FROM THE CEO

BRENTON SCOTT

STRATEGIC PLAN

Particularly exciting to advise that the strategic plan refresh has been completed and publication and supporting advice to participants will take place over the coming week.

The plan guides the industry strategic path over the next three years. It includes a reshaped vision and a targeted reconsideration of the values that we will all need to uphold as we continue to positively reposition our industry. The plan divides into four pillars – Animal Care and Welfare, Governance and Integrity, Growth and Capacity and Engagement and People.

Each pillar is driven by a concise objective that must be achieved within the plan term while the outcomes we will collectively achieve have been broken down into priorities and key actions. Importantly, workplans also sit behind the key actions and these will ensure those responsible for plan execution are informed on a detail basis and that the plan is able to be measured and held to account.

Importantly, the plan is highly synchronised with the Ashton Review recommendations whilst also capturing the feedback of industry participants, clubs and employees who were also consulted during its considerations. The plan was also subjected to external review by Marc Makrid and Associates, so as to ensure independent expertise supported its content and structure.

I trust that all industry participants, club members and industry employees are able to embrace and collectively take responsibility for the plan outcomes that we must achieve. If we do, I am supremely confident that we will ensure that our industry not only continues, but genuinely cements its position as a trusted community contributor with a viable and sustainable future.

IER REPORT

It is important that the South Australian racing industry continue to trumpet the many benefits that arise from its existence.

To this end, I am pleased to advise that the three codes recently commissioned IER to prepare a report that highlights the economic, social and community benefits that the South Australian racing industry contributed to the state economy across FY23. The report clearly confirms that the economic impacts generated by the racing industry were substantial, with a total direct expenditure of \$573.1m.

This expenditure resulted in a direct value added impact of \$211.8m (wages, salaries and profits), which increased to over \$669.7m when flow-on effects were taken into account. The racing industry was responsible for sustaining 4,971 full-time equivalent (FTE) jobs across the state with significant number of individuals engaged within the racing industry. In addition to the economic impacts, the racing industry played a vital role in the social and community fabric of South Australia.

Thoroughbred, harness, and greyhound racing events brought together family and friends for a social experience, connected people with diverse backgrounds, and reinforced community values. The industry also contributed to the tourism profile of towns and cities, supporting local businesses and educating visitors about the local community.

Key Highlights – South Australian Greyhound Industry

- In 2022/23, the South Australian Greyhound racing industry was responsible for generating \$125m in value added contribution to the South Australian economy
- 918 FTE jobs sustained by the South Australian Greyhound racing industry
- 1390 participants involved in the industry as an employee, participant or volunteer
- 448 Race Meetings conducted at 5 clubs
- 1932 Individual greyhounds in training with 476 registered pups for the year

NATIONALS... A ROARING SUCCESS

The South Australian greyhound industry can be extremely proud of its efforts in hosting the recent National Championships at Angle Park and Murray Bridge during August.

The efforts applied by the Murray Bridge Greyhound Racing Club in hosting the National Straight Track Championship on the Saturday morning of August 24, 2024 were exceptional. A large contingent of interstate guests viewed outstanding racing on both tracks whilst also being presented with a demonstration of the newly constructed greyhound education circuit. The feedback received was highly complimentary with one delegate describing the venue as "Australian greyhound racing's best kept secret".

A very good crowd also attended the Sprint and Distance grand final meeting at Angle Park later in the day and, again, no racing enthusiast went home disappointed. A large number of nationally focussed meetings (business and training), plus a symposium were also staged to strong acclaim. All in all, a great experience and a time where the national spotlight well and truly shone on our great state. Congratulations go to the hard working officials, employees and participants who again combined so effectively. Well done to all.

RACING SAFETY WORKING GROUP

Ongoing considerations regarding the safest possible presentation of greyhound racing are very much a requirement of the Ashton Review. Given this, GRSA is delighted to advise participants that it has recently formed a Racing Safety Working Group that will be charged with analysing injuries and causation, track diagnostics and various race safety initiatives.

