CEO'S UPDATE

The Importance Of Heritage

A number of initiatives are currently on the move behind the scenes in our efforts to preserve the history of the sport of greyhound racing in South Australia. Many of our longer-term participants have been interviewed by former South Australian trainer and breeder, Tony Welfare, across the past couple of years to capture personal perspectives about the sport as it was, and stories of the past. Those interviews will feed into a publication being authored by current industry Director, Ray Fewings, which GRSA aims to release in 2022. June Whyte has also been kind enough to help put together the history of coursing in the State. In conjunction with that process Ray will be reaching out to Clubs and industry participants as required to gain access to images of yesteryear and related material he may not already possess.

At the same time, we will progressively modernise honour boards at our venues, for and working closely with Clubs and Committees to reconcile those historical records as they relate to both people and greyhounds across the decades.

In noting that the works at Angle Park will 'freeze' the track records which were held at the time of closure, a statue has been commissioned in honour of what was singularly the most significant racing performance in the history of racing at headquarters, that being Brett Lee's record-breaking win in the final of the 2001 Adelaide Cup, running the 'impossible' time of 28.88. That win is popularly regarded as the pinnacle performance across the history of Group 1 racing in this country.

This Sunday, we will celebrate Gawler's 50th anniversary meeting, with Angle Park due to reach that same milestone in April 2022. It's important that we stop to reflect, at such times, on the significant foundation that has been put in place and the rich tapestry of our racing history, including those whose contributions gave the modern sport a start all those years ago.

The 'Truck' delivers Group 1 success

ALBION PARK

After narrowly missing out on Group 1 success on two previous occasions, Sir Truculent finally delivered the Group 1 victory that owner Wally Harkins and his fanbase had been eagerly waiting for in the Queensland Cup at Albion Park on Thursday, 8th July.

Under the watchful eye of highly successful Queensland trainer Tony Brett, Sir Truculent's odds got out to a mouth-watering \$10 for local punters despite being the fastest heat winner the week prior. Up against the highly fancied Maggie Moo Moo, Five Star and Micks Recall, the 'Truck' began strongly from box 5 to find himself sitting behind early leader Brockie Magic on the first bend and into home straight on the first occasion. As they turned the bend into the back straight, Sir Truculent swept around the outside of Brockie Magic and pushed clear of the congestion in the field behind him to gain a big advantage in the race. Out in the open, the 'Truck' put the foot down with a fantastic burst of speed and extended his lead out to 5 lengths from Maggie Moo Moo and Micks Recall who had pushed up into contention for the placings. However, Sir Truculent did not give them a look in as he powered away to a memorable win for all connections and SA racing fans. crossing the finish line in an impressive 41.58 seconds for the 710-metre trip.

Despite the longer odds for Sir Truculent, owner Wally Harkins was confident that his chaser was up for another big performance. "He has his own Facebook page and I posted up that we were in another big race and a good chance, and he never lets me down!" said Wally, "As soon as he jumped well, I felt we had one hand on the Cup after the first 100m. He just needs some room to move and if he gets it, then he just does what he does best. We love flying the flag for SA."

Harkins was full of praise for Tony Brett who has guided the 2020 SA TAB Greyhound of the Year during his





campaign's interstate. "Tony is a fantastic trainer, very knowledgeable, and I know he is in very capable hands."

Queensland has been a happy hunting ground for Sir Truculent in 2021 with the champ winning the Group Listed Gold Cup at Albion Park in February. He will now stay in Queensland with Tony Brett and contest the Ipswich Grand Prix over the 732m on Saturday 17th July as he looks to keep his strong top-end form.

"We are targeting the Ipswich race there and then we will back to SA for the National series. I have been watching Fantastic Radley at Murray Bridge and look forward to some great competition between them," said Wally on what is next for his star.

In another great note for South Australian greyhound racing, and breeding in particular, the win marked the first Group 1 victory for SA sire Worm Burner making the win extra memorable being an SA Bred winner by an SA sire. Worm Burner's career as a sire continues to impress and the performances of Sir Truculent will no doubt have more breeders pencilling his name in as a potential suitor.

After Thursday night's win Sir Truculent's already impressive record now stands at 92 starts for 40 wins and 31 placings for prizemoney of just over \$399,000. With runs like this, there may just be more Group wins in the tank for the 'Truck'.

