WHERE'S POPPY PROVIDES A LOCAL OAKS WIN

Rising SA star Where's Poppy took out the 2023 Group 3 SA Oaks on Thursday 14th September overcoming a wide draw and a talented field at Angle Park.

The win was an emotional result for trainer Kirin Corby, who claimed her first SA Oaks after winning the SA Derby with Lion Hearted, twenty years ago in 2003.

Success in the Oaks with Where's Poppy was a thrill for Corby who bred the chaser out of Sennachie and Fabwik and made the success a truly homegrown South Australian affair.

Speaking with greyhoundracingsa.com.au, Corby said she was thrilled to claim the Oaks with Where's Poppy.

"I am a bit emotional. It's special because I had her Mum and I had her Dad and it was a really good win," Corby said.

"I won the Derby many years ago and it is nice to win the Oaks because I don't think I have had a chance as good as her before."

Where's Poppy entered the race in excellent form having won five of her last six starts including an impressive heat victory where she was well supported in winning from box four.

While the heat win was impressive, the box draw had Corby concerned with a box eight draw not suiting the hard railing chaser.

"I was really a bit depressed when I got eight," Corby said on the box draw.

"She is a railer and I knew she wanted to get across I knew she had early speed but I didn't dare to hope that she could win."

However, an excellent 5.28 first split saw Where's Poppy take the lead at the first post and she was never troubled from there, holding off the field with an excellent run home before stopping the clock in 30.58 which was nearly one tenth of a second quicker than her personal best.

It was an eighth career win from 11 starts for Where's Poppy which includes six wins in her last seven starts mostly across Thursday night company.

"She's been getting fitter," Corby said.

"Last week's weather was not her weather, but we have had a few runs in a row with her and she is just getting better."

Weblec Jewel and Purified finished second and third for Victorian trainer Jeffrey Britton while Zipping Mahalia for local trainer Nicole Price finished in fourth place.



FIORANO GIVES OAKLEY KINGS & QUEENS SUCCESS

A fantastic 12-race card on Thursday 31st August was headlined by the final of the 2023 Kings and Queens over the 530m trip.

The feature event was taken out by Fiorano, who prevailed by the tightest of margins holding off the fast finishing Could Be King by a nose in 30.55.

Trained by Brenda Oakey, Fiorano has now won six of his eight starts since arriving in South Australia with his biggest win coming in the feature event.

Jumping from box three, Fiorano jumped to an early lead on the back of 5.28 first split with clear running out in front with some trouble in behind. The trouble gave clear running to the powerful Could Be King who quickly moved into second and closed on Fiorano.

While Could Be King made a late dive on the line, it was Fiorano who claimed the feature in a tight finish with another promising chaser in Finnis Jewel running into third.

Speaking after the race, trainer Brenda Oakey said she was thrilled that Fiorano was able to bank his good form into feature race success.

"I was pretty nervous, I must admit," Oakey said about her feelings as the chasers entered the home straight.

"He [Fiorano] has settled in really well. He's had eight starts now for six wins and he works so hard and he's always happy."



SCHILLACI SIZZLES TO DERBY GLORY AT ANGLE PARK

Victorian greyhound Schillaci produced one of the fastest times on the redeveloped Angle Park circuit stopping the clock in 30.00 even in taking out the 2023 Group 3 SA Derby on Thursday 14th September.

The red-hot favourite for the Derby after drawing box one following his impressive heat win in 30.27, Schillaci left his rivals in his wake in the final producing a scintillating 5.10 first split which is just shy of the 5.04 record set by He's On Fire.

Schillaci enjoyed the clear running in front bursting away from the field down the back and extending away with a 12.67 run home and winning by five and a half lengths.

It was as an all Victorian first four with the Jeffrey Britton trained trio of Weblec Wolf, Mepunga Smokey and Departed rounding out the first four.

Speaking with greyhoundracingsa.com.au, trainer Jihad Talgi said he was blown away by the improvement at which Schillaci had made in his three visits to Angle Park.

