MESSAGE FROM MATT

Breeder Focus Groups

Over the course of the coming week, GRSA will be conducting focus group sessions with breeders to explore the industry's thinking in relation to breeding – challenges and opportunities – and discuss the manner in which GRSA should introduce additional support of breeders, both now and in the years immediately ahead. The question here, is not about whether we implement new support initiatives but how that should be done in a manner which positively impacts breeder viability whilst, at the same time, lining up with broader industry strategies around the quality of mating selection, the rate at which we succeed in getting pups to the track, average racing career length and our fundamental need to rehome.

Discussion within those focus groups will also need to consider the impact and timing of costs upon our breeders, the particular need that exists to support that group during certain periods of a litter's development and other relevant context.

In noting that it is not entirely practical to involve all breeders in this initial discussion, all reasonable efforts have been made to constitute those groups with a mix of breeders which represent a balanced cross-section of that participant group and one that will guide the process towards some balanced and meaningful outcomes. Our breeders are the cornerstone of the industry and within any bounds of reason, that fact needs to be reflected in industry strategy as we seek to push forward towards a new and prosperous future.

The son of Lochinvar Marlow and Amity Kinship won his heat from box 8 when he was able to lead throughout, and again he drew box 8 in the final with connections hoping for the same result. He began nicely from the pink and headed towards the lead however, Larrikin Locky for Lisa Rasmussen beat him to the punch first as they raced into the back straight. The pair matched motors down the back until Hesa Marlow gained the advantage up the inside off the back straight and shook of Larrikin Locky as they turned for home before a late charge from the Petar Jovanovic trained Cairlea Ollie who flashed home in the shadows of the post. Hesa Marlow held on for a terrific win running a handy 30.13 for the 515m journey defeating Cairnlea Ollie by 3/4 length with Larrikin Locky in third a further 23/4 lengths away.

Hesa Marlow was locally Bred by Tony Milligan and owned by Gloria Milligan and with last night's win

2017 Coffex Coffee SA Oaks heats

After the delay of the SA Oaks series last week we were pleased to get two excellent heats for the Group 3 feature.

The quality is terrific and it all goes well for an outstanding final on Thursday, 21 September.

Heat 1 features Victorian Hoo Gur Affair for Angela Langton and Slinky Inky for Jeff Britton who both competed two weeks ago and suffered surprise defeats. They should be better for the experience and expect improvement. Crystal Bling is only lightly raced for Victorian trainer John Westerlo however she has had a couple of looks at the track and with an inside draw should run a bold race. Last start winner Dazzling Liesel for trainer Ken Trowbridge looks the best of the locals however will need some luck from her wide draw.

Heat 2 and talented Victorian Paradiso Lass looks the testing material for trainer Jeff Britton. She trialled at Angle Park two weeks ago in 30.15 so she should be cherry ripe tonight. She was placed in the Group 1 Maturity at the Meadows so she has a class edge on her rivals. Victorian Osakalaka for Jessica Sharp who came through the recent Speedstar series at Sandown and Comaneci for Queensland trainer Tom Tzouvelis look strong chances along with local hope Libby Raider for Paula Hearnden who could sneak a place.

GRSA would like to thank all local and interstate trainers and connections for supporting the Oaks series. Without your support this prestigious event may not have gone ahead.

The first four from each heat will qualify for the \$35,000 Group 3 Coffex Coffee SA Oaks Final with the box draw to be conducted oncourse after race 4.



2017 BGC Industrial Cleaning Supplies SA Derby heats

If you thought the heats of the Coffex Coffee Oaks were going to be exciting and produce ultra-competitive racing then the heats of the BGC SA Derby looks just as enthralling.

The anticipation will be electric as some of the best young local sprinters do battle with greyhounds from Victoria, Queensland, NSW and Western Australia.

Heat 1 features Victorian flyer Mepunga Blazer for Jeff Britton who trialled in a brilliant 29.48 two weeks ago and ran second in the Speedstar Open event at Sandown against local series hope Stitch 'Em Up for Ken Gill. Stich 'Em Up has won his last 4 starts and now takes the big step to Group 3 company. WA performer Bundles Galore for Enzo Crudeli could surprise from his inside draw.

