from an employee of another Controlling Body who admitted giving Mrs. Johnstone incorrect advice. On that basis, Stewards noted the new information, reversed the decision lifting the convictions and penalties of the two offences Mrs. Johnstone was found guilty off. Mrs. Johnstone also signed an irrevocable undertaking with regard to the use of her remaining BRETT LEE breeding units.

Mr. Steve Meimetis – Stewards inquiry 12/09/18 – GAR 83 [2] – Failed to present the greyhound HOT MARLOW free of any prohibited substance [COBALT] for an event at Angle Park on 2 April 2018. Mr. Meimetis pleaded guilty and was disqualified for a period of four [4] months. HOT MARLOW was disqualified from the event.

Mr. Tracie Price – Notice of positive sample – greyhound CILLA BROWN was found to have COBALT in excess of the allowable threshold in a urine sample following an event at Mount Gambier on 19 August 2018. Inquiry to be scheduled at a date to be fixed.

Mr. Jamie Quinlivian – Stewards inquiry 08/10/18 – GAR 83 [2] – Failed to present the greyhound MR. WORLDWIDE free of any prohibited substance (CAFFEINE and its metabolites THEOPHYLLINE, PARAXANTHINE and THEOBROMINE) for an event at Angle Park on 21 May 2018. Mr. Quinlivian pleaded guilty and was disqualified for a period of four [4] months. MR. WORLDWIDE was disqualified from the event.

Mr. Robert Wombwell – Notice of positive sample – greyhound BANJO BONITO was found to have METFORMIN in a urine sample following an event at Mount Gambier on 22 July 2018. Inquiry to be scheduled at a date to be fixed.

The Golden Rules

Since the introduction of cobalt and arsenic thresholds, all participants should be reminded – in their own best interests – that there are a number of Golden Rules that can help them to avoid making any such breaches (for prohibited substances generally) and which should be adhered to as principles of best practice:

- Always consult your vet to seek guidance in relation to any of the products that you are using, any associated risks and other relevant context
- Review the range of any feeds or supplements that you typically purchase and, wherever it is reasonable to do so, replace products containing substances that could contribute to a threshold breach under the rules (eg. cobalt) with alternative products
- Observe the instructions on any products that you use and adhere strictly to those directions (having regard for prescribed amounts, frequency of administration/ application, methodology for administering/applying)
- Ensure a greyhound is never administered any treatment on race day other than as relates to its feeding and drinking requirements [GAR83[A][1] treats this as a specific offence]
- Refrain from the use of injectable treatments (eg. Vitamin B12) to any extent that is practical, including ensuring a greyhound is not administered any injectables the day before an event

Our registered participants have the responsibility to ensure that greyhounds are presented to the track free of any prohibited substances. This information is offered as advice in good faith and should not be relied on as a defence in the event of a breach occurring.



Long time between drinks for 'KD'

MOUNT GAMBIER

Mordred's win at Tara Raceway on Sunday, after a break of more than three months, was local sporting identity Kevin "KD" Douglas' first win with a greyhound in close to 26 years.

In fact it was on November 14, 1992 when his 26 kilogram fawn bitch called Lichine defeated Charming Gypsy over 479 metres at Glenburnie in a best of day time of 30.15 seconds.

By Wild Conquest out of Mystic Lake, Lichine, trained locally for Douglas by John Reid, won 13 races at the greyhound track situated inside the racecourse.

Fast forward something like 23 years and Douglas, in his muchvalued role of handling the major race presentations for the Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club, first encountered Moyston trainer Peter Franklin.

He recalls that Franklin, trainer of former local track record holders Ireland's Oyster (400 m) and Mojito Mayhem (512 m), as well as current 600 metre record holder McIvor Verna, presented himself as an outstanding person and also presented the multiple cups winner Mojito Mayhem in magnificent order.

"In fact, I was so impressed by Peter and the manner in which he turned out his greyhounds that I asked him if he could find me a couple of pups to race with him," Douglas said.

"It took him a while but 18 months later Peter came up with two black pups by Kinloch Brae out of Wicked Princess that he then proceeded to rear at his Moyston property. Now my portfolio included shares in three pacers and two greyhounds."

And there wasn't too much wrong with the pups' breeding. The US-bred Kinloch Brae has been an outstanding sire while Wicked Princess, a daughter of Bartrim Bale and Wicked Witch, was unraced but her litter sister Secret Spell won 23 races and more than \$276,000 in stakemoney.

Fast forward another couple of years and one of the black pups,

now named Mordred, had knocked up a couple of second placings at Tara Raceway. His first win looked imminent, however an injury sustained at Ballarat subsequently kept him off the track for 14 weeks.

