It's fair to say that the last few weeks have tested the strength of our community and industry.

GRSA's investigation into allegations of live baiting by a South Australian participant continues, as does the RSPCA's. So, while I won't be providing an update, I would like to be clear on our approach to this unprecedented incident.

GRSA takes a zero-tolerance approach to any participant found to be in breach of the standards we set for everyone in our industry.

We have a proven commitment to animal welfare, and our focus on integrity, transparency, accountability and leadership underpins everything we do.

The person who alerted us to potential live baiting in our state clearly shares these values. As soon as we were made aware of the allegations, we informed the RSPCA and worked closely with them to collect evidence. We suspended the participant's training license and registration with immediate effect.

We acted quickly, proactively and decisively. And then, we shared what had happened with our stakeholders, our community and the media – because transparency matters.

If confirmed, this would be the first case of live baiting ever recorded in South Australia.

I know all of you join me in absolutely condemning anyone who undertakes this abhorrent practice. It goes against everything Greyhound Racing SA stands for as an organisation, a sport and a community.

On that note, I would like to thank the GRSA team for their dedication and hard work throughout this process, and our community for your unwavering support. I look forward to sharing updates as they come to hand.

North vs South Challenge produces 2 great finals

■ MURRAY BRIDGE

The final round of the inaugural North v South challenge took place at Murray Bridge on Sunday August 28, with the two very strong Finals taken by a pair of deserving victors.

The 395m 'short course' Final went the way of the 'South' team with Victa Kurt using box one perfectly to take out the race with a cracking 22.25 gallop. After winning the Gawler Heat the Sunday prior, he went into the race a firm second favourite behind Classy Chaos, who went much quicker when she took out her Gawler Heat. When the boxes opened, there was plenty of pace from those drawn wide, but despite this, Classy Chaos was able to muster quickly to find the front, but then lost the turn which provided a fantastic opportunity for the tight railing Victa Kurt, and that opportunity was quickly taken as he powered through on the rail, defeating Classy Chaos by a length and half. That took Victa Kurt's career record to 17 wins from 64 starts, which isn't bad for a 'fourth stringer' from the Fernando Bale x Victa Victoria litter!

The traditional 530m 'sprint' Final proved to be a cracker, as we hoped it would with the strong lineup assembled. Spring Agatha went into the race off the back of an electric Gawler Heat win, whilst Spring Phoebe was a close second favourite after drawing terrifically in box one. When the lids opened, it was Spring Phoebe that jumped the best and quickly gained a three length lead on the field. Her first challenger was Toby West, as he mustered beautifully to land in second whilst Spring Agatha started her run down the outside. Hitting the turn, Toby West was able to get underneath Spring Phoebe, before winning in a quick 29.93, holding off a fast finishing Spring Agatha. The win continued the amazing form that Toby West is currently in and it was quite pleasing for trainer Adam Manton.

"It was a very good run. Just before they hit the bend I thought he had the race, because I knew he was a bit stronger than the one dog [Spring Phoebe], but then when he bumped with her halfway around the bend I thought we were in a bit of trouble. I knew the eight dog was coming [Spring Agatha], she was right there as well. He [Toby West] ran a little bit wide, and I was a bit worried coming down the home straight, that's for sure!" said Adam.

With the Adelaide Cup looming, the option is there for Toby West to have a crack at the Group 1 series, but Adam will take his time and see how well he is racing when the heats roll around.

■ ANGLE PARK

Sister Roberta for trainer Ben Rawlings proved too strong in the 2022 Kings And Queen's Final at headquarters on September 1.

The daughter of Barcia Bale and Phantom Mime was sent out a clear second favourite just behind the David Peckham trained Captain Larry in box 1. Sister Roberta showed her blistering early speed from box 3 to assume control with a sizzling first split of 5.16. She led by three lengths early with Captain Larry pushing up along the inside.