"We came up here and trialled on a Monday and he ran 30.53 and a couple of the locals said the track wasn't really fast on a Monday and they thought he would really improve from that trial run," Talgi said.

"He came out last week in the howling winds and ran 30.27 and we were shocked and tonight he comes out and runs like that I'm just absolutely thrilled."

While Schillaci impressed over the 530m trip at Angle Park, Talgi admitted he had his doubts about the chaser's ability to get the trip after many of his early races were over the 450m at Warrnambool, the 460m at Warragul and the 515m journey at Sandown Park.

"When you are a young dog you just don't know how they are going to run the 530," Talgi said.

"It was an incredible start, he just had to lead and have that few lengths on them and he kicked away in the home straight."

"When they can do it and do it in a fast time where no one has run those times for a long time here it's absolutely thrilling and I am over the moon."

Schillaci's run moves him into the top echelon of times at the redeveloped Angle Park with only four chasers including group one winners Wow She's Fast and Aston Rupee.

With a trio of impressive performances behind him now at Angle Park, trainer Talgi was now looking to bigger goals with his rising star including the SA vs All Stars Match Race series and the Group 1 2023 TAB Adelaide Cup.

"I think he handles Angle Park really well," Talgi said.

"Hopefully nothing goes wrong between now and then and we will get him looked at and we will come back for the heats or the match race and see what happens."

As well as on the track, Talgi also hopes his good fortune can continue on the football field with the devout Collingwood supporter also hoping for premiership success for his beloved Magpies.

"It's been a great couple of weeks and hopefully it keeps going on the field next week and then back here the week after."

We have some of the best greyhounds across Australia taking on SA's best in one on one racing.

TAB and Sky Racing have been very supportive of this series. TAB have markets open on Head to Head winners and overall winners. All matches will be on Sky 1 or Sky 2 so please check the coverage so you don't miss a moment.

GRSA will again show live footage of the greyhounds inside the boxes, looking from behind the greyhounds, as they get ready to race and just after the start which will be very exciting and has been well received by participants and patrons alike.

Prizemoney for each Match will be range between \$4,750 and \$4,000 with unplaced \$1,000 for each Match dependent upon the rating of each match up.

Overall TAB Match Race Challenge winner [based on overall time to three decimal places only] will be \$7,500, second \$2,500, third \$1,000.

GRSA will still guarantee the winner of the TAB Match Race Challenge direct entry into the \$100,000 to the winner Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final on Friday, 6th October [bypassing the Adelaide Cup Heats]. The winner of the Match Race series is considered qualified for the Group 1 Adelaide Cup and will not be eligible to compete in another series. [If there is a dead heat for the overall win then all will be guaranteed the spot in the Adelaide Cup]

ADELAIDE CUP TRIAL TONIGHT

There will be plenty of Adelaide Cup interest with the Match racing and other interstate greyhounds engaged in our fields tonight in preparation for next week's Heats, however, there will also be one solo trial this evening.

Tamanian star sprinter, Wynburn Ruby, for trainer Ben Englund will trial in between races. She has an excellent record with 17 wins and 9 placings from 30 starts and over \$140,000 in prizemoney. She won the Group 2 Launceston Cup back in February in a slick 29.31, however, has not raced since May so it will be interesting to see how she goes in a lead up to the Cup.

2023 GOTBA OAKS, DERBY AND WATERLOO CUP THIS SUNDAY

The Oaks, Derby and 2023 GOTBA Waterloo Cup will be held this Sunday, 24th September at Virginia.

The Club has a field of 11 for the Waterloo Cup, 13 for the Oaks and 10 for the Derby.

Coursing kicks off at 9.00am on Sunday at Virginia.

Remaining Coursing dates are -

Sunday October 9.

Please be advised of the policy in regard to running of events at Coursing.