The RSWG membership will comprise representatives from various departments of the GRSA administration and will be further supported by specialist veterinary and trainer representation. In addition, I am very pleased to advise of the appointment of Paul Marks as the GRSA Race Safety Officer [part time]. Paul is a former Chief Steward at GRSA and has, for the past eight years, provided specialist support to GRNSW in injury analysis and track maintenance. Welcome back Paul.

RIGHT ROYAL EFFORT

The GRSA Greyhounds As Pets team was once again an exhibitor at the Royal Adelaide Show. Following on from record adoptions in FY24, the GAP team again presented with great enthusiasm, promoting adoption to the general public over nine long days.

The show obviously presents greyhound racing with a great opportunity to explain the virtues of our wonderful breed. Much of the work undertaken is 'slow burn' in terms of influencing future decisions. However, in excess of 50 formal expressions of interest in adopting a greyhound were received with several of those already converting to actual adoptions. Brilliant work team!

WE REMEMBER

Extremely sad to learn of the passing of some industry stalwarts in recent times, Don Wenham, Helen Deacon and Cyril Boston.

Don was the track curator at Gawler for many years and very handy trainer in his own right. He and wife Helen raced the brilliant stayer Nat Gatty in the 1980's and, in the pre-betting Bolivar days, they trained the exceptional Chari Sparu. Don greeted all with a welcoming smile and firm handshake and will be missed by many.

Helen, from an industry perspective, is best remembered as the owner of the Adelaide Cup winner Ernie Bung Arrow, a front running cult hero who brought her great joy.

Cyril was a former committee member of the Gawler Greyhound Racing Club and a particularly proficient trainer. Though always restricted to a small kennel, he was always a force to be reckoned with and raced a number of topline including Smithy's Belle for long term friend Ross Smith.

STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT SESSIONS

2024 TAB MATCH RACE CHALLENGE – SA TAKES ON THE ALL STARS – NOMINATIONS CLOSE ON MONDAY 23rd SEPTEMBER

South Australia will again conduct the annual Match Race Challenge in September, to be held on Thursday, 26th September during the rich Adelaide Cup Carnival.

GRSA has kept the conditions of the series the same as last year to be “SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS” to ensure that the Angle Park TAB Match Race Challenge attracts the best greyhounds possible.

It will be four [4] SA greyhounds taking on the four [4] best nominated greyhounds from anywhere in Australia.

GRSA will still guarantee the winner of the TAB Match Race Challenge direct entry into the \$100,000 to the winner Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final on Friday, 11th October [bypassing the Adelaide Cup Heats]. The winner of the Match Race series is considered qualified for the Group 1 Adelaide Cup and will not be eligible to compete in another series.

Conditions of the TAB Match Race Challenge – SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS:

Eligibility as to who represents South Australia or All-Stars will be based around the National Championships domiciliary clause. Greyhounds need to be trained in the State they wish to represent for 76 days out of the last 150 days prior to the date that nominations close [23rd September].

The best four [4] greyhounds nominated from SA will be selected by the GRSA Grader to represent “SA’s Best”. The best four [4] greyhounds nominated from Interstate will be selected by the GRSA Grader to represent “the All-Stars”.

The Grader will use whatever information he has available to select those greyhounds including liaising with other State bodies as required. The SA Grader’s decision will be final.

Those greyhounds not selected from Interstate will be given the opportunity to solo trial or race in another event on the night.

Reserves will be declared, with one [1] from SA and one [1] from Interstate [dependant on nominations], which will replace the SA or All-Stars representative as required.

For example the SA reserve will only replace an SA scratching.

The Grader will rate the four [4] greyhounds from SA and the four [4] from Interstate in order from 1 to 4, with No.1 being the highest rated greyhound from each group. The head-to-head matches will be decided by the two No. 1 rated greyhounds competing against each other and then it will be 2 v 2, 3 v 3 and 4 v 4.