Into the back straight and Sister Roberta was high rolling out in the lead, still with a nice break from Captain Larry in second, followed by Foreshadow for Kirin Corby. Kruger Lass began to make ground, however, On The Tequila found trouble and lost all winning chance being checked back towards last. Off the back straight and Sister Roberta was still out by three lengths from Captain Larry who was trying to bridge the gap without much success. Turning for home and Sister Roberta was going strongly in the lead with the race all parcelled up and was an impressive 2.25 length winner from Kruger Lass which rattled home along the inside to claim second from Captain Larry. Owned by the Toot Toot Syndicate, Sister Roberta ran a slick 30.58 for the 530m journey showing her class against strong opposition.

Fantastic Radley's dominant month rewarded

Greyhound of the Month for August was Fantastic Radley for trainer Elizabeth Chegia after he won his way through to the Group 1 National Final at Wentworth Park in a dominant display at headquarters in the State Series.

The son of Fernando Bale and Fantastic Dotty had three starts in the month for two wins, kicking off with a brilliant 42.64 win over the staying trip at Angle Park where he won by 8.25 lengths. He then was sent out a very short priced favourite in the State Series of the National Distance Championships where he had to work hard for the win but came away for a strong victory in a sizzling 42.63 in winning by .75 lengths. This qualified him for the Group 1 at Wentworth Park where he was far from disgraced in a hot field running a credible 5th after being wide most of the way.

At the end of the month Fantastic Radley's record stood at 50 starts for 28 wins and 14 placings and earnings around \$125,000.



Victa Grosso claims award with record breaking run

Victa Grosso for Tony Rasmussen was voted the unanimous Run of the Month for August after he broke the track record at Mount Gambier on Sunday, 28th August in a Grade 5 event over the 512m at only his first look at the venue.

He began nicely from box 7 to assume control and from there he raced away for a brilliant 9.50 length win. He ran 29.18 breaking the existing record by .01 held by Giant's Flash.

TAB MATCH RACE CHALLENGE – SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS NOMINATIONS CLOSE ON MONDAY

South Australia will again conduct the annual Match Race Challenge in September, to be held on Thursday, 22nd September during the rich Adelaide Cup Carnival. Previously conducted as a State of Origin Series between SA and Victorian greyhounds, this was changed last year to an Allstars edition due to Covid and the linking of feature races with Victoria being unavailable.

After liaising with GRV and due to a change in the feature race programming and conditions, the linking of the Group 1 Adelaide Cup with Victorian events is not available this year. Also the Million Dollar Chase which was programmed on top of the Group 1 Adelaide Cup has been changed to an earlier timeslot giving SA's prestigious event much needed clear air on the racing calendar.

To ensure that Angle Park TAB Match Race Challenge attracts the best greyhounds possible, GRSA has kept the conditions of the series the same as last year to be "SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS". It will be four [4] SA greyhounds taking on the four [4] best nominated greyhounds from anywhere in Australia.

GRSA will still guarantee the winner of the TAB Match Race Challenge direct entry into the \$100,000 to the winner Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final on Friday, 7th October [bypassing the Adelaide Cup Heats].

Nominations close at 9am on Monday, 19th September with GRSA.

Conditions of the TAB Match Race Challenge – SA TAKES ON THE ALL-STARS:

Eligibility as to who represents South Australia or All-Stars will be based around the National Championships domiciliary clause. Greyhounds need to be trained in the state they wish to represent for 76 days out of the last 150 days prior to the date that nominations close [19th September].

The best four [4] greyhounds nominated from SA will be selected by the GRSA Grader to represent "SA's Best". The best four [4] greyhounds nominated from Interstate will be selected by the GRSA Grader to represent "the All-Stars".

The Grader will use whatever information he has available to select those greyhounds including liaising with other State bodies as required. The SA Grader's decision will be final.

Those greyhounds not selected from Interstate will be given the opportunity to solo trial or race in another event on the night. Reserves will be declared, with one [1] from SA and one [1] from Interstate [dependant on nominations], which will replace the SA or All-Stars representative as required. For example the SA reserve will only replace an SA scratching.

The Grader will rate the four [4] greyhounds from SA and the four [4] from Interstate in order from 1 to 4, with No.1 being the highest rated greyhound from each group. The head-to-head matches will be decided by the two No.1 rated greyhounds competing against each other and then it will be 2 v 2, 3 v 3 and 4 v 4.

