## CEO'S UPDATE

### Saturday Mornings

It's really pleasing to see how the weekly flow of nominations has held up to the introduction of Saturday morning racing. The application of G-SIX grading across all meetings has enabled GRSA to consistently field meetings of 10 races or more. In turn, that will increasingly allow GRSA to reverse out any caps on race numbers immediately preceding or pursuant to our fortnightly Saturday spot. Somewhat predictably, the wagering on this meeting has a clear skew to fixed odds, particularly for the earlier races. Our aim is to see progressive growth in this space over 6, 12 and 18 months. This meeting will be favoured by the introduction of daylight saving which will push the whole schedule roughly an hour later into the day.

### Wagering Activity Payments

We're immediately seeing the benefits that can accrue from the WAP model when wagering performance is strong. August was another unusually strong month which has contributed to a WAP allocation of just over \$264,000 for the month. It would be remiss of me not to stress the fact that the expectation of WAP is far lower than has been our early experience, and that wagering can be low enough that it fails to trigger any WAP at all. However, for the moment, this part of the model is providing us with a much-needed silver lining in a year that has, otherwise, been lacking for highlights.

It's our expectation that the wagering environment in the first half of 2021 may present a different face than that which we are currently seeing, but these early WAP payments will at least give us a welcome head-start in the interim.

### Weekly Scheduling Consultation

In the coming fortnight (or so), GRSA will undertake a process of consultation with the ICG and Member Clubs in relation to various matters pertaining to weekly scheduling, both for the longer-term and during the expected interruption of racing at Angle Park in the first half of next year. One of the key considerations for that discussion will relate to what venues should race on which days with such decisions having implications for participants, nominations and wagering outcomes alike. If you have any strong views in this regard, please don't hesitate to convey those opinions to an ICG Member or any Club President or Secretary. As with any such process, we're not aiming for a perfect outcome, but rather an optimal outcome.

# Sunset Milo claims a big win in 40th Cup

## ■ MOUNT GAMBIER

It wasn't quite what the Club had envisaged for the 40th running of its time-honoured Mount Gambier Cup (512 metres), sponsored this year by David Peckham's Bourne Kennels of Allendale East.

After a delay due to COVID, the Mount Gambier Cup was held on August 30th and while retaining Group Listed status the prizemoney was reduced to a \$10,000 first prize but there weren't too many complaining about that.

With the SA-Victoria border still closed, the success of the Mount Gambier Cup ultimately came down to local support and that of Adelaide trainers.

Visiting trainers Tony Rasmussen, Tim Aloisi, Damien Bates, Ben Rawlings, Tim Richards and Michael Stewart threw their support behind the event to the extent that five heats were run at the Sunday, August 23 meeting.

Aloisi, of Munno Para West, and better known as an owner, stepped in as caretaker trainer of three of his top dogs, bringing Sunset Milo, Kipling and Rajasthan over from Rob Camilleri and Deb Coleman's Lara kennels.

And as things turned out, the successful Victorian training team would have loved to have been at Tara Raceway, especially after being on track last year to witness Slingshot Hammer go down by the narrowest of margins to Galactic Athena.

The trio made their way through to the final, with Aloisi holding a particularly strong hand after former WA chaser Sunset Milo, a son of My Bro Fabio and Jewel Action, ran a near-record 29.29 seconds in his heat win.

However, Sunset Milo, who jumped a \$1.90 favourite, couldn't match the early pace of Kipling out in box six, the son of Fernando Bale x Some Kinda Girl opening up a big break down the back and leaving his kennelmate to do the chasing.

Turning for home, Kipling still held a slight advantage. Even half-way up the straight he looked to have the favourite's measure. On the line, though, it was Sunset Milo who got the nod in what was a race record 29.42 seconds.

Rough Pearl, a son of Dyna Double One and West On Jorji, flew the flag for the locals, running a five lengths third – the margin likely to have been a bit less than that but for a check down the back.

Actually, one could have been excused for thinking Worrolong trainer Lee Bartholomew had won the cup with the \$31 chance Rough Pearl such was her excitement after the race!

Sunset Milo is raced by Aloisi and Matt Lehman who also ran the quinella in the past two Gawler Gold Cups with Honcho Monelli and Shima Breeze in 2018 and Awesome Catch and Immediate. They also own Kipling in partnership with Damien Bates and Mick McSorley.