Rushes claims memorable Shane McQueen Final

Since Rushes burst onto the SA racing scene with an eye-catching finish to claim second-place in a heat of last October's Adelaide Cup series it was only a matter of time before he produced a similar performance to win a feature final.

Starting from box 4 and considered an each-way hope in the Shane McQueen Final on July 24th at Murray Bridge, Rushes, trained by Lisa Rasmussen, put it all together in the final, defeating a top-field to claim a stirring win for connections. It was the 530m track holder Fantastic Shell who jumped the best from box 5 finding the early lead before Zipping Sultan for Ken Gill (box 1) pushed up to take over on the rail while Rhyme Nor Reason for Lauren Harris and Rushes were also tracking behind the leaders.

Heading into the bend and the field was very evenly bunched up behind leader Zipping Sultan while Max Voltage for Lauren Harris (box 2) found a nice sit on the rails however, Rushes was crowded and found himself at the back of the pack as the field turned for home. Into the home straight, Max Voltage began to edge past Zipping Sultan as Rhyme Nor Reason and Jack's Well for Cameron Butcher (box 8) pushed hard out wide trying to catch the two leaders. Meanwhile, Rushes was tracking just behind Max Voltage nearing the halfway point of the straight, pushed himself out from the rail and found a gap for a run between Max Voltage and Zipping Sultan. Nearing the post, Rushes sprouted wings and with a thrilling burst managed to pull ahead of Max Voltage and win in a time of 29.85 seconds just a neck ahead of Max Voltage with Zipping Sultan finishing a length behind in third place, in a great finish.

A consistent performer for trainer Lisa Rasmussen and the Gold Rush Syndicate, Rushes has made a number of feature race finals including the 2021 Murray Bridge Cup in March and the SA Anniversary Cup last month at Gawler, but this brilliant win in the Shane McQueen will definitely stand as the highlight of his career thus far. Rushes' career record now stands at an impressive 18 wins and 9 placings from his 49 career starts with prizemoney of \$54,985.

The series is always a highlight of the racing calendar each year and is named in the memory of former GRSA CEO, Shane McQueen who tragically passed away in May 2003. Shane worked with the Office of Gaming in Western Australia and then as the Operations Manager with Greyhounds







WA before moving his family across the border and joining Greyhound Racing SA as the CEO back in 1998. An outstanding administrator with a real passion for our sport in South Australia, his significant impact on our industry can still be easily

seen today. Many family members of Shane were on-course last night at Murray Bridge to enjoy the event and assist with presentations to connections which is always great to see.

Gawler Greyhound Racing Club celebrates 50 years

The Gawler Greyhound Racing Club is set to celebrate its 50-year anniversary this weekend, culminating in the running of the Anniversary Cup on Sunday on a bumper card which also features the final of the Gawler Produce Series.

It took years to get the Gawler track off the ground after the idea was first floated by half a dozen men from the SA Greyhound Racing Club in 1967 to hold race meetings at Gawler Oval.

Original funding was raised by the six founders of the club, with a \$25,000 loan from the TAB and surprisingly a \$10,000 loan from the NSW Greyhound Breeders, Trainers and Owners Association.

8000 patrons attended the first meeting, making it the largest crowd to ever attend a South Australian greyhound meeting at the time.

Since then, the SA Greyhound Racing Club became the Gawler Greyhound Racing Club, and has gone from holding one race meeting per fortnight to now holding two per week.

Opportunities to trial were limited and not welcomed by some councillors, and original facilities didn't allow for the range of catering, public comfort and function facilities now available.

The biggest change in recent years came with the construction of the Nixon Function Centre in February, 2015, which club secretary Bob May said has ushered in a new era of the Gawler Greyhound Racing Club.

"Not only was it a great for participants, but it enabled the club to attract the public and provide a facility for widespread community promotion and use," he said.

"The Gawler Greyhound Racing Club is now a hub for the major population of SA greyhounds and trainers, based in the Lewiston, Two Wells and Barossa areas, and as such has always attracted a strong following.

"Gawler has always been the number two ranked track in SA, originally being ranked as the only 'Provincial' track, and

it offers a 'close up' experience which is popular with the public.

"The Town of Gawler is also well known nationally for its racing participation and interest in all racing codes, and so has always been supported."

Throughout the years, the Gawler Greyhound Racing Club has been an active member of the local community, and can boast the first greyhound race ever broadcast on South Australian television with its special charity Telethon race meeting run with Channel Nine in December of 1971.

