CEO'S UPDATE

Bricks and Mortar

The completion of works at Angle Park is an important milestone in a venue strategy which dates back over a decade. At that point in time, the industry had to make some difficult decisions about how the number and location of tracks across the state could be reconciled with a sustainable commercial model. The other pressing challenge at that time related to the aged nature of some facilities and some acknowledgment of the fact that existing tracks would need to undergo a process of 'renewal' at some point in time, as has been the case with headquarter in recent months.

Over the course of that decade, GRSA has spent more than \$20 million on infrastructure works, with the predominant share of that being directed towards facilities and tracks. Obviously the two 'big ticket' items prior to this recent project at Angle Park were the establishment of a new dual track facility at Murray Bridge and the replacement of the refurbished 'shed' at Gawler with a modern two-storey patron complex. With regard to the latter, the Club has continued to invest faithfully in further development of the ground floor facilities in an effort to make the venue more flexible from both a raceday and function perspective.

The next two items on the 'hit-list' include the addition of an external patron area at Murray Bridge, to complement the main facility, and the renovation of the patron facility at Mt Gambier. Preliminary drawings and concept work have commenced for both projects. From a track perspective, Mt Gambier has had recent design changes to incorporate the learnings from University of Technology Sydney (UTS) and, of course, similar thinking has been enshrined in the design of the two new tracks at Murray Bridge and, now, the renewed Angle Park circuit.

It's a critical part of our charter to ensure that the sport is conducted to a modern standard which has fundamental regard for greyhound welfare, patron comfort and our reputational standing with the public. And even though we will always have some new requirement in this space, we find ourselves many times closer to the winning post than the starting boxes than was the case at the beginning of that decade.

Radley 'fantastic' at Murray Bridge in Distance Final

MURRAY BRIDGE

Fantastic Radley continued his dominance of the Murray Bridge 680m journey when he made it 9 wins in a row in the SA final of the National Distance Championship series.

Starting a raging hot favourite the son of Fernando Bale and Fantastic Dotty looked a certain winner, however, as the boxes flew open his chances drifted dramatically as he was badly away and found himself last early. New Year Tears for Ryan Tugwell, Tapestry Tears for Lauren Harris and Bedrock Fred for Cherylee Barber all showed good speed early to challenge for the lead. Staying star Sir Truculent for Wally Harkins began steadily to secure a spot midfield early as they raced out of the front straight. Bedrock Fred showed great pace and quickly ran to the front however, he was quickly challenged by Fantastic Radley who showed amazing acceleration to circumnavigate the field and challenge for the front. Departure Gate for Damien Bates, Sir Truculent and New Years Tears all looked to make ground but as they headed off the back straight, not only had Fantastic Radley ran to the front but he had opened up a sizeable lead with the quality field of stayers all struggling to stay with the Murray Bridge star. As they raced for home there was no stopping Fantastic Radley as he went on to win by 6 1/2 lengths in a handy 38.96. Bedrock Fred stuck on very well for second while Sir Truculent who got motoring in the last section will be looking forward to the 730m distance at Angle Park.

With the National Championships canceled at the Meadows it's a shame Fantastic Radley couldn't be tested against the best in Australia because the form he is in he would very extremely competitive for SA.



Rushes proves too good again at Murray Bridge

With the State Finals of the Nationals at Murray Bridge this year, Rushes for Lisa Rasmussen would have been feeling confident after his brilliant performance when winning the Shane McQueen Feature back in June and again he proved too good for his rivals.

After winning his heat he was sent out at the surprisingly good odds of \$7 and after beginning midfield he looked in trouble as quality sprinters Danyo's Charlie for Lauren Harris and Gary's Miracle for Michael Stewart pounced on the early lead. However, with some tightening in the lead, Rushes was presented with the best clear run ever to race to the to the lead. Around the outside came Steal The Prize for Matthew Payne to challenge Gary's Miracle as a bit of crowding occurred off the back straight. But it was Rushes who was racing in clear air in the lead and in no danger of stopping as he raced away for a brilliant win in 29.78 in winning by 3 lengths. Steal The Prize never gave in for second and as a Grade 6 performer looks very promising for the future while Maximum Refusal charged home into third for David Peckham a further 1 1/4 lengths away.

Rushes now looks one of the leading contenders as we head towards the Group 1 Adelaide Cup series.

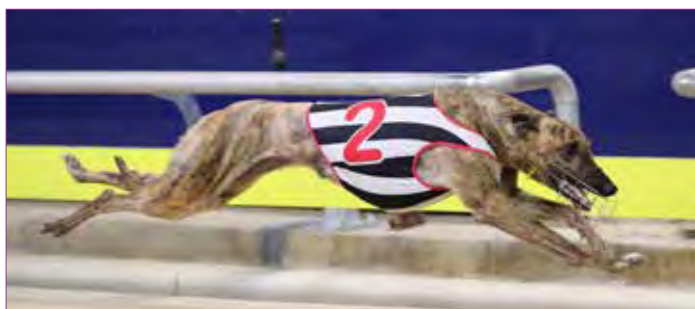

The first feature final back at the newly redeveloped Angle Park was the 2021 Kings and Queens Final over the 530m trip on Thursday, September 2 which was won by Adele's Entity for trainer Adrien Chevalier.

After a fantastic 30.61 second win in her heat the previous Thursday night, Adele's Entity was the pre-race favourite after drawing box 2 for the final. The final field was dominated by the very successful 'Victa' littermates for the Rasmussen kennel with 6 runners represented including Howard Ashton winner Victa Haydn and the other favourite in the race Victa Reid. The other 'non-Victa' runner making up the 8 for the field was Meet Joe Black for trainer Bec Romyn who was coming off some very handy form at the Murray Bridge straight track.

It all went to plan for Adele's Entity with the daughter of Fernando Bale and Zara's Entity beginning brilliantly from box 2 to pinch a handy break on the field to the first turn and from there it was a question of whether the strong Victa dogs could catch her.

Heading down the back straight Adele's Entity kept Victa Kurt at bay by a length and a half as Victa Emma and Victa Haydn made moves through the field to get into handy positions. As they rounded the final bend into the home straight it was clear Adele's Entity wasn't going to give up her advantage finishing strongly to an all-the-way to claim a great win ahead of the fast-finishing Victa Haydn in second for Tony Rasmussen and Victa Kurt who ran solidly in third for Lisa Rasmussen. It was the 3rd win in a row for the promising chaser since coming to South Australia for owners Tim Aloisi and Matt Lehman and she looks to have a bright future ahead.