Resuming from box three in Sunday's Metal Worx Maiden Stake [400 m], Mordred was slowly away but found a rails run to move into third spot down the back before finishing over the top of Red Hat Ruby and Coco Suzy to win by three-quarters of a length in 23.48 seconds.

Now, if only one of those pacers could win a race.

QUALIFYING TRIALS – NOW WEEKLY

Angle Park Qualifying Trials are run weekly on Tuesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting and the Wednesday APD meeting. Trainers must be specific on their nominations about which day they are trialling for and what distance. (ie Wed 388m, Mon 515, Mon 600m etc)

Tuesday Angle Park Qualifying dates are:

October 23rd (for APM Monday meeting on 29th October – for APD Wednesday meeting on 31st October)

October 30th (for APM Monday meeting on 5th November – for APD Wednesday meeting on 7th November)

November 6th (for APM Monday meeting on 12th November – for APD Wednesday meeting on 14th November)

November 13th (for APM Monday meeting on 19th November – for APD Wednesday meeting on 21st November)

November 20th (for APM Monday meeting on 26th November – no APD Friday meeting on 28th November due to Time Grading meeting)

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Tuesday of the meeting.

NOMINATING ONLINE FOR QUALIFYING TRIALS

For Angle Park, Gawler and Strathalbyn qualifying trials the nominations must be lodged with GRSA by 12.30pm on the day of the meeting. To nominate online however you can only do this up until 11.59pm the day before. Due to a system security policy you cannot nominate on the day for these trials online. Please contact our staff if you have any issues with these nominations prior to them closing.

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number.

POLICY FOR TRIALS IN PLACE

Remember trials will only be taken from -

- * 11.30am Monday for Angle Park Tuesday nights
- * 11.30am Tuesday for Gawler Wednesday nights

* 11.30am Thursday for Angle Park Saturday morning (day earlier due to being morning trials)

* For Public Holidays it will be the working day before ie if Monday is a Public Holiday then bookings taken on the Friday

trial days that are not booked in with GRSA remain the same process (ie Gawler Thursday)

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK AND GAWLER BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

RACE MEETING TRIAL POLICY

Angle Park Monday & Wednesday along with Gawler Tuesday, Friday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the Race Meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than 8 greyhounds nominated.

- 1. Reserves at the Meeting that do not obtain starts.
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located in an area affected by track closures.
- 3. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged.
- 4. Satisfactory trials.
- 5. Other greyhounds.

PROCEDURE/CRITERIA

- For Monday nights trainer to contact GRSA between 10.00am and 11.00am on the Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching line.
- 2. For Angle Park Wednesday, Gawler Tuesday & Friday trainer to contact GRSA between 4.00pm and 4.30pm on the day before.
- 3. For Gawler Sunday trainer to contact GRSA between 8.00am and 9.00am on the scratching line to nominate.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds Trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards allot the Box for the Greyhound.
- 6. Trials will be 515m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension or not cleared to race are not eligible to be nominated (these trials are conducted as if they are at a race meeting so all greyhounds need to be eligible at nomination time).
- 8. Greyhound registration certificate or cards must be produced at kennelling time.

9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilize the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave OR trainers with no other greyhounds will be free to leave following their trial.

If there are 12 races at Angle Park or Gawler there will be NO trials.

The Vet Clinic at these meetings cannot be used to accommodate any greyhounds to allow for extra trialling greyhounds. This policy has been introduced so that participants book in under the policy. The Vet Clinic needs to be available for the Vet and Stewards at race meetings

EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY-

- Thursday nights are kept available for the option for Interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead up to our Group races and also local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead up to a feature race upon request and they will take one of the eight kennels available for trialling ahead of the policy and sit separately to the 4 dog trials. Feature races are considered to be – Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals & any Group race Interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event and nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy.
- If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between this will be conducted as a solo trial and sit separately to the 2 four dog trials.

It is extremely important that trainers book in to trial at these race meetings. If unable to book in at these times then please contact GRSA where permission may be given to accept a booking outside of these times.

GAWLER QUALIFYING TRIALS AT GAWLER

Qualifying trials are held every Wednesday for the corresponding Tuesday.

MURRAY BRIDGE

Trials are held on SUNDAY MORNINGS, from 9am to 10.30 am. Bookings MUST be sent via Telephone to Kay Burns 0437 497 554 or Bob Harris 0410 668 682 or email to burnsron1@bigpond.com. If there are no bookings there will be no trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER

The Mt Gambier GRC committee advises that satisfactory trials can be run in the summer months under the criteria below.

- 1. On race days when there are less than 12 races.
- 2. On race days with 12 races when the temperature is 30 degrees or less trial can be run before the first race but greyhounds must leave the track straight after the trial to head back to their home kennel.
- 3. On a Saturday trial session when stewards are available.

These trials will have to be booked in with GRSA in consultation with the Mt Gambier GRC.