Aloisi, who is involved in about 20 greyhounds in Adelaide and Melbourne, was delighted to win his first cup as a trainer but was quick to give credit to

Camilleri and Coleman.

"A lot of trainers wouldn't have wanted the dogs to leave their kennels but Rob and Deb had enough faith in me to send them over so that we could have a crack at the Mount Gambier Cup," he said.

"We love the Mount Gambier track, it's one of the best places to race in Australia. And the Mount Gambier Cup is a race we've wanted to win for a long time.

"Sometimes it's not about the money. It's about the thrill of winning a cup and meeting a lot of good people along the way. Even Deb was crying after yesterday's win!"

It was the biggest crowd Tara Raceway had seen this year. Certainly no record but pretty good considering the obstacles involved in running and promoting the event in the current climate.

# Jabari's win lifts trainers spirit

Jabari gave trainer Neil Mann a much needed boost when he was able to take out the 2020 Kings And Queen's Final at Angle Park on September 3. Neil had been suffering some ill health recently and the win of Jabari has certainly lifted his spirits.

The son of Fernando Bale and Flying Cheryl began well from box 5 to move forward and challenge for the early lead with Established for Cameron Butcher pushing through hard along the rails from box 2 as they reached the finishing post on the first occasion. Back in third was the Gavin Harris trained Springvale Shine closely followed by Sweet Rose [box 1] for Nicole Price and race favourite Blister [box 4] for Chris Jaensch who was only fairly away.

Entering the back straight and Established and Jabari had raced clear of their rivals by about 4 lengths with Springvale Shine



moving to a clear third while Spring Burner for Greg Board made good ground out wide into fourth. Jabari put his paw to the floor down the back straight and ran to the front opening up a good break from Established who was battling on well. Both Springvale Shine and Spring Burner continued to run home well. Prior to running for home Jabari was in full flight in the lead with Established coming under pressure from Springvale Shine who ran to second. As they approached the finish line Jabari was hanging on from a fast finishing Springvale Shine to win by



1 length. Spring Burner charged home late into third a further 2.5 lengths away just ahead of Established. Jabari ran a solid 30.30 for the 515m with splits of 4.43 and 16.97.

Jabari is owned by Dwayne Jiggins and Teresa Mann and is locally bred by Leon Cummins. He has now won 11 races with 11 placings from 30 starts with career prizemoney just over \$20,000. Steve Coates who was in charge of Jabari advised that Neil should be back at the races very soon and it would be a great thrill for him.

## INTERSTATE GREYHOUNDS COMING TO SA FOR FEATURE EVENTS

**Following Government advise since COVID-19 restrictions were put in place from earlier in the year GRSA have not been accepting any nominations from trainers domiciled in other States and this remains the case at present.**

It is possible for Interstate greyhounds to compete in SA, however, they must be transferred into the kennels of a trainer domiciled in SA.

As the COVID-19 situation can change rapidly, GRSA will continue to update all participants of any changes to racing restrictions.

## TAB SA MATCH RACE SERIES – CLOSE MONDAY, 21ST SEPTEMBER

**Due to border restrictions the normal State of Origin Match Race series (SA V VIC) has been postponed for 2020. Instead SA will still run a Match Race series on Thursday, 24th September for the best greyhounds nominated.**

The Graders decision will be final and he will use all information available for him to select the "Best" greyhounds nominated. Trainers are encouraged to nominate and also provide an alternate race type nomination if not selected.

### Conditions -

- 515m Special Event - No Penalties Apply • Best 8 greyhounds in match race conditions
- 4 match races worth \$2,500 - \$3,250 each (runner-up \$350) with overall winner receiving \$5,000, 2nd place \$1,430 and 3rd place \$715.
- Nominations close Monday, 21st September at 9am.

The head to head matches will be decided based on the final listing and nominations. Match 1 will be 1 v 4, Match 2 will be 2 v 3, Match 3 will be 5 v 8 and Match 4 will be 6 v 7. The Grader will then have to randomly draw the boxes [1 or 3] that each greyhound starts from. The most prizemoney will be allocated to the highest rated match.

GRSA will also have exclusive footage from inside the boxes of the greyhounds which has been a real highlight in past years.

GRSA conducted the Easter Match Race series in April where Alfieri won for Bill Wudarczyk in a sizzling 29.54. As part of that series, for winning, Alfieri would be guaranteed a spot as an SA representative in the State Of Origin. Whilst that series has been postponed GRSA will honour this condition with accepting Alfieri as one of the 8 greyhounds for the SA Match Race series so long as he is nominated.