Prizemoney for each individual match will also reflect the seeding of greyhounds from 1 to 4, with the No. 1 rated greyhounds racing for the most prizemoney in the head-to-head races. However, the overall winner of the race will still be determined on actual race times run by each greyhound [to three decimal places only].

PRIZEMONEY:

Prizemoney for each pairing:

- 1 v 1 – Winner \$4,750, Runner Up \$1,000
- 2 v 2 – Winner \$4,500, Runner Up \$1,000
- 3 v 3 – Winner \$4,250, Runner Up \$1,000
- 4 v 4 – Winner \$4,000, Runner Up \$1,000

Prizemoney for the overall placings for TAB Match Race Challenge (based on overall times): • 1st – \$7,500 • 2nd – \$2,500 • 3rd – \$1,000

• Nominations for the Match Race close Monday, 23rd September at 9.00am.

2024 SA COUNTRY CUP SERIES LATER THIS MONTH

Below are details of how and where greyhounds can qualify for the \$8,500 SA Country Cup Final, to be run at Angle Park over 530 metres on Adelaide Cup Final night Friday, 11th October 2024 as a G-SIX.

GRSA have kept the changes to the conditions from last year to encourage more support for the series with the Heats at each venue increased to \$4,000 each.

Conditions

- All South Australian Greyhound Racing Clubs outside of Angle Park will conduct Heats or nominate greyhounds from which the Greyhound Racing SA Grading Department will choose two representatives. These meetings are Gawler Provincial 1 and 2, Murray Bridge One Turn Provincial 1 and Mount Gambier Provincial 1 and 2.

- The event is open to all South Australian greyhounds that are not above Grade 5 at Angle Park (APK City A meeting only) over 530 metres at the time of nomination. This condition is not applicable to the Mount Gambier representatives. Winner of each event takes a penalty including the Final.

Special Exceptions:

Mount Gambier Club is allowed to include non-South Australian trainers under strict conditions:

1. The Interstate trainer has had starters at 10 meetings for Mt Gambier in the previous 12 months.

2. The Interstate trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 2 months.

- Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.

- The greyhound must be SA trained (except Mount Gambier as above).

o A South Australian trained greyhound is defined as one that has been racing in SA for a period of not less than 2 out of the 6 months immediately prior to the time of nomination.

- The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track it is attempting to represent.

- There will be a maximum of two Heats per Club with the winners of each Heat qualifying. If there is only one Heat conducted, then the first two placegetters will qualify.

- The two reserves will be determined firstly by a ballot of the second placegetters from all Heats. The third placegetters will then be considered by ballot if required. If a Heat was not conducted at the track, then that track is not included in the ballot. Should a greyhound be withdrawn prior to the ballot, the next placed greyhound from that Club's Heat will be selected.

- If a greyhound does not qualify from a Qualifying Heat it is eligible to compete at another track in this series so long as meets that tracks criteria.

- Once a greyhound has qualified from a Qualifying Heat, it is not eligible to compete at another track in this series, unless there are insufficient nominations to fill the field.

- Once qualified for the Country Cup Final the greyhound will be ineligible for the Adelaide Cup series or any other race on this Cup Final night.

- Lead up Heats may be up to 8 greyhounds however the Final on Adelaide Cup night will be a G-SIX Final.

2024 TAB ADELAIDE CUP TO RACE ON FRIDAY 11TH OCTOBER

Thanks to the support of Greyhound Racing New South Wales this year, South Australia will be able to run our premier Group 1 meeting on Friday, 11th October. SA will swap meetings with NSW so we can race in the evening, and we will have full Sky 1 coverage for this meeting.

Murray Bridge will race on the Thursday night before the Cup (10th October) retaining our normal night time Sky 1 slot. Murray Bridge Straight track will run a Full Time Graded meeting on the Saturday morning after the Adelaide Cup (12th October) to accommodate necessary clean up after the night.

GRSA is very appreciative of GRNSW for assisting us this year with this scheduling change which would not have happened without their support.

The overall winner of the SA Match Race (SA V Allstars) series will be guaranteed a spot in the Group 1 Adelaide Cup on Friday, 11th October. This greyhound will not be eligible to compete in the Heats on Thursday, 3rd October.