Heat 2 and talented Victorian Dyna Dean for Mark Delbridge looks a strong contender after his brilliant win at the Meadows recently in 29.98. The race is full of chance's with Vanderworp and Backpacker Jack from WA, Manifold and Mepunga Tycoon from Victoria and the impressive and well named Mr. Pupparazzi for NSW trainer Barry Riccio. The best of the locals look to be Cairnlea Gump for Petar Jovanovic.

The last heat also has plenty of chances and some very exciting chasers. Maurice Minor for QLD trainer Tom Tzouvelis trialled here last week in a slick 29.70 and is fresh from his stylish Ipswich Derby win.

Poke The Bear for trainer Gerry O'Keefe from Victoria is only lightly raced but could not have been more impressive in winning at the Meadows last start. Black Bombshell for Enzo Crudeli from WA has an outstanding record with 8 wins from 14 starts and did trial solidly last week at headquarters. Locals Emerley Nolen, Half A Mill and Long Gully Pete are all nice types but will need to be at their best to qualify.

The first two from each heat along with the two fastest thirds will qualify for the \$35,000 Group 3 BGC Industrial Cleaning Supplies SA Derby Final on Thursday, 21st September. The box draw will be conducted oncourse after the running of Race 8.

On Fire claims another round of accolades



SA's star chaser On Fire claimed another accolade by winning the Greyhound of the Month award for August taking out the last four monthly awards.

He had another great month of racing with two wins and two seconds in his four starts. He won the heat and the final of the State series of the National Championships before representing SA in the Group 1 National Final at Albion Park. He ran a sizzling second behind the Queensland representative Jury in the final without having much luck early and established himself as a potential Group 1 winner. He came back to his home State and suffered an unlucky defeat at headquarters but no doubt the highlight was his Group 1 placing.

At the end of the month On Fire's record stands at 48 starts with 29 wins and 14 placings with earnings around \$140,000.

The Run of the Month for August was again awarded to the Cameron Butcher trained On Fire for his performance at Angle Park on Thursday 3rd August in the State heats of the National Sprint Championship.

Sent out a warm favourite he began well from box 2 to sit midfield early. He got into his work down the back straight but was still giving the leader, Cairnlea Kenny a handy head start however turning for home he knuckled down and claimed the win in the shadows of the post. He won by just under a length and seemed to do it easy however his time of 29.54 was blistering for the 515m journey.

Black caps now available from GRSA

Gun McBain another shot at Australian record on Sunday

South Australia's iron dog Gun McBain will again be looking to make history at Gawler on Sunday.

He will be taking aim at the Australian record for the most TAB wins by any greyhound in Australia. The Raye Kelly trained star equaled Just Proper's record of 65 wins when he won at headquarters a few weeks ago. Just Proper raced from 2012 to 2015 in Darwin and built an exceptional record. If Gun McBain can win he will take his record to 66 wins from 162 starts including 53 placings and prizemoney will surpass \$160,000. He is engaged in race 8 on Sunday (box 6) due to start at 8.02pm SA time and he will hopefully add another accolade to his outstanding career.

The Australasian TAB record is 74 wins held by Little Mother who raced in New Zealand from 2009 to 2012 so there may be another target in "Guns" sights with success Sunday.



Notification of training amendment and clearance of greyhounds

Trainers are reminded of their obligation to notify GRSA within 3 working days of a greyhound coming into or leaving their kennel (Rule 105(4)(i)).

This is a requirement for all greyhounds regardless of where bred. We have had a number of trainers recently put in training amendments late the night prior to nominations closing at 9am the following day, this practice can lead to your nomination not being accepted or being unable to nominate online should any issues arise the following morning.

Trainers are also leaving it to the night before nominations close to have greyhounds "checked off". This practice can also lead to your nomination not being accepted or being unable to nominate online should any issues arise.