GRSA will continue the condition that the overall winner of the SA Match Race series will be guaranteed a spot in the Group 1 Adelaide Cup on Friday, 9th October.



# Shadow Mist wins awards ahead of a big Spring

Greyhound of the Month for August was Shadow Mist for trainer Lauren Harris which only had two race starts for the month, winning them both, but what significant races they were.

The son of Dyna Double One and Diva's Shadow started the month off with a sizzling win in an SA Heat of the National Sprint Championships at Angle Park where he blew away his opposition in a blistering 29.33 leading throughout and winning by 9.50 lengths. He then started a red hot favourite in the SA Final and repeated the dose with a dazzling display, winning by 4.50 lengths in 29.39. This also booked his spot, if they accepted, into the Million Dollar Chase Semi-Finals in October. Connections elected to take Shadow Mist to NSW and trial at Wentworth Park leaving their options open for a return trip which is why the greyhound had only two starts for the month.



At the end of the month Shadow Mist's record stood at 43 starts for 19 wins and 10 placings and earnings around \$53,000,

with some exciting racing ahead for this star sprinter.

The Run of the Month for August was also Shadow Mist for trainer Lauren Harris for his performance in a Heat of the National Championships at Angle Park on Thursday, 6th August.

He exploded from the boxes to lead early and whilst there was some interference on the first turn it had no impact on his performance. He ran splits of 4.39, 16.62 with an overall of 29.33, one of the quickest times recorded in recent times. He won by 9.50 lengths and dominated his rivals.

**With GRSA being able to race on Friday, 9th October due to the support of GRV swapping their meetings, Gawler will race in the twilight on Thursday, 8th October.**

This has been the case for the last few years.

## GREYHOUND RACING SOUTH AUSTRALIA - 2020 SA COUNTRY CUP

**Below are details of how and where greyhounds can qualify for the \$6,430 SA Country Cup Final [G-SIX], to be run at Angle Park over 515 metres on Adelaide Cup Final night Friday, 9th October 2020.**

### Conditions:

- All South Australian Greyhound Racing Clubs outside of Angle Park will conduct Heats, or nominate greyhounds from which the Greyhound Racing SA Grading Department will choose two representatives. These meetings are Gawler Provincial 2, Murray Bridge One Turn Provincial 1 and Mount Gambier Provincial 2. [Performances at Gawler Provincial 1 meetings are not eligible for consideration]
- The event is open to all South Australian greyhounds that are not above Grade 5 at Angle Park [APK City A & APM City B meetings only] over 515 metres at the time of nomination. Winner of each event takes a penalty including the Final.

There are no Special Exceptions this year as ALL greyhounds must be SA trained to be eligible:

- A South Australian trained greyhound is defined as one that has been racing in SA for a period of not less than 3 out of the 6 months immediately prior to the time of nomination.
- The trainer can only qualify for one of the Clubs.
- The trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 3 months.
- Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.
- The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track it is attempting to represent.

- There will be a maximum of two Heats per Club with the winners of each Heat qualifying. If there is only one Heat conducted then the first two placegetters will qualify.
- The two reserves will be determined firstly by a ballot of the second placegetters from all Heats. The third placegetters will then be considered by ballot if required. If a Heat was not conducted at the track, then that track is not included in the ballot. Should a greyhound be withdrawn prior to the ballot, the next placed greyhound from that Club's Heat will be selected.
- Once a greyhound has qualified from a Qualifying Heat, it is not eligible to compete at another track in this series, unless there are insufficient nominations to fill the field.
- Once qualified for the Country Cup Final the greyhound will be ineligible for the Adelaide Cup series or any other race on Cup Final night.
- Lead up Heats may be up to 8 greyhounds, however, the Final on Adelaide Cup night will be a G-SIX Final

## MURRAY BRIDGE TO RACE ON FRIDAY, 25TH SEPTEMBER

**When the 2020/2021 calendars were released months ago Murray Bridge was scheduled to race on Friday, 25th September and swap with Gawler who will race on Sunday, 27th September.**

This was due to the Murray Bridge Show and Murray Bridge Speedway scheduled on that day. Due to COVID -19 the Show was cancelled a few months ago, however, the Speedway was only cancelled a month ago on their website. With Gawler well underway with a Sunday night offering GRSA decided to retain the schedule that was released months ago.