There will be a Consolation for the Adelaide Cup worth \$14,275 on Cup night along with the \$8,500 Country Cup Final. The \$15,250 Premier's Cup over the 730m will also be conducted on Adelaide Cup Final night for the stayers.

HEATS CLASSIC 2024 PRELUDE (2) AT ANGLE PARK IN OCTOBER

The \$3,700 Heats of Classic 2024 Prelude (2) will be run on Monday, 7th October with the \$4,500 Final on Thursday, 17th October over the 530m. For SA Bred greyhounds whelped July 22 to December 22 and paid up for Classic 2024.

2024 GAWLER CUP CARNIVAL KICKS OFF ON MONDAY 21ST OCTOBER

The Gawler Gold Cup carnival will be run over two meetings again this year. The Gawler GRC with the Thoroughbreds and Harness Racing in the region are hoping to make a mini carnival again this year with all three codes running their main races for the year around the same time.

Our Gawler Cup carnival will kick off on Monday, 21st October with \$3,000 Heats for the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup over the 531m along with \$2,095 Heats of the Gawler Sprint Classic for open 400m greyhounds and the \$2,905 Heats of the "Bothing" Gawler Stayers Cup for open 643m greyhounds.

The Group 3 Gawler Cup Final will be run on Sunday night, 27th October worth \$36,000 in prizemoney with the winner to receive \$25,000. This night will include the \$8,000 Gawler Sprint Classic Final, the \$8,500 Final of the Bothing Gawler Stayers Cup and there will be a \$4,000 Consolation for the Gawler Gold Cup.

Nominations for the Gawler Cup Heats, Gawler Sprint Classic Heats and Bothing Stayers Cup close with GRSA at 9.00am on Thursday, 17th October

NO TRIALS AT GAWLER ON MONDAY MORNING OF GAWLER CUP HEATS

Please note with the Gawler Cup Heats on Monday night, 21st October there will be NO trials at the Gawler venue that morning to allow preparation for the race meeting.

CHANGE OF VENUES TO ACCOMMODATE THE GAWLER CUP HEATS IN OCTOBER

Please note with the Gawler Cup Heats this year being conducted on Monday night, 21st October our normal schedule will change slightly.

Angle Park will run on Friday, 18th October with a day meeting at City B class while Sunday night, 20th October will be a Murray Bridge Prov 1 meeting around the One Turn. Please check the October All Tracks calendar for programmed events.

GAWLER TRIALS ON THURSDAY 26TH SEPTEMBER TO FINISH BY 9.30AM

The Gawler GRC have advised that they have a SAPSASA football event on at Gawler on Thursday, 26th September which was the same as last year. To ensure access for this event the trials will need to be completed by 9.30am in the morning.

AGRC TO SPONSOR RACES ONCE A MONTH

The Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club will sponsor an event each month starting from November, these events will also include Heats and Finals. The sponsorship will be \$1,000 per event, totaling 10 events bringing their sponsorship to a total of \$10,000. GRSA is very appreciative of the Clubs sponsorship. Programmed events will be advised once determined.

The AGRC will provide two prizes to be paid out for each winner.

MAIDEN SELECTION CRITERIA

As determined through the Grading Review Panel the entry criteria for Maidens into an event will be Order of Preference, Maidens with a placing in their last two starts using WPS, First starters then other Maidens using WPS.

PREFERENTIAL BOX DRAWS AT MURRAY BRIDGE STRAIGHT TRACK

GRSA have started conducting Preferential Box Draws for selected events at the Murray Bridge Straight track meetings (Maidens, Feature Cup and Championship series are excluded). These types of events are being regularly programmed Interstate under each state's conditions. Events will be specifically advertised, and trainers must advise if they want to compete in these events along with the racing trait of the respective greyhound at the time of nominating in the comments box. If trainers do not provide this information when nominating, they will not be considered for these advertised PBD events.