“For any GOTBA Coursing meetings programmed effective immediately all Coursing events will be conducted and completed as programmed, there will not be a choice as to whether to run or not. The only time that a race will be declared a No Course is if there is a mechanical or other defect that may prevent a race from being completed in the opinion of the stewards at their discretion, supported by the rules of racing”

Thanks to the support of Greyhound Racing Victoria, South Australia will be able to run our premier Group 1 meeting on Friday, 6th October. SA will swap our Friday Day meeting with Victoria's night meeting so we can race in the evening. Due to programming some of the races early on the program will be on Sky 2, however, our Group 1 Adelaide Cup and feature races will be on Sky 1 with the Cup to be run slightly later than normal to accommodate Sky Racing scheduling.

Murray Bridge will race on the Thursday night before the Cup [5th October] retaining our normal night time Sky 1 slot. In past years this meeting was run in the twilight on Sky 2.

GRSA is very appreciative of GRV for assisting with this scheduling change which would not have happened without their support.

2023 GAWLER CUP CARNIVAL KICKS OFF ON MONDAY 23RD OCTOBER

The Gawler Gold Cup carnival will be run over two meetings this year. The Gawler GRC has been in consultation with the Thoroughbreds and Harness Racing in the region and has made a mini carnival again this year with all three codes running their main races for the year around the same time called the “Gawler Carnival of Cups”.

Our carnival will kick off on Monday, 23rd October with \$3,000 Heats for the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup over the 531m along with \$1,995 Heats of the Gawler Sprint Classic for open 400m greyhounds and the \$2,760 Heats of the “Bothing” Gawler Stayers Cup for open 643m greyhounds.

The Group 3 Gawler Cup Final will be run on Sunday night, 29th October worth \$36,000 in prizemoney with the winner to receive \$25,000. This night will include

the \$8,000 Gawler Sprint Classic Final, the \$8,500 Final of the Bothing Gawler Stayers Cup and there will be a Consolation for the Gawler Gold Cup.

Nominations for the Gawler Cup Heats, Gawler Sprint Classic Heats and Bothing Stayers Cup close with GRSA at 9.00am on Thursday, 19th October

OzChase will update the currency of the Greyhound's vaccination and will be displayed within Online Nominations shortly. Each Greyhound on the Currently Trained list of a trainer will include a new column displaying the latest vaccination date recorded.

It will be colour coded according to the condition outlined below:

MURRAY BRIDGE STAT TRIALS

Please be advised Satisfactory Trials at Murray Bridge on Wednesday nights will be conducted on a fortnightly basis due to staffing issues.

The next fortnightly opportunity will be Wednesday, 30th August.

INDUSTRY CONSULTATIVE GROUP PANEL MEETING OUTCOMES – TO BE IMPLEMENTED FROM 1ST SEPTEMBER

GRSA has been publishing the change in policy and penalties to be applied from the most recent ICG meeting. These will now take affect from the race meetings to be conducted from 1st September and introduced from 1st September.

- There will only be one provisional breeders license being provided to multiple participants residing at the same residence. All other applications would be dealt with on a case by case basis. For implementation from 1st September.
- 2 in 7 starts and 7 in 28 starts rule. The ICG agreed that a 10 day stand down period would be an appropriate penalty for those that knowingly nominated greyhounds that would be ineligible due to the rule. It was suggested any further infringements could attract a monetary penalty. To clarify, any penalty would only apply once the dog had gone around, not in instances with late scratchings etc. It is the trainer's responsibility to be aware of this rule and their implications. For implementation for meetings conducted on the 1st September onwards.
- The ICG panel confirmed and supported a \$100 fine for any late Pink Card applications. For implementation from 1st September.
- The ICG panel supported all trialling to be booked through the Trial Booker process to ensure specific criteria is met. Management to investigate amending trial booker into group categories to achieve greater efficiency at the session. For implementation in the month of September.