The club has since continued to work with local organisations, particularly the Gawler Show Society and Gawler Central Sports Club, as well as hosting many charity functions.

A pillar of the community, the Gawler branch of Rotary conduct their weekly meetings at the Gawler Greyhound Racing Club, while the club also regularly hosts clients of SCOSA for meals on race days, and offers special lunches for retirees on race days.

The track record times have remained untouched for nearly six years now, with Avid Tyson setting the 400m record in 2014, It's Classified matching Regional Image's 2003 531m record in 2015, and Bothing is approaching 15 years since setting its 643m record of 36.81 seconds in August of 2006.

An incredibly talented group of greyhounds will be trying to break those records on Sunday, so if you are interested in attending, book ahead with the club by calling 8522 2935.

Next Saturday morning meeting

The next meeting will be on Saturday, 24th July at Gawler which is a Timed Graded Meeting - "Worst to Best" rating. (Ratings 11-6 given preference for the meeting including the heats).

Greyhounds will be graded into 3 categories; Maidens, 1-4 wins and 5 or more wins. Specific grades of greyhounds are not considered except for Maidens. Races are non-penalty with Pathway prizemoney. Reserves will be determined by the Grader and there will be no guarding. Please refer to "Time Based Grading" published conditions.

\$890 Six Fastest Forward [1-4 wins] Heats – 400m [Max 4 Heats - \$1,430 Final Friday 30/7/21]. Selected from worst to best of this category. Final field will be a 6-dog field plus reserves, comprising of the greyhounds running the fastest times in the Heats, regardless of their finishing position in those Heats].

• Nominations close Tuesday, 20th July at 9.00am.

Murray Bridge to race on Saturday 7th August

Whilst we are in the final weeks of the Angle Park redevelopment being completed Saturday Morning, 7th August will have to be conducted at Murray Bridge Straight track as the Gawler Oval has football commitments on this day.

Saturday mornings are crucial to our sustained race program so it is important to have these meetings supported. Whilst it is an early start GRSA will program this meeting with increased prizemoney to support those trainers.

The meeting will be normal grading for Prov 2, however, will have Prov 1 prizemoney. There will be -

- \$1,525 Heats Mixed 345-300m (\$1,855 Final Wednesday 18/8/21)
- \$1,255 Heats Daish Irrigation & Fodder Maiden 300m (\$1,430 Final Wednesday 18/8/21. \$100 voucher provided by Daish to winning connections for final)
- Nominations close Wednesday, 4th August at 9.00am.

The following Saturday morning meeting will be the opening of the Angle Park track on Saturday, 21st August.

Racing dates released for July and August 2021

The racing dates for July and August have been released with the anticipated first race meeting back at Angle Park to be on Saturday, 21st August.

The remainder of the racing dates for season 2021/2022 will be

released in the coming weeks with some programming details still to be finalised. This is also dependent upon the first race meeting at Angle Park being on Saturday, 21st August. In a lead up to this, it is expected that there will be significant trialling at Angle Park.

Daish Irrigation & Fodder vouchers for Murray Bridge

The Murray Bridge GRC has been able to secure some \$100 vouchers from their sponsor Daish Irrigation & Fodder to be used on heat and final series' over the next 12 months.

In the All Tracks calendar these races will be highlighted which is a terrific initiative of the Murray Bridge GRC.

GOTBA racing dates for the remainder of the year

The Coursing at Virginia continues with 4 dog events programmed. Upcoming dates are – Sunday 18th July, Sunday 15th August, Sunday 29th August, Sunday 12th September, Sunday 26th September and Sunday 10th October.

2021 National Championships in Victoria – SA Sprint heats over 530m

The GCA National Championships are just around the corner. The National Finals this year will be held at the Meadows in Victoria and will be conducted on Saturday, 28th August.

Unfortunately the associated conferences and dinners with the Nationals week have been cancelled due to the travelling of dignitaries from across the country, however, the racing will continue.

Both the National Sprint and National Distance Finals will carry prizemoney of \$75,000 to the winner.

The State series' for SA will be held at Murray Bridge on Thursday, 5th August for the Sprint Heats over 530m with the State Final of the Sprint and a one-off Final over 680m of the Distance on the 12th August.

These events have to be run on the same night at the one venue to meet National requirements. In an effort to support these series' all States will be conducting their Finals on the same night to be run within a two hour period.

• Nominations this year will close at the normal time with GRSA which will be at 9am Monday, 2nd August

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 76 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the nomination closing date to be eligible to represent SA, which going back is on Wednesday, 19th May, 2021. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA grading staff.