Prizemoney for each individual match will also reflect the seeding of greyhounds from 1 to 4, with the No.1 rated greyhound's racing for the most prizemoney in the head-to-head races. However, the overall winner of the race will still be determined on actual race times run by each greyhound [to three decimal places].

Please be advised a change to policy in regard to running of events at Coursing.

"For any GOTBA Coursing meetings programmed, effective immediately all Coursing events will be conducted and completed as programmed, there will not be a choice as to whether to run or not. The only time that a race will be declared a No Course is if there is a mechanical or other defect that may prevent a race from being completed in the opinion of the stewards at their discretion, supported by the rules of racing"

2022 SA COUNTRY CUP CONDITIONS

Below are details of how and where greyhounds can qualify for the \$7,500 SA Country Cup Final, to be run at Angle Park over 530 metres on Adelaide Cup G-SIX Final night Friday 7th October 2022.

Conditions below:

- All South Australian Greyhound Racing Clubs outside of Angle Park will conduct heats, or nominate greyhounds from which the Greyhound Racing SA Grading Department will choose two representatives. These meetings are Gawler Provincial 2, Murray Bridge One Turn Provincial 1 and Mount Gambier Provincial 1 & 2. [Performances at Gawler Provincial 1 meetings are not eligible for consideration]
- The event is open to all South Australian greyhounds that are not above Grade 5 at Angle Park [APK City A meeting only] over 530 metres at the time of nomination. Winner of each event takes a penalty including the final.

Special Exceptions:

Mount Gambier Club is allowed to include non-South Australian trainers under strict conditions:

- The trainer has had starters at 15 meetings for Mt Gambier in the previous 12 months.
- The trainer can only qualify for one of the clubs.
- The trainer must have trained the greyhound nominated for the previous 3 months.

- Graders' discretion will be used to determine the best nominated.
- The greyhound must be SA trained [except Mount Gambier as above].

o A South Australian trained greyhound is defined as one that has been racing in SA for a period of not less than 3 out of the 6 months immediately prior to the time of nomination.

- The greyhound must have started at least 2 times in the last 12 months at the track it is attempting to represent.

- There will be a maximum of two heats per Club with the winners of each heat qualifying. If there is only one heat conducted then the first two placegetters will qualify.

- The two reserves will be determined firstly by a ballot of the second placegetters from all heats. The third placegetters will then be considered by ballot if required. If a heat was not conducted at the track, then that track is not included in the ballot. Should a greyhound be withdrawn prior to the ballot, the next placed greyhound from that Club's heat will be selected.

- Once a greyhound has qualified from a Qualifying Heat, it is not eligible to compete at another track in this series, unless there are insufficient nominations to fill the field.

- Once qualified for the Country Cup Final the greyhound will be ineligible for the Adelaide Cup series or any other race on this Cup Final night.

- Lead up Heats may be up to 8 greyhounds however the Final on Adelaide Cup night will be a G-SIX Final

2022 GAWLER CUP CARNIVAL KICKS OFF ON MONDAY 17TH OCTOBER

The Gawler Gold Cup carnival will be run over three meetings this year. The Gawler GRC has been in consultation with the Thoroughbreds and Harness Racing in the region and has made a mini carnival with all three codes again running their main races for the year around the same time called the "Gawler Carnival of Cups".

Our carnival will kick off on Monday, 17th October with \$3,000 Heats for the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup over the 531m along with \$1,855 Heats of the Gawler Sprint Classic for open 400m greyhounds.

The Group 3 Gawler Cup Final will be run on Sunday night, 23rd October worth \$36,000 in prizemoney with the winner to receive \$25,000. This night will include the \$8,000 Gawler Sprint Classic Final and there will be a Consolation for the Gawler Gold Cup. To add to this feature night there will be the \$2,565 Heats of the "Bothing" Gawler Stayers Cup for open 643m greyhounds.

The \$8,500 Final of the Bothing Gawler Stayers Cup will be run on Sunday, 30th October along with the \$4,000 Gawler Anniversary Cup over the 531m rounding out the outstanding three meetings of racing.

Nominations for the Gawler Cup Heats and Gawler Sprint Classic Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Thursday, 13th October

Nominations for the Gawler Stayers Cup Heats close with GRSA at 9.00am on Wednesday, 19th October

Nominations for the Gawler Anniversary Cup close with GRSA at 9.00am on Wednesday, 26th October

Change of venues to accommodate the Gawler Cup Heats in October

Please note with the Gawler Cup Heats this year being conducted on Monday night, 17th October our normal schedule will change slightly.