Conditions -

- PBD racing introduced for advertised race events at the Murray Bridge Straight track from August 1, 2024
- Three racing traits – R = Rail, M = Middle, W = Wide
- The Trainer nominates the racing trait of the greyhound relating to box rise and 50m after the start
- This is reviewed by Stewards/Grading teams
- Box draws via OzChase which can now accommodate an automated process where greyhounds can be grouped by trait and then automatically box drawn
- Grading of each race event will be done under normal grading and programming guidelines
- There will be NO Reserves for these events

Tuesday 13th August – PDB Grade 6 Final – 300m, PBD Grade 5 300m (3 events)

CURRENT MASTERS TIMES AND POLICY

- For greyhounds 3¾ years and older. 4yo and older will get preference. City A, City B and Prov 1 meetings are done by form for 4yo and older and then greyhounds will only get in from under 4yo to 3¾ yo in age from oldest to youngest. Prov 2 meetings are all done on age from oldest to youngest regardless of form for all ages.
- Dates are exact so going back 4yo and 3¾ from the date of race. Ie date of race run on 20/11/22 – 4yo would be 20/11/18 whelping.
- Time restrictions if a greyhound wins a Grade 5 Masters race in a faster time than published and it will have to have 2 runs (placed or unplaced) in normal company (if in a Mixed Masters and wins and runs faster than the time standard then will NOT count) at that class of meeting before being eligible at that class of meeting.
- The Grader will look to grade a Grade 5 Masters event on every program over a distance if enough dogs are nominated regardless if it is advertised in the All Tracks calendar.
- All races Non Penalty.

Angle Park 342m 19.75, 530m 30.80, 595m N/A, 730m N/A

Gawler 400m 23.00, 531m 31.15, 643m N/A

Murray Bridge 300m 16.70, 350m 19.25, 395m 22.50, 455m 25.75, 530m N/A

If a Mixed Masters is programmed the Grade 5 dogs will be mixed if there is Grade 4 and Grade 3 dogs linking together like normal grading. If there are Grade 2 and 3 dogs and then Grade 5 dogs only a Grade 5 Masters will be conducted under normal conditions as these cannot be linked. If there is enough to run a high grade Mixed Masters (ie Grade 2/3 & 4) we will do that and not include Grade 5 unless they nominate specifically for this programmed event.

305m Masters Policy for Mt Gambier – With Mt Gambier GRC conducting one 305m Grade 5 Masters race each meeting where possible, the Grading Department determined conditions for these races using some of the conditions of normal Grade 5 Masters events, however, factoring in the restricted nature of the 305m distance. There will still be a Time Standard applied based on the published table being 17.75. If a dog wins and runs faster than 17.75, it can still remain eligible for the next week, if the dog then

wins and runs faster than 17.75 again it will be ineligible for the race and distance the following week. The dog will either run over another distance or will miss that week's race. The following week it will then be eligible. If there is no 305m Masters race the greyhound has to miss the next time that race is conducted. This only refers to the greyhounds that win.

VACCINATION RULE FOR RACING IN SA – REMINDER

Trainers are reminded that Rule 25 (Minimum Vaccination Requirements) took effect Monday, 1st May, 2023. Vaccination Certificates must be received by GRSA prior to close of nominations for affected greyhounds to be considered eligible for nominating. It is also imperative that once the greyhound has been vaccinated the paperwork is lodged by yourself as soon as possible. Trainers are also reminded that they must not have their greyhound vaccinated within 5 days of racing. Should this occur, the greyhound will be scratched from its engagement or if paperwork lodged after an engagement and discovered the greyhound raced inside the 5 days then the matter will be referred to the stewards.

SA REGISTERED BREEDERS SUPPORT PROGRAM

The South Australian greyhound racing industry has a long and proud breeding history. GRSA remains committed to supporting registered SA Breeders achieve the best possible breeding outcomes.

The Breeders Support Program provides a range of support to SA Registered Breeders including:

- No fees for whelping notice
- No fees for registration of litter
- \$180 rebate for DNA costs for breeding female; and
- A breeders rebate of up to \$5500 for each SA Bred litter

SA BRED UPDATE

The pool of money is \$45,000 per month.

