It's been a cracking month for our Greyhounds as Pets team who have been out at Mount Gambier for our first ever regional foster and adoption day. Our 25th birthday adoption day was also a roaring success, with 24 dogs adopted in one day alone – which led to a record month of 64 adoptions, our most to date!

On the track, wagering activity continues to provide the industry with ups and downs. Victa Damian remains undefeated taking out the Leigh Rogers feature

■ ANGLE PARK

Boom youngster Victa Damian trained by Lisa Rasmussen remained undefeated, making it 4 wins in 4 starts, when he took out the Leigh Rogers Grade 6 Feature Final at Angle Park on Thursday 3rd November.

The son of Fernando Bale and Victa Polly started a short priced favourite from his wide draw and began well as the boxes flew open. He raced up to challenge the early leaders Spring Honour for Greg Board and Emerley Spicy for Graeme Stirling as they left the front straight on the first occasion. Down the back straight and Spring Honour pinched a handy break from Victa Damian who slotted into second ahead of Emerley Spicy while the remainder of the field jostled for position. Turning for home and both Spring Honour and Victa Damian settled down to fight out the finish with Victa Damian looming large. As they raced down to the finish line Victa Damian's class prevailed going on to win by ½ length from Spring Honour who was brave in defeat. Emerley Spicy held on for third just ahead of kennel mate Shan's Jinx and Basil Brush Rose for Renata Maruszczczyk. He ran the handy time of 30.81 in winning and showed what a bright future he has on the race track. The recent honour roll of the Leigh Rogers highlights potentially where Victa Damian could go with last years winner Don't Tell Lies winning the Group 3 SA Oaks, the year prior Fly For Trix won which also won the Group 3 Brian Johnstone, super star bitch Coorong Lucy won in 2019 and was a multiple Group winner and SA Greyhound of the Year winner while Tauwither won in 2018 and also took out the Group 2 Launching Pad at Sandown.

This feature event was introduced to the SA racing calendar five years ago in recognition of the former Greyhound Racing SA employee, Leigh Rogers, who sadly passed away in December 2016 after a short fight with a very rare and extremely aggressive cancer. Leigh joined Greyhound Racing SA as the Food & Beverage Manager back in 2000 and left the organization in 2012. Amongst many of his achievements, he played an instrumental role in the re-development of the McQueens Tavern and cemented Chasers Restaurant as a sought after venue for Christmas Parties, Weddings and other functions. Leigh's most notable quality however was his affection and loyalty to the staff that he worked alongside, which will be remembered for years to come.

Leigh's wife Rachel was oncourse, along with his daughters Emily, Chloe and Madison, unfortunately stepson Jayden could not make it, however, they were joined by family members who travelled as far away as Mt Gambier, along with many friends and work colleagues. In a touching gesture the Rasmussen and Schadow's donated the trophy to Leigh's kids which they were extremely appreciative of and already looking forward to next years race.



Victa Reid wins Cup with fast finish

A terrific night at Gawler was had by a handy crowd, who braved the weather conditions to watch some great racing.

The star of the night was Victa Reid who took out the 2022 Gawler Gold Cup, making it back-to-back victories for the Fernando Bale x Victa Victoria litter, with his brother Victa Grosso winning the 2021 edition. It was a cracking field with the Victorian Kelsey Bale all the rage in the market, starting odds on favourite in the Group 3 event. When the boxes opened, it was Charlee's Misty that headed the field, leading clearly to the first mark. Came And Went quickly got up inside of her but had to work hard to try and force a clear run. Turning up the back straight it was still Charlee's Misty leading with Came And Went and Impress Us behind. The tension built turning for home, with the lead pair coming back and the swoopers arriving fast. It was an open race still with 30 metres to go, but Victa Reid was the one coming home the hardest and he was able to hit the front in the shadows of the post, claiming a brilliant win in 30.90. Came And Went and Charlee's Misty rounded out the placings, but all credit went to the winner who showed his smarts and strength to take home the Cup. The win, which was surprising to many punters given he blew in the market, took Victa Reid's career earnings to \$98,865 and was his 23rd win. It has been a freakish litter, which has now won 173 races from 780 starts and amassed almost \$600,000 in prize money. At just three and a half years old, it would appear that there is still plenty of racing left for Victa Reid and his fellow littermates.