Racing Report

TAB Match Race Challenge – SA takes on the All-Stars – Nominations Close Monday 20th September

South Australia will again conduct the annual Match Race Challenge next month, held on Thursday, 23rd September during the rich Adelaide Cup Carnival. Previously conducted as a State of Origin Series between SA and Victorian greyhounds, current Covid-19 restrictions have again forced a rethink for the event in 2021, which was temporarily changed to an SA trained event last year for the same reasons.

After liaising with GRV and noting the current border restrictions that are likely to remain in place for some time, the linking of the Group 1 Adelaide Cup with Victorian events (Group 1 Topgun and Group 2 Shootout) will not occur in 2021.

To ensure that Angle Park TAB Match Race Challenge attracts the best greyhounds possible, GRSA has altered the conditions of the series to be "SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS". It will be a similar format to the previous State of Origin concept; however, the four (4) SA greyhounds will take on the four (4) best nominated greyhounds from anywhere in Australia.

This will provide another exciting dimension in what has proven to be a very successful format. With Covid-19 restrictions and border closures in place across Australia, opening up the series to all states (including Victoria) ensures the series will be conducted with a high-quality field.

Despite the removal of links to key Victorian races, GRSA will still guarantee the winner of the TAB Match Race Challenge direct entry into the \$100,000 to the winner Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final on Friday, 8th October (bypassing the Adelaide Cup Heats).

Nominations close at 9am on Monday, 20th September with GRSA.

Conditions of the TAB Match Race Challenge – SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS:

The TAB Match Race Challenge – SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS, between South Australia and the All-Stars from the rest of Australia, will be held at the new Angle Park track on Thursday, 23rd September.

Eligibility as to who represents South Australia or All-Stars will be based around the National Championships domiciliary clause. Greyhounds need to be trained in the state they wish to represent for 76 days out of the last 150 days prior to the date of the race (23rd September).

The best four (4) greyhounds nominated from SA will be selected by the GRSA Grader to represent "SA's Best". The best four (4) greyhounds nominated from Interstate will be selected by the GRSA Grader to represent "the All-Stars".

The Grader will use whatever information he has available to select those greyhounds including liaising with other State bodies as required. The SA Grader's decision will be final.

Those greyhounds not selected from Interstate will be given the opportunity to solo trial or race in another event on the night. Reserves will be declared, with one (1) from SA and one (1) from Interstate (dependant on nominations), which will replace the SA or All-Stars representative as required. For example the SA reserve will only replace an SA scratching.

The Grader will rate the four (4) greyhounds from SA and the four (4) from Interstate in order from 1 to 4, with No.1 being the highest rated greyhound from each group. The head-to-head matches will be decided by the two No.1 rated greyhounds competing against each other and then it will be 2 v 2, 3 v 3 and 4 v 4.

Prizemoney for each individual match will also reflect the seeding of greyhounds from 1 to 4, with the No.1 rated greyhound's racing for the most prizemoney in the head-to-head races. However, the overall winner of the race will still be determined on actual race times run by each greyhound (to three decimal places).

PRIZEMONEY:

Prizemoney for each pairing:

- 1 v 1 – Winner \$4,750, Runner Up \$500
- 2 v 2 – Winner \$4,500, Runner Up \$500
- 3 v 3 – Winner \$4,250, Runner Up \$500
- 4 v 4 – Winner \$4,000, Runner Up \$500

Prizemoney for the overall placings for TAB Match Race Challenge (based on overall times):

- 1st – \$7,500
- 2nd – \$2,500
- 3rd – \$1,000

This year, with various borders closures impacting travel to SA and some states in lockdown, GRSA has determined that we be guided by SA Government advice for travel from each state.

If trainers from certain states can freely enter SA, GRSA will accept their nomination without further investigation. If trainers from states in lockdown or are subject to travel restrictions from entering SA, GRSA will accept their nomination only if they have approval from GRSA Stewards regarding:

1. Where the greyhound will be kennelled in SA
2. Who will have authority for the greyhound whilst in SA
3. Evidence that the greyhound is travelling to SA by an approved freight company

Upon GRSA Stewards approval, these greyhounds can remain in the Interstate trainer's name whilst they compete in SA feature events. This will be subject to review and change dependent on updated SA Government advice.

Rushes claims second monthly award

Greyhound of the Month for August was Rushes for trainer Lisa Rasmussen making it the second monthly award for the son of Collision and Midnight Moments who also took out the award in June.

He had five starts for three wins and a second with the highlight being the National Sprint Championship SA Final held at Murray Bridge where he won in brilliant style. He started the month off with a second at Gawler before the Heats of the National Championships. He won his Heat nicely before producing a sizzling 29.78 win over the 530m where he led for most of the way in winning by 3 lengths against a quality line up. He was then unlucky over the 455m at the Bridge before returning to Angle Park and recording the fastest time so far over the 530m where he ran 30.47 in winning by over 8 lengths.

At the end of the month Rushes record stood at 57 starts for 22 wins and 11 placings and earnings just over \$75,000.



Fantastic Radley keeps producing amazing runs

The Run of the Month for August was again Fantastic Radley who produced an amazing performance for trainer Ossie Chegia at Murray Bridge over the 680m on Thursday, 12th August in the SA Final of the National Distance Championship. Shooting for 9 wins in a row over track and trip he was sent out a raging hot favourite, however, as the boxes opened he came out last and in trouble.

All of a sudden he was beatable, however, he showed electrifying speed to accelerate around the field and hit the front down the back straight. Having worked so hard to the amazement of the onlookers he raced away from his rivals going further and further in front. His time was 38.96 yet he won by over 6 lengths and produced one the year's great runs.

TAB Adelaide Cup Race Dates:

Thursday, 30th September : TAB Adelaide Cup Open Heats up to 8 @ \$14,275 each

Friday, 8th October: TAB Adelaide Cup Final @ \$145,250 (\$100,000 to the winner)

TAB Adelaide Cup Consolation @ \$14,275

Nominations: TAB Adelaide Cup Heats close Monday, 27th September with GRSA at 9.00am.

Nominations can be made on-line, please specify Adelaide Cup or on a Multi Nomination Form.

GRSA will continue the condition that the overall winner of the Match Race series will be guaranteed a spot in the Group 1 Adelaide Cup on Friday, 8th October. This greyhound will not be required to compete in the heats on Thursday, 30th September.

The \$15,250 Premier's Cup over the 730m will also be conducted on Adelaide Cup final night for the stayers.