GAWLER TRIALS TO MOVE TO ONLINE SHORTLY

As advised previously, GRSA has been working with the Gawler GRC and staff to transition the Gawler trial booking process to online like Angle Park and Murray Bridge for their Monday and Thursday morning sessions. An implementation date will be advised shortly.

GRSA online trial booking system FAQs

Below are details regarding the Trial Booker process.

Below are examples provided a few years ago so the dates and distances will have changed, however, will give industry a good idea when they log on to the Trial Booker which they can do through the GRSA website.

How do I register an account to book public trials online?

Visit www.trialbooker.com, click on the "register an account" link and fill in the appropriate details.

How do I book a specific trial online?

To book 4 trials, click Book 4:

As soon as you have pressed the Book button, those trials are booked and yours to keep. You then customise the distance, number of dogs, and type for each trial, and confirm them

To review your bookings, return to the Home page:

Field Trials

Existing field trials will appear in each block. To book a dog in an existing field trial simply click the Book 1/2/3 button.

If there are no available field trials of the distance and type you require then feel free to create one yourself. Simply book a slot as-per-normal and select Maiden Field or Performed Field, as shown below.

Note: booking a dog or several dogs in a field trial counts as 1 trial towards your 4 trial maximum.

When do trial bookings commence each week?

Bookings for meetings will commence at 11.30am the working day prior to the trial session (henceforth known as "booking opening time").

Is there a limit to how many trials I can book online?

Yes: 4 (Gawler is 6). If you wish to reserve more than 4 trials a session then you must phone the office as per normal. For example, in the screenshot below, it indicates that you can book 3 more trials using TrialBooker without phoning.

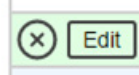

Why am I limited to 4 trials in one block?

In short: to prevent abuse of the system. To book more phone the office after booking opening time.

Can I cancel a trial booking online? Yes: Press the X button and confirm.



Will I receive a confirmation to confirm my online trial booking?

Your trials are reserved for you as soon as you press the "Book 4" button [or "Book 4" or whichever it may be]. You must then confirm the details of those trials [distance, number of dogs etc.]. There will be a summary of your bookings in each session on the Home page.

Can I book trials for other licensees? No—under no circumstances may you book trials for anyone other than yourself using TrialBooker. Dogs must be brought in and paid for by the person whose name they were booked under. If you wish to share a non-field trial with another trainer you must book over the phone.

How can I book a trial if I don't have access to a computer?

You can still book trials by calling the office after booking opening time.

JUNE'S GRADING REVIEW PANEL MEETING OUTCOMES – MAIN POINTS

- GRSA will allow one extra Grade 6 over another distance for City A Thursday meetings bringing this into line with all tracks in SA. No retrospectivity regarding this change. Implemented
- GRSA has removed the condition where once a greyhound has won a Grade 5 or higher event on a City A meeting that the greyhound will lose all Grade 6 events at all other tracks. This means a greyhound could be a Grade 4 or Grade 3 over 530m on a Thursday City A meeting and will still be able to win Grade 6 events at other tracks. No retrospectivity regarding this change. Implemented
- GRSA will now allow a greyhound after winning a Grade 5 Masters event in faster time than the time standard to get back into Masters with 2 runs in a Grade 5 at the track and distance, it doesn't matter if they are placed or unplaced just so long as there are two starts out of Masters. This has been changed from being just unplaced to get back. Implemented

RACING AND TRIALLING FREQUENCY – STARTED 1ST FEBRUARY

GRSA has adopted a new local rule in regard to frequency of racing and trialling which took effect on Wednesday, 1st February 2023. The update local rule is below -

69A Racing and trialling frequency

[1] In this rule:

Race has the same meaning given to this term in R9 of the GAR.

Trial means a satisfactory trial, or a qualifying trial as defined in R9 of the GAR.

[2] A greyhound will only be permitted to start in –

[a] No more than a combined total of 2 race and trial starts in any 7-day period; and,

[b] No more than a combined total of 7 race and trial starts in any 28-day period.