It is therefore in the trainer's best interest to have lodged with GRSA the training amendment and clearance of the greyhound a number of days prior to wishing to nominate the greyhound. It is not GRSA's responsibility to ensure that the paperwork is processed within ½ hour, which is the amount of time available to have it processed before nominations close at 9am.

Completion of paperwork

Participants are reminded of their obligation to ensure that when lodging paperwork that it is fully completed and payment is made at the time of lodgement.

GRSA is here to assist should you be unsure of how to complete any paperwork however it is not our responsibility to arrange for its completion, nor is it our responsibility to ensure that it is lodged. Therefore, please ensure when lodging any paperwork eg, Transfer of Ownerships, Litter Registrations etc that they are fully completed and paid for and lodged within a timely manner.

2017 SA Country Cup qualification details

Below are details of how and where greyhounds can qualify for the \$7,375 SA Country Cup Final, to be run at Angle Park over 515 metres on Adelaide Cup Final night Friday 13th October 2017.

Conditions:

- All South Australian Greyhound Racing Clubs outside of Angle Park will conduct heats, or nominate greyhounds from which the Greyhound Racing SA Grading Department will choose two representatives. These meetings are Gawler Provincial 2, Strathalbyn Provincial 2, Mount Gambier Provincial 2 and Port Augusta Country. (Performances at Gawler Provincial 1 meetings are not eligible for consideration)
- The event is open to all South Australian greyhounds that are not above Grade 5 at Angle Park (APK City A & APM City B meetings only) over 515 metres at the time of nomination. Winner of each event takes a penalty including the final.

Special Exceptions:

Mount Gambier and Port Augusta Clubs are allowed to include non-South Australian trainers under strict conditions:

- 1. The trainer has had starters at 5 meetings for Pt Augusta and 15 meetings for Mt Gambier in the previous 12 months.
- 2. The trainer can only qualify for one of the Clubs.
- 3. The trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 3 months.
- Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.
- The greyhound must be SA trained (except Mount Gambier & Port Augusta as above).
 - A South Australian trained greyhound is defined as one that has been racing in SA for a period of not less than 3 out of the 6 months immediately prior to the time of nomination.
- The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track it is attempting to represent.
- There will be a maximum of two heats per Club with the winners of each heat qualifying. If there is only one heat conducted then the first two placegetters will qualify.
- The two reserves will be determined firstly by a ballot of the second placegetters from all heats. The third placegetters will then be considered by ballot if required. If a heat was not conducted at the track, then that track is not included in the ballot. Should a greyhound be withdrawn prior to the ballot, the next placed greyhound from that Club's heat will be selected.
- Once a greyhound has qualified from a Qualifying Heat, it is not eligible to compete at another track in this series, unless there are insufficient nominations to fill the field.
- Once qualified for the Country Cup Final the greyhound will be ineligible for the Adelaide Cup series or any other race on this Cup Final night.

Breeders support updates

In September last year in response to inquiries about the changes to the Breeders Support Program taking effect in April 2016 Greyhound Racing SA advised the changes below.

These changes are in support of breeder viability and continues increased spending on animal welfare and integrity initiatives.

Changes listed below:

Breeder Support Program

The following changes to the Breeder Support Program have been implemented:

- 1. Combined claim limit of \$800 for all veterinary and transport expenses
- 2. Removal of the advanced application process for the breeders rebate now that both sires and breeding females must be registered
- 3. Removal of the cap on litters in anticipation of national (tiered) breeder licensing

SA Bred Maiden Payment - \$1,000 if whelped in 2016 The SA bred maiden payment rewards participants that get a greyhound to the track to win a race.

GRSA has committed to dramatically increase this payment from \$175 to \$1,000 (\$500 breeder/\$500 owner) on 1st July, 2017. This will result in all greyhounds that are whelped in 2016 being eligible for this support.