Murray Bridge to race in twilight on Thursday, 7th October

With GRSA being able to race on Friday, 8th October for the Group 1 Adelaide Cup due to the support of GRV swapping their meetings, Murray Bridge will race in the early twilight on Thursday, 7th October.

This timeslot has been the case for the last few years.

Greyhound Racing South Australia – 2021 SA Country Cup

Below are details of how and where greyhounds can qualify for the \$7,500 SA Country Cup Final, to be run at Angle Park over 530 metres on Adelaide Cup G-SIX Final night Friday 8th October 2021.

Conditions

- All South Australian Greyhound Racing Clubs outside of Angle Park will conduct heats, or nominate greyhounds from which the Greyhound Racing SA Grading Department will choose two representatives. These meetings are Gawler Provincial 2, Murray Bridge One Turn Provincial 1 and Mount Gambier Provincial 1 or 2. (Performances at Gawler Provincial 1 meetings are not eligible for consideration)
- The event is open to all South Australian Greyhounds that have not won 4 or more CITY A Grade 5 or higher events at time of nomination (600m, 643m & 680m excluded). Also, they cannot have won a Metro Grade 5 or higher interstate in the last 6 months. Winner of each event takes a penalty including the final.

Special Exceptions:

Mount Gambier Club is allowed to include non-South Australian trainers under strict conditions:

- The trainer has had starters at 10 meetings for Mt Gambier in the previous 12 months.
- The trainer can only qualify for one of the clubs.
- The trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 3 months.
 - Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.
 - The greyhound must be SA trained (except Mount Gambier as above).
 - A South Australian trained greyhound is defined as one that has been racing in SA for a period of not less than 3 out of the 6 months immediately prior to the time of nomination.
 - The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track it is attempting to represent.
 - There will be a maximum of two heats per Club with the winners of each heat qualifying. If there is only one heat conducted then the first two placegetters will qualify. Heats will be worth \$2,125.
 - The two reserves will be determined firstly by a ballot of the second placegetters from all heats. The third placegetters will then be considered by ballot if required. If a heat was not conducted at the track, then that track is not included in the ballot. Should a greyhound be withdrawn prior to the ballot, the next placed greyhound from that Club's heat will be selected.
 - Once a greyhound has qualified from a Qualifying Heat, it is not eligible to compete at another track in this series, unless there are insufficient nominations to fill the field.
 - Once qualified for the Country Cup Final the greyhound will be ineligible for the Adelaide Cup series or any other race on this Cup Final night.
 - Lead up Heats may be up to 8 greyhounds however the Final on Adelaide Cup night will be a 6 DOG Final

GOTBA Oaks, Derby and Waterloo Cup this month at Coursing

Feature meetings for Coursing come up this month with the Oaks and Derby Preludes on Sunday, 12th September while the Oaks and Derby along with the 2021 GOTBA Waterloo Cup will be held on Sunday, 24th September at Virginia.

The Oaks and Derby are for bitches and dogs whelped on or after 1/7/19 with greyhounds required to have competed at Coursing to be eligible. The Waterloo Cup is always a feature on the Clubs program and is much sought after.

Coursing dates are -

Sunday 12th September
Sunday 26th September
Sunday 10th October

- The club will increase prizemoney and will conduct 4 dog and 8 dog fields at upcoming meetings.
- 4 dog-----\$265 winner-----\$90 Runner up
- 8 dog-----\$380 winner-----\$120 Runner up
- Feature prizemoney is still to be determined.

Angle Park return to racing – Trial Schedule

With Angle Park now back on the race schedule, the trial schedule has reverted to –

- Angle Park Tuesday night and Saturday/Sunday morning (depending on racing)
- Gawler Monday morning and Friday morning (STAT)
- Murray Bridge Wednesday night one turn, Monday morning on both tracks and Thursday on straight track. These sessions will be monitored depending on their support. STAT will be done on Wednesday nights for the one turn while the STAT for the Straight track will be done at race meetings where possible (less than 12 races). As we move towards daylight saving in October consideration will be to have STAT for the Straight track available on Wednesday nights.

No reference has been made to Mt Gambier on this schedule as this does not affect their trialling.

Some points from Grading Review Panel

Grading for newly redeveloped Angle Park confirmed

The Grading Review Panel has reviewed the Grade 6 guidelines and to fall in line with other grades on the "New" Angle Park track the Grade 6 rule will be implemented as if greyhounds had not won at the venue like we have done for Murray Bridge and Gawler recently.

- Distance ranges will be 342m, 530m, 595m and 730m. There will be no 342m conducted at Angle Park on Thursday City A meetings
- Angle Park will be considered a "NEW" track for the Grade 6 policy. For example if a greyhound has won a City A grade 6 at the old Angle Park over 515m it will still be eligible to win a City A grade 6 over 530m if still eligible for grade 6 events. If a greyhound has won one grade 6 over 388m at the old Angle Park and has one more grade 6 left it can win a grade 6 over 342m, 530m, 595m or 730m. If a greyhound has won a 515m and 388m at old Angle Park City B and has two more grade 6's to win they can win 342m and 530m City B if they choose. Non SA bred greyhounds can still only win 4 grade 6 events and SA Bred can still only win 12 lifetime events before reverting to grade 5 everywhere.
- When a greyhound wins a Grade 5 or above over 530m on the new Angle Park and has grade 6 events left it will not be eligible for any more Grade 6 events (this condition is re-introduced).
- Trainers will see that OzChase has automatically given greyhounds a grade at the new distances to assist the grading of meetings allowing trainers to nominate into events. This was done as a bulk download with the Grader required to review each grade of each greyhound based on above.

Mixing of Grade 6 in higher grade middle distance & stayers events –

GRSA introduced a Mixed 4/5/6 to the schedule for Middle Distance and Staying events. 530m & 680m at Murray Bridge, 643m at Gawler, Mt Gambier and Angle Park to assist those Grade 6 greyhounds that win to only take a Grade 6 penalty and not lose their Grade 6 from the track. Occasionally the Grader has received feedback from participants that as a Grade 6

greyhound they should not be included with Grade 4 dogs etc. The panel decided that for Staying events and Middle distance this was fine to mix, bearing in mind, they would prefer limited mixing. However, they advised this would not be done for the 530m journey at Murray Bridge.

Mount Gambier cross border bubble at 70km

We advise that the SA Government still have a 70km cross border bubble, therefore, only those trainers from Victoria with that exemption will have nominations accepted for upcoming Mt Gambier meetings, however, these directions do change regularly.