With this change Murray Bridge will now trial on Thursday, 24th September and Gawler will trial on Friday, 25th September.

### COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED "ONLY"

**A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields, in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds. The panel previously resolved that "Only" would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]**

If trainers put "Only or no start or leave me out" then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

## MASTERS GRADE 5 RACES

Previously the GRP approved Time Standards for Grade 5 Masters Events at different tracks over different distances.

When a greyhound breaks the Time Standard they will be ineligible for a Grade 5 Masters Event at that distance and track [Prov1, City A etc]. They will have to have two unplaced runs at the track and distance in other races before being re-considered for a Grade 5 Masters event at that venue over that distance. Mixed Masters events are not considered under this criteria.

Trainers who fall within the radius and have obtained approval from SAPOL are required to supply GRSA with the approval. Upon receipt GRSA will accept nominations from the trainer for Mt Gambier meetings only. All approvals are from SAPOL and GRSA will accept their direction.

GRSA advises that the boxing procedure for feature Heat and Finals will revert back to 2 rows effective immediately where applicable. GRSA will continue to monitor these processes.

## REMOTE TRAINERS FEE TO ASSIST MOUNT GAMBIER MEETING

With continuing border restrictions affecting participation in the South East due to COVID-19, GRSA has decided to support the Mount Gambier meetings knowing the importance to be racing on a weekly basis during this time.

For those trainers that live more than 150 kilometres from Mount Gambier and travel to these meetings they will receive an additional \$75 payment to their normal Trainers Fee. The fee will be capped at one payment per registered premises and will continue until the borders are open.

## GOTBA COURSE SUNDAY, 27TH SEPTEMBER

The next GOTBA meeting at Virginia will be on Sunday, 27th September and they will be running their feature events for the year.

Nominations permitting the Oaks, Derby and Waterloo Cup will be run. These events will only be 8 dog fields and open to greyhounds that have coursed before or GOTBA members who have supported the Club this year and previous years.

# SATURDAY MORNING FORTNIGHTLY MEETINGS

## We recently introduced the fortnightly Saturday morning meeting at Angle Park.

To accommodate this meeting through our weekly schedule we made some changes to the amount of races run during and after this meeting at other venues. We have changed to all G-SIX accept for feature and specific races, moved the Wednesday meetings to be back to back Straight track and then Angle Park on a 3 week rotation. We have also made the Saturday morning meetings Time Graded with alternate conditions as this is the biggest group of greyhounds, with programming crucial to accommodate the weekly schedule. There is a meeting drawn for this Saturday 19th September with the first of 10 races to start at 8.52am and the last of 10 at 11.22am. This meeting has 4 Heats of the 1-4 win Time Graded over the 388m with the greyhounds running the fastest times in the Heats, regardless of their finishing position in those Heats qualifying for a \$1,230 Final at Angle Park on Monday, 26th September.

The next meeting will be on Saturday morning, 3rd October with the below program –

Timed Graded Meeting - "Worst to Best" rating. 1-4 AND 5 + WIN RACES WILL HAVE FIRST PREFERENCE

Greyhounds graded into 3 categories. Maidens, 1-4 wins & 5 or more wins. Specific grades of greyhounds are not considered except for Maidens. Races–N/P with Pathway Prizemoney. Reserves will be determined by Grader. There will be No Guarding. Refer to "Time Based Grading" published conditions.

- Nominations close Tuesday, 29th September at 9.00am.

## ADJUSTMENT TO WEEKLY SCHEDULE'S

**GRSA advised that they would be restricting the number of races run each week to accommodate the weekly schedule with the introduction of the fortnightly Saturday morning. This has been working on a basic 12 races in the first week and then 10 in the second under certain conditions.**

With the encouraging nomination numbers across the week recently GRSA has changed to 12 races in the first week and 11 in the second. Which has now been implemented.

## OZCHASE BOX DRAW AUDIT

**The most recent Box Draw Audit for all Ozchase States has been completed with SA details available on the GRSA website.**

Below refers to the Introduction, Results and Conclusions.