Kurt Donsberg – Thursday nights and also Mondays

GRSA secured the services of Kurt Donsberg for oncourse photography. Kurt is no stranger to greyhound racing and his face will be familiar to many industry people. Kurt will not only be doing Thursday nights he will now also be available on Monday nights for the next few months.

Myozchase introduction

In June GRSA went Live with MyOzChase which provides an easy way for participants in the Greyhound Racing Industry to perform transactions online that previously had to be completed manually via paper-based Forms.

The portal available on the GRSA website will also improve communications between participants and Greyhound Racing Controlling Bodies.

MyOzChase will initially be offering the following functionality to users who register, obtain a log-in and complete a once-off identity verification prior to transacting online with their Controlling Body:

- · Submit Notifications of Retirement for greyhounds
- Submit Trainership and/or Kennel changes for greyhounds (replacing the current Kennel Notification or Notice of Training / Removal Form) *Please note should you wish to transfer a previous Victorian trained greyhound into your kennel you will need to do this via the Online Nomination portal.
- Link through to the Online Nominations website (for Trainers only)

70 Nominations for greyhound auction

Stewarding, Animal Welfare and Licensing

Reserve scratching policy

Stewards have recently become aware that some participants are unaware of the policy to assist greyhounds that gain a start when they are a reserve.

This allows greater opportunity to race rather than being bound by the 'consecutive day' Rule.

The reserve scratching policy (as of 1 February 2016) is as follows:

If a greyhound gains a start as a reserve and is engaged in another event with 48 hours, an application may be made by the trainer to withdraw the greyhound from that subsequent engagement free of any penalty. This shall not apply to any other circumstances.

Testing of reserve sample when prohibited substance is detected

GRSA advises a change to the testing process for the reserve or 'B' in the case of a sample recording a positive reading to a prohibited substance.

Previously, the Trainer was given the option to have an independent representative present during the further testing of the 'B' sample and control sample.

Effective immediately, when an irregularity is detected in the 'A' sample by the laboratory, the 'B' sample will be sent to a different laboratory for further testing. This allows for greater transparency and integrity with the testing process.

Products not correctly labelled

A reminder to all participants keeping greyhounds to ensure all medications and veterinary products must be labelled and prescribed in accordance with relevant State or Commonwealth legislation, particularly if they are prohibited substances.

Anything that is not may be seized during kennel inspections for testing and/or to be destroyed. If you are in doubt about a substance in your possession, please check with your veterinary surgeon.

R84 Possession of prohibited substance

(1) For the purpose of this Rule "possession" means any form of personal physical possession, or the on site control/storage, of a prohibited substance.

(2) A registered person who has in their possession at any place used in relation to the training or racing of a greyhound, any quantity of a prohibited substance commits an offence unless that substance has been registered or labelled, or prescribed, dispensed or obtained, in compliance with the relevant State or Commonwealth legislation. The Stewards may take possession of any of these substances or preparations to test and/or destroy.

(amended - 01.01.14)

For the purposes of this Rule, if a prohibited substance is found at any place used in relation to the training or racing of a greyhound then any owner, trainer or attendant who owns, trains, races or is in charge of greyhounds at that place is deemed to have the prohibited substance in their possession.

Trainers relocating to a new address or building additional kennels

The Animal Welfare team remind participants to advise them as early as possible if they are moving to a new kennel address or building additional kennels on an existing property.

Both of these changes must be approved by the Animal Welfare department to ensure they meet our standards. An inspection will be booked in as soon as practicable.

Passports

All participants are reminded prior to the exportation of a greyhound, contact must be made with Greyhounds Australasia to obtain a greyhound passport.

There are strict regulations around the exportation of greyhounds to approved countries only. Any person who exports a greyhound without obtaining a passport could be in a breach of the Rules.

Inquiry process

Recently, the Stewards have been queried about how the inquiry process is undertaken and if one Steward decides on charges and/or penalties.

A Stewards inquiry is a formal matter and Stewards can inquire into any matter concerning greyhound racing. If you are called to attend an inquiry, it is not negotiable. You will be required to give evidence. If you refuse to come, Stewards may inquire into the matter regardless.