These winners all receive a \$225 base payment with \$75 to the Owner and \$150 to the Breeder.

The SA Bred Bonus scheme is continuing to go over budget with the number of SA Bred winners increasing. This meant that last financial year we went over budget by \$6,750 (30 winners). So far, this financial year in July 2024 there were 224 and August 212 meaning we are 36 winners over budget already (\$8,100).

Long time South Australian trainer, breeder and administrator Judi Hurely was one of four people recently inducted into the Greyhound Clubs Australia Hall of Fame.

Honoured at the Greyhounds Clubs Australia Gala Dinner during the recent Nationals in South Australia, Hurley was joined in the Hall of Fame by New South Wales breeder Jan Wheeler and Victorian administrator Marg Long.

The three women were the first three women to be inducted into the Greyhound Clubs Australia Hall of Fame.

Also acknowledged on the night was Mount Gambier's Kevin 'KD' Douglas who was awarded the Denise Fysh award for 2024.

The award recognises an industry person who has faced adversity but continues to serve the industry and their local community. KD was nominated for this award by all of our South Australian greyhound racing clubs.

KD was celebrated for his more than 50 years volunteering in the the Mount Gambier area including at the Mount Gambier Greyhound Racing Club where he has been instrumental in the Tara Tipsters and 'Catch for Cash' initiative.

His generosity and commitment to the local community saw him recognised as the Mount Gambier Senior Citizen of the Year at the Australia Day awards in 2024 and made him a truly worthy recipient of this year's Denise Fysh award.

The other major awards that were handed out at the 2024 GCA Gala Awards Dinner included

The Paul Wheeler Dam of the Year award which was won by Maximum Dos.

The Sire of the Year was taken out for the sixth consecutive time by Fernando Bale.

The Run of the Year was won by Hector Fawley for his eye-popping run to win the Sandgroper this year.

The Australian Greyhound Trainer of the Year was Jason Thompson for his year which included 199 wins and five Group 1s.

The Australian Greyhound of the Year was taken out by distance star Palawa King who claimed five group 1s in the 23/24 season including the Queensland Cup, National Distance Final, Association Cup, Bold Trease and the Fanta Bale.



Miss Envy & Raider's Guide take National titles

Raider's Guide gave Tasmania its first win in the Group 1 National Distance when romping home by eight and a quarter lengths at Angle Park on Saturday August 24.

Raced and trained by Gary Fahey, the son of Zambora Brockie and Sacred Shadow led easily and was never really in danger despite Gary having doubts about his ability to run out a strong 730m.

He downed Ritza Piper which was last going into the back straight, with Fahey's Magic holding on for third.

It took Raider's Guide's career to 62 starts for 34 wins and 16 placings and his earnings to \$386,000.

He had been a finalist in the G1 National Sprint in 2023.

The winner was handled at Angle Park by Gary's daughter, Carol Martin, because Gary has not been in the best of health in recent times.

WA's emerging sprint superstar Miss Envy got a dream run at the first turn to rail to the front and hold on to win the G1 National Sprint.

The Steve and Krystal Shinners bred and raced daughter of Aston Dee Bee and wonder brood-bitch Miss America, Miss Envy held off Smooth Plane to win the final in 30.20 with Might Have Been rattling home for third.

Miss Envy, the hot favourite for the final after a sensational first-up trial on the track, took her record to 12 starts for eight wins and three placings and her earnings to \$160,000.

Victoria also enjoyed National success when Mile A Minute clinched a thrilling win in the Group 3 National Straight Track Championship Final at Murray Bridge.

Mile A Minute showed incredible determination to overcome an early tussle.

The brindle chaser managed to catch up with and overtake Express Ethics from New South Wales and Cash On Delivery from South Australia, clinching victory by a neck in 19.17.