GRSA would be hopeful this changes soon to allow more of our Victorian friends across to support the South East venue. In the meantime the Club have been very appreciative of the support from the local trainers and those from Metro Adelaide ensuring none of their meetings have lost.

Daish Irrigation & Fodder vouchers for Murray Bridge

The Murray Bridge GRC has been able to secure some \$100 vouchers from their sponsor Daish Irrigation & Fodder to be used on Heat and Final series' over the next 12 months.

In the All Tracks calendar these races will be highlighted which is a terrific initiative of the Murray Bridge GRC.

Classic 2021 Preludes coming up

The first Angle Park prelude series for the SA bred greyhounds which are paid up for Classic 2021 is coming up this month. It is a special event over 530m and no penalties apply.

The Heats will be held on Monday, 20th September for \$2,200 with the Final on Monday, 27th September for \$4,500.

- Nominations for the Heats close Thursday, 16th September at 9.00am.

The second prelude of \$2,200 Heats will be run on Friday, 15th October with the \$4,500 Final on Thursday, 21st October.

Nominations for the Heats close Tuesday, 12th October with GRSA at 9.00am.

2021 Gawler Cup Carnival kicks off on Monday 15th October

The Gawler Gold Cup carnival will be run over three meetings this year. The Gawler GRC has been in consultation with the Thoroughbreds and Harness Racing in the region and has made a mini carnival with all three codes running their main races for the year around the same time called the "Gawler Carnival of Cups".

Our carnival will kick off on Monday, 18th October with \$3,000 Heats for the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup over the 531m along with \$1,855 Heats of the Gawler Sprint Classic for open 400m greyhounds.

The Group 3 Gawler Cup Final will be run on Sunday night, 24th October worth \$36,000 in prizemoney with the winner to receive around \$25,000. This night will include the \$8,000 Gawler Sprint Classic Final and there will be a Consolation for the Gawler Gold Cup. To add to this feature night there will be the \$2,565 Heats of the "Bothing" Gawler Stayers Cup for open 643m greyhounds.

The \$8,500 Final of the Bothing Gawler Stayers Cup will be run on Sunday, 31st October along with the \$4,000 Gawler Anniversary Cup over the 531m rounding out the outstanding three meetings of racing.

Nominations for the Gawler Cup Heats and Gawler Sprint Classic Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Thursday, 14th October

Nominations for the Gawler Stayers Cup Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Wednesday, 20th October

Nominations for the Gawler Anniversary Cup close with GRSA at 9.00am on Wednesday, 27th October

Lodgement of Breeding Documents

Participants are reminded of their obligations to lodge breeding documents within the time frames as set out under the Rule of Greyhound Racing.

These being – Notice of Service (within 14 days of the service), Whelping Notice (within 14 days of the whelping date) and Litter Registration (within 4 months of the whelping date).

Should the documents be lodged after this time the following penalties may be imposed:

- 2 to 4 weeks overdue \$50
- 5 to 8 weeks overdue \$100
- 9 to 12 weeks overdue \$150
- 13 to 16 weeks overdue \$200
- 17 plus weeks overdue \$250

Change of venues to accommodate the Gawler Cup heats in October

Please note with the Gawler Cup Heats this year being conducted on Monday night, 18th October our normal schedule will change slightly.

Angle Park will run on Friday, 15th October with a Day meeting at City B class while Sunday night, 17th October will be a Murray Bridge Prov 1 meeting around the One Turn. Please check the October All Tracks calendar for programmed events.

Time Grading & Pathway Races – Angle Park Standards

The commencement of racing at the newly designed Angle Park has necessitated the setting of time standards for the purposes of the Time Grading methodology and Pathway Races.

In normal circumstances, GRSA would allow a period of time to pass before setting these standards, to allow sufficient races to be conducted to establish the average winning times.

However, given the importance of Angle Park to the racing system in SA, the Grading Department felt the need to set time standards straight away.

It also provides the opportunity to add time standards for the

new 680m start at Murray Bridge and the new 305m start at Mount Gambier.

As such, please find below the revised Time Grading and Pathway time standards for all tracks in SA.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

WAP Update for participants - August 2021

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) wishes to advise that the Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for August 2021 is currently being calculated. It is expected that the calculation will be complete during the week ending Friday 20th August and the result announced as soon as it is available.

Example to help participants understand the WAP they receive

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dog[s]. The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

Assumptions:

In this example, assume the owner/trainer received \$1,000 in prizemoney for any/all races for the month.

EXAMPLE		
Net Wagering Revenue		\$1,800,000
<i>Multiplied by</i>		x
WAP Benchmark Return (50%)		50%
<i>equals</i>		=
Payout		\$900,000

<i>Equals</i>		=
WAP for the month		\$50,000

In this example the total prizemoney (paid to all participant) is **\$700,000** (excluding WAP).

In this example, the total WAP is **\$50,000**.

In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of **\$71.43**, calculated as:

$$\text{\$1,000} \div \text{\$700,000} \times \text{\$50,000} = \text{\$71.43}$$

Participants should note that:

- WAP is not payable for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000];
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney.

If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.



Sterilisation Contribution Policy

Please remember that effective from now, any greyhound you retire as a pet (except to GRSA's GAP SA) must be sterilised BEFORE you move the greyhound out of your custody. This is by an amendment to local rule 114, but will most likely become a national rule later this year. When you notify us of the retirement, on Form GAR106R, you must attach a copy of the sterilisation certificate.

GRSA now has a sterilisation contribution policy, where you can claim back up to \$375.00 of the procedure. Please note, the claim can only be for the procedure and the cost of the procedure (so, up to \$375.00). Please forward your paid Tax Invoice to GRSA Animal Welfare for processing (at or after you lodge the retirement form). Please note that vets cannot, at this time, claim for you and you must pay your vet.

This local rule is enforceable, so please be aware that retiring a greyhound that is not sterilised may incur a penalty.

If you have any queries or difficulties, please consult the local rule and policy on the GRSA website, or contact animal welfare.

Greyhound Movements

I remind everyone of GAR105(4) –

(i) A registered person shall within 3 working days of a greyhound coming pursuant to or leaving the person's care or custody, give notice to the Controlling Body of that occurrence.

Notifications can be made via email to animal welfare.

Covid-19 and Angle Park

The new Angle Park now has dedicated QR Check-In for participants attending the venue for all racing and training activities. QR Code Check In signs are located at various places from the front trainer's carpark gate and into the facility. I encourage everyone to use the QR Code Check-In. If you cannot, please see a Steward or other staff member for the manual contact tracing forms, if you cannot find a manual contact tracing station.