Angle Park will run on Friday, 14th October with a day meeting at City B class while Sunday night, 16th October will be a Murray Bridge Prov 1 meeting around the One Turn. Please check the October All Tracks calendar for programmed events.

CANCELLING TRIALS

If Trainers have booked trials for a session and decide not to come with all of their booked greyhounds, it would be appreciated if they could notify GRSA so amendments can be made.

If this is at short notice then there is little that could be done, however, if trainers know their confirmed numbers during normal business hours then please advise GRSA.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY AND NORMAL TRIALS – TIMING FOR BOOKINGS

Trainers are reminded of their requirements when booking Satisfactory Trials and normal trials at Mt. Gambier. Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays which need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

For normal trial bookings they need to be done by 4pm the day before for both Wednesday and Saturday. They will not be accepted after this time. Effective immediately.

GRSA is working with the Club in regard to an online trial booker system which would help the management of these normal trials.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

NOMINATIONS FOR SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Recently we have had several trainers nominating online using the Qualifying Trial meeting for Satisfactory Trials. The online Qualifying Trial meetings are for trainers to nominate their greyhound which they wish to improve on the Order of Choice for the upcoming meeting only. Trainers, whom have a greyhound that is required to complete a Satisfactory Trial, are required to contact the offices of GRSA and provide the relevant details. By contacting the office, you will be advised of any further requirements that are needed for the Satisfactory Trial.

MURRAY BRIDGE TRIALLING TIMES

Murray Bridge trial on Monday morning and Wednesday night on both tracks. On Monday morning the One Turn track starts at 8am and will go to 9.30am and then the Straight track will follow on from there. On the Wednesday night during non daylight saving Straight track trials will start at 4.30pm with the One Turn at 5.30pm. During Daylight saving the Straight track will start at 5.30pm with the One Turn 6.30pm.

Online bookings are now available for both tracks.

GAWLER TRIALS TO MOVE TO ONLINE

In the next month GRSA will be working with the Gawler GRC and staff to transition the Gawler trial booking process to online like Angle Park and Murray Bridge for their Monday and Thursday morning sessions. An implementation date will be advised shortly.



NEW HANDLER VESTS COMING IN SEPTEMBER

GRSA will be introducing new handler vests to be worn at all race meets beginning early September. Keep an eye on GRSA's channels for more information to come.

GRSA online trial booking system FAQs

Below are details regarding the Trial Booker process. GRSA is working at getting all tracks in SA on the online booking process to assist with clubs, staff and participants at trial sessions.

Below are examples provided a few years ago so the dates and distances will have changed, however, will give industry a good idea when they log on to the Trial Booker which they can do through the GRSA website.

How do I register an account to book public trials online?


Visit www.trialbooker.com, click on the “register an account” link and fill in the appropriate details.

How do I book a specific trial online?

To book 4 trials, click Book 4:



As soon as you have pressed the Book button, those trials are booked and yours to keep. You then customise the distance, number of dogs, and type for each trial, and confirm them

Field Trials

Existing field trials will appear in each block. To book a dog in an existing field trial simply click the Book 1/2/3 button.



If there are no available field trials of the distance and type you require then feel free to create one yourself. Simply book a slot as-per-normal and select Maiden Field or Performed Field, as shown below.



Note: booking a dog or several dogs in a field trial counts as 1 trial towards your 4 trial maximum.

When do trial bookings commence each week?

Bookings for meetings will commence at 11.30am the working day prior to the trial session [henceforth known as “booking opening time”].

Is there a limit to how many trials I can book online?

Yes: 4. If you wish to reserve more than 4 trials a session then you must phone the office as per normal. For example, in the screenshot below, it indicates that you can book 3 more trials using TrialBooker without phoning.

Why am I limited to 4 trials in one block?

In short: to prevent abuse of the system. To book more phone the office after booking opening time.

Can I cancel a trial booking online? Yes: Press the X button and confirm.



Will I receive a confirmation to confirm my online trial booking?