Pet Detective takes out Kings & Queens Final

The South Australian Spring Carnival is underway for 2024 with the final of the 2024 Kings & Queens series run and won at Angle Park on Thursday September 5.

The Kings & Queens series is for greyhounds whelped between 1st March and 31st May 2022 and has produced high quality fields previously, and this year's race was no exception.

With a strong field assembled and a wide-open betting market, the race produced a sensational finish with half a length separating the top three runners.

It was the Ben Rawlings trained Pet Detective who claimed the event, holding off the fast-finishing pair of Lenny's Honey for Manuel Stuppos and Daintree Granite for Lauren Harris winning by a nose in a sensational finish.

Speaking on the dais post-race, trainer Ben Rawlings said that the success was an excellent reward for the improvement Pet Detective had shown over the past few weeks.

"He broke in really well and then hadn't really shown a whole lot and he has just been sort of steady," Rawlings said.

"He is really starting to mature; he is over two now and his last six weeks have probably been his best."

The close finish was a reversal of last year's race for Rawlings, who fell just short with Could Be King in an excellent race with Fiorano and he was happy to flip the result "Last year, I was the one flashing on that just missed and this year I was the one leading and just hanging on," Rawlings said.

"It was a great race; a very competitive race and it was nice to get the result."

For the May 22 whelping by Fernando Bale x Tangelo Fire, it was career win number 10 to go with eight placings at start number 22 and looks to be a chaser on the rise.

Tuesday 17/9/24 - 5 minutes after kennel closing

Friday 27/9/24 - 5 minutes after kennel closing

Saturday 28/9/24 - 9am to 9.15am

We are pleased to inform you the facility will be available for use from 6am to 6pm, excluding designated racing times. Pre-online booking will be required to secure access, and participants will need to provide their own GRSA approved lure for use at the facility. Further details including booking instructions and essential safety information will be provided directly to registered trainers and handlers in advance of the facility's opening on 1 October 2024.

We trust the GEC will serve as a valuable resource in the training process for industry participants and we look forward to your participation.





STAYING SAFE AROUND THE LURE

This Toolbox Safety Talk is about staying safe around the lure. Always stay vigilant and follow directions to prevent accidents and injuries.

Some important points:

1. Understand the Lure

The lure is a mechanical device that travels along the path of the inner racetrack rail, controlled by a lure driver. The lure can travel very fast and is relatively quiet. The lure can start, stop and change its speed at any time and without warning.

2. The Trial

Before the use of a lure at a trial, you must listen to, or read, this safety briefing and note the warning signs on the racetrack. Only use the gates to move between areas. Never use the lure chute on the catching pen gate as a thoroughfare. Where chains are in place to stop movement, do not move them without direction.

3. Wear Proper Clothing

You must always wear a visible vest or clothing when you are near the track. Clothing must be suitable for physical work.

4. Stay Clear of Moving Parts

You must never walk onto the racetrack (sand) surface unless under direction and supervision of a GRSA official. You must never approach the lure, or approach or stand in the path of travel of the lure, which is within 1.5-metres of the inner rail.

5. Communication is Key

If you ever see something that you think is a hazard, while the lure is moving, yell out –

STOP LURE. STOP LURE. STOP LURE.

6. Be Aware of Surroundings

Stay alert to your surroundings. Avoid distractions like mobile phones or personal conversations that might divert your attention from the lure.

Remember, your safety and the safety of those around you are of utmost importance. By following these guidelines and respecting the rules and directions around the lure, we can create a safer and more productive environment for everyone.

Kind reminder from GAP:

Please submit a placement form if your greyhound has already passed the GAP first point assessment.

If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialed after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!

As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.

We continue to look to increase these further in order to offer a wider variety of times to meet participants varying requirements.

Payment of placement fees

TRIALS

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held fortnightly on a Wednesday night (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Normal trials start at 4:00pm during non-daylight savings and 5:30pm during daylight savings. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kennelling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Murray Bridge Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. At Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

RACE WELL SUBSTANCE VALIDATOR – NOW AVAILABLE ON YOUR APP STORE

The Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission (GWIC), NSW, released an app named Race Well Substance Validator. GWIC kindly offered access to this app to the general greyhound racing industry and we thank them for their work and generosity.