Whilst the Rules of Racing state one Steward can officiate on any matter, the GRSA Stewards will generally sit as a panel of three Stewards to hear matters. The process in hearing any matter is the whole panel is given the opportunity to vote, the decision is not down to the 'Chair' of the panel.

Breath testing

In the June issue of Kennel Capers, Stewards reminded all handlers they have the power to conduct breath testing during race meetings.

Stewards intend to conduct random tests shortly so please ensure you are not affected by alcohol when handling greyhounds.

Arsenic

Further information in relation to arsenic follows in a GRSA release which is also available on the website.

The Golden Rules

Avoidance of Prohibited Substance Breaches In noting that we have seen recent Cobalt and Arsenic threshold breaches, it serves as a timely opportunity for GRSA to remind participants – in their own best interests – that there are a number of Golden Rules that can help them to avoid making any such breaches (for prohibited substances generally) and which should be adhered to as principles of best practice:

- Always consult your vet to seek guidance in relation to any of the products that you are using, any associated risks and other relevant context
- Review the range of any feeds or supplements that you typically purchase and, wherever it is reasonable to do so, replace products containing substances that could contribute to a threshold breach under the rules (eg. cobalt) with alternative products
- Observe the instructions on any products that you use and adhere strictly to those directions (having regard for prescribed amounts, frequency of administration/ application, methodology for administering/applying)
- Refrain from the use of injectable treatments (eg. Vitamin B12) to any extent that is practical
- Refrain from any treatment of a greyhound on raceday other than as relates to its feeding and drinking requirements (GAR83(a)(1) treats this as a specific offence)

Our registered participants have the ultimate responsibility to ensure that greyhounds are presented free of prohibited substances. This information is offered as advice in good faith only and should not be relied upon as a defence in the event of a breach being recorded.

These Golden Rules will appear in the Integrity section of future Kennel Capers editions on an ongoing basis as a reminder for participants of this responsibility.

Inquiries and notifications

Mr. Oswald Chegia – Racing Appeal Tribunal 16/08/17 – GAR 83(2) – Failed to present the greyhound SHEZ ROCKING free of any prohibited substance (ARSENIC) for an event at Angle Park on 11/01/17. Mr. Chegia pleaded guilty was suspended for a period of six (6) months with 3 months suspended for 24 months on the condition he does not reoffend under the same Rule and was fined \$4,000. Suspension commenced midnight 11/06/17 as a stay of proceedings was not granted. Mr. Chegia's fine was altered to \$2,000. In all other respects, the penalty imposed by Stewards was affirmed.

Mr. Anthony Milligan – Notice of positive sample – greyhound AMITY MARLOW was found to have THEOBROMINE in a urine sample following an event at Angle Park on 1 June 2017. Inquiry to be scheduled at a date to be fixed.

Warning to Trainers - Arsenic threshold

Warning to trainers - Avoiding potential breaches of the arsenic threshold

On 1 July 2016, Greyhounds Australasia introduced a urinary threshold for arsenic of 800ng/mL within GAR 83 (11) as follows:

"Arsenic at or below a mass concentration of 800 nanograms per millilitre in a sample of urine taken from a greyhound will not breach the provisions of sub rule (1A) or (2) of this rule."

GRSA wishes to reiterate previously published warnings surrounding the arsenic threshold and advise of husbandry practices trainers should avoid to minimise their risk of breaching the threshold.

CCA (Copper Chrome Arsenate) treated timber

CCA is used for wood preservation and it protects wood from dry rot, fungi, mould, termites and other pests that can threaten the integrity of wood products. Wood that is freshly treated with CCA has a greenish tinge that fades over time.

It has been claimed in equine codes that breaches of their arsenic threshold may have been due to ingestion of CCA treated timber. In a research study involving horses fed CCA timber sawdust, some of the horses marginally exceeded their threshold.

Similarly, it has been suggested in greyhound cases that the ingestion via chewing of CCA treated timber may be capable of resulting in breaches of the 800 ng/mL canine urinary threshold. While this has not been proven scientifically, a reduction in urinary arsenic concentrations following removal from the affected kennels does point to this possibility.