[3] This sub-rule commences on a date to be fixed by Stewards' Notice.

The intent of this rule is to monitor and regulate the frequency of races and official trials of greyhounds, to ensure adequate rest time is given between events. The rule is similar to one in effect in Western Australia. We have automated the OzChase Racing system to be able to monitor this rule. The rule is self-explanatory. A greyhound must not start more than 2 times [races or trials combined] in any 7-day period. Further, a greyhound must not start more than 7-times [races or trials combined] in any 28-day period.

Any attempt to nominate a greyhound outside these parameters will be flagged by the OzChase system. If a greyhound gains a start from reserve deeming it ineligible under this rule for its next engagement or it competes in another State prior to racing back in SA, then the greyhound will come out.

****Racing Administration staff will scratch these greyhounds acting under this rule without notification. [the responsibility rests with the trainer to ensure they do not contravene this rule]**

****For clarity if a greyhound races on Sunday, Wednesday then Sunday it will be eligible. The first**

DUAL LURE TO BE TRIALLED AT ANGLE PARK IN TRIAL SESSIONS

As advised in last months Kennel Capers, a dual lure will be trialled at Angle Park commencing on Tuesday, 29th August and will be for each Tuesday after, until sufficient trialling has taken place to determine the positives and negatives of the dual lure at our venues.

To manage this process trainers will need to book trials as normal. GRSA will allocate timeslots 7.15pm to 7.40pm and 7.40pm to 8.05pm each Tuesday meaning we will be trialling up to 20 trials each Tuesday night. Having two blocks of time this will assist trial staff manage the changing of the lure etc.

When booking online please book as normal in these slots and it will be assumed that you want to trial on the dual lure. If a trainer does not want to trial on the dual lure then please book in different time slots.

When ringing up to book a trial please advise staff if you want to book a dual lure trial, bearing in mind there is only 20 trials and once gone there will not be anymore until the following week.

NEW SPONSOR FOR MURRAY BRIDGE SUMMER DERBY AND OAKS IN DECEMBER

The Murray Bridge GRC are please to announce a new sponsor for their Club in Fischer Motors and also that they will take the naming rights sponsors of both the Summer Oaks and Summer Derby to be run in December. Along with the sponsorship the club has increased both races to \$7,500 each from \$5,000 and added a \$1000 bonus for the trainer of each final if they are a member of the MBGRC. Conditions -

RECEPTIONS TO GO CASHLESS

From September 1st, GRSA and GAP receptions will be fully cashless and will accept payments via card only for all charges.

CURRENT MASTERS TIMES AND POLICY

- For greyhounds 3¾ years and older. 4yo and older will get preference. City A, City B and Prov 1 meetings are done by form for 4yo and older and then greyhounds will only get in from under 4yo to 3¾ yo in age from oldest to youngest. Prov 2 meetings are all done on age from oldest to youngest regardless of form for all ages.
- Dates are exact so going back 4yo and 3¾ from the date of race. ie date of race run on 20/11/22 – 4yo would be 20/11/18 whelping.
- Time restrictions if a greyhound wins a Grade 5 Masters race in a faster time than published and it will have to have 2 runs [placed or unplaced] in normal company at that class of meeting before being eligible at that class of meeting.
- The Grader will look to grade a Grade 5 Masters event on every program over a distance if enough dogs are nominated regardless if it is advertised in the All Tracks calendar.
- All races Non Penalty.

If a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading. If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs, only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters (ie Grade 2/3 & 4) we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event.

305m Masters Policy for Mt Gambier – With Mt Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events, however, factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance. There will still be a Time Standard applied based on the published table being 17.75. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week. The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.

COMMENTS ON NOMINATIONS MARKED “ONLY”

A few years ago the Grading Review Panel agreed that some trainers were using the comments box to influence the grading of fields in particular Grade 5 Only for all their greyhounds.