### Introduction

The Centre for Applied Statistics [CAS] of the University of Western Australia [UWA] was contacted by Mark Bottcher [Greyhound System Coordinator & Analyst – Project Delivery] from Racing and Wagering Western Australia [RWAA] and asked to perform a statistical analysis of results from actual greyhounds races in various Australian states and territories [NSW, NT, QLD, SA, TAS and WA] in which RWAA's box draw algorithm was used. This box draw algorithm is supposed to randomly allocate, for a given race, the greyhounds that run in the race to the boxes that are used in the race, such that each greyhound is equally likely to be allocated to any of the boxes used.

Specific questions of interest are whether there is any evidence in the data that the box draw algorithm does not perform as designed

when looking at:

1. the allocation of individual greyhounds to boxes over all the races that they ran in,
2. the allocation of the greyhound[s] of any owner to boxes over all races in which that owner had greyhound[s] running,
3. the allocation of the greyhound[s] of any trainer to boxes over all races in which that trainer had greyhound[s] running, and
4. the allocation of greyhounds trained by the same trainer to neighbouring boxes, if a trainer had multiple greyhounds in the same race.

The analysis was proposed to be done for each state and territory separately. The following section will describe the methodology used to analyse the data followed by the results of the analyses for each state and territory in Section 3. A summary conclusion from all these analyses is given in Section 4.

### Results

#### Races in South Australia

The provided spreadsheet contained information on 20,479 races held at 1,867 meetings between 1 January 2015 and 31 December 2019. There were 7,572 unique greyhound IDs, 2,650 unique owner IDs and 664 unique trainer IDs.

#### Allocation of individual greyhounds

The analysis of the actual overall allocation of greyhounds to boxes provided no evidence against the assumption that in every race every greyhound is equally likely to be assigned to any one of the boxes used [pall=0.640]. Analysing each individual greyhound's allocation to boxes, taking into account that this involves the analysis of 7,572 p-values by either using a 1% significance level with a Bonferroni correction or controlling the false discovery rate at 1%, provided no evidence that the box allocation of any individual greyhound was suspicious. Analysing the 1,224 p-values for the subset of greyhounds that started in at least 40 races yielded the same result, i.e. no evidence was found that the assumption, that each greyhound is equally likely to be assigned to any one of the boxes used in races in which the greyhound ran, is not tenable.

#### Allocation of greyhounds by owner

The analysis of the actual overall allocation of greyhounds owned by the same owner to boxes provided no evidence against the assumption that in every race every greyhound is equally likely to be assigned to any one of the boxes used [pall=0.260]. Analysing for each individual owner the allocation of his or her greyhound[s] to boxes, taking into account that this involves the analysis of 2,650 p-values by either using a 1% significance level with a Bonferroni correction or controlling the false discovery rate at 1%, provided no evidence that the box allocation of greyhound[s] belonging to the same owner was suspicious for any of the owners. Analysing the 789 p-values for the subset of owners who had greyhounds starting at least 40 times yielded the same result, i.e. no evidence was found that the assumption, that the greyhound[s] of any owner is/are equally likely to be assigned to any of the boxes used in races in which the greyhound[s] ran, is not tenable.

#### Allocation of greyhounds by trainer

The analysis of the actual overall allocation of greyhounds trained by the same trainer to boxes provided no evidence against the assumption that in every race every greyhound is equally likely to be assigned to any one of the boxes used [pall=0.715]. Analysing for each individual trainer the allocation of his or her greyhound[s] to boxes, taking into account that this involves the analysis of 644 p-values by either using a 1% significance level with a Bonferroni correction or controlling the false discovery rate at 1%, provided no evidence that the box allocation of greyhound[s] trained by the same trainer was suspicious for any of the trainers. Analysing the 329



p-values for the subset of trainers who had greyhounds starting at least 40 times yielded the same result, i.e. no evidence was found that the assumption, that the greyhound(s) of any trainer is/are equally likely to be assigned to any of the boxes used in races in which the greyhound(s) ran, is not tenable.

#### Allocation of greyhounds to neighbouring boxes

Of the 20,479 races in the spreadsheet, 15,292 were races with 8 runners and in 6,182 of those at least one trainer had exactly two greyhounds running. Altogether there were 317 trainer IDs involved and 7,574 cases in which trainers had exactly two greyhounds running in a race.