Other feature finals were also run on the night with Nathan Goodenough landing his first big win as a trainer, taking out the Sprint Classic for 2022 with his gun chaser Taylor Toves. An even field was assembled and it was reflected in the market, with no clear favourite in the race. From box eight, Taylor Toves had it all to do, with some quick chasers drawn nicely down low. It was a hot go to the first turn when the boxes opened, with Sutton Sandy the first to put the head in front. A clip from behind ended her chances with Taylor Toves quickly sweeping around and pouncing on the lead. Once he found the front, he quickly found himself two lengths ahead with the race seemingly over. Patched was gallant behind but Taylor Toves was too good, winning in 22.90 and making it a memorable night for Nathan!

The Gold Cup Consolation was next with Top Quality making amends for a luckless Cup Heat run last week, absolutely blitzing the field in the other feature of the night. It was quite a handy field that was assembled, with Top Quality starting favourite ahead of Springvale Max who drew perfectly in box one. Top Quality flew out of box two and led by a length as they went past the finishing post for the first time, before a bit of bumping in behind meant that he had a handy margin leaving the first turn. Down the back straight the race was done, with Top Quality a huge leader, and the margin only extending the further they ran. In the end, Top Quality demolished them by 9 lengths in 30.63, a time which would have had him winning the Cup by some margin!

Other notable performers of the night were Mr. Ibrox and Spring Agatha, who both took out their respective Heats of the Bothing Stayers race. Hill Top Jack took out a hot grade 4/5 race, with a professional run that saw him lead the entire trip ahead of Springvale Roxy and Strategise.

Well done to all involved on a terrific night and to the Rasmussen and Schadow teams on taking out their second successive Gawler Gold Cup!

MURRAY BRIDGE SUMMER DERBY AND OAKS IN DECEMBER

With the support of the Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club, Murray Bridge will conduct the Summer Oaks and Derby again this year. Eligibility will be for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st July, 2020. Heats will be run on Sunday, 4th December with the Finals on Sunday, 11th December.

The conditions are set out below -

\$1,645 Heats 2022 AGRC/Murray Bridge Country Summer Derby – 455m [For dogs whelped on or after 1st July, 2020. \$5,000 Final on Sunday 11/12/22 sponsored by the AGRC. All grades eligible]

\$1,645 Heats 2022 AGRC/Murray Bridge Country Summer Oaks – 455m [For bitches whelped on or after 1st July, 2020. \$5,000 Final on Sunday 11/12/22 sponsored by the AGRC. All grades eligible]

Nominations for the Heats close at 9am with GRSA on Wednesday, 30th November.

MURRAY BRIDGE ANNIVERSARY CUP ON SUNDAY 11TH DECEMBER

On Sunday, 11th December the \$4,000 Murray Bridge Anniversary Cup will be run over the 530m.

Nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am on Wednesday, 7th December.

GOTBA FREE FOR ALL ON THURSDAY 8TH DECEMBER

GOTBA will have the wrap up of the year at Angle Park on Thursday, 8th December.

As normal there will be a Free For All programmed worth \$5,150 over the 530m for those greyhounds which coursed during the 2022 season. To be graded on circle form.

• Nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday, 5th December.

FESTIVAL OF FIRE TO HEAT UP ANGLE PARK IN DECEMBER

GRSA will continue to support local participants in December when the Festival of Fire series of races are conducted. GRSA is thrilled to conduct for the second year, the Festival of Fire series, the newest and most exciting fortnight on the South Australian greyhound racing calendar.

The Festival Of Fire, series will provide opportunities for the best 48 nominations over the 530m trip, the best 16 nominations over 595m and the best 8 nominations for a 730m event. There will be Heats and a Final of a restricted event (0-5 wins), running from Saturday morning to Thursday night which will provide a separate opportunity for that category of runner. There will be a change in that the second 595m event will be removed and the main 595m event has been increased from the best 12 greyhounds to best 16 greyhounds. Taking the place of the second 595m event will be a 530m Time Graded event for the lowest ranked 32 greyhounds.