Award tops off a big month for Rushes

Greyhound of the Month for June was Rushes for trainer Lisa Rasmussen. The son of Collision and Midnight Moments had a great month of racing winning three and running a second in his 4 starts with the highlight being the Shane McQueen Final over 530m at Murray Bridge.

He started the month off with a metro win at Gawler in a mixed 4/5 series over 531m before finishing an excellent second in the Final. He then headed back to Murray Bridge for the Shane McQueen series. He won his Heat in a brisk 29.87 coming off the speed showing that he would be a major player in the Final. In the Final he looked like he was in a hopeless position of the back straight when he was midfield and tightened for room in one of the strongest editions of the Shane McQueen before he found a passage through and exploded close to the line getting up in the final few strides running 29.85.

At the end of the month Rushes' record stood at 49 starts for 18 wins and 9 placings and earnings around \$55,000.



Fantastic Radley claims ROTM with fantastic win

The Run of the Month for June was Fantastic Radley's track record performance for trainer Ossie Chegia at Murray Bridge over 680m on Thursday, 10th June.

Whilst he was undefeated at Murray Bridge during the month winning 4 races it was his clash with staying star, Sir Truculent, and victory in record time that took the judges attention. He gave "The Truck" a start and a beating running 38.63 [.02 inside his own record] in winning by 1 length.

National Straight Track Championships in Queensland this year

The National Straight Track Championship this year will be held at Capalaba on Sunday, 15th August —with the winner receiving \$25,000.

This year SA will have two SA dogs represent the State in the series with QLD, NSW, VIC and SA challenging for the title.

Our local Heats are listed on Wednesday, 28th July with the Final on Wednesday, 4th August. This will allow 11 days until the National Final to organise travel and trialling arrangements. SA eligibility conditions refer to 76 days out of the last 150 days prior to our nominations closing for the Heats.

GRSA have been advised that Capalaba trial every Friday and Monday, with Monday the ideal day to trial in preparation for a Sunday meeting (National Final). Capalaba have also advised they can accommodate trials on Sunday and Wednesday race meetings. The Club has a Wednesday meeting on 11th August just prior to the NSTC. The Capalaba Club are more than happy to accommodate the needs of visiting trainers and already have had a number of trainers offer their place for Interstate visitors.

Champion Puppy moved to August and conducted at Gawler

The Champion Puppy series for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st July, 2019 will be conducted in August.

This series is normally conducted in July, however, with changes to feature events it has been moved to August with the Heats on Sunday, 1st August and the Final on Sunday, 8th August. GRSA has committed to running this series in this timeslot and with Angle Park not being ready at this time the series will be run at Gawler and will coincide with the City A meetings.

The Heats will be worth \$5,150 with the Final now worth \$14,275.

Prov 1 prizemoney for Mount Gambier

As from the 1st July, 2021 Provincial 1 prizemoney will be paid for the Mount Gambier Sunday meetings and will be the same breakdown as Gawler and Murray Bridge.

These meetings will be considered a Provincial 1 meeting for Grading and the grades that the greyhounds currently have for Provincial 2 will carry over to Provincial 1 at the greyhounds first start at Provincial 1. This was the same process when Gawler split into Provincial 1 and Provincial 2 meetings a number of years ago. Thursday meetings will remain Time Grading under the current format as it has proven to be quite successful over the years, however, the impact of these changes will be monitored by GRSA.

The club will also look to program (0-2 win) 600m races on Time Graded Thursday meetings and gage the response from trainers.

Border Challenge (Mt Gambier v Warnambool) Series reprogrammed in August

The new dates have now been finalised for the Border Challenge (Mt Gambier V Warrnambool) series between the two Clubs.

The Mt Gambier series will now be run on the 22nd August for the \$2,125 Heats with the Border Challenge Final at Mt Gambier on Sunday, 29th August worth \$5,800.

The Conditions for the series are:

Maximum of 2 Heats. If 1 Heat the first 4 through, if 2 Heats first two through to \$5,800 Final over 512m at Mt Gambier.

Trainer must have had starters at 15 Mount Gambier meetings in the past 12 months.

Trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 3 months.

Greyhound must have started at least four times in the past 12 months at Tara Raceway.