We are trying to have the Adelaide Cup 2021 as close to 'normal' as we can. As you can appreciate, living in a post-COVID world is a day-by-day assessment exercise and it is extremely difficult to predict the exact numbers or configuration for the cup, until we get closer to the date. Rest assured we are preparing with your safety in mind. A few things will not change – please, as usual, check in; do not attend if you are sick and make sure you seek medical

attention; maintain social distancing (1.5m); and, wash your hands. Please also prepare for the requirement that you might need to wear a mask. We will announce what the requirements will be closer to the event.

As always, we at GRSA appreciate the efforts you all put into fighting COVID-19.

Covid-19 Vaccinations

As you will see on the news, the issue of COVID-19 vaccinations is a rapidly evolving area.

We have seen, so far, a number of large companies mandate vaccinations for their employees. GRSA is monitoring the situation closely and we will advise of any updates. Now is time, though, to seriously consider getting a vaccination and speaking to your GP if you need advice. If I had a crystal ball, I think it would show that by year's end, there will be some restrictions on day-to-day activity, where you might need to show your vaccination status. Exactly how that will look is unknown, but it might be worth making a decision on the vaccine sooner rather than later in case these decisions are made.

The new Angle Park

You will see at the new Angle Park some changes to the layout of the facilities and some of these might take some getting used to.

Please take some time to familiarise yourself with the changes and contact us if you have any concerns.

Some changes to your kennels may need Council approval.

Angle Park Redevelopment Project Update

Angle Park has been back racing for a couple of weeks now and the whole team at GRSA is really pleased with the quality of racing at the first five meetings.

All the newly positioned starts seem to be racing fairly and it appears that the greyhounds can handle the circuit quite well, with limited interference to date.

It has been interesting to hear opinions on how the track will race, based on this small sample size, and wondering if these initial assessments will stack up in the long term.

There is no doubt the track surface is still in the process of settling, which may have had some impact on how the track has raced over the past fortnight.

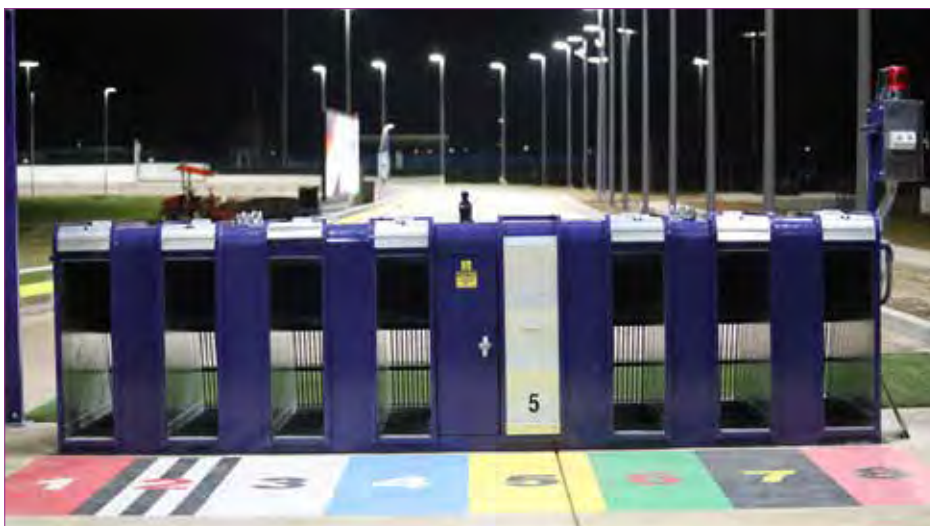
The team has been working hard to tidy up a number of different remaining project elements, most of these relating to the aesthetics of the grass and track surrounds.

There are also a number of operational and back-of-house elements that we are continuing to work on, including the track video camera system setup, sectional camera issues and excess water issues in the wash bays.

Unfortunately we continue to battle with the weather and significant amounts of rain, which is keeping the grassed areas fairly saturated and making it difficult for participants to navigate around the track on race day.

The goal for the team is ultimately to have everything functioning at 100% by the Adelaide Cup series in early October, something we are confident of achieving.

Participants are encouraged to forward suggestions or discuss any concerns with the Angle Park facility with your ICG representatives or committee members of the AGRC.



SafeChase Lure Roll Out

The recommencement of racing at Angle Park coincided with the first use of Steriline Racing's SafeChase lure at a metropolitan track in Australia.

This takes South Australia's use of this exciting new technology to two tracks, the other being the Murray Bridge straight track which has operated the system since early 2019.

The entire GRSA team has been a strong supporter of this lure development, in partnership with Steriline Racing and Kovey Engineering

GRSA believes that these remote/battery lures are the way of the future in regards to greyhound racing lure systems, with most other states also beginning to invest in the technology.

The goal of management is to eventually roll out the SafeChase lure units at all of the greyhound racing venues in South Australia.

Therefore it is currently planned to commence using the SafeChase lure on the Murray Bridge 1-turn track for all race meetings and trial sessions from Monday 4th October 2021.

Following this, the technology will be rolled out for all race meetings and trial sessions at Gawler Greyhound Racing Club from Monday 1st November 2021.

Both tracks will retain their existing systems for a period, those being the cable system at Murray Bridge and the Bramich system at Gawler, providing a redundancy at each venue.



At this stage there is no immediate plan to introduce the SafeChase lure at Mount Gambier, until such time that an assessment of the current lure rail can occur to gauge its suitability for the new lure.

Management hopes that participants have now embraced this new technology after racing behind it up the Murray Bridge straight and now at the newly built Angle Park track.

GRSA Regional Club Projects

The conclusion of works at Angle Park will allow greater focus on a number of smaller projects at other SA Clubs over the coming months.