The Festival of Fire is an end of year celebration for the local industry, which provides fantastic opportunities across the entire

spectrum of racing classes, across all three distances at Angle Park, the home of SA greyhound racing.

The Festival of Fire series will commence on the racenight of Thursday, December 15, continue into the Saturday morning timeslot [December 17] and then culminate in 5 Finals and a special stayers event with all Finals carrying a collective purse in excess of \$100,000 the following Thursday night [December 22]. The Board has resolved that the top-up amounts for this series will sit outside the Wagering Activity Payments (WAP) model. This means that the majority of the stakemoney for the series will be additional to the guaranteed return that has already been committed to industry through the WAP model.

Conditions –

- Greyhounds must be SA trained.
- Greyhounds must be in South Australia as of midnight 1st November 2022 to be eligible [unraced greyhounds that have not had their first training amendment lodged that are in SA at this time will be eligible]. For those greyhounds that have left the State prior to this date, however, are considered SA based on the Nationals criteria of 76 days out of 150 days prior to close of nominations for each event will be eligible.
- All races will be Non Penalty

THE ASHES [530M] – Best 16 nominated – Selected by the GRSA Grader – no Reserves – Maidens ineligible – maximum of two Heats – guarding applies For Heats

Heats Thursday, 15th December [Open City A Prizemoney] – Final Thursday, 22nd December [1st \$20,000, 2nd \$5,800, 3rd \$2,900]

THE INFERNO [530M] – For those Greyhounds not selected for The Ashes and not selected for The Flame. Best 32 nominated on Time Rating with reserves – Maidens are ineligible – maximum of four Heats – selection of Heats will be guarded and separated under normal Heat and Final rules. If the same Time Rating, most race wins go in and then most prizemoney go in and then by Graders discretion].

Heats Thursday, 15th December [Grade 5 City A Prizemoney] – Final Thursday, 22nd December [1st \$12,500, 2nd \$3,650, 3rd \$1,825]

THE FLAME [530M] – Lowest ranked 32 nominated on Time Rating – no reserves – Maidens are ineligible – maximum of four Heats – Guarding applies. Selection of Heats will be guarded and separated under normal Heat and Final rules. If same Time Rating, greyhounds with the least race wins go in then the least amount of prizemoney go in and then by Graders discretion. Greyhounds must have had at least one race start over 455m or further in the last 3 months prior to close of nominations to be eligible.

Heats Thursday, 15th December [Grade 6 City A Prizemoney] – Final Thursday, 22nd December [1st \$10,000, 2nd \$2,900, 3rd \$1,450]

THE BONFIRE [595M] – Best 16 nominated – Selected by the GRSA Grader – with Reserves – Maidens ineligible – maximum of two Heats – guarding applies for Heats

Heats Thursday, 15th December [Open City A Prizemoney] – Final Thursday, 22nd December [1st \$15,000, 2nd \$4,400, 3rd \$2,200]

Remaining events determined by nominations received for other events.

*If all Heats are taken then GRSA will allow any 730m greyhound nominated for this night to solo trial in preparation for The Blaze on Thursday, 22nd December.

• Nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday, 12th December.

ANGLE PARK AND TOWNSVILLE TO SWAP IN DECEMBER

Greyhound Racing SA have liaised with Racing Queensland in regard to swapping a Saturday morning meeting in December. The Angle Park meeting set down for Saturday, 10th December will now be run on Saturday, 17th December with the Townsville meeting swapping from the 17th to the 10th December. This will allow GRSA the opportunity to align and showcase some feature races during the Christmas period.

The trials will remain at Angle Park on Sunday, 11th December due to rostering availability even though we will not race on the Saturday morning.

SATURDAY TO THURSDAY NIGHT FINALS AT ANGLE PARK

Once a fortnight GRSA run Heats on the Saturday morning meeting at Angle Park, where there will be either [1-4 wins or 5+ wins] over the 530m and will be Non Penalty events, run as 8 dog fields. The Final will be conducted as Race 1 on the Thursday night.