Your trials are reserved for you as soon as you press the “Book 4” button [or “Book 4” or whichever it may be]. You must then confirm the details of those trials [distance, number of dogs etc.]. There will be a summary of your bookings in each session on the Home page.

Can I book trials for other licensees? No—under no circumstances may you book trials for anyone other than yourself using TrialBooker. Dogs must be brought in and paid for by the person whose name they were booked under. If you wish to share a non-field trial with another trainer you must book over the phone.

How can I book a trial if I don't have access to a computer?

You can still book trials by calling the office after booking opening time.

Distribution of WAP Payments between Trainers and Owners

GRSA would like to remind all participants that receive a WAP that the payment is the equivalent of prizemoney. If you are currently responsible for distributing prizemoney to another party then the same approach applies to WAP payments.

From GRSA's perspective the position in relation to third parties is reflective of OzChase records and is as follows:

- If GRSA have been notified of an ownership split [which is recorded in OzChase] then you DO NOT need to make a payment to owners for the WAP because GRSA will do this automatically; however
- If you ordinarily forward on payments to owners on your own accord, then you DO need to do the same for the WAP. Each remittance will include the name of the dog for which the WAP is being made.

Example to help participants understand the WAP they receive

It is not uncommon for GRSA to receive requests for more information in relation to how the WAP is calculated for their particular dogs(s). The example below is provided to assist in the general understanding of the calculation.

Assumptions:

In this example, assume the owner/trainer received **\$1,000** in prizemoney for any/all races for the month.

In this the total prizemoney (paid to all participant) is **\$700,000**.

In this example, the total WAP is **\$50,000**.

In this example, the owner/trainer would receive a WAP of **\$71.43**, calculated as:

$$\text{\$1,000} \div \text{\$700,000} \times \text{\$50,000} = \text{\$71.43}$$

THE NEW TIRS: Q&A

I thought I would write some questions and answers this month on the new Track Injury Recovery Scheme (TIRS). This is a new policy and process, so we will refine our procedures when we need to. Your cooperation in this is appreciated.

Q: When does the new scheme commence?

A: The new scheme applies to eligible injuries from July 2022. It is not retrospective [that is, it does not apply before July 2022].

Q: My greyhound is injured at a race meeting. Do I do anything different from the old policy?

A: You proceed pretty much the same as the old policy. As always, the health and welfare of the greyhound is paramount. Be guided by veterinary advice.

Q: What application form should I use?

A: We have a new application form that you can download from the website. It can be filled out and emailed [PDF]. Please make sure you complete all parts to avoid delays in processing. We also accept the old application form, but sometimes we might need to contact you with further questions.

Q: My greyhound is injured at a trial. What do I do?

A: You must seek immediate veterinary treatment. This is the first step and always the most important. Take a note of the GRSA official, club member or veterinarian on duty. Take note of the location, date and trial number. You then fill out and lodge the application, after all relevant areas of the application are filled out.

Q: Do I need a veterinarian's Tax Invoice?

A: Yes. Please pay the veterinarians Tax Invoice and submit the receipt with your application. In some circumstances, GRSA can pay the tax invoice directly to the veterinarian up to the scheme maximum, in which case you need to pay the gap fee [much like Medicare]. Please contact GRSA for assistance.

Q: I will not pay the veterinarian until I get my money. Is that okay?

A: No. Your relationship with your veterinarian is like any other service provider and you must pay for service. You cannot hold over payment relying on GRSA. This is a breach of your contract with the service provider and GRSA consider on going bad debts as a breach of the rules of racing. If you have an issue paying, contact GRSA and we will try to assist in cooperation with the veterinarian. Your veterinarian has spent many years studying a very expensive course and has many overheads. Veterinarians are dedicated professionals, and we cannot afford to see their numbers reduce due to the costs of business. Please look after them.

Q: The veterinarian will take care of the paperwork and lodge

it for me. Is that okay?

A: No. It is your responsibility as the applicant to gather and lodge all the paperwork.

Q: I am from interstate, should I need to know about the policy? I only visit here.