Below is a summary of works either recently completed or likely to occur in the coming weeks and months at our regional venues:

Gawler

- Installation of new starting boxes at 531m and 400m starts
- Purchase of water truck and tank/irrigation equipment
- New maintenance and vehicle shed
- New greyhound ambulance
- Photo finish lighting upgrade

Murray Bridge

- Retention of the 680m start at the recommencement of Angle Park racing
- Footpaths from the 530m start to the 395m start
- Purchase of new water tank/irrigation trailer
- Expansion of the empty out yards including shelters and car park
- Large scale planting of established trees around the entire property

Mount Gambier

- New greyhound ambulance / maintenance vehicle
- Concrete tractor turnaround at the track access point
- New concrete plinth along the home straight
- Installation of the second hand Gawler boxes, reinstating the 732m start
- Installation of new water tank/irrigation unit to replace existing tank
- Expansion of the slipping track to dual runs
- New perimeter fence and entrance gates
- Expansion of the kennel house wash bays

Virginia

- Assisting the club to make repairs to the return lure system
- Top dressing of the track surface
- Repairs and maintenance of the access road [ongoing issue]

GAP kennelling fee payment process change

Please note that as of 1st August 2021 the GAP kennelling payment process will change for a trial period of three months.

The changes are as follows:

Instead of making a weekly payment of \$33 per dog, the new kennelling fee will be a flat amount of \$50 per dog, irrespective of the time period the greyhound will spend at the GAP kennels.

Participants who would like their greyhounds placed in the GAP kennels will be requested to pay the \$50 at the time when the placement form is filled in and the \$60 placement fee is paid.

This means that for greyhounds that are to be kennelled with GAP an upfront payment of \$110 will be requested. After that, participants will not need to make any additional payments for their dogs in the GAP kennels. Noting that prior to foster care dogs spend an average of 4 weeks in kennels, this change is expected to generate a saving of \$82 per dog for participants.

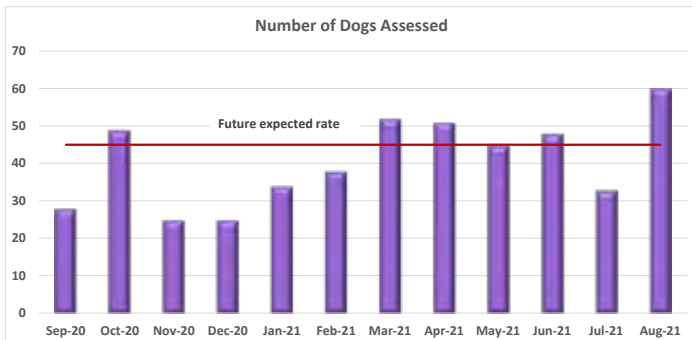

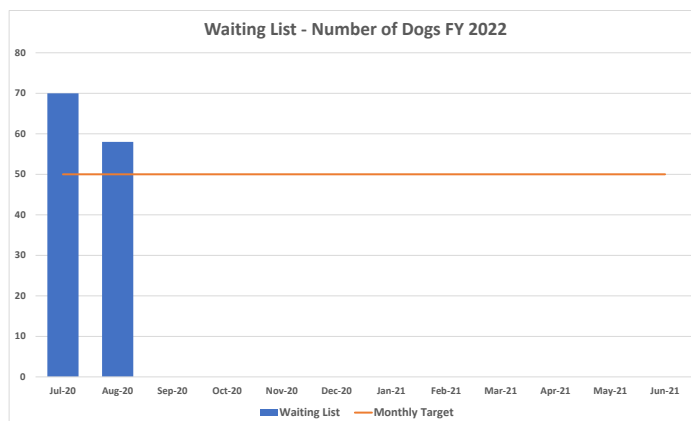
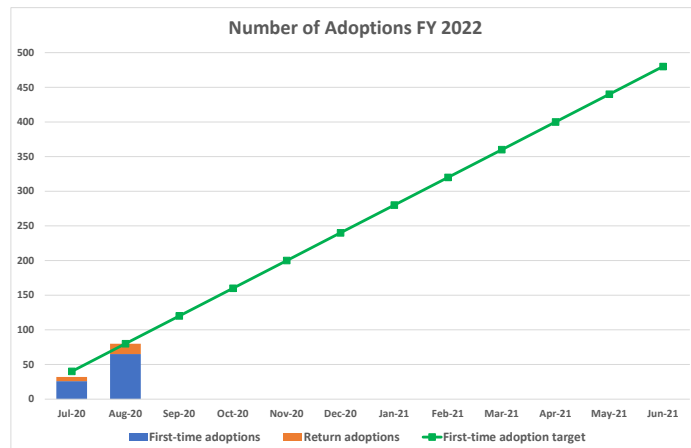
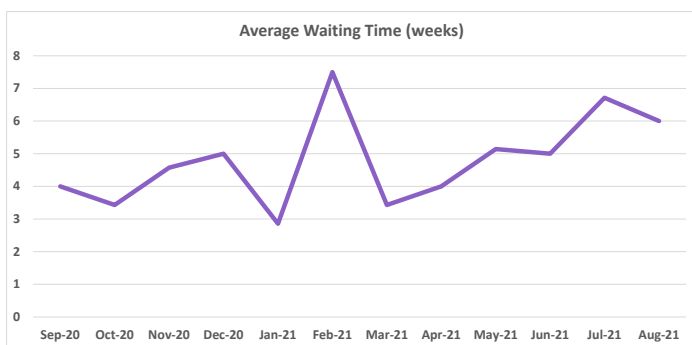
Latest updates from GAP

It took a while, but local charity Foodbank was finally able to collect a \$2000 cheque at Mount Gambier's greyhound meeting at Tara Raceway on Sunday August 29.

The presentation had actually been set down for a month previously to coincide with the running of the Foodbank Feature Grade 5 final (512 m) that had been won by Nathan Wilson's Oakvale Style.

However, due to Covid restrictions no patrons had been allowed on track on that particular day.

The chase for charity at Tara Raceway initially came about through a Catch for Cash initiative whereby many of the greyhound catchers at the twice-weekly meetings donated their modest fee. Subsequently the local Sunset Community Kitchen received a cheque for \$2000 last November.

Following this was the introduction of the Tara Tipsters, initially 14 race day regulars who threw in a few dollars each week in support of a local charity as they set about outdoing one another in what turned out to be a fiercely contested tipping competition.

Introducing Foodbank's Mount Gambier Regional Branch Manager, Lynne Neshoda, was greyhound owner Kevin "KD" Douglas, also one of the Tara Tipsters and well known in the district for his outstanding charitable work.

And speaking after the running of the Foodbank Mixed Stake (512 metres), Mrs Neshoda said Foodbank SA had been supporting the Limestone Coast community for more than 15 years.

"Currently, Foodbank is supplying more than 130 local charities and schools in the region with food relief. In the past 12 months our warehouse has distributed more than 380,000 meals to those in need living on the Limestone Coast."

In attendance at Tara Raceway for the first time, Mrs Neshoda was certainly appreciative of the Foodbank donation.