The app can install on your preferred mobile device (see below) and be a reference source for guidance on certain substances. As you know, some substances that are intended for treatment or supplements will be, on a test, identified as a prohibited or permanently banned substance. The rule relating to presenting a greyhound not free of a prohibited substance is extremely rigid and strictly applied.

You can download the app from your preferred app store, for your mobile device. Head over to your app store and search "Race Well". The app is yellow, green and white, with a white tick icon. As standard, the use of the app comes with terms and conditions. These terms and conditions, together with information on the app, can be found here:

GRSA will be guided by these terms and conditions when considering the use of Race Well.

It is important to note that the app is for guidance only.

GRSA relies on laboratory test results and scientific

classification of substances as evidence in related inquiries. Just because a substance is not on the Race Well database does not mean it is not a prohibited or permanently banned substance.

Race Well results (for, against or absent) will not be considered an excuse for a breach of the relevant rules. You should always seek professional advice from a veterinarian if you are in any doubt about a substance.

Further, you need to record the use of the therapeutic substance in your treatment records books and therapeutic substances must have on the label, an APVMA number. This is a formal record of the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority.

You must keep all substances in their original packaging and, where prescribed by a veterinarian, keep legible the prescription label.

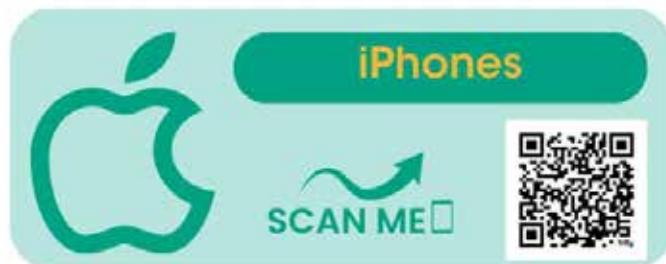

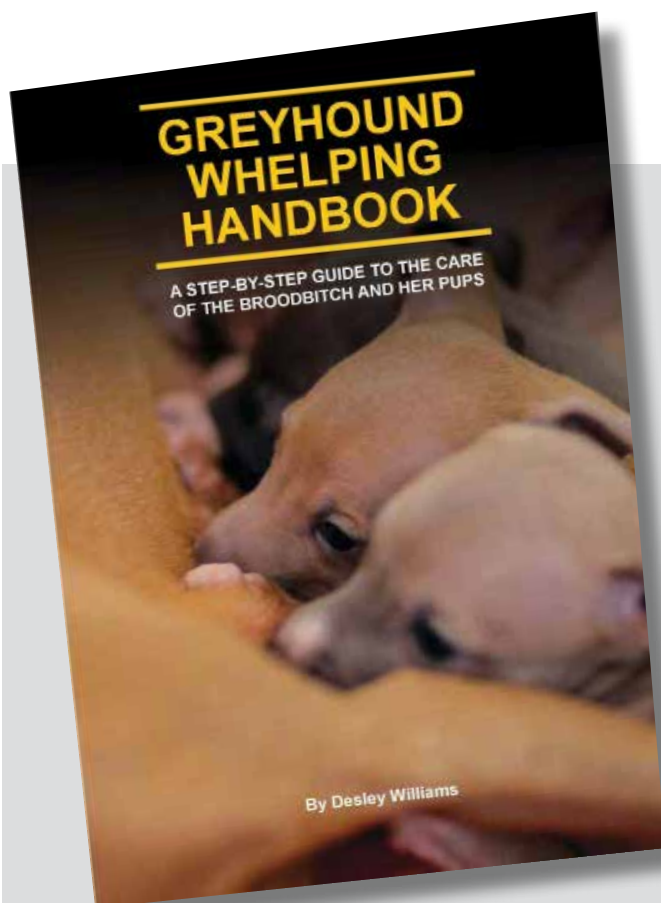