A: Yes. The new policy has strict safeguards relating to greyhound injury management and recovery. They apply to any registered person who is the custodian of a greyhound injured on a SA racetrack. Failure to obey the policy, whether you claim or not, will result in you being banned from nominating greyhounds for events in South Australia. Where a breach of the Greyhounds Australasia Rules is detected, you will also face inquiry, regardless of where you live.

Q: What are the scheme maximums?

A: GRSA will pay \$3500.00 towards surgery and \$300.00 for recovery, as scheme maximums. Where no surgery is required, up to \$200.00 is payable.

Q: My greyhound needs follow up surgery. Can I claim?

A: Once your application is accepted, if you need further surgery, GRSA may pay an additional sum, provided the total does not exceed the scheme maximum [\$3500.00] and it satisfies the policy requirements. Please read the policy document for more information on what is covered.

Q: Where do I get further information?

A: Please read the policy document and application form, available on the GRSA website.

ADELAIDE CUP 2022 & COVID-19

For the first time in a long time, the Adelaide Cup this year will be free of COVID-19 controls and restrictions. GRSA will continue, as best practice, to provide a venue that minimises your risk to COVID-19.

To that end, please remember it is always good practice to observe social distancing and wash your hands when needed. If you feel unwell, it is best not to attend. Importantly, if you are isolating as a COVID-19 positive case [or under some other SA Health direction], it is still an offence to breach those requirements. Finally, you are always welcome to wear your own mask if you want you.

QUALIFYING AND SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Angle Park qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Tuesday night between 6.50pm and 7.15pm. Qualifying will be for the following Monday meeting (drawn Thursday). Nominations close at 12.30pm on the Tuesday (for online nominations 11.59pm Monday).

Gawler qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Thursday morning from 7am. Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm Wednesday the day prior.

Murray Bridge qualifying and satisfactory trials are held every Wednesday night at approximately 5.15pm (between the end of the straight track trials and the beginning of the one turn track trials). Qualifying will be for the following Friday/Sunday meeting (drawn the following week). Nominations close at 12.30pm on Wednesday (for online nominations 11.50pm Tuesday).

ANGLE PARK

SINGLE TRIALS

A reminder to trainers that single trials can be booked with two greyhounds however you need to advise when booking of your intention to do this. If you wish to put three or more into this trial then a field trial will have to be booked.

BOOKING NUMBER FOR TRIALS

Participants wishing to book trials are required to ring 8243 7172, this phone line will only be used for trial bookings and will queue participants. By having this one number with participants queuing makes this process to be a more efficient way of booking trials.

There will be NO trials accepted through the normal administration number. To be fair to everyone GRSA will only accept bookings using the new number or alternatively logon to trialbooker.com, create an account and book your own trials.

POLICY FOR TRIALLING AT ANGLE PARK, GAWLER AND MURRAY BRIDGE BEFORE THE RACE MEETING

Policy Background

This policy is to detail the procedure for trainers seeking greyhounds to trial before race meetings. This policy is effective from 2 May 2019.

Race Meeting Trial Policy

This policy is in place for the following race meetings:

Angle Park Monday, Gawler Wednesday and Sunday, Murray Bridge Tuesday and Friday.

Two fields from the boxes with a maximum of four (4) greyhounds. Trials may be conducted at any time during the race meeting from immediately after kenneling until after the last race, at Stewards' discretion.

The following lists the order in which greyhounds will be selected in the event if more than eight (8) greyhounds are nominated:

1. Reserves at the meeting that do not obtain a start
2. Trainers that have greyhounds engaged and are located more than 100km in distance from the track
3. Satisfactory trials

Procedure/criteria

1. For Angle Park Monday night, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 9am and 10am on Monday to nominate. Should the Monday be a public holiday bookings are to be made between 8am and 9am on the scratching number.
2. For Murray Bridge Tuesday & Friday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times.
3. For Gawler Wednesday, the trainer is to contact GRSA between 3pm and 4pm the day before. Should any of these times fall on a public holiday bookings are to be made during scratching times. For Gawler Sunday, the trainer is to contact the scratching number on Sunday between 8am and 9am.
4. Other than reserve greyhounds, trainers will be restricted to trialling one (1) greyhound unless nominations determine otherwise.
5. Stewards will allocate the box for the greyhound.
6. Trials will be 515m, 530m & 531m in distance as first preference. Other distances considered depending on nominations.
7. Greyhounds currently under suspension are ineligible to trial unless they are undertaking a satisfactory trial to be cleared.
8. Greyhound registration cards must be produced at kennelling time.
9. Trainers with other greyhounds engaged can utilise the extra kennel space until such time they are ready to leave. Trainers with no other greyhounds engaged will be permitted to leave with Stewards permission.
10. In the case of race at Murray Bridge, trials will only be available on the track that is prepared to race that day i.e. Friday meeting on the u-shaped track, trials will be on the u-shaped track only.