The analysis of the overall contingency table provided no evidence against the hypothesis that allocation mechanism works as it is designed to do ( $p=0.304$ ). Analysing the results for individual trainers, taking into account that this involves the analysis of 317 p-values by either using a 1% significance level with a Bonferroni correction or controlling the false discovery rate at 1%, provided no evidence that any trainer has his or her two greyhounds allocated more often to neighbouring boxes than what would be expected under the allocation mechanism. Analysing the 73 p-values for the subset of trainers who have exactly two greyhounds starting in at least 20 races yielded the same result, i.e. no evidence was found that the assumption, that the two greyhounds of any trainer are equally likely to be assigned to any of the 8 boxes, is not tenable.

#### Conclusions

RWWA's box draw algorithm is supposed to allocate, in any given race, the participating greyhounds to boxes in such a manner that each greyhound is equally likely to be assigned to any of the employed boxes. The summary conclusion from all the analyses reported in Section 3 is that there is no evidence in the data to suggest that RWWA's box algorithm does not work as designed

when analysing the data with respect to

- the allocation of individual greyhounds to boxes over all the races that they ran in,
- the allocation of the greyhound(s) of any owner to boxes over all races in which that owner had greyhound(s) running,
- the allocation of the greyhound(s) of any trainer to boxes over all races in which that trainer had greyhound(s) running, and
- the allocation of greyhounds trained by the same trainer to neighbouring boxes, if a trainer had two greyhounds in the same race.

## GRSA PLAN TO DISSEMINATE SCRATCHINGS IN A MORE TIMELY MANNER

**Historically, it has been GRSA's standard practice to wait until after the appointed scratching time to officially release all the scratchings.** GRSA would not release any scratchings for a meeting until this time. However, in the current climate with many wagering organisations wanting to open markets early on our races, they are not able to do so due to greyhounds potentially being scratched for injury, illness, ineligibility etc. This can affect potential revenue back to the industry with persons not able to invest, or investing and having the market alter when scratchings are finalised. This will also provide greater transparency for trainers, staff and our business.

For a trial period of 3 months it will be GRSA's intention upon receiving a scratching from a trainer to input this into OzChase at that time, which will then be made public through the GRSA website. Once the greyhound has been scratched by the trainer and made public it is considered as being withdrawn. This is not uncommon practice with other States doing the same thing. For greyhounds that become ineligible for a race meeting due to winning a Maiden event, racing on consecutive days, offending during the run or being injured on the night etc and engaged in another race meeting, GRSA staff will automatically scratch the greyhound (as it is ineligible) at either the completion of the meeting when finalised by the stewards or the next working day. We have always encouraged trainers to scratch these greyhounds that have become ineligible for their next engagements, however, this is not always the case with staff waiting to withdraw them at the appointed time. For trainers in certain circumstances that may wish to appeal an offence with their greyhound engaged in another event then they would be required to flag that intent with the stewards on the day.

The benefits of this change will provide -

- Transparency across our meetings
- Correct information in real time
- Wagering companies can field up to date markets
- Allows punters to wager with confidence
- Allows for wagering dollars not to be tied up until after the 'All Clear' of a race if a selection was scratched

This has been in place since Monday, 24th August 2020.

## Hot Weather Policy review complete

The GRSA Hot Weather Policy was reviewed in March at an Industry Consultative Group Meeting. Some important changes have been made:

- 1) Early kennelling will be implemented if the temperature is expected to reach or exceed 35 degrees at kennelling time. Participants will be advised via text message.
- 2) Trainers will no longer be required to provide a Veterinary Certificate confirming that a greyhound suffers from heat stress to have a greyhound included on the Heat Stress Register.
- 3) Early kennelling will not be provided for day meetings. It will apply to twilight and night meetings only.

# Projects Update

## Murray Bridge Straight Track Catching Pen

**After nearly 12 months of incident free racing on the Murray Bridge straight track, the past few months have seen a number of catching pen incidents resulting in injuries to greyhounds.**

GRSA has been proactive in investigating the root cause of these incidents, engaging with participants, veterinarians, stewards and interstate authorities to seek ongoing improvements to the running of straight track races.

A comparison of the Murray Bridge Straight track catching pen to the three existing straight racing tracks (Healesville, Capalaba and Appin) on the next page, show the differences are relatively immaterial.

Feedback from interstate authorities also suggest that the greatest challenge for straight track racing is the conclusion of the race when greyhounds are stopping very quickly, we share a common issue.

Earlier this week management held a consultation session with a small industry group to discuss ideas which could further improve the safety of the Murray Bridge straight track catching pen.