Participants should therefore be mindful that chewing or licking of kennels / yards constructed with CCA treated timber may result in breaches of the threshold.

Stewards advise this information will not constitute a defence to a charge in the case of a positive sample being returned over the threshold levels.

Seaweed/Kelp based nutritional supplements

Some seaweed based animal nutritional supplements have been tested by GRV and found to have high concentrations of arsenic. It was established that feeding these products could breach the threshold. Participants that choose to administer these products do so at their own risk and should avoid feeding close to racing.

Injectable supplements containing arsenic

Avoid the use close to racing of injectable supplements that contain arsenic including: NV Ferrocyl Injection (Sodium Cacodylate 6.4 mg/mL), NV Jurocyl (Sodium Arsanilate 50 mg/mL), TROY Invigorate As Injection (Sodium Arsanilate 50 mg/mL) and Jurox ARCYL Solution For Injection (Sodium Arsanilate 50 mg/mL).

It is ultimately the responsibility of participants to carefully consider the use of any and all food and additives to make sure that all greyhounds are presented for racing free of any prohibited substance.

Murray Bridge development underway

Construction at the new Murray Bridge facility commenced this week. This project is a key element of GRSA's strategic planning framework and will drive a number of significant benefits back to industry.

The development will include a 640m circumference '1-turn' track and a 350m straight track, both of which will ensure a strong focus on animal welfare priorities.

GRSA will continue to keep the industry updated as the project progresses.



Winning post and semaphore board installed

The maintenance team has done a fantastic job in managing the construction of the new winning post over the past month.

The project certainly had its challenges as the Adelaide weather turned nasty just as works were about to commence.

There were some queries about the track records that were previously displayed on the winning post, the team were wondering if anybody had noticed them being relocated to the top of the semaphore board?





Gawler track works and safety rail

GRSA has engaged a steel fabrication company to provide a safety/bump rail to approximately 240 metres of the Gawler track.

The new addition will extend from approximately the winning post to the back straight and have the capacity to be adapted as an irrigation system in the future.

Works to lower the track and the infield directly inside the rail have been put on hold, as recent weather has resulted in saturated conditions. As the weather improves into spring, the team will look to schedule these works in as conditions improve.



Chaser's audio system

During the Angle park shutdown, the opportunity was taken to upgrade the audio system around the venue.

The new system is more of an automated system, that gives GRSA greater flexibility in configuring the audio for different events at the venue.

Obviously some teething problems have been encountered at the first few meetings as we try to configure the system to the various race meetings. The team thanks participants for their patience during this period as we attempt to get it 100% right.

GAP assessment area

Participants will have noticed some fencing work in the betting shed at Angle Park. These works serve a number of purposes, however the primary aim was to find a permanent home for the GAP team to conduct greyhound assessments.

Hopefully they will be ready to go next week after some finishing touches, including some screening between the area and the vet clinic.

ANGLE PARK QUALIFYING TRIALS – NOW WEEKLY

Angle Park Qualifying Trials are run weekly on Tuesday night, for the corresponding Monday APM meeting and the Wednesday APD meeting. Trainers must be specific on their nominations about which day they are trialling for and what distance. (ie Wed 388m, Mon 515, Mon 600m etc)

Tuesday Angle Park Qualifying dates are:

September 19th (for APM Monday meeting on 25th September – not for APD Wednesday meeting on 27th September due to Time Grading)

September 26th (for APM Monday meeting on 2nd October – for APD Wednesday meeting on 4th October)

October 3rd (for APM Monday meeting on 9th October – for APD Wednesday meeting on 11th October)

October 10th (for APM Monday meeting on 16th October – for APD Wednesday meeting on 18th October)

October 17th (for APM Monday meeting on 23rd October – not for APD Wednesday meeting on 25th October due to Time Grading)

Nominations close with GRSA at 12.30pm on the Tuesday of the meeting.