Trainers should be mindful that if you have a greyhound in a Heat and it qualifies for the Final that the greyhound will be ineligible to compete in the Final if it is engaged to race the day prior [Wednesday].

The next lot of Heats will be on Saturday, 12th November for 1-4 wins with the 8 dog Final on Thursday, 17th November.

This will be followed by Heats on Saturday, 26th November for 5+ wins with the 8 dog Final on Thursday, 1st December.

GOTY AWARDS NIGHT ON SATURDAY 25TH FEBRUARY CONFIRMED WITH SOME RACING DATE CHANGES

Please be advised that Greyhound Racing SA have swapped dates with Gawler and Angle Park for Saturday, 4th February 2023. This was initially programmed to accommodate the Greyhound of the Year awards night to be held at Angle Park, however, this date has now been shifted to Saturday, 25th February. This being the case we will now race at Angle Park as normal rather than at Gawler.

2023 GAWLER PRODUCE STAKES – NOMINATIONS CLOSE FRIDAY 25TH NOVEMBER

The 2022 Gawler Produce Stakes will be run by GRSA in conjunction with the Gawler Greyhound Racing Club.

Once again we will offer guaranteed Final stakemoney of \$22,000. The estimate for the total series prizemoney is \$40,000, based on this years series. The series is for greyhounds whelped in 2021.

In 2023 we will again be offering additional incentives for trainers to nominate. A bonus will be offered to any greyhound which can win both the Produce Stake and the Gawler Gold Cup.

The jackpot has increased from \$10,000 to \$11,000 as Springvale Max missed out on winning the Gawler Gold Cup this year after running fourth in his Heat and not qualifying for the Final.

The SA Bred bonus will also be continued; should the winner of the Final be SA Bred, there will be an SA Bred bonus of \$1,000 to the owner and \$500 to the breeder.

The series will be in June with the Final on Sunday, 25th June 2023. [Pending alterations]

GRSA administers the event for the Club, so all payments are to be made to GRSA. The fees are, one-off payment option \$121.00 or the sustaining option of \$33 (first), \$55 (second) and \$88 (Final).

Nomination Forms are available, along with the full list of conditions and the payment schedule.

*** Nominations for the 2023 Gawler Produce will close on Friday, 25th November with GRSA.**

GREYHOUND OF THE MONTH - OCTOBER

Greyhound of the Month for October was Buzz Junkie for trainer Petar Jovanovic who only had one start for the month for one win, but what a win it was, claiming the 2022 Group 1 Adelaide Cup on Friday 7th October.

SA owned and trained at the time Buzz Junkie started at close to 100/1 for the years most prestigious race. After a good beginning and some trouble on the first turn the son of Ritza Lenny and Zipping Spring found himself out by 3 lengths down the back straight with connections daring to dream. As they turned for home there was no catching Buzz Junkie as he went on to win by 2½ lengths in a brisk 30.72 giving SA a rare victory in our premier sprinting event.

At the end of the month Buzz Junkie's record stood at 25 starts for 13 wins and 2 placings and earnings just under \$145,000.



RUN OF THE MONTH – OCTOBER

The Run of the Month for October was the Elizabeth Chegia trained staying star, Fantastic Radley which finally claimed the Angle Park 730m track record.

He stepped out in an open race on Thursday, 7th October and once he landed in front early all the attention turned to the time as he had been getting close to the record coming from behind but being in front would be a different story. He raced away from his rivals to win by almost 8 lengths in a time of 42.47, bettering the previous mark by 1½ lengths.

REVIEW OF TRIALS

I am conducting a review of trial procedures, with a view to providing options that are most beneficial to trainers, but not compromising safety. While the focus is Angle Park, the procedures will [amended as needed] apply to all tracks. If you would like to make a submission for the report, please email me.

Topics include –

- Access to the track from the starting boxes
- Access to the track from other areas [other than starting boxes]
- Hand slipping

You may like to comment on how the current operation of trials affects you. I would appreciate any responses by 21st November 2022.

NEW LOCAL RULE – RACING FREQUENCY

Following endorsement from the Board, the following, new, local rule has been added:

69A Racing and trialling frequency

[1] In this rule:

Race has the same meaning given to this term in R9 of the GAR.