The panel previously resolved that “Only” would be disregarded over all distances and the grading left to the Grader. [Masters Only or Juvenile Only will be accepted as this is for a specific type of race]

If trainers put “Only or no start or leave me out” then the grader will grade as normal and if a greyhound would be graded into a mixed event based on race wins then he will leave them out based on the trainers request. The more information provided to the Grader allows for him to accommodate those requests.

WINNING GRADE 6 RACES IN ORDER

GRSA reminds trainers to win their grade 6 events in order at a specific venue.

For the venues that allow two Grade 6 wins trainers need to win a Grade 6 over one distance and then a Grade 6 over the other distance. If a greyhound wins a Grade 6 and then a Grade 5 then they will lose their Grade 6 over the other distance at that venue.

RE-GRADING FOR ALL TRACKS AND DISTANCES

Re-grading will occur for all tracks and distances for Grade 3 or higher greyhounds.

A trainer can apply for a re-grade after two unsuccessful nominations over the corresponding distance. If having met this criteria the responsibility is on the trainer to apply for a re-grade prior to the close of nominations. Only one distance will be considered for a re-grade per meeting.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is not much that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month.

These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner & \$150 to the Breeder.

At the ICG meeting in January the SA Bred Bonus scheme was tabled for discussion where when we have 200 or more SA bred winners we go over budget and there is no Monthly payment for the Owner of Breeder separate to the \$225. It was discussed that this was happening more regularly with more racing and more SA Bred greyhounds winning events. It was suggested increasing the base amount from \$225 and removing monthly payments, therefore reducing monthly administration of the scheme. The Board advised changes to be implemented from 1 July 2023, however, kept the base amount at \$225 due to the increased numbers and racing opportunities. Due to this change the SA bred winners will no longer be listed in Kennel Capers each month.



RISK AND COMPLIANCE

ADELAIDE CUP 2023 & COVID-19

The Adelaide Cup this year will be free of COVID-19 controls and restrictions for the second year in a row. GRSA will continue, as best practice, to provide a venue that minimises your risk to COVID-19. To that end, please remember it is always good practice to observe social distancing and wash your hands when needed. If you feel unwell, it is best not to attend. Finally, you are always welcome to wear your own mask if you want you.

RACETRACK SAFETY

Please remember to stay safe in and around the racetrack, especially at trials. Always stay vigilant and follow directions to prevent accidents and injuries.

SOME IMPORTANT POINTS

UNDERSTAND THE LURE

The lure is a mechanical device that travels along the path of the inner racetrack rail, controlled by a lure driver. The lure can travel very fast. The lure can start, stop, and change its speed at any time and without warning.

BEFORE THE TRIAL

Before participating at a trial, you must listen to, or read, any safety briefing and note warning signs on the racetrack. Only use the designated gates to move between areas. Never use the lure chute on a catching pen gate as a thoroughfare or jump any fences or inner rails. Where chains are in place to stop movement, do not move them without direction.

STAY CLEAR OF MOVING PARTS

You must not walk onto the racetrack surface unless under the direction and supervision of a GRSA official. You must never approach the lure, or approach or stand in the path of travel of the lure [which is within two (2) metres of the inner rail] at any time.

COMMUNICATION IS KEY

If you ever see something that you think is a hazard, while the lure is moving, yell out – STOP LURE. STOP LURE. STOP LURE.

BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS

Stay alert to your surroundings. Avoid distractions like mobile phones or personal conversations that might divert your attention from the lure. Remember, your safety and the safety of those around you are of utmost importance. By following these guidelines and respecting the rules and directions around the lure, we can create a safer and more productive environment for everyone. Let's all work together to stay safe!

Distribution between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants who receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party (e.g. owners) then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective, the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you **DO NOT** need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically, however;
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners of your own accord, then you **DO** need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

Example to help participants understand the WAP they receive

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dog(s). The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

Assumptions:

In this example, assume the owner/trainer received **\$1,000** in prizemoney for any/all races for the month.

In this the total prizemoney (paid to all participant) is **\$700,000**.