"On behalf of Foodbank I'd like to sincerely thank the Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club and the Tara Tipsters for their terrific support. It is likely that the donation will go towards one of our forthcoming projects – the upgrading of a volunteers' kitchen."

Winner of the Foodbank Mixed Stake was Two Hands George, the third leg of a treble for owner-trainer Tim Richards.

Richards and his greyhound weren't required to be at the presentation but the Meningie trainer was more than happy to lend his support to the cause. This was much appreciated by the club.

The Tara Tipsters are now throwing their support behind the Visually Impaired Club of Mount Gambier. And adding to the tipsters' team are Kerry Hawker, Christine Yourgules, John Hawker, John Little and Jeff Guy.

GRADING REVIEW PANEL

The Grading Review Panel met on Monday 16th August (via Zoom and phone) to discuss grading in South Australia from an Agenda provided. Following is a summary and recommendations of items discussed:

The panel approved the minutes from the previous GRP meeting held on 21/03/21. The panel reviewed recommendations and implementations from the previous GRP meeting with their recommendations below.

Business Arising

The Racing Manager provided a general verbal update to the panel on those items introduced from the last meeting. The panel were comfortable that no further updates were required as some items exist in the Agenda.

Agenda Items

Grade 6 Non SA Bred Maximum Of 12 Lifetime Wins – This is item will remain on the agenda for discussion at each of our meetings. Again there was much discussion around the 4 wins for Interstate and 12 wins for SA Bred. Should it change or remain the same, the panel felt there were still more positives than negatives so elected to remain with the same conditions. The panel suggested some statistical information regarding the movement of Grade 6's to Grade 5's to establish if greyhounds are not moving quickly enough through the classes to assist with higher grades. The RM to provide some data.

The RM advised that the Grading Department were still working on a policy book and would be intending to have some kennel house meetings about Grading in the future

Actions:

The RM to provide data regarding greyhounds moving from Grade 6 to Grade 5 to the panel

Commencement of the Newly Redeveloped Angle Park - The panel discussed the newly developed Angle Park in regard to grades and grade 6 events. The panel considered Angle Park as if it was a "NEW" track with the grading to reflect that. It was agreed that by being a "NEW" track this would mean that all the grades will be basically Maiden, Grade 6 and Grade 5 and the Grade 6 rule will now be implemented as if a greyhound had not raced at the venue like Murray Bridge and Gawler recently. See below-

Confirmed for implementation for the first meeting at Angle Park on Thursday 26th August were -

- Distance ranges will be 342m, 530m, 595m and 730m. There will be no 342m conducted at Angle Park on Thursday City A meetings
- Angle Park will be considered a "NEW" track for the Grade 6 policy. For example if a greyhound has won a City A grade 6 at the old Angle Park over 515m it will still be eligible to win a City A grade 6 over 530m if still eligible for grade 6 events. If a greyhound has won one grade 6 over 388m at the old Angle Park and has one more grade 6 left it can win a grade 6 over 342m, 530m, 595m or 730m. Non SA bred greyhounds can still only win 4 grade 6 events and SA Bred can still only win 12 lifetime events before reverting to grade 5 everywhere.
- When a greyhound wins a Grade 5 or above over 530m on the new Angle Park and has grade 6 events left it will not be eligible for any more Grade 6 events [this condition is reintroduced]
- Trainers will see that Ozchase has automatically given greyhounds a grade at the new distances to assist the grading of meetings allowing trainers to nominate into events. This was done as a bulk download with the Grader required reviewing each grade of each greyhound based on above.

The panel requested these changes be made public prior to grading the first meeting at Angle Park. They confirmed there would be no

standby 342m races programmed for the City A Thursday night meetings at Angle Park.

The panel suggested that trainers put in their comments the grade they believe their greyhound to be at Angle Park to assist the grader bearing in mind that he will have to cast his eye over each greyhound in the short term to ensure they are graded correctly.

The panel were mindful there could be an occasional error in grading during this process and hoped the industry would be understanding of this.

Actions:

The RM to publish new conditions of grading and grade 6 to industry as soon as possible

Schedule of Angle Park When Returns To Calendar – The panel were advised of the schedule when Angle Park returned to racing on Thursday 26th August. The main points being Murray Bridge racing One Turn every Friday, Murray Bridge to race every Tuesday on the Straight track, Gawler to race on Wednesday and Sunday, Angle Park Monday and Thursday with the fortnightly Saturday morning meeting and Mt Gambier remaining on Thursday and Sunday

The panel queried with their now being no Angle Park Prov 2 meeting for normal grades due to the Straight track running every week will there be an opportunity on Saturday morning. The RM advised there was a chance very shortly that we may be able to secure a Saturday meeting every week and this could free up an option for Time Grading and Normal. He did advise however he would try and manage the meetings so that there was a meeting for Prov 2 normal graded events at Angle Park.

The panel were advised that the Time Grades for the new distances will be disregarded until a suitable time has been determined for Angle Park which they were supportive of. They were of the view to only run about three Time Graded meetings per month and/or some hybrids.

Feature Races for Angle Park, Gawler And Murray Bridge – The RM attached a list of the upcoming Feature Races for the 2021/2022 Season which has been released for the panel to review which they were comfortable with. The RM advised the Country Cup conditions had changed to accommodate Mt Gambier and the new Angle Park. The panel were fine with this however did query whether a greyhound and trainer can represent two tracks. The RM advised a greyhound can't but a trainer could if they qualified.

The RM also updated the group in regard to the Phoenix race in Victoria in December which GRSA has put in an application for a slot. This is decided on September 6 and will hopefully provide an SA dog into this race.

Interstate Greyhounds Coming to SA for Feature Events – The RM advised that as the COVID-19 situation continues to change rapidly, GRSA would continue to update all participants of any changes to racing restrictions. It was GRSA's intention over the next few weeks we will put out different scenarios which will aid trainers making decisions coming to SA and also those trainers in SA. It was hoped that our feature races of the SA Oaks, SA Derby, Match Races Series and Adelaide Cup would allow uninterrupted Interstate representation. The panel felt some changes needed to occur and information released to industry being clear about what GRSA will allow.

It was agreed that this year, with various borders closures impacting travel to SA and some states in lockdown if trainers from certain states can freely enter SA, GRSA will accept their nomination without further investigation. If trainers from states in lockdown or are subject to travel restrictions from entering SA, GRSA will accept their nomination only if they have approval from GRSA Stewards regarding:

The also agreed that the Match race series [SA V Vic] should be altered. The RM advised

after liaising with GRV and noting the current border restrictions that

are likely to remain in place for some time, the linking of the Group 1 Adelaide Cup with Victorian events [Group 1 Topgun and Group 2 Shootout] will not occur in 2021.