Nomination days to change for Mt Gambier Sunday and the metro Saturday morning meetings from August

After consultation with the Mt Gambier GRC, Member Clubs and Industry Consultative Group, GRSA has approved the change for the Mt Gambier Sunday meetings to now be graded on the Tuesday with nominations closing at 9am on that morning. This will assist the Club to provide the Sunday fields into the local paper which is important for persons in the South East to have this available.

As a result the Saturday morning metro meeting will now move to Wednesday, with nominations closing at 9am on that morning. This will give an even spread of no more than two meetings to be graded on any given day (except public holiday requirements). This will be effective from the 1st August.

Gawler Show in August

With the Gawler Show being programmed again this year in August there will be some Gawler meetings that will be transferred to Angle Park and Murray Bridge this year.

This year the Annual Gawler Show will be held on the weekend of Saturday, 28th and Sunday, 29th August. Racing on Friday, 27th August will be at Angle Park. Sunday, 29th August will be held at Murray Bridge on the One Turn while Wednesday, 1st September will be at Angle Park as the Show Society have advised that they needed more time to vacate the showgrounds.

Updates regarding trialling will be advised closer to these dates.

Gawler Classic 2021 in August

The first series for the SA bred greyhounds which are paid up for Classic 2021 will be the Gawler Classic over 400m (short course). It is a special event and no penalties apply.

Grading of Angle Park new distances

Effectively meaning they will be Maidens, Grade 6's or Grade 5's. GRSA is working with OzChase how to best manage this with this decision part of the Agenda for the upcoming Grading Review Panel meeting on Monday, 26th July.



Time grading rating available online

Time Ratings for greyhounds are now displayed online when trainers go to nominate a greyhound. It is displayed in the area the grades of the dogs are displayed.

This will allow trainers a clear understanding of their greyhounds rating prior to nominating for a Time Graded meeting.



Online scratchings now available

GRSA have now made scratchings out of drawn race meetings available for trainers through the OzChase system. This will provide flexibility for the trainers during their busy schedules. Trainers can still phone scratching's through as normal.

Once a scratching has been lodged, GRSA will consider this greyhound as requiring to be removed and will be published as soon as received on the next work day.

Any Late Scratching's cannot be made via online and will have to be phoned through to the stewards.

Please see right for the process of making a scratching via OzChase -

To request that a greyhound is scratched from a race, a trainer can select the 'Scratch Greyhound' action.

A greyhound can be selected from the dropdown on the screen. Once selected, the details related to this greyhound (ear brands, certificate number and microchips) will be displayed.

The meeting list presented to the trainer for selection will show those meetings where the selected greyhound has been allocated as a runner or reserve. If the greyhound has multiple starts at the meeting, then all races for this greyhound will be listed against the appropriate meeting entry.





The email notification sent to the Trainer and Grader will list the meeting and race details as shown in the example below:



WAP Update for participants - June 2021

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) wishes to advise participants that the Wagering Activity Payment (WAP) for the month of June 2021 amounted to \$425,000. Separately, the annual reconciliation (for the financial year ending 30 June 2021) has determined that a further amount of \$125,000 is payable. The end of year reconciliation payment is an adjustment to bring the total annual payment to exactly 50% of net wagering revenue.

Total WAP payments for year will amount to \$3,194,000 which is more than five times the initial total estimate of \$600,000 for the full year, reflecting the extent of unexpected growth during the year. As announced on 31 May, base stakemoney increased from 1 July 2021 and, in combination with the expectation of lower wagering revenue, this will foreseeably result in much more modest WAPs across this next financial year and, quite possibly, some months for which there is no WAP payable. Importantly, however, the minimum 50% benchmark payout ratio will continue to be adhered to throughout the year.

The table below is provided for the benefit of those participants wishing to better understand the computation of the WAP.

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney.

If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which
 is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to
 make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA
 will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

The sessions will also provide an opportunity for participants to ask questions.



COVID-19 UPDATE

At the time of writing this, NSW is, sadly, in the grip of a COVID-19 outbreak. In recent weeks, we have seen the SA borders close, at various times, to all States except Tasmania.

As you know, the borders can be restricted or closed within hours of an outbreak. Always remember when travelling to have a plan if you cannot return to SA as intended. Your plan might include alternatives for accommodation or transport. Also, when booking trips, take a good look at the cancellation policies for your bookings (e.g., airline and accommodation). There is no guarantee that if you need to cancel due to COVID-19, that you will receive a refund. Check the fine print and shop around to make sure what you are paying for is fair in the post-COVID-19 world.