Trial means a satisfactory trial, or a qualifying trial as defined in R9 of the GAR.

[2] A greyhound will only be permitted to start in –

- No more than a combined total of 2 race and trial starts in any 7-day period: and,
- No more than a combined total of 7 race and trial starts in any 28-day period.

[3] This sub-rule commences on a date to be fixed by Stewards' Notice.

Note this rule will commence on a date to be fixed by Stewards' Notice. This is to allow GRSA to modify some systems to provide for easier monitoring of nominations to allow for the rule.

EDUCATION SERIES

On 26th October 2022, GRSA hosted the second seminar in its education series, a presentation by Boyd Hooper on breeding and rearing. Thank you to all who attended to make the evening enjoyable. If you have any topics, you would like us to try to arrange seminars for, please let animal welfare know.

VET FEES

Owning and keeping a greyhound fit and healthy can be expensive and this includes veterinary expenses. Veterinary care is vital to a greyhound's health and proper veterinary care is mandated under the rules. Please remember that your

veterinarian runs a clinic that has, as you do, many expenses. Veterinary training, clinic and staff costs are high, and your veterinarian must, like all businesses, maintain cash flow to keep the clinic operating effectively. You can do your part by paying your veterinary bill on time. Remember, for some veterinary care like track injury or sterilisation, GRSA contributes to this expense. Make sure you speak to your veterinarian about your options and contact Animal Welfare for enquiries about the Track Injury Recovery Scheme or the Sterilisation Contribution Scheme. Accruing unreasonable amounts of debt could result in your registration being reviewed under the fit and proper person test in our local rules.

UNPAID FINES

Remember to check and arrange payment of any unpaid fines to GRSA. Rule 175 of the GAR requires you to pay fines within 14 days. Failure to pay fines can result in you being declared a defaulter – a penalty with the same result as if you were disqualified.

AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. HOW SOON? 3-DAYS SOON.

You will see in the new [post 1 May 2022] GAR the phrase “as soon as possible” used for setting some timelines to do certain things [e.g., notify a greyhound movement]. But what does “as soon as possible mean”? Generally, the phrase means soon or in a short amount of time. To assist being more precise, GRSA considers “as soon as possible” to be “as soon as possible but no more than three [3] days”. This is consistent with some times specified in the old GAR. Note, however, that where a rule in the GAR or Local Rules or associated policies specifies a time [e.g., 24 hours or 10 days], then that time is the one that is used for that rule or policy.

Kruger Lass Takes Out Bothing Stayers Cup

It was a top night of racing, with the headline act the Bothing Stayers Cup which was taken out by a rising star in the form of Kruger Lass, who was brilliant in victory.

A couple of big scratchings made it a more even race, with Spring Agatha starting favourite from her preferred box eight. When the boxes opened it was Springvale Rex that burnt to the front and set up a two-length lead. With the margin closing up the back straight, Spring Agatha took over in front and looked as if she would run away with it. Springvale Rex then took over again with the wall behind closing in. With a tangle in front, Kruger Lass charged around and levelled up to Springvale Rex, before going past to land a memorable victory in 37.83. Springvale Rex and Howling Hoss finished in behind, but all honours went the way of Kruger Lass. The now two and half year-old bitch has shown that she has the speed to perform with anything over 500m, but also the strength to run out a 700m which is incredibly exciting for her trainer Bronwyn Walsh. The win would have also made the long drive back to Mildura a little bit nicer for Bronwyn!

A real rising star in the form of Victa Marli showed that she is maturing and getting better with a strong but fast victory on the night. After drawing box eight in a quality juvenile race, she was led early by Agent Four who had just come out of the South Australian Oaks series. Up the back straight, Victa Marli displayed her brilliant speed, going straight past Agent Four and taking a two-length lead to the turn. Arguably the most impressive part of her run was the last section, as she continued to run away from the field and win easily by a couple of lengths in a flying 22.47. She has always shown lightning speed and on occasions struggled to run out her races, but clearly the penny has dropped with some maturity. Her future looks rather bright!