The following is the outcome of that discussion:

### 1. GREYHOUND EDUCATION

The group noted that the large majority of incidents have involved inexperienced, northern region trained greyhounds that had never trialled or raced at the track.

It was agreed that GRSA should be providing more education to participants and more trialling opportunities for greyhounds to increase experience on the unique nature of the straight track.

**ACTION 1** - Educational material regarding the benefits of trialling before racing on the straight track be made available to participants.

**ACTION 2** - MBGRC look to expand the Tuesday evening trial session (during daylight savings) to include straight track trialling.

### 2. VISUAL DISTRACTIONS

The group felt there was a need to further differentiate the catching pen from the actual race track, by increasing visual cues for the greyhounds that the race had concluded.

**ACTION 3** - Placing a person in the catching pen on the grandstand side to throw the decoy lure to the rear of the pen. This person to have a whistle and secondary decoy in the event they are required to distract a trailing greyhound.

**ACTION 4** - Further visual markers to be placed on the rear of the catching pen fence.

### 3. SURFACE PREPARATION

In early August, the MBGRC maintenance team commenced pre-meeting harrowing of the catching pen surface, which the group felt was a significant improvement.

**ACTION 5** - The deep harrowing of the catching pen prior to each meeting to continue to create a very soft surface.

**ACTION 6** - The maintenance team to apply water to the catching pen during the meeting if necessary, subject to weather conditions.

### 4. AUDIBLE LURE OPTIONS

The absence of lure noise using the remote/battery lure was discussed, with the group feeling that some type of electronic lure noise could benefit holding the attention of the greyhounds in the catching pen.

**ACTION 7** - Management discuss with Steriline racing the possibility of adding an electronic squeaker noise to the remote/battery lure.

### 5. INFRASTRUCTURE CHANGES

The group discussed options to modify the catching pen, including lengthening and widening the pen to different levels and it was agreed that widening of the catching pen could only provide benefit.

It was felt one of the biggest issues was greyhounds turning and running back down the track once the lure had disappeared.

To address this, the group proposed that the fence between the stationary lure and the catching pen be made transparent, to hold greyhounds at the point where the lure stops.

**ACTION 8** - The northern catching pen fence be realigned, resulting in a widening of the pen by 2 metres at its rear.

**ACTION 9** - Replacing the northern catching pen fence with Perspex panels, to allow the greyhounds to keep a visual with the race lure post-race.

These changes will be progressively rolled out over the coming weeks, with some of the logistical changes in place for the next straight track race meeting on Wednesday 23rd September.

It is expected that all changes, including those to infrastructure, will be completed prior to the straight track meeting on Wednesday, 21st October.

The consultation group will continue to monitor the outcome of these changes and have discussed a number of additional interventions that could be considered if necessary.

# WARNING – Snake Season!

**Spring is peak season for snake activity and brown snakes have been spotted in and around the Murray Bridge slipping track.**

Trainers should be vigilant and GRSA recommends walking the track prior to slipping greyhounds.

If you spot a snake, try to back away slowly to a safe distance and wait for the snake to move away.

The MBGRC maintenance team will spend some time in the coming weeks to try and 'snake proof' the slipping track, by blocking potential access points.

## New GAP Process

The Greyhound Adoption Program is changing to a new streamlined Foster and Adoption Process on September 21st.

We have been utilising a scrupulous matching process to find the best homes for the greyhounds in the GAP SA program, but now it is time for a change. Rather than us finding a family for each greyhound that is retired to GAP, we are going to give the public the opportunity to apply for the greyhound that they wish to foster or adopt. We will no longer be retaining an ongoing list of applications that we match, instead we will be assessing applications for specific greyhounds as they are received.

### SO WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU?

- All of our greyhounds will be listed on our website for applications. We expect this to help certain greyhounds move faster on the waiting list. While dogs will get advertised according to their position on the waiting list, we cannot predict which ones will be taken first.
- A more streamlined process. Allowing us to rehome more greyhounds more efficiently, with a quicker matching process, working towards a lower wait time for trainers.
- We will need more assistance with information regarding the greyhound and high quality photos. As all greyhounds will need to be listed on our website we will need bios and high quality photos of every greyhound entered into the program.
- Implementation of designated handover days/times. We will operate designated handover sessions at GAP Offices for greyhounds entering foster care.

We will be switching over to this new process this Monday, 21st September - please call GAP if you have any questions.