Please remember that anytime you attend a GRSA facility, you need to check in at the QR-Code posters or manual contact tracing stations. Everyone must check in and that includes staff. The easiest way is to use the mySA GOV app on your phone. For help, please see the posters at venues and the GRSA webpage.

Finally, please consider having the COVID-19 vaccine. The way the vaccine and rollout is reported in the media may not give you confidence, but the vaccine is the best way for us to return to some semblance of normal.

Registration of your greyhounds with DCMB

Remember that greyhounds over 3 months of age need to be registered – like any other dog – with the Dog and Cat Management Board. You can do this online or via your local council. GRSA works in conjunction with the DCMB, through it's systems, to monitor compliance with the law.

Remember, if you retire your greyhound [rehomed or not], you (or the person taking possession of the greyhound) must – unless a registered breeder or exempt – have the ground desexed. Where GRSA identifies non-registered people with greyhounds that are not desexed (unless exempt) we will pass that information onto the Dog and Cat Management Board.

Remember also that, in addition to the above, you need to notify GRSA of all retirements.

The ICG

The Industry Consultative Group was established under the Constitution of GRSA to, amongst other things, serve as a channel for communication between industry stakeholders and GRSA.

I attend the ICG meetings, as do other department managers, to assist and provide information to members about GRSA operations. The channel operates both ways, so I urge you to make contact with your ICG members if you have ideas, information or concerns. The advantage of the ICG process is you do not have to guess who you need to speak to at GRSA.

Conduct on social media

We continue to monitor and respond to complaints about comments on social media.

Always remember, that while your comment may, on the surface, read alright, you must consider that some reader might be offended. Always think before you post. Here is a suggestion from an initiative of many police forces - the S.E.L.F Test. I changed the wording to suit our industry –

S.E.L.F TEST

SCRUTINY – Would your conduct withstand scrutiny by the community and industry?

ETHICAL – Is you conduct ethical and consistent with the vision of industry?

LAWFUL – Does your conduct comply with laws, rules and policies?

FAIR – Is your conduct fair to others?

KNOW. TELL. PROTECT.

You will see in some editions of Kennel Capers the advertisement for the Know Tell Protect initiative.

If you know something, or of someone who is involved in illegal practices, tell us in absolute confidence so that we can investigate and, if necessary, prosecute; help us protect the future of our great industry.

GAP kennelling fee payment process change

Please note that as of 1st August 2021 the GAP kennelling payment process will change for a trial period of three months.

The changes are as follows:

Instead of making a weekly payment of \$33 per dog, the new kennelling fee will be a flat amount of \$50 per dog, irrespective of the time period the greyhound will spend at the GAP kennels.

Participants who would like their greyhounds placed in the GAP kennels will be requested to pay the \$50 at the time when the placement form is filled in and the \$60 placement fee is paid.

This means that for greyhounds that are to be kennelled with GAP an upfront payment of \$110 will be requested. After that, participants will not need to make any additional payments for their dogs in the GAP kennels. Noting that prior to foster care dogs spend an average of 4 weeks in kennels, this change is expected to generate a saving of \$82 per dog for participants.


If you have not submitted the placement form within six months after the assessment, your greyhound will have to be re-assessed by GAP.

If your greyhound returned to racing or trialled after a successful assessment, it will have to be re-assessed after a 10-day downtime again. Thank you!




As previously advised, GAP have been increasing the number of assessments in the monthly schedule.



When asked why he decided to adopt Wayne stated, "what attracted us to adopting a greyhound from GAP was knowing we would get a dog that's been very well looked after, trained and fully vet checked."

"The family loves coming to the track to see the dogs, even the young fella who is 12 can't wait to get his catcher's licence."

Satisfactory and Qualifying trials at Murray Bridge for both tracks are now on Friday mornings once a week – effective immediately. Nominations close 12.30pm Thursday (for online nominations 11.59pm Tuesday) Qualifying for the following Friday.

Trainers are advised that Satisfactory Trials on these days **ONLY** will be approved.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

- 1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
- 2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
- 3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

- For Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
- 2. For Tuesday, Wednesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these days fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
- 3. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
- 4. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
- 5. Trials will be 455m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
- 6. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
- 7. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
- 8. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
- In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Sunday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races there will be NO trials.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Trainers are advised of a change to the booking of Satisfactory Trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Tuesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Tuesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shepheard from the Club on 0419 824 512.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shepheard.