On a night of fast times, there were none faster than Toby West, who equalled the track record, which has been held by Avid Tyson for 8 years. Trained by Adam Manton, Toby West has been in brilliant form, which included running a slick time at Angle Park. He wasn't favourite for the event, with Taylor Toves taking those honours, but after 10 metres, there was no doubt who punters would've wanted to be on. From box six, he jumped and found himself a close second early, before rushing to the front and striding out well. From there, he put a space on the field, winning by 6 lengths in a lightning 22.27. That was his 22nd career win and he has shown an amazing ability to adapt to any distance, which is not



always easy to do as you get older. Well done to Adam and his team, and good luck to anyone coming up against Toby

West in the next few weeks!

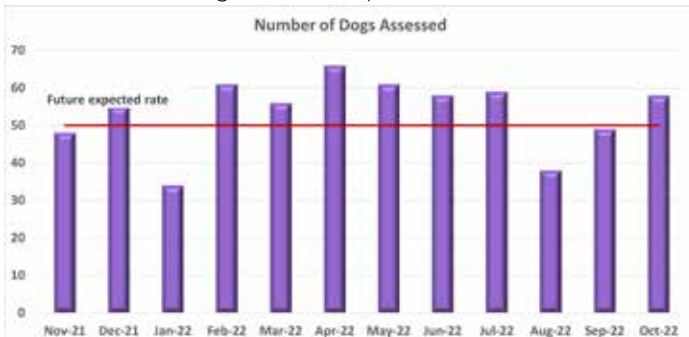

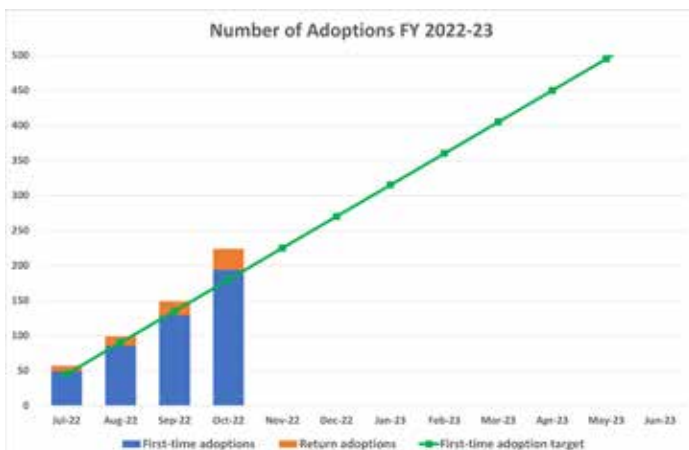
Latest updates from GAP

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

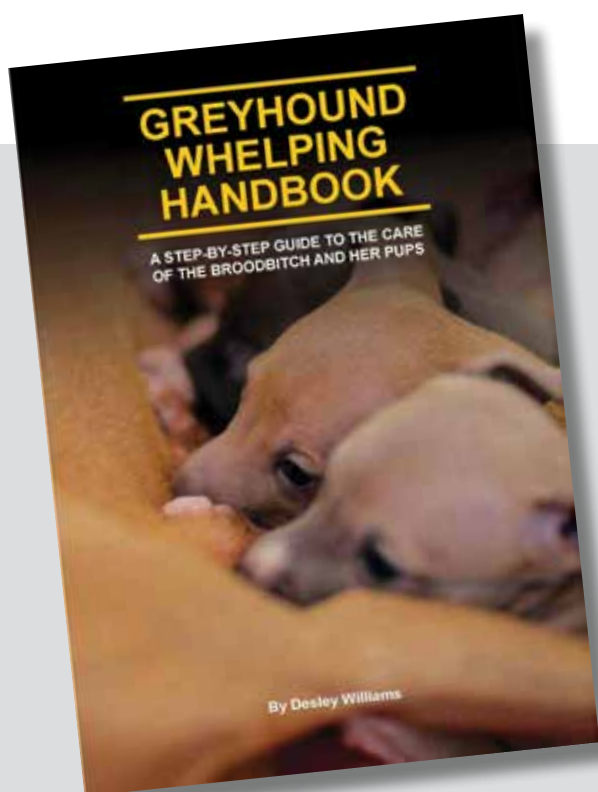