The panel recommended altering the conditions of the series to be the four [4] SA greyhounds against the four [4] best nominated greyhounds from anywhere in Australia.

Despite the removal of links to key Victorian races, the panel were still happy guarantee the winner of the Match Race Series direct entry into the \$100,000 to-the-winner Group 1 Adelaide Cup final on Friday 8th October [bypassing the Adelaide Cup heats].

Actions:

The RM to publicise changes to the Match Races series and advise requirements for interstate trainers for our carnival.

Time Grading With The New Calendar – The RM advised previously GRSA was programming one Time Grading meeting every two months at Angle Park Tuesday, one Time Grading at Gawler Tuesday per month, every Saturday was some form of Time Grading and Murray Bridge had a mix of Time Grading and normal and what were the panels thoughts. Most were happy with the mix and as advised before would assist if we got a weekly Saturday to spread Time Grading. They were comfortable with Hybrid meetings to assist nominations. They felt these greyhounds only needed 3 or 4 opportunities per month and could still manage normal graded events.

Time Grading Ratings – The RM advised recently we were finding long odds on favourites in Time Grading events highlighted by a Straight track hybrid meeting where we had 3 long odds on favourites which were not the intent of Time Grading. He advised that we currently have a policy where we leave out greyhounds with a rating nor more than 50% of the slowest rated dog in the field and maybe this needs to be altered. He also suggested considering leaving out greyhounds whose last start was in a City A meeting or a Time Standard like Masters Events. The panel felt the hybrid meeting on the Straight was an anomaly due to only being 1 race of each block. They felt the more races run the better. They were surprised by the way some trainers nominated for Hybrid meetings. The felt that Time Grading is pretty clean for the grader and adding extra layers would start compromising the intent. They did believe it was best to leave Time Grading as just best to worst and not do too many 11-5 groupings. The RM to look at this when programming.

Mixing Of Races – The RM advised that the last meeting it was advised that the Grader gets most of his queries from the mixing of greyhounds in races. Whilst he guards trainers for general grading, greyhounds he mixes by race wins [with most wins in higher grade]. He has done this for some time. This was agreed last meeting as the fairest option bearing in mind we have had some feedback regarding mixing greyhounds that have never won a Grade 5 event or separating 500m wins from 300m wins when grading. The panel still believed the fairest way was to mix on race wins if mixing was to occur. They requested trainers highlight this on their nomination if they do not wish to be mixed. The RM did advise that in Victoria they use Aged Prizemoney to mix so some form of Prizemoney application could be considered. The panel were happy for the RM, to investigate.

Actions:

The RM to investigate some form of prizemoney application for mixing greyhounds

Mixing Of Grade 6 in Higher Grade Middle Distance & Stayers Events – The RM advised that GRSA introduced a Mixed 4/5/6 to the schedule for Middle Distance and Staying events. 530m & 680 at Murray Bridge, 643m at Gawler, Mt Gambier and Angle Park to assist those Grade 6 greyhounds that win to only take a Grade 6 penalty and not lose their Grade 6 from the track. However the Grader has received feedback from participants that as a Grade 6 greyhound they should not be included with Grade 4 dogs etc.

The panel felt that for Staying events and Middle distance this is fine

to continue bearing in mind they would prefer limited mixing. They suggested that the 530m journey at Murray Bridge was not middle distance so should not be included.

Actions:

The RM to continue to mix except for 530m at Murray Bridge

SA Owned and SA Bred Races Selected On Order Of Preference – The RM advised that GRSA program SA Bred and SA Owned Grade 5 and 6 events in the All Tracks calendar on occasions that have more money attached than normal. Trainers do not need to nominate for these events to be considered. Normally there is only one event and with that being the case the Grader will consider ALL eligible greyhounds for these events and select them based on the Order of Preference for the race. He will consider guarding guidelines but as these have more money attached he will select the "Best" dogs based on the Order of Preference. The remaining greyhounds will be considered for normal events. The grader advised that trainers can advise "No SA bred" and they can be considered elsewhere. This confirmed this has been the policy for these types of programmed events for a number of years and were happy with this process.

Submissions –

The panel discussed a submission from Tim Aloisi regarding guarding of owners now that Angle Park is back on the schedule with all greyhounds graded as if they have not raced at the venue. Tim advised that Owners are a vital cog in the industry and with all dogs virtually the same grade not only trainers but owners should be separated. The panel agreed with Tim that owners are vital however advised some time ago GRSA moved away from guarding owners [accept for heats] and only guard trainers which has worked extremely well. They advised that it won't take too long for there to be a separation in grades so that a different of mix of races can be released. They advised the RM to thank Tim for his submission but did not see a need to change at this stage.

The panel discussed a submission from Daniel Grgurovic regarding eligibility for Masters or Juveniles to appear in Ozchase for nominating. The panel felt this information was readily available however requested the RM advise these conditions more regularly in kennel capers.

Late Items –

The panel discussed a submission from Lachlan Mill regarding removal or a significant decrease in Grade 6 heat and finals. Part of his submission was trying to get greyhounds through the grades quicker. The panel felt running heats allows for more dogs to get to grade 5 bearing in mind they all end up in the final the next week. The RM advised he had been running more heat and final series than normal at Gawler and Murray Bridge while Angle Park was being redeveloped to ensure races at these venues and anytime there is a Grade 6 heats programmed they are always well supported. He advised they will reduce regardless with Angel Park back on the schedule. The panel advised the RM to monitor the programming of these events however felt these series provide a good opportunity for trainers.

The panel discussed a submission from Tim Richards regarding running some SA Bred Maiden events. The panel were comfortable for the RM to program these events as he sees fit in the All Tracks calendar.

The panel requested that for the next GRP Agenda that the panel should discuss the possibility of performance trials in SA for unraced greyhounds. The RM to add to the Agenda.

Subsequent to the meeting the RM received a recommendation from members of the panel for the Gawler Stayers Cup run in October to be renamed the "Bothing" Stayers Cup in recognition of the Group 1 National Staying Champion and 643m track record holder at Gawler. The RM will liaise with the Gawler GRC.

Next Meeting –November (days and dates TBD)

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday (drawn Thursday) meetings. Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Friday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Thursday. Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Friday (drawn Tuesday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kennelling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.