NOMINATING ONLINE FOR QUALIFYING TRIALS

For Angle Park, Gawler and Strathalbyn qualifying trials the nominations must be lodged with GRSA by 12.30pm on the day of the meeting. To nominate online however you can only do this up until 11.59pm the day before. Due to a system security policy you cannot nominate on the day for these trials online. Please contact our staff if you have any issues with these nominations prior to them closing.

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will

only accept bookings using the new number.

POLICY FOR TRIALS IN PLACE

Remember trials will only be taken from -

- * 12.30pm Monday for Angle Park Tuesday nights
- * 12.30pm Tuesday for Gawler Wednesday nights
- * 12.30pm Thursday for Angle Park Saturday morning (day earlier due to being morning trials)
- * For Public Holidays it will be the working day before ie if Monday is a Public Holiday then bookings taken on the Friday

trial days that are not booked in with GRSA remain the same process (ie Gawler Thursday)

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK AND GAWLER BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

RACE MEETING TRIAL POLICY

Angle Park Monday & Wednesday along with Gawler Tuesday, Friday and Sunday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds will be conducted immediately following the completion of the kennelling procedure for the Race Meeting.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than 8 greyhounds nominated.

- 1. Reserves at the Meeting that do not obtain starts.
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located in an area affected by track closures.
- 3. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged.
- 4. Satisfactory trials.
- 5. Other greyhounds.

PROCEDURE/CRITERIA

- For Monday nights trainer to contact GRSA between 10.00am and 11.00am on the Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching line.
- 2. For Angle Park Wednesday, Gawler Tuesday & Friday trainer to contact GRSA between 4.00pm and 4.30pm on the day before.
- 3. For Gawler Sunday trainer to contact GRSA between 8.00am and 9.00am on the scratching line to nominate.
- 4. Other than reserve greyhounds Trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 5. Stewards allot the Box for the Greyhound.
- 6. Trials will be 515m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 7. Greyhounds currently under suspension or not cleared to race are not eligible to be nominated (these trials are conducted as if they are at a race meeting so all greyhounds need to be eligible at nomination time).
- 8. Greyhound registration certificate or cards must be

produced at kennelling time.

 Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilize the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave OR trainers with no other greyhounds will be free to leave following their trial.

If there are 12 races at Angle Park or Gawler there will be NO trials.

The Vet Clinic at these meetings cannot be used to accommodate any greyhounds to allow for extra trialling greyhounds. This policy has been introduced so that participants book in under the policy. The Vet Clinic needs to be available for the Vet and Stewards at race meetings

EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY-

- Thursday nights are kept available for the option for Interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead up to our Group races and also local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead up to a feature race upon request and they will take one of the eight kennels available for trialling ahead of the policy and sit separately to the 4 dog trials. Feature races are considered to be – Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals & any Group race Interstate.
- Local greyhounds will be allowed to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event and nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy.
- If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between this will be conducted as a solo trial and sit separately to the 2 four dog trials.

It is extremely important that trainers book in to trial at these race meetings. If unable to book in at these times then please contact GRSA where permission may be given to accept a booking outside of these times.

GAWLERQUALIFYING TRIALS AT GAWLER

Qualifying trials are held every Wednesday for the corresponding Tuesday.

MURRAY BRIDGE

Trials are held on SUNDAY MORNINGS, from 9am to 10.30 am. Bookings MUST be sent via Telephone to Kay Burns 0437 497 554 or Bob Harris 0410 668 682 or email to burnsron1@bigpond.com. If there are no bookings there will be no trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER

The Mt Gambier GRC committee advises that satisfactory trials can be run in the summer months under the criteria below.

- 1. On race days when there are less than 12 races.
- On race days with 12 races when the temperature is 30 degrees or less trial can be run before the first race but greyhounds must leave the track straight after the trial to head back to their home kennel.
- 3. On a Saturday trial session when stewards are available.

These trials will have to be booked in with GRSA in consultation with the Mt Gambier GRC.