## Do you have a small dog?

Do you or someone you know have a small dog that could benefit from some socialisation and company during the day?

GAP SA is looking for small dogs to help with their green collar and first point assessments.

Your dog will be well looked after with plenty of pats and treats throughout the day. They will assist with either green collar assessments for dogs that have been living with foster carers or for greyhounds entering the program.

During assessments, greyhounds will be muzzled, on a leash and handled by an experienced assessor and handlers. All dogs will be walked around together in a secure testing area for approximately 5-10 mins to assess the greyhound's reaction to the small dog. If the greyhound is reacting well we will allow them to approach and sniff the small dog.

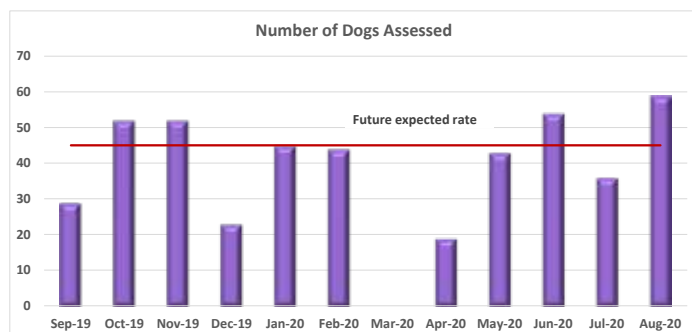

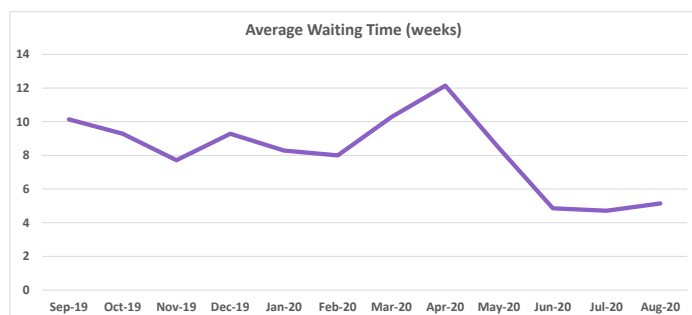
## Latest updates from GAP

The field bunched a little behind Marlee Jaye, with Marlee Jaye getting out to a four length break over Our Boy Wolf. That dog was able to gradually reduce the margin, and entering the home straight, he was able to raise another effort, but Marlee Jaye wasn't to be headed, winning with a margin of 1¼ lengths in hand. Winning in a very good time of 22.78 secs, Marley Jaye was able to turn the tables on Our Boy Wolf, when she had run second to that dog in the Heat. Our Boy Wolf ran a very good second for Brenton Prouse of Kadina.

Marlee Jaye gave her owner and trainer, Liz Harley a big thrill in winning, particularly as she had also bred the blue female as well. From a litter of nine that Liz whelped and reared, this was the first litter from her former good racer Australasian Tab. It was also special for Liz's daughter Hayley, who shared the litter with her mother, with Marlee Jaye being named after Hayley's daughter. Liz said that Hayley brings her luck and now has the boxing duties on race day.

Coming off a month's spell, Liz is pleased with Marlee's progress in her short career, even though she has some learning to do, in particular correcting a tendency to run wide. Marlee's record now stands at two wins and three seconds from six starts.

Liz loves the dogs and showed that with an impromptu kiss for Marlee after the race, and said greyhounds are responsible for keeping her going. This was the first race in a series of special events that this group of dogs are eligible for, and Liz intends to compete in the other races, being confident that she can



run the 515m distance at Angle Park.

Liz has been involved with greyhounds for over 40 years, and currently has some 26 dogs of various ages on her property. To be able to work with that number requires a lot of help, and she said that without the help of partner Tim Ieraci, she wouldn't be able to do it.

# TRIALS

## QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday (drawn Thursday) or Wednesday (drawn Friday) meetings.

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the Tuesday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations for both of these qualifying trials close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Wednesday.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held on a monthly basis at a Friday morning session, which has both tracks trialling. The next session will be Friday, 16th October. Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Thursday prior.

## ANGLE PARK

### SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

### BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to [trialbooker.com](http://trialbooker.com), create an account and book your own trials.

## POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

### Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

### Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Tuesday and Friday, Murray Bridge Wednesday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kennelling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

### Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Gawler Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before.
3. For Murray Bridge Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

## Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

## MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.