In this example, the total WAP is **\$50,000**.

In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of **\$71.43**, calculated as:

$$\text{\$1,000} \div \text{\$700,000} \times \text{\$50,000} = \text{\$71.43}$$

Participants should note that:

- WAP is **not payable** for any prizemoney received in relation to feature races [where total stakes are above \$5,000];
- Trainers' fees and other bonus payments are not included in the calculation of the share of the WAP; and
- It is a requirement that a greyhound has to have raced and received prizemoney during a month to be eligible to receive the WAP payment for that month.



ZIPPERING NEUTRON

TRAINER: TIM ALOISI

Greyhound of the Month for August was Zippering Neutron for trainer Tim Aloisi, who continued to dominate the local staying ranks with scintillating performances.

Zippering Neutron had four starts for the month winning three of his local starts with his only defeat coming in the Group 1 National Distance Championship Final at the Meadows in Victoria. He started the month off with a 42.65 win at headquarters over the 730m before a strong win in the Final of the National Distance SA series recording a handy 43.22.

He then was far from disgraced finishing 6th in the Group 1 National Final against the best stayers in the land. The son of SH Avatar and Zippering Abby returned home and didn't miss a beat recording a 6-length win at Angle Park over the staying trip in 43.17.

At the end of the month Zippering Neutron's record stood at 47 starts for 19 wins and 9 placings and earnings around \$108,000. His record over the 730m at Angle Park is brilliant winning 9 of his 10 starts.



COULD BE KING

TRAINER: BEN RAWLINGS

The Run of the Month for August was the Ben Rawlings trained Could Be King for his fantastic win at Angle Park on Thursday, 3rd August over the 530m journey in a Heat of the National Sprint SA Series.

In a small field Could Be King began fairly to race near the tail of the field, however, accelerated brilliantly through the middle stages to hit the lead turning for home and racing away. He won by 3 lengths in a blistering 30.35.

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

We continue to look to increase these further in order to offer a wider variety of times to meet participants varying requirements.