Please note: If there are 12 races at Angle Park, Gawler or Murray Bridge there will be NO trials.

The Angle Park Vet Clinic and/or swab kennels cannot be used to accommodate any additional greyhounds due to operational requirements of the Clinic and Stewards.

It is vital that trainers nominate to trial at these race meetings. If you are unable to nominate at these times, please contact GRSA as soon as possible as permission may be given at GRSA's discretion to accept bookings outside these times.

Exceptions to this policy

Thursday nights are kept available for interstate greyhounds to solo trial in a lead-up to SA Group races as well as local greyhound's trialling for Group racing interstate.

Upon request, local greyhounds will be allowed to solo trial in a lead-up to a feature race and they will take one of the eight (8) kennels available for trialling greyhounds ahead of the policy and sit separate to the four (4) dog trials. Races considered to be a feature are: Adelaide Cup, Gawler Cup, Oaks, Derby, Howard Ashton, Brian Johnstone, SA Sprint, SA Distance Championship, SA Anniversary Cup, SA Country Cup, National Finals and any interstate Group race

Local greyhounds will be permitted to trial on a race night, where they are in preparation for a feature event, nominated for a meeting and the race does not stand up. This will include all distances and also take precedence over the policy. If a greyhound qualifies for a feature final and requires a trial in between, this will be conducted as a solo trial and will sit separately to the four (4) dog trials.

MOUNT GAMBIER SATISFACTORY TRIALS

Mt Gambier hold trials on Wednesday and Saturday mornings with Satisfactory trials ONLY being conducted on Wednesdays and need to be booked with Barry Shephard from the Club on 0419 824 512 no later than 12pm the day before.

At Race meetings Satisfactory trials can be done when less than 12 races. When there are 12 races these can be considered, however, the trainer will not be able to kennel and must take their greyhounds home straight after the trial. These race day trials will also need to be booked through Barry at the Club. GRSA administration staff will NOT accept these bookings and trainers will be directed to contact Barry Shephard.

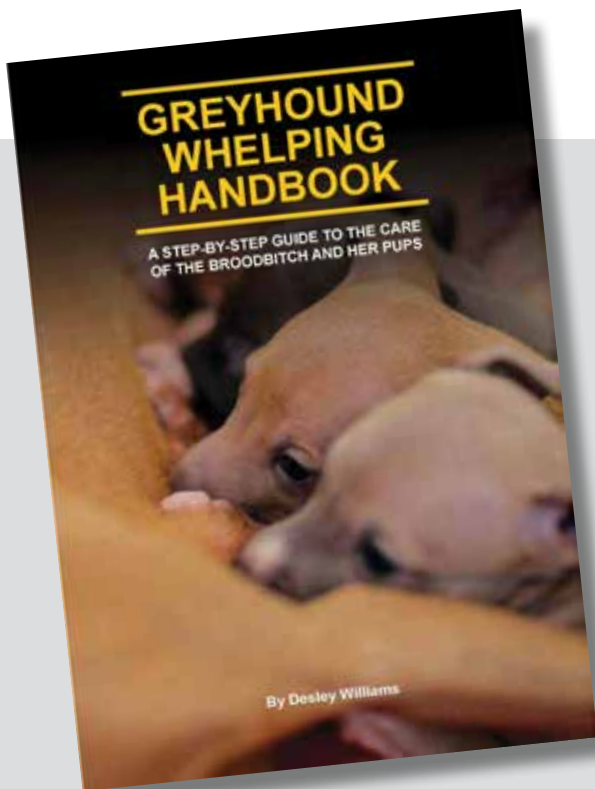