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

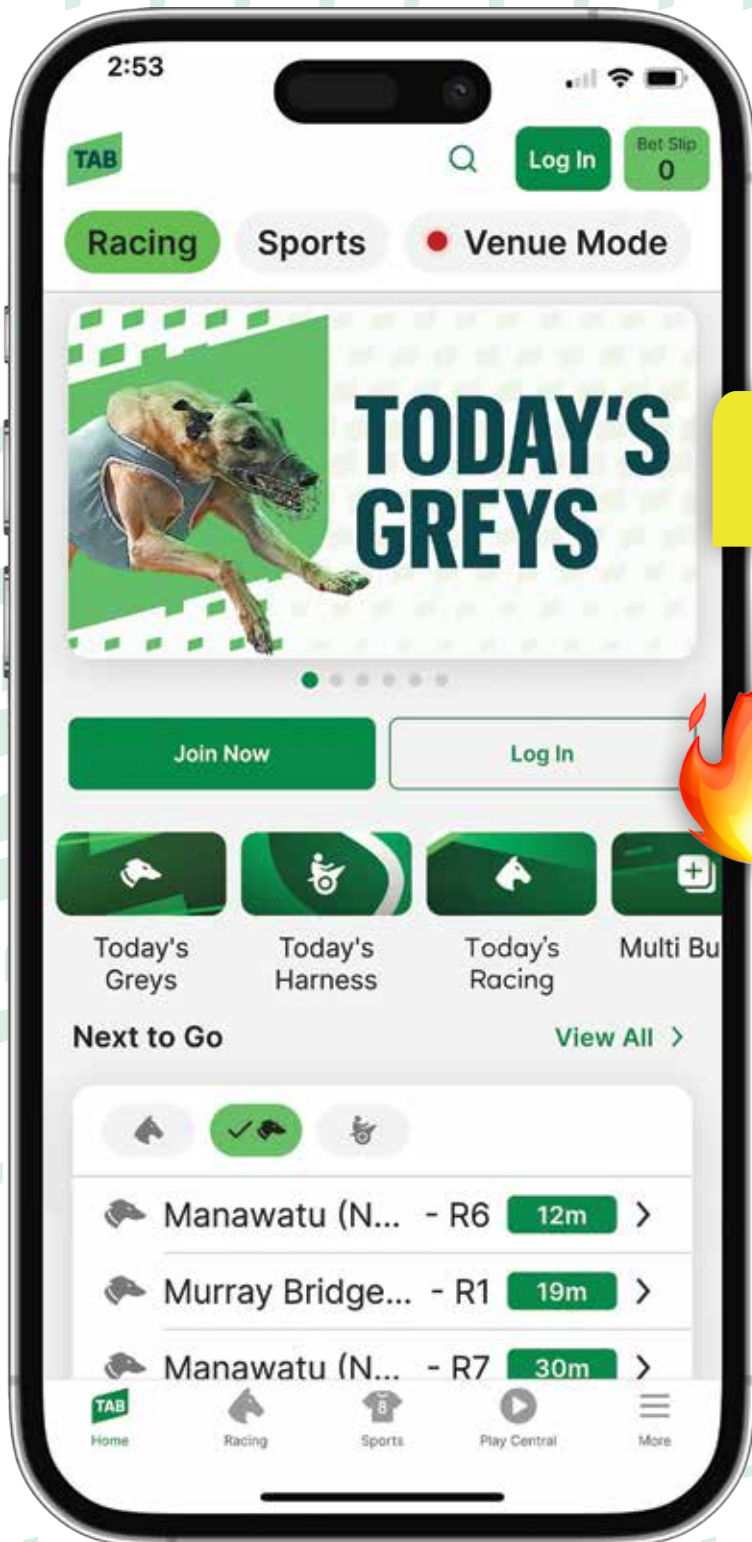

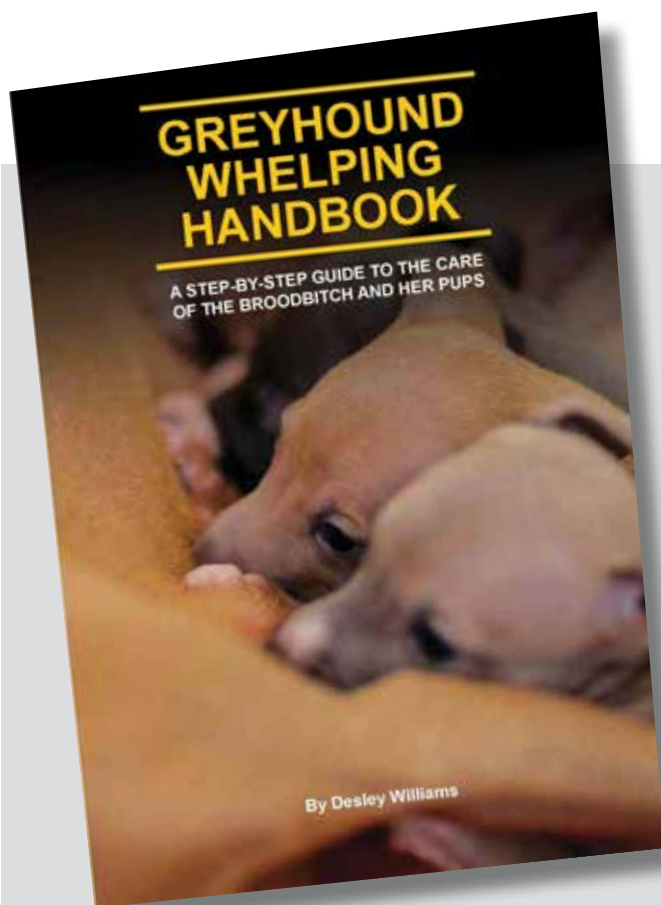
